The ornamental design for a sugar bowl, as shown and described.

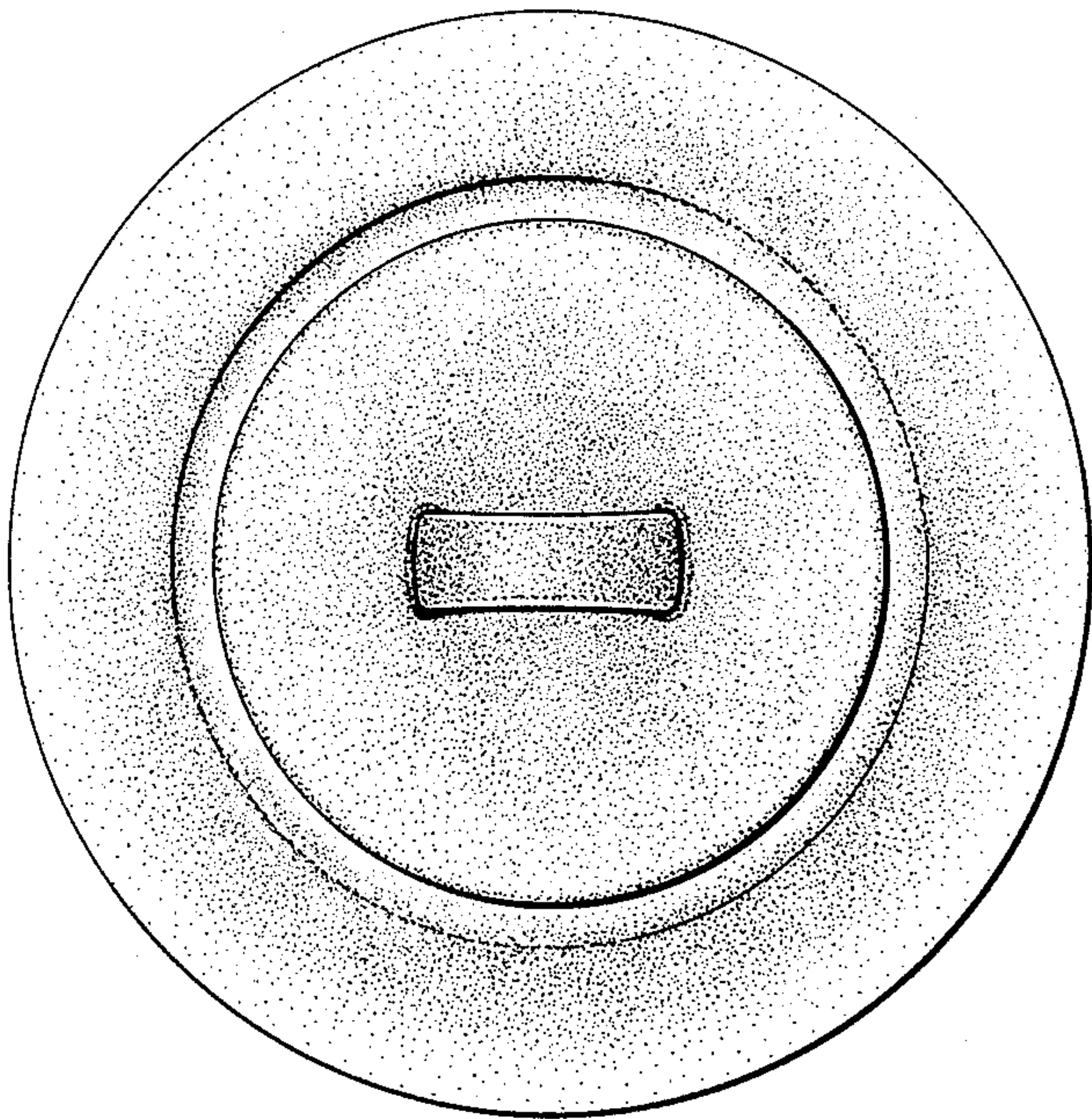
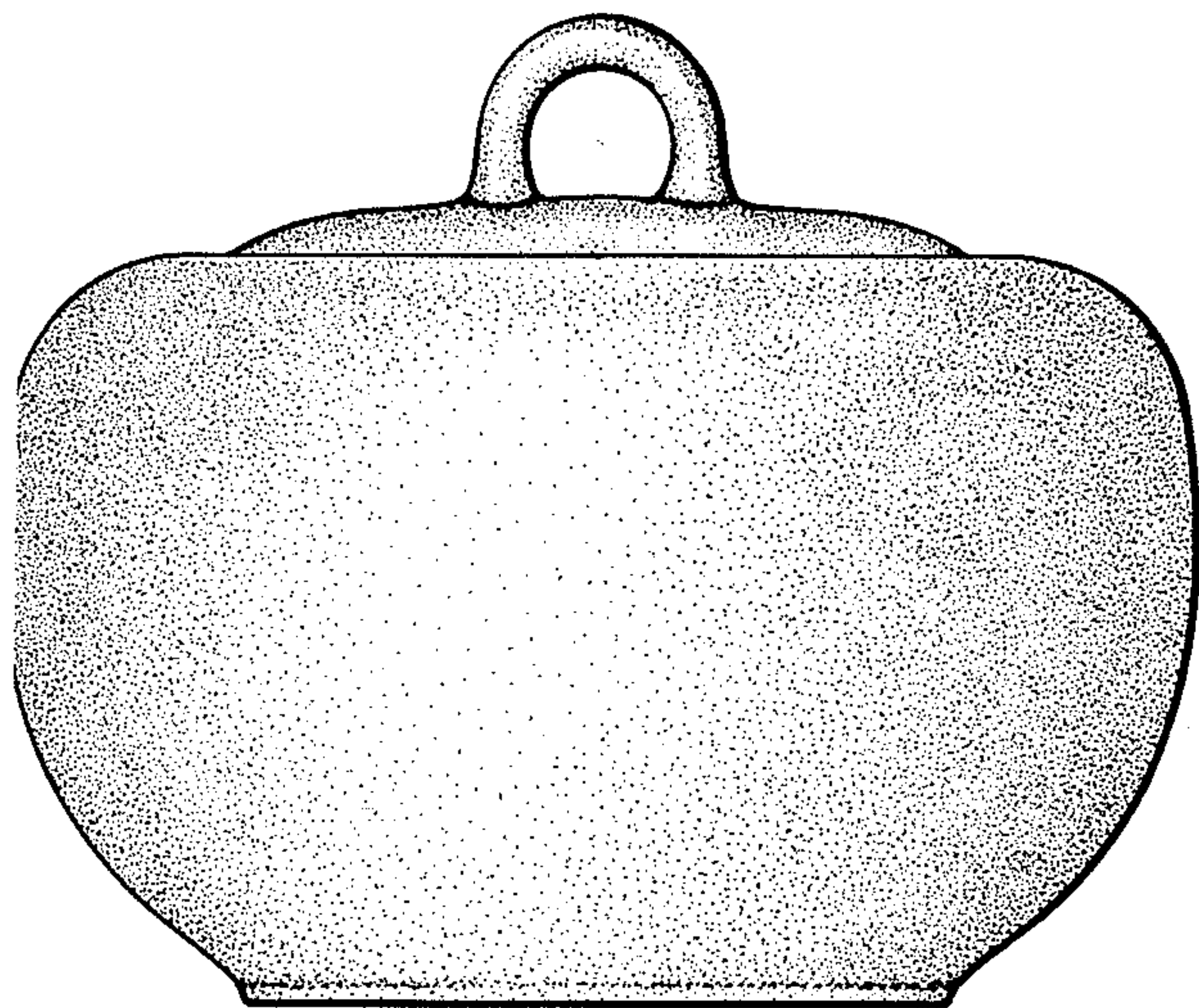
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sugar bowl showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front side elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear side elevational view being substantially identical therewith; and

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view, the left end elevational view being substantially identical therewith.



