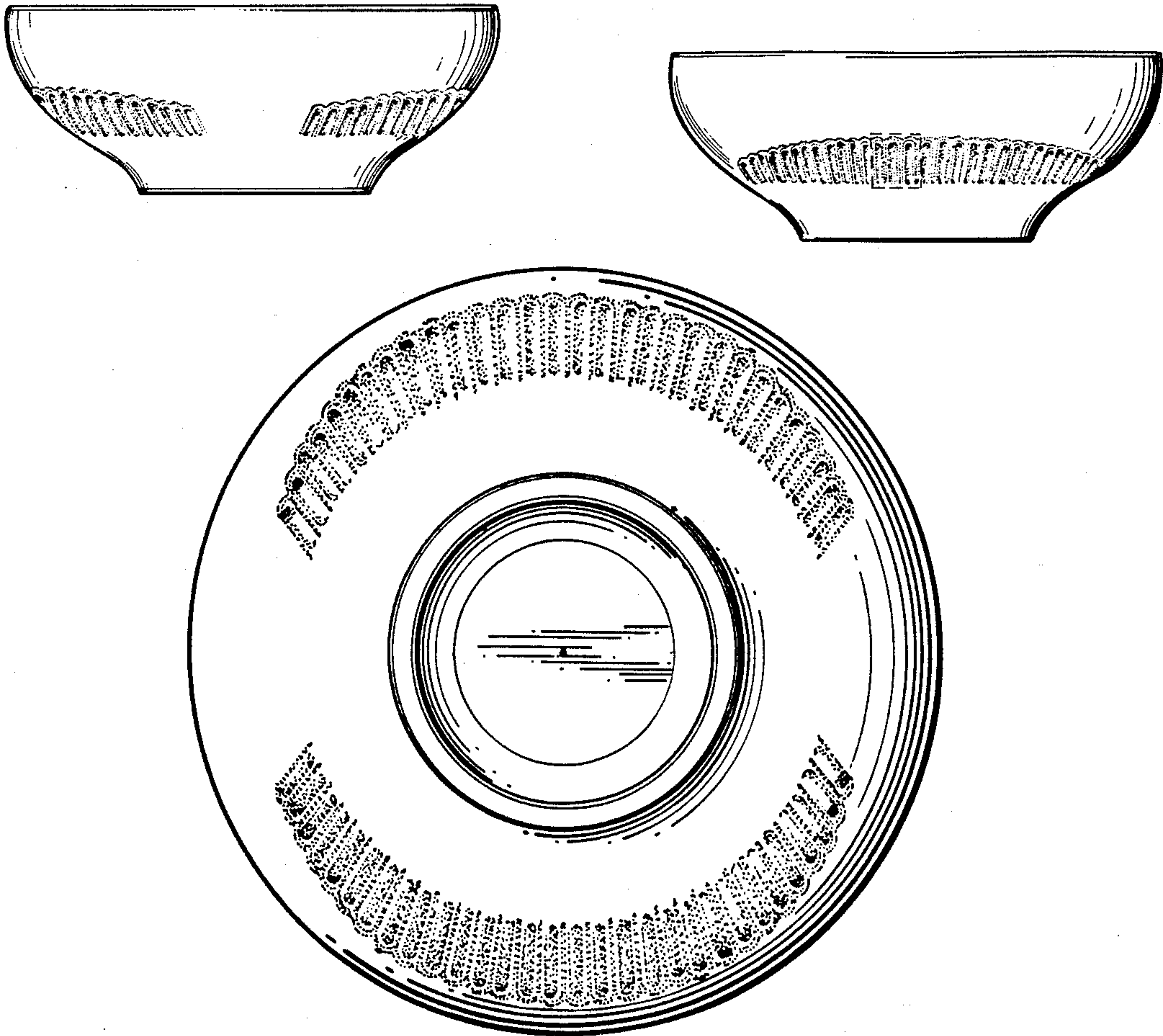

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a soup bowl or similar arti-
cle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a soup bowl or
