DESCRIPTION

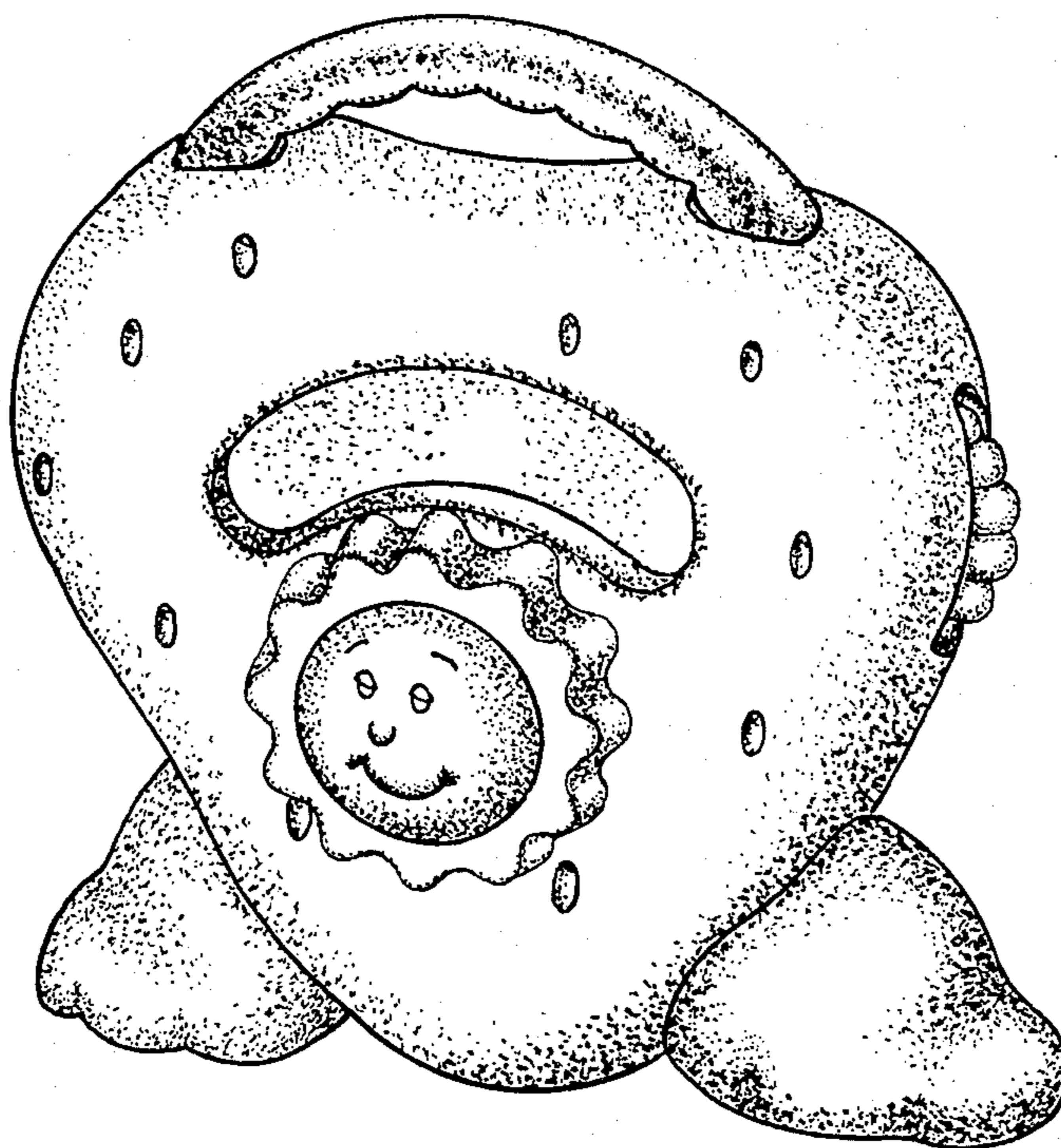
