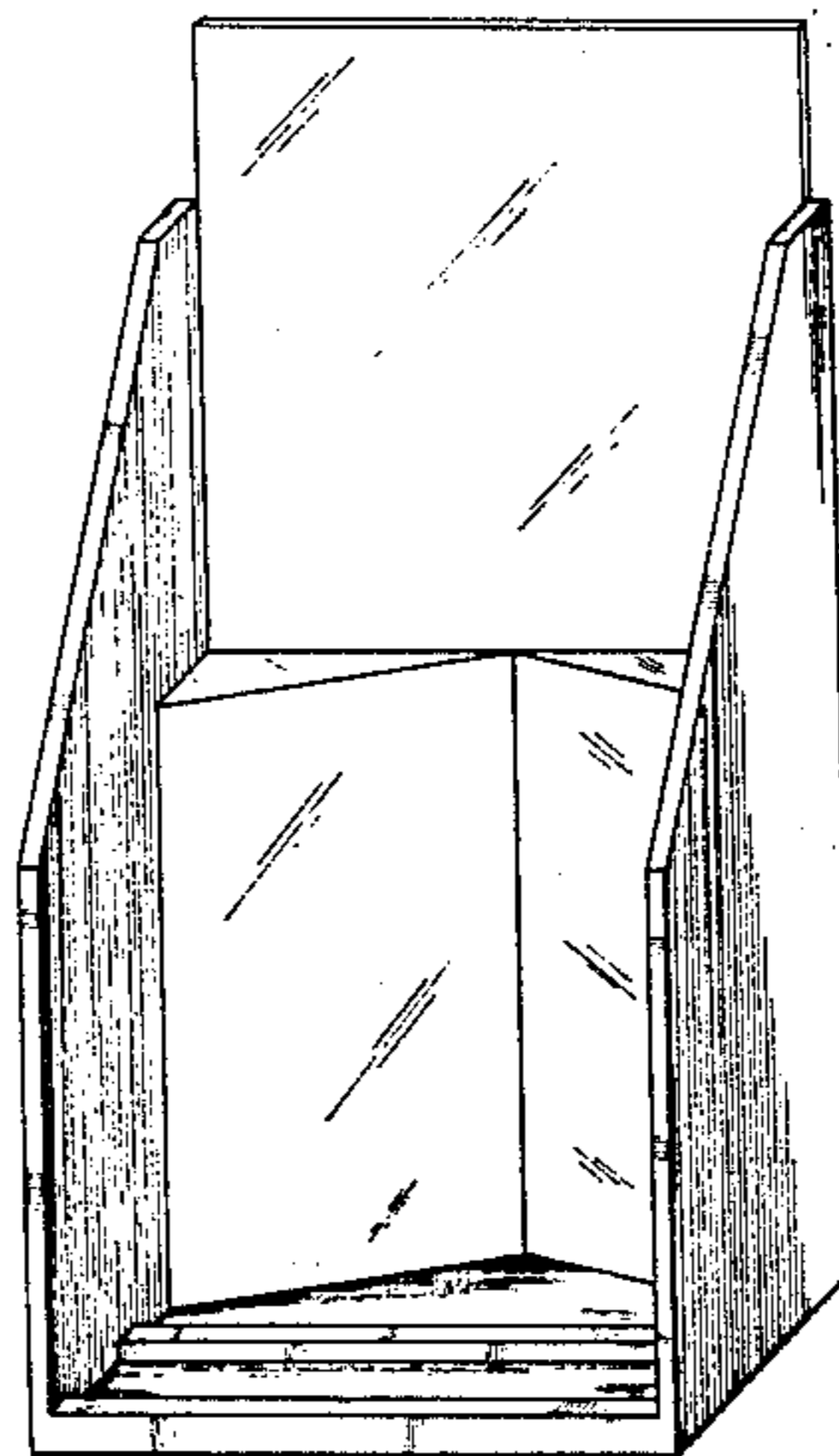

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a mirror assembly, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view;
FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view.
