FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

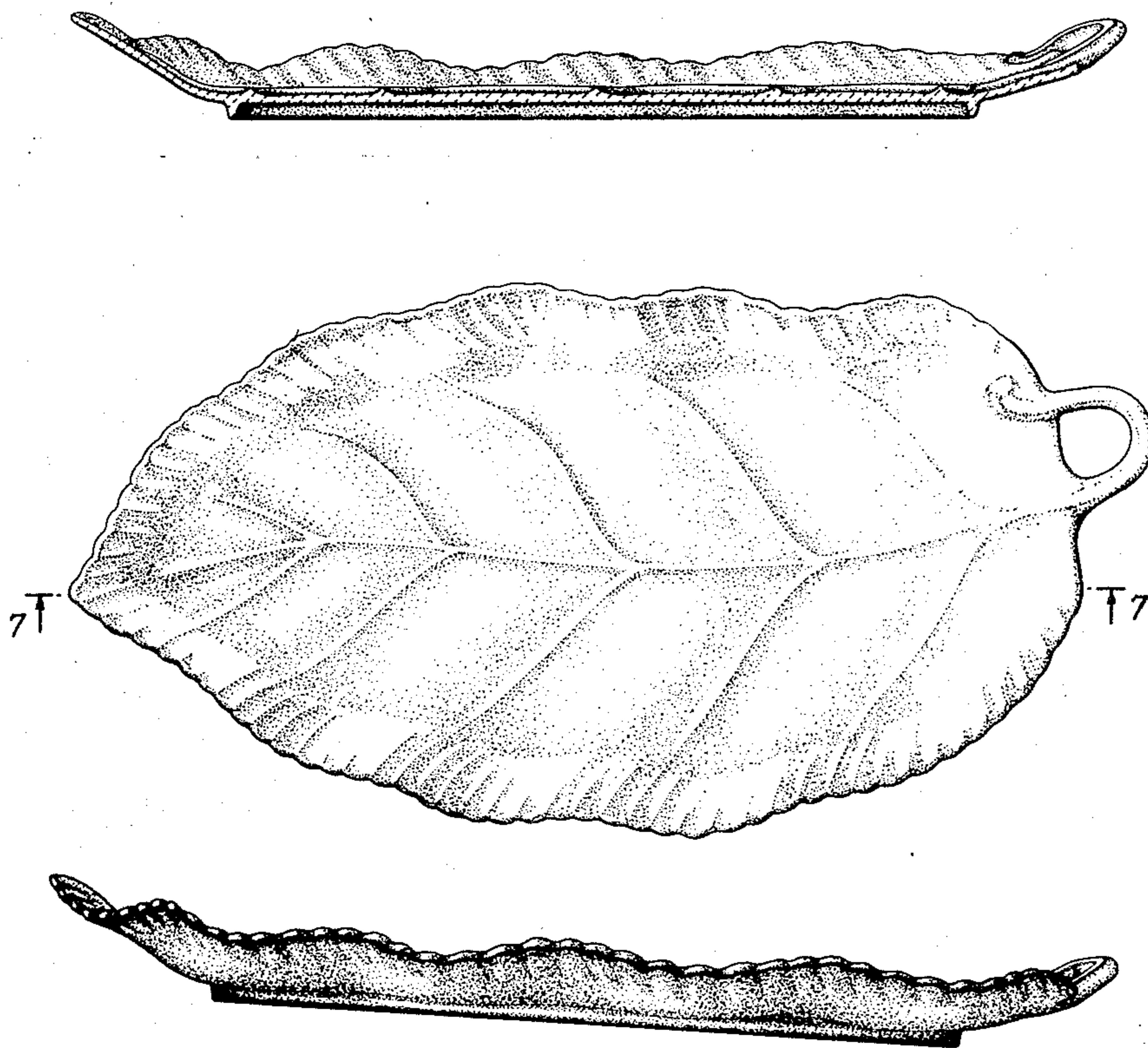
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the hors d'oeuvre platter shown in FIG. 1;

