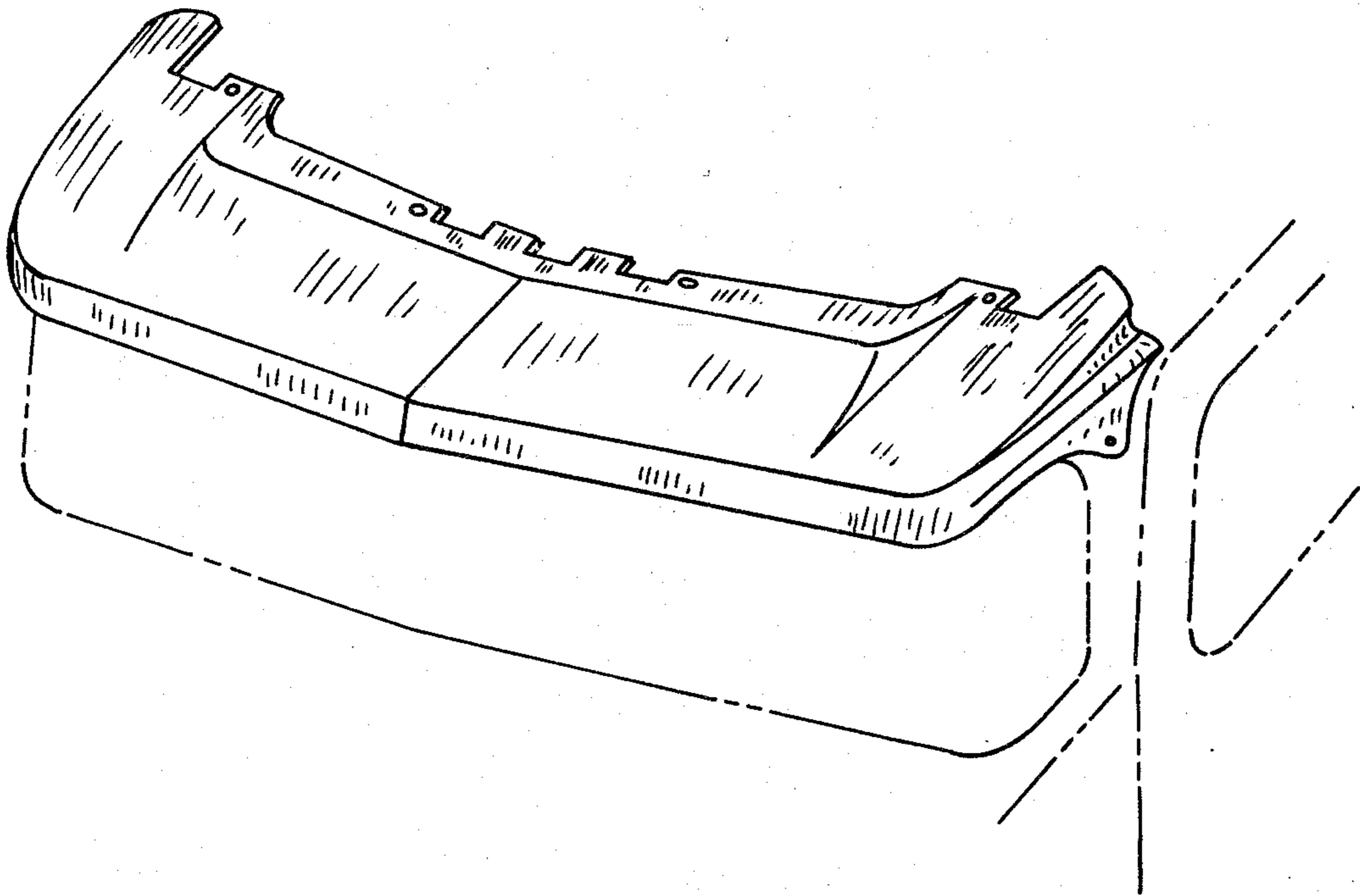

FIG. 8 is a vertical section view taken substantially along line 8—8 of FIG. 7.



