DESCRIPTION

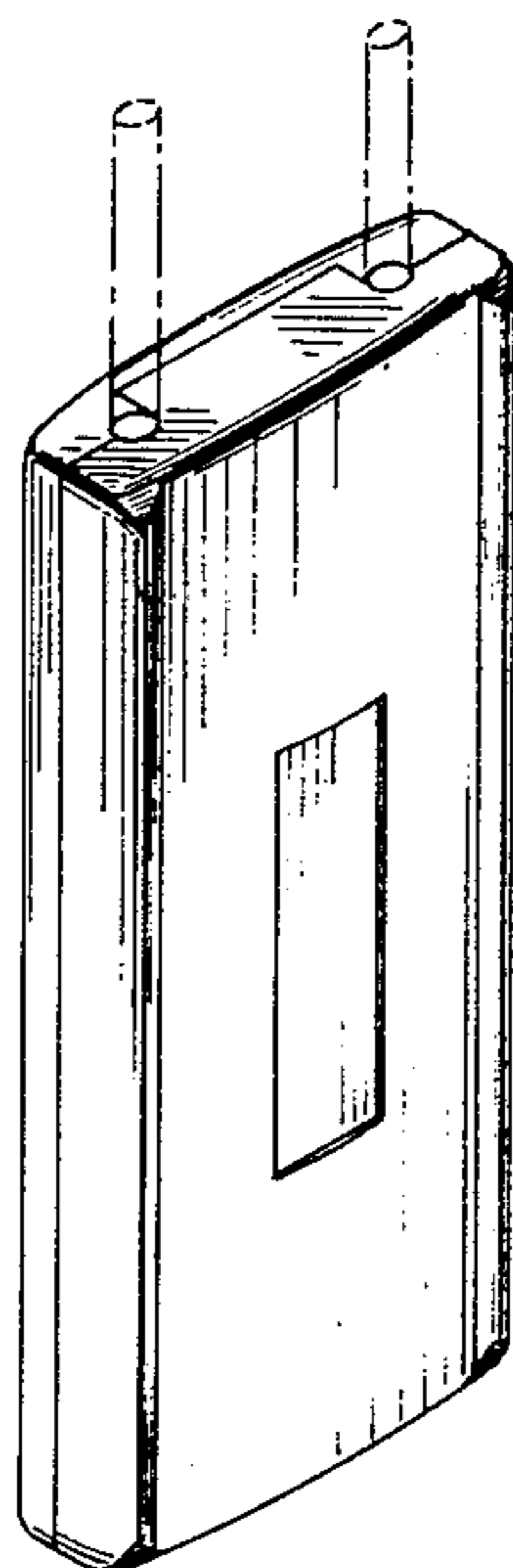
FIG. 1 is a front, top perspective view of a weighted cord drop or similar article showing our new design, the broken line showing of the portions of cords is for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