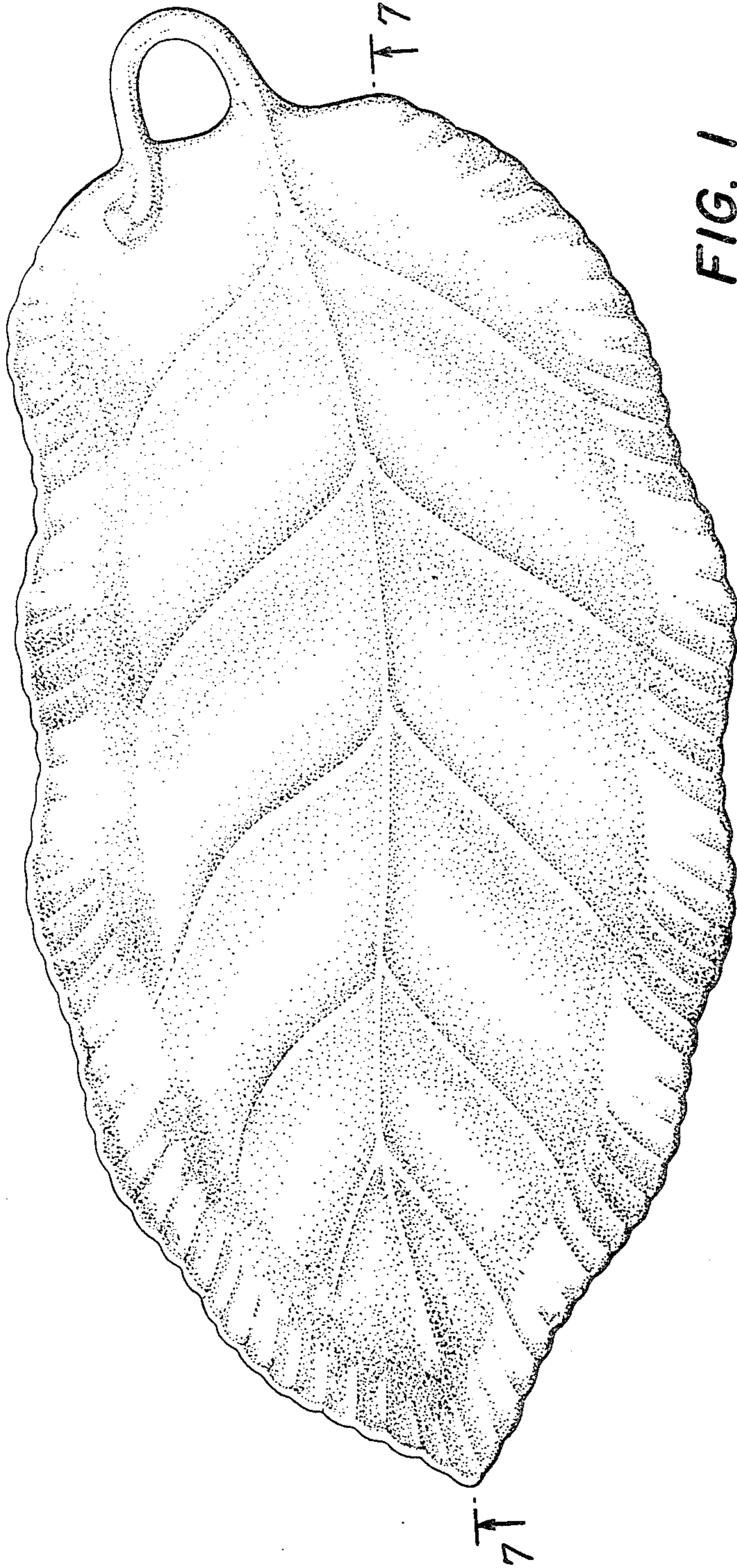
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a sectional view as taken along the line 7—7 in FIG. 1.