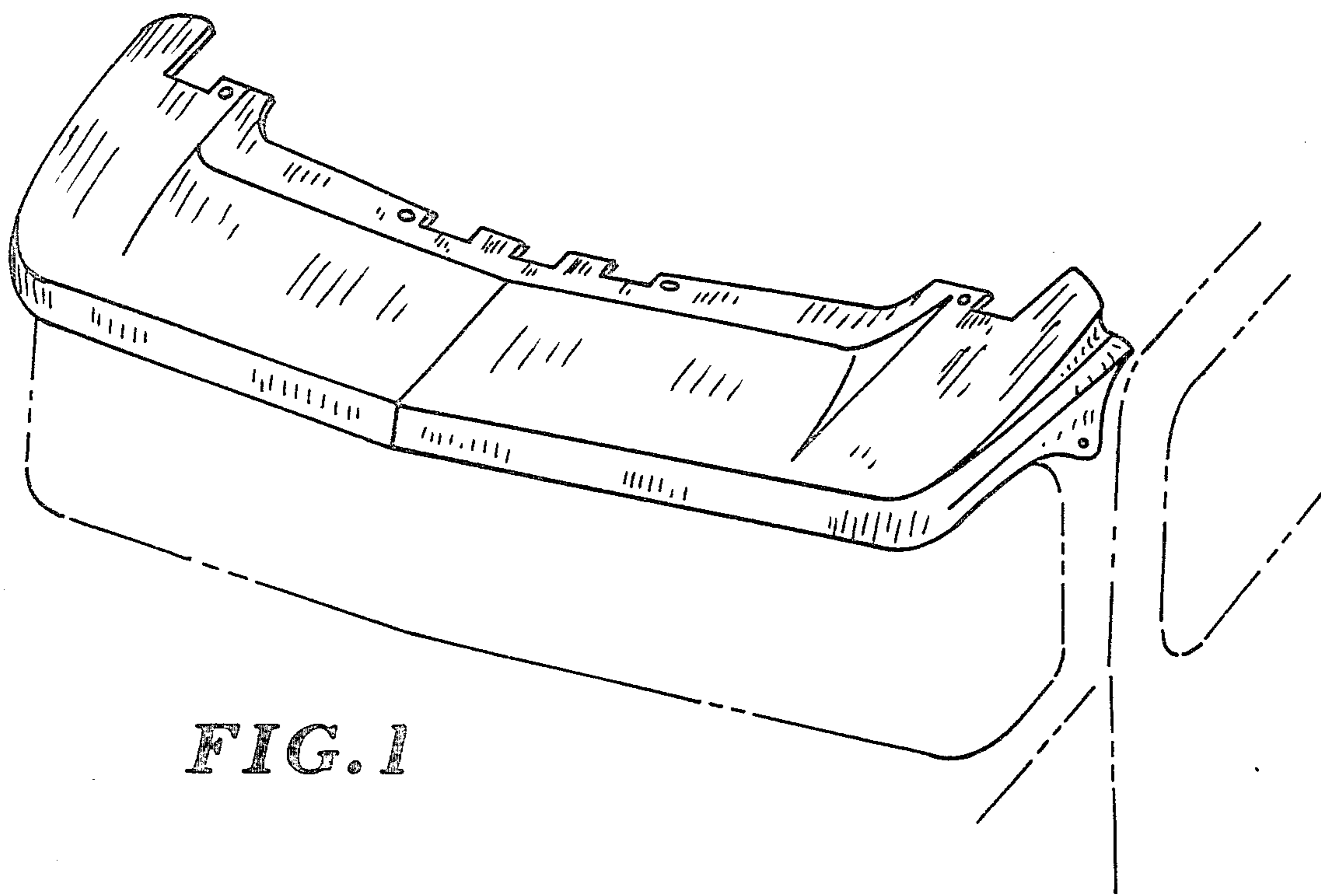

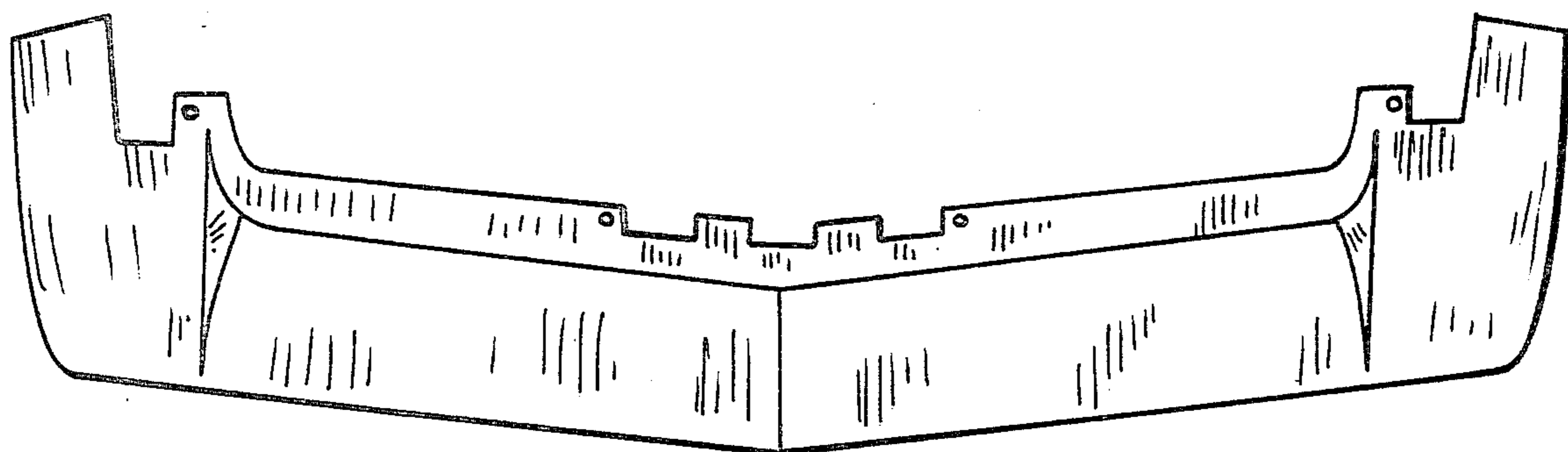