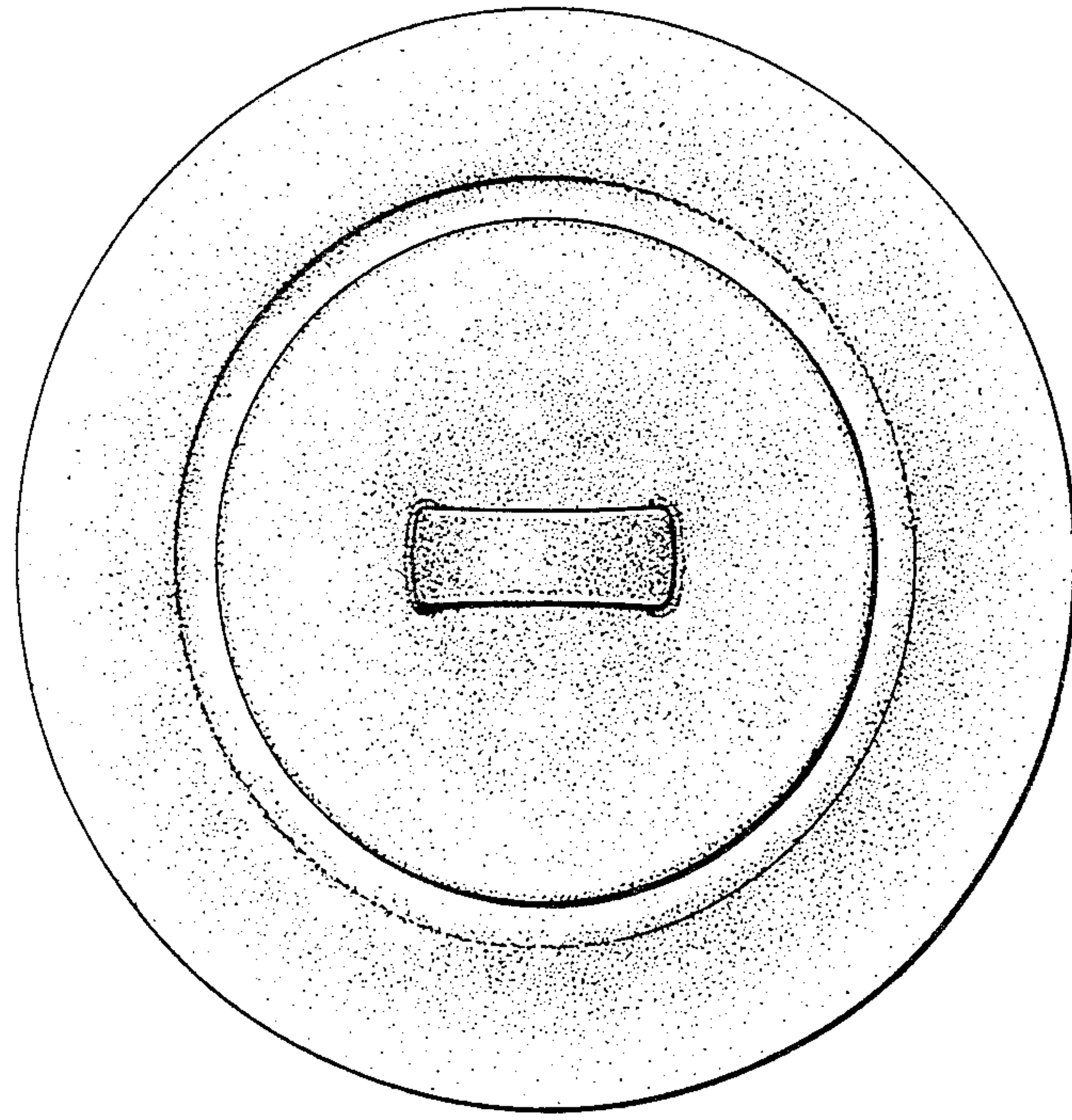

