[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle for surgical instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a handle embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an end view thereof, looking at the handle from right to left, as shown in FIG. 2; and

FIG. 4 is an end view thereof, looking at the handle from left to right, as shown in FIG. 2.

The broken line showing of the instrument's tip is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
