DESCRIPTION

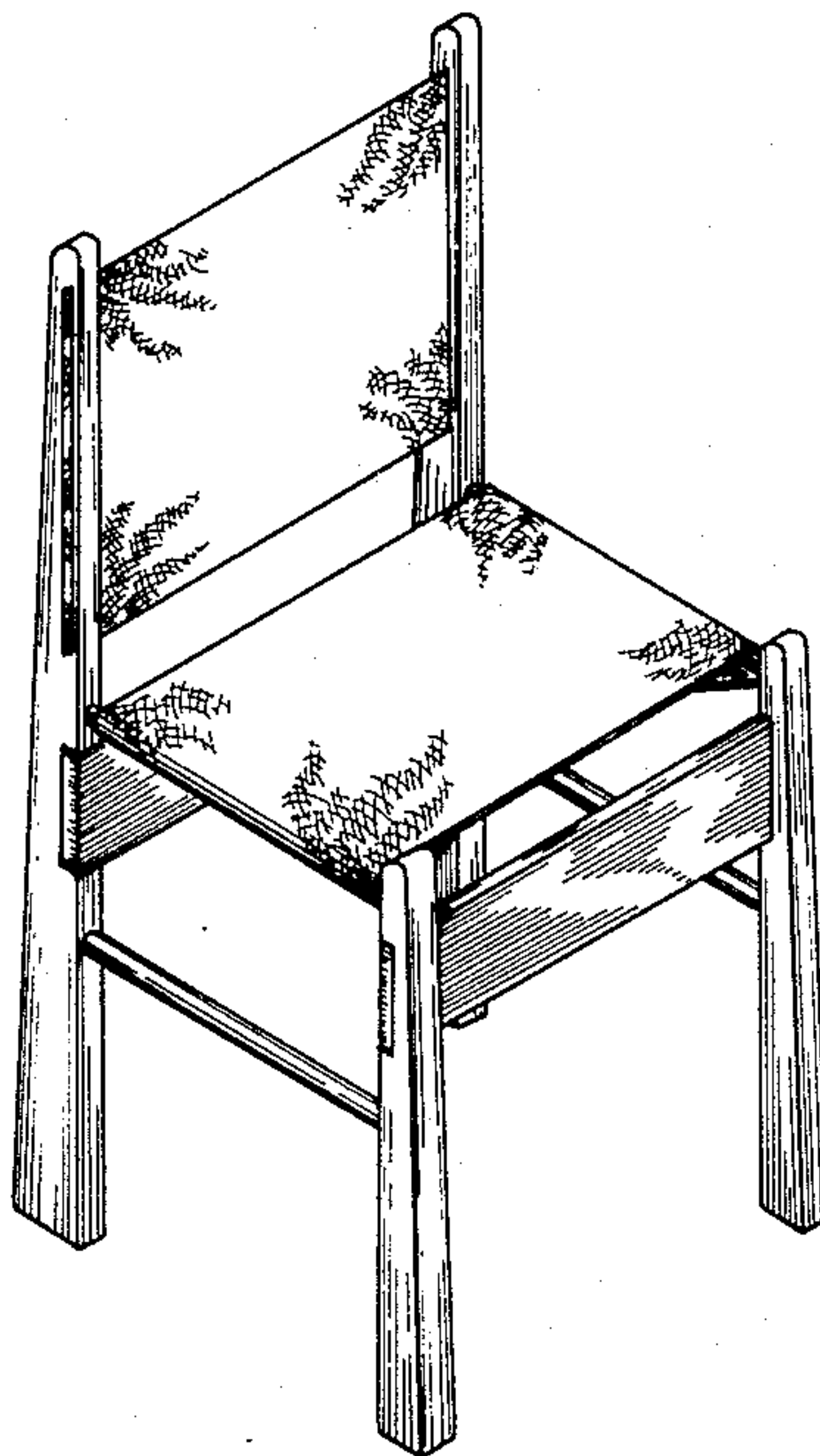
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a child's chair
