[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floor standing enclosure for personal computer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front left side perspective view of a floor standing enclosure for a personal computer showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear left side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively right and left side elevational views thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

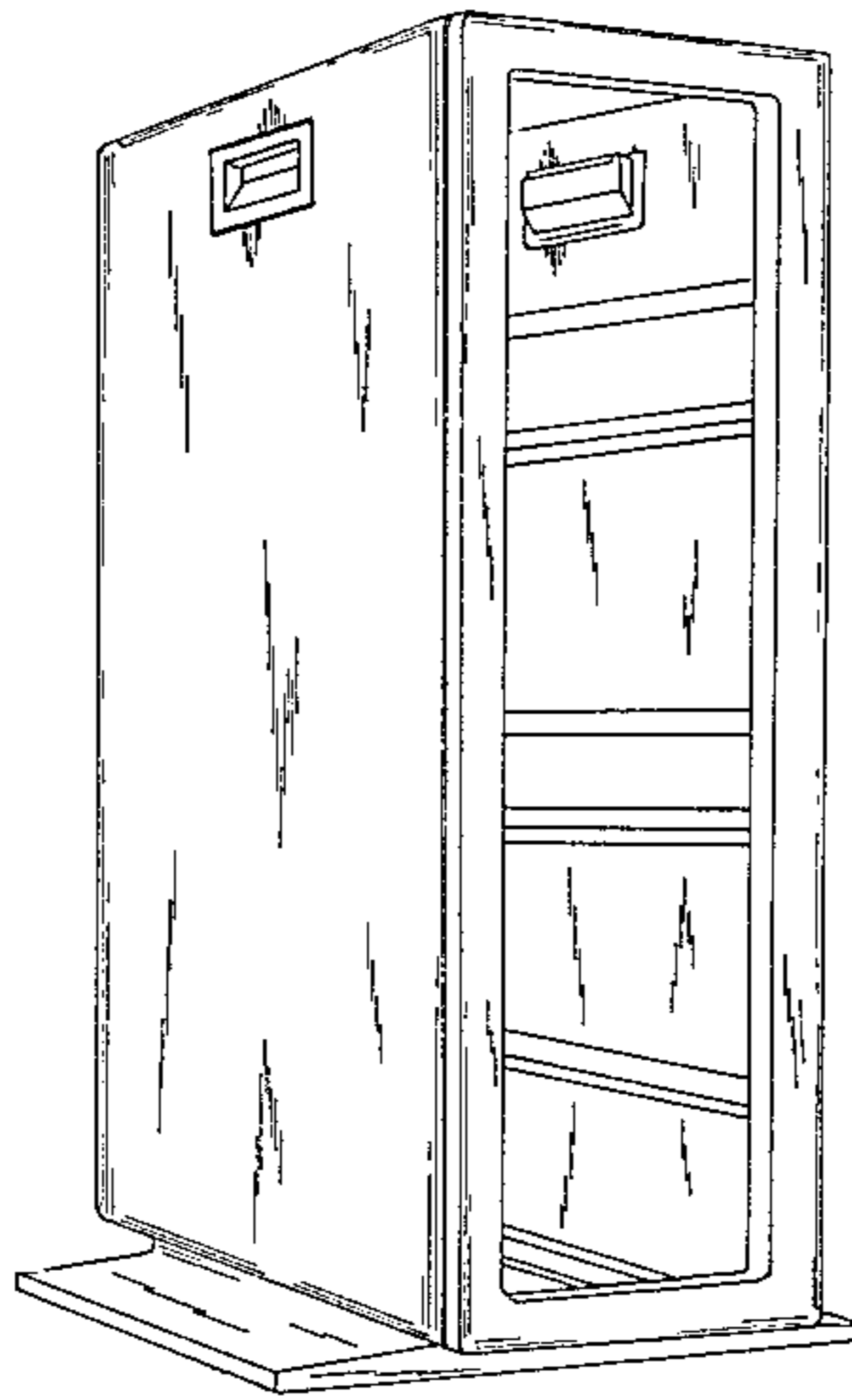

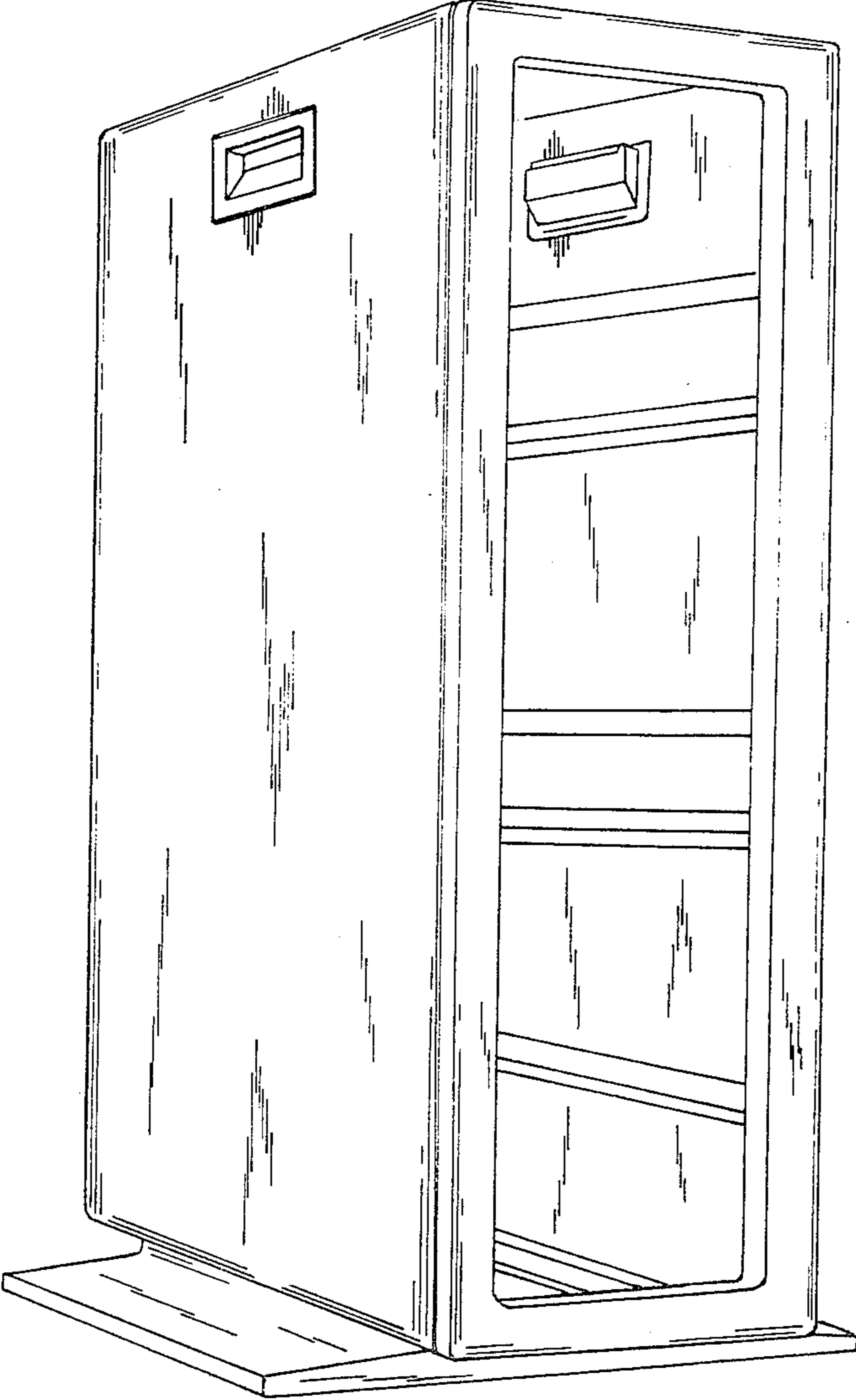

