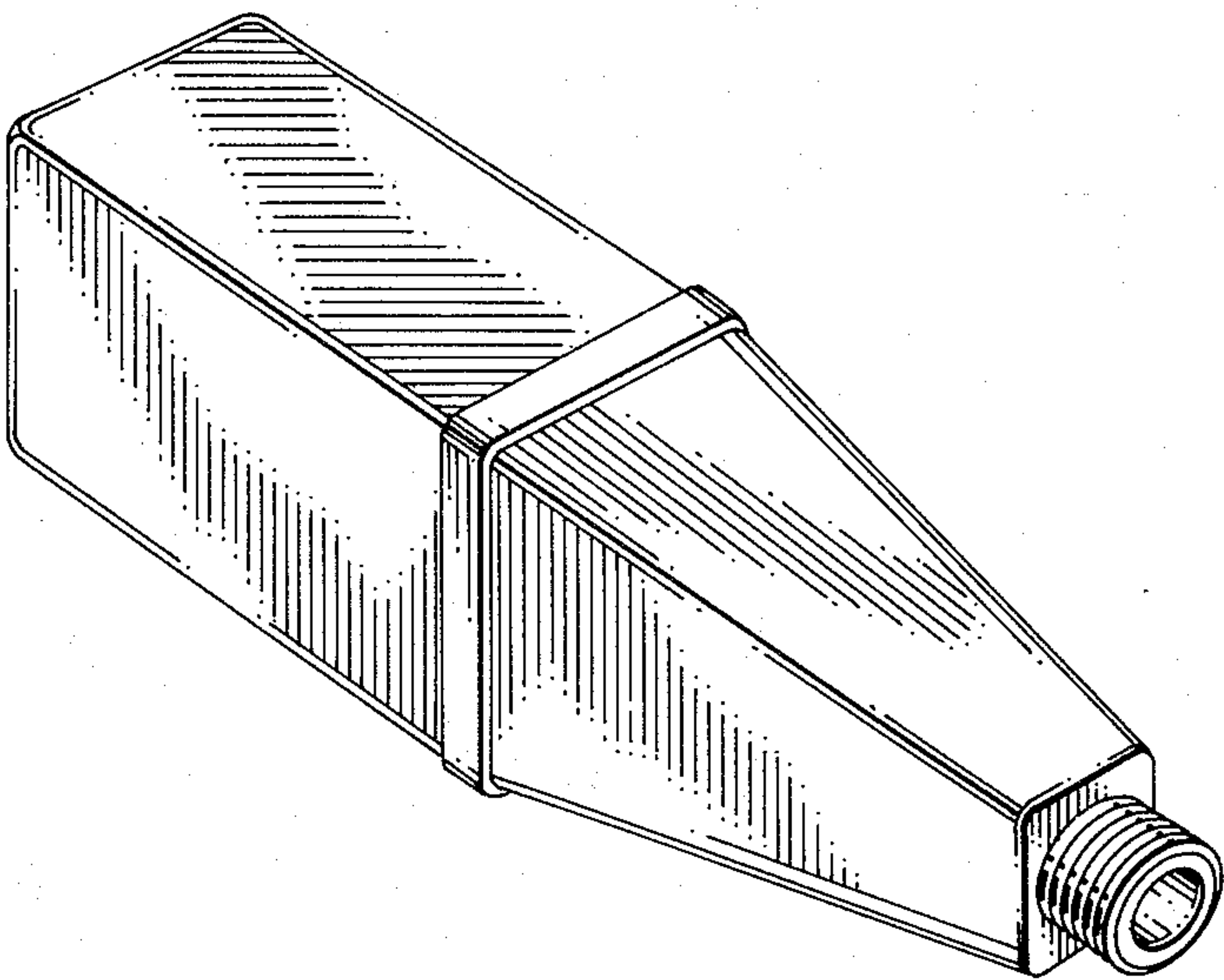

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a
