[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sanitary napkin with adhesive attachment pattern, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a sanitary napkin with adhesive attachment showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of a sanitary napkin with another adhesive attachment; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIGS. 1 and 2; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of FIG. 2.

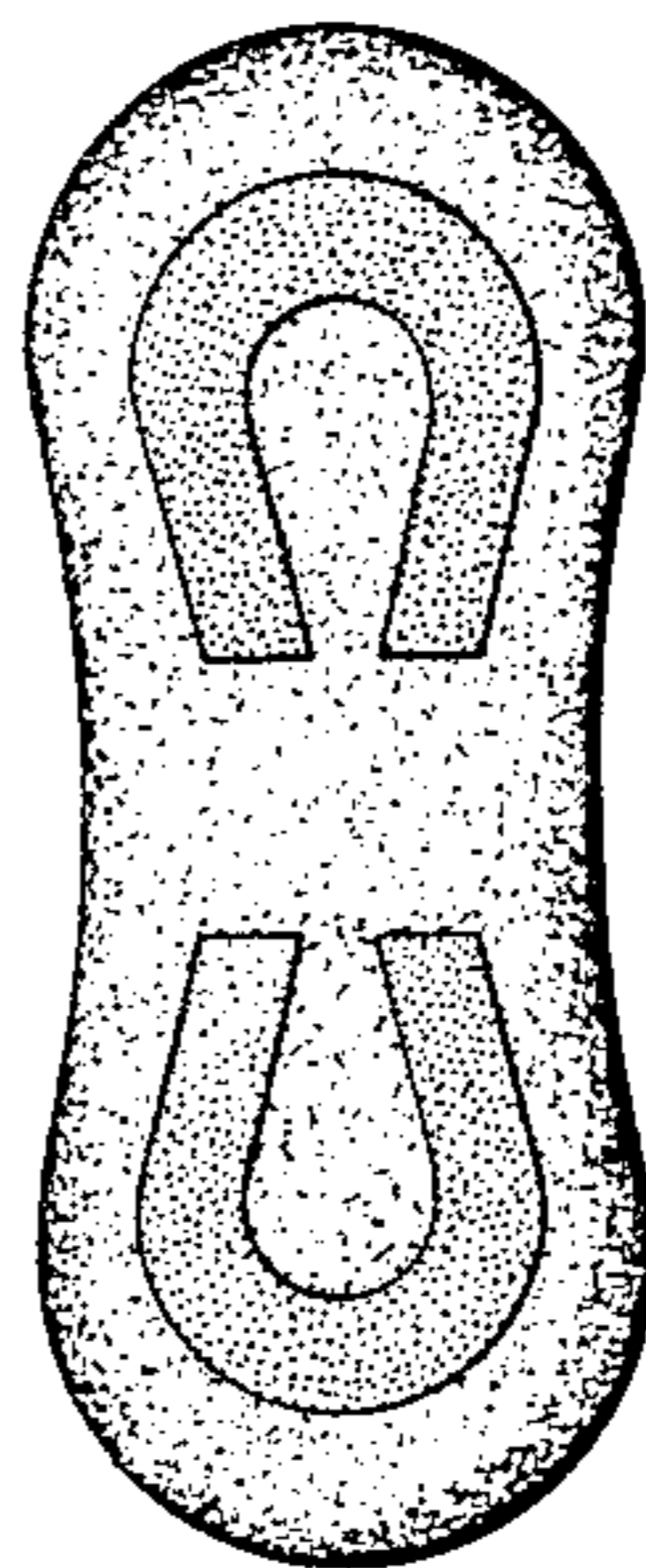
