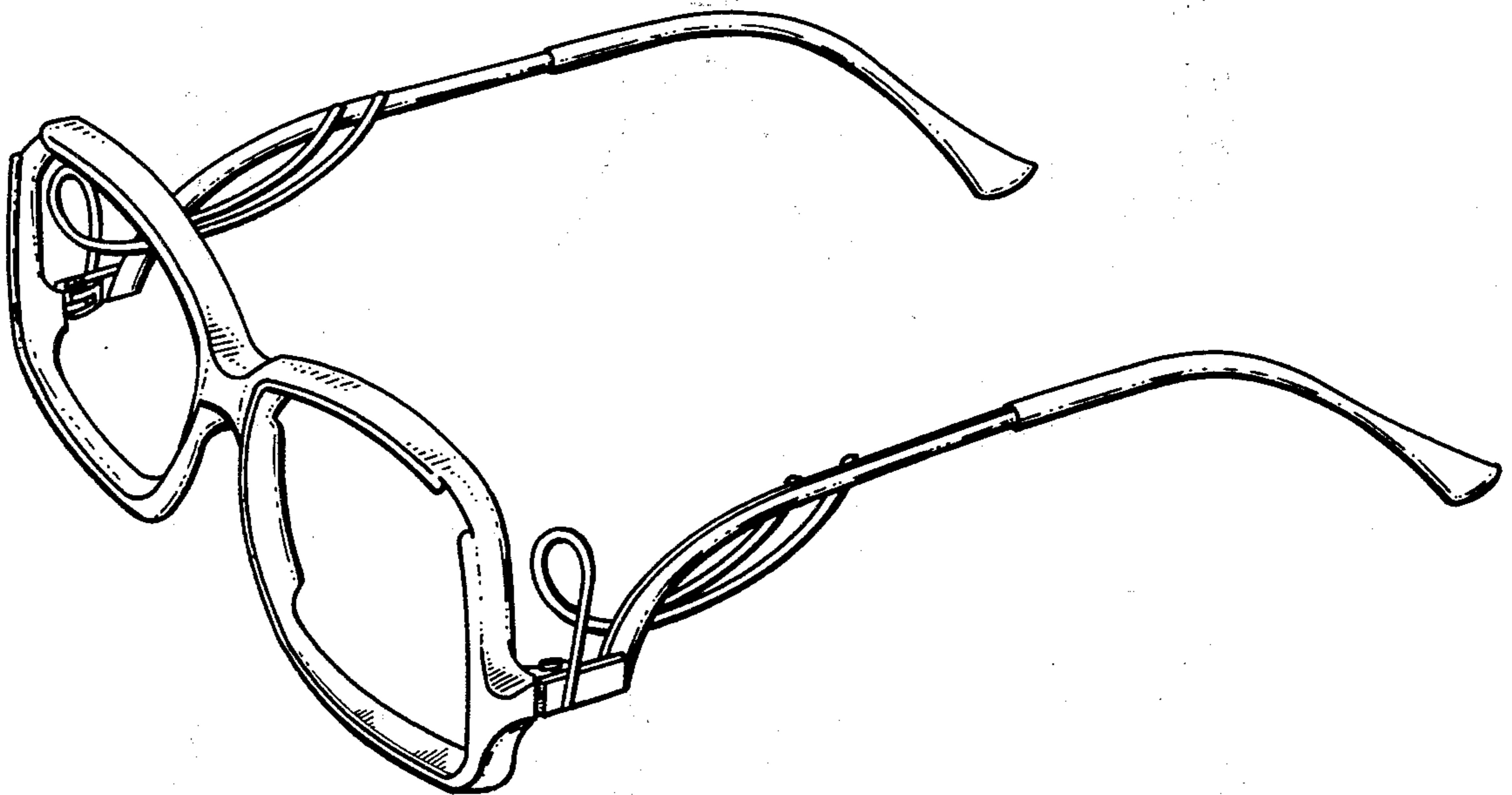

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an eyeglass frame, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking from the top of an eyeglass frame, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image.



