FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.

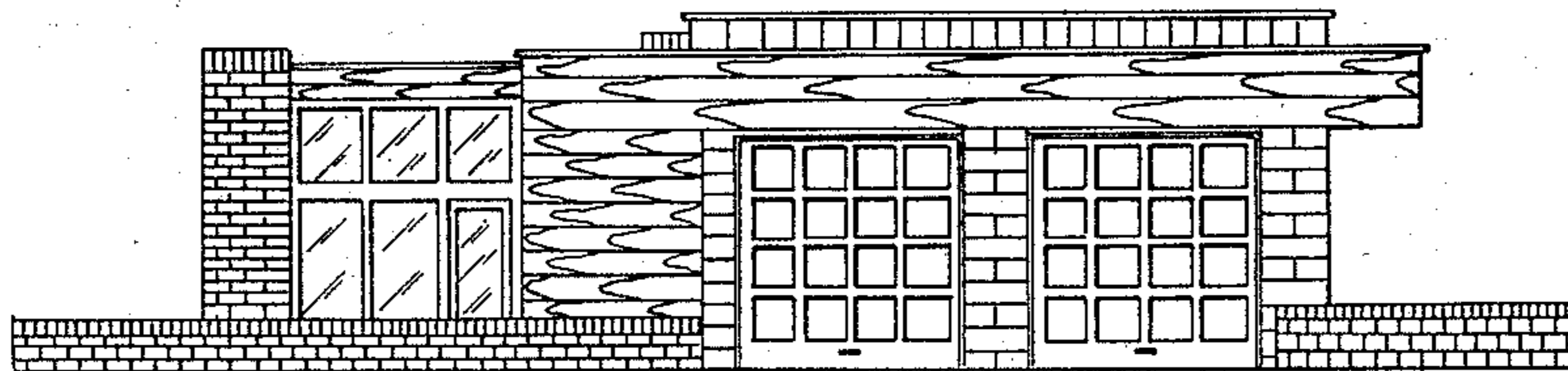