showing our new design;

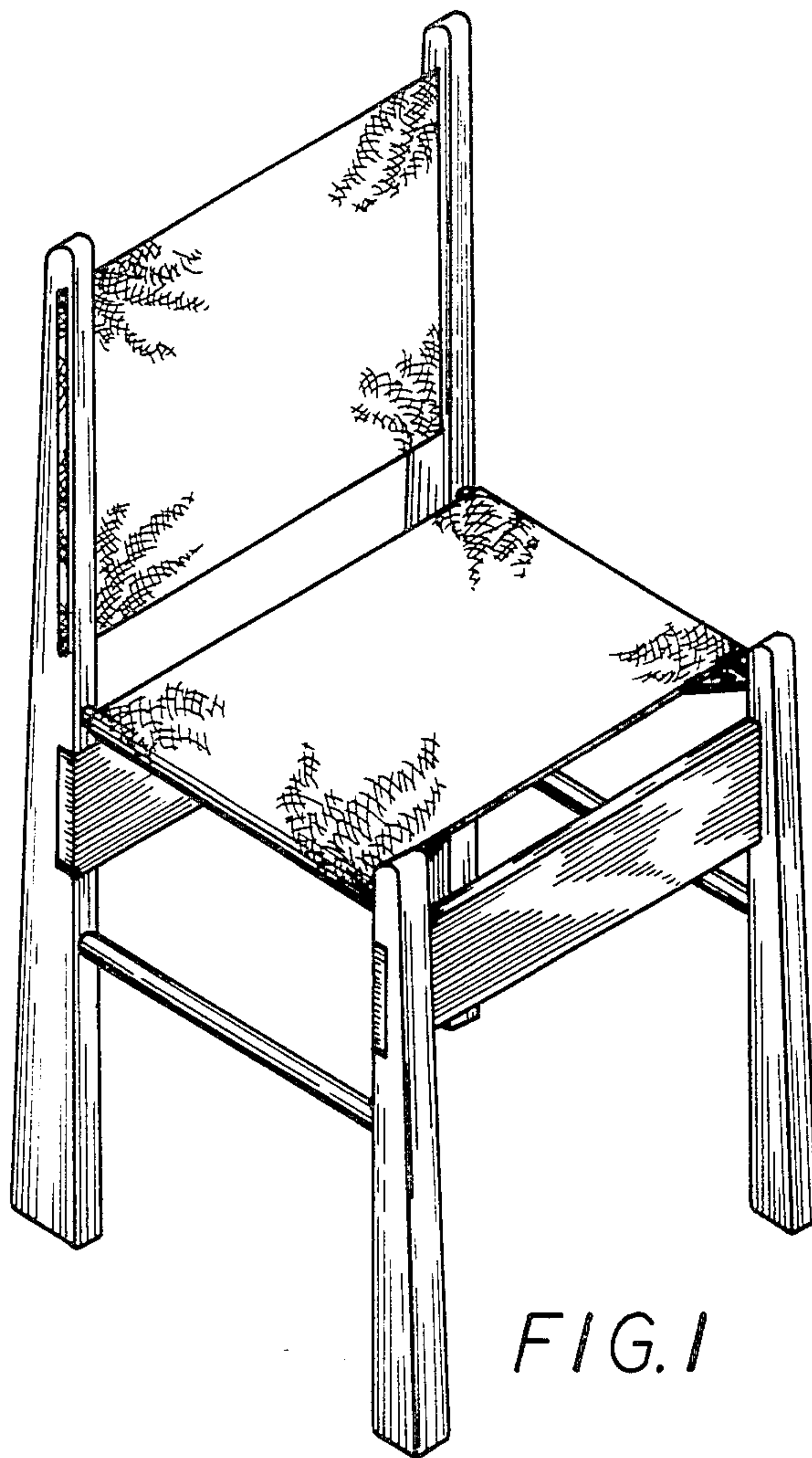
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair.





