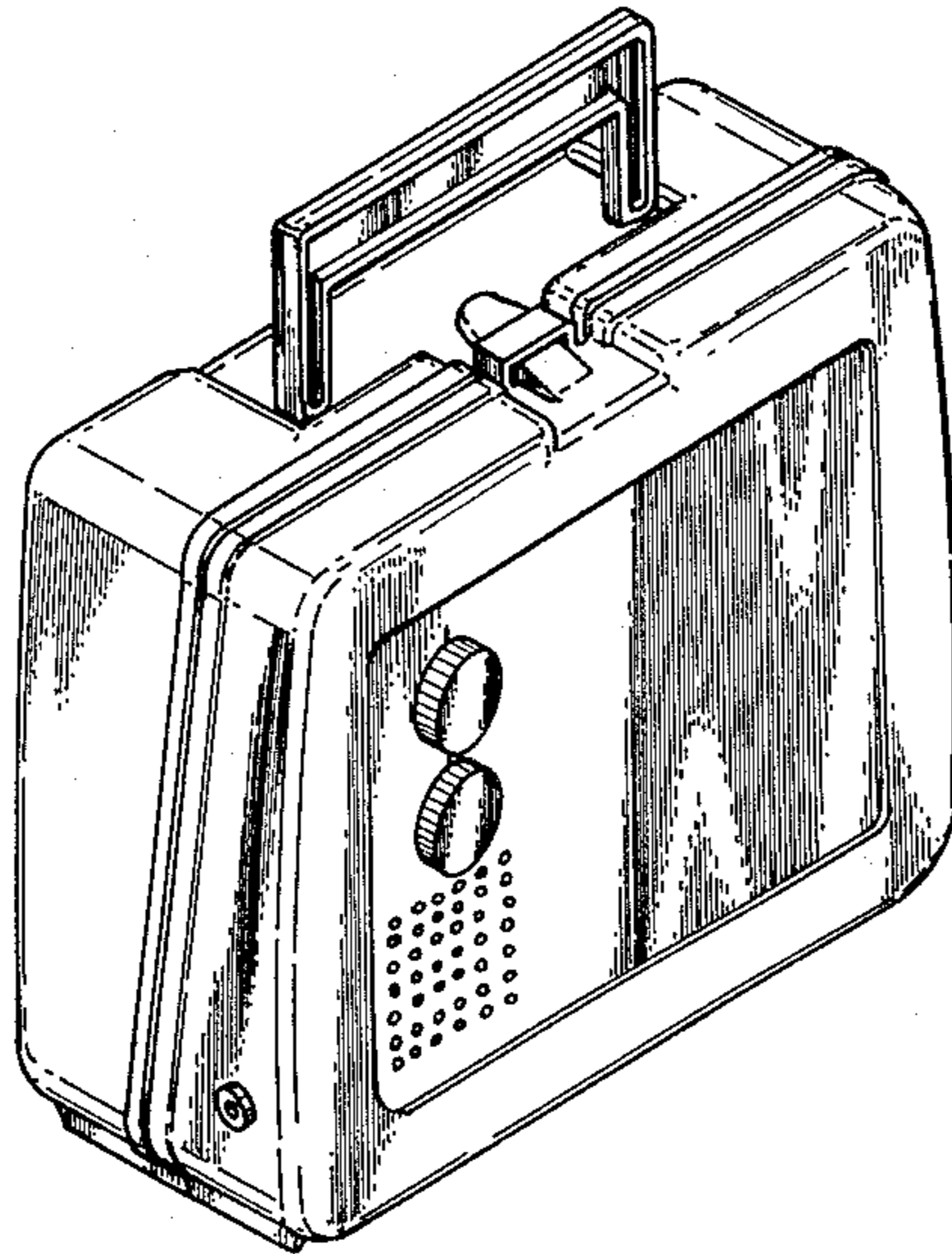

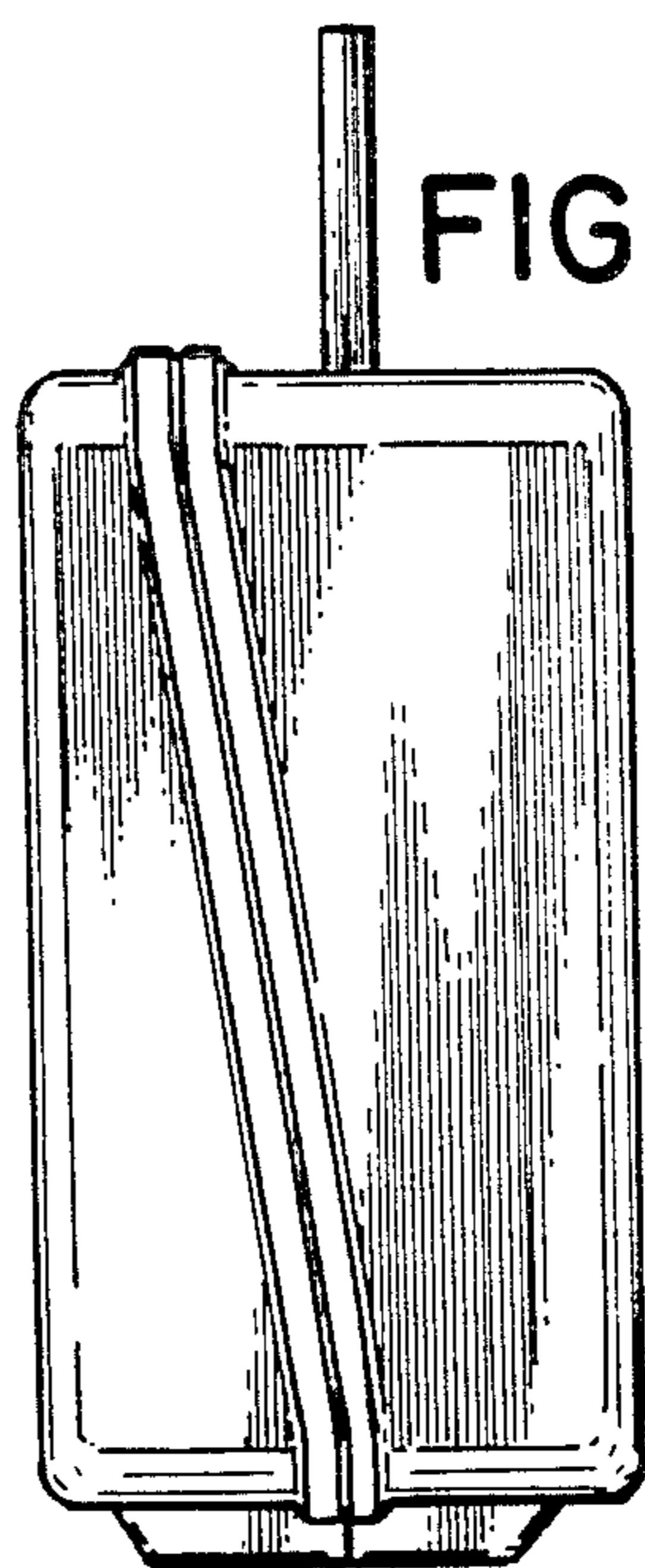
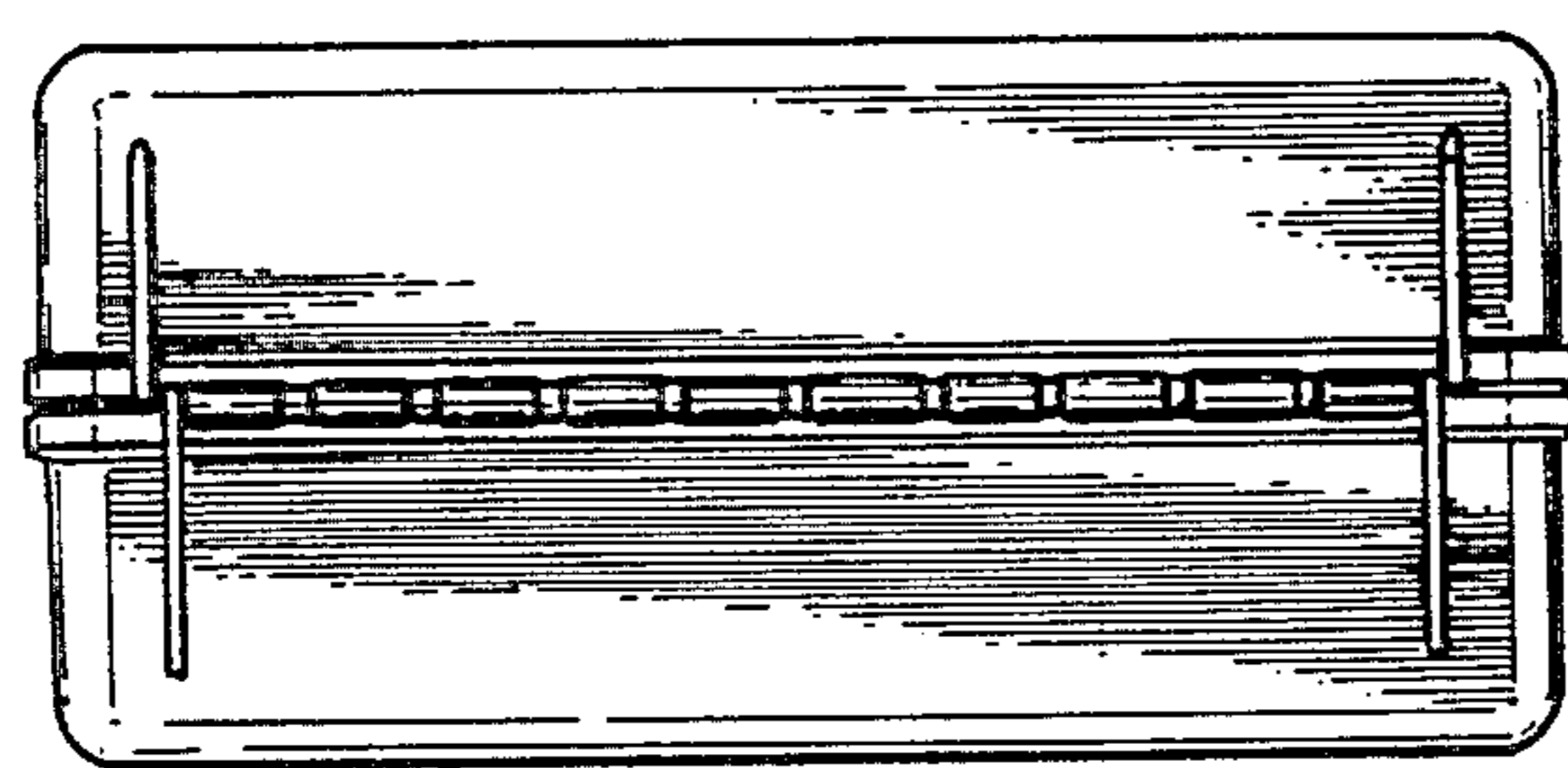
