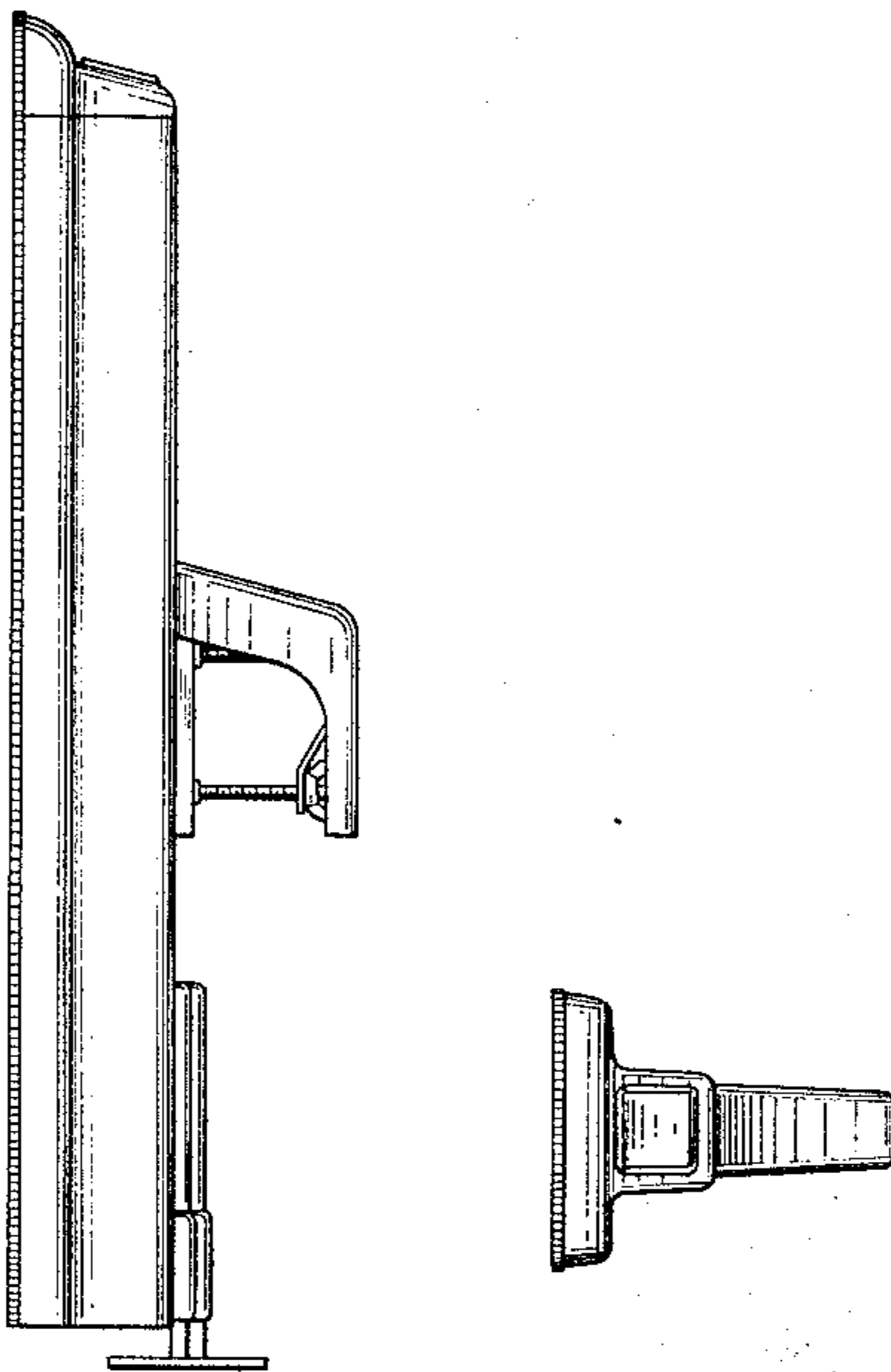

The ornamental design of a telescoping tie rack housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a telescoping tie rack housing embodying our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



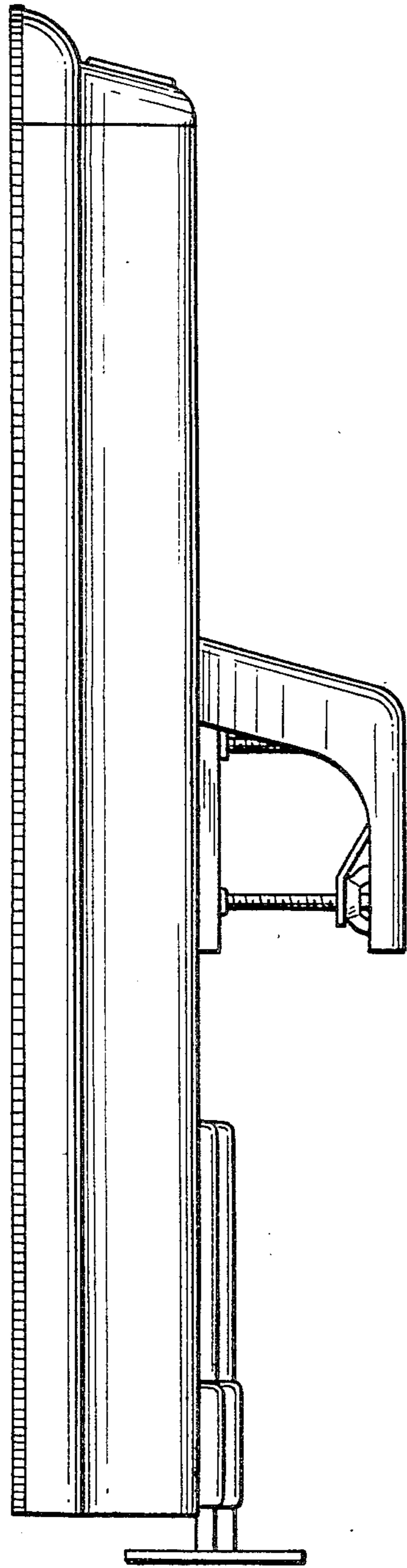