microwave down converter showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being identical;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof, the top plan view
being identical; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



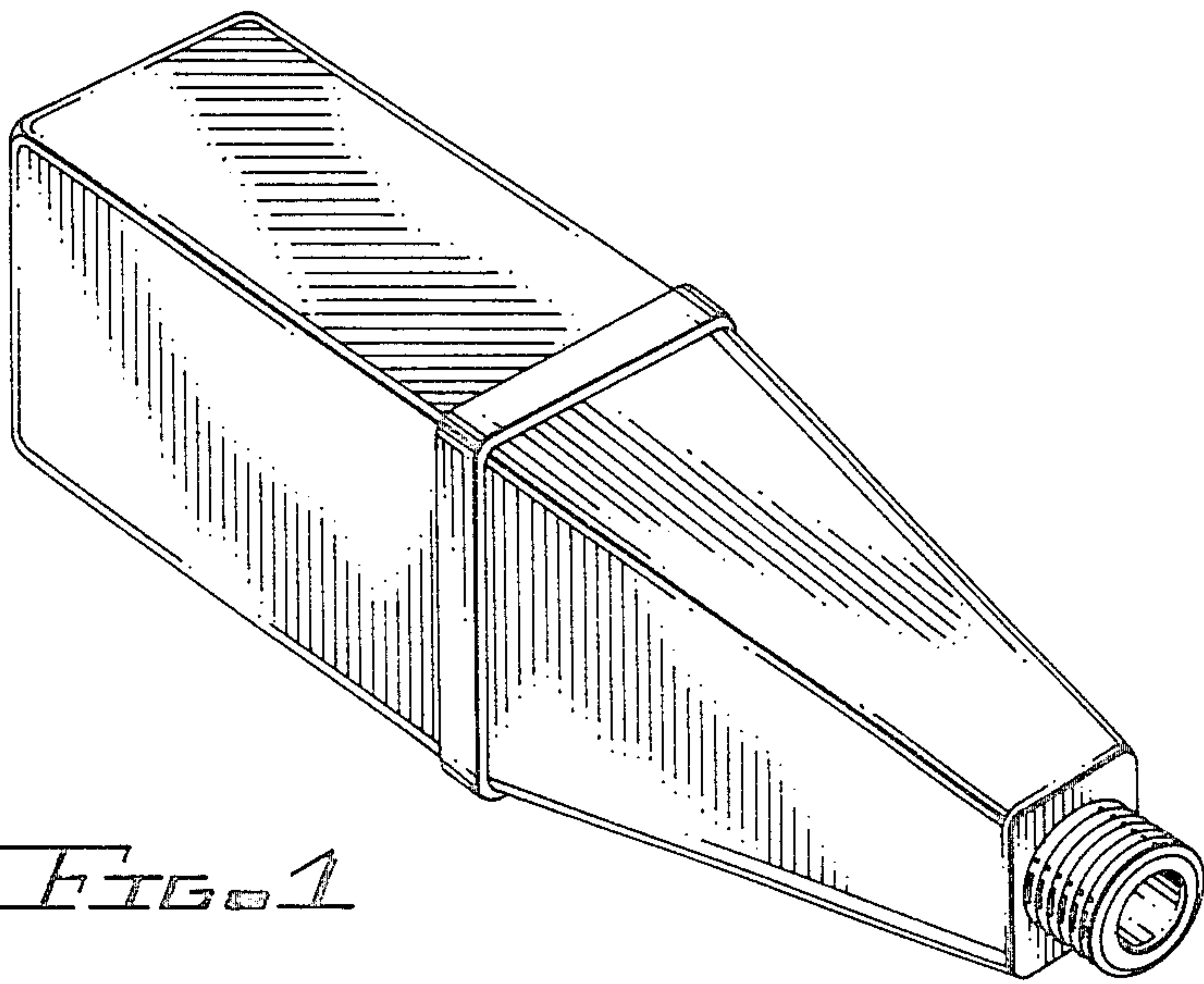

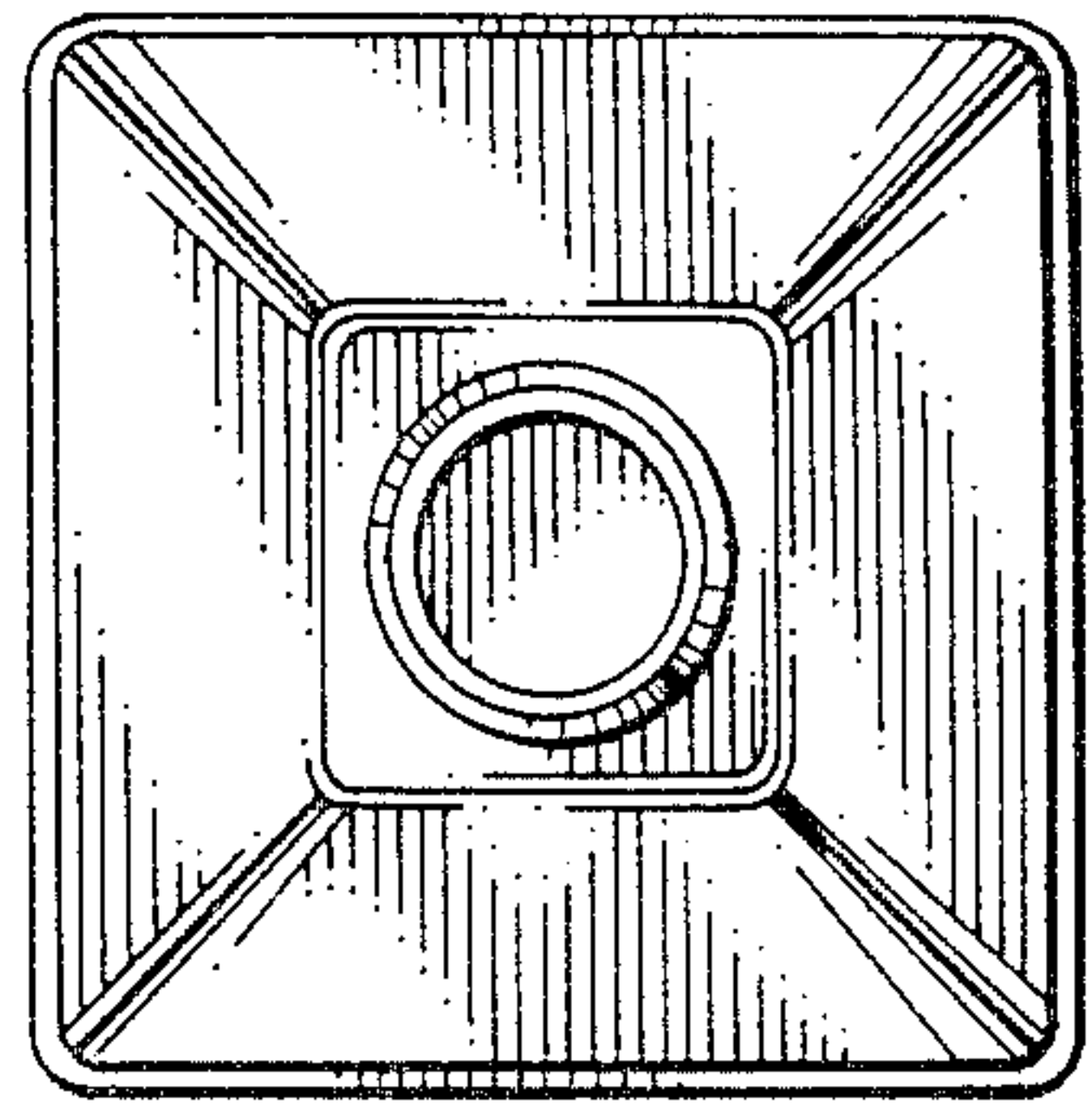