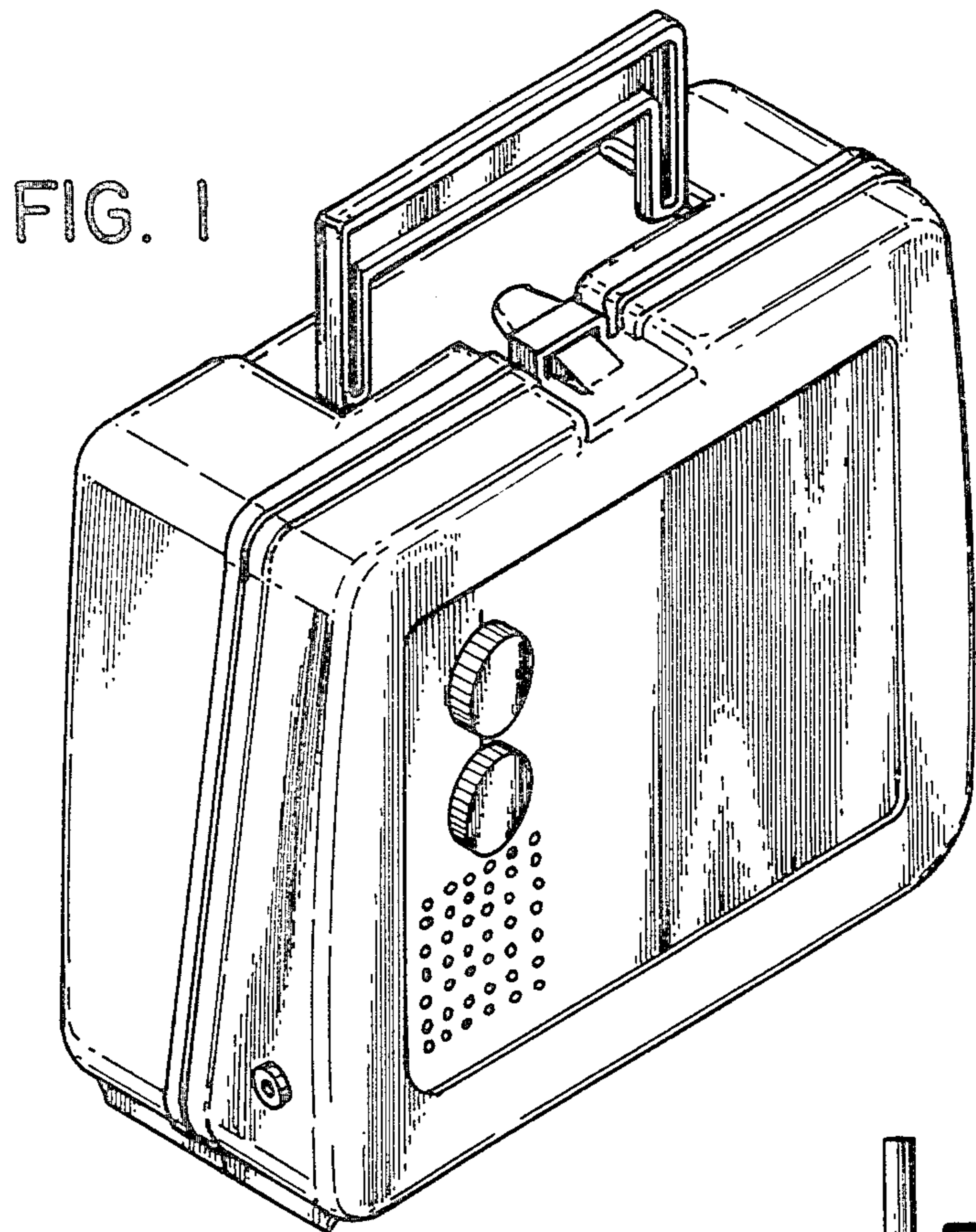
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined radio and lunchbox, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a combined radio and lunchbox showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of our new design; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a radio showing our new design; FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of a third embodiment showing our new design; and FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the second embodiment thereof.





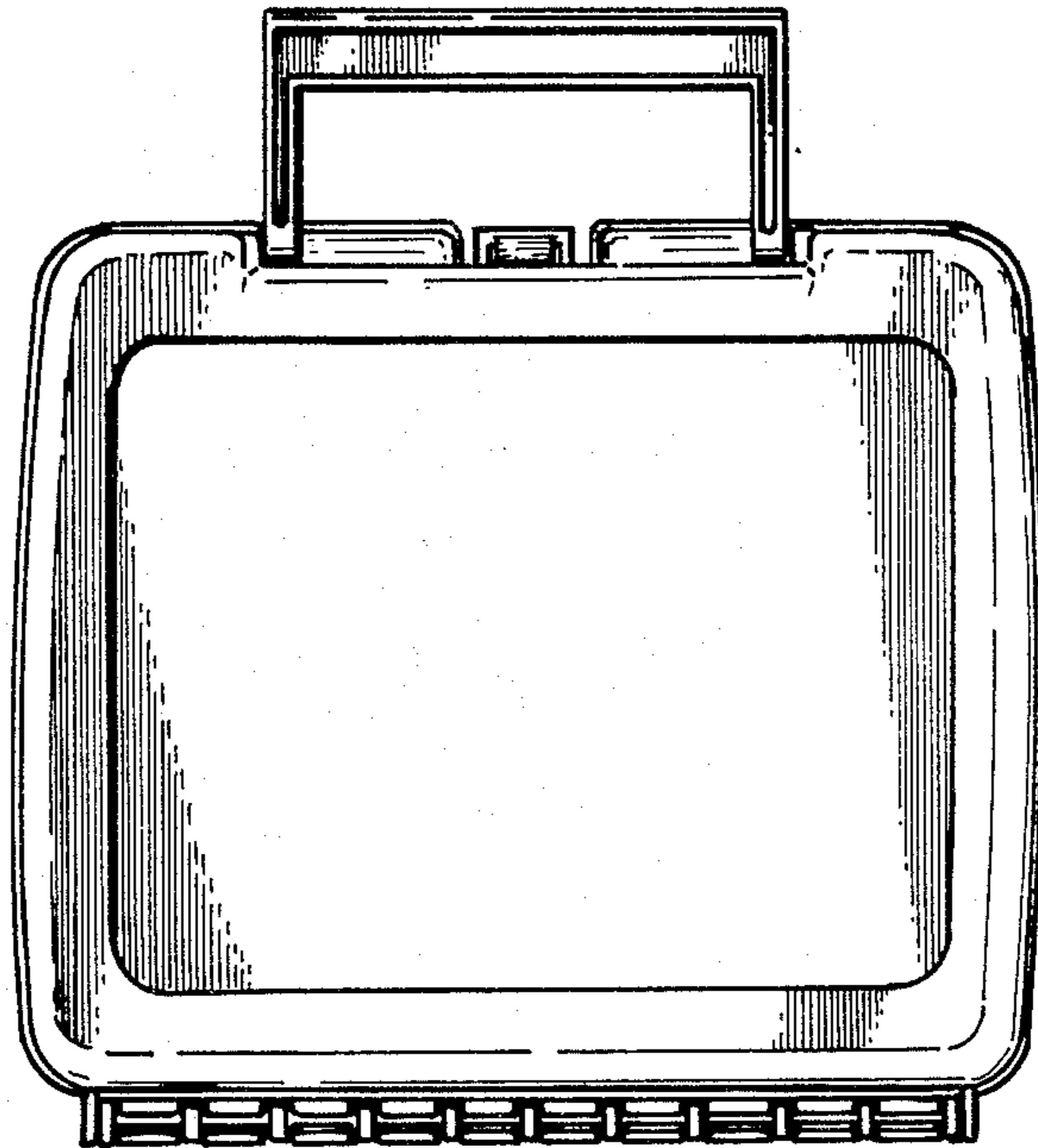

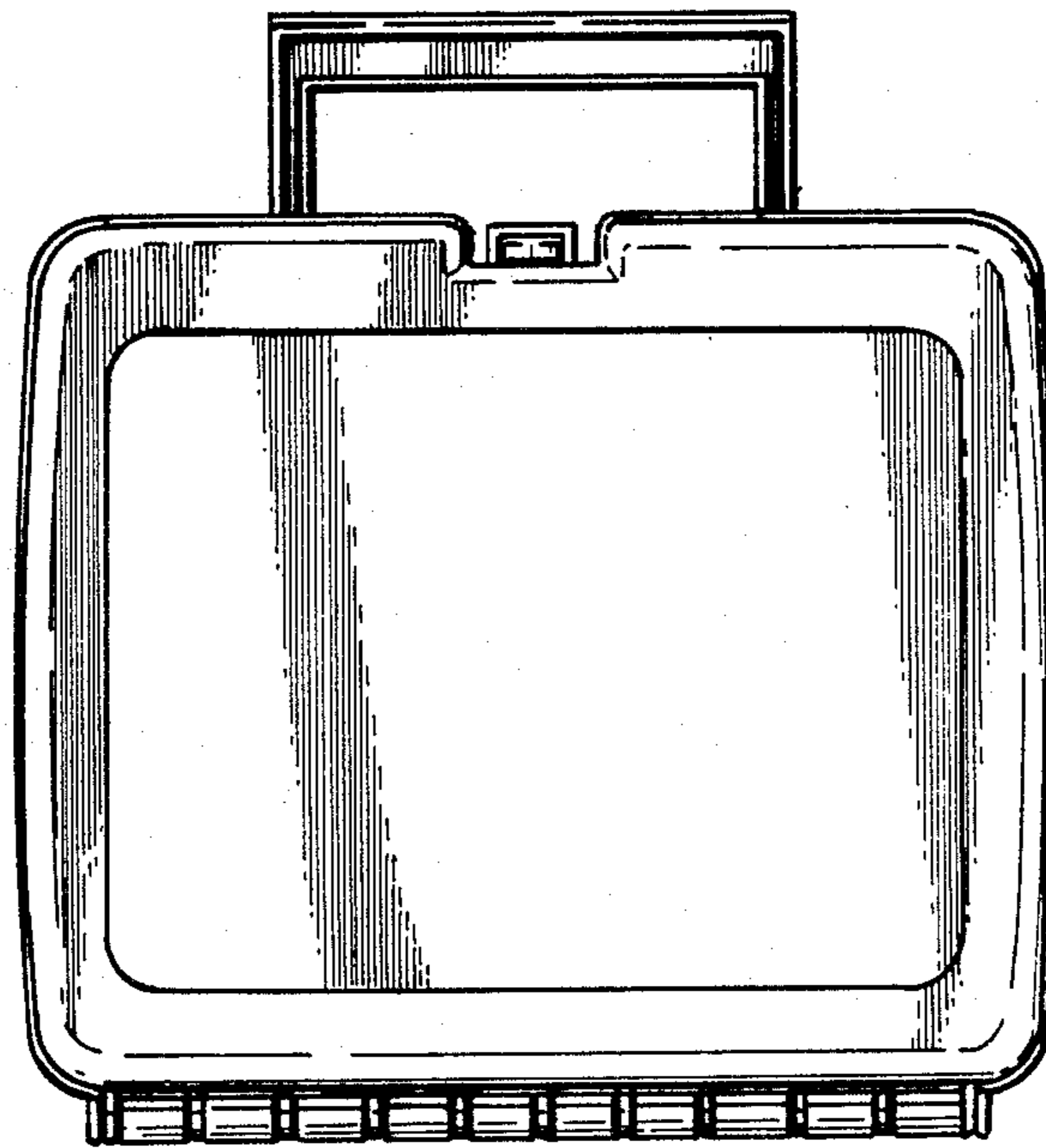