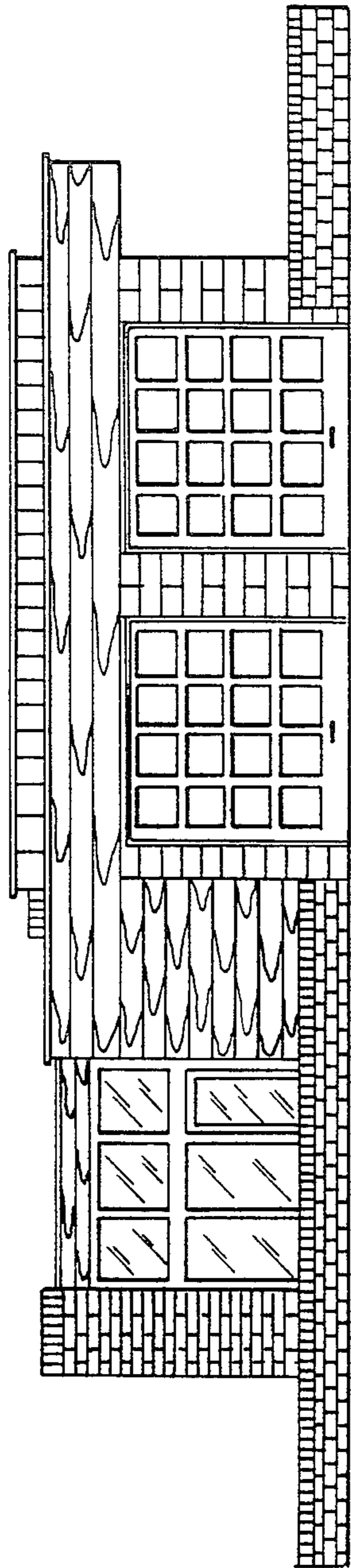

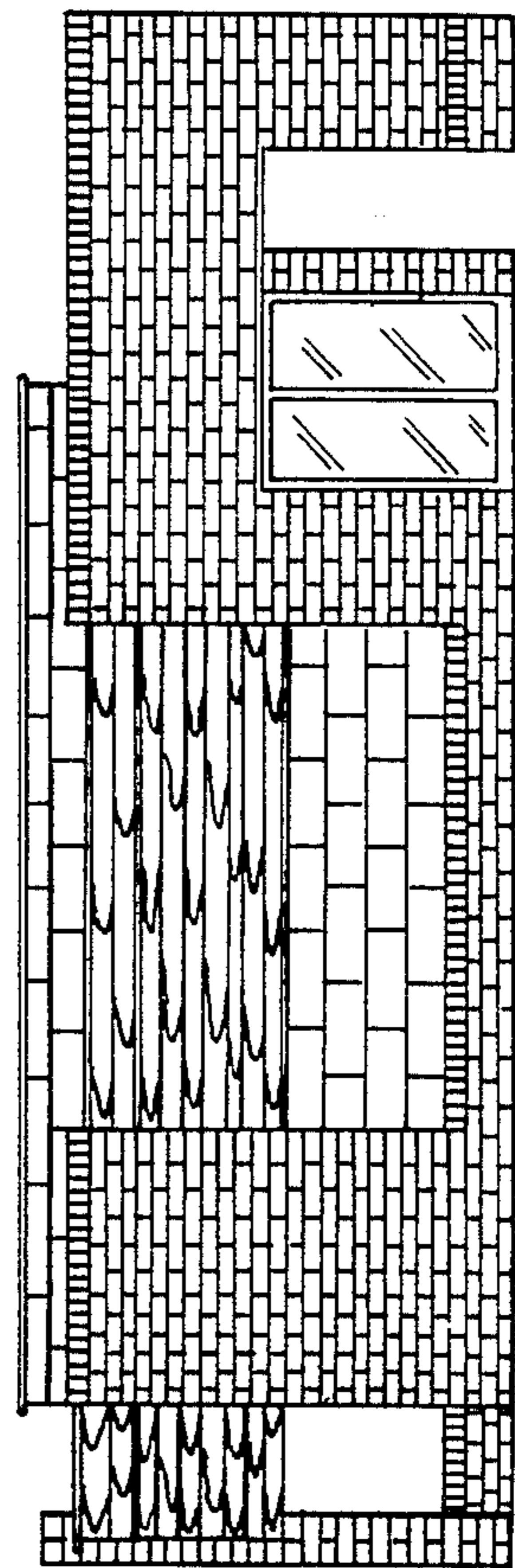

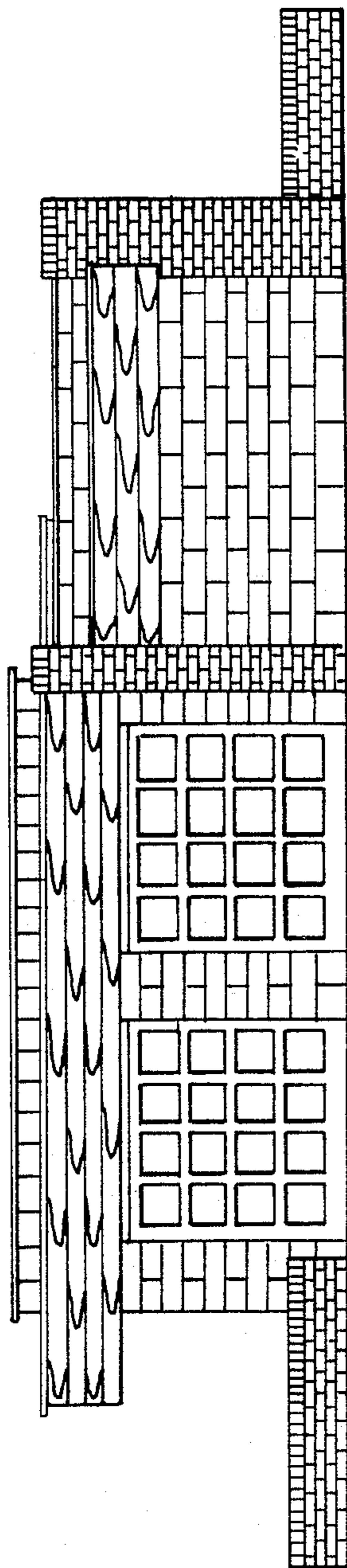