The appearance of the right side is a mirror image of that shown in FIG. 6.



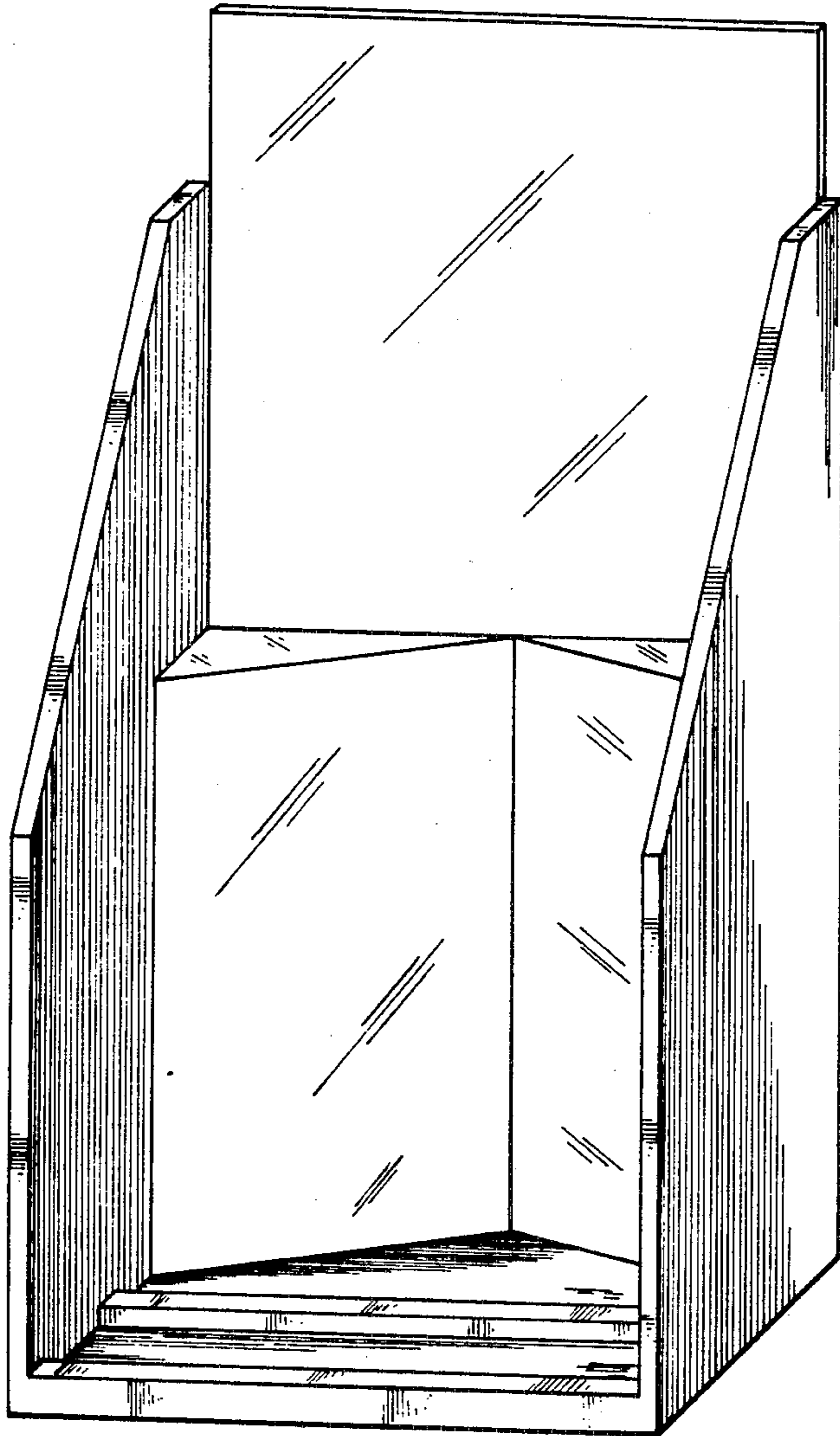

