The ornamental design for a display stand, as shown and described.

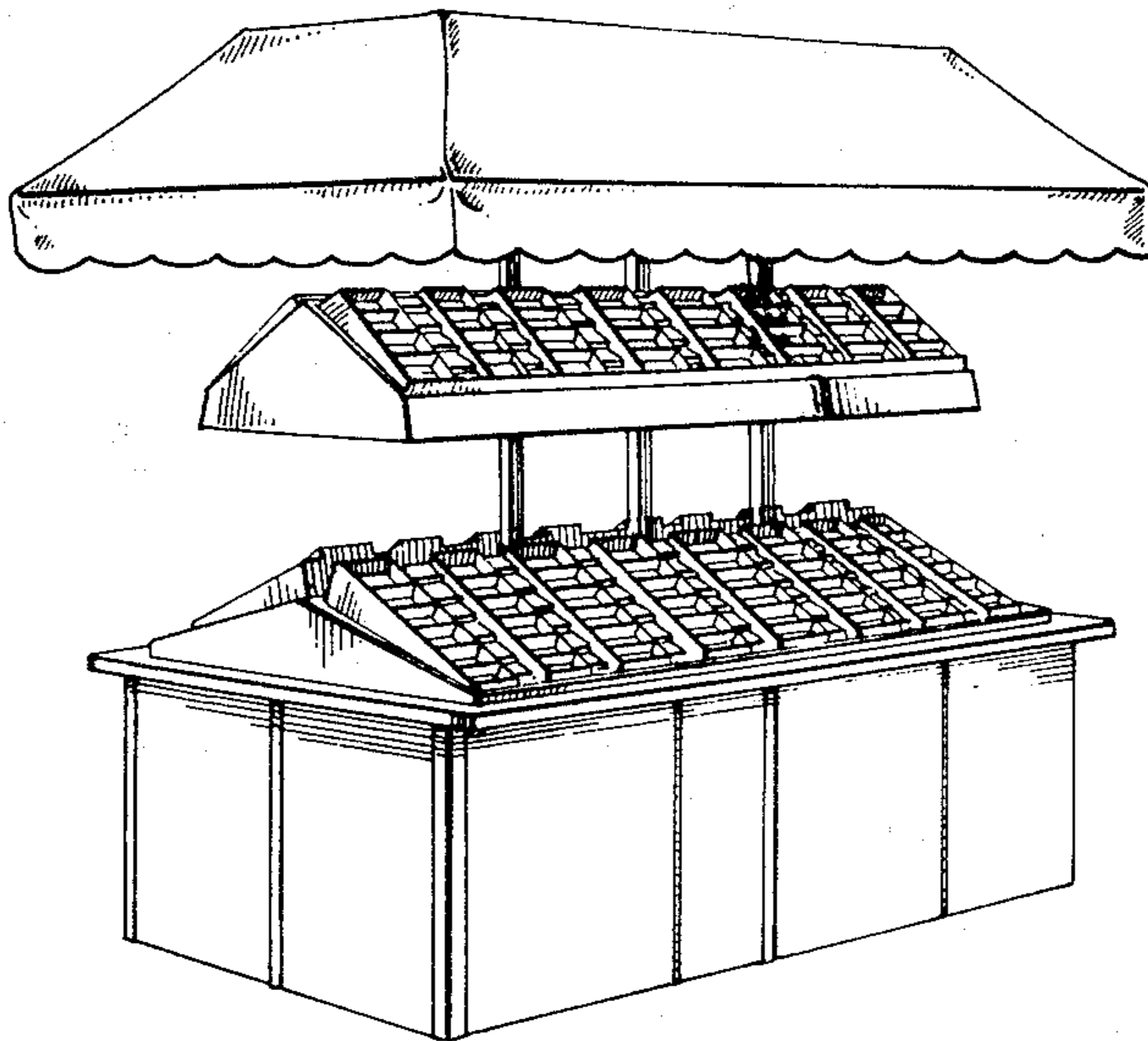
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view, the rear view being a mirror image thereof.



