The ornamental design for a case for a compact disc surface cleaning device and compact disc cleaning support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a disc-cleaning device showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

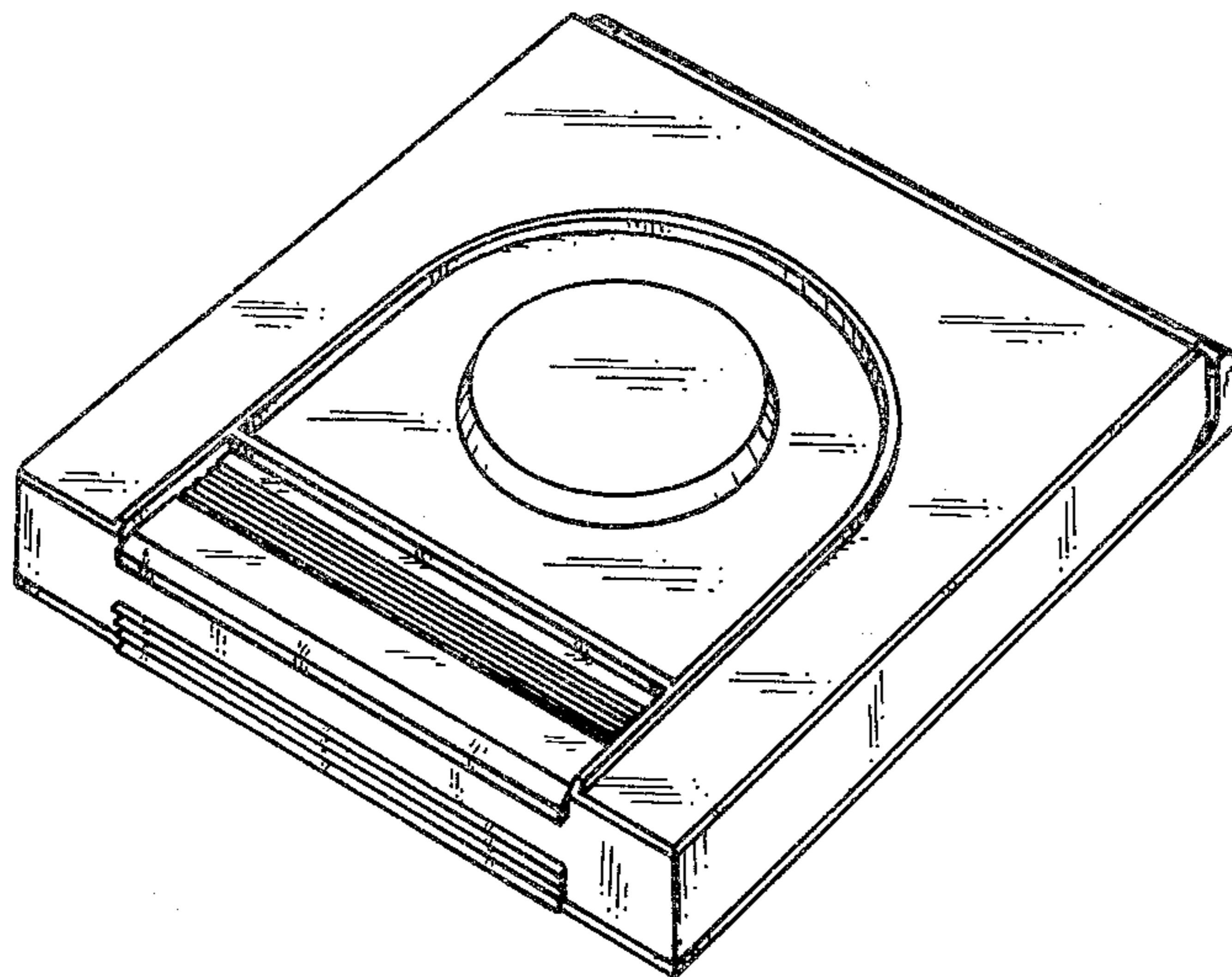
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof but on a reduced scale.