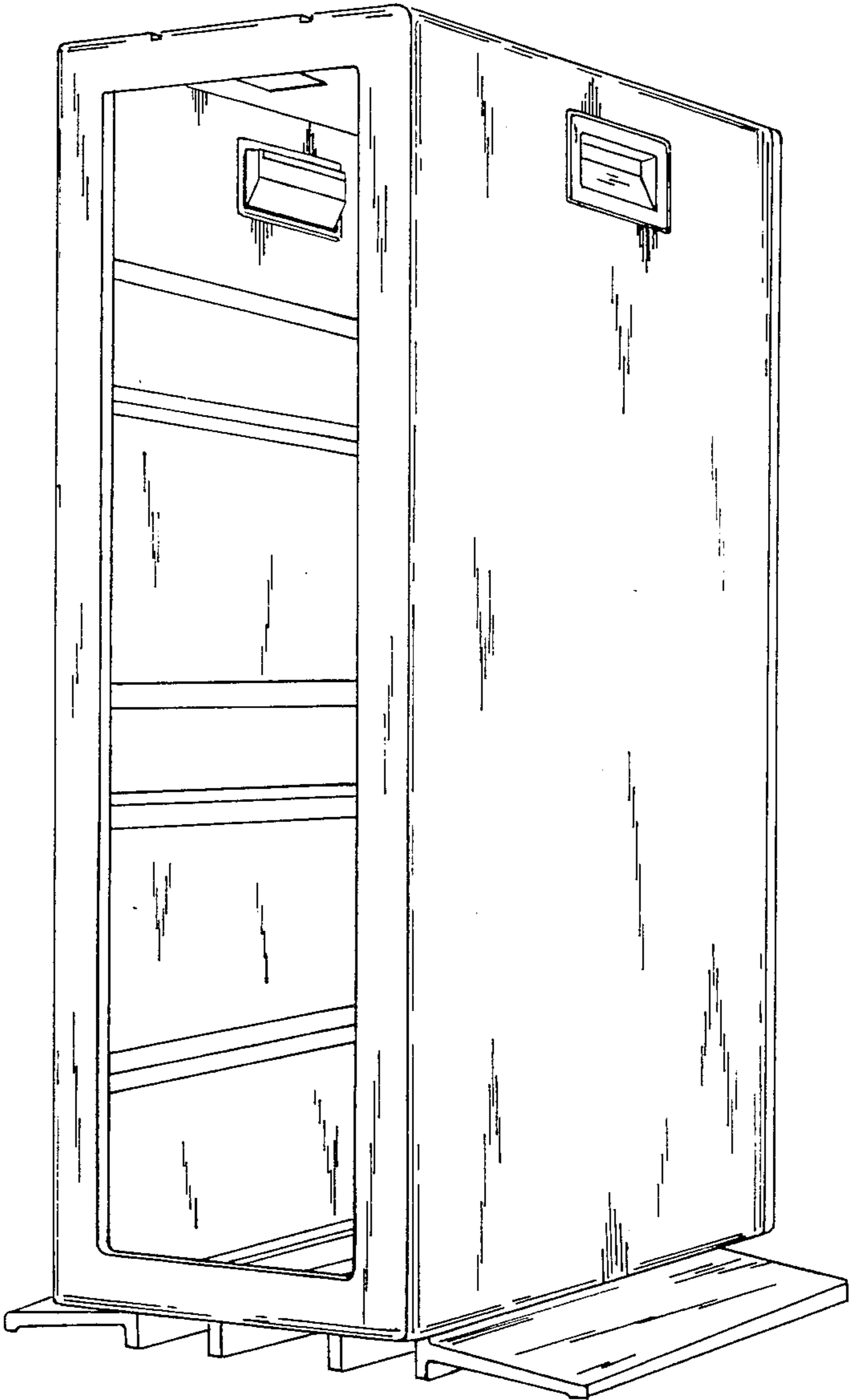

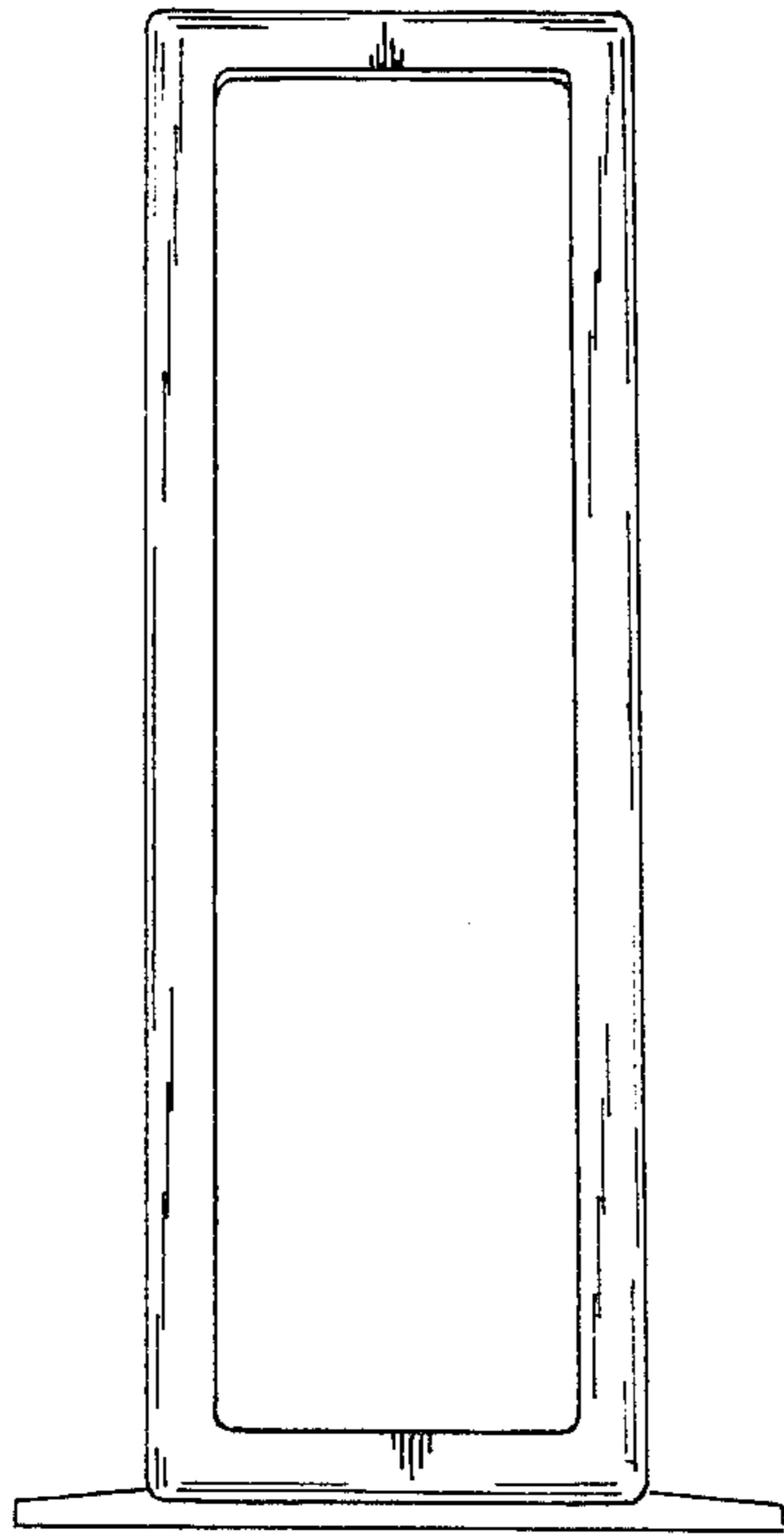

