DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy kettle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

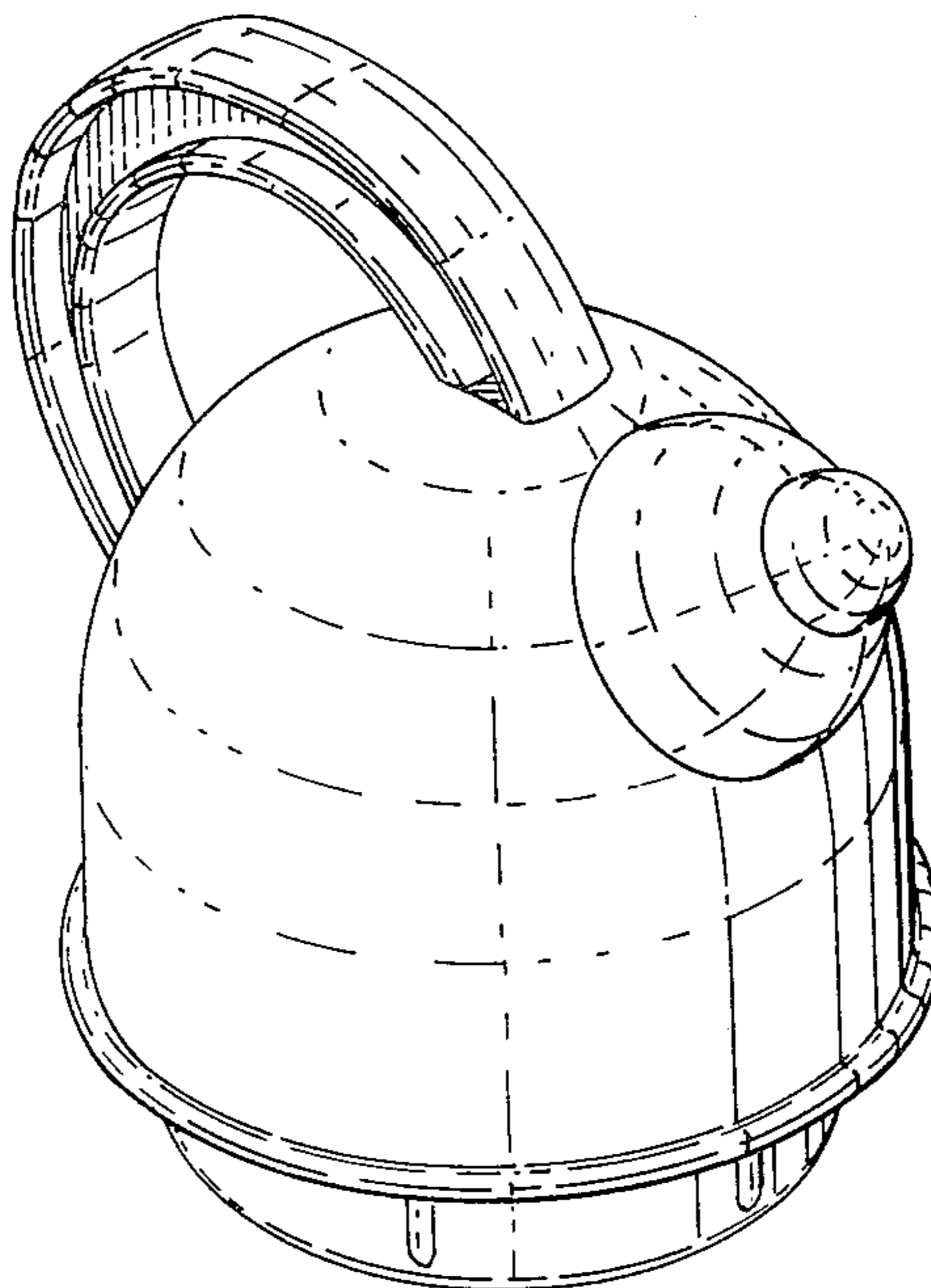

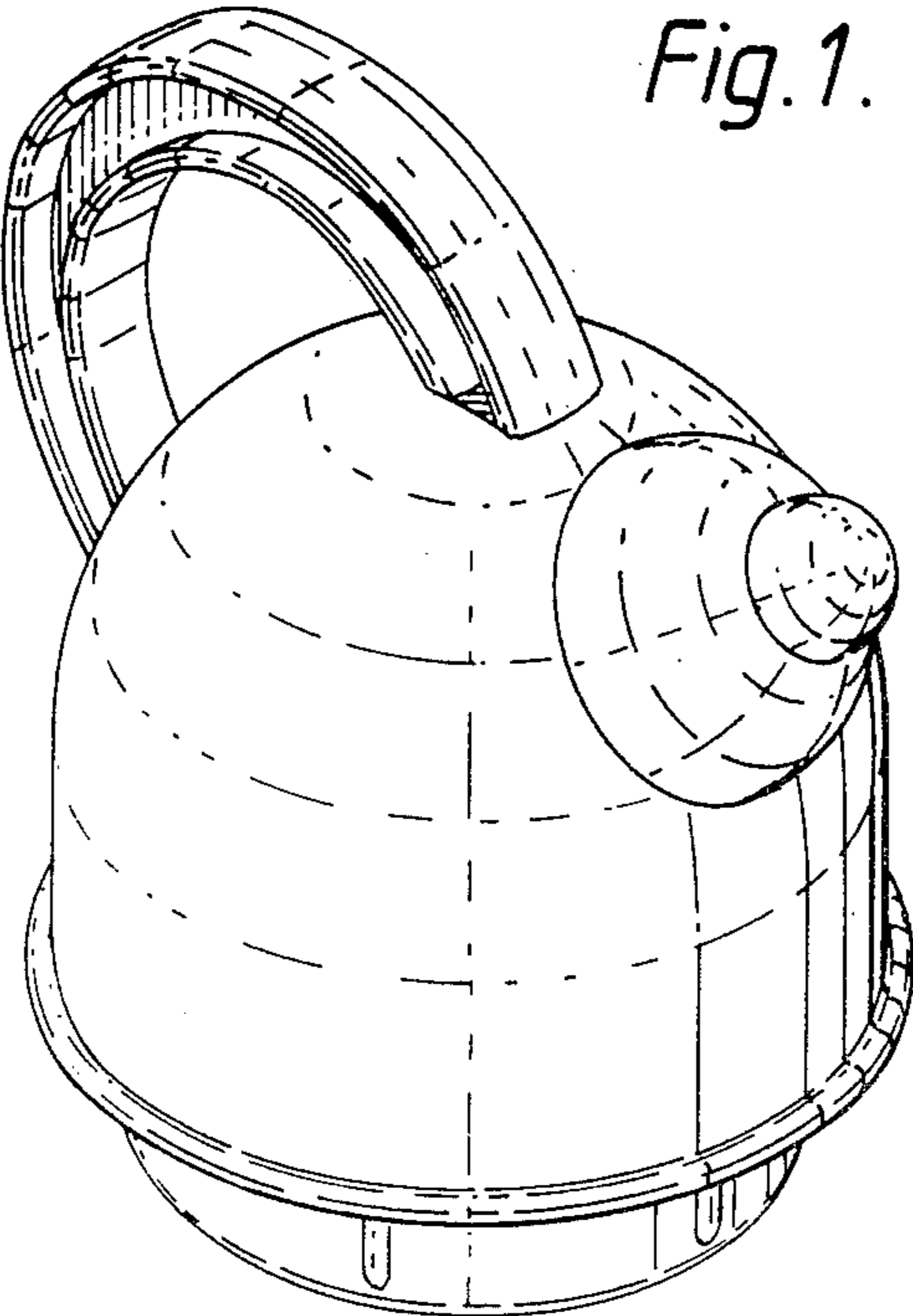