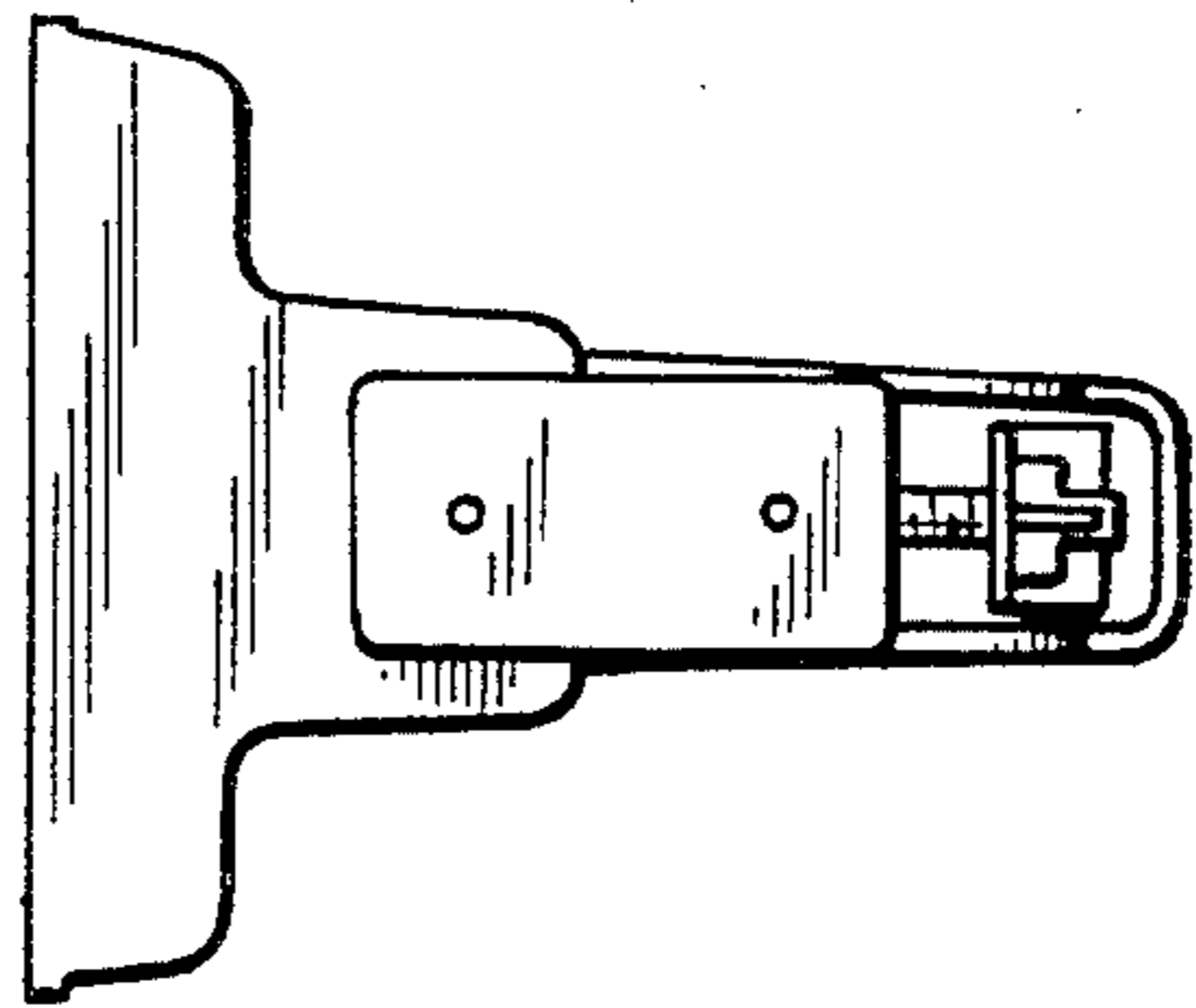

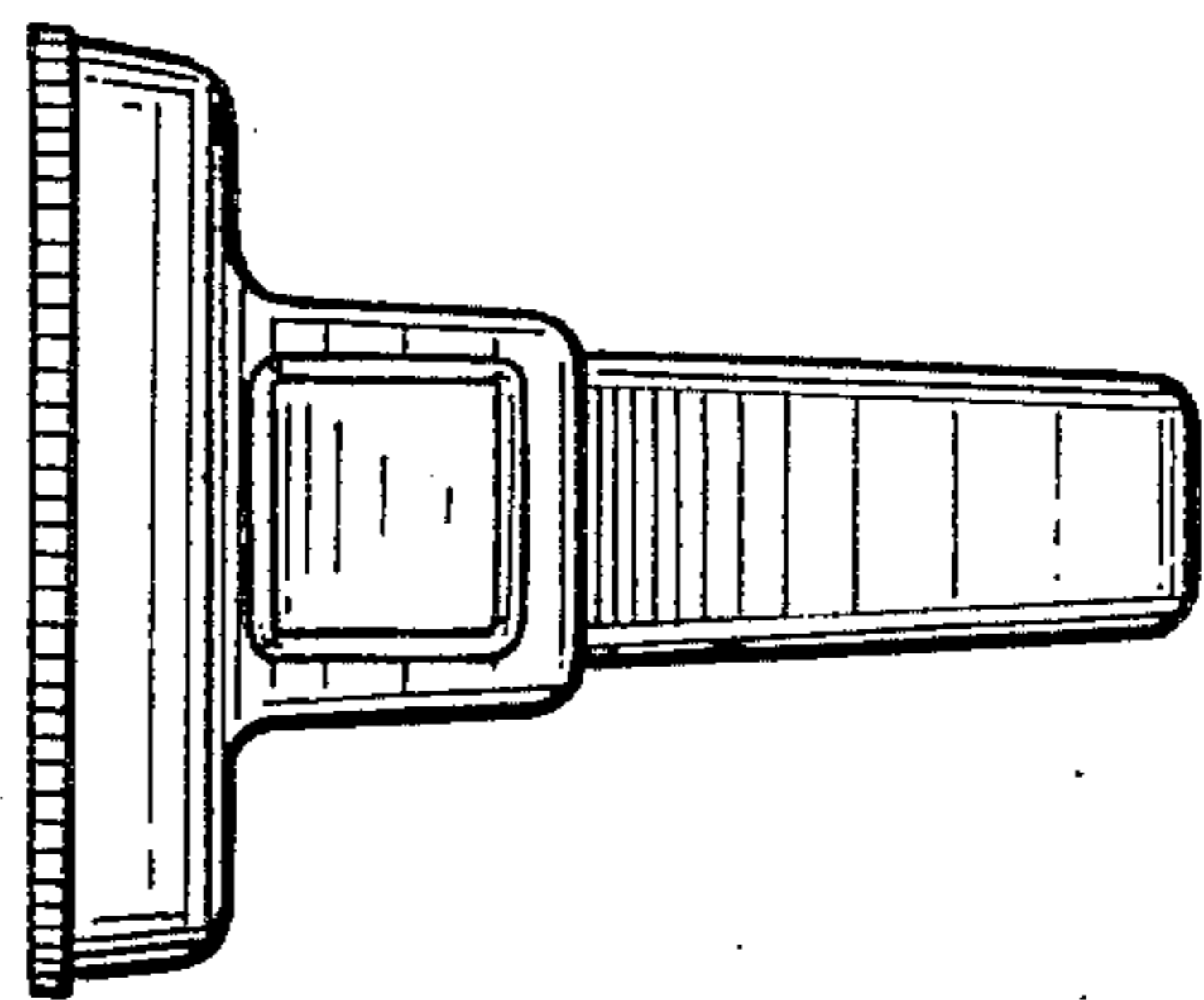

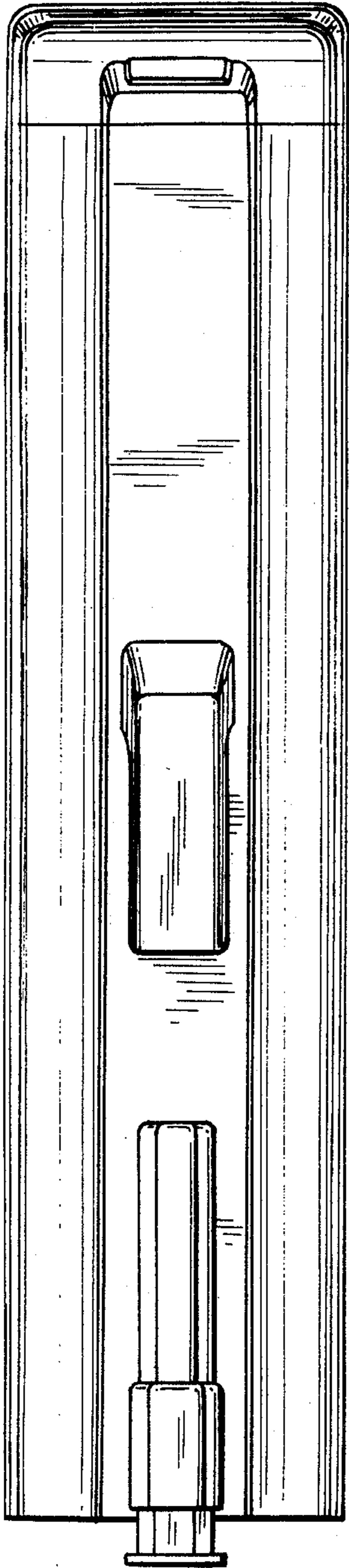