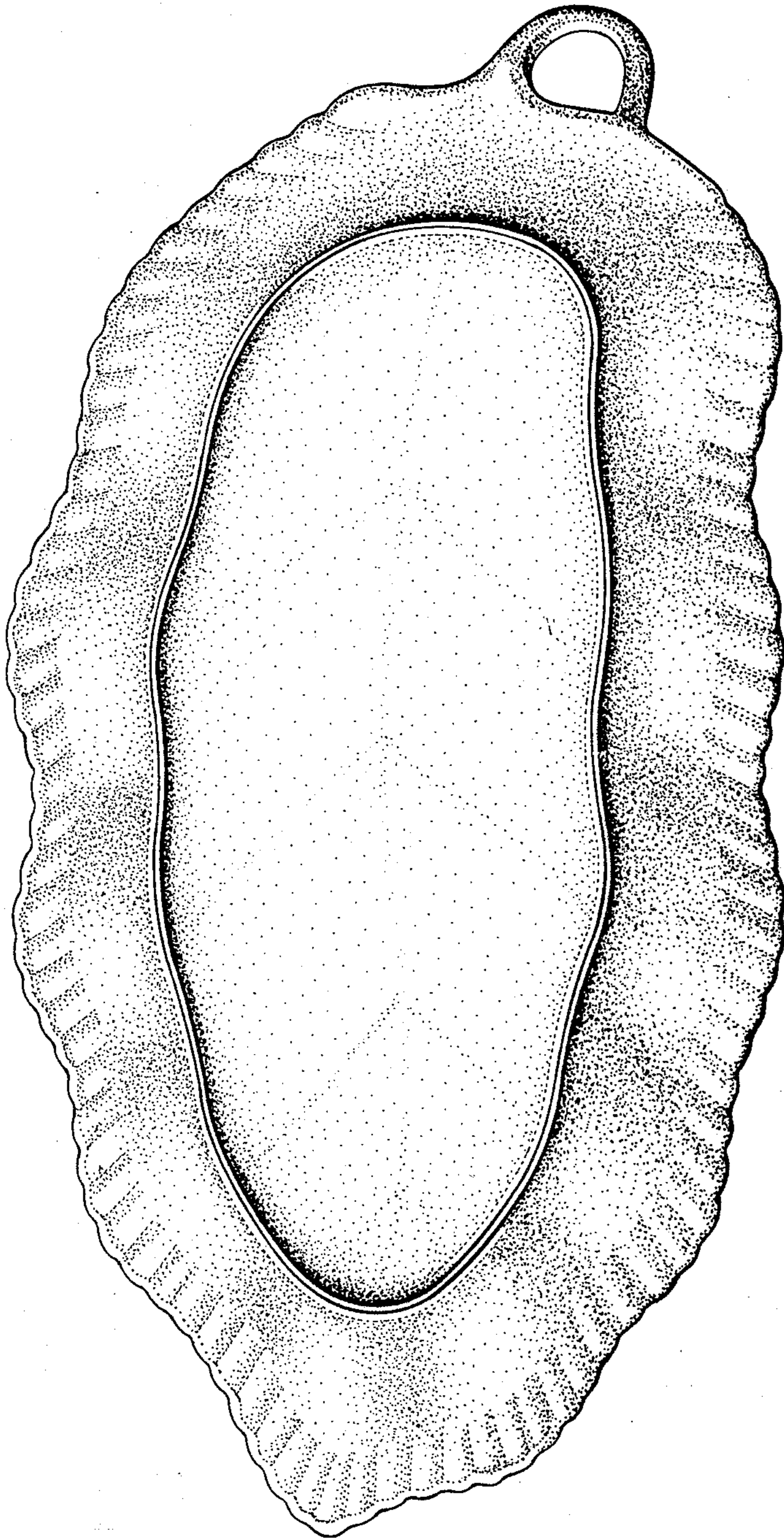

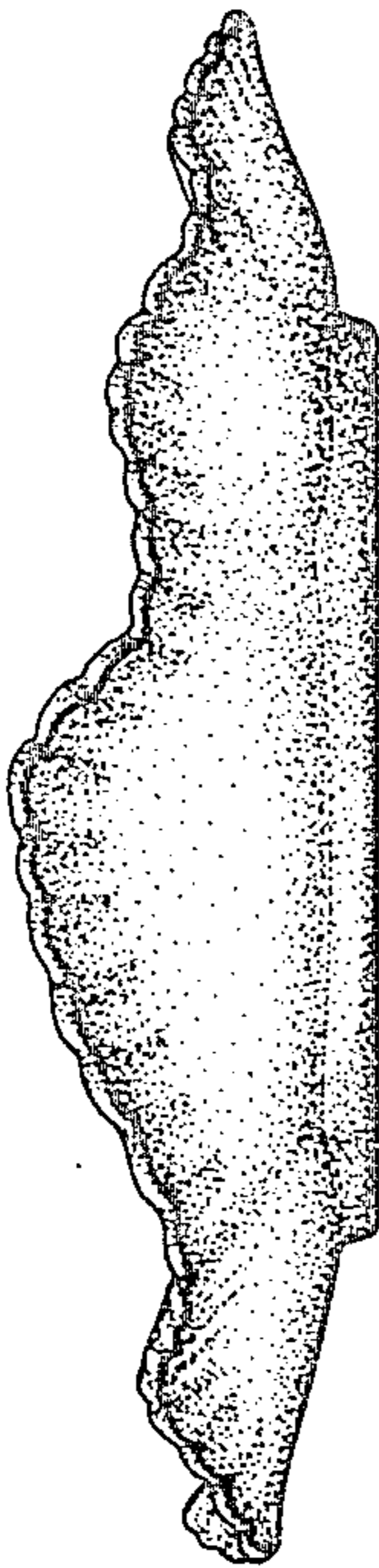