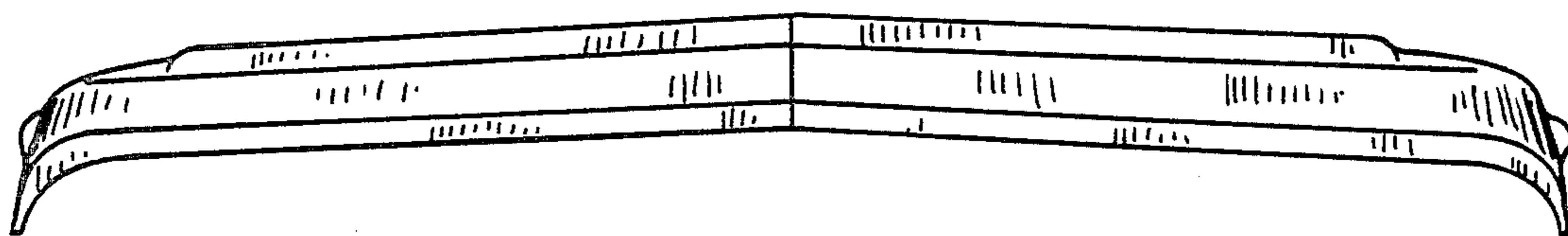

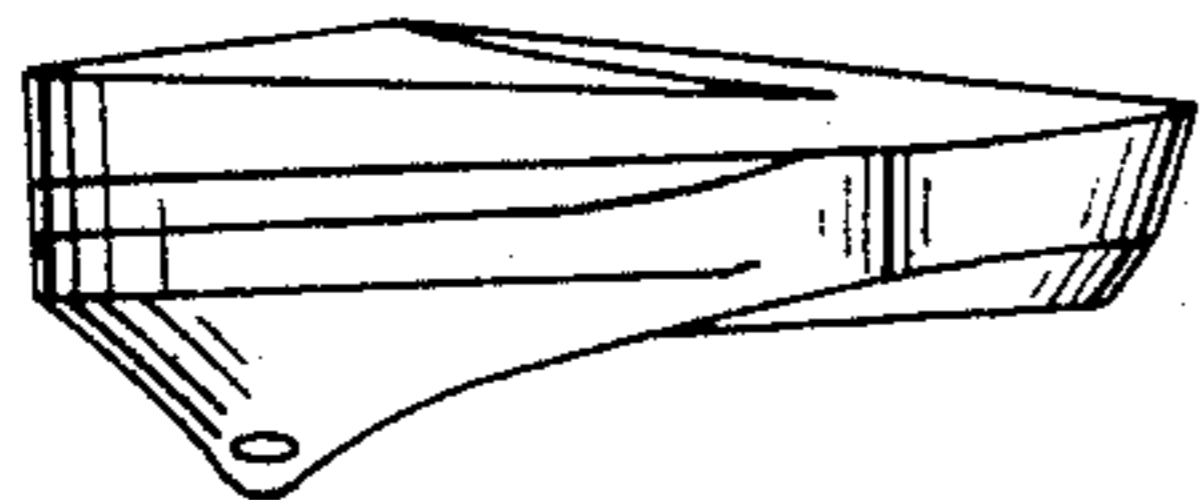