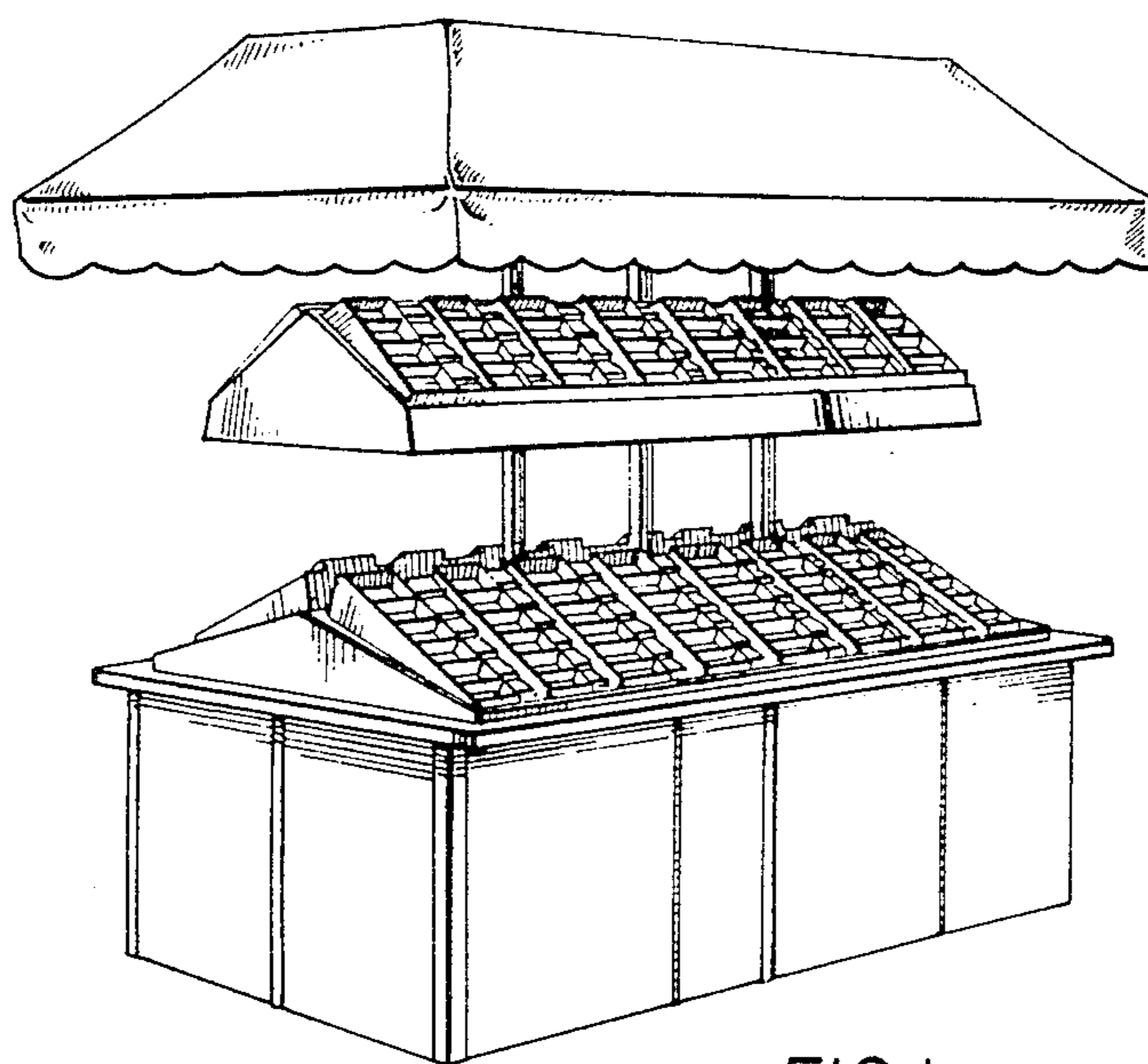

