DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my design;

FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view through line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a third embodiment;

FIG. 8 is a plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged cross-sectional view through line 11—11 of FIG. 7; and

FIG. 12 is a front perspective view of a fourth embodiment.

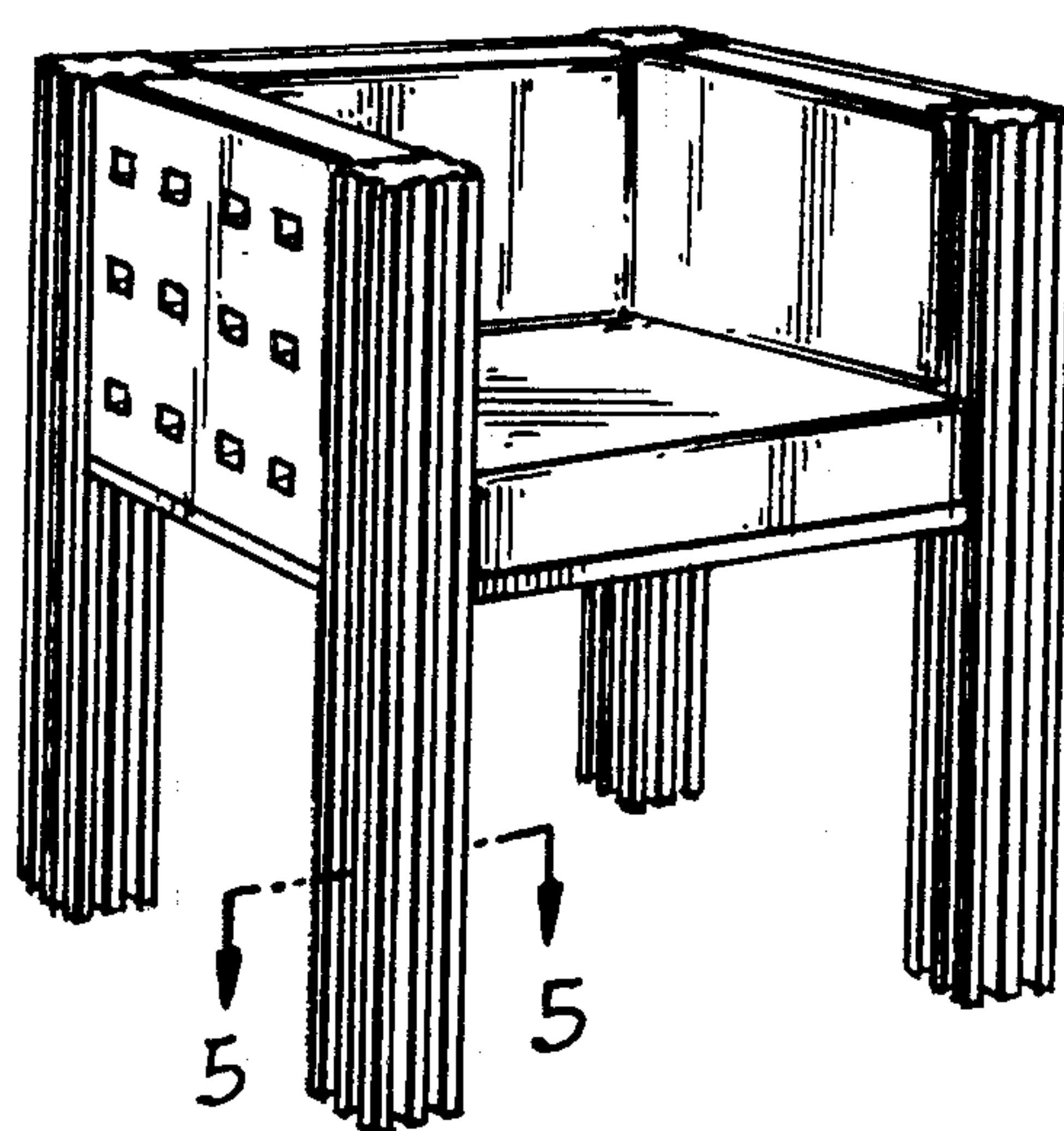

