[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a necklace, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a necklace showing my new design, the rear being the same;
FIG. 2 is a fragmentary top plan view showing the clasp; and
FIG. 3 is a fragmentary bottom plan view showing the medallion and neck chain junctions.
The broken line showing of indicia on the medallion is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

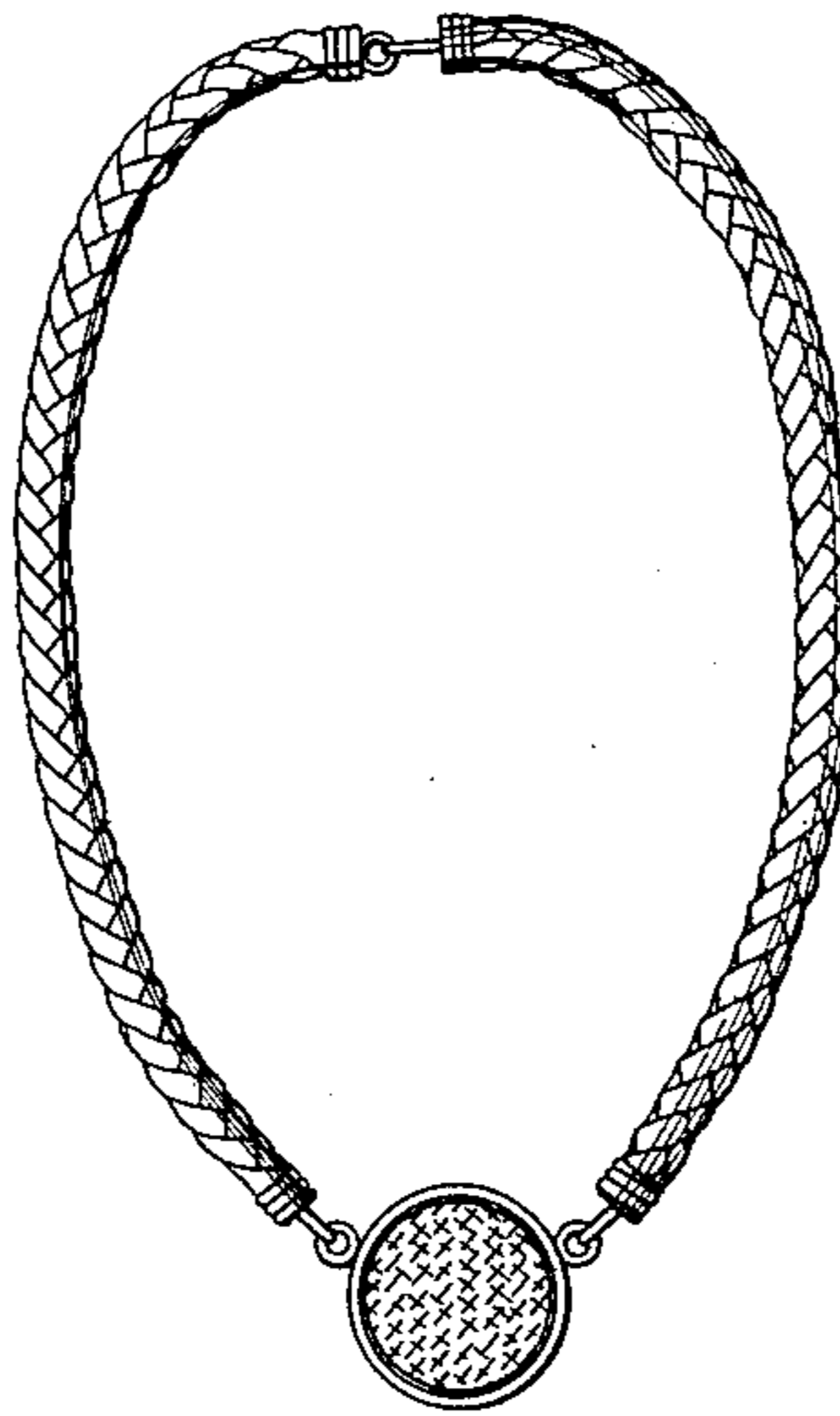

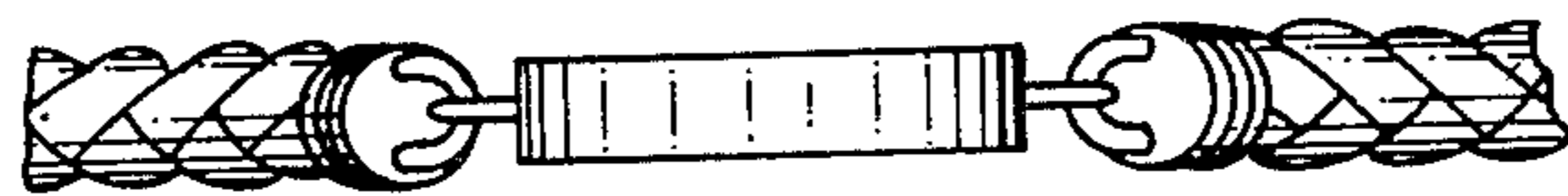
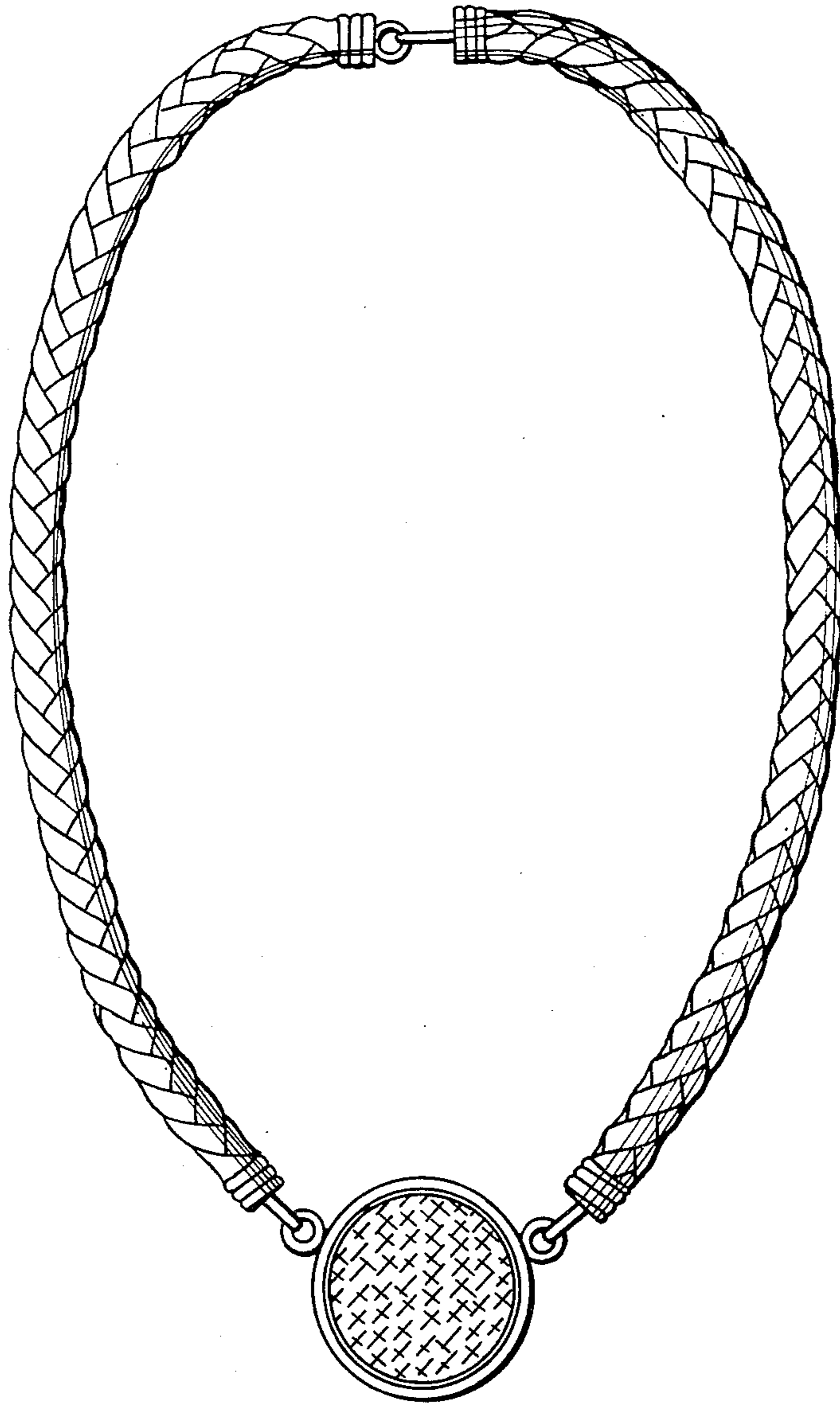