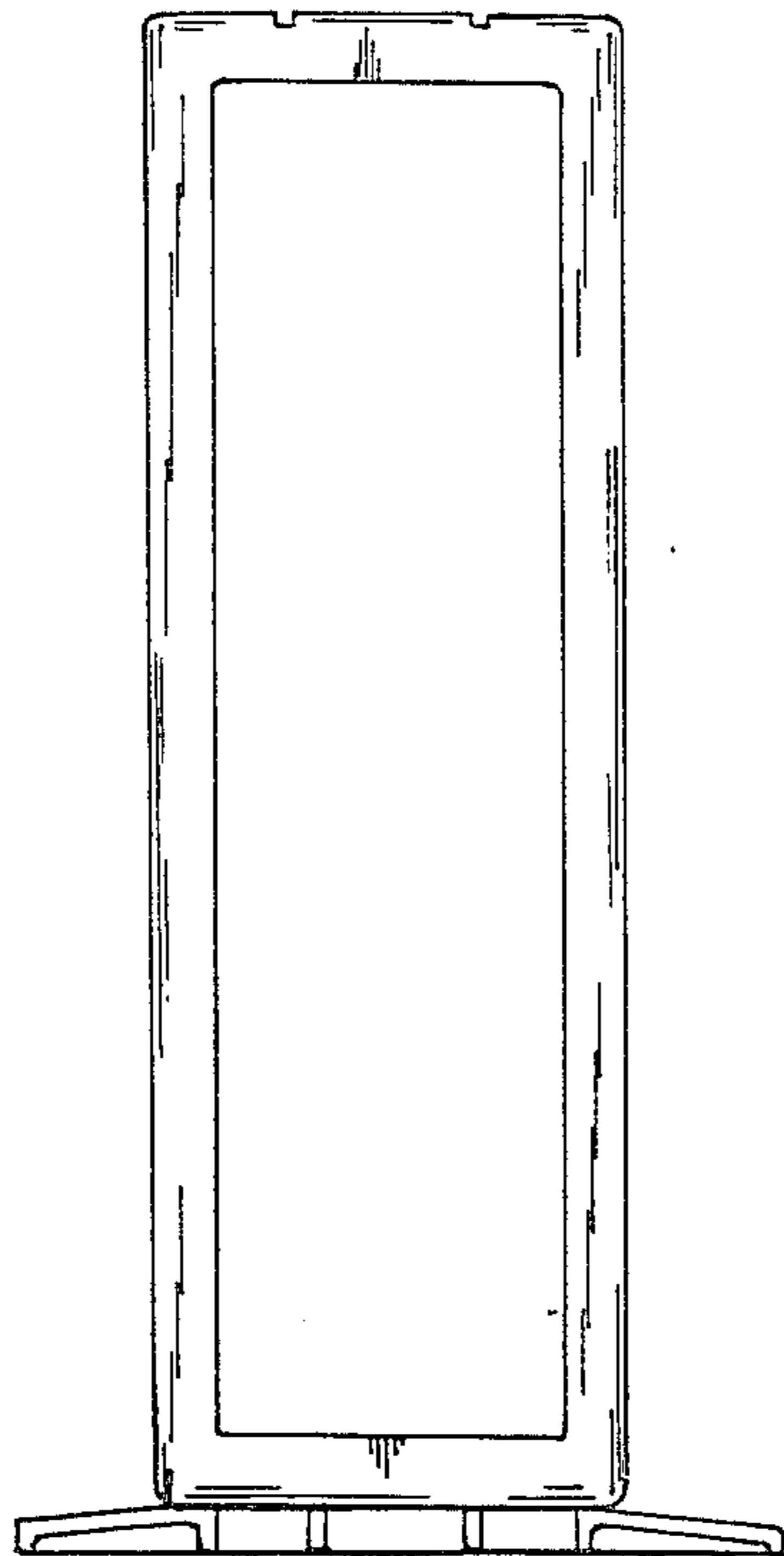

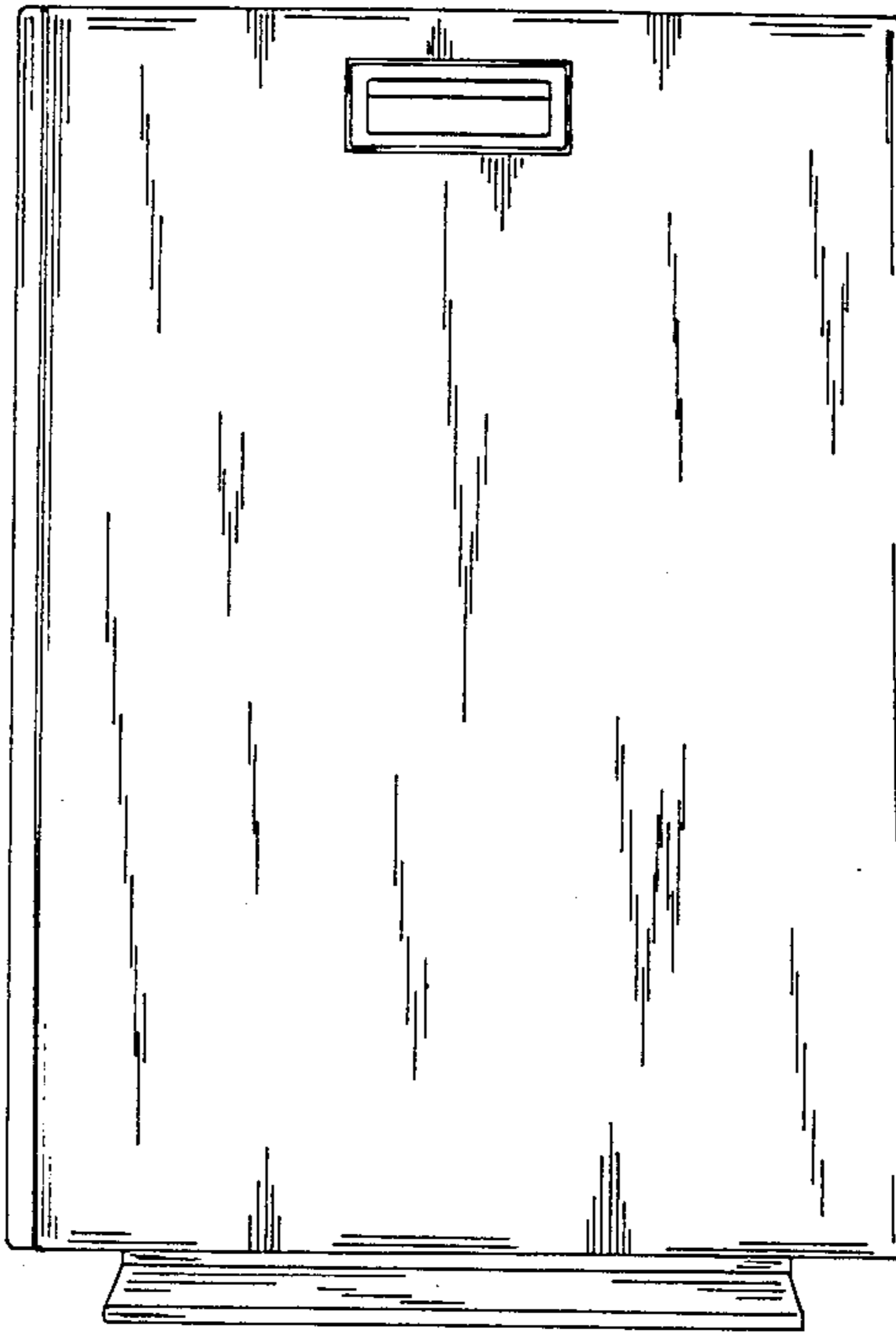

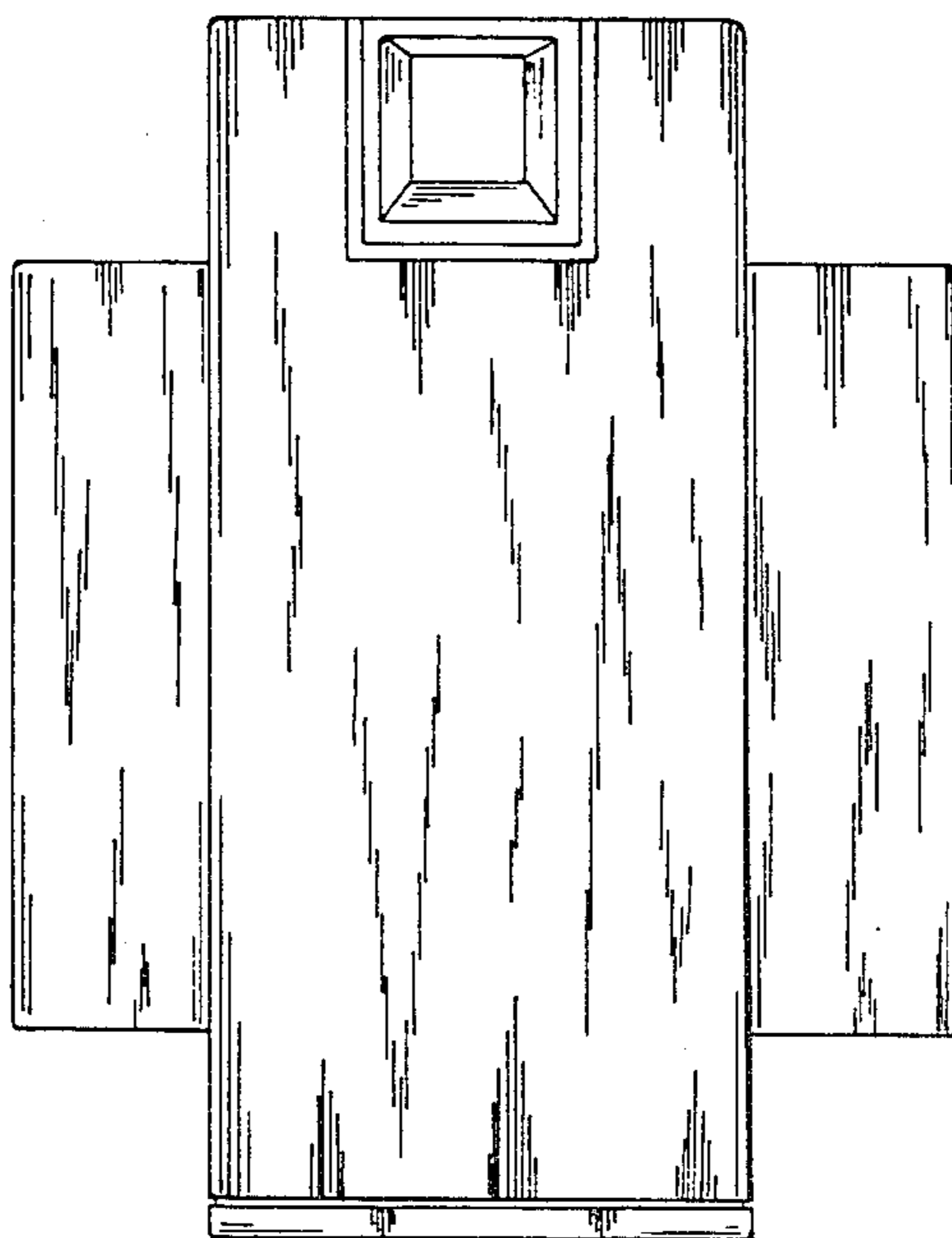
