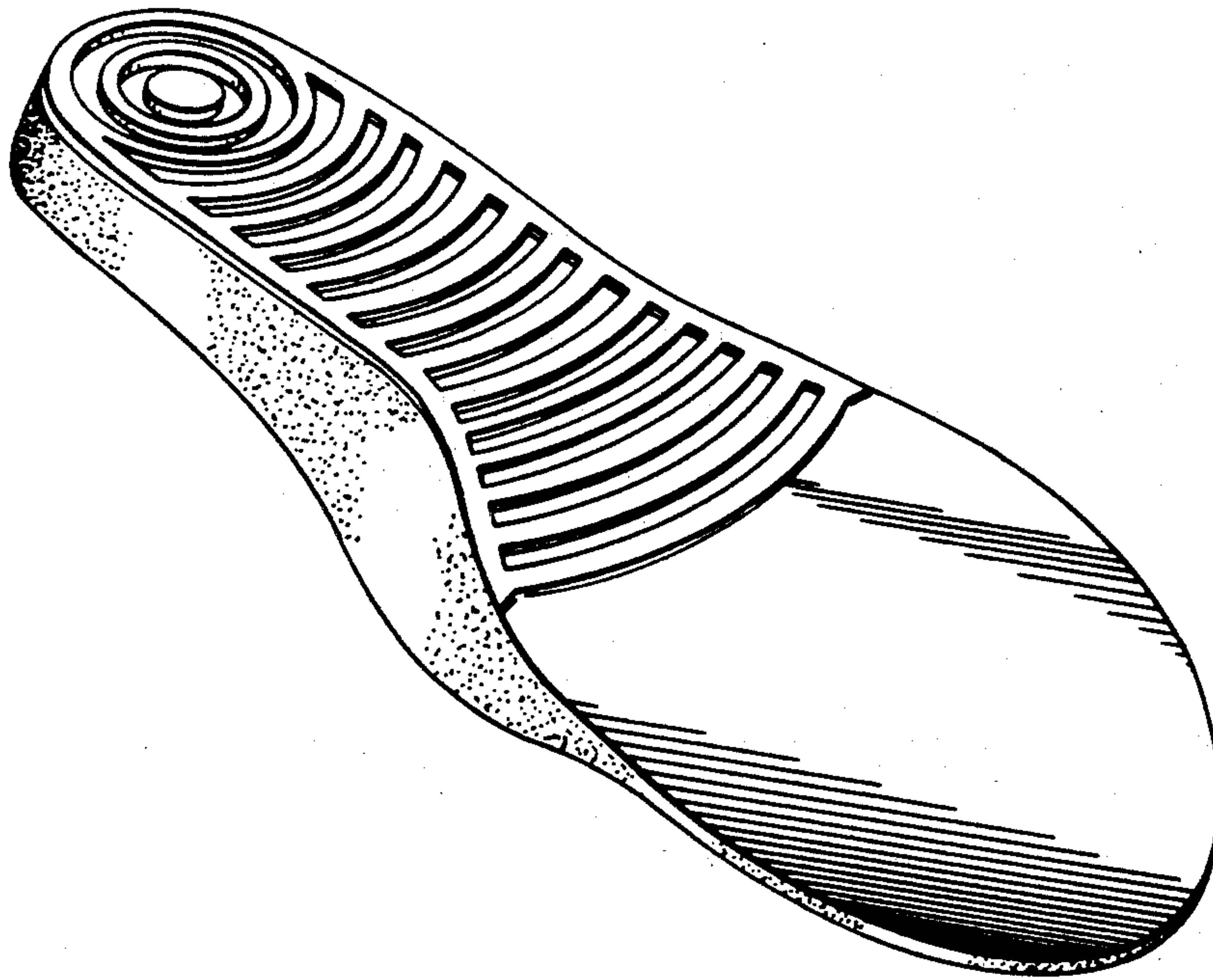

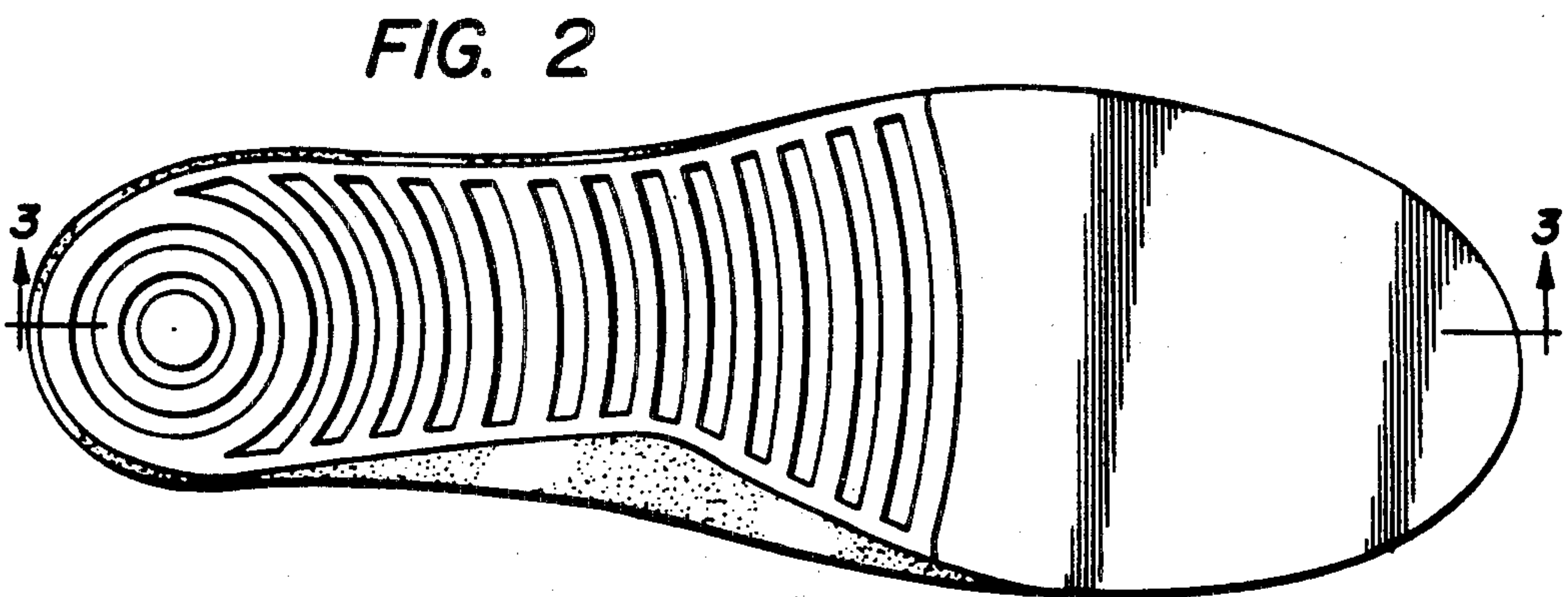