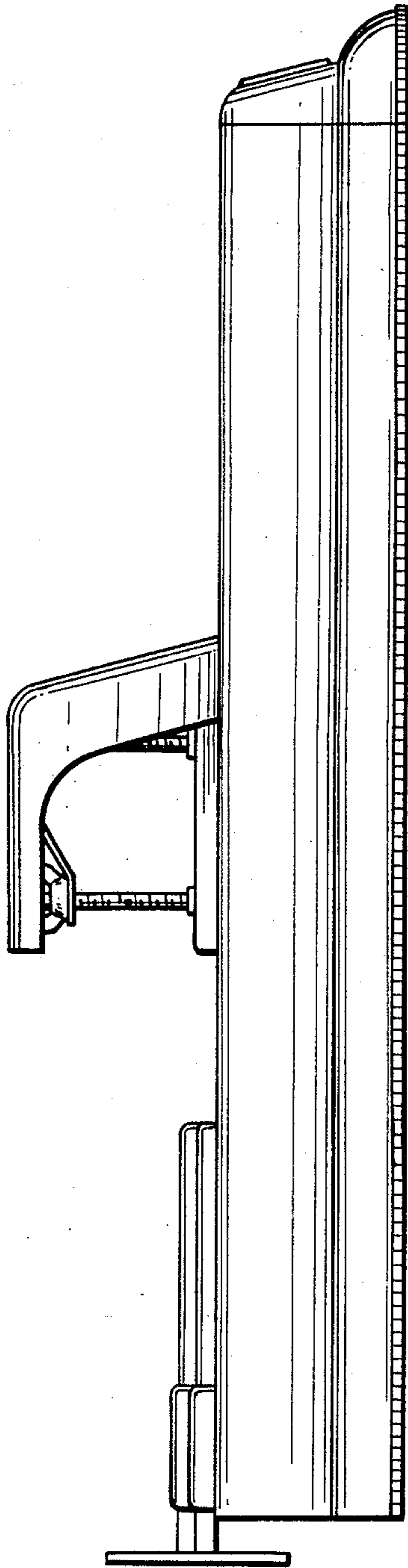

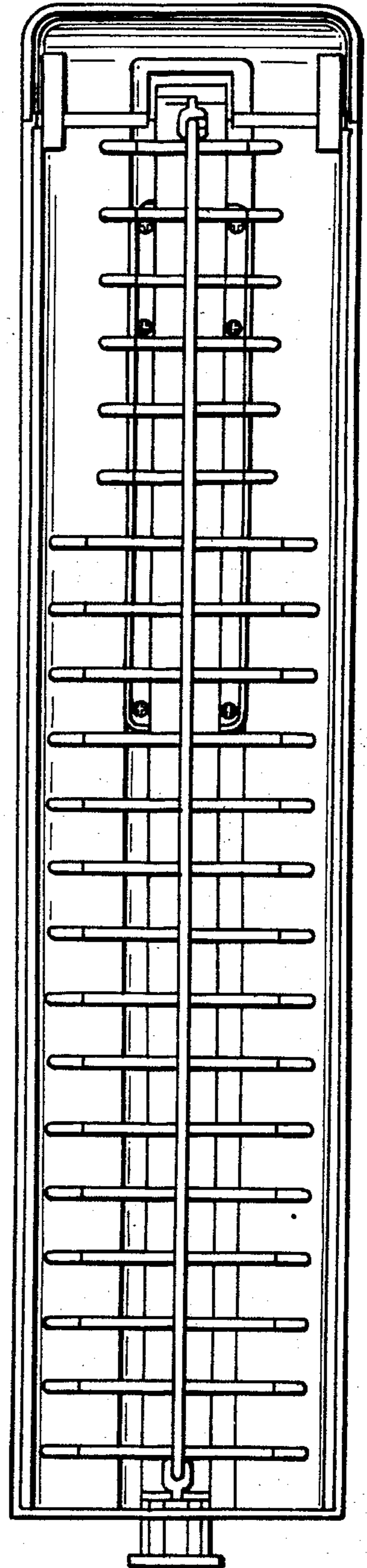