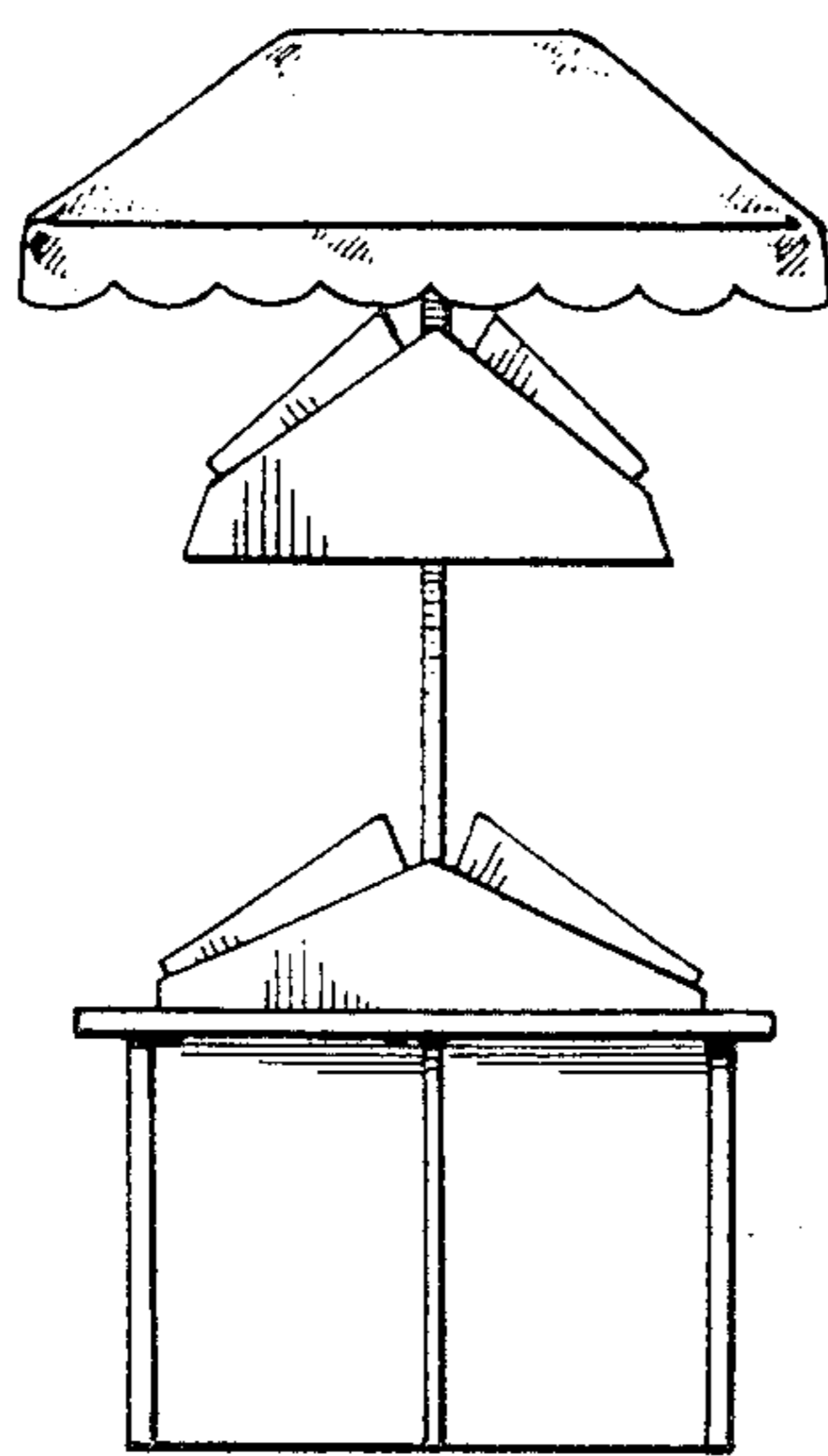

