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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a motorcycle tire, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motorcycle tire showing our new design, it being understood that the tread design is repeated throughout the circumference of the tire, the opposite side being substantially the same as that shown;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.

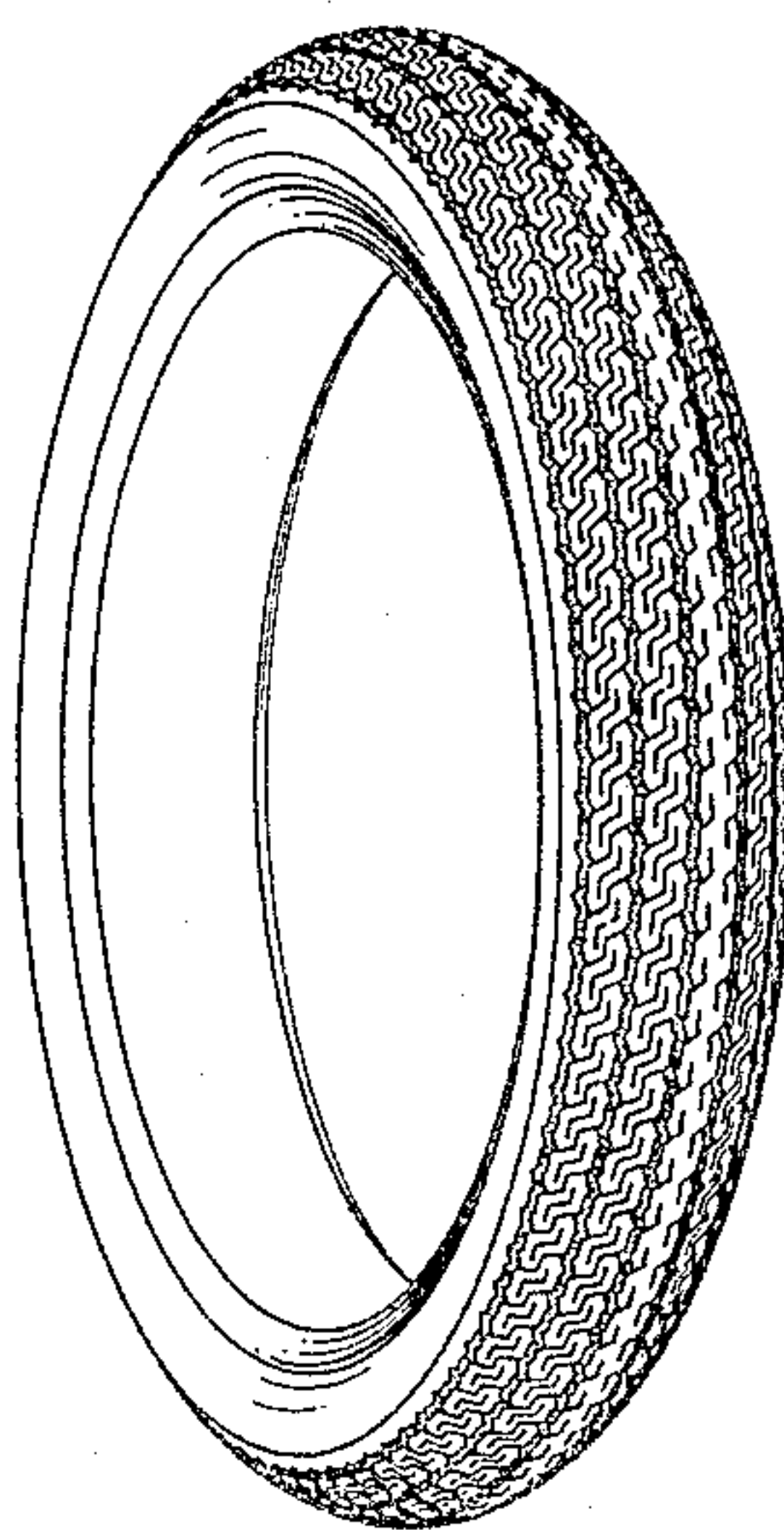

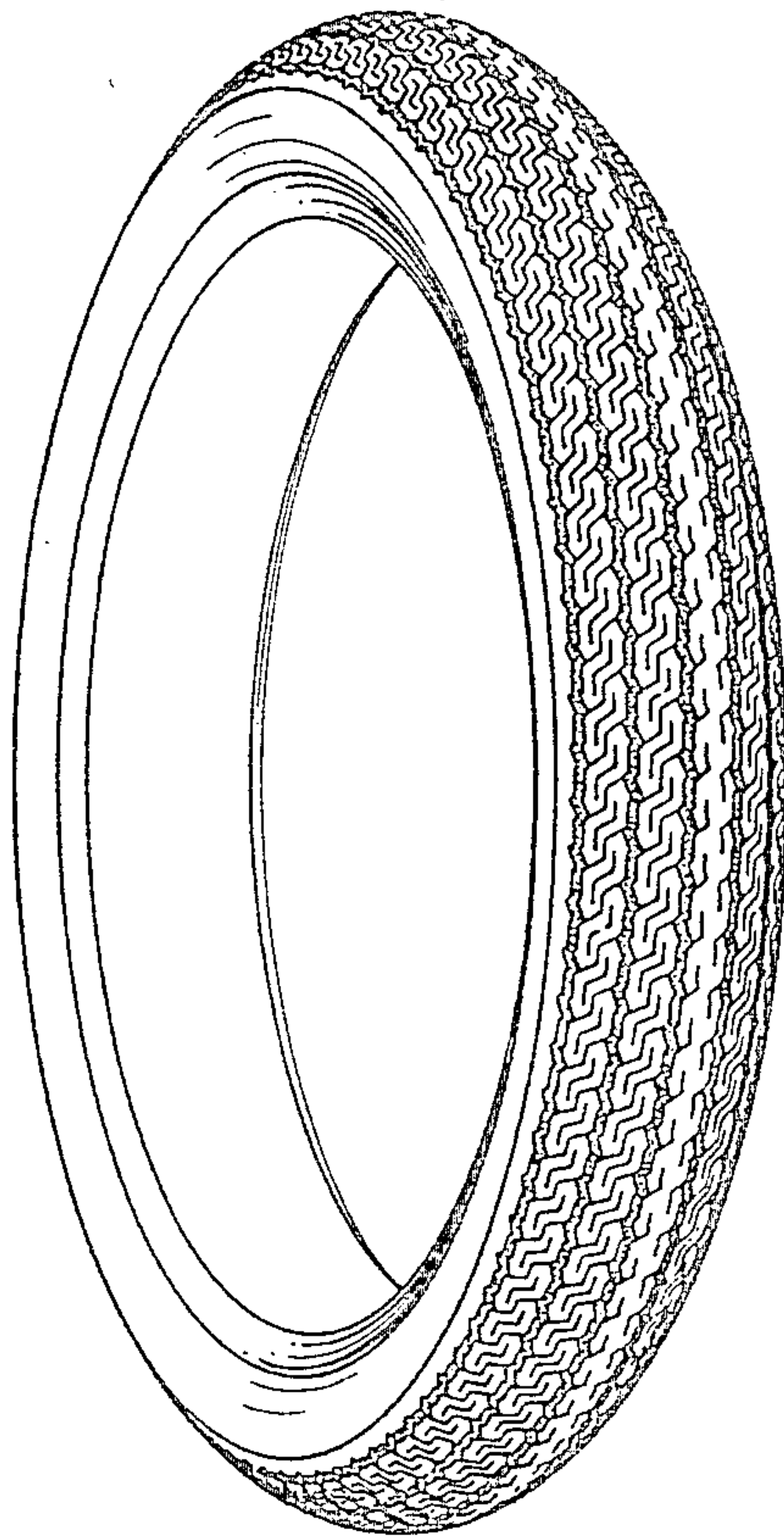

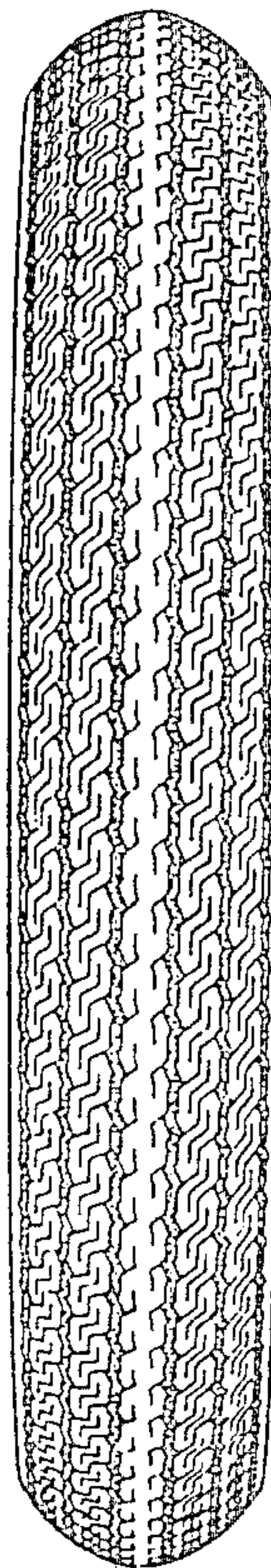