The case is shaded to indicate translucent material.



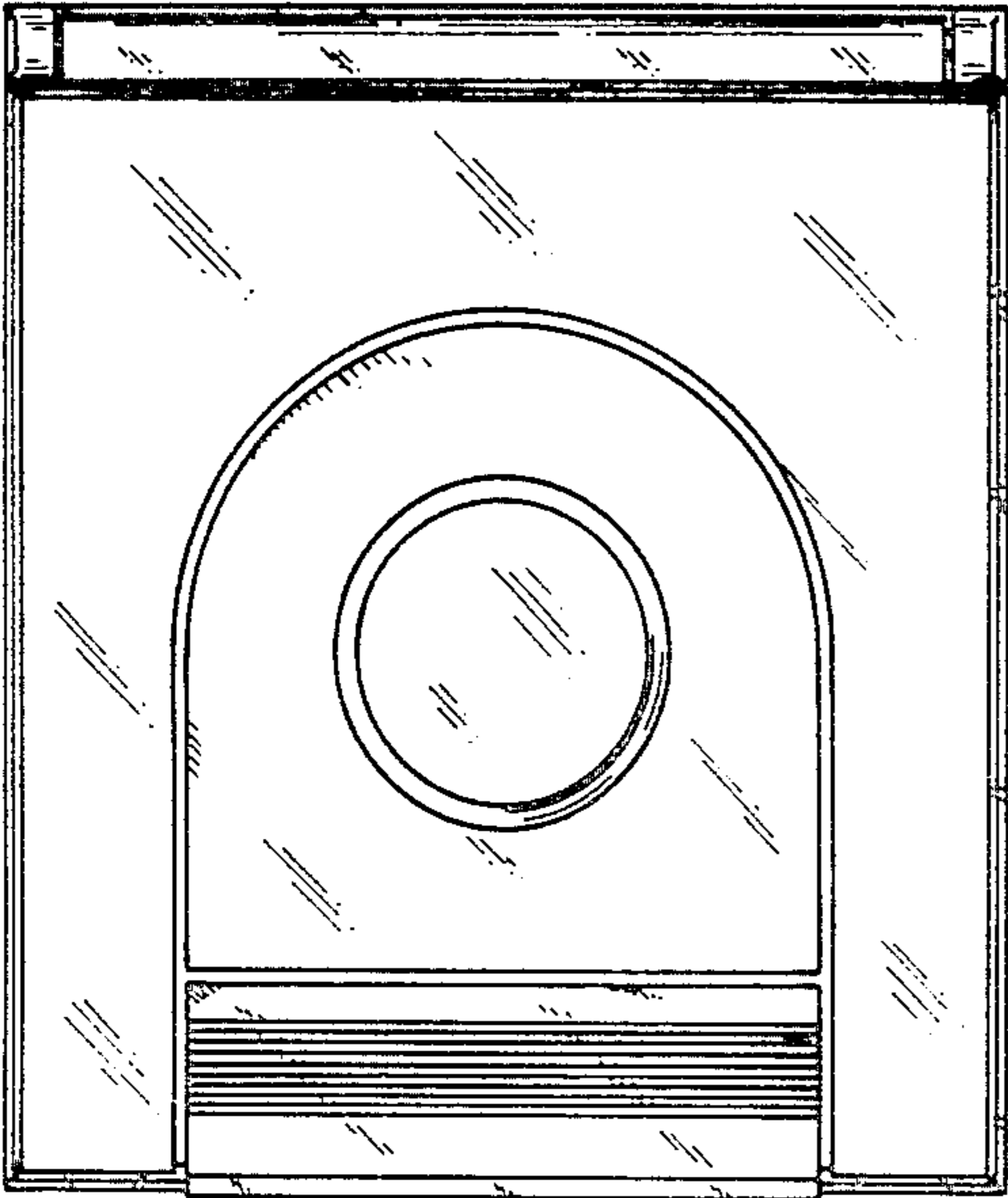

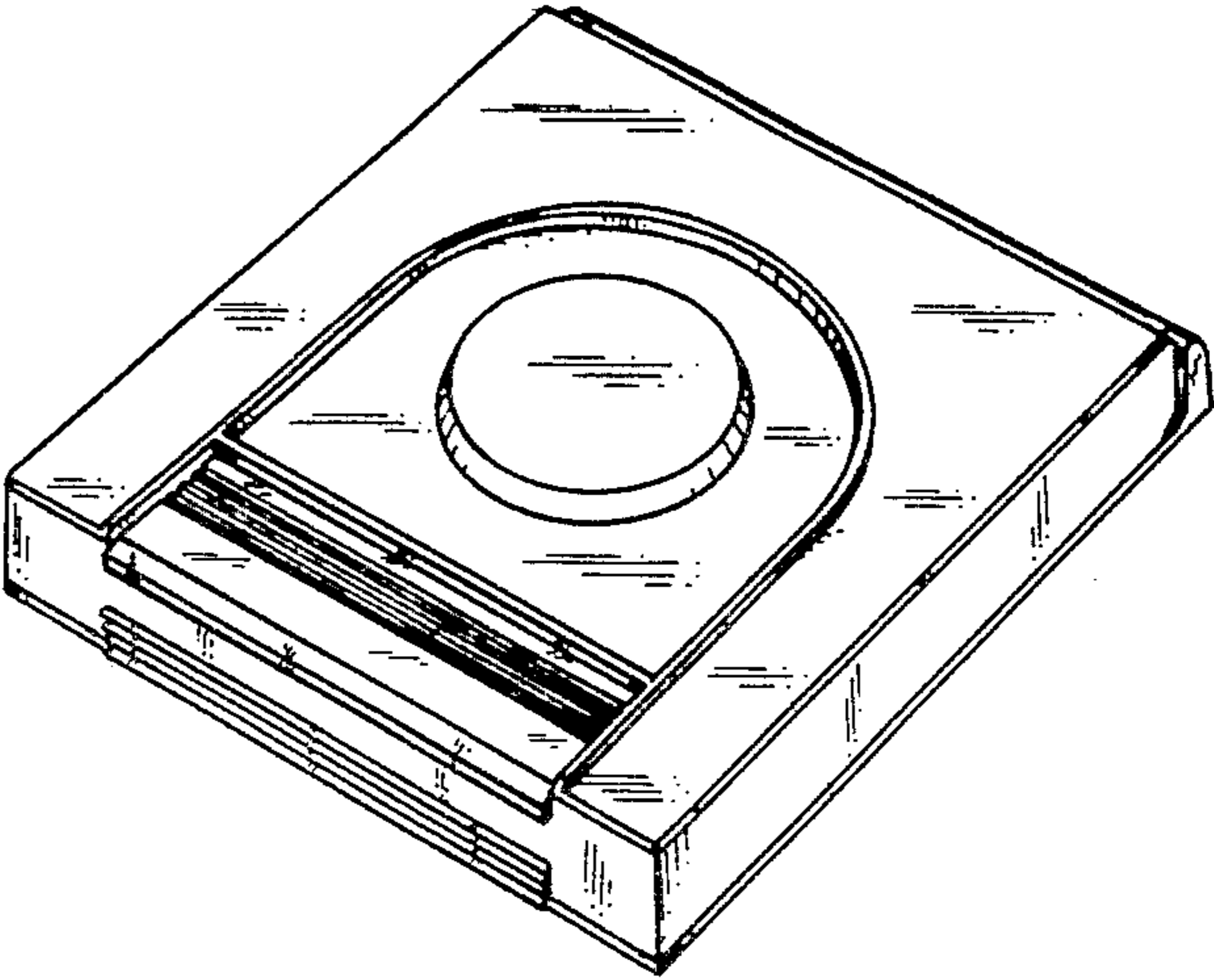

