[57] The ornamental design for a bowling pin clock, as shown and described.

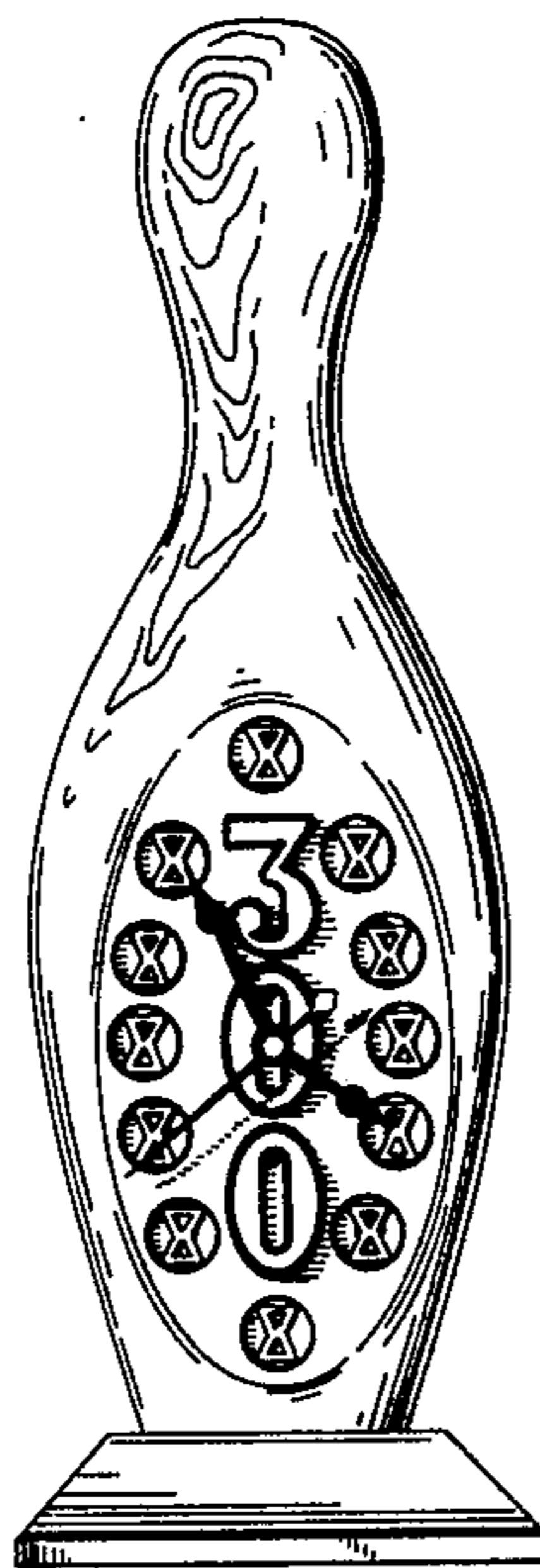
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear an isometric view thereof.



