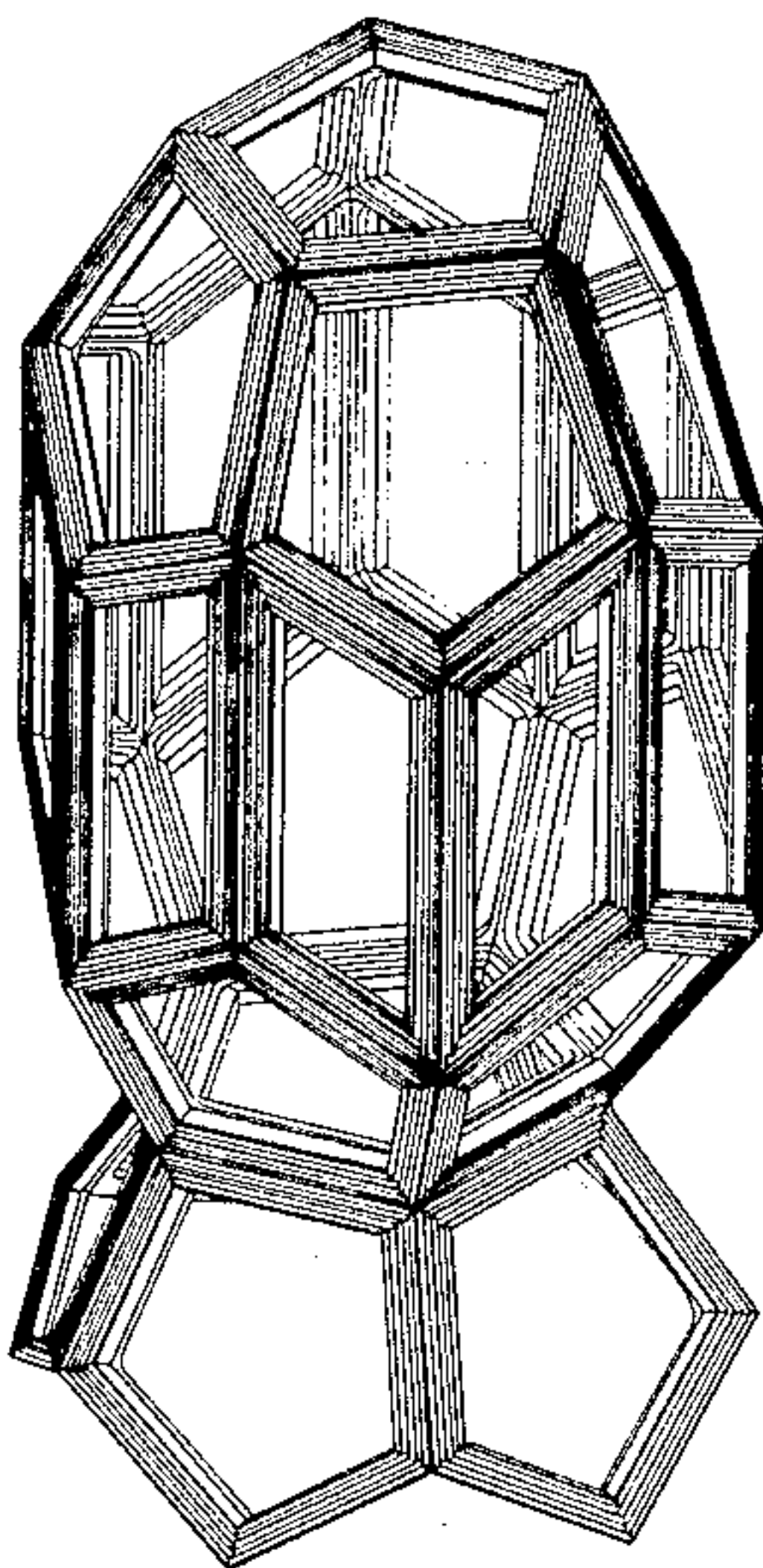