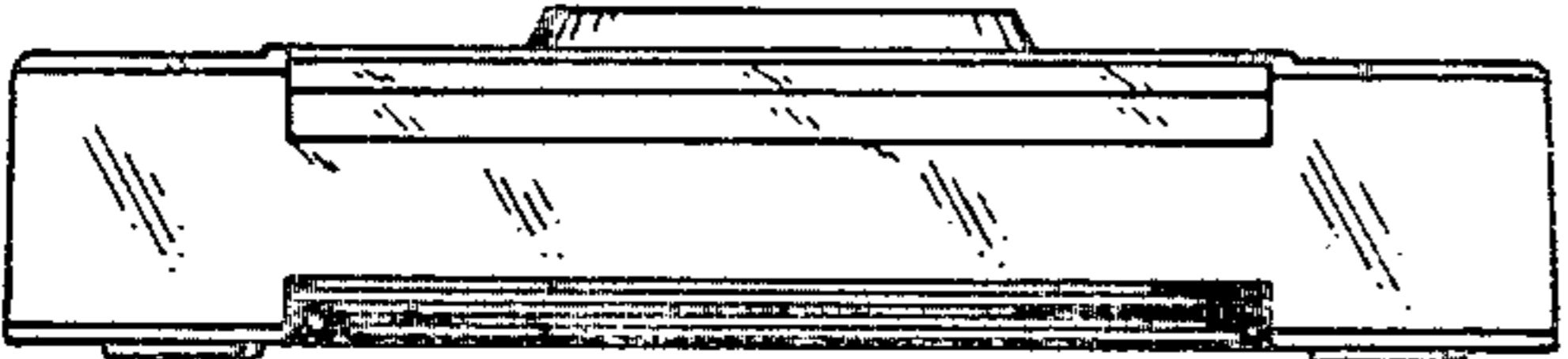