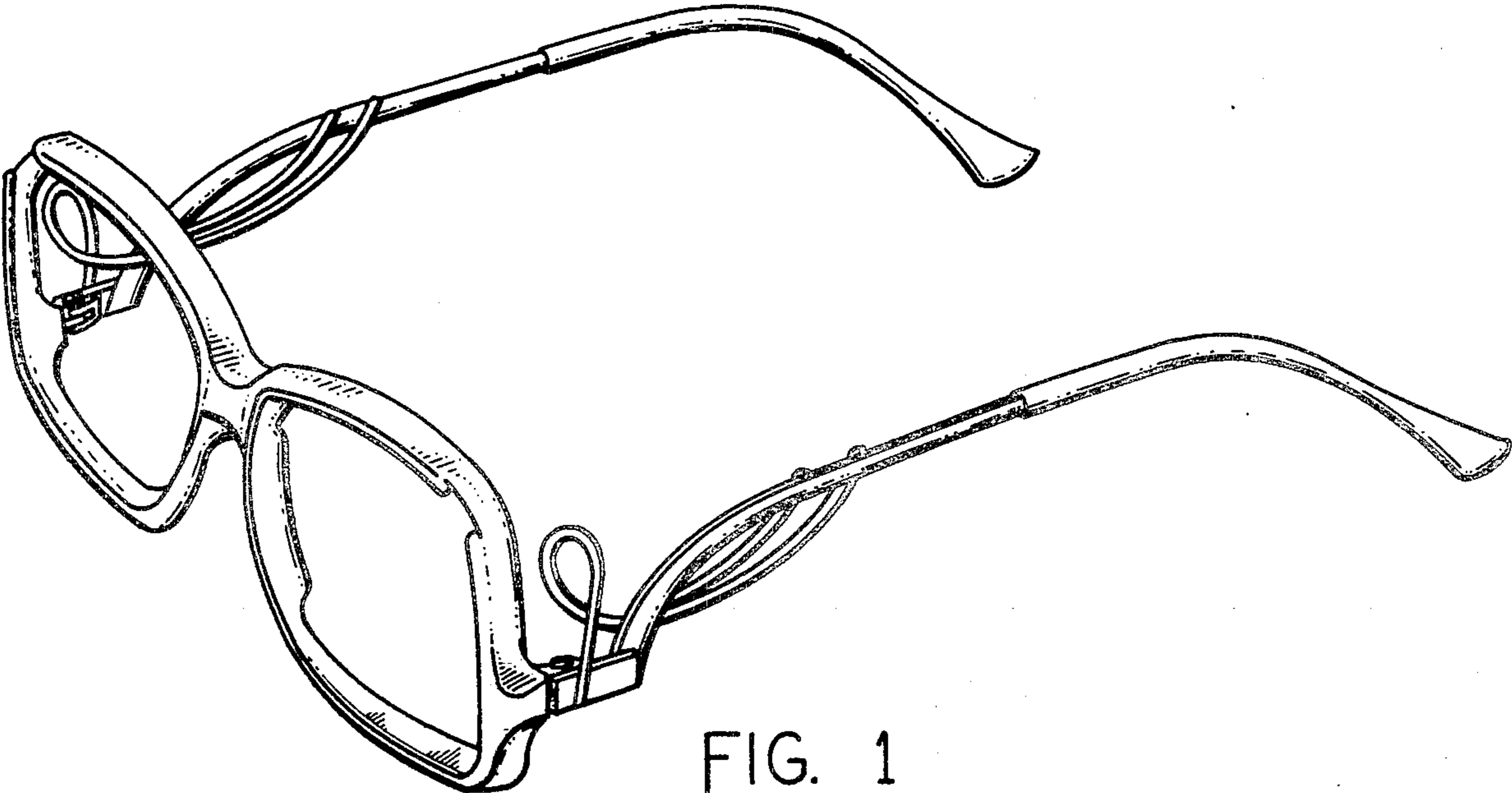