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toy radio showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



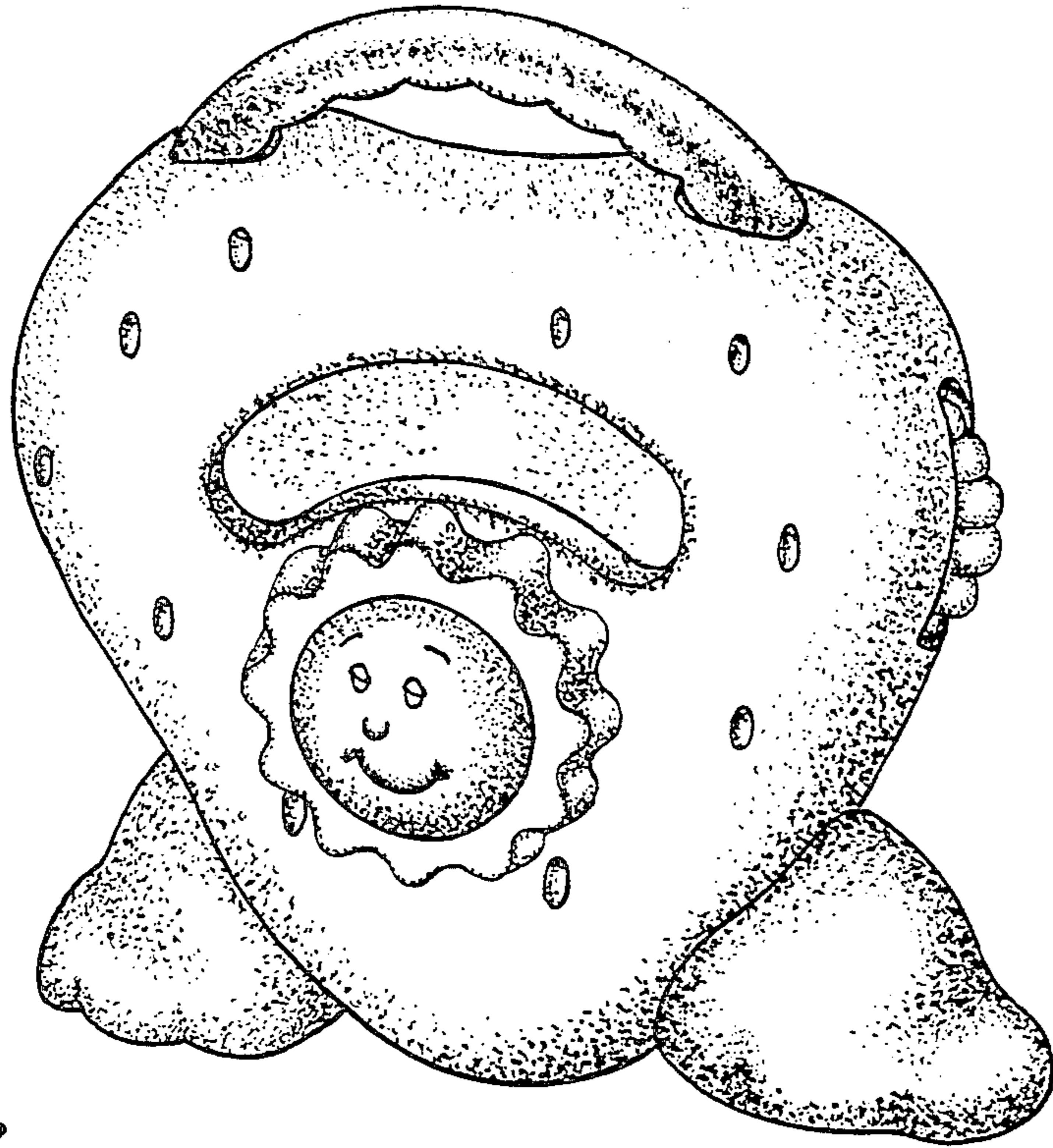

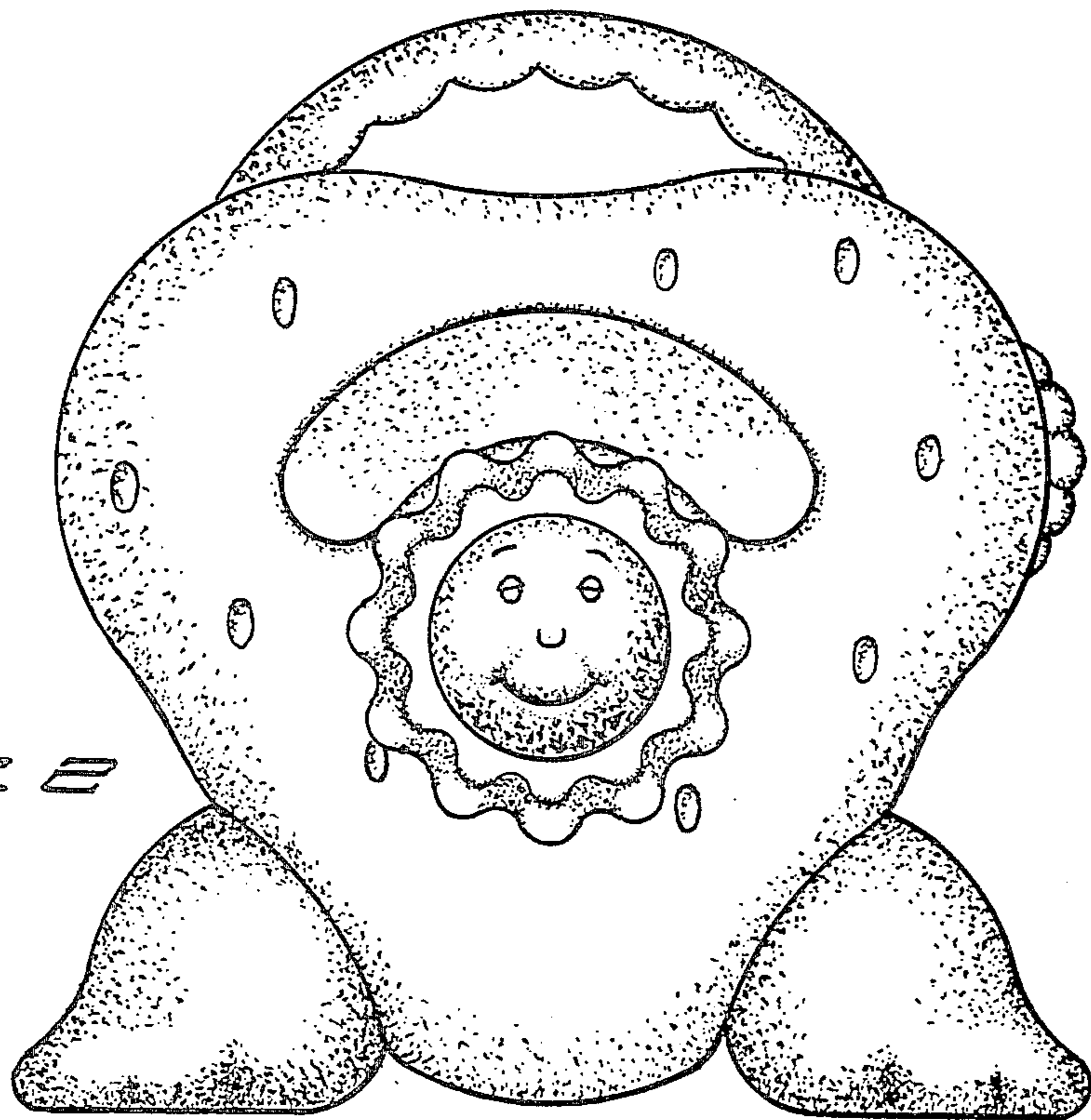