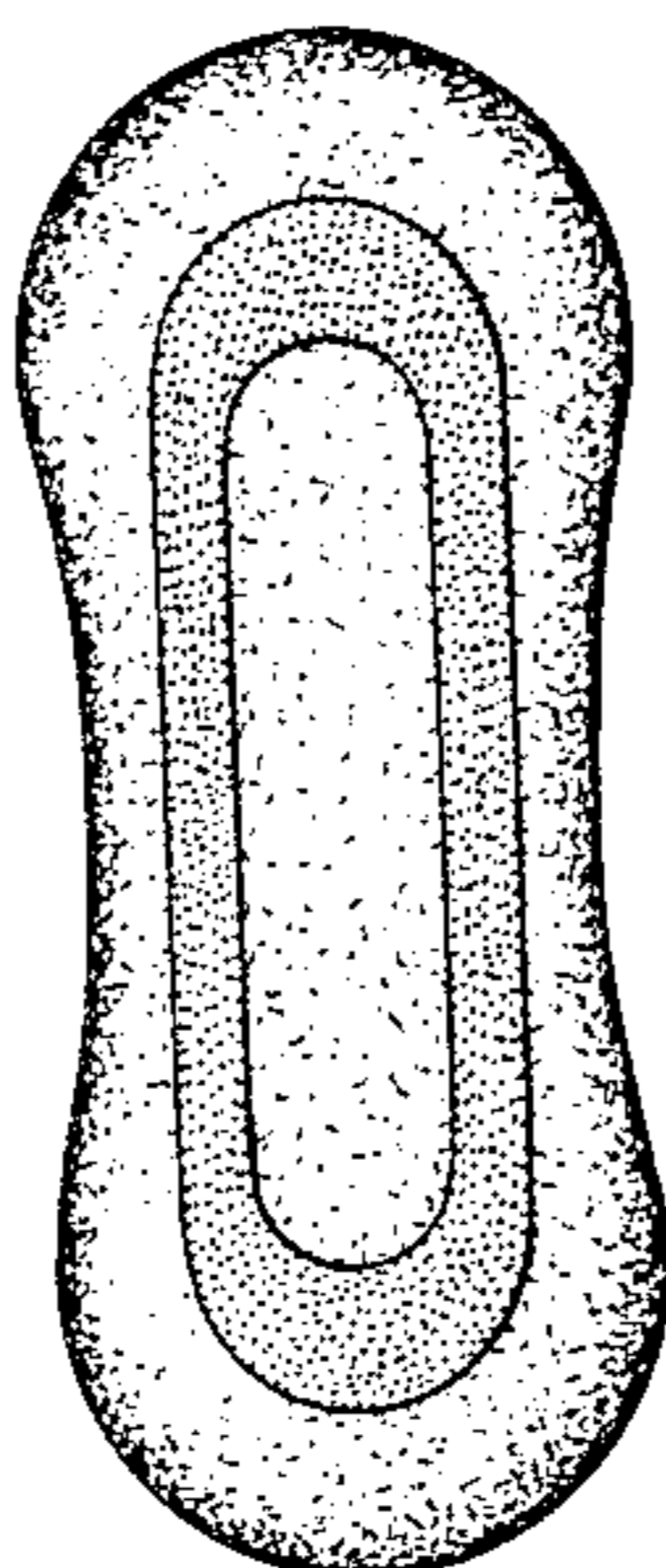

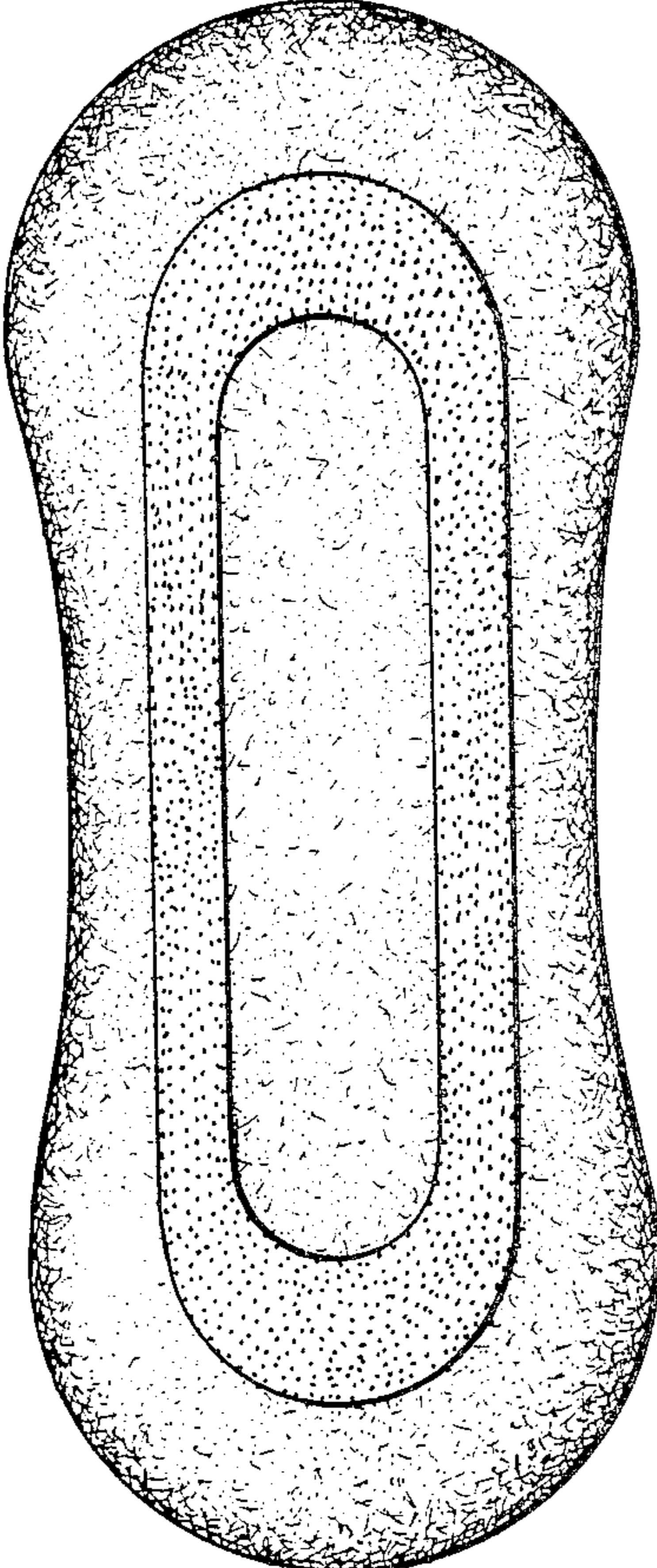

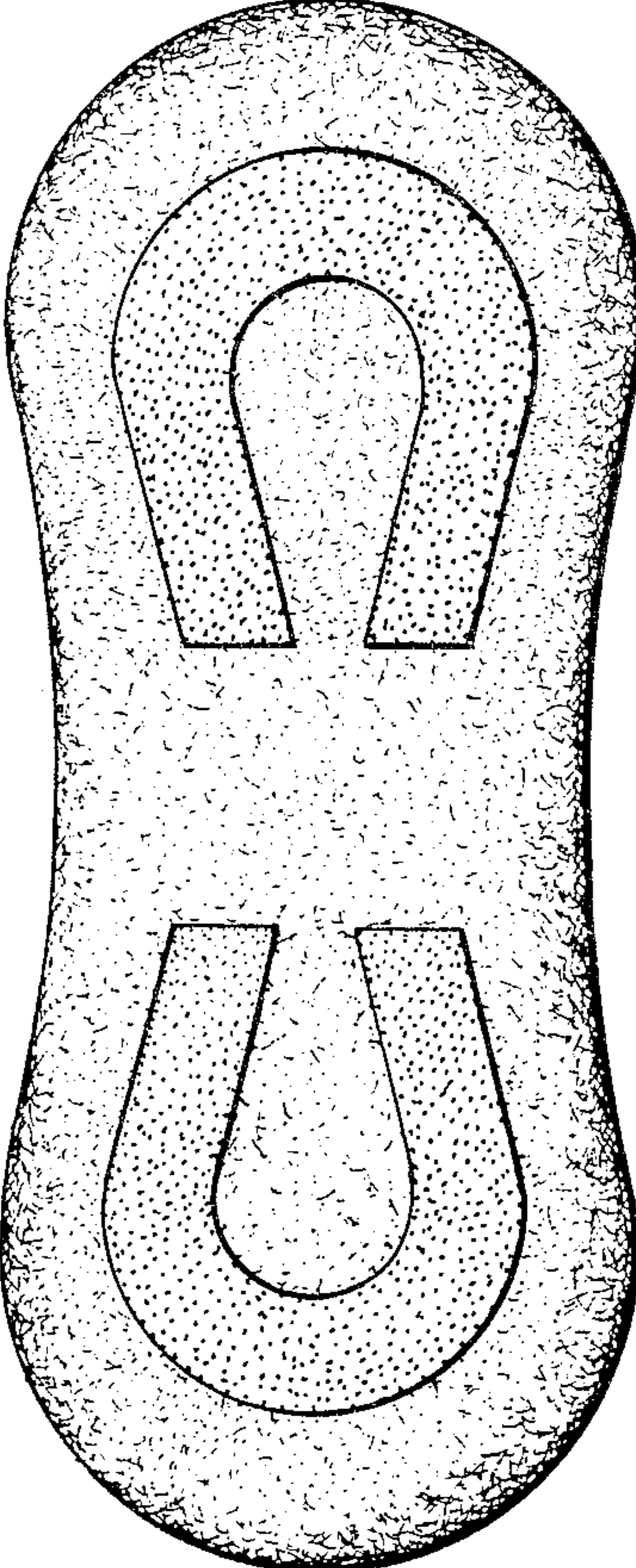

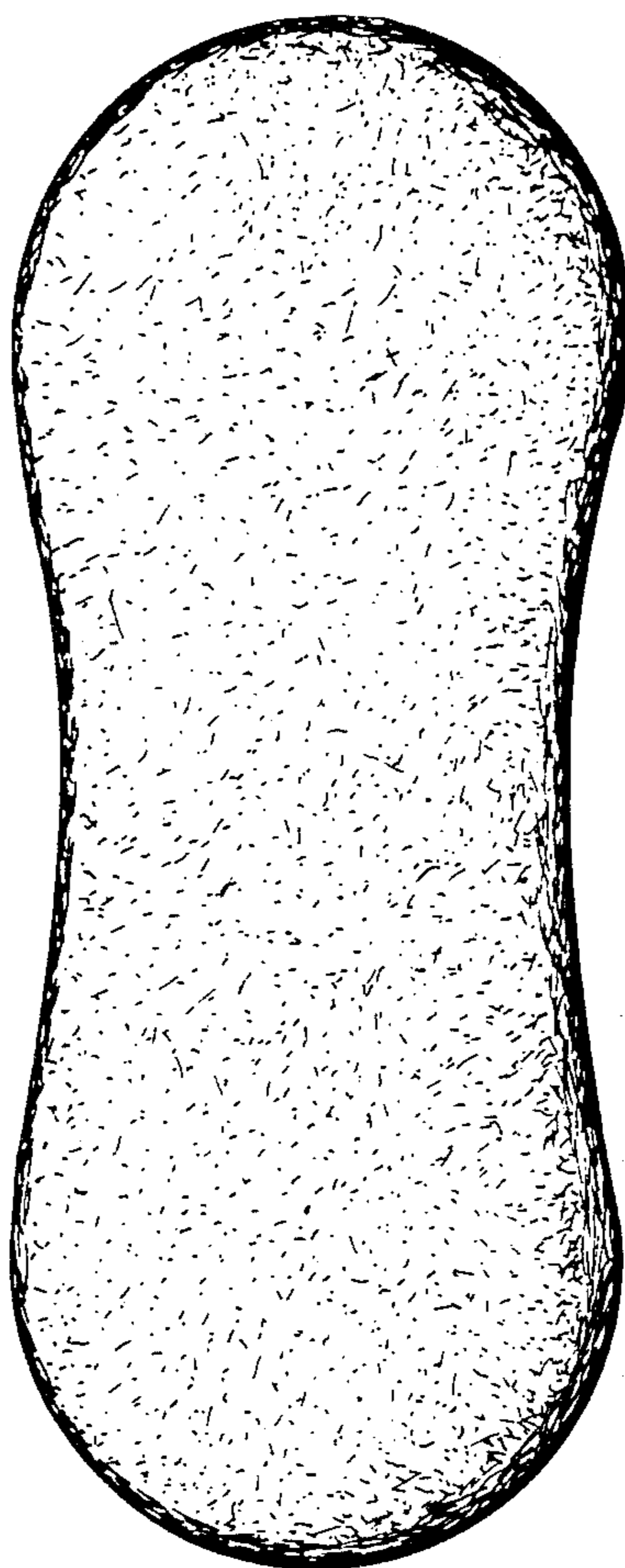
