FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

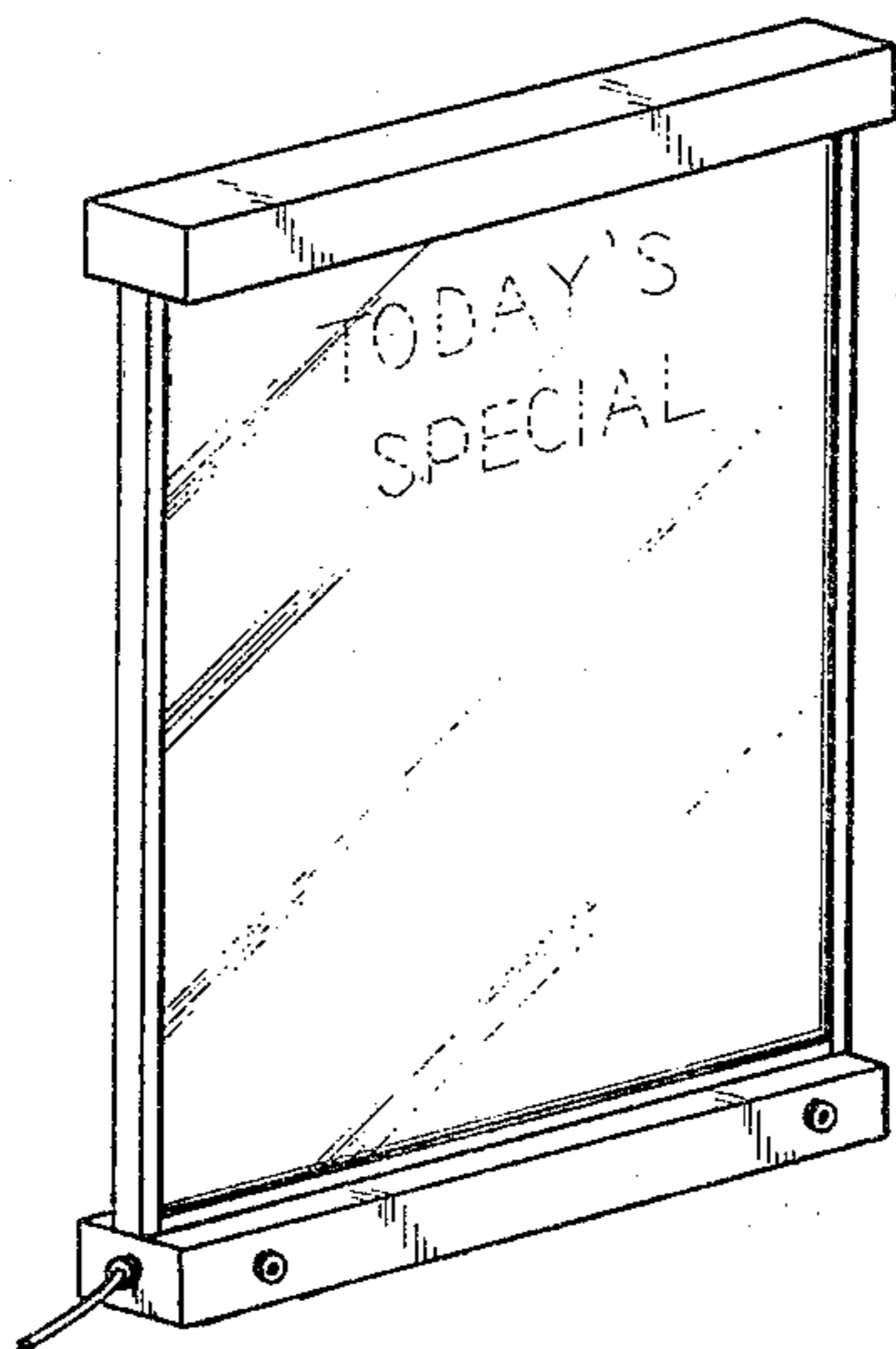