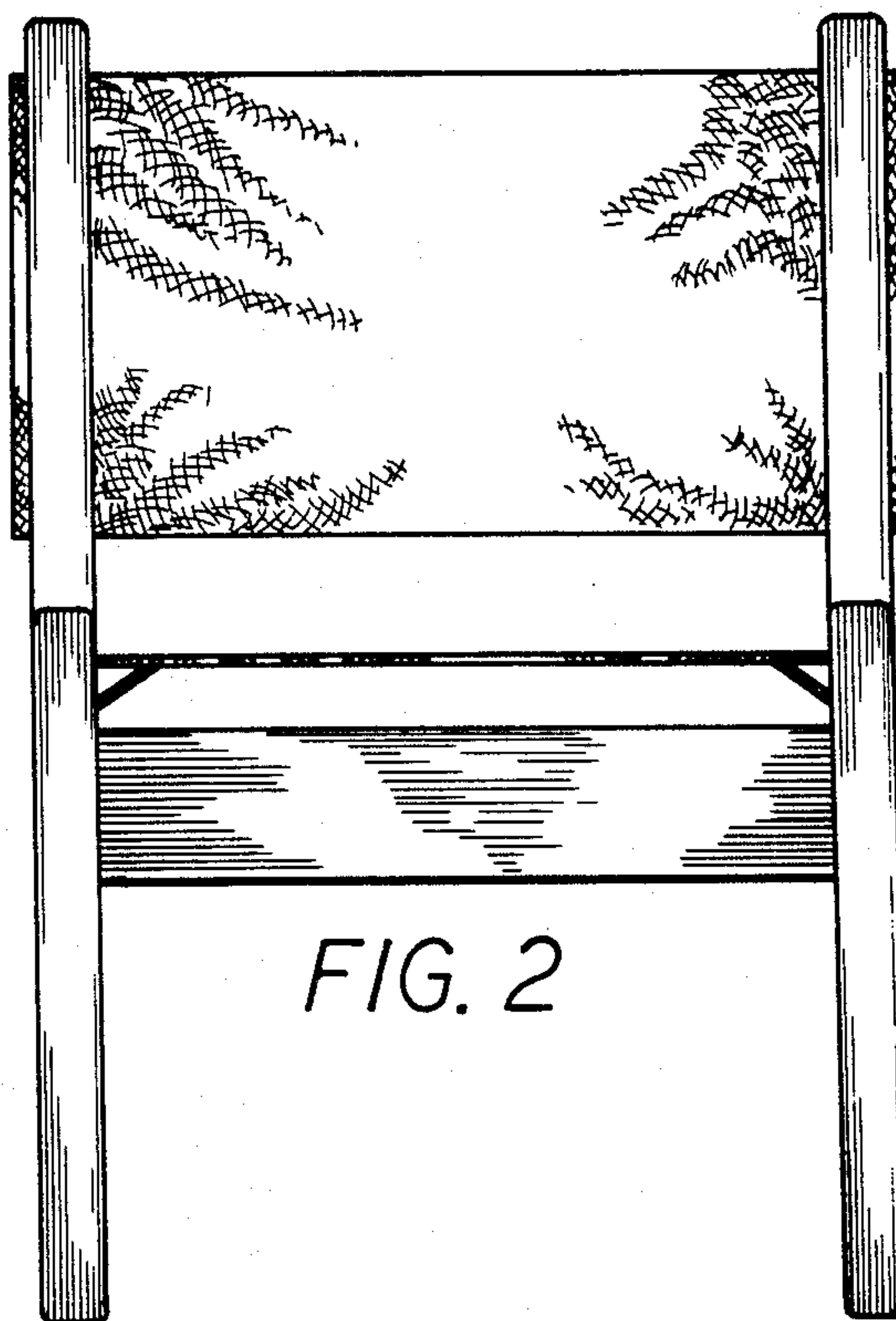