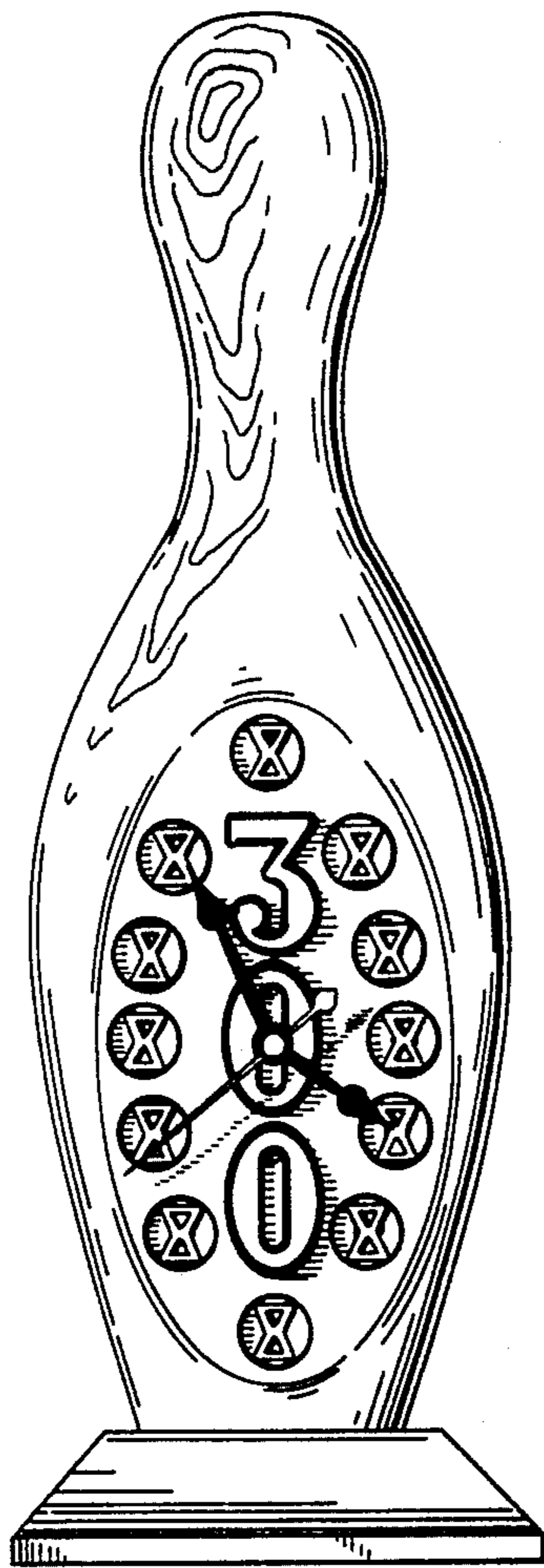

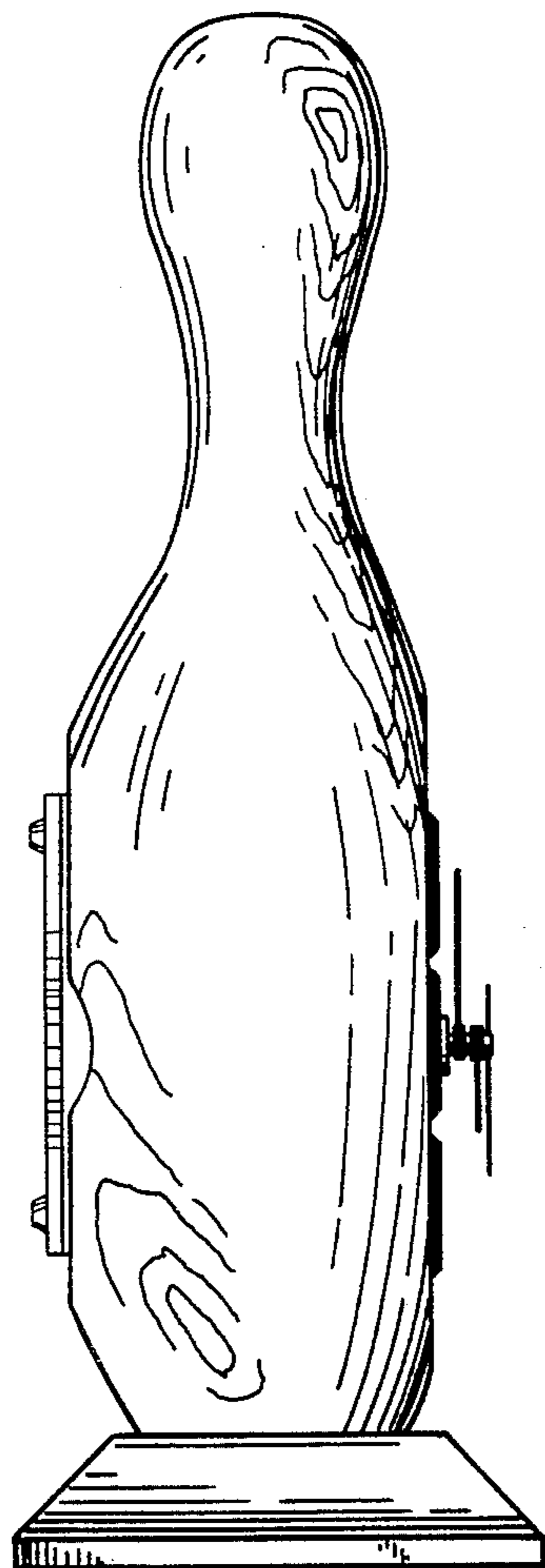

