DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a parasol, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment, wherein the canopy has an oval shape;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown on FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown on FIG. 2.

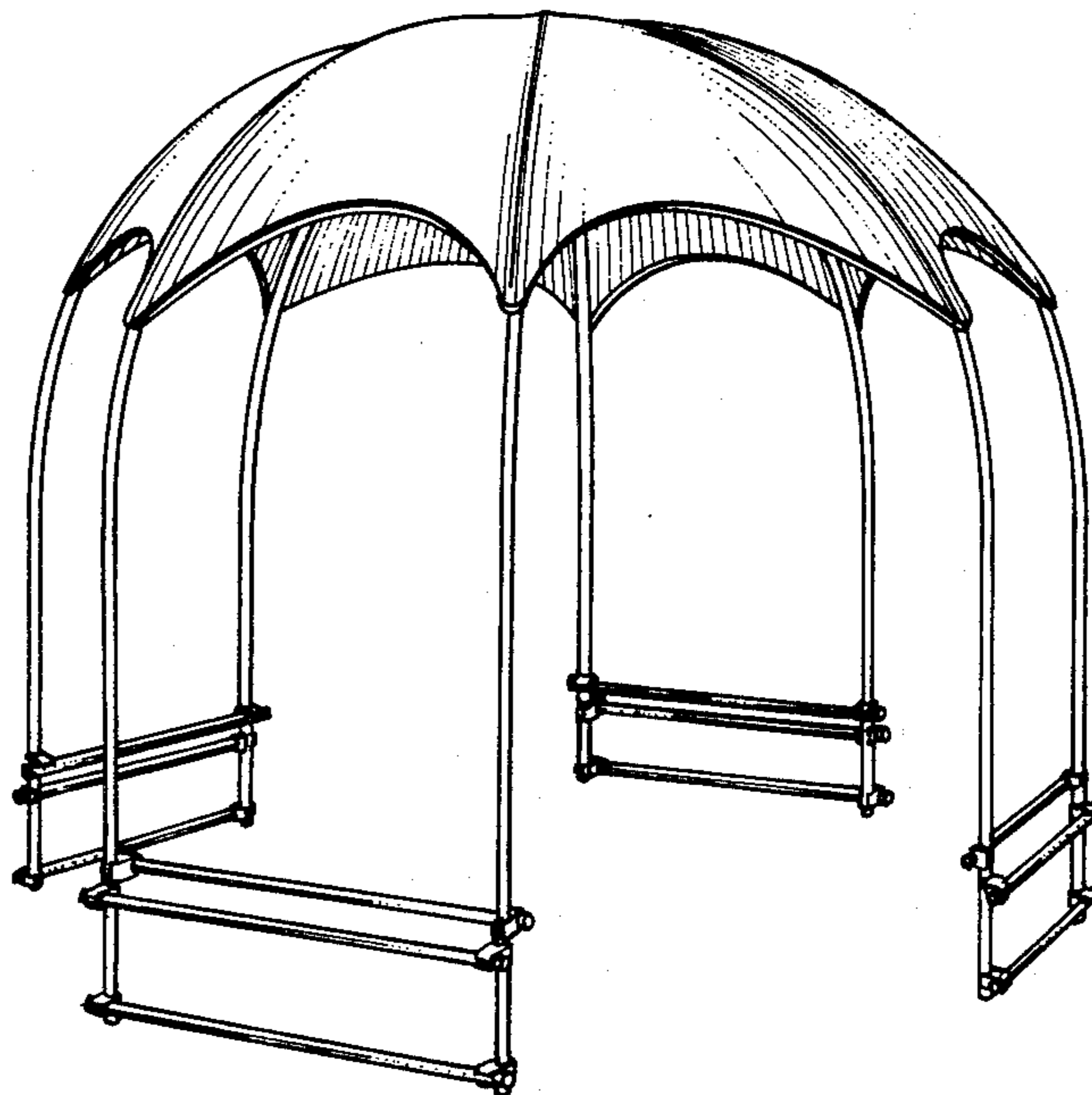