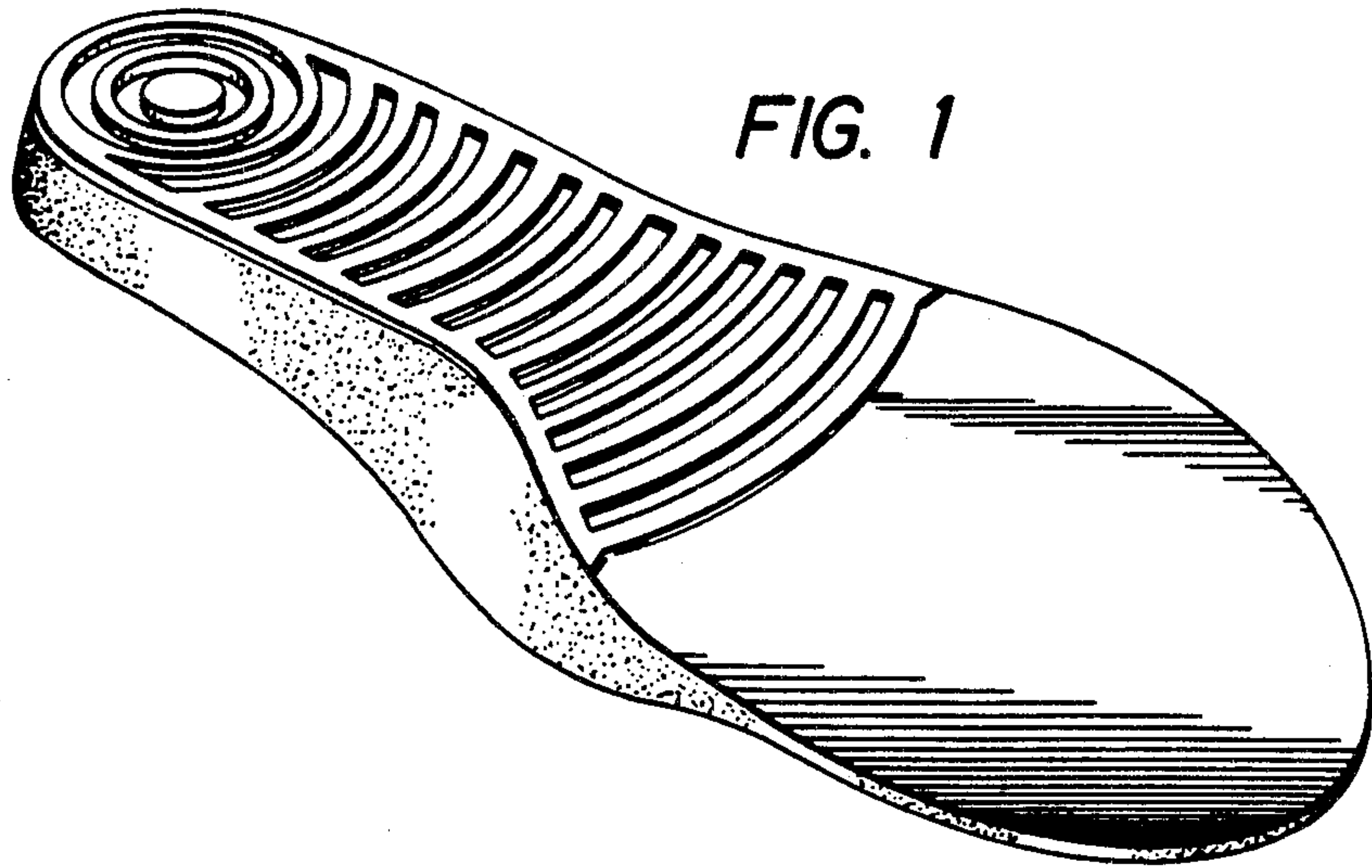

 FIG. 4 is a top and left front perspective view thereof.





