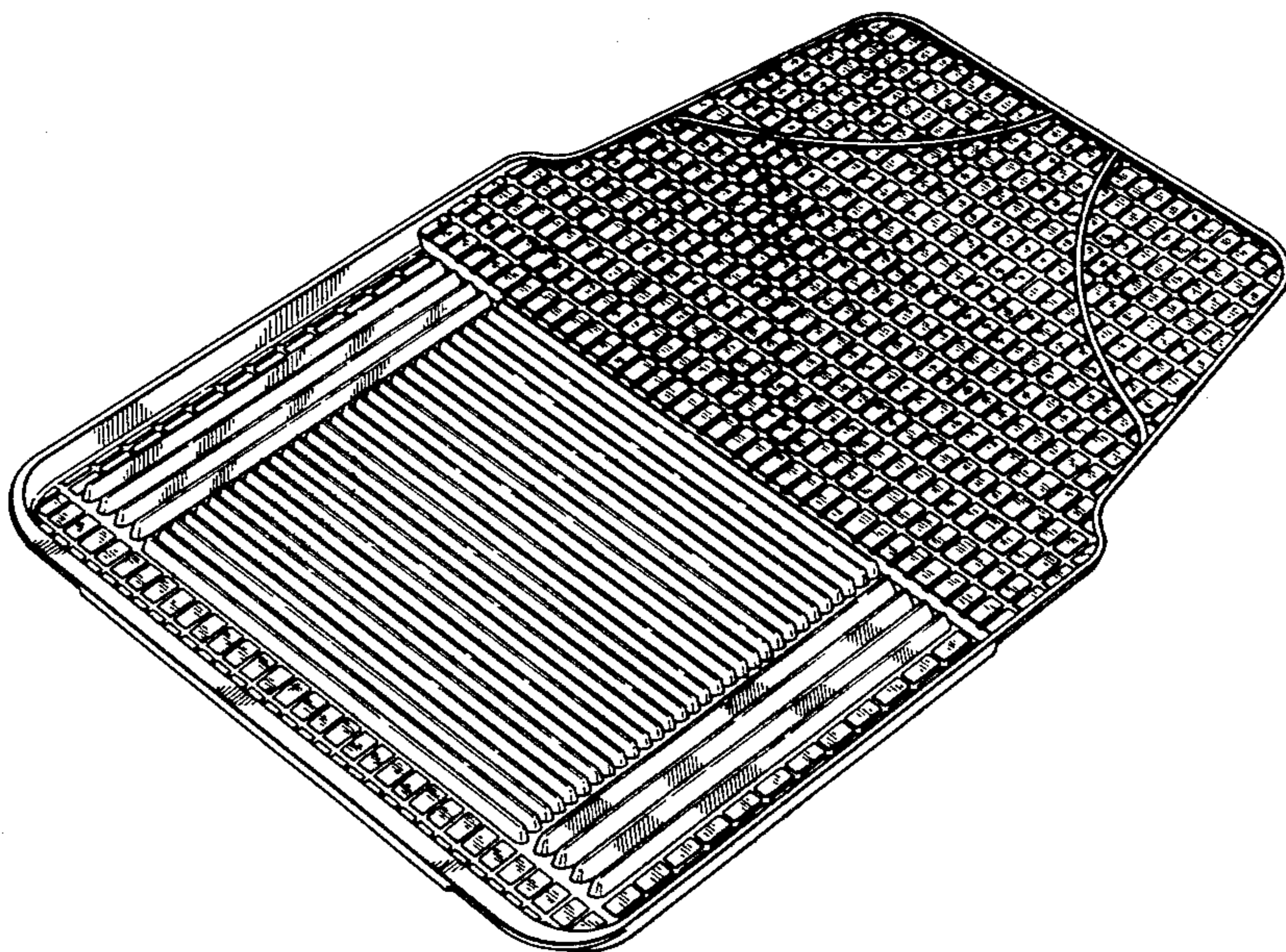

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a car mat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a car mat showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, the other side being substantially identical; and
FIG. 8 is an enlarged longitudinal, cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 8—8 in FIG. 3.



