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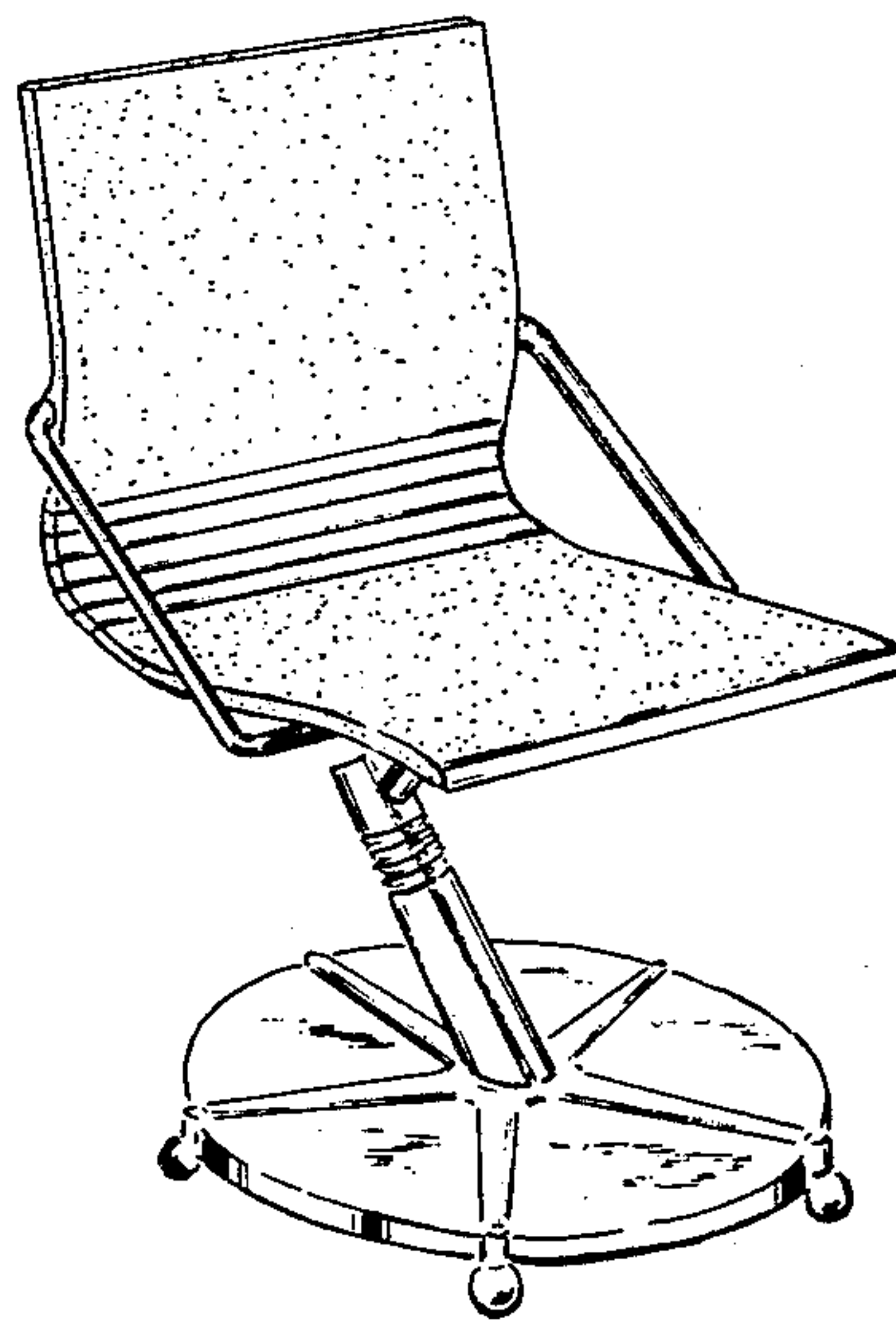

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair taken from slightly above showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view taken slightly from below;
FIG. 3 is a right side perspective view; and
FIG. 4 is a left side perspective view thereof.