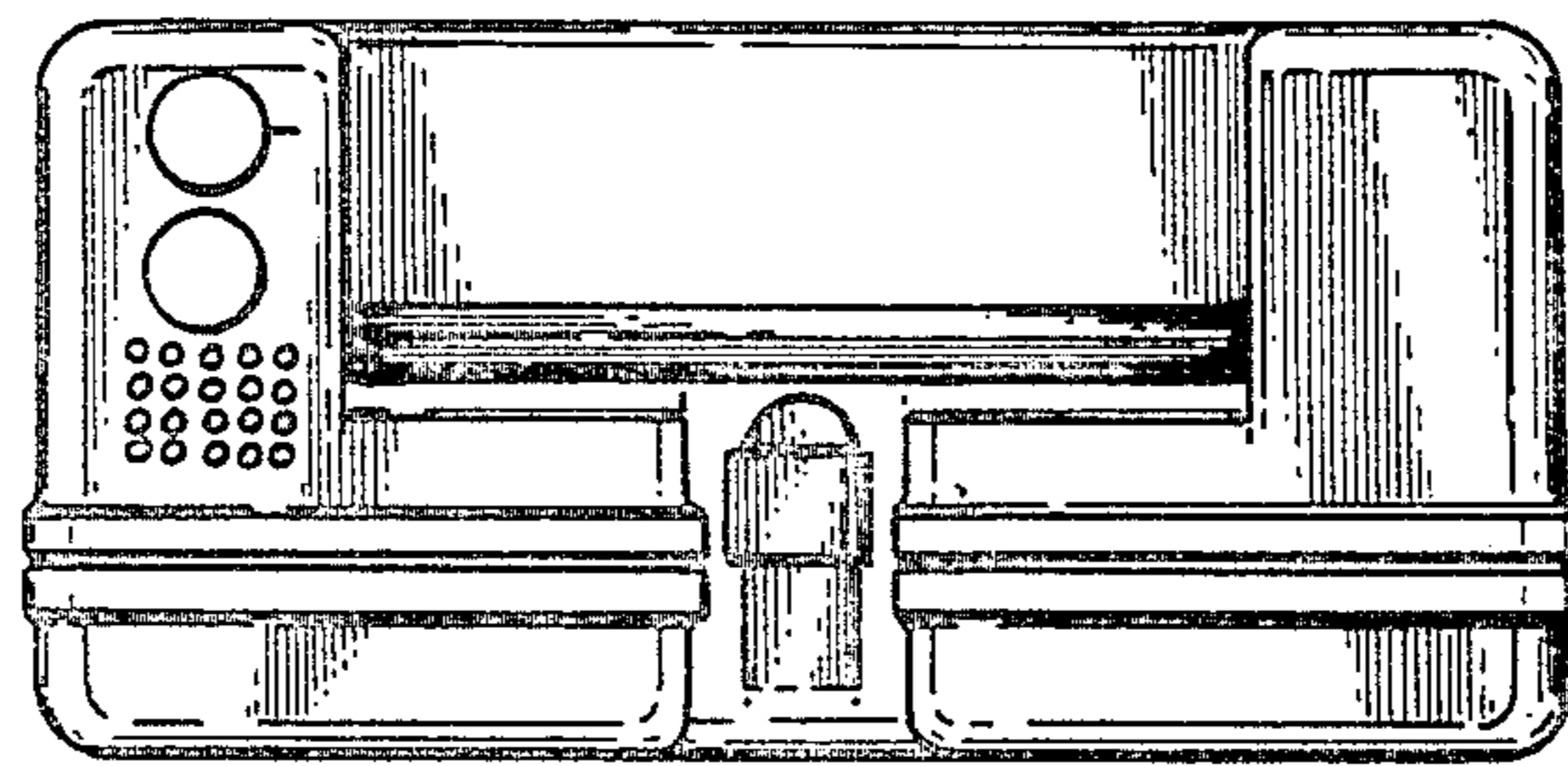

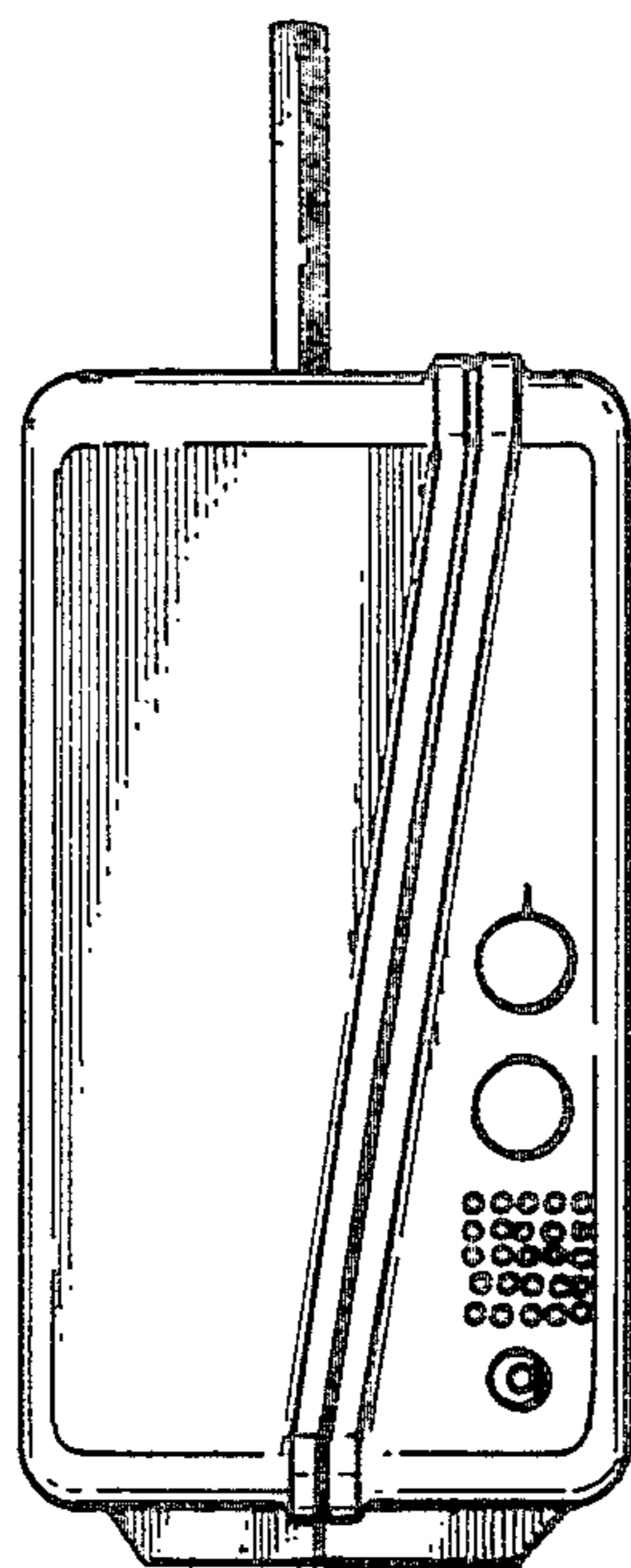

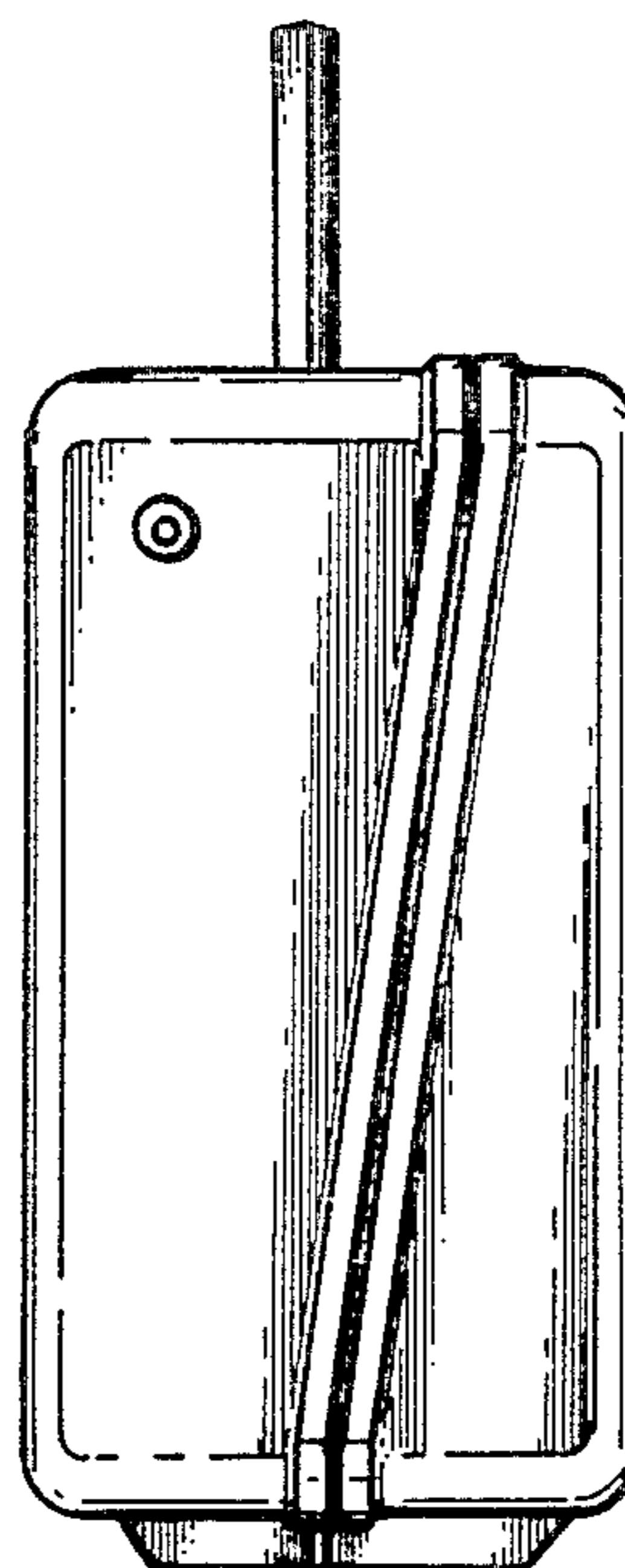