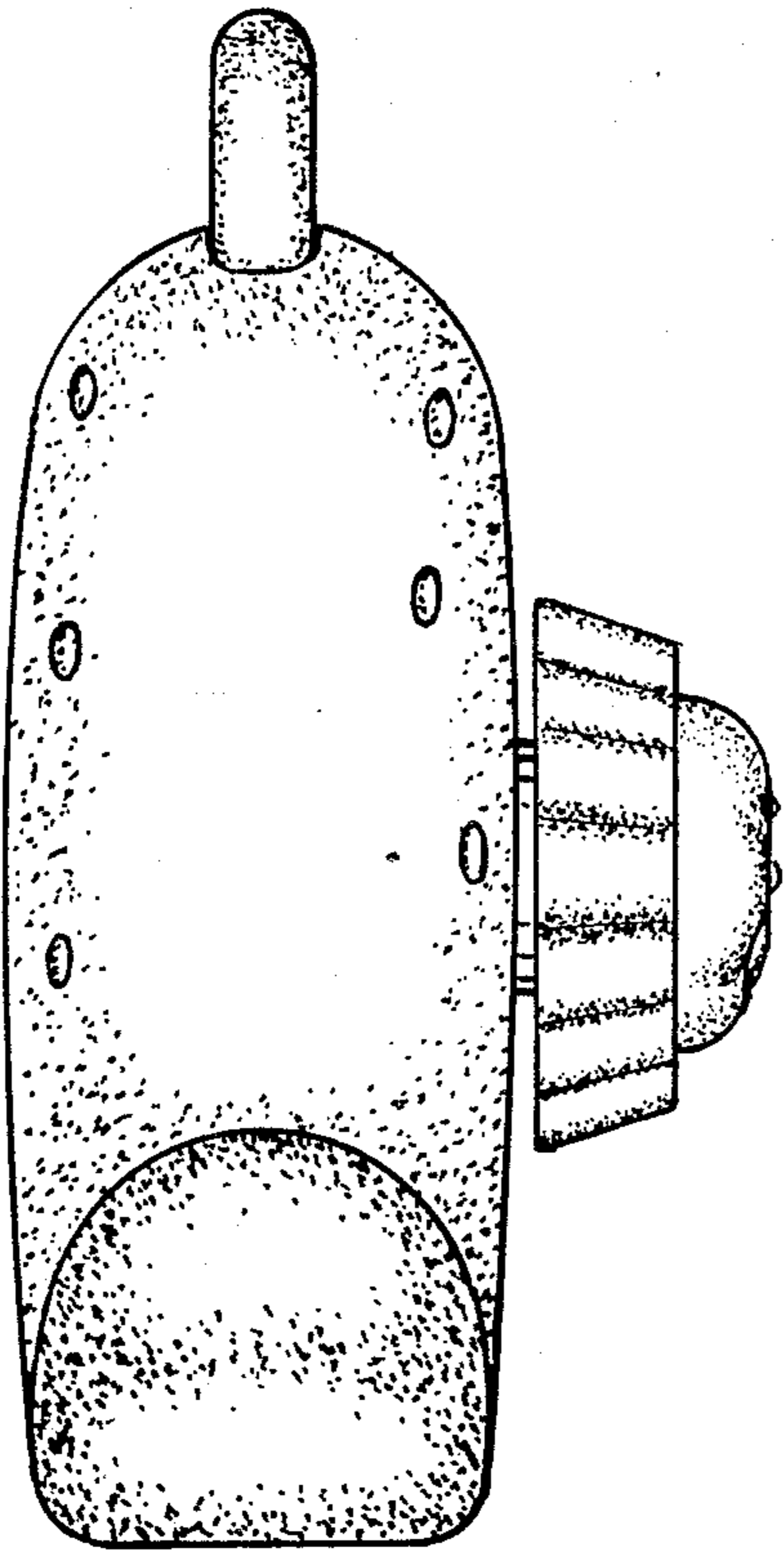