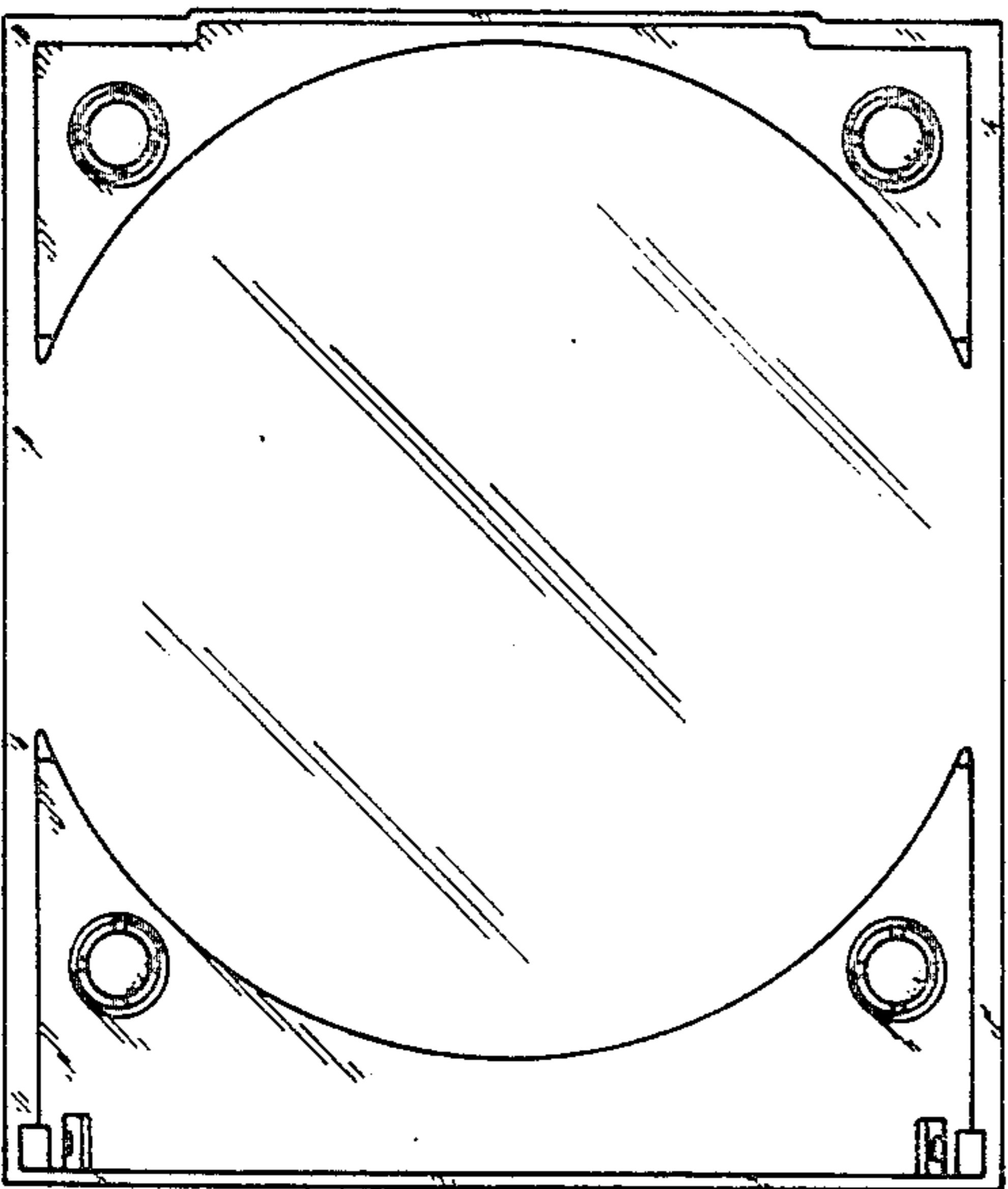

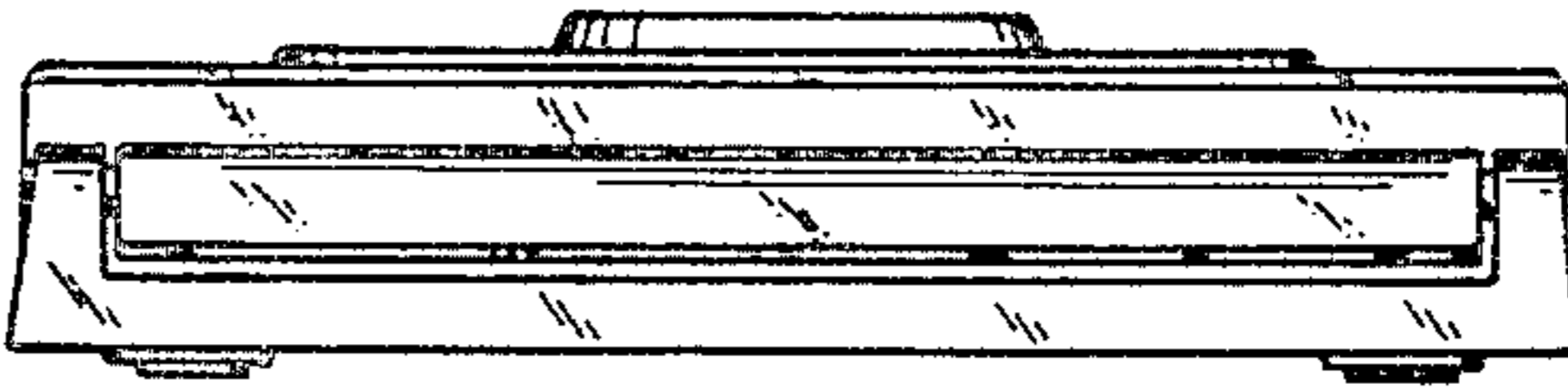