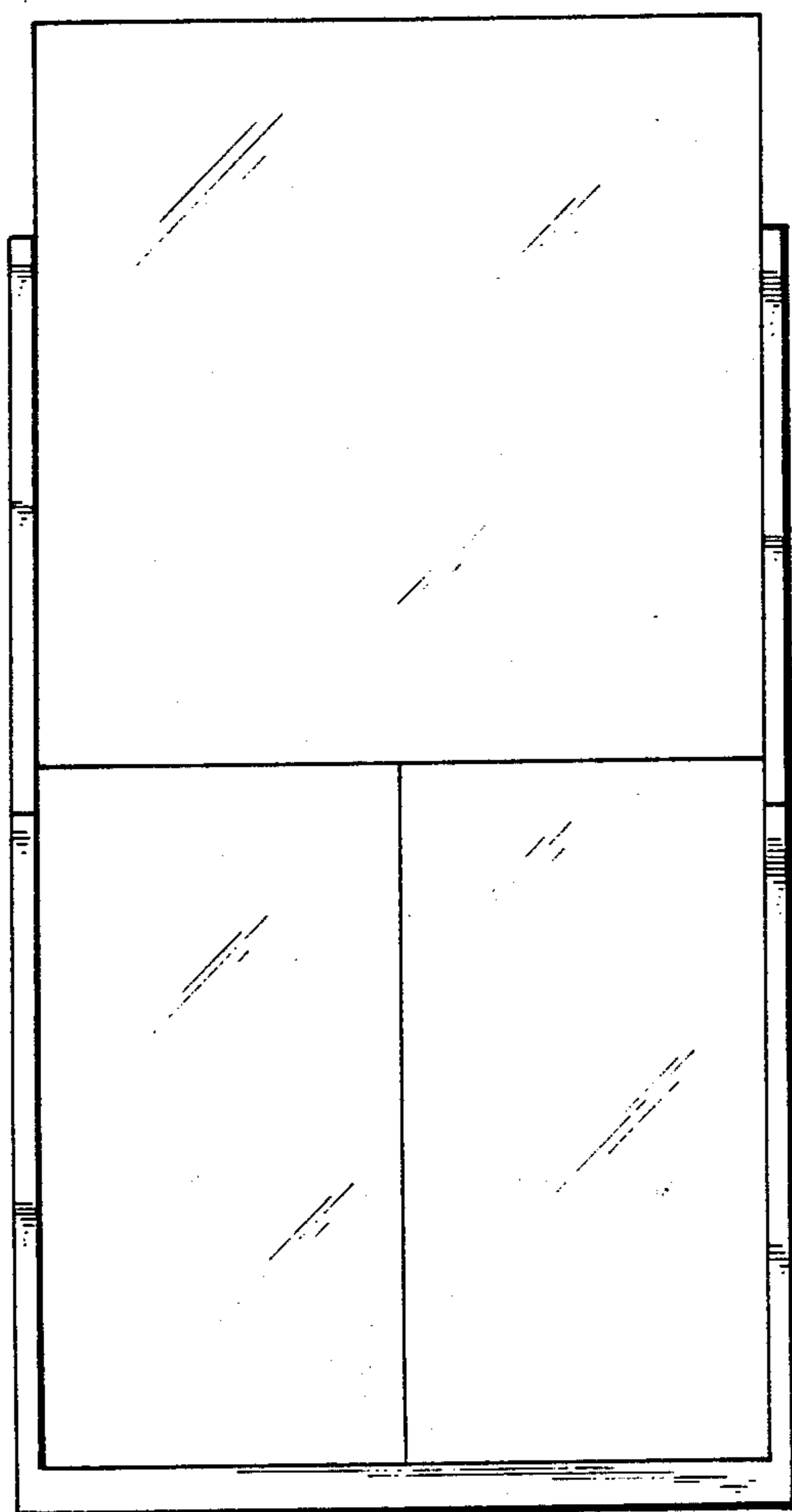

