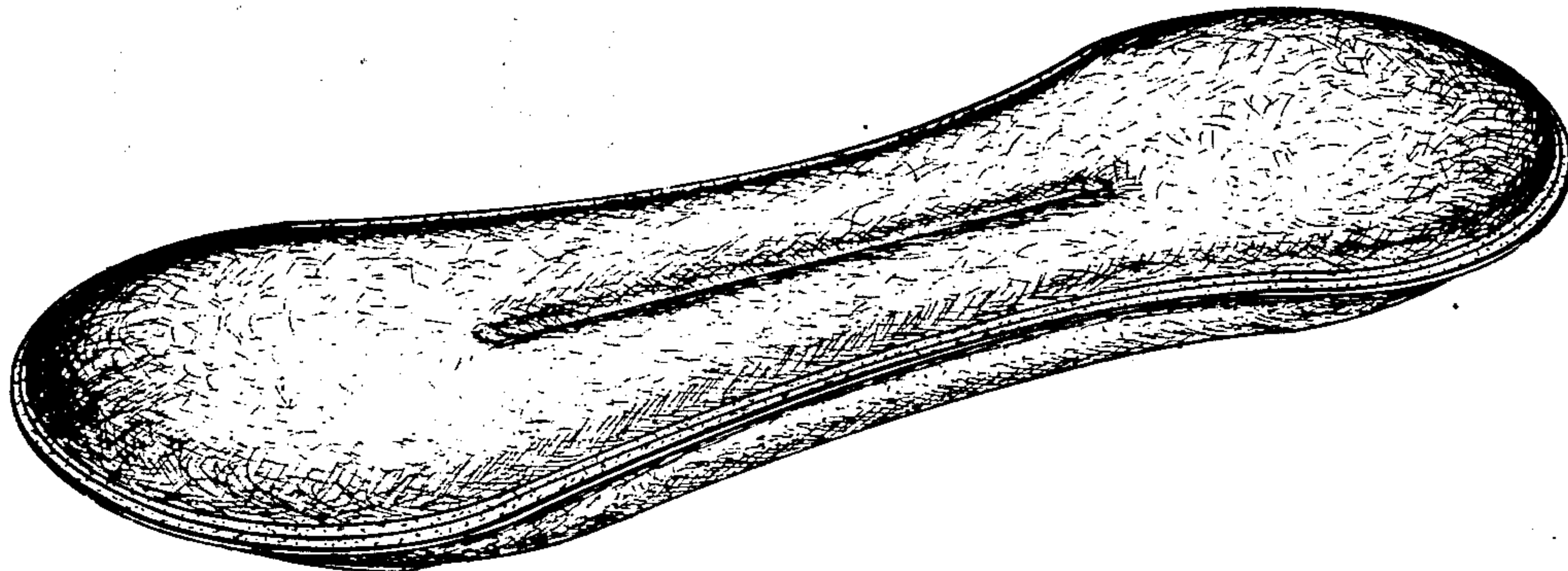

The ornamental design for a channeled sanitary napkin, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