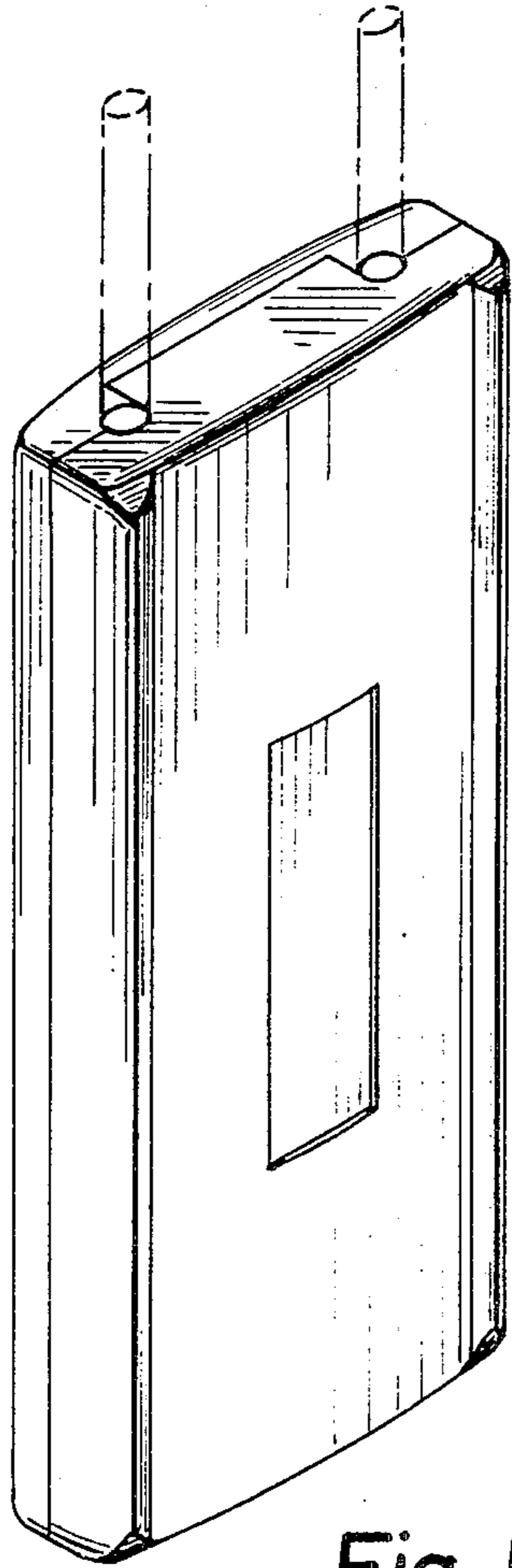

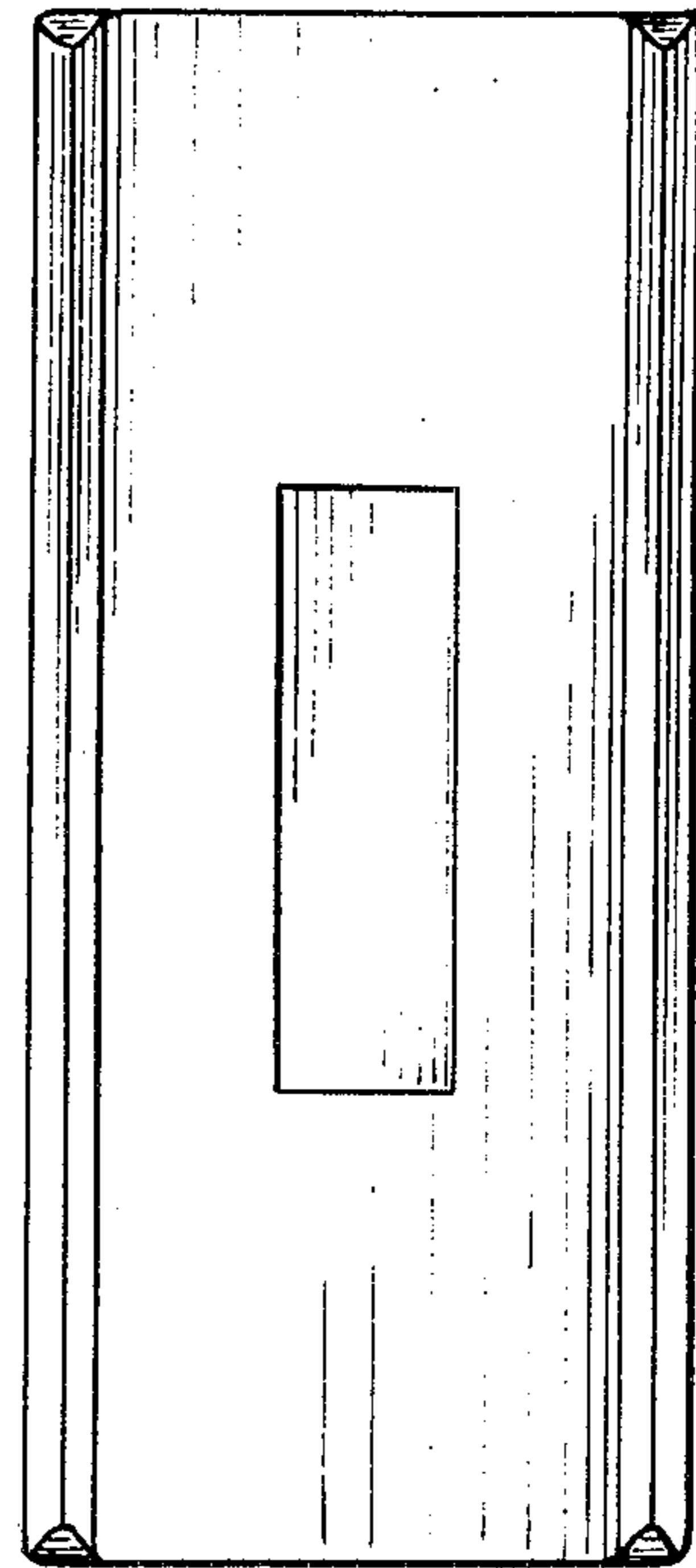