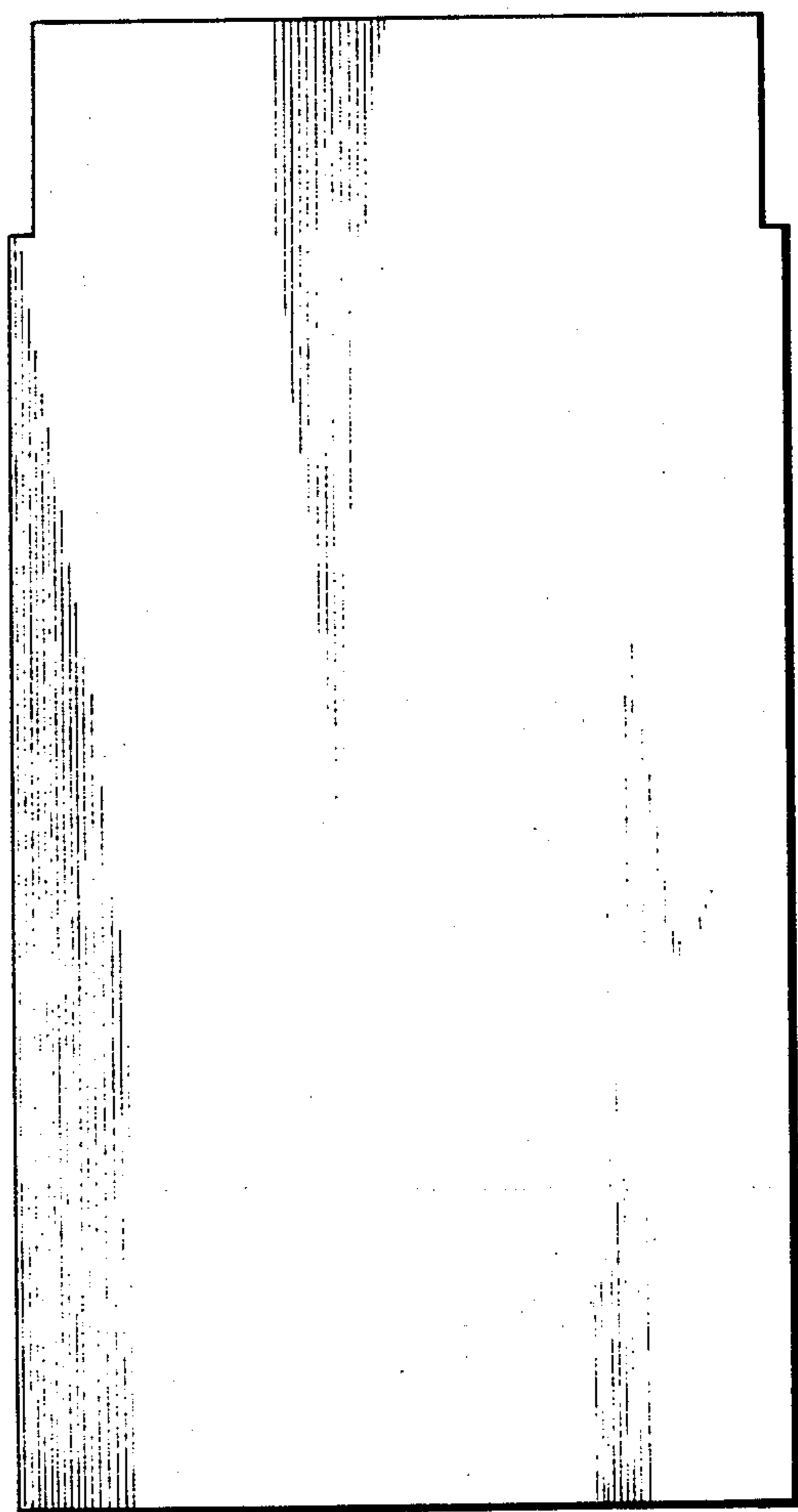