The undisclosed rear surface of the chair is conventional in appearance.



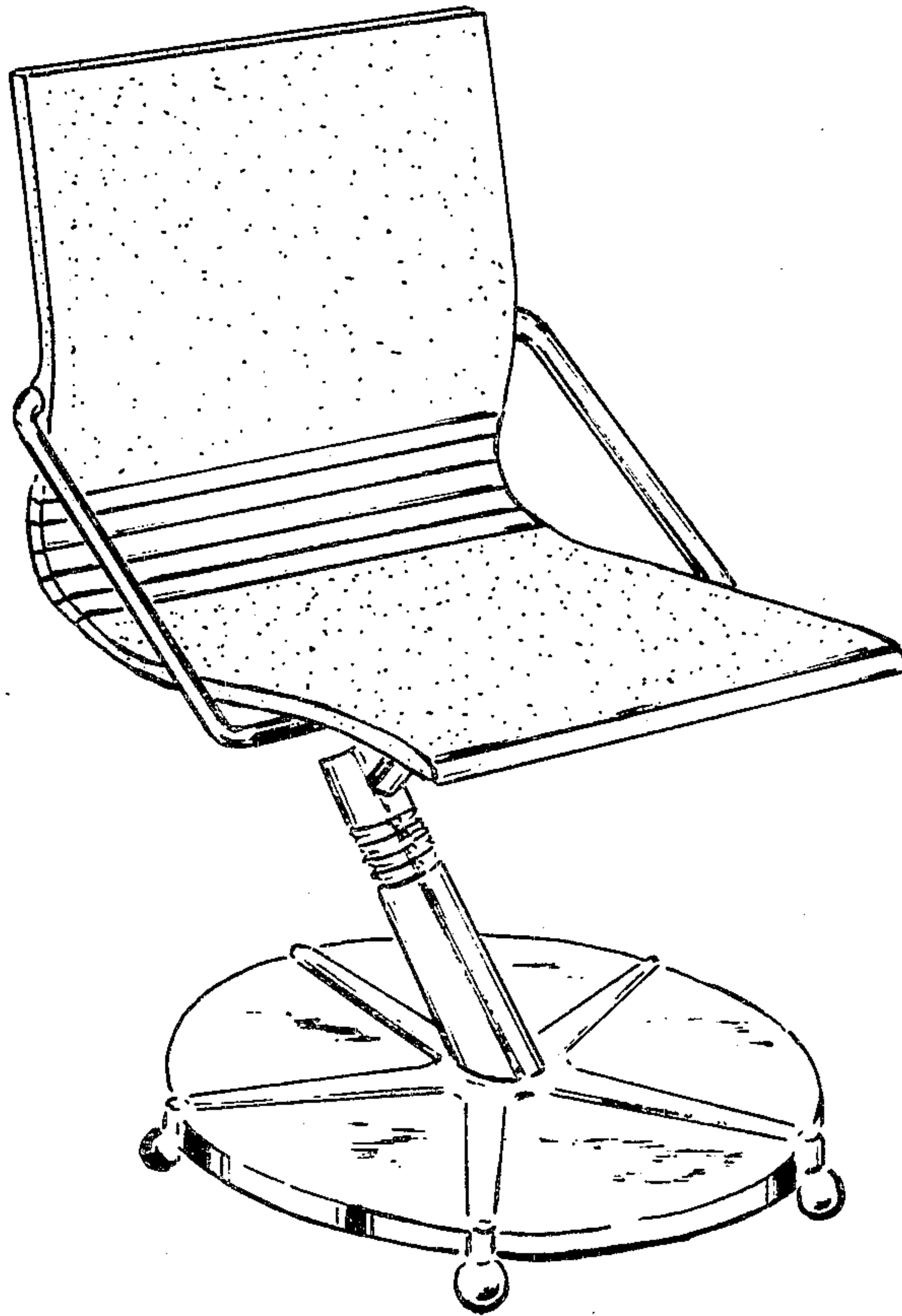