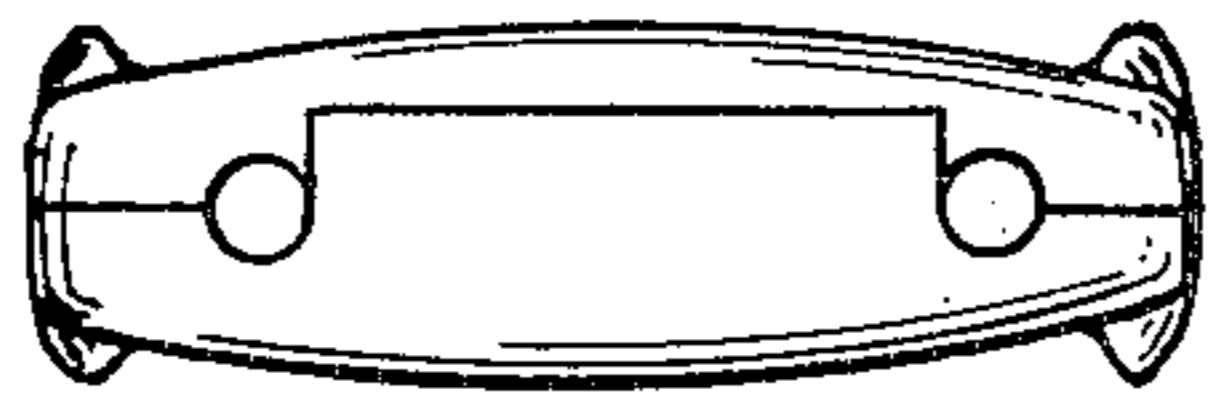

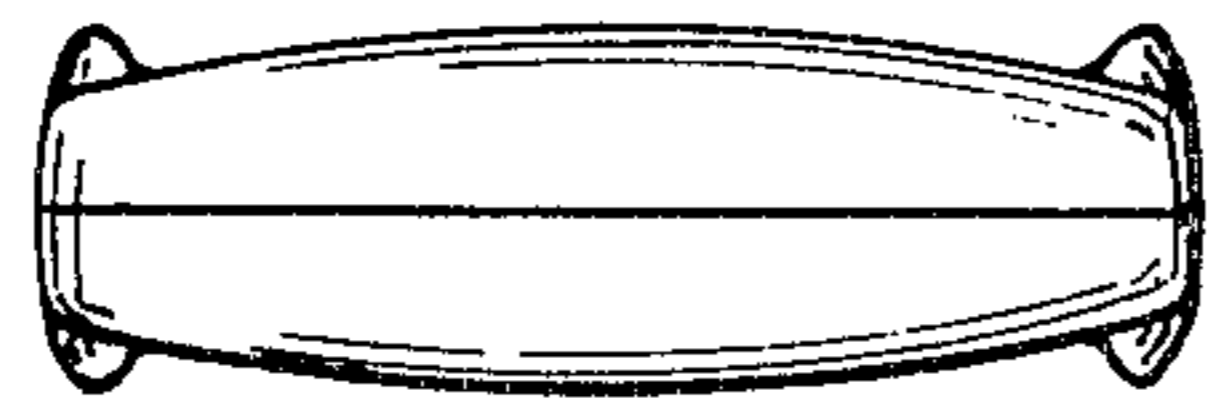

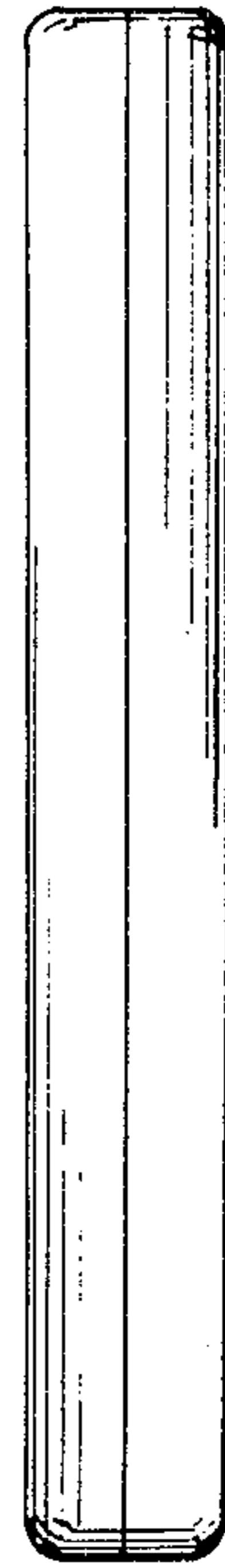