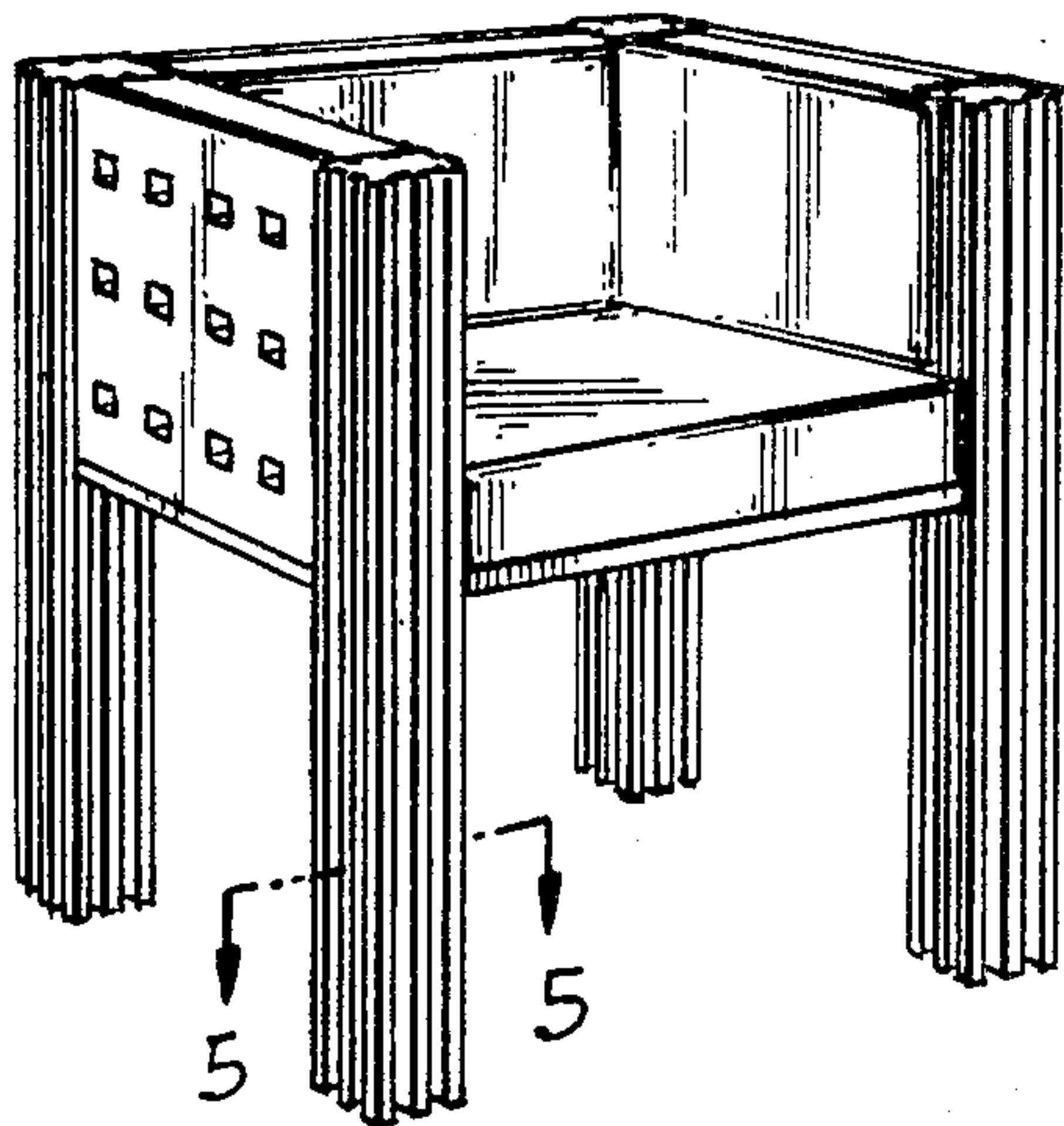

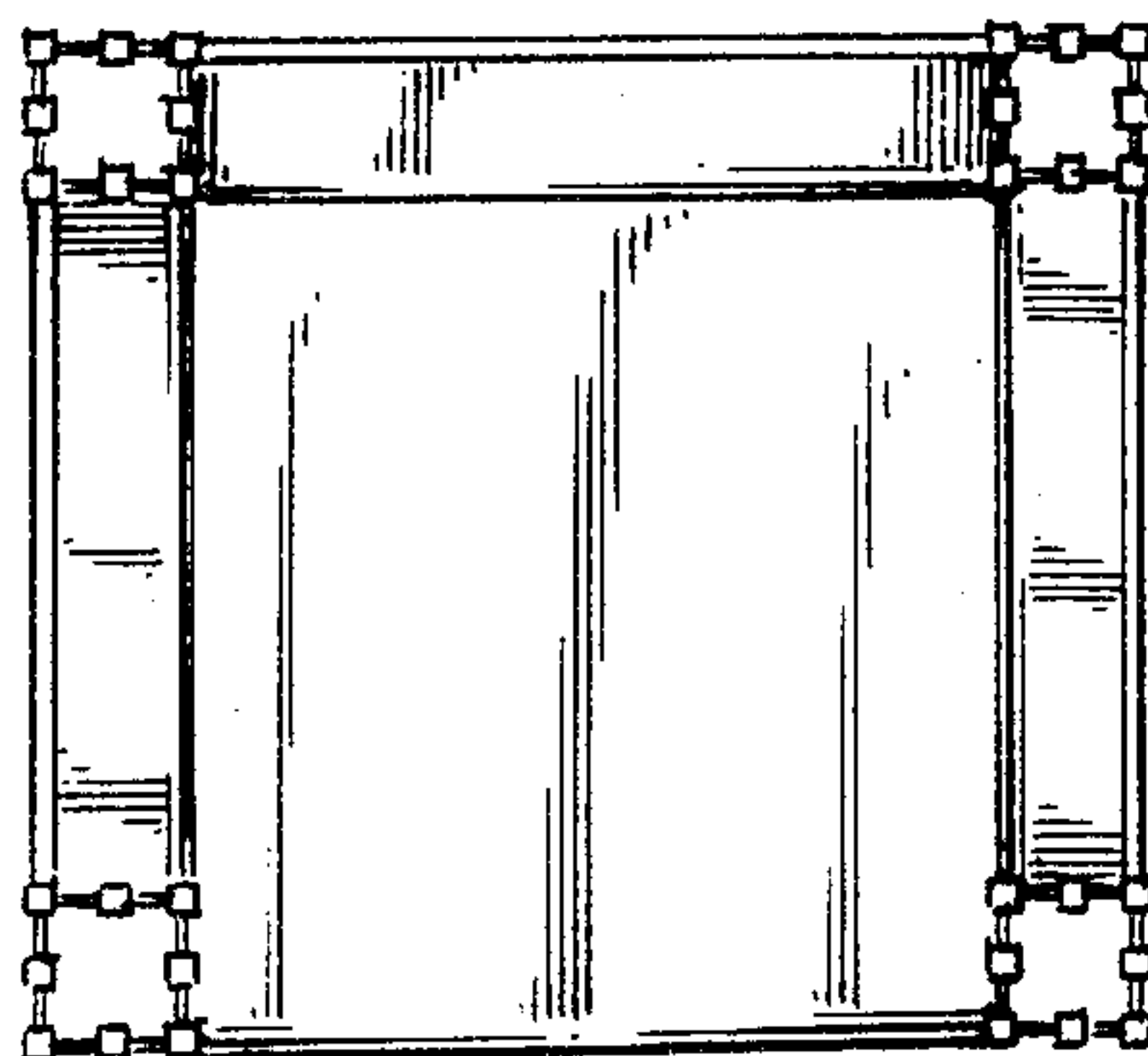

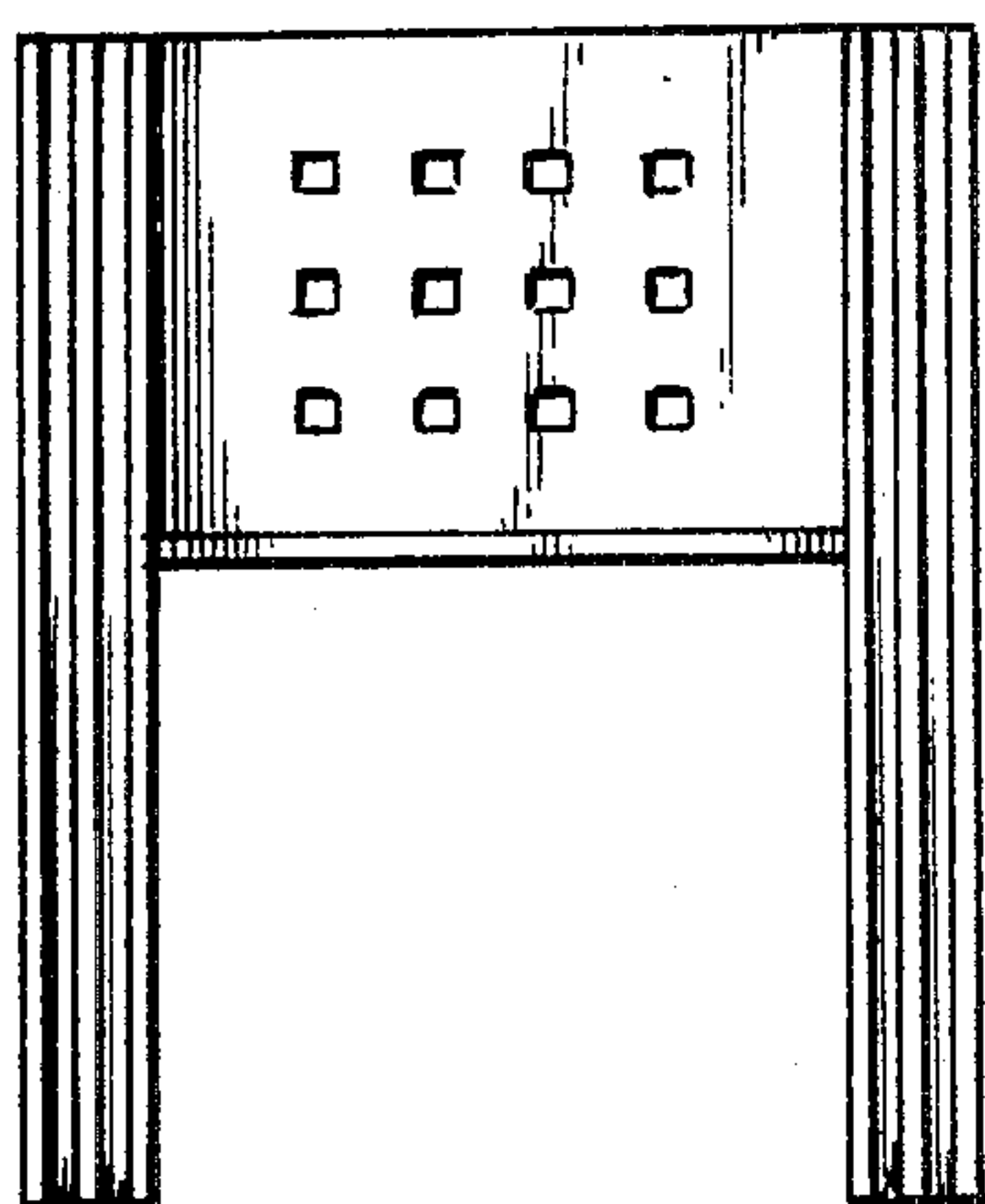