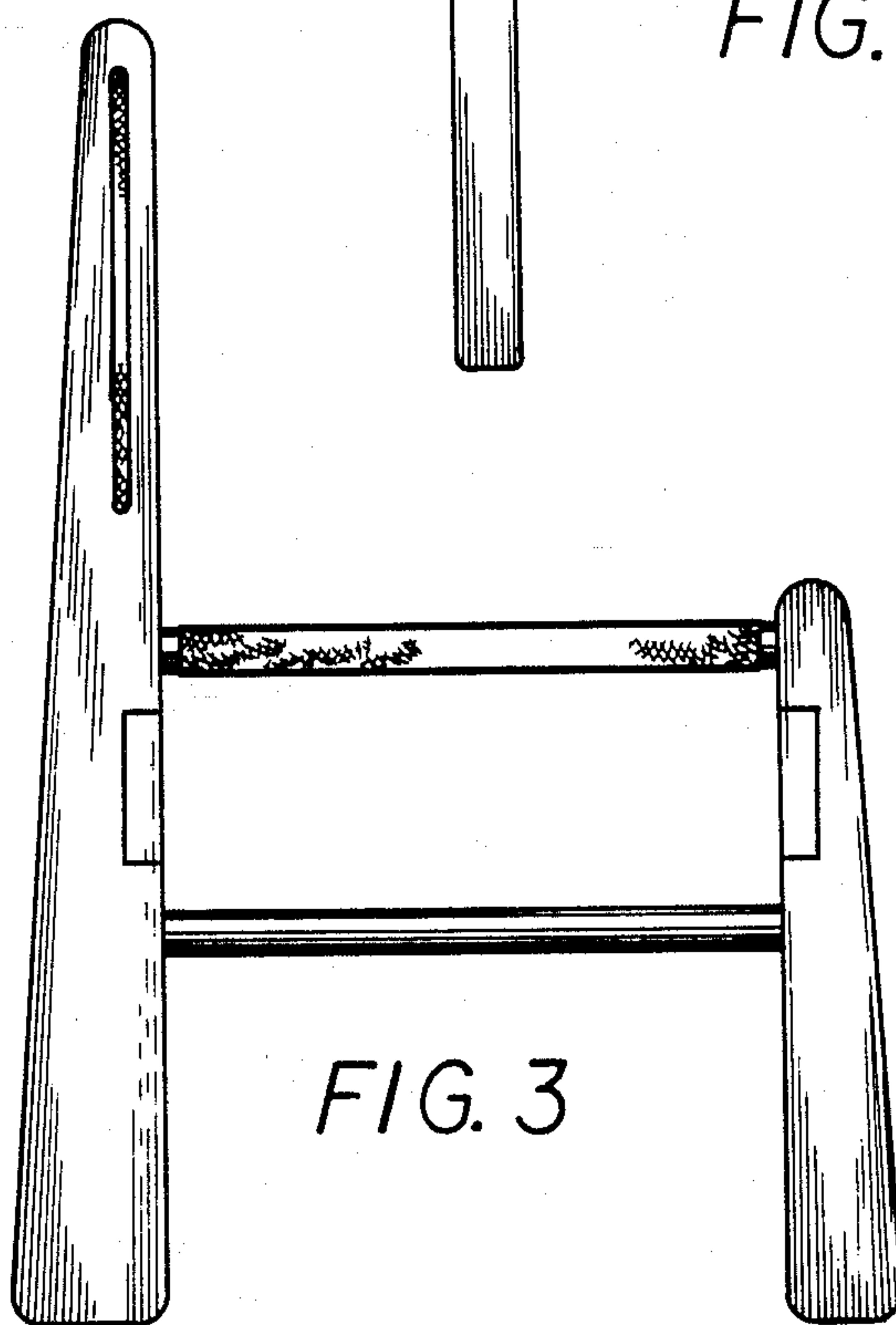