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The broken line disclosure shown in FIGS. 1, 2 and 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



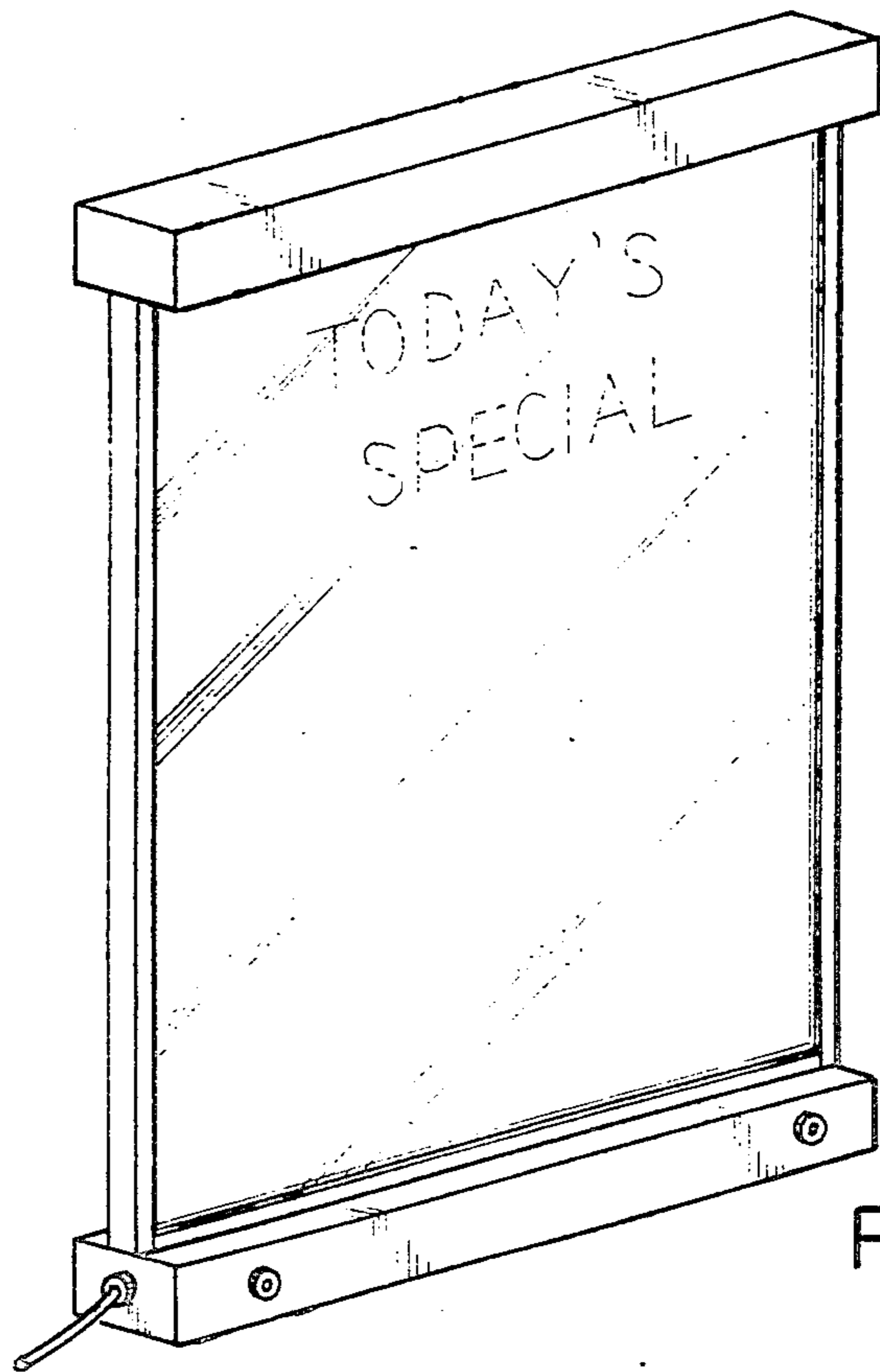