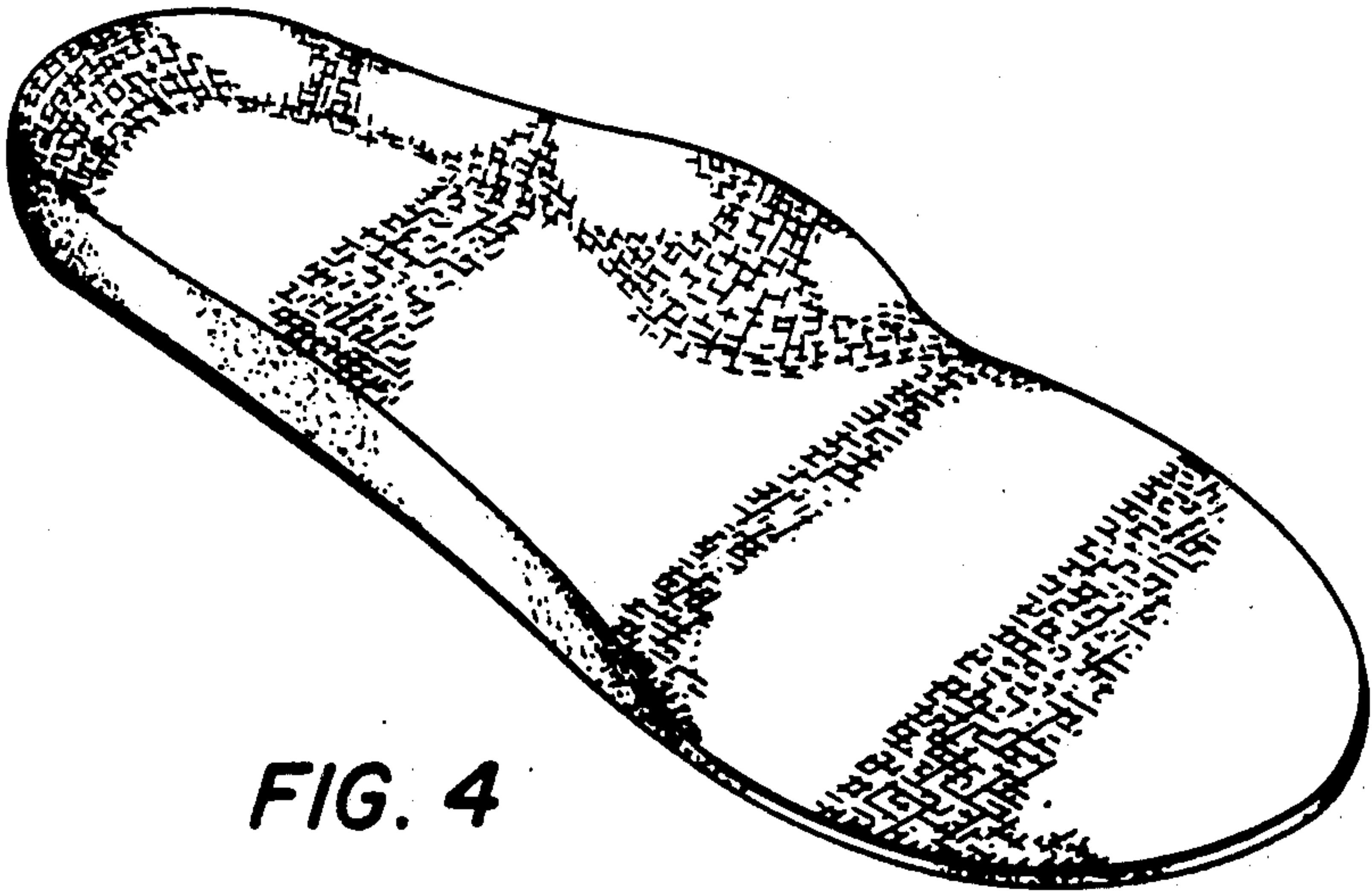