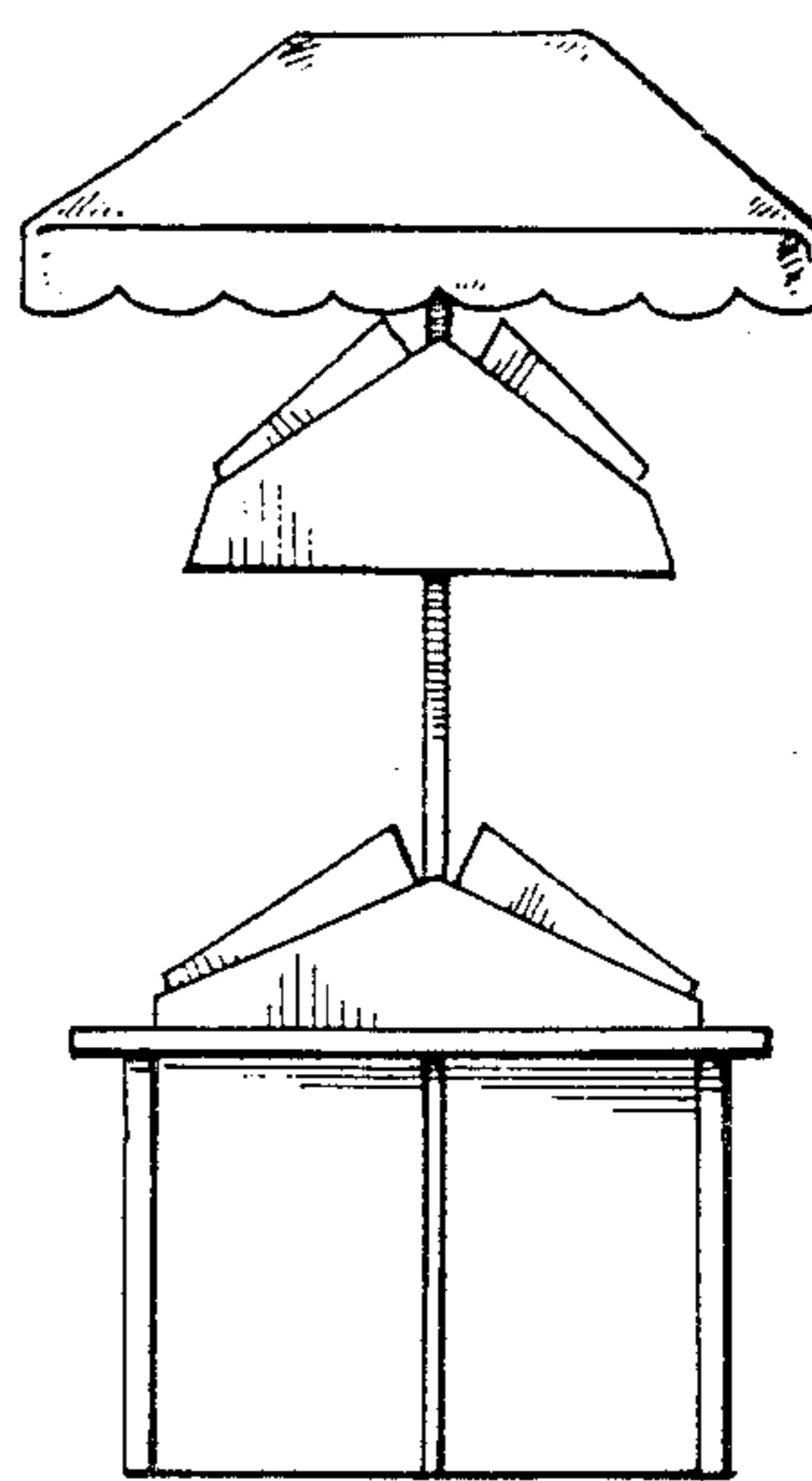