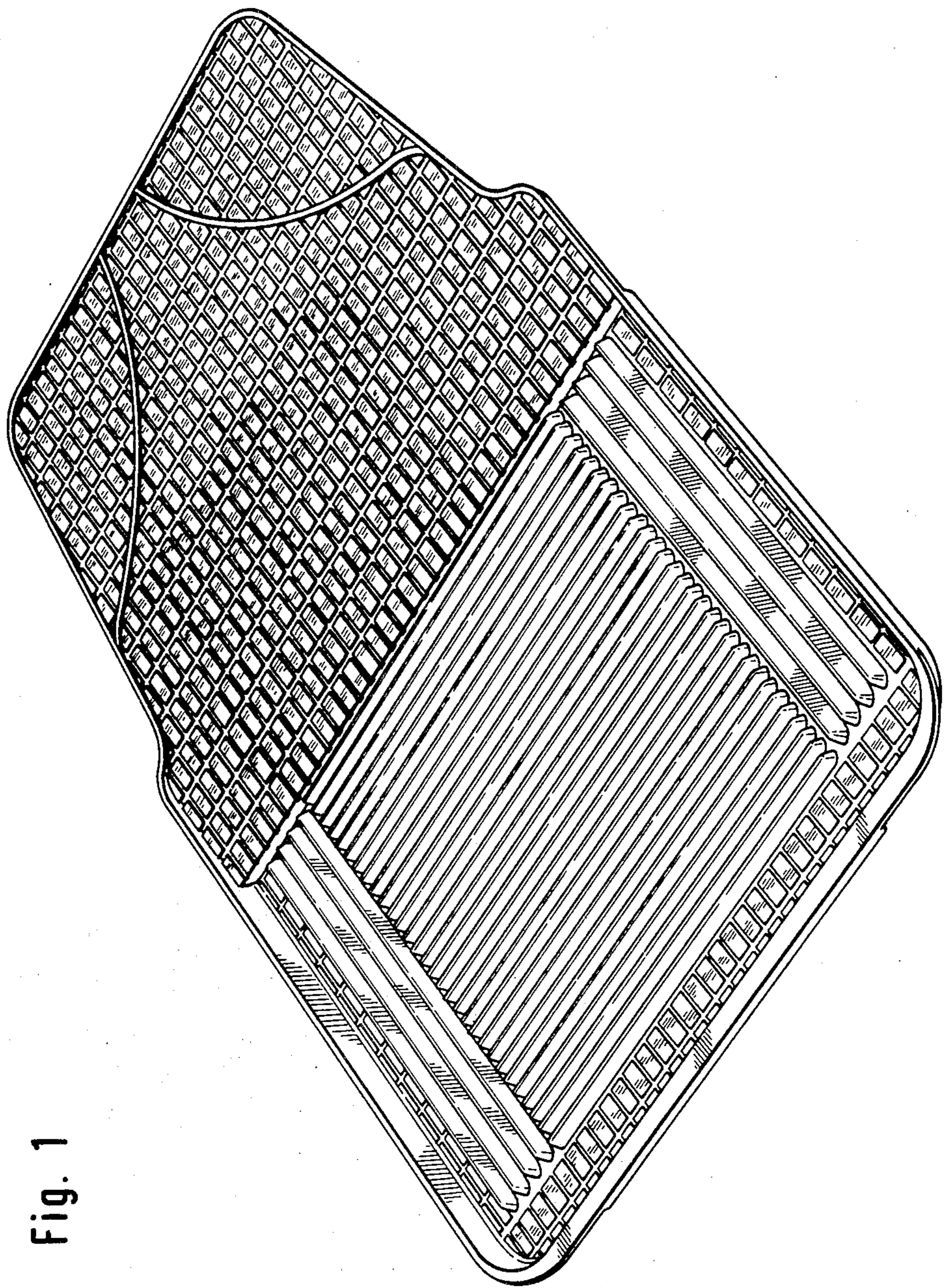