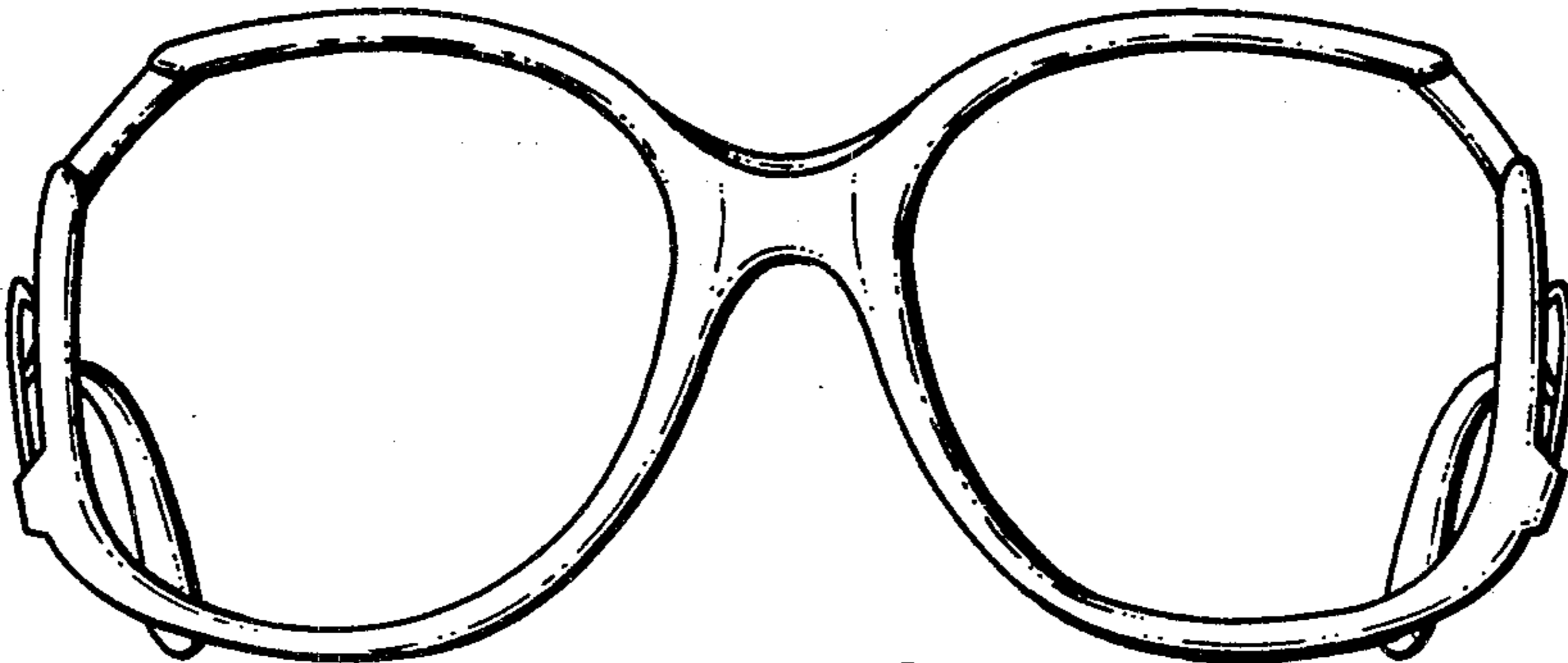

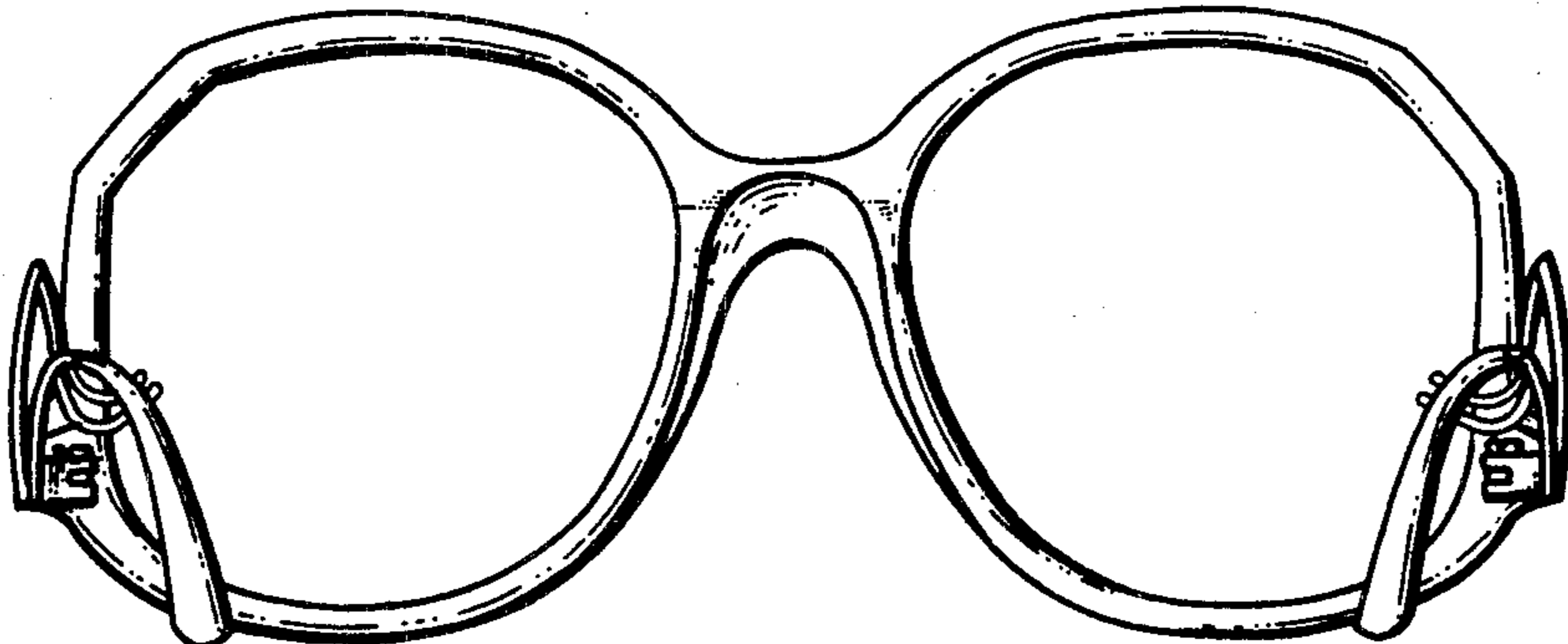