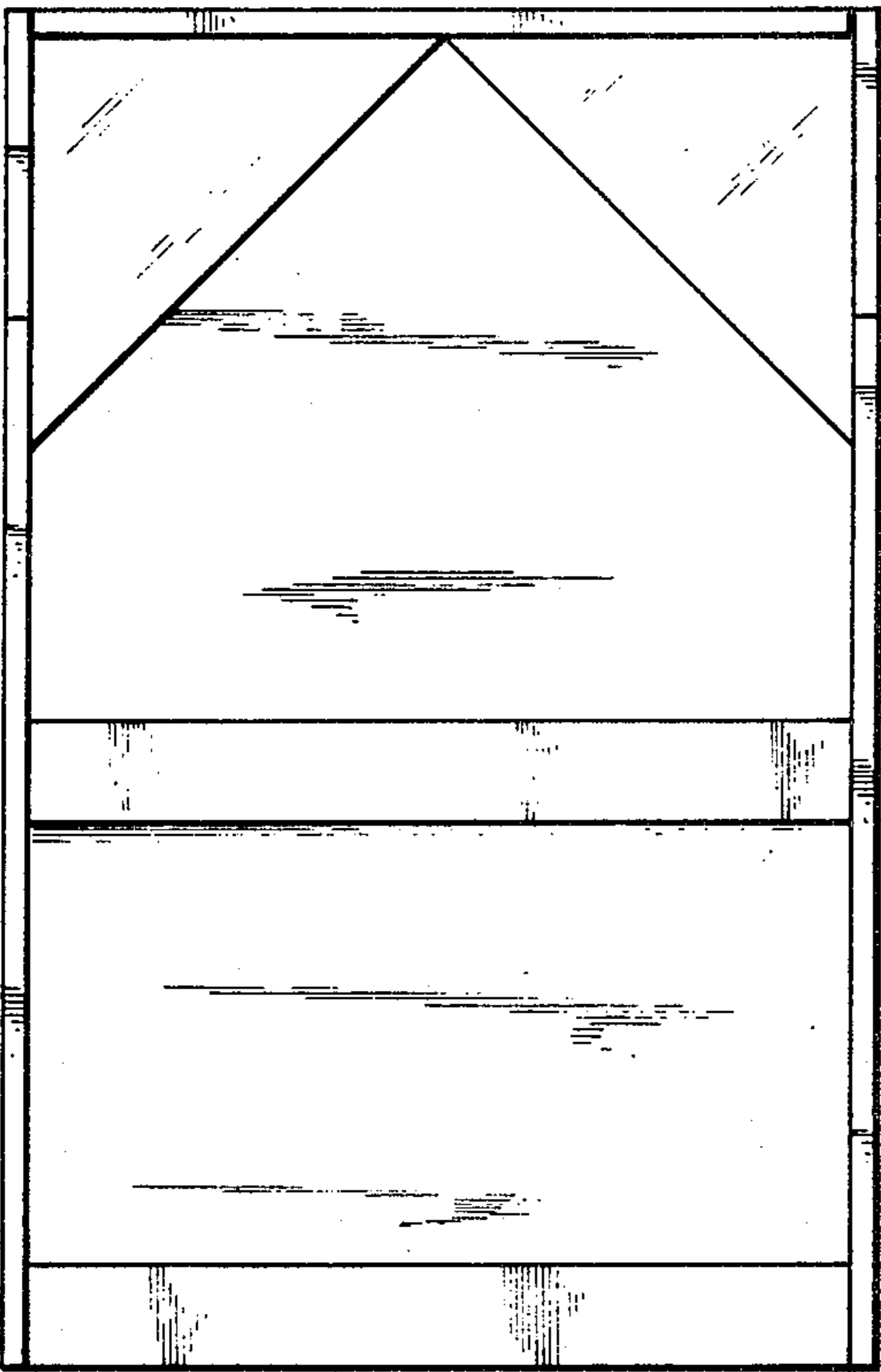

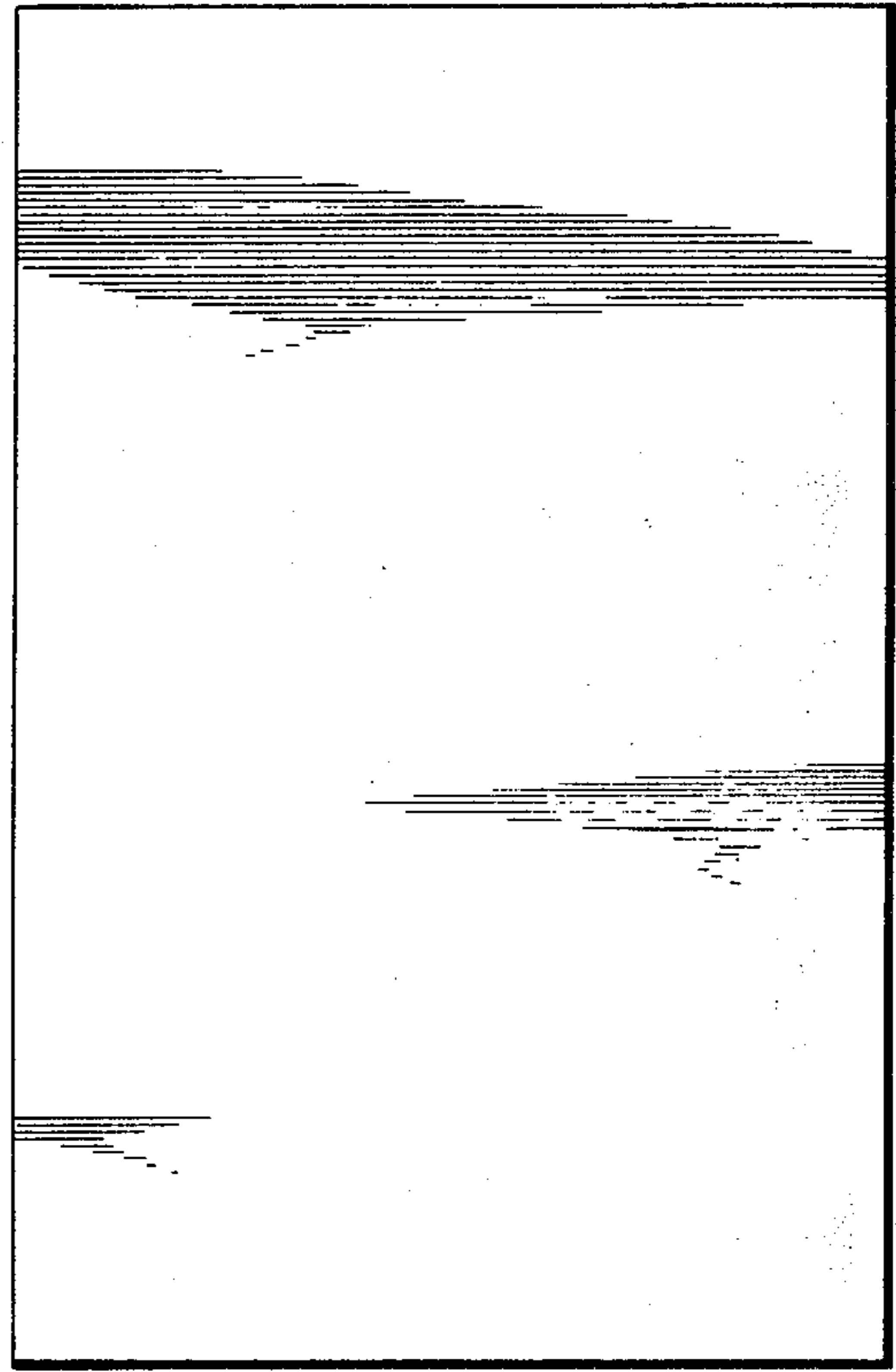