similar article showing my new design, the rear eleva-
tional view is identical hereto;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the oppo-
site side is identical hereto;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the sculp-
tured portion within the broken line area of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view
taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view
taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



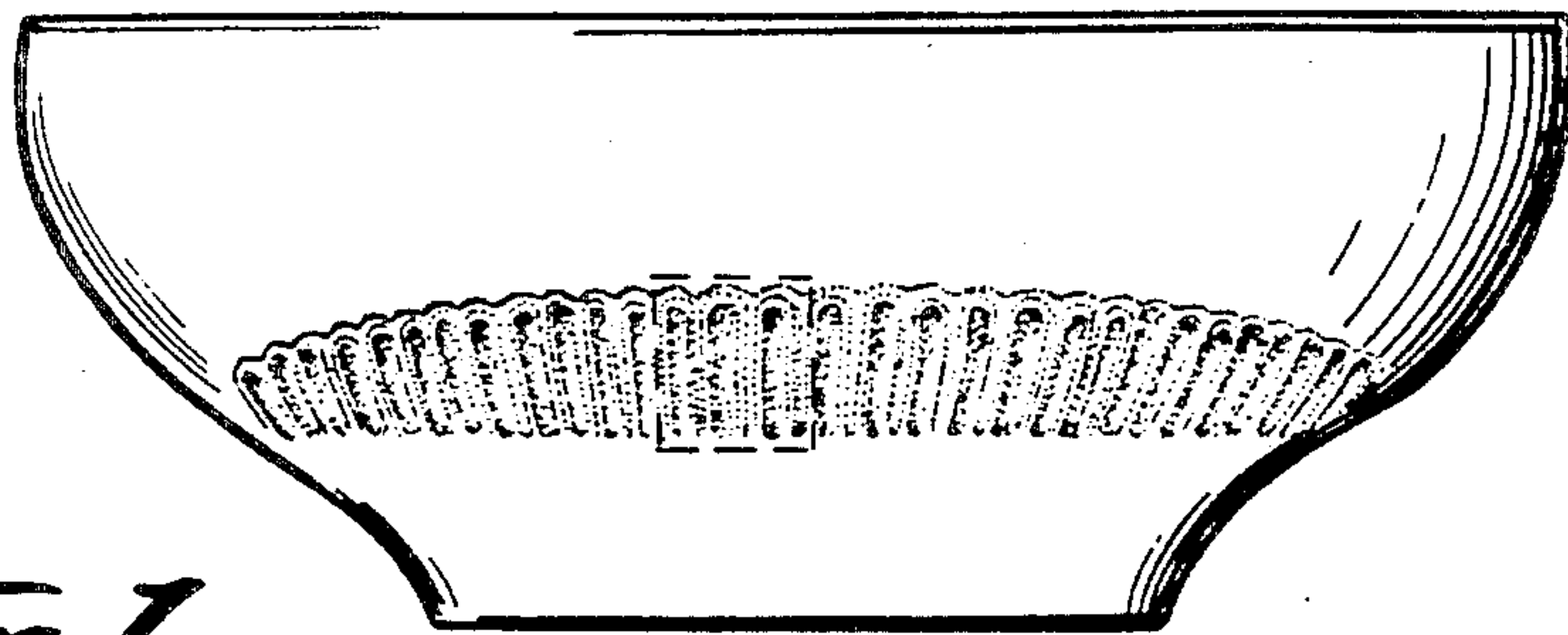