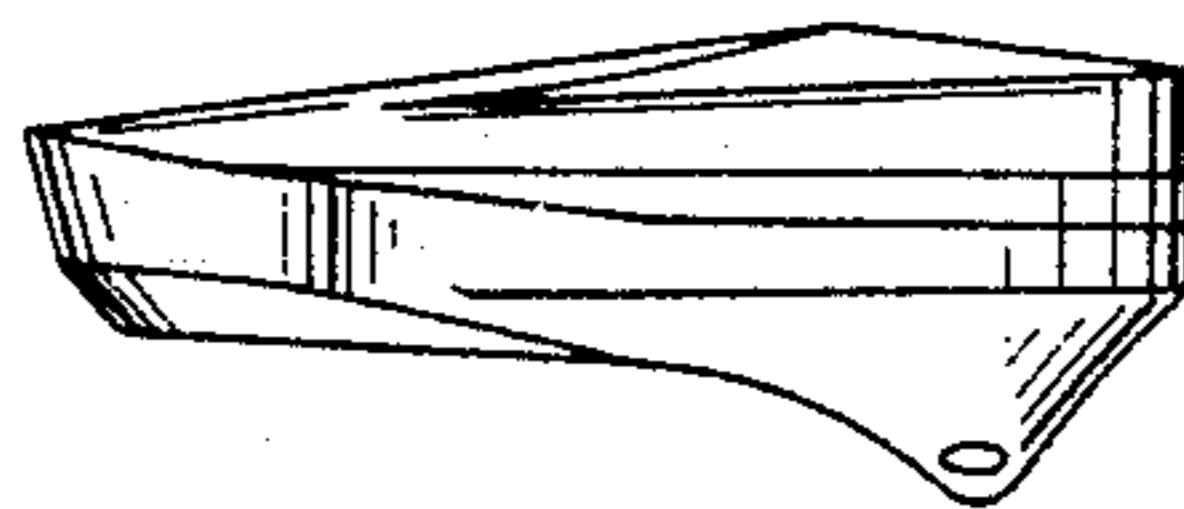

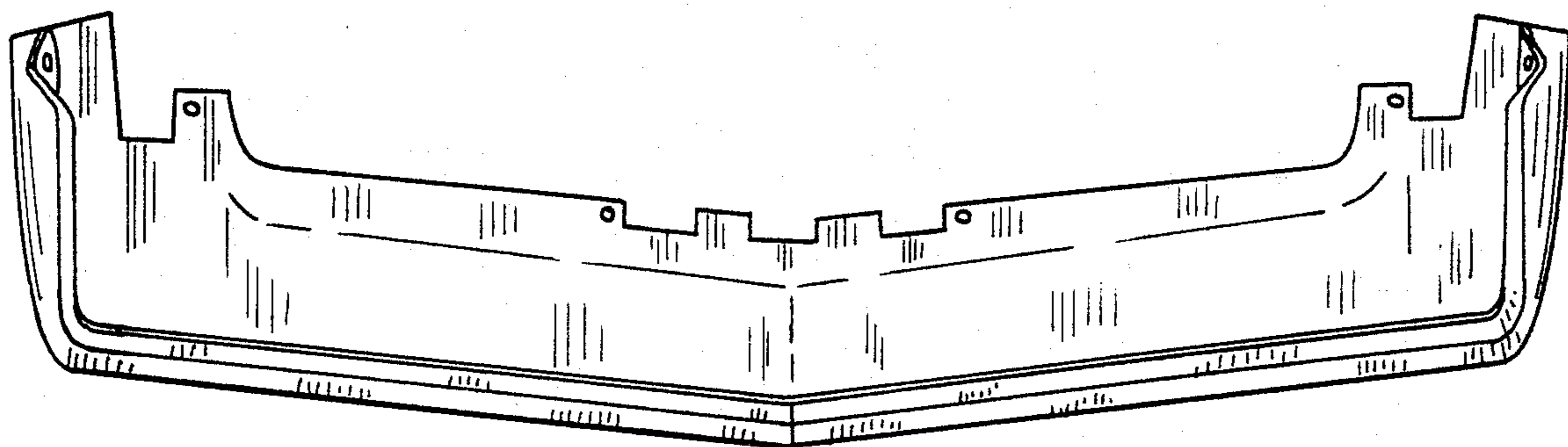