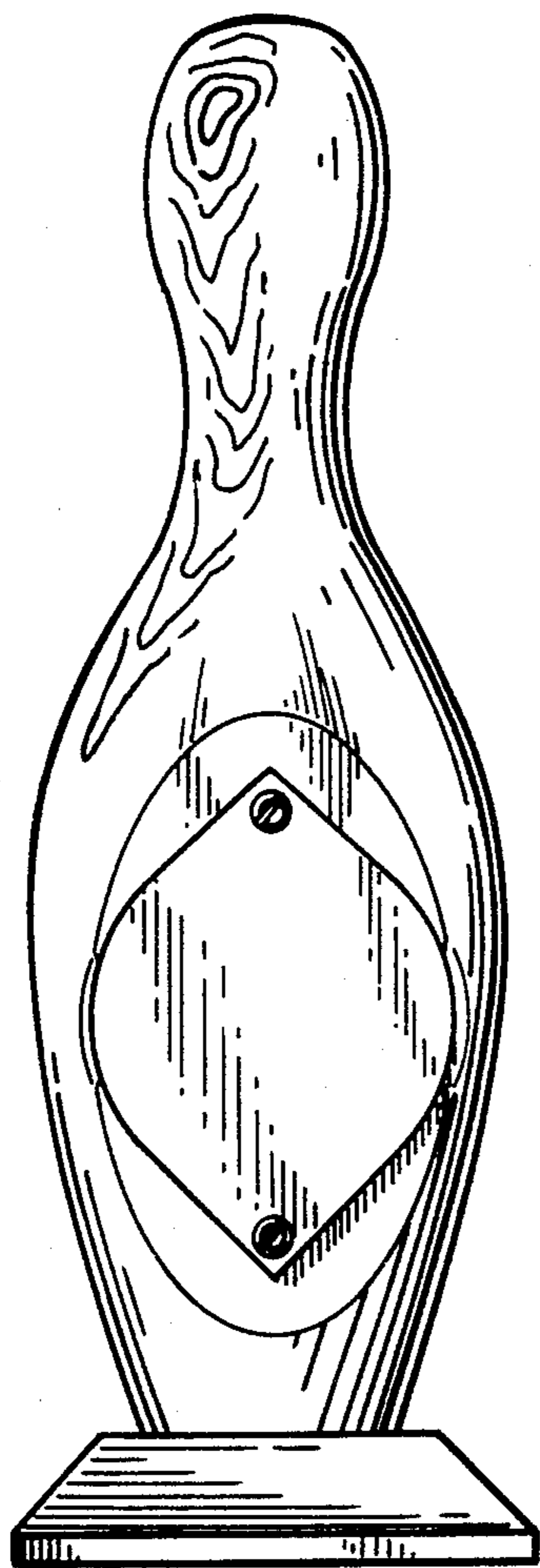

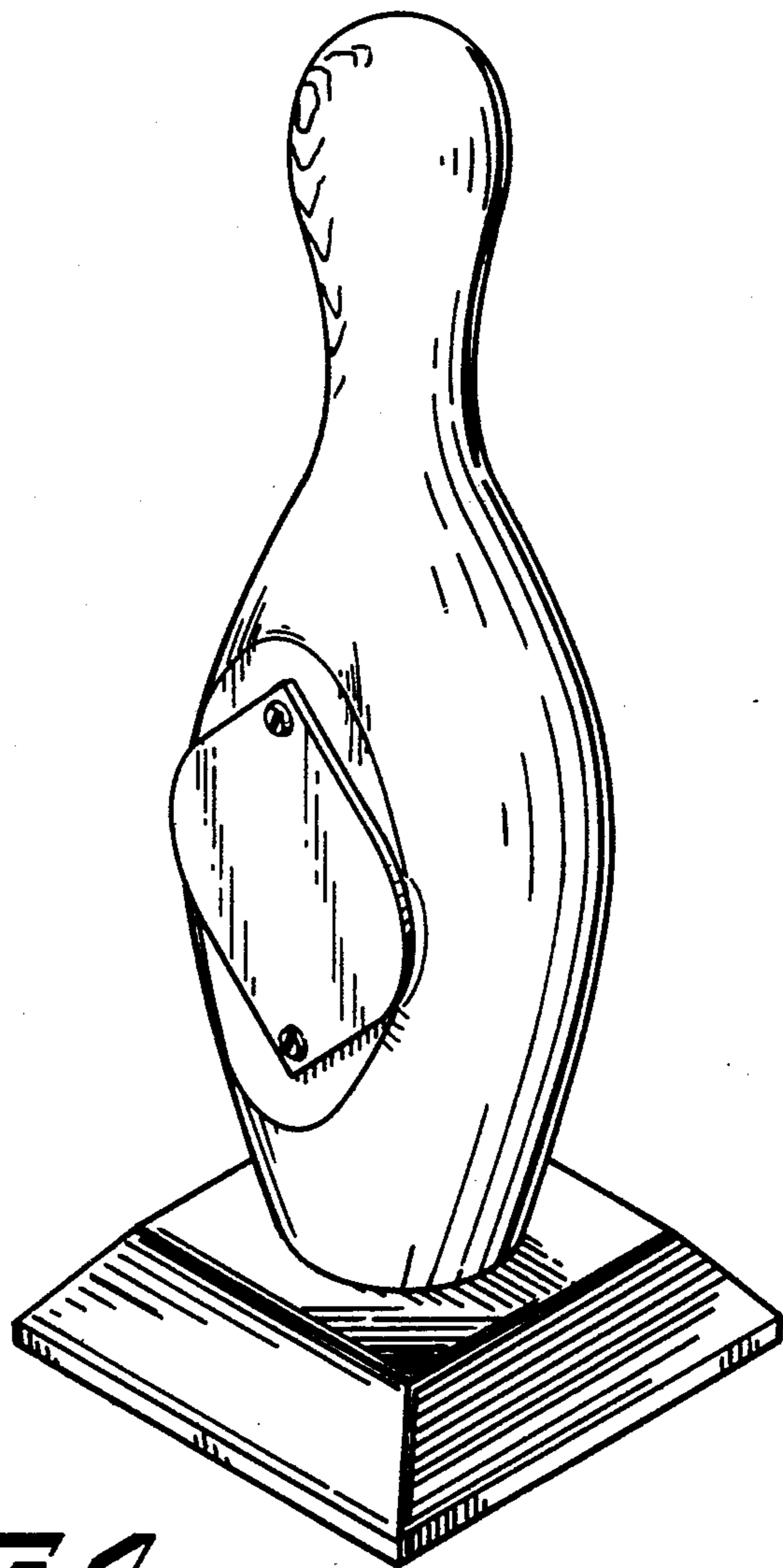