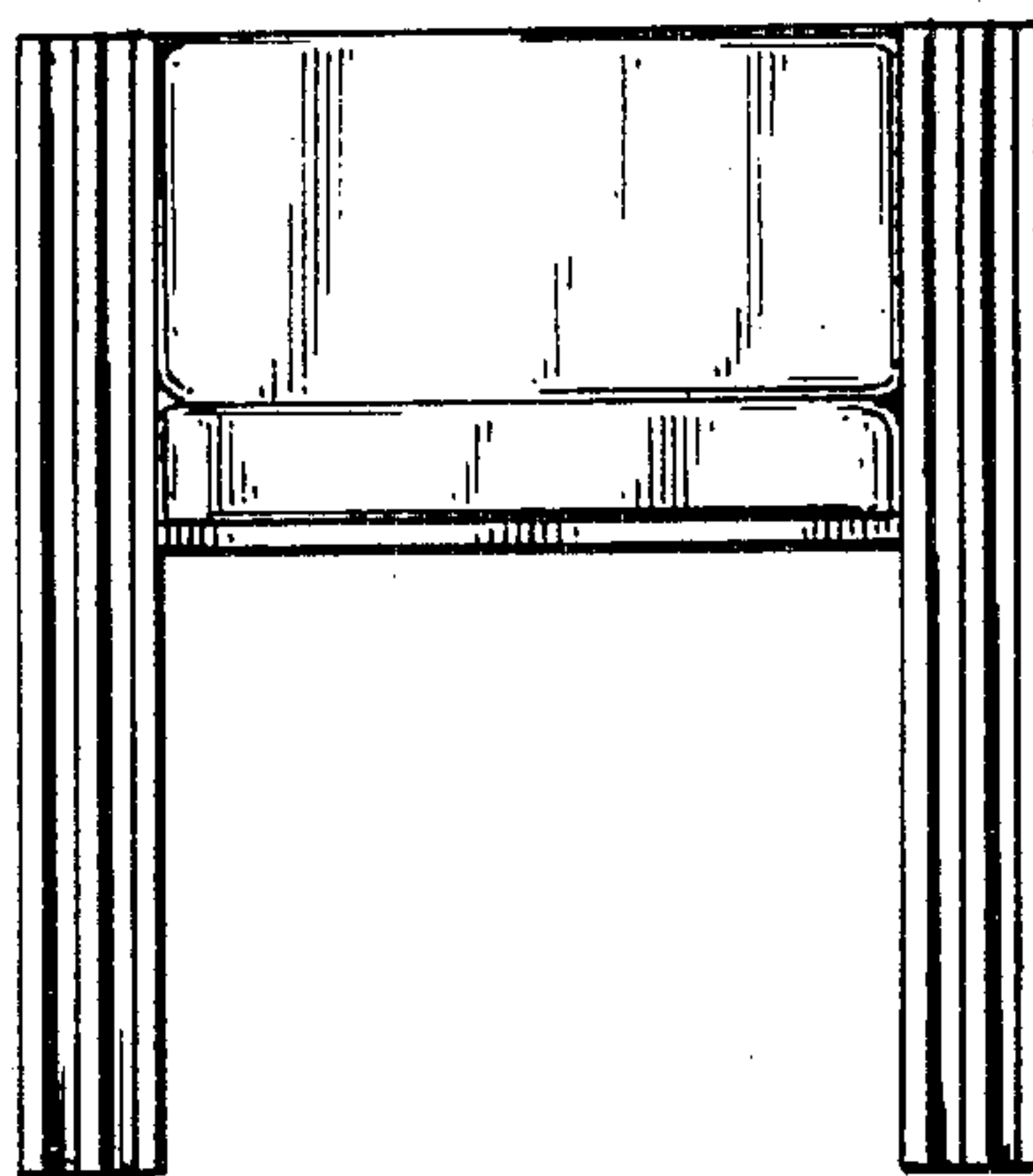

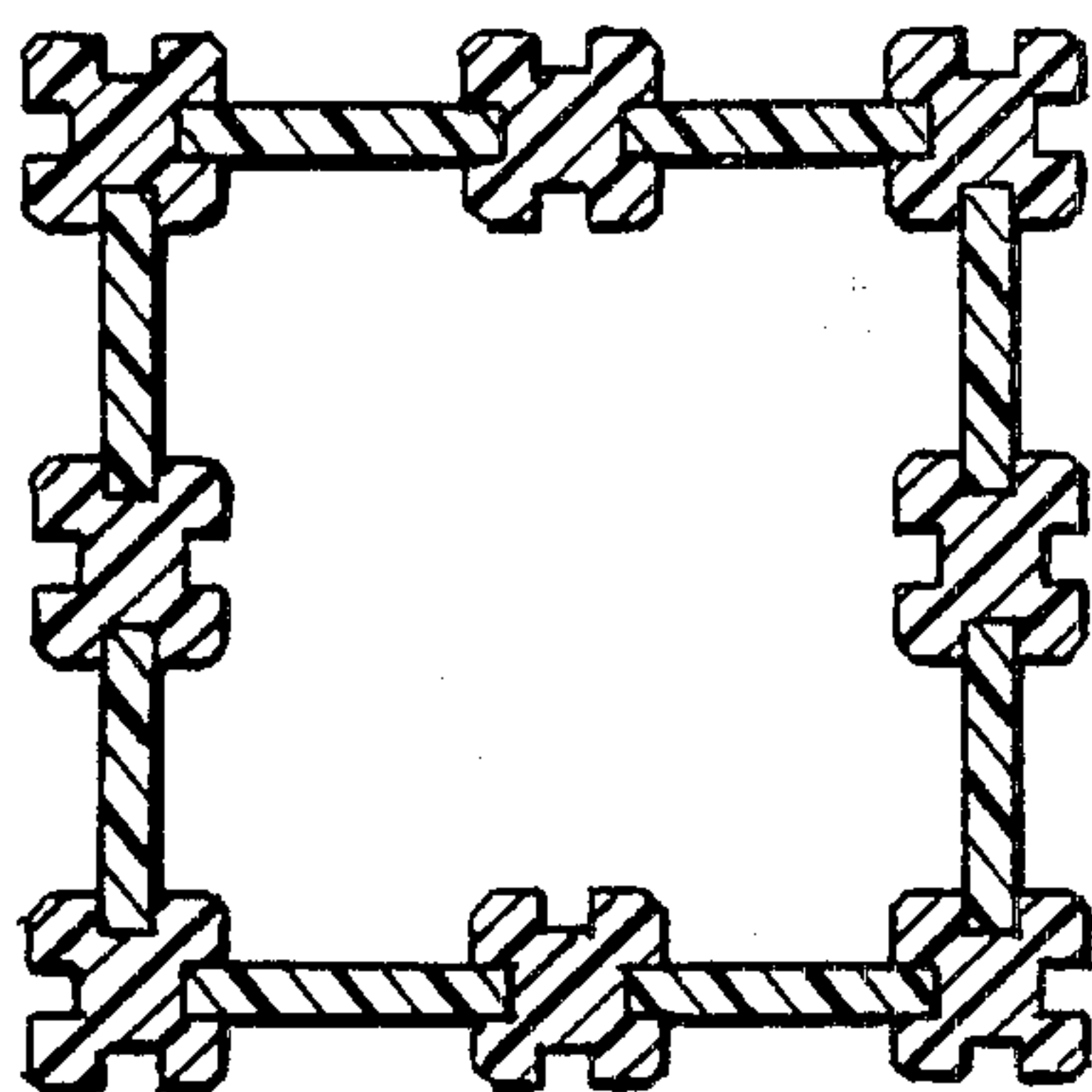

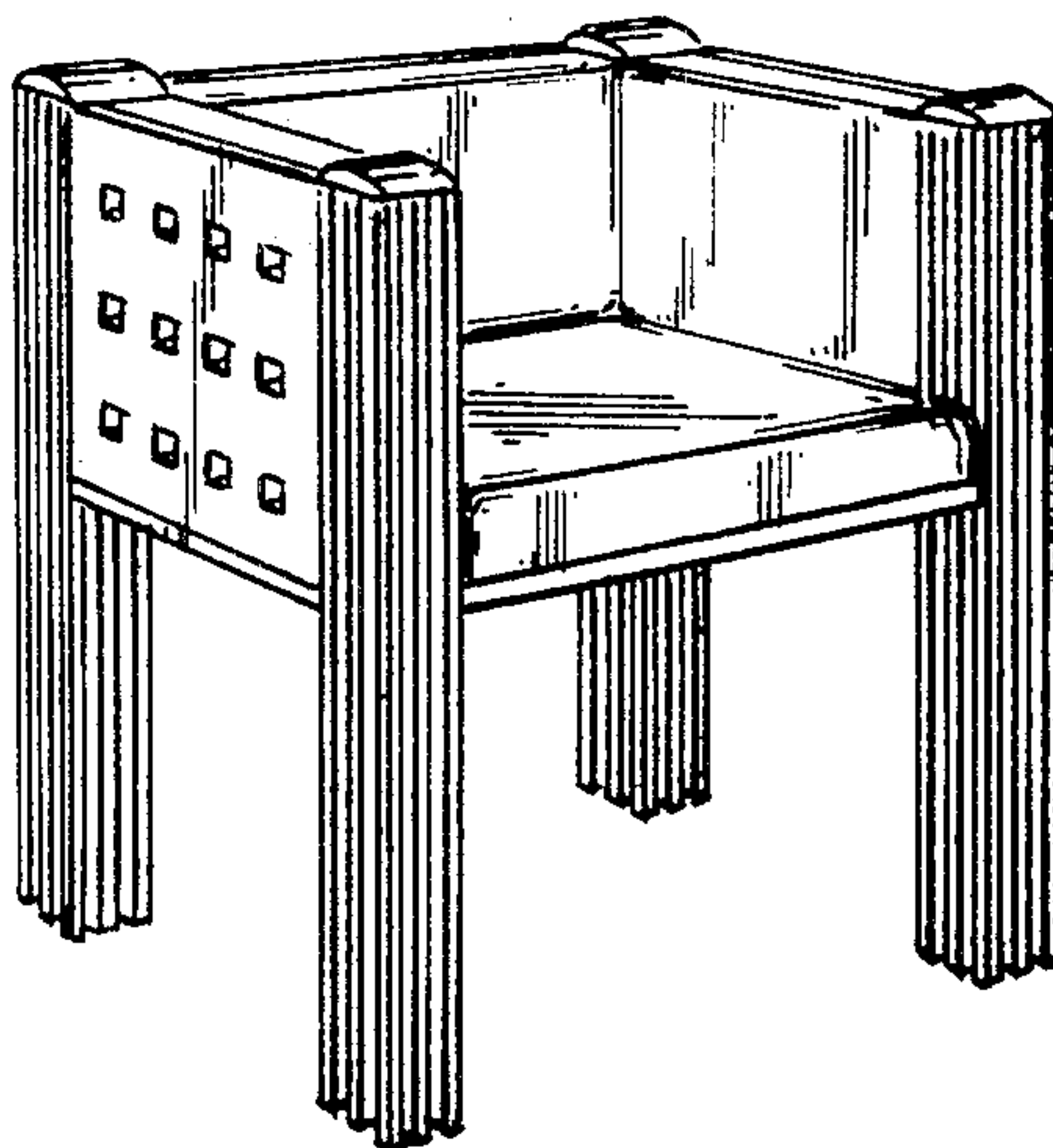