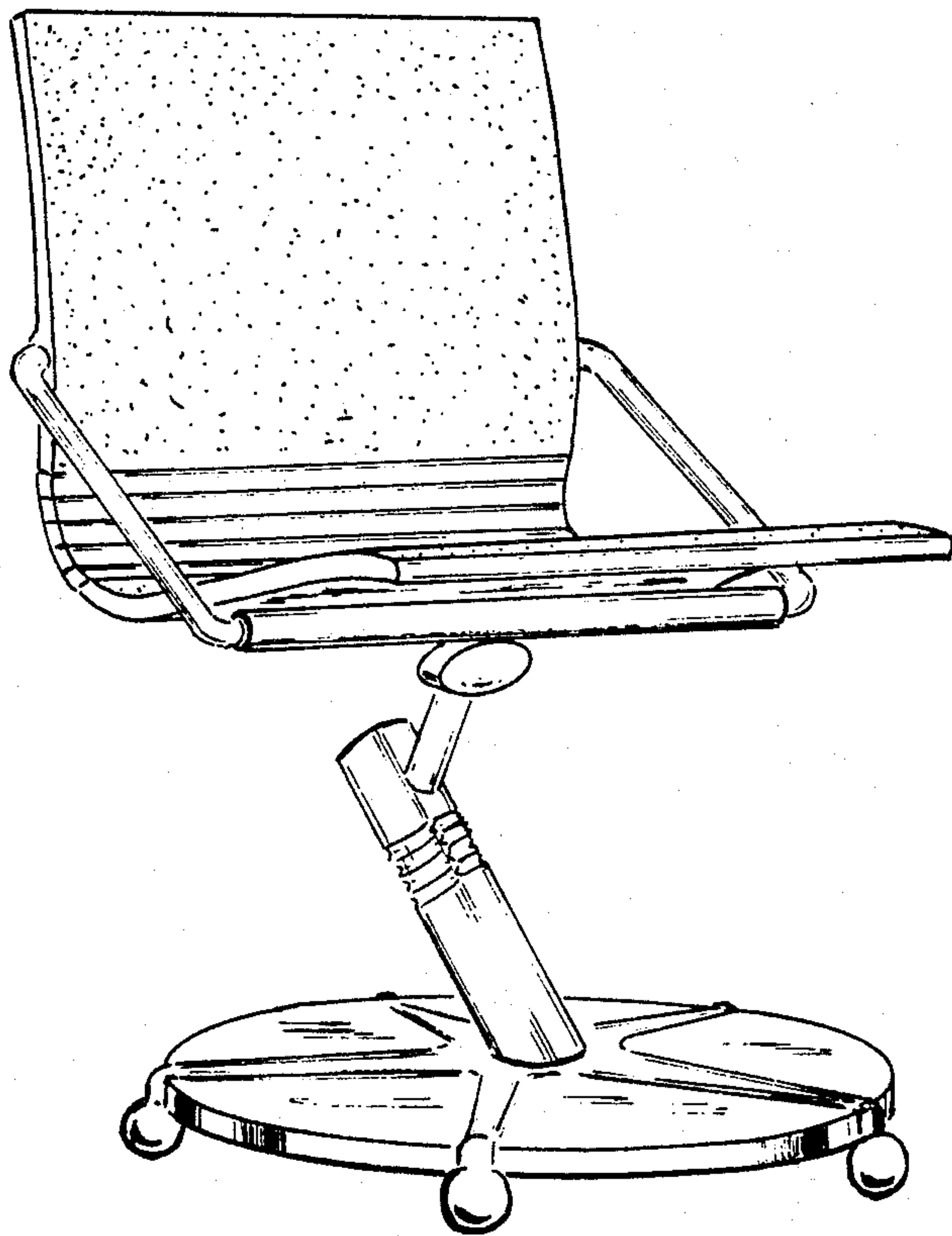

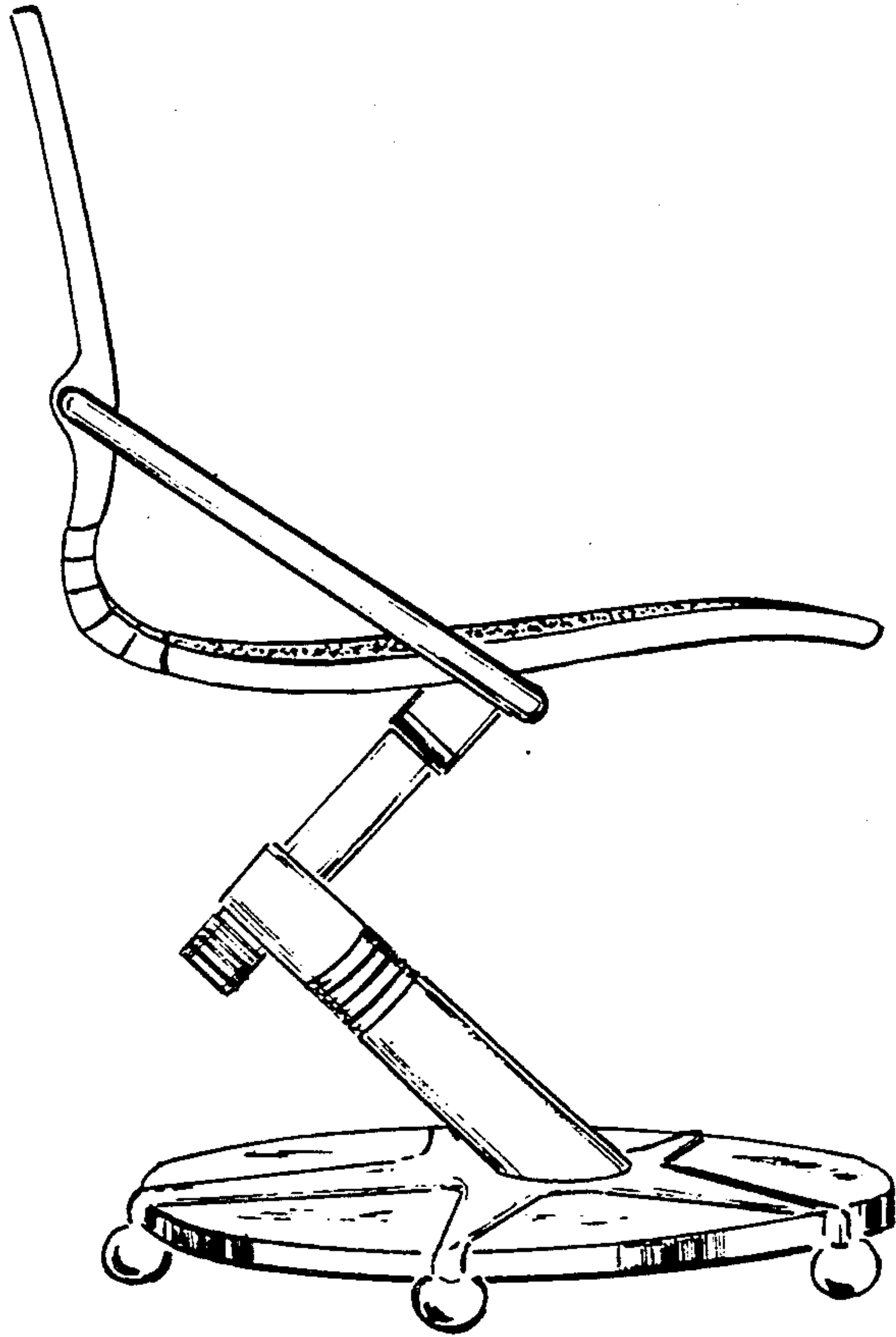

