The ornamental design for a coupon display card, substantially as shown and described.

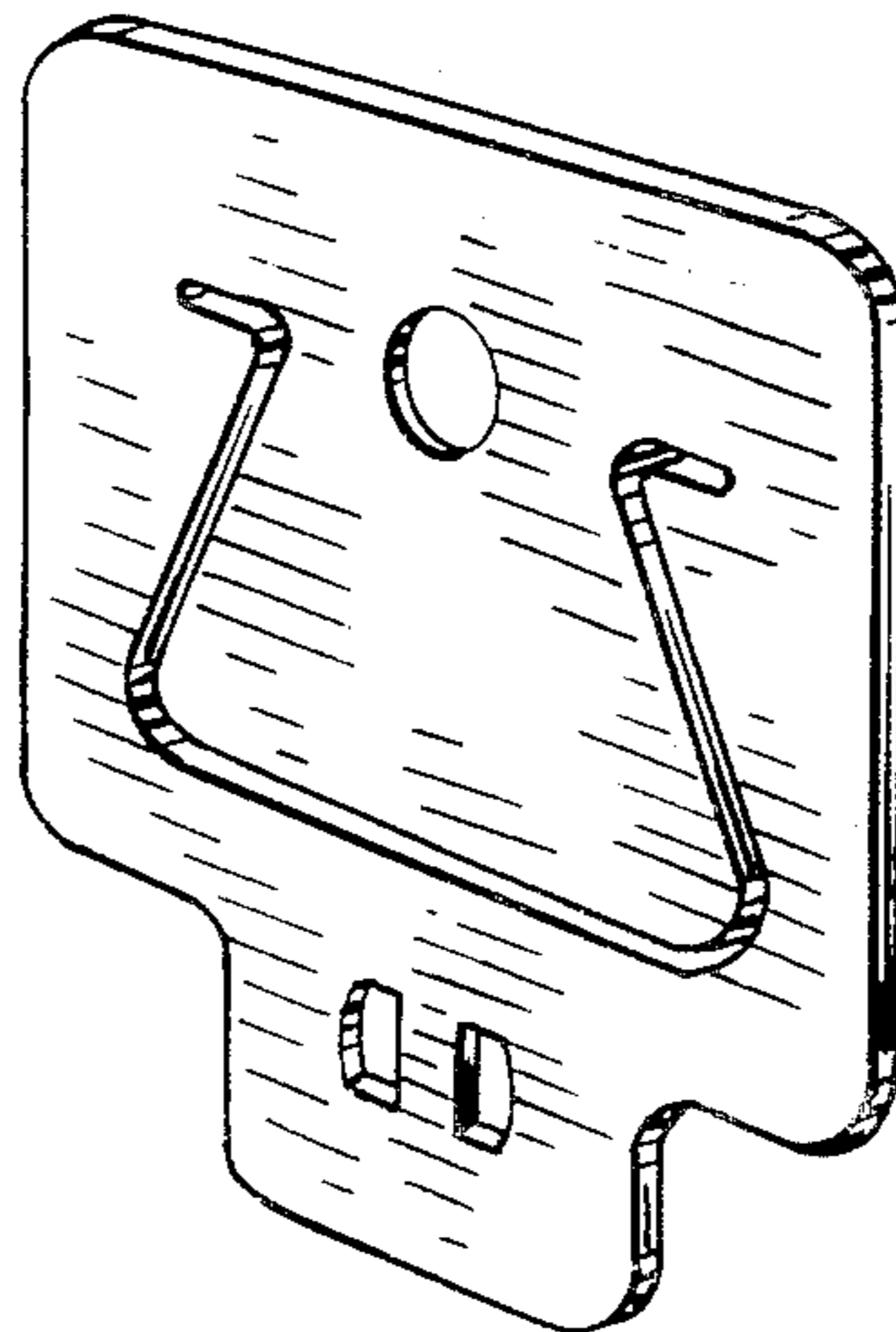
DESCRIPTION

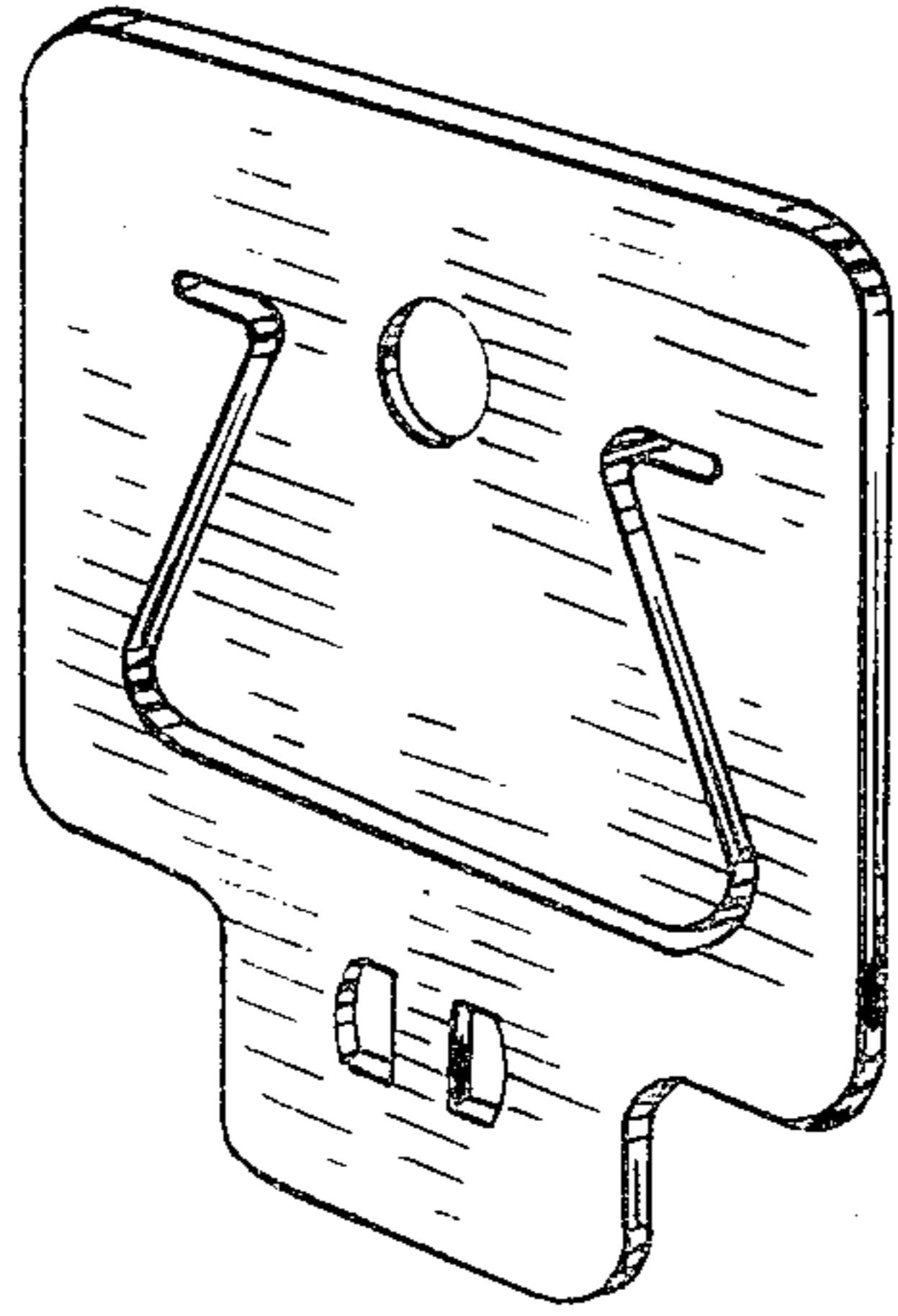