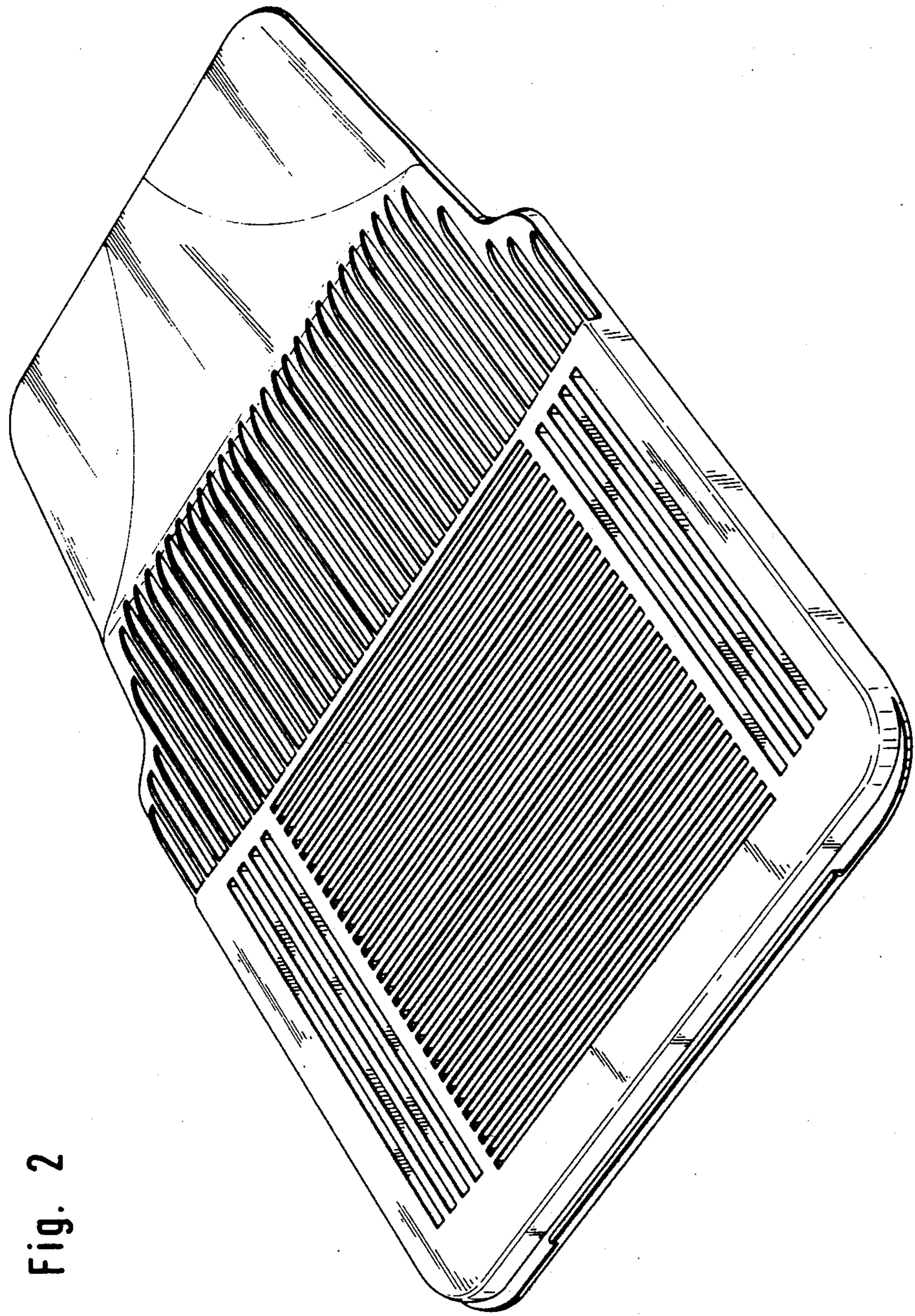