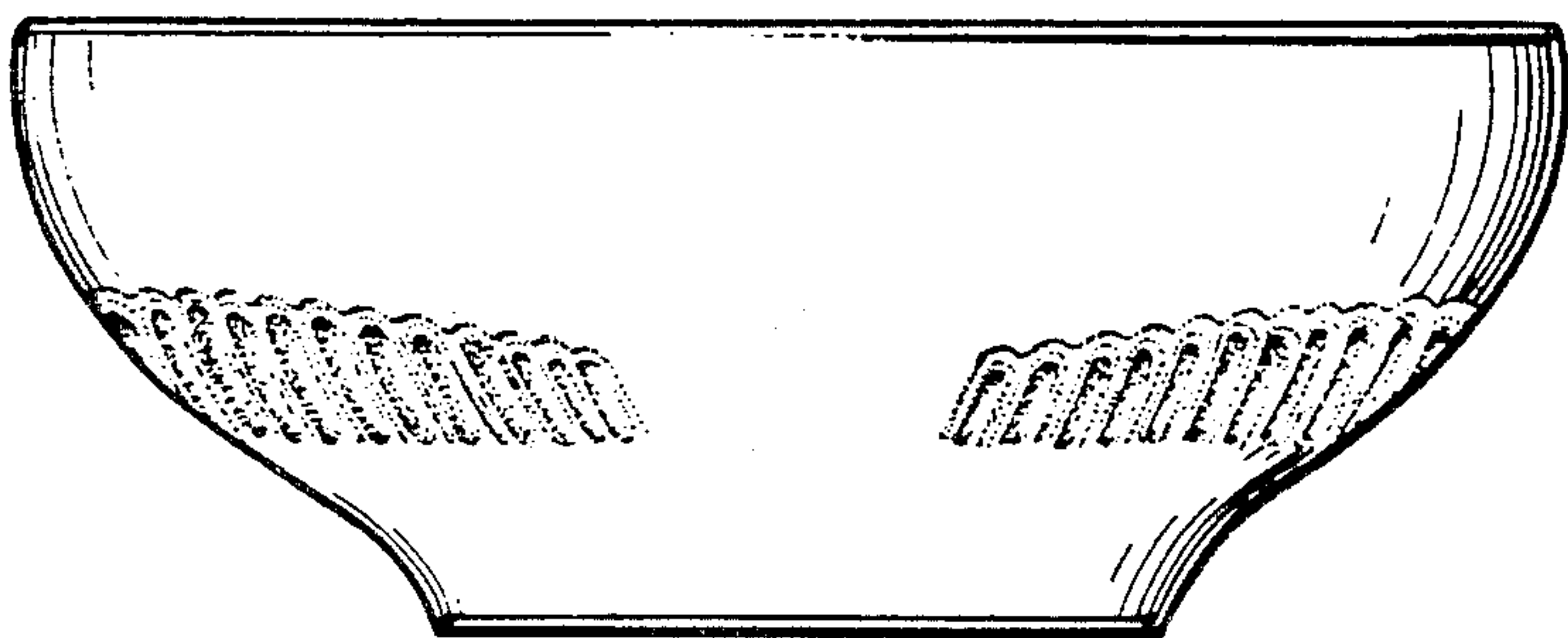

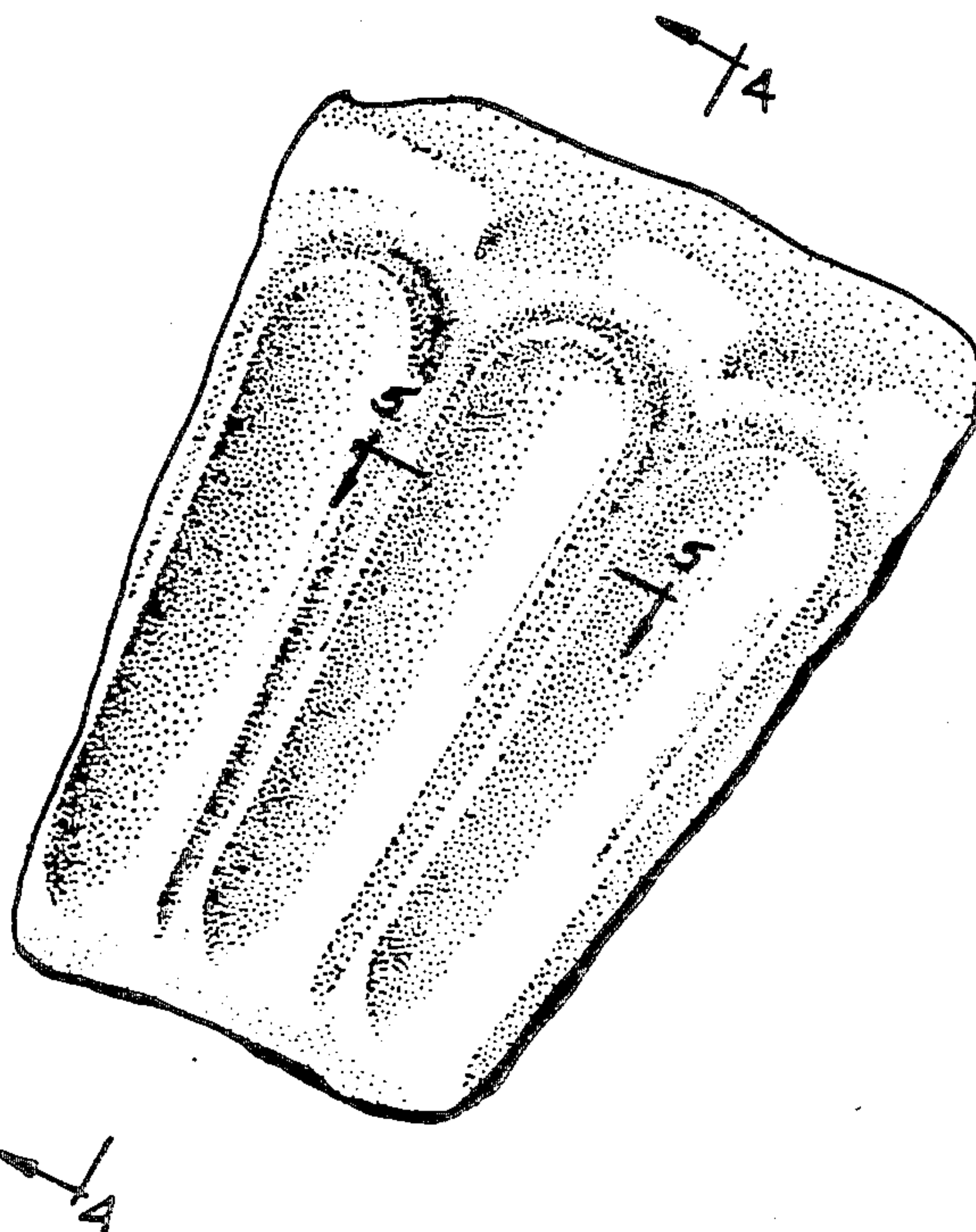

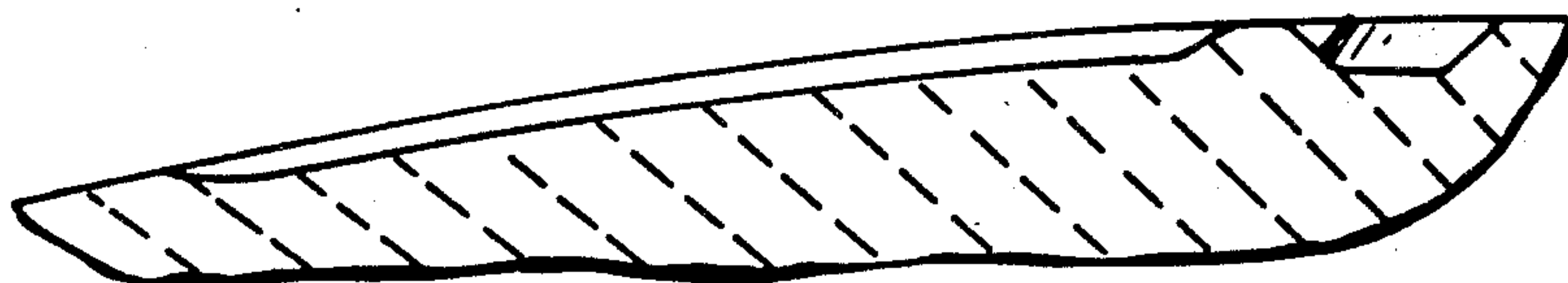

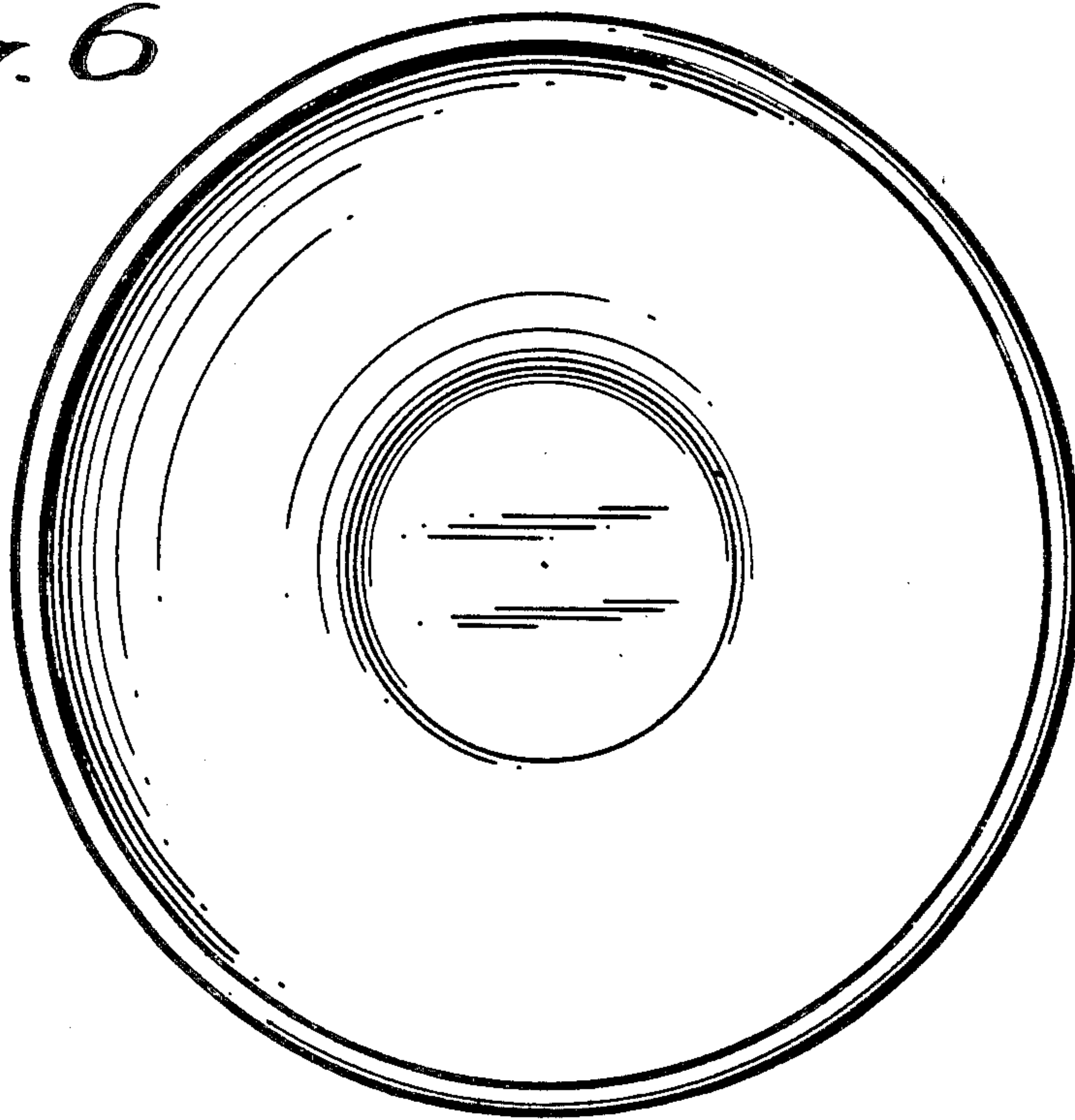