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a frame for an audio speaker showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



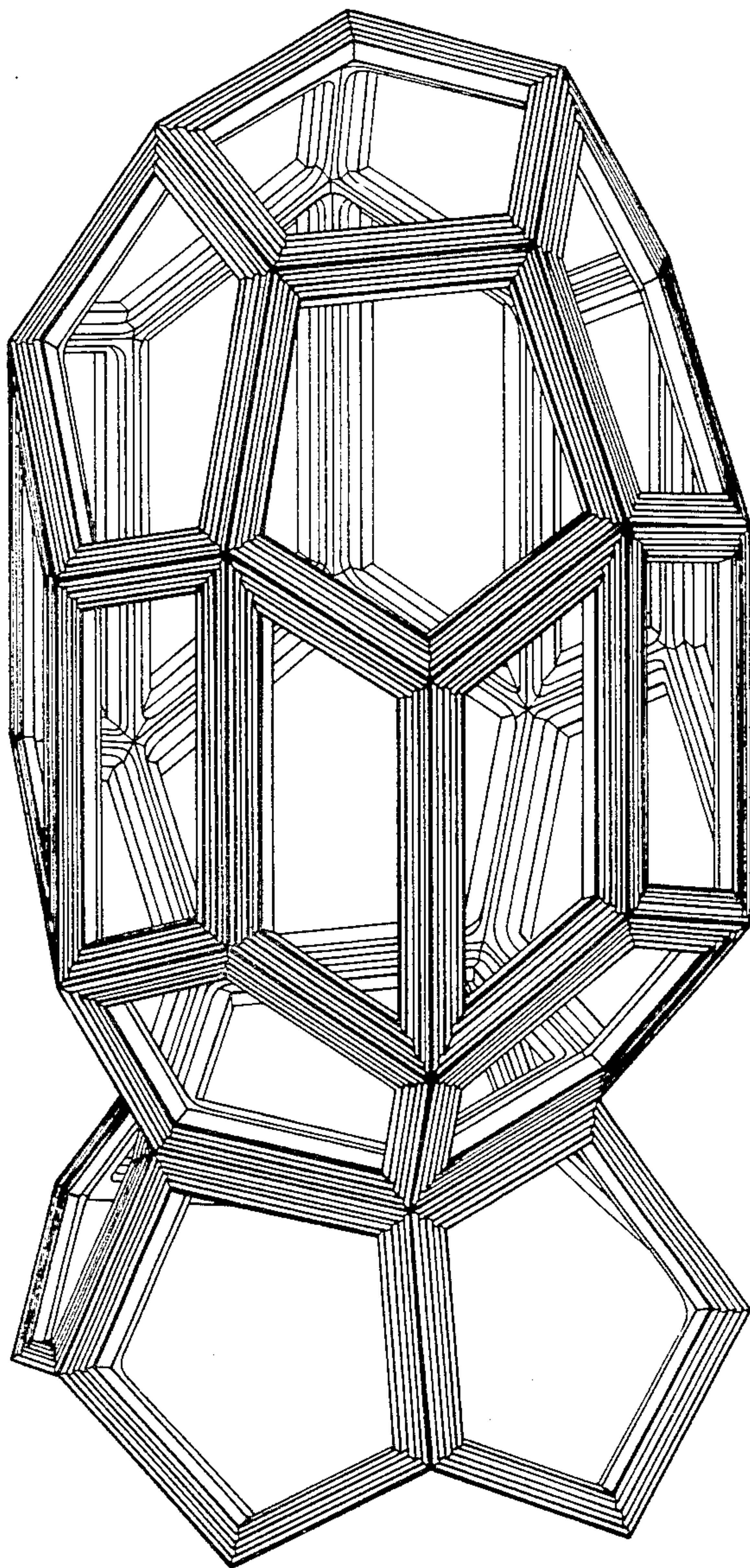

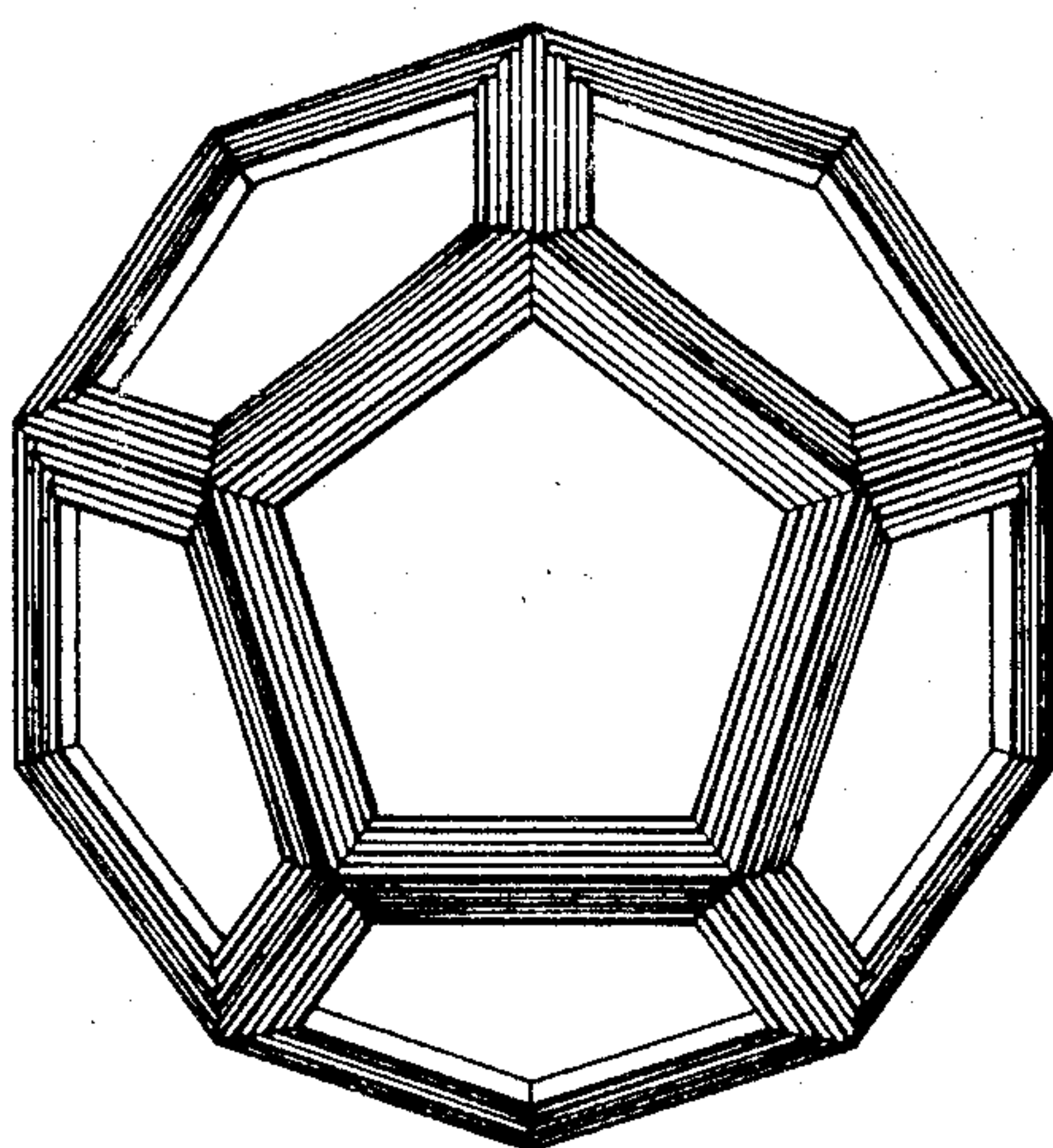