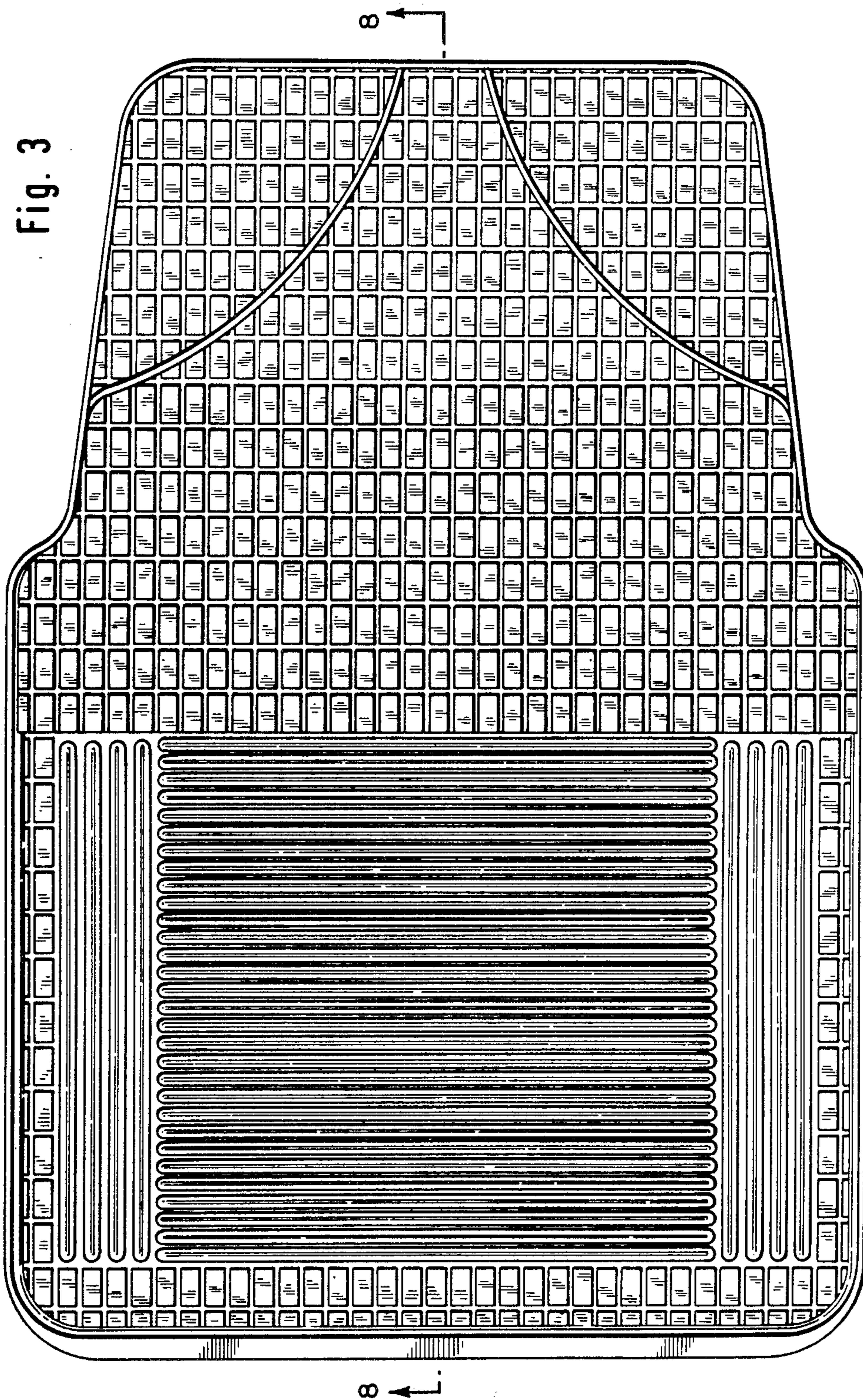

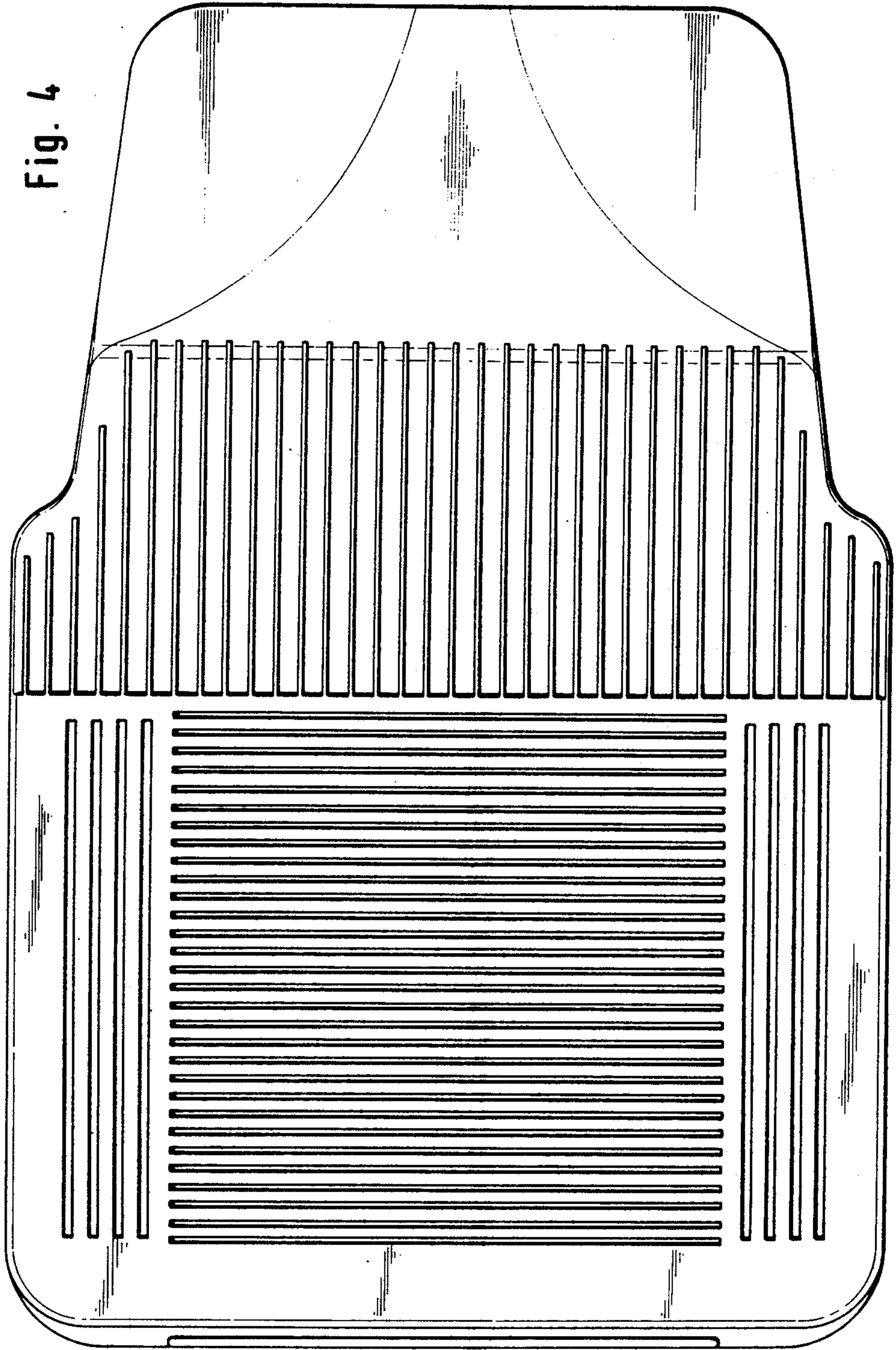

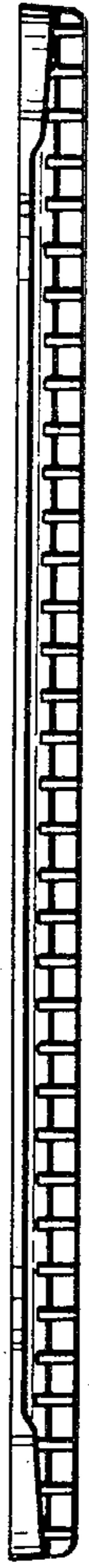