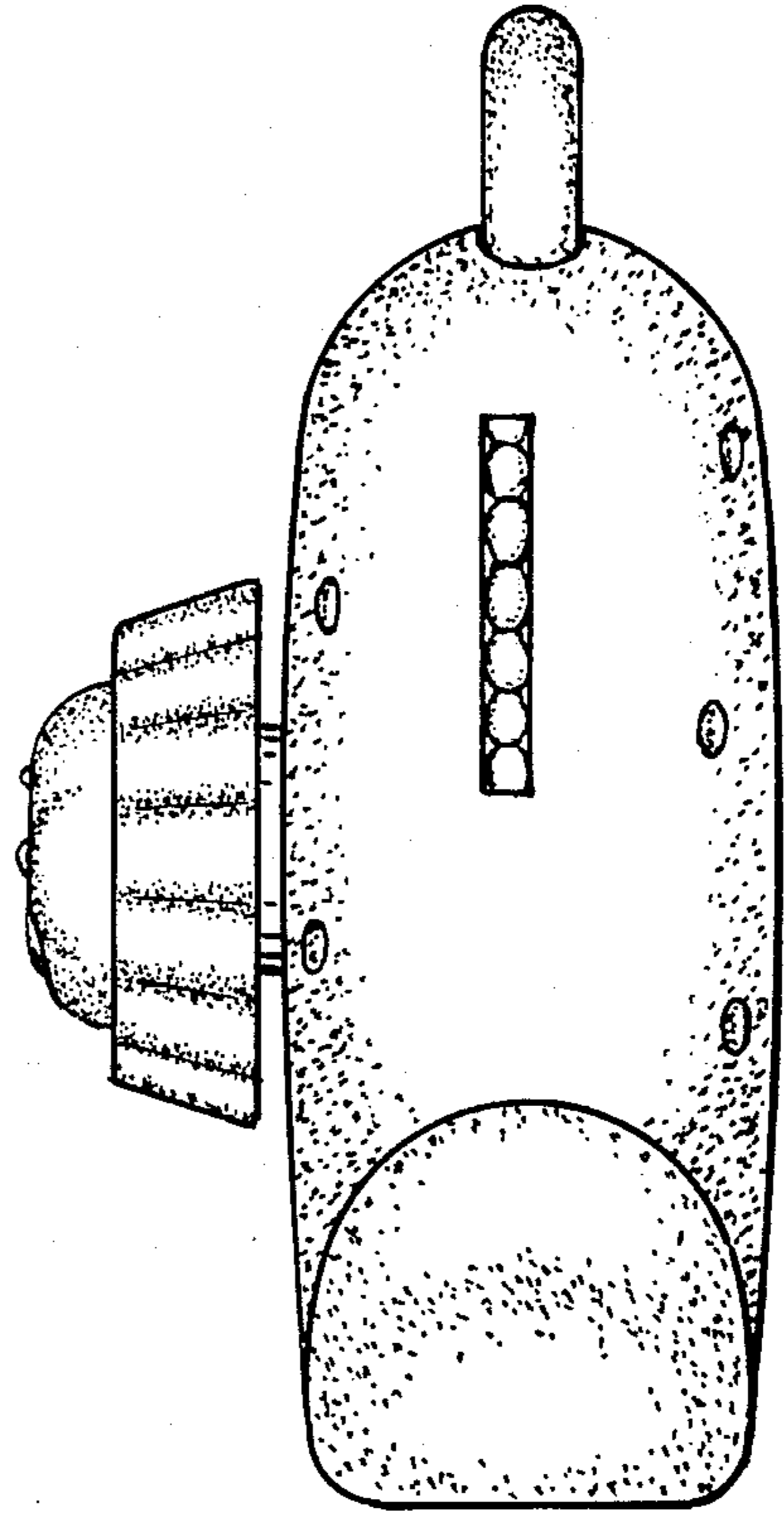

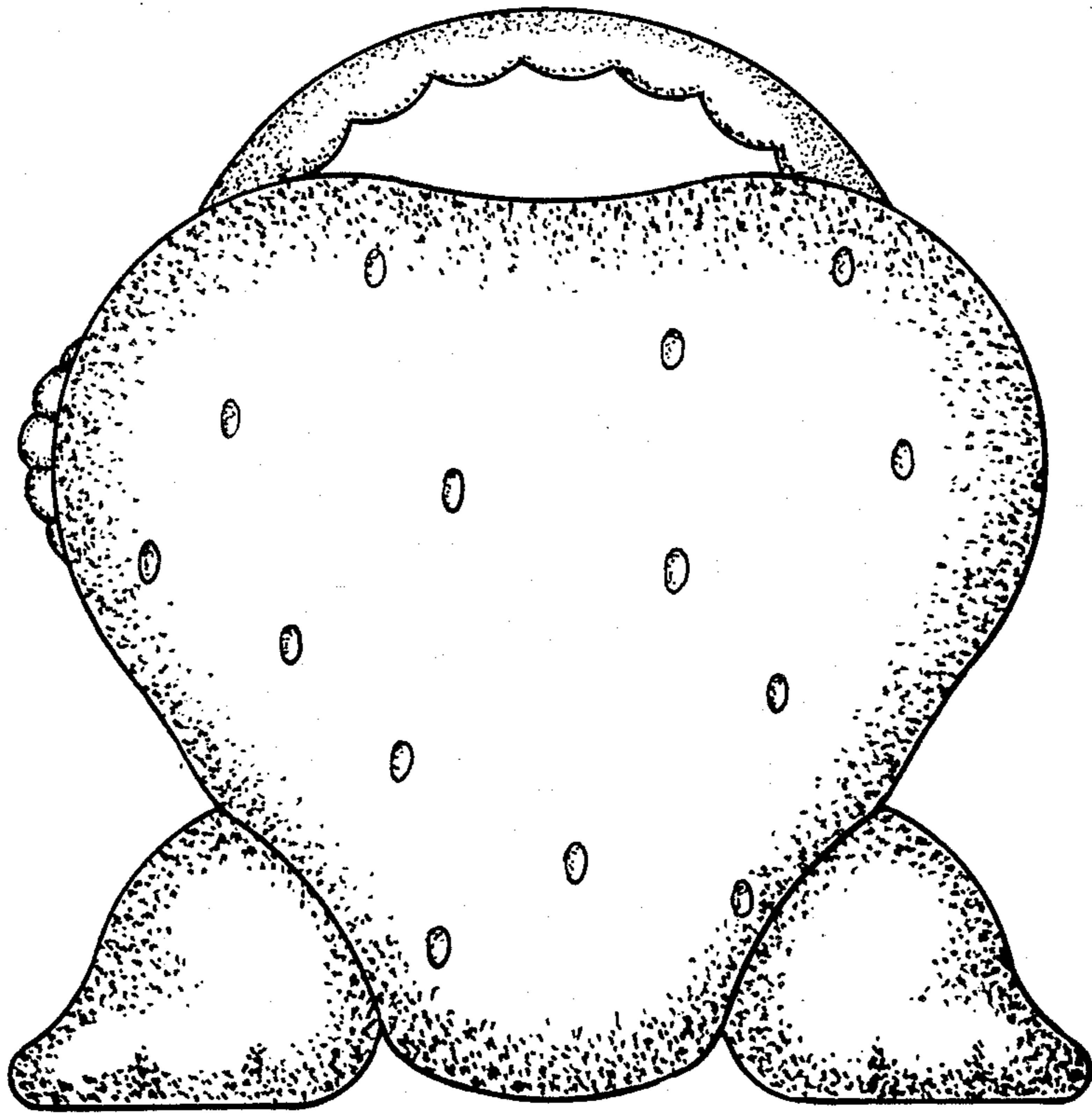