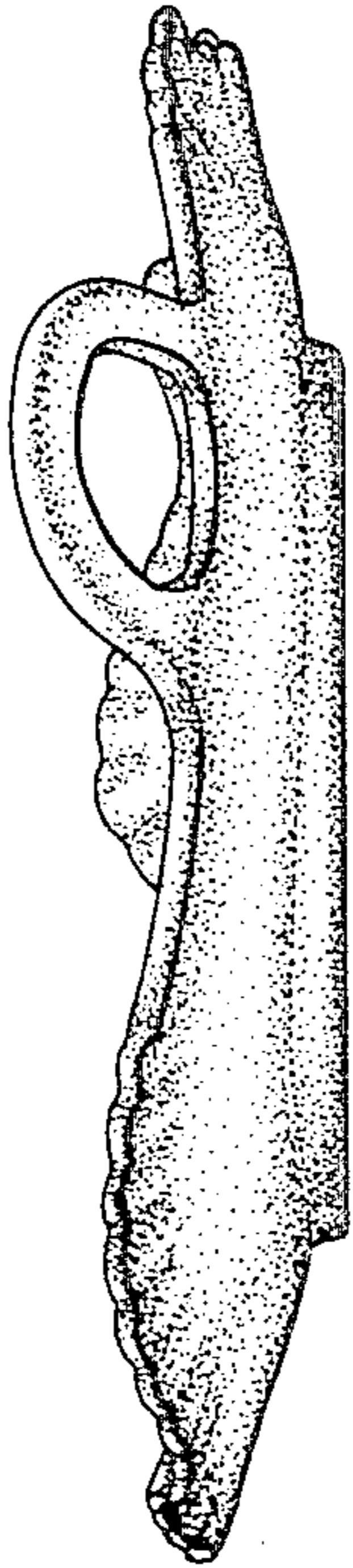

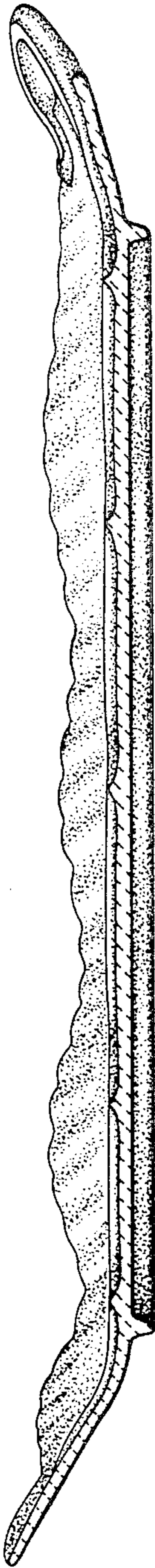