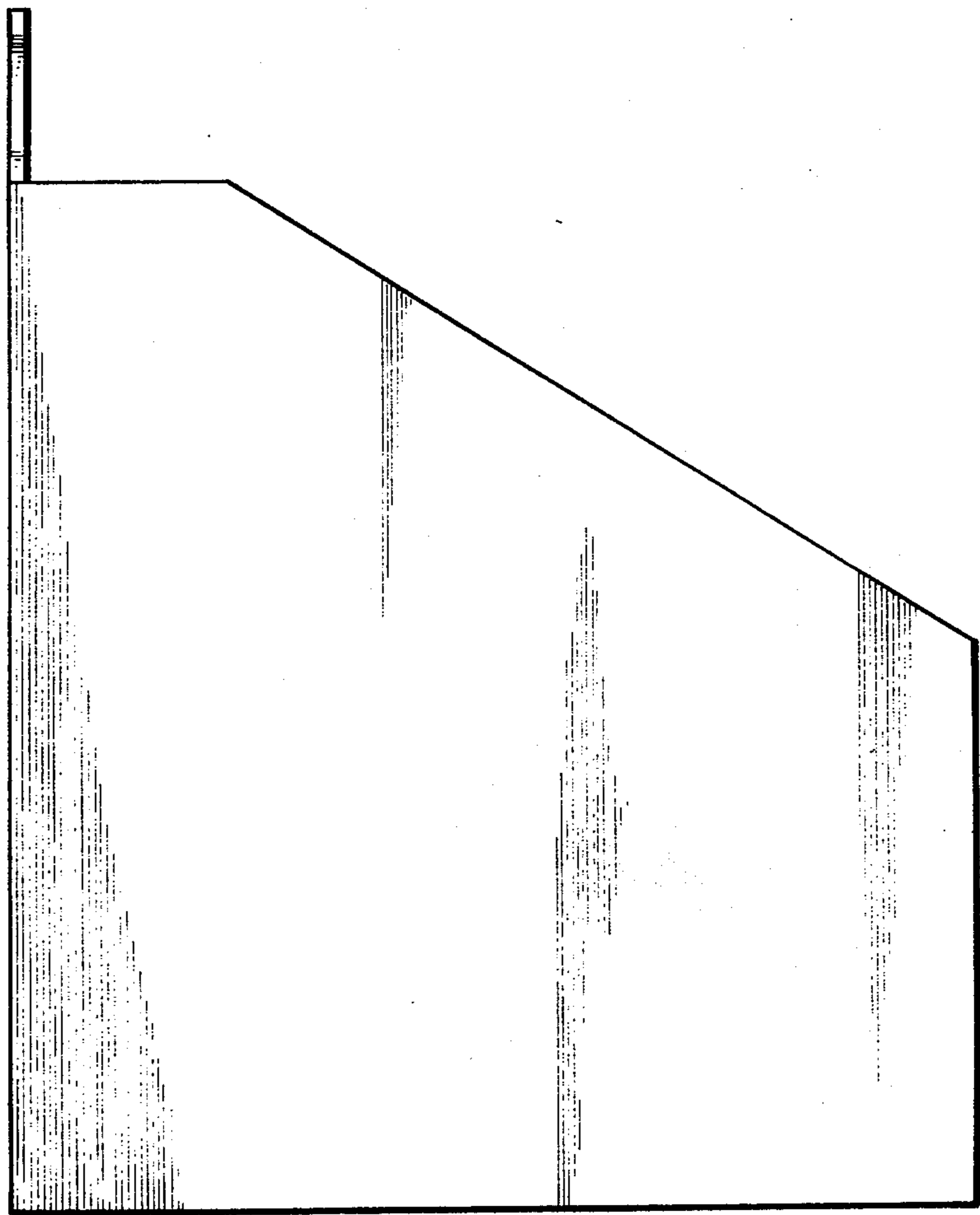