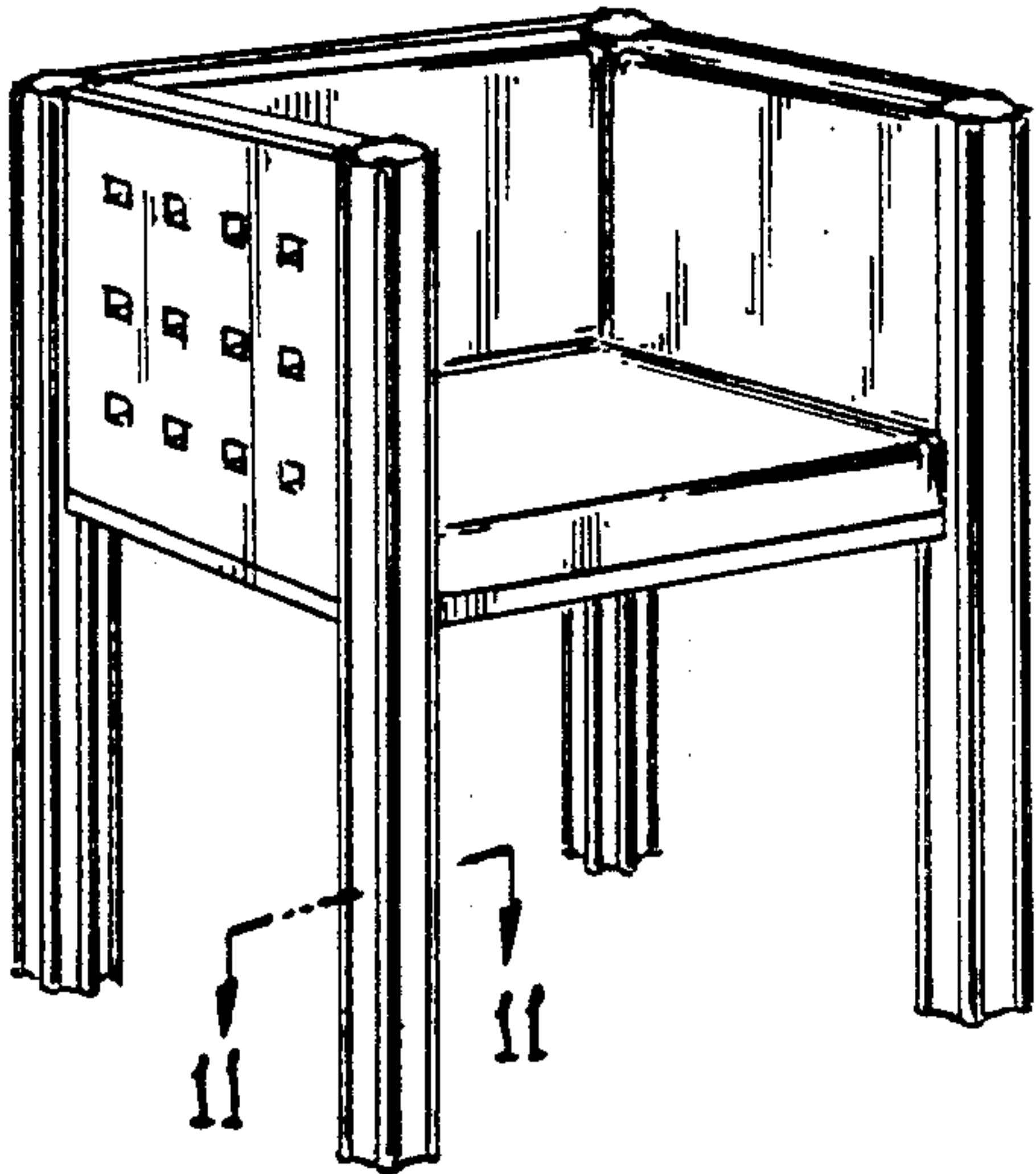

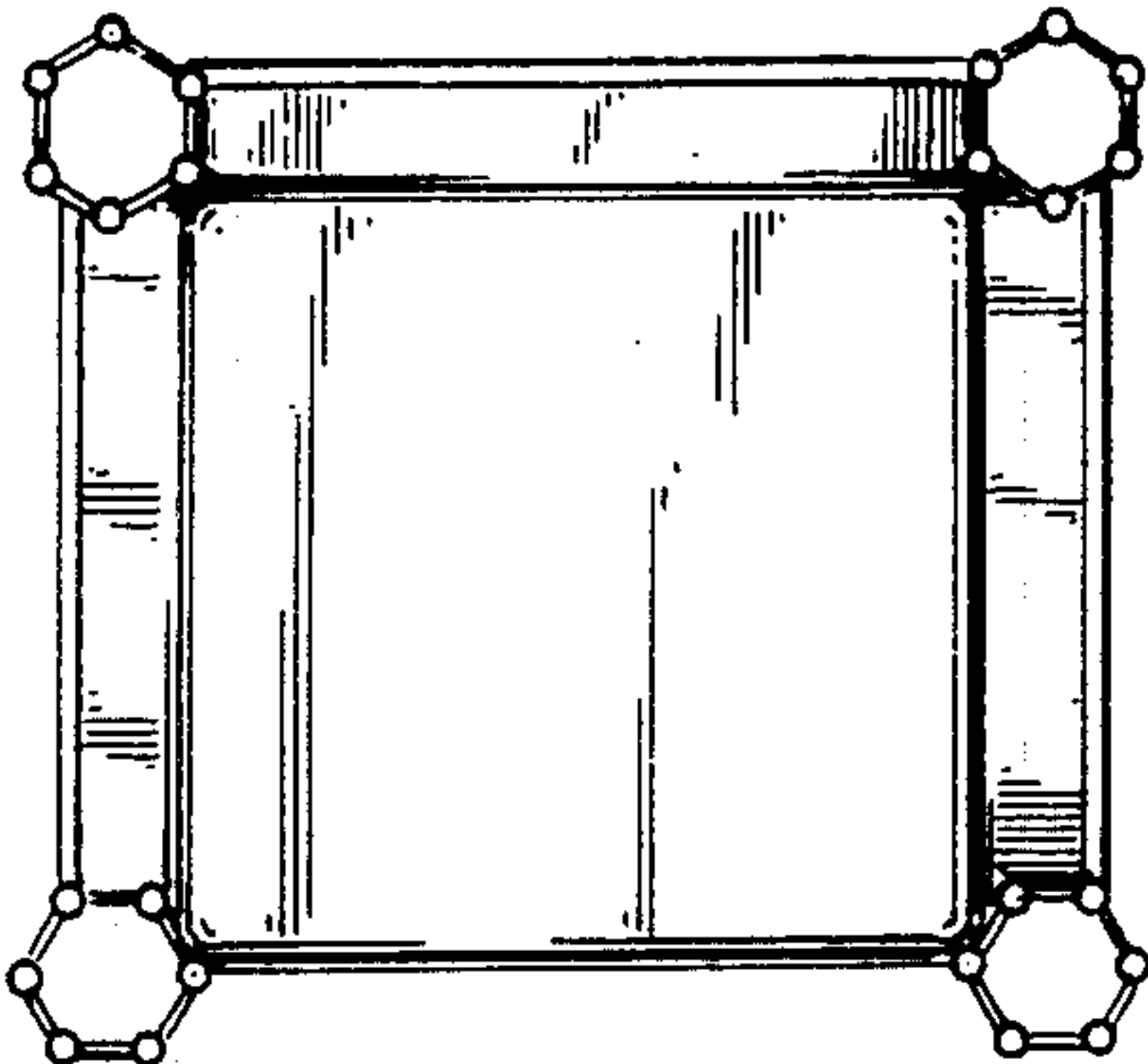