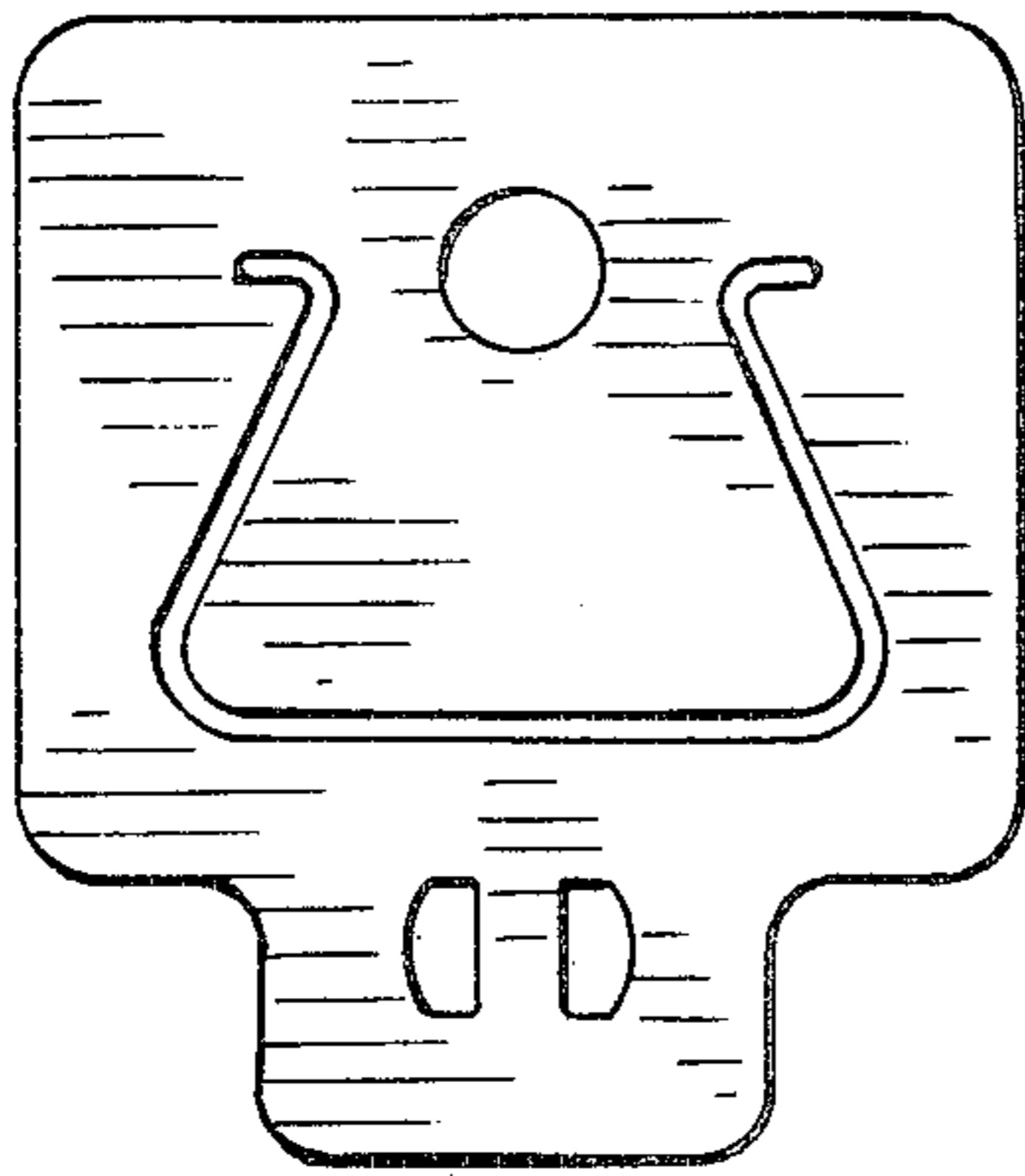

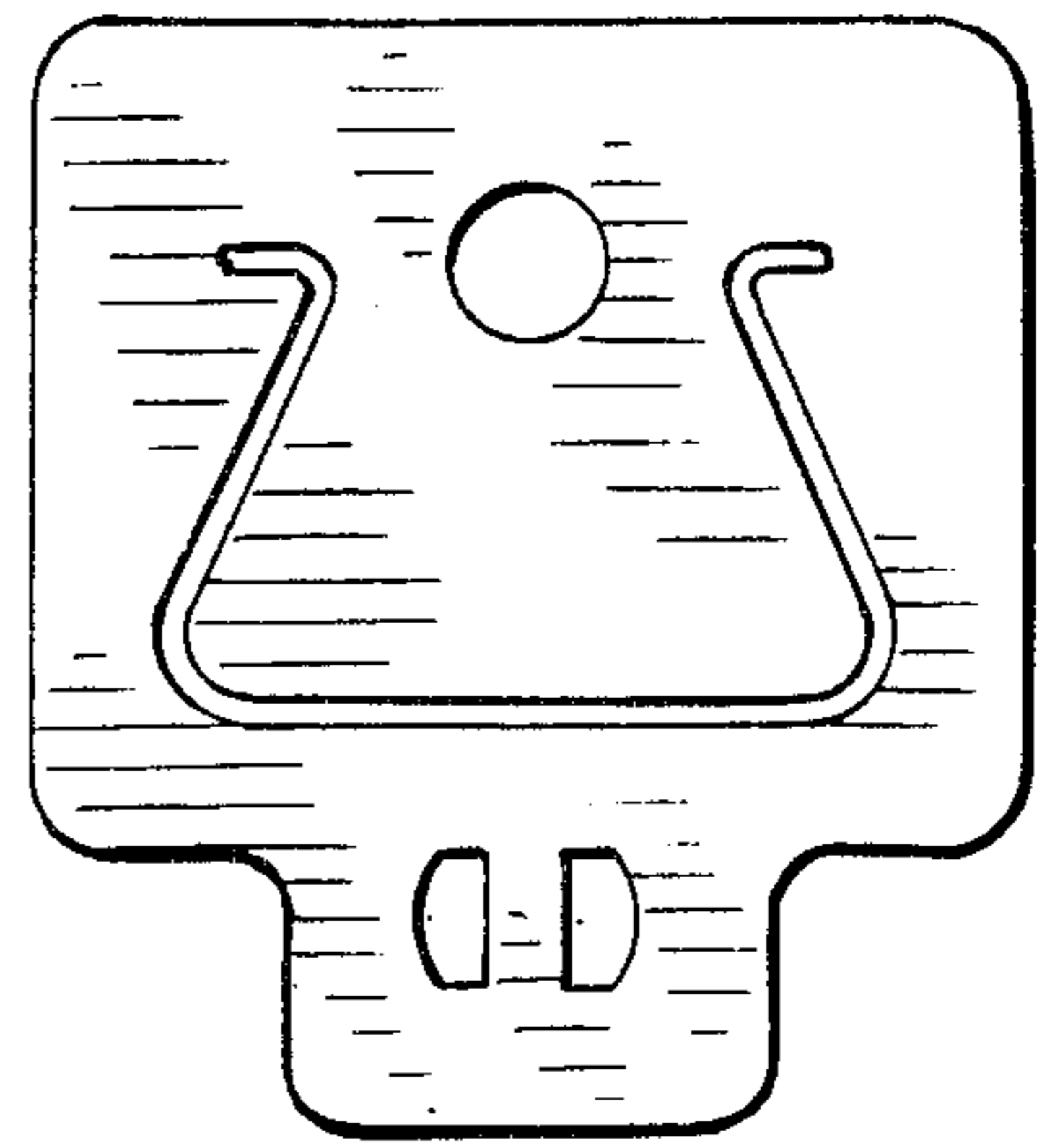

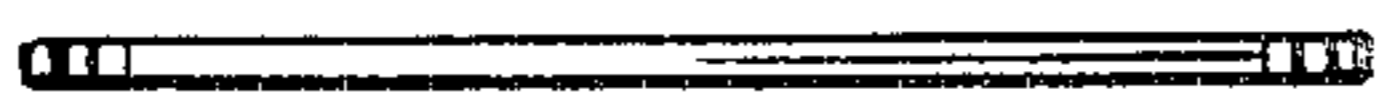

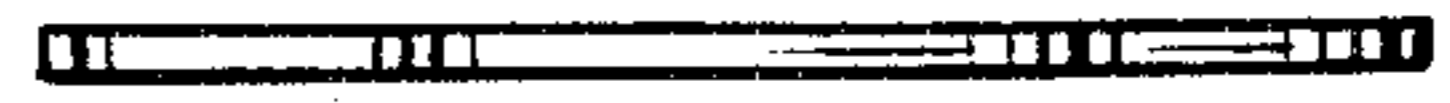