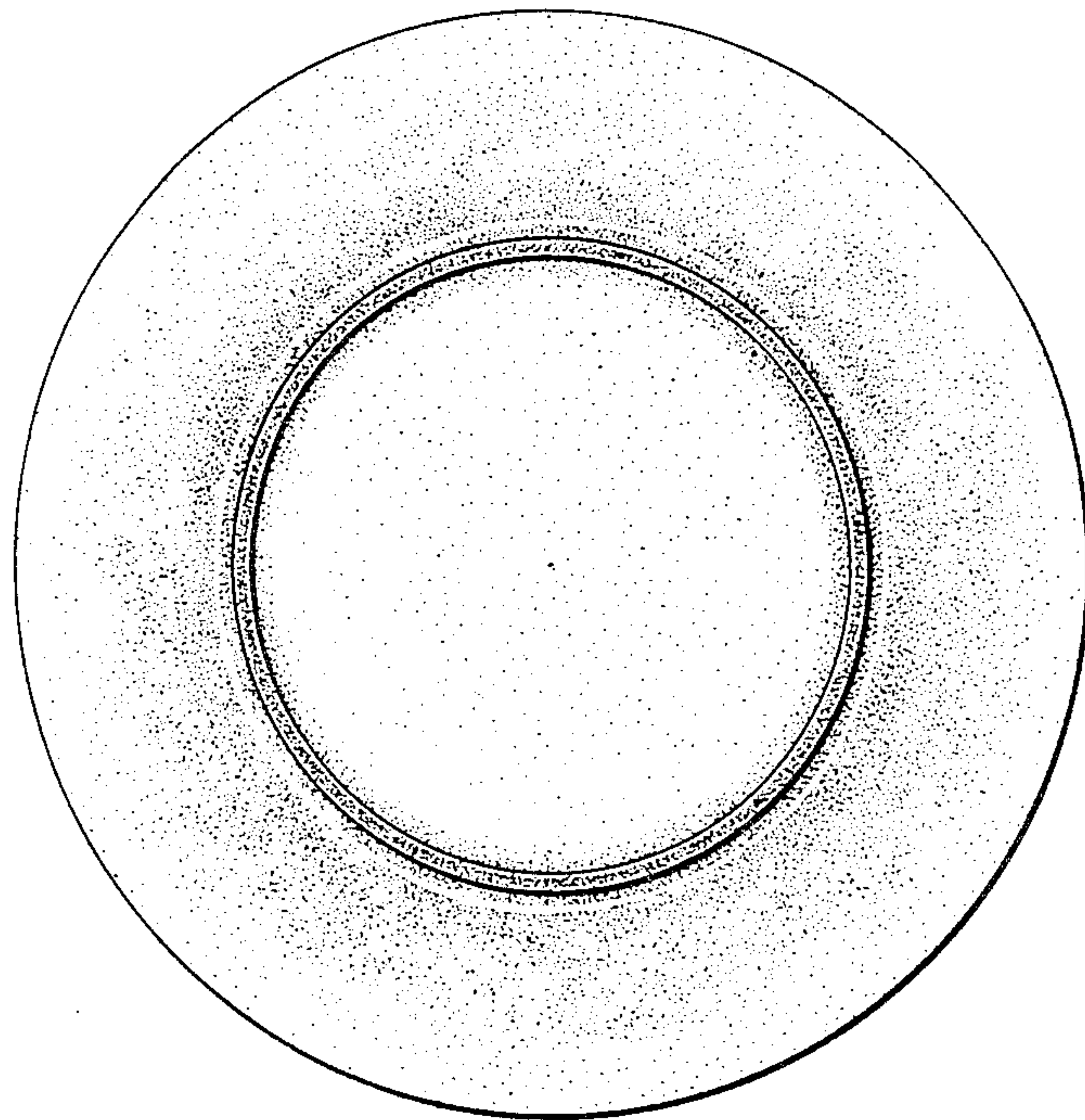