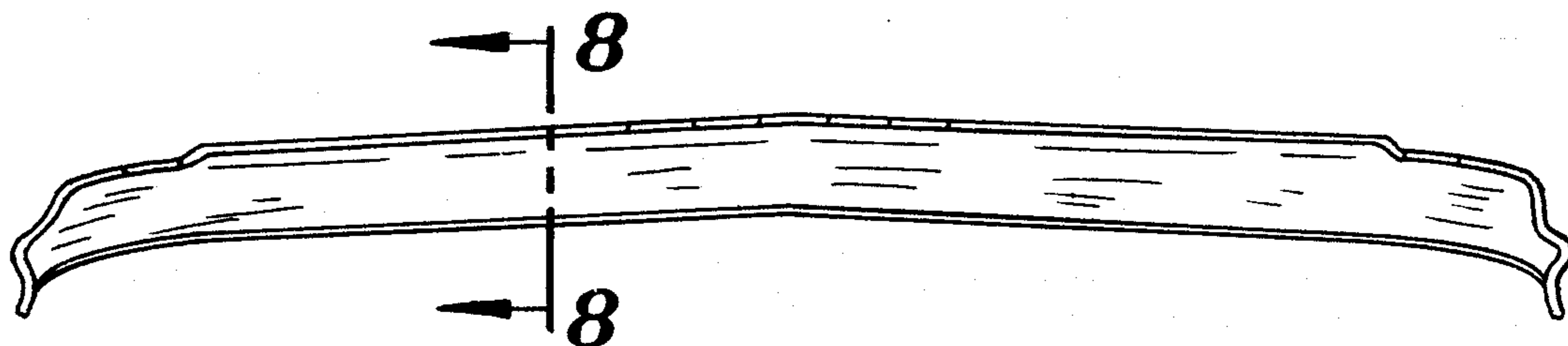

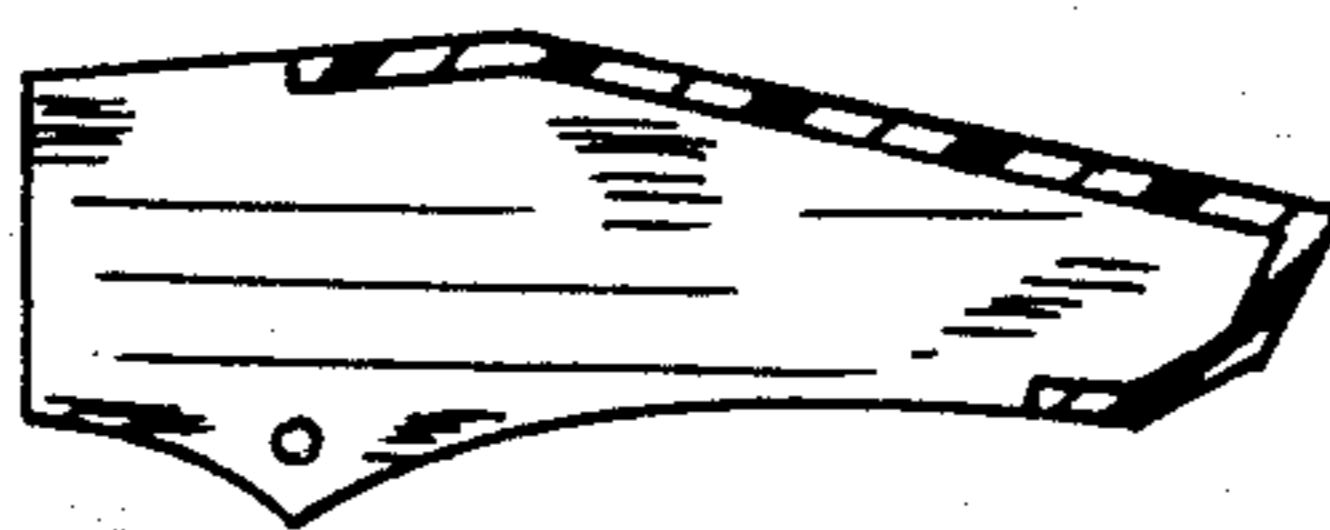