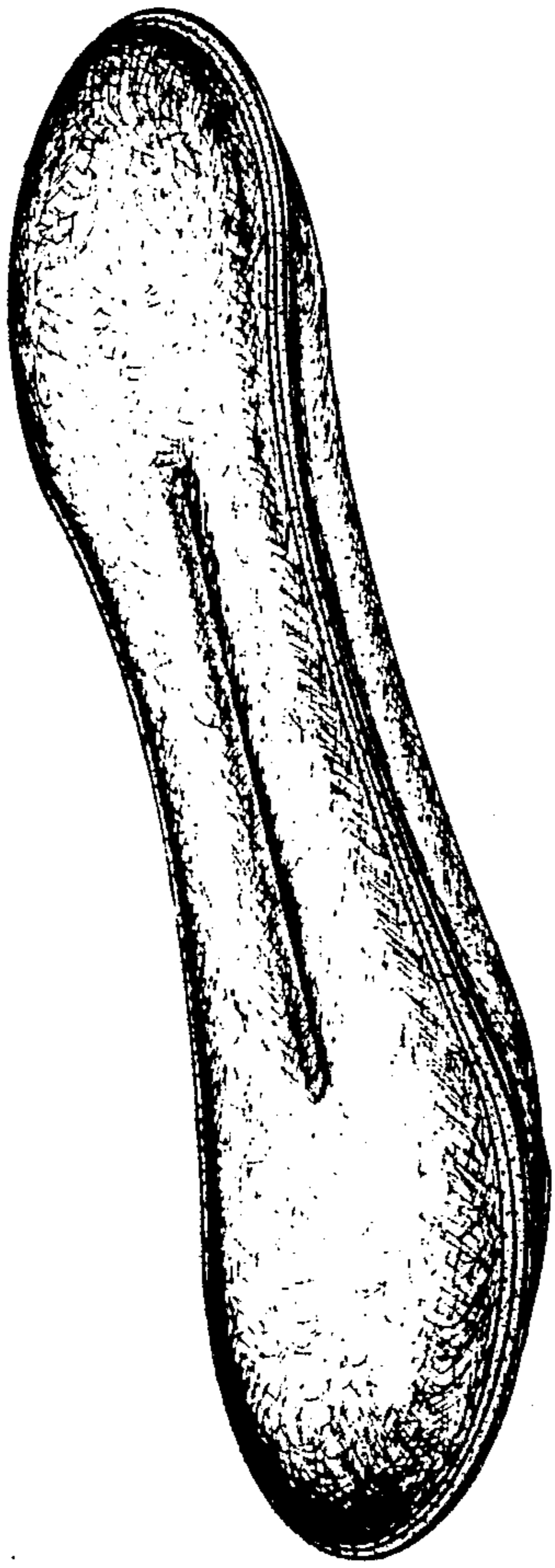

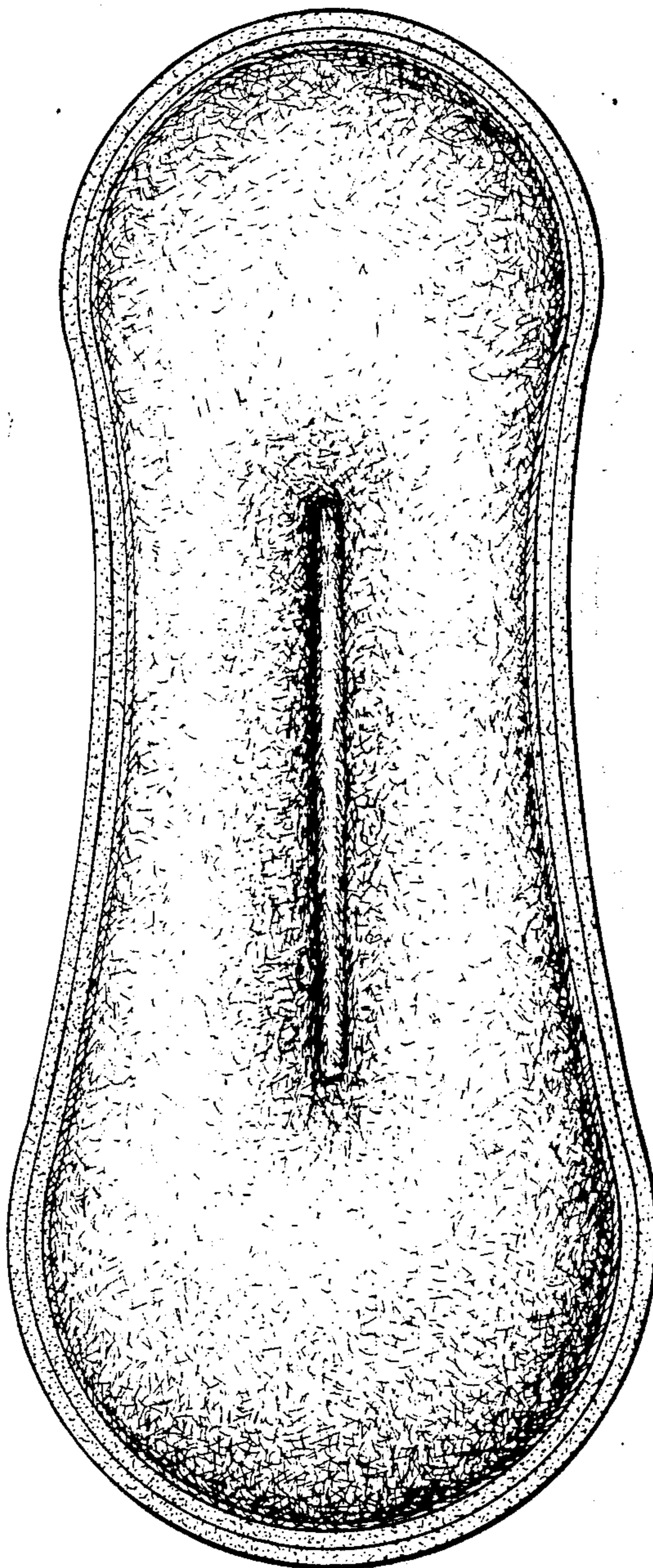