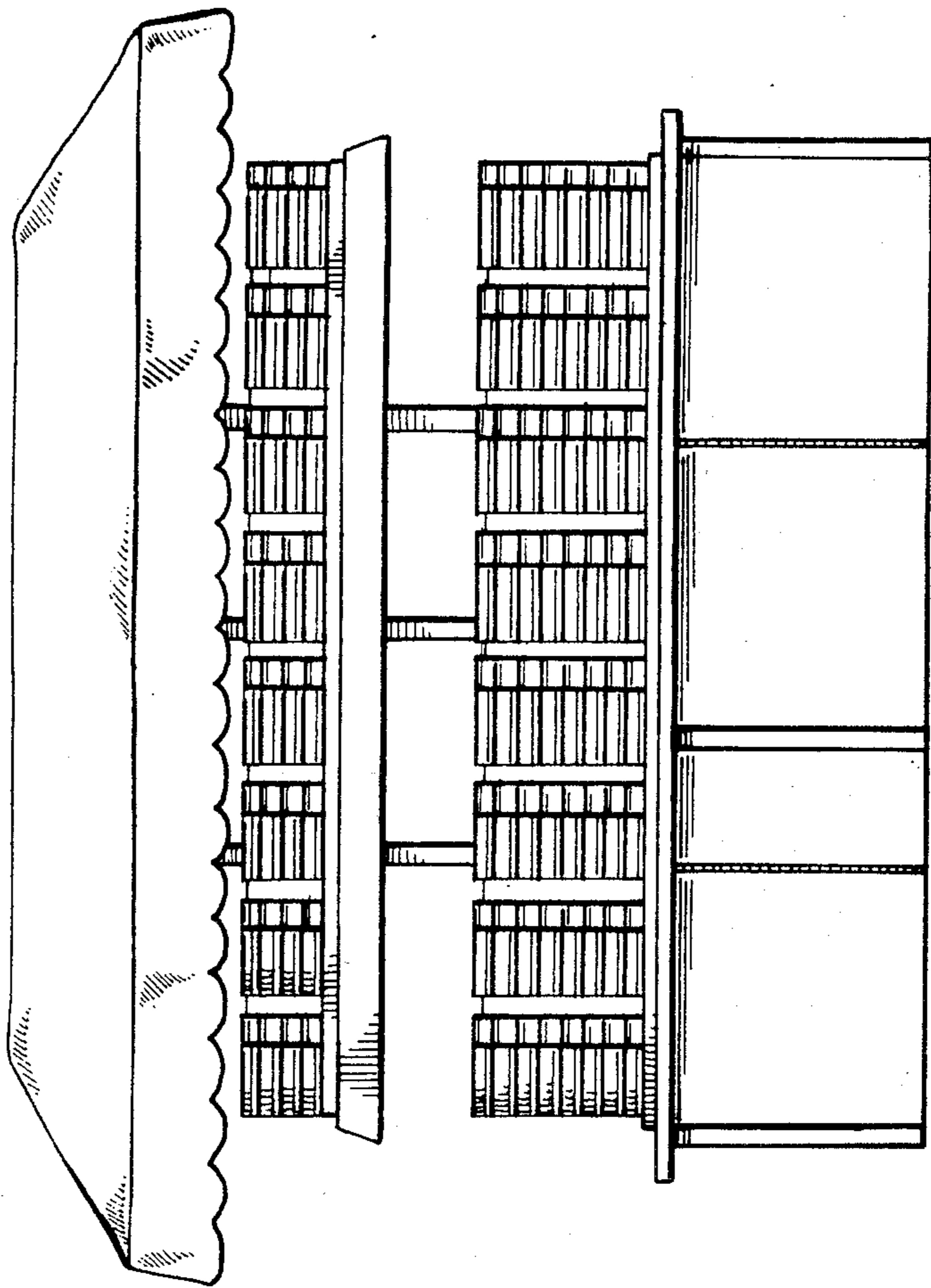