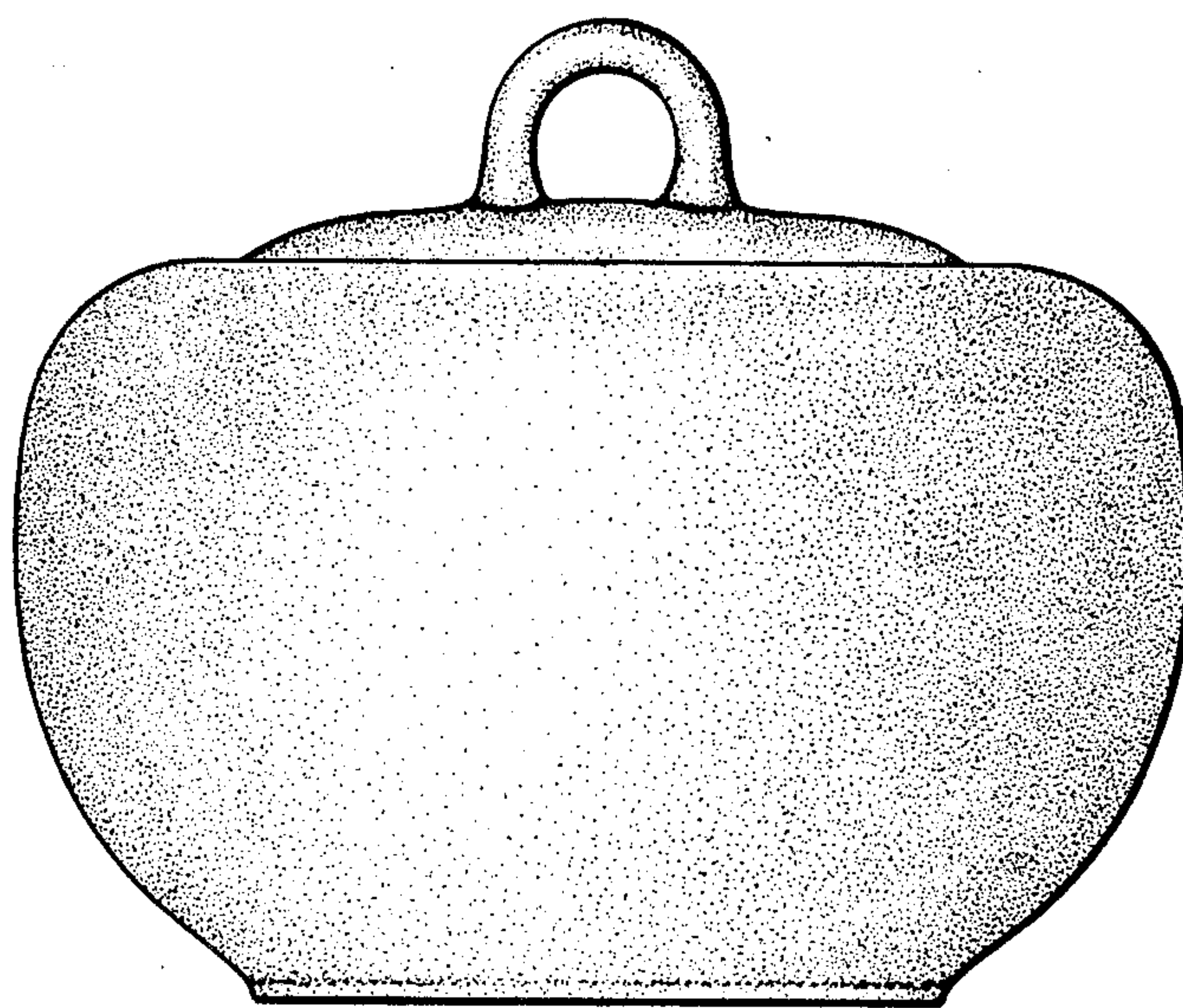