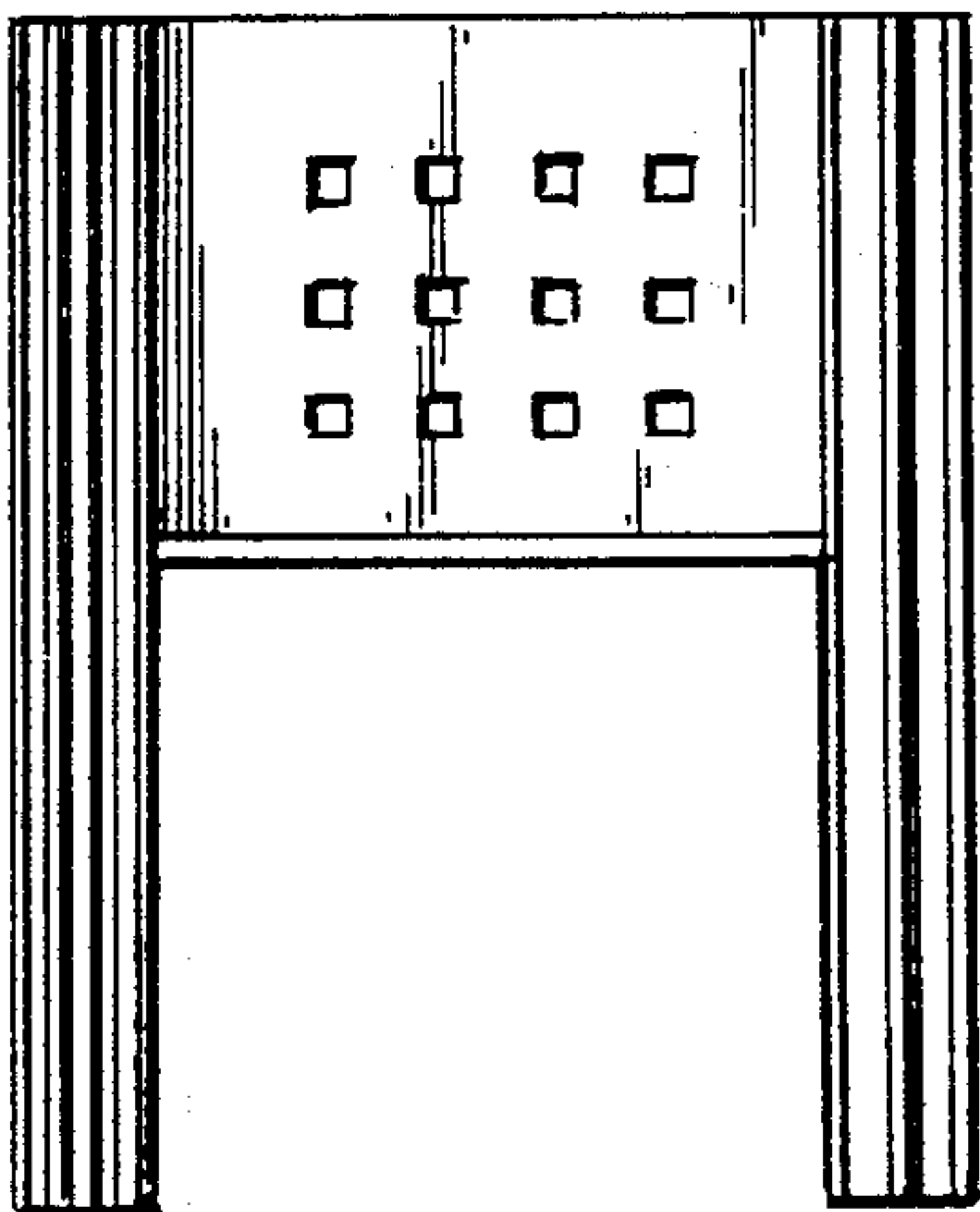

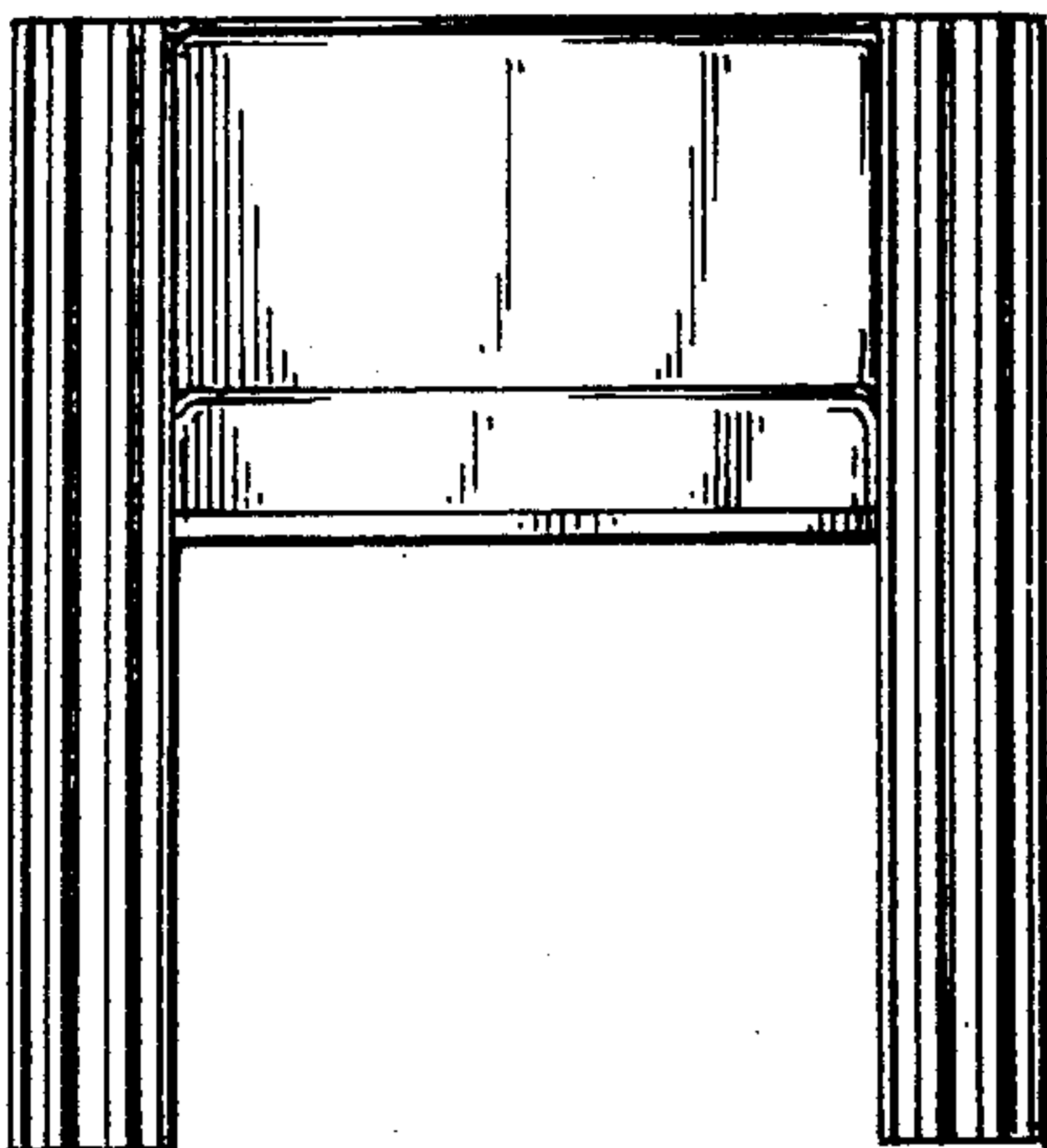

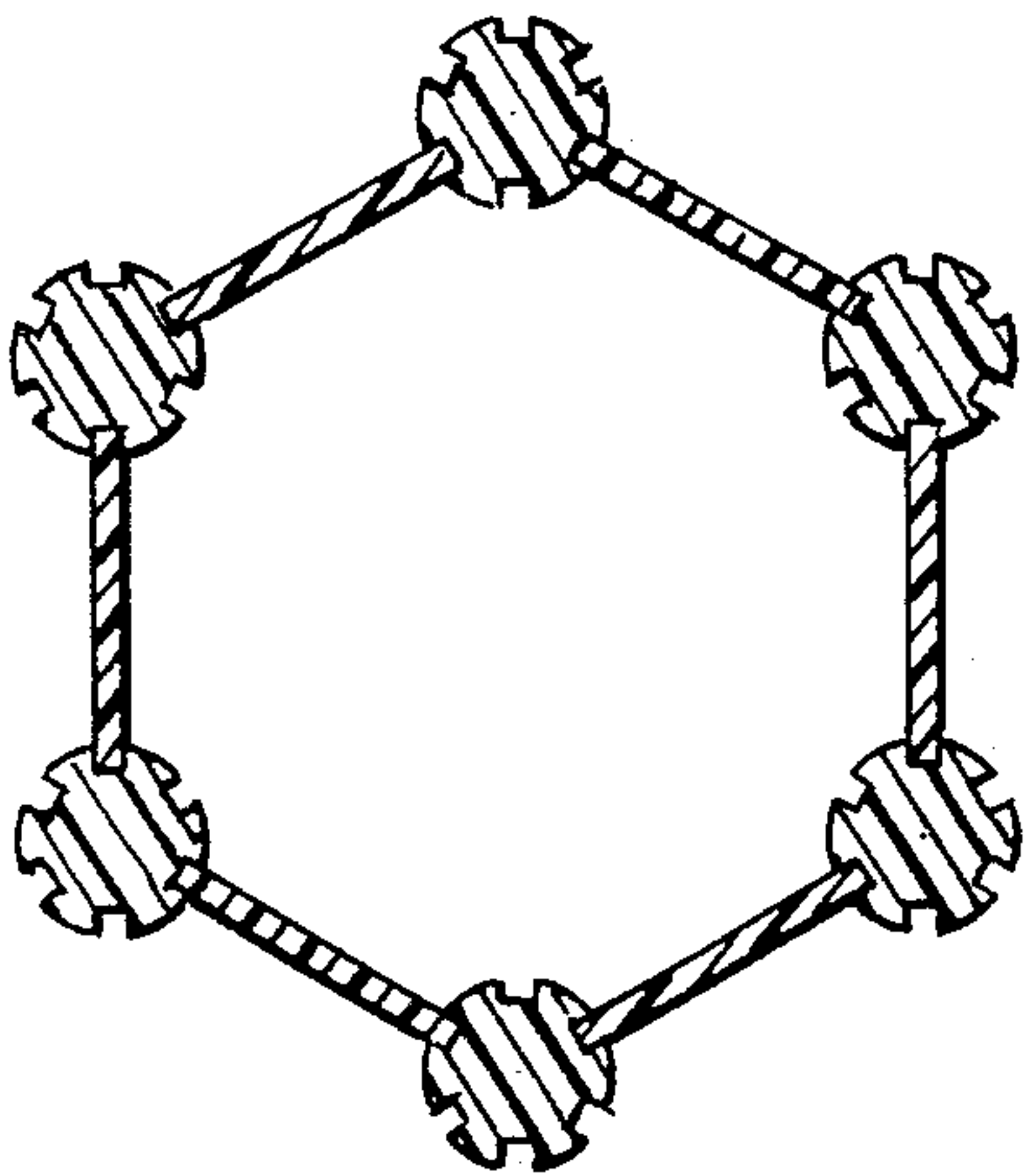