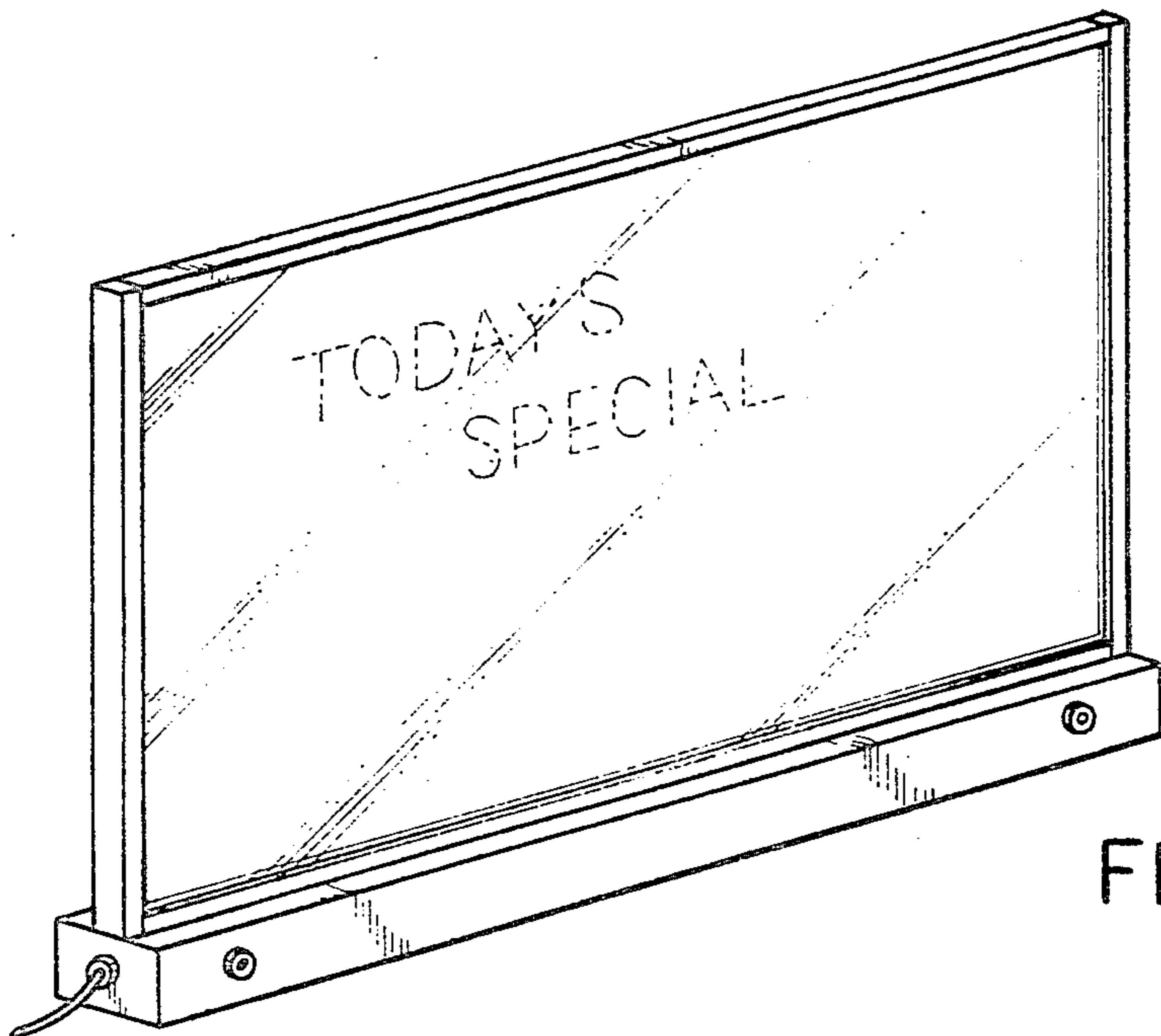

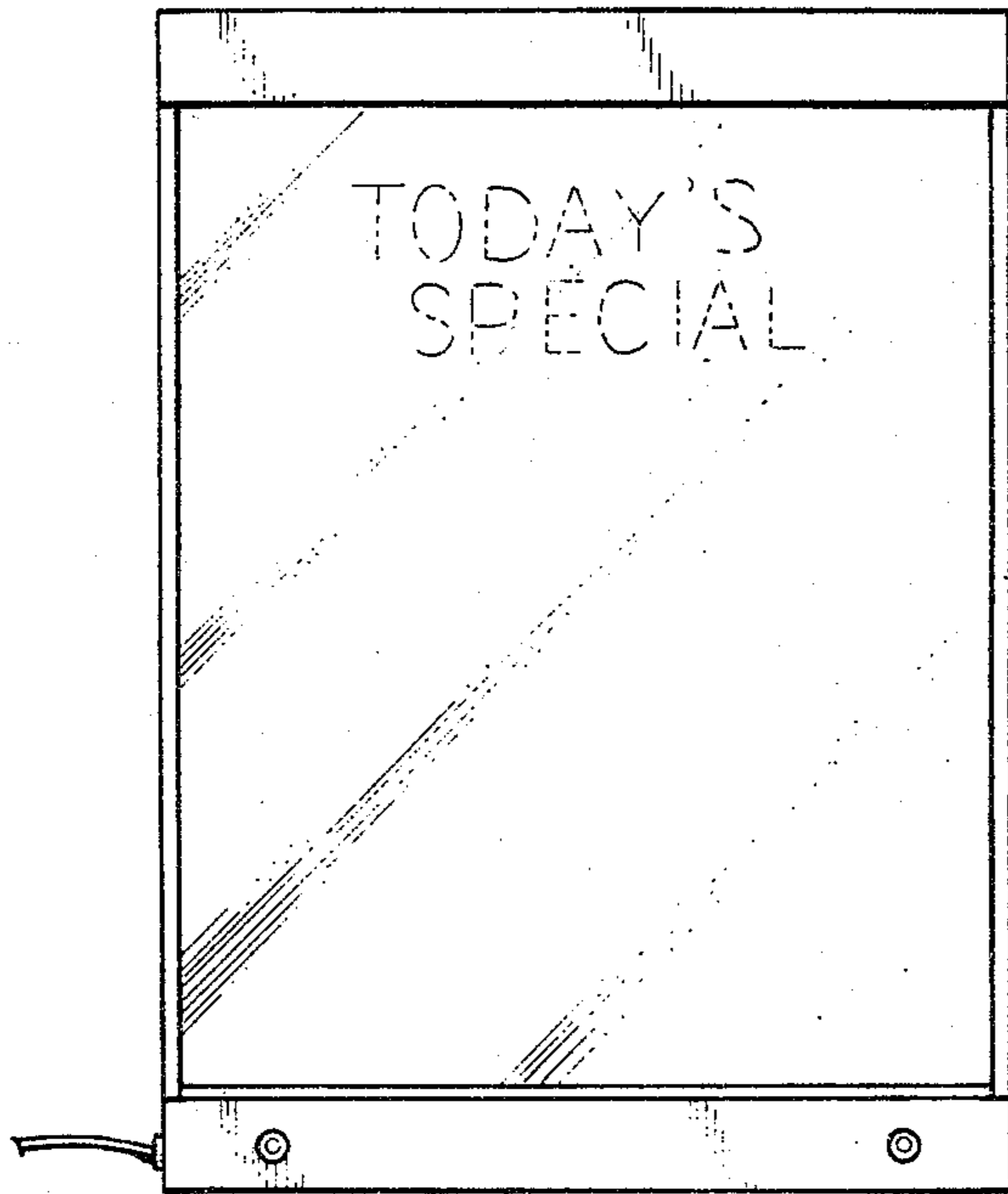