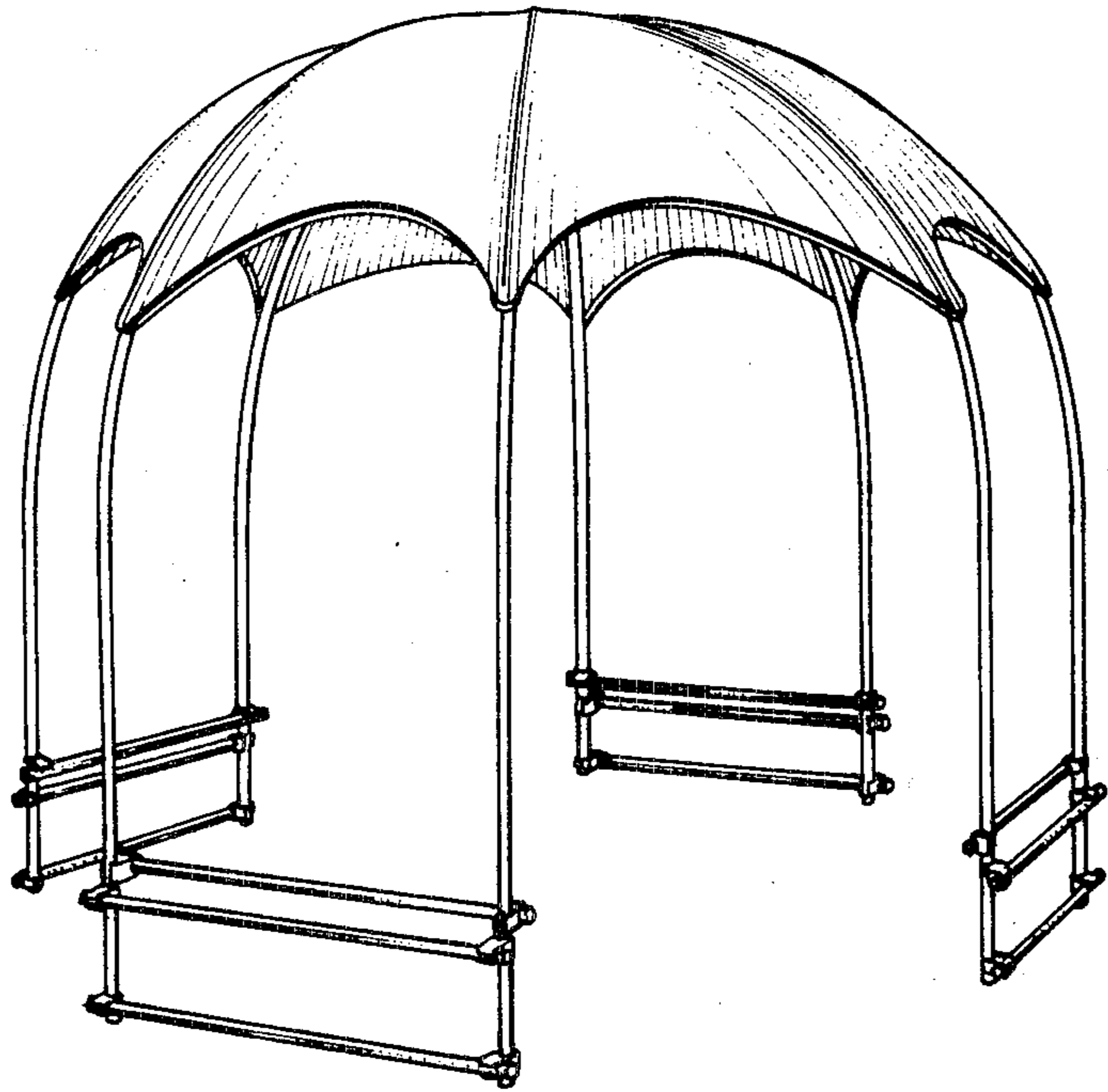

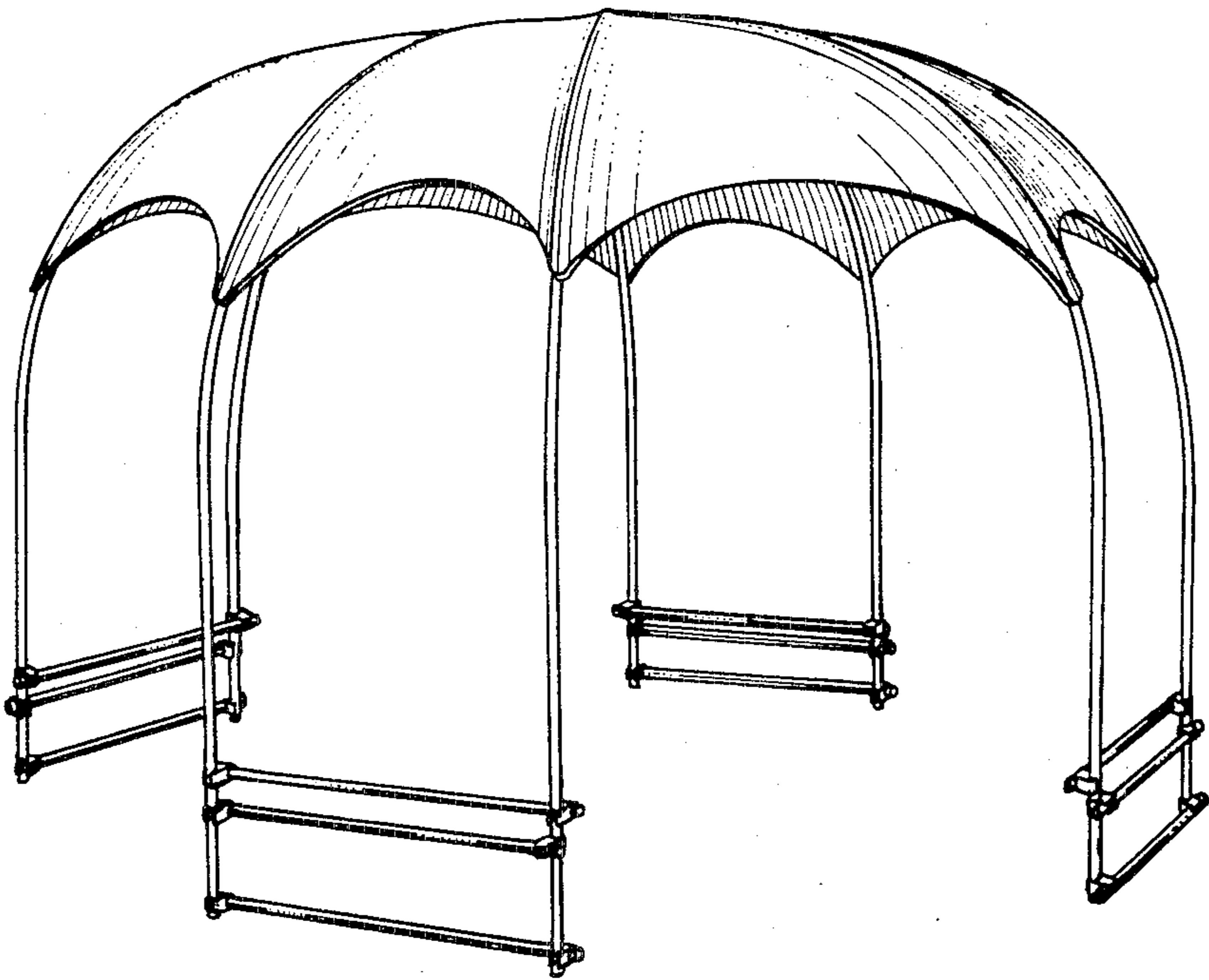

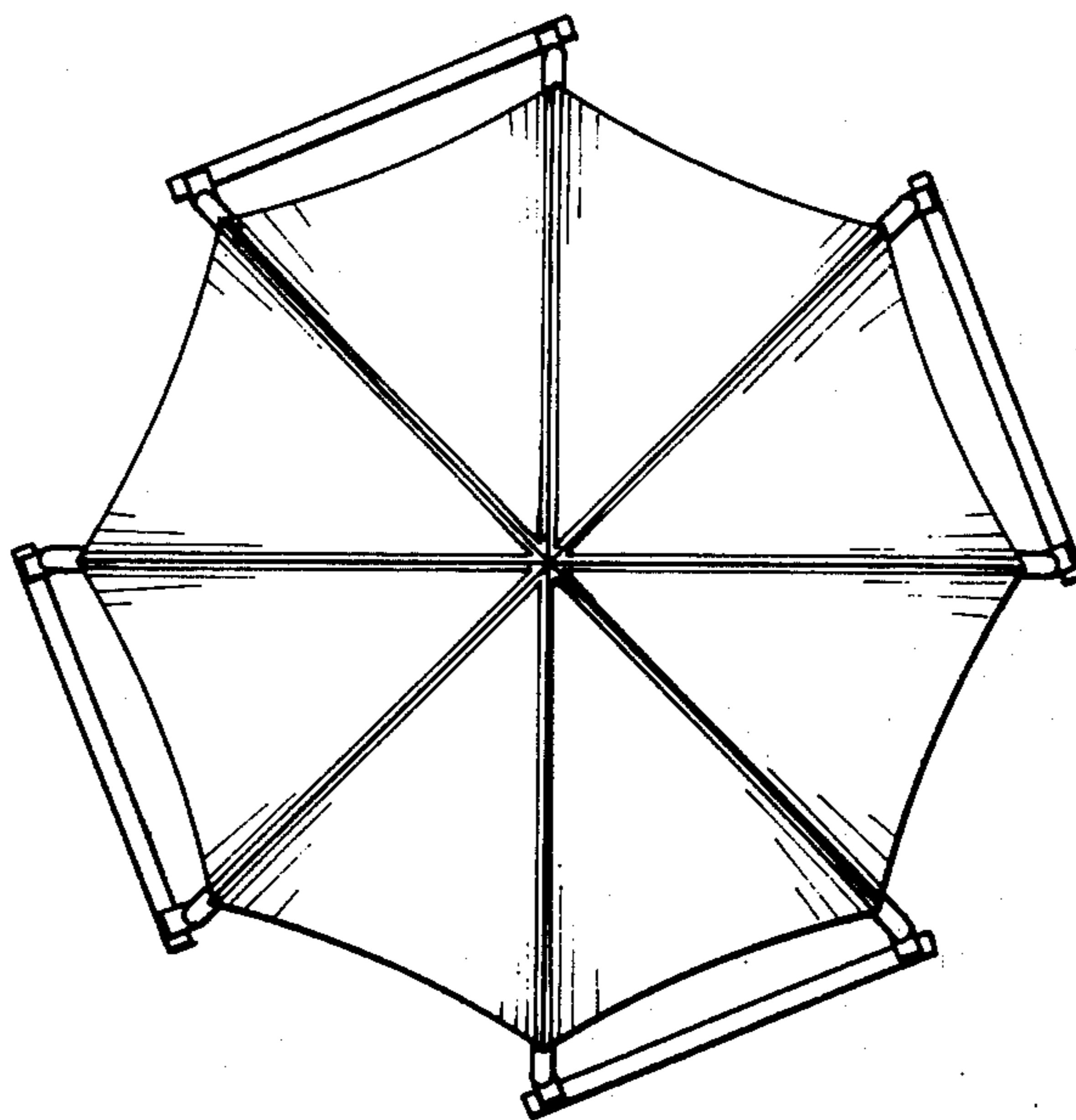