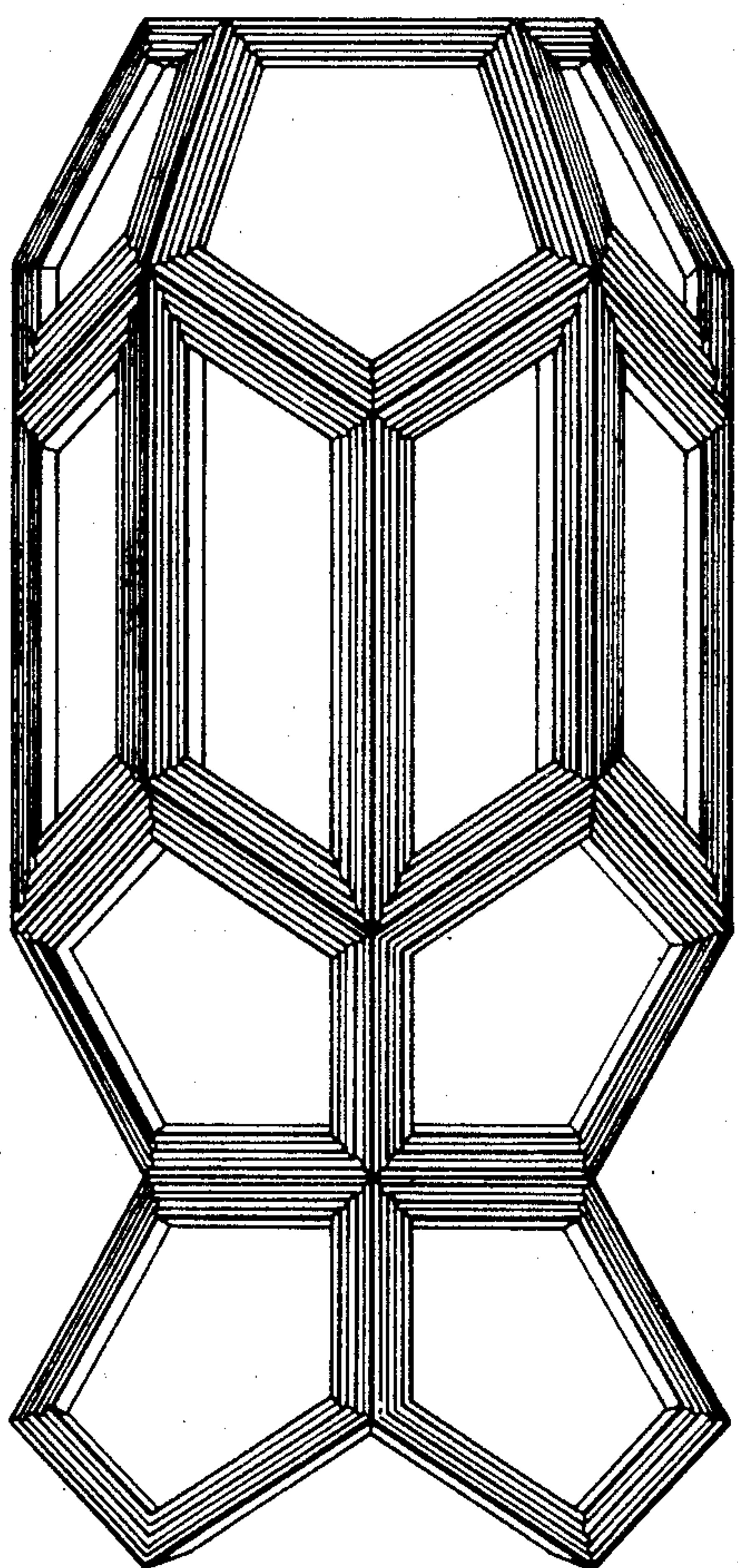