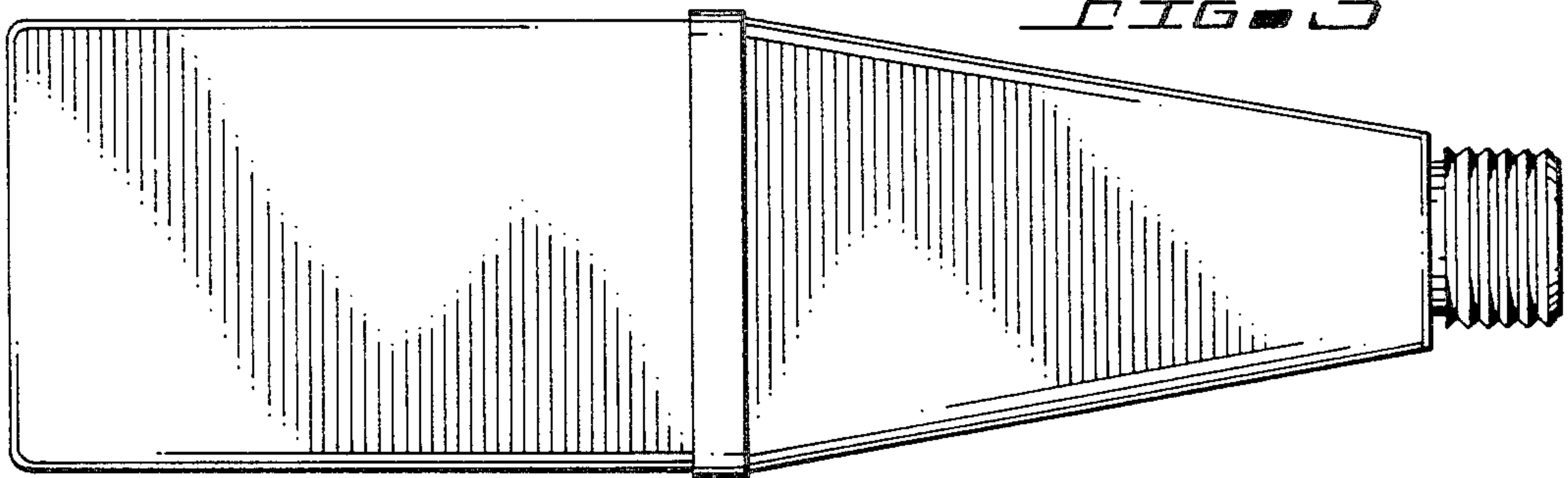

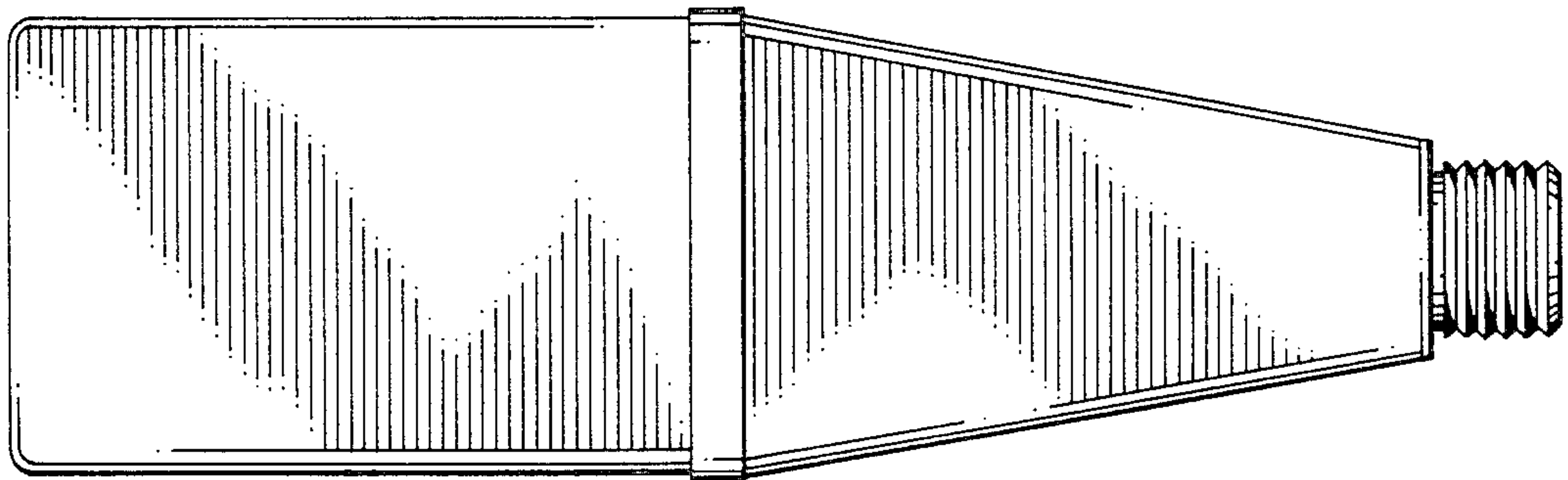

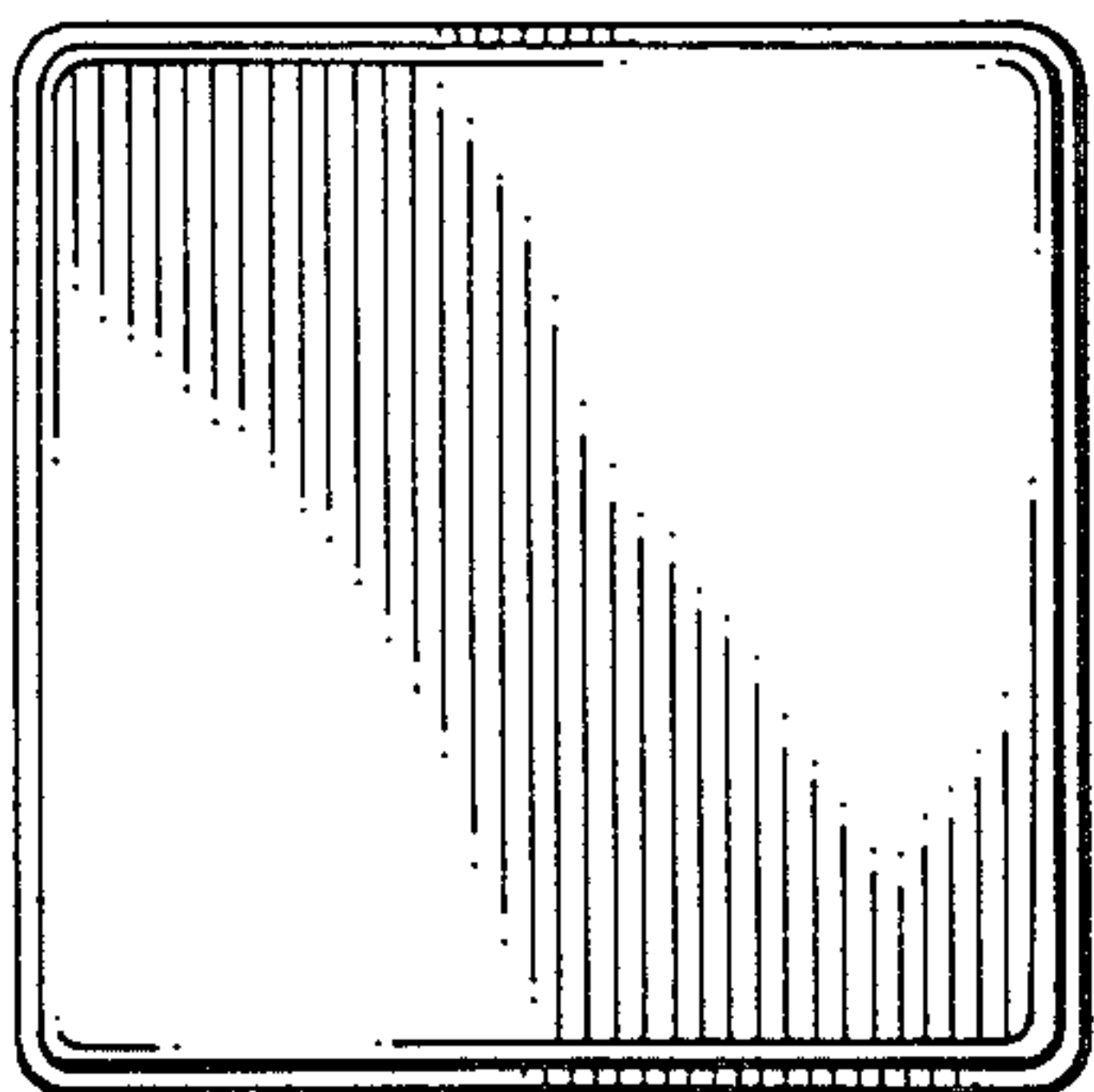
