The ornamental design for a wrist watch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wrist watch showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and


FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the narrow flat rectangular bezel with chamfered corners.