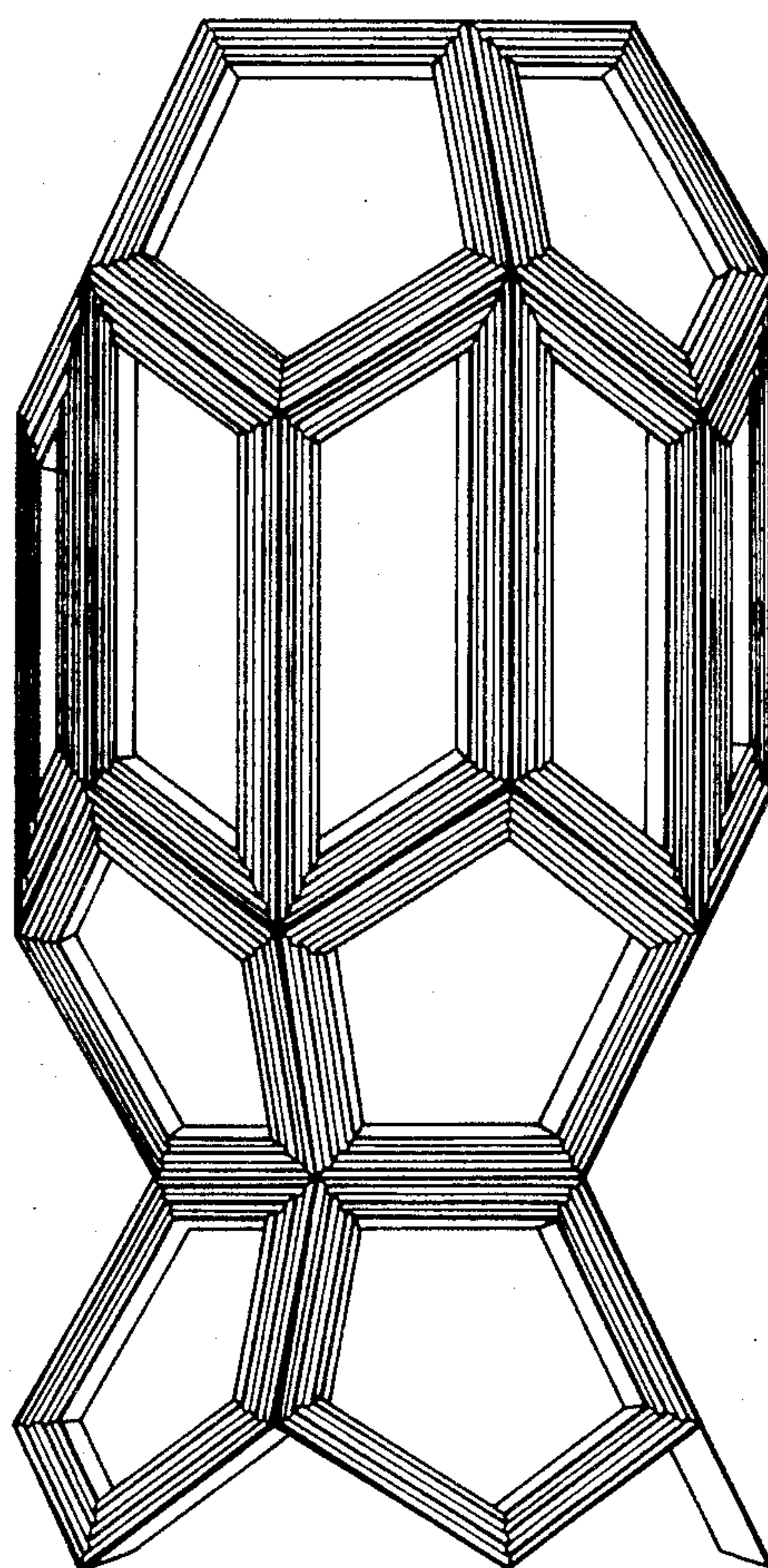

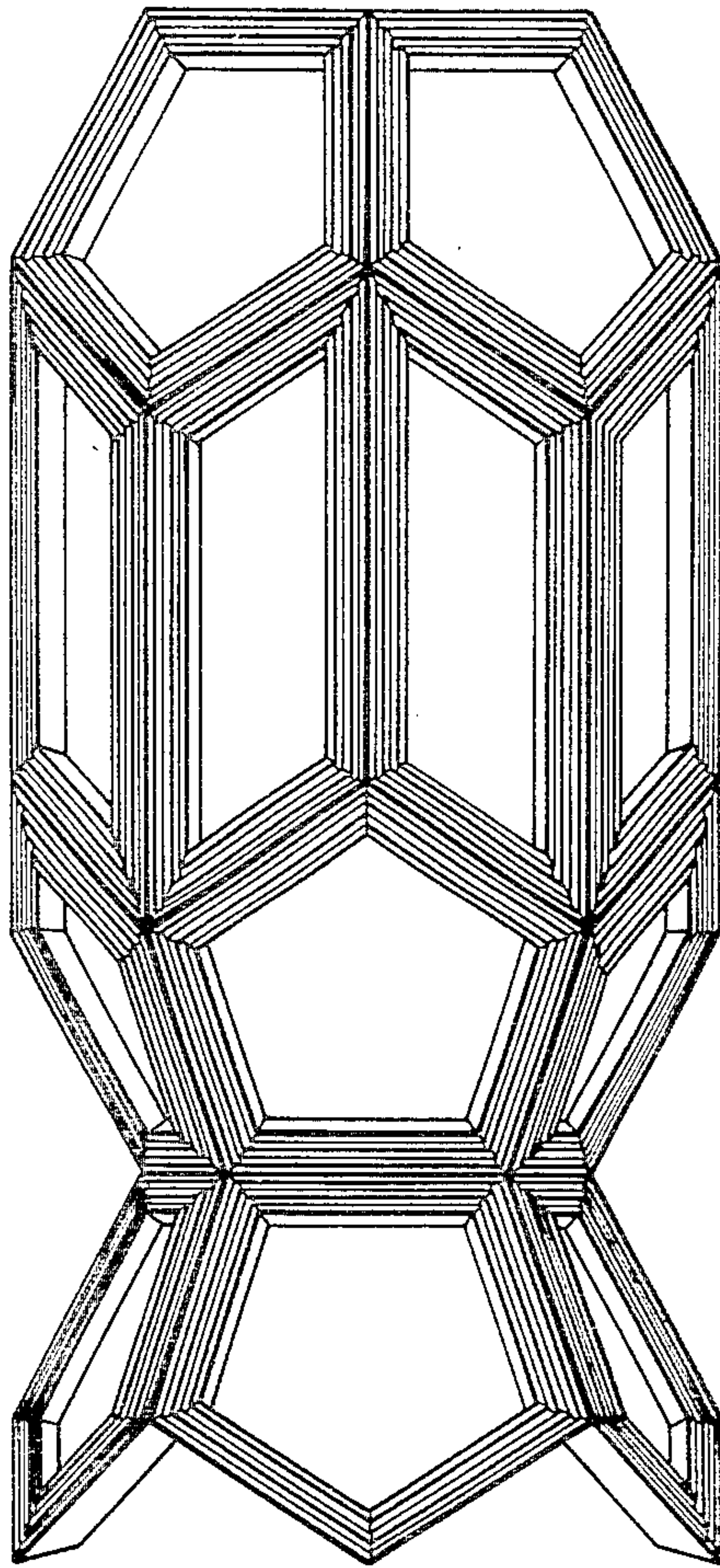