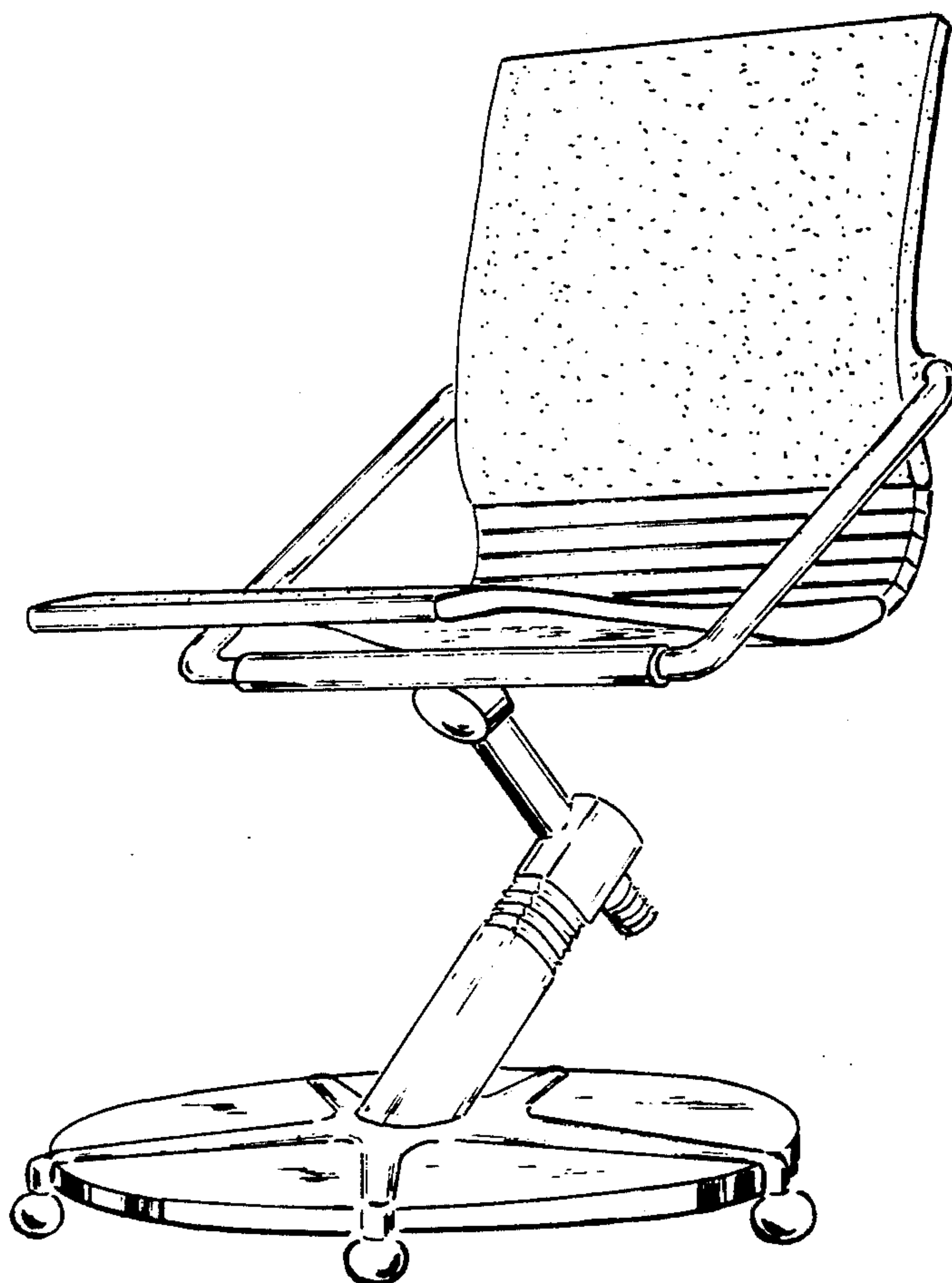