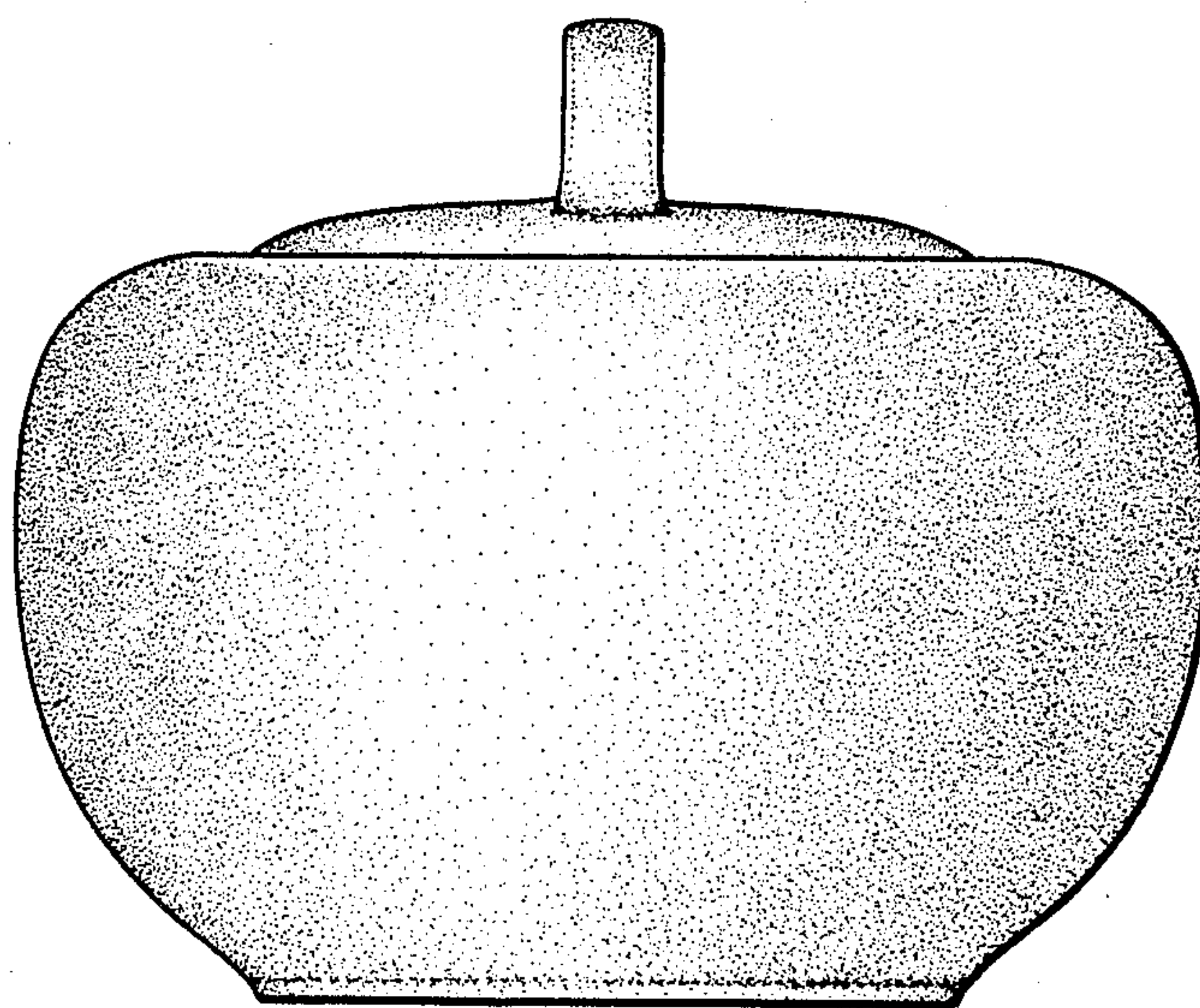