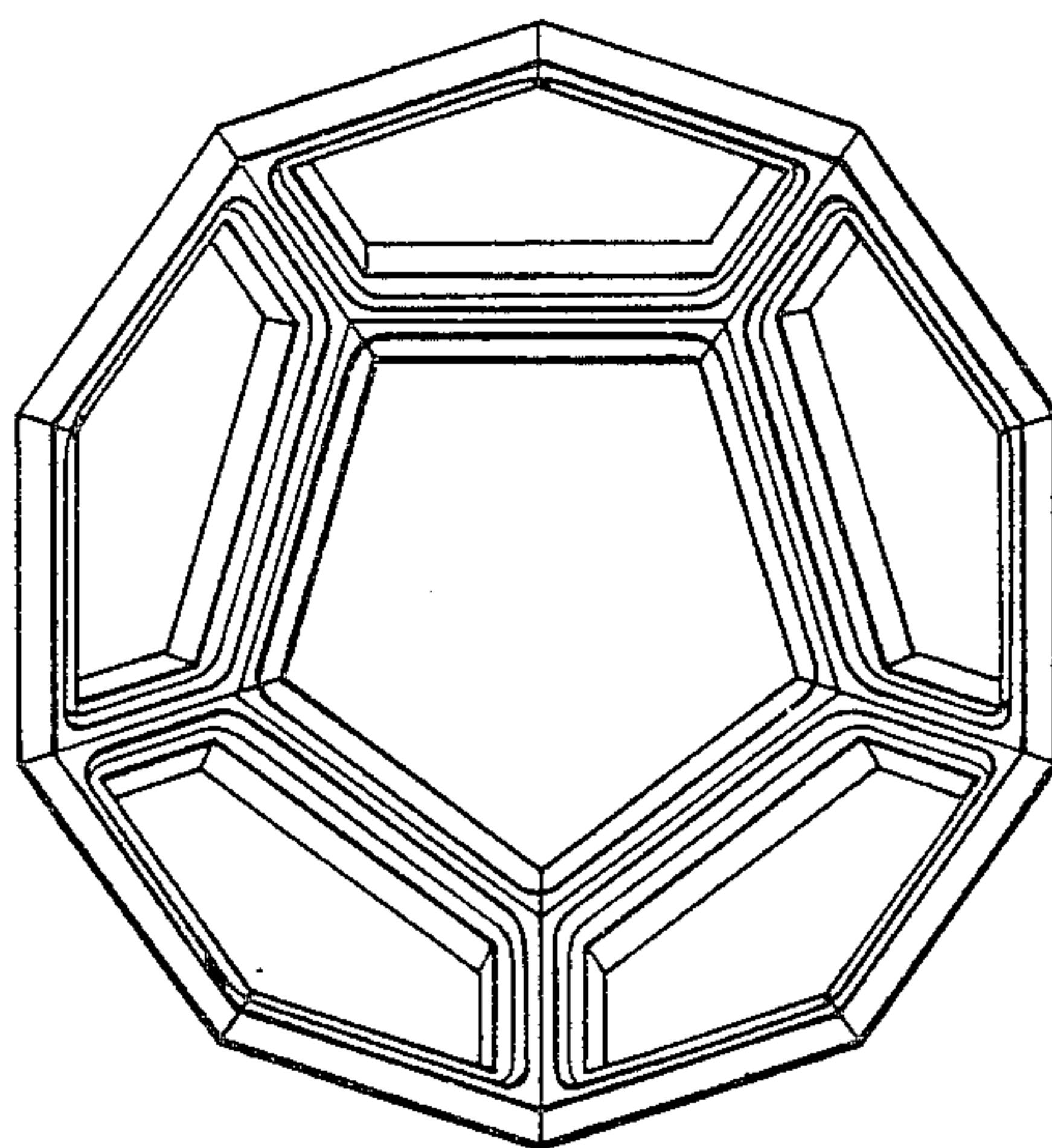
