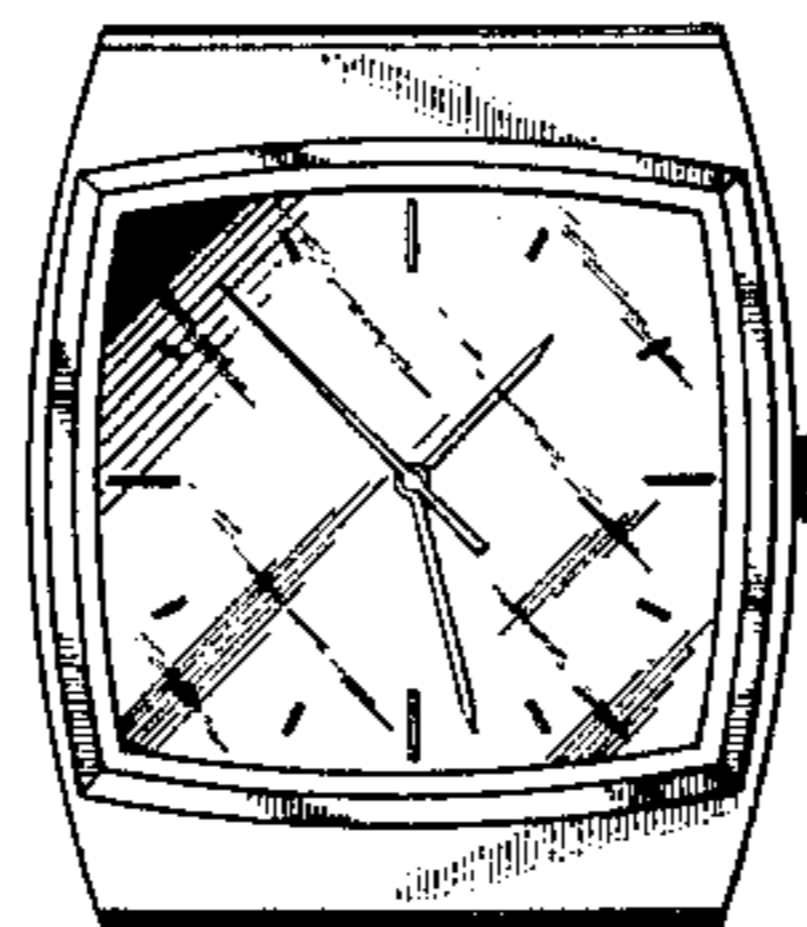
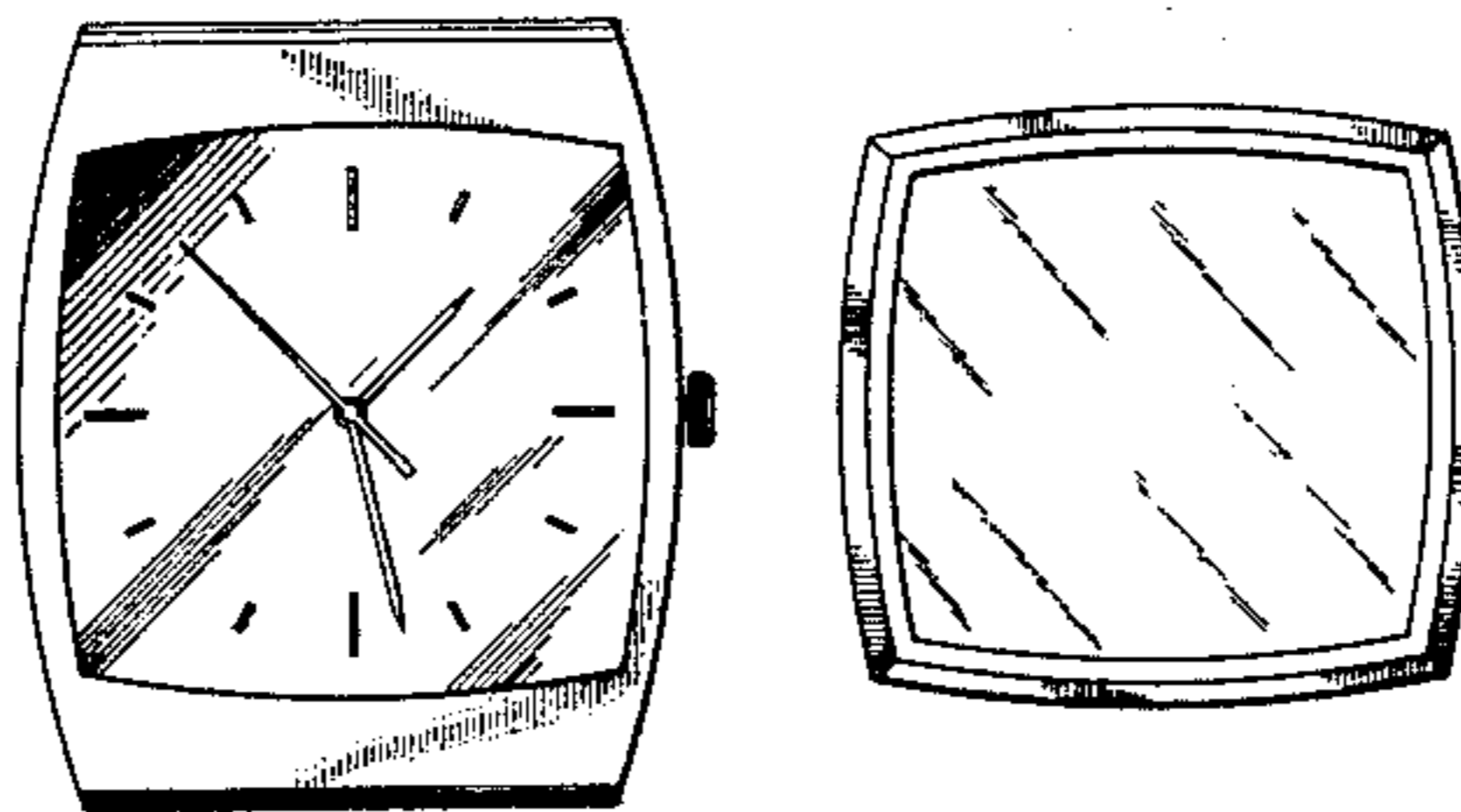

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined watch and mirror, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined watch and mirror showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 shows the mirror on the face of the watch with the crystal removed.



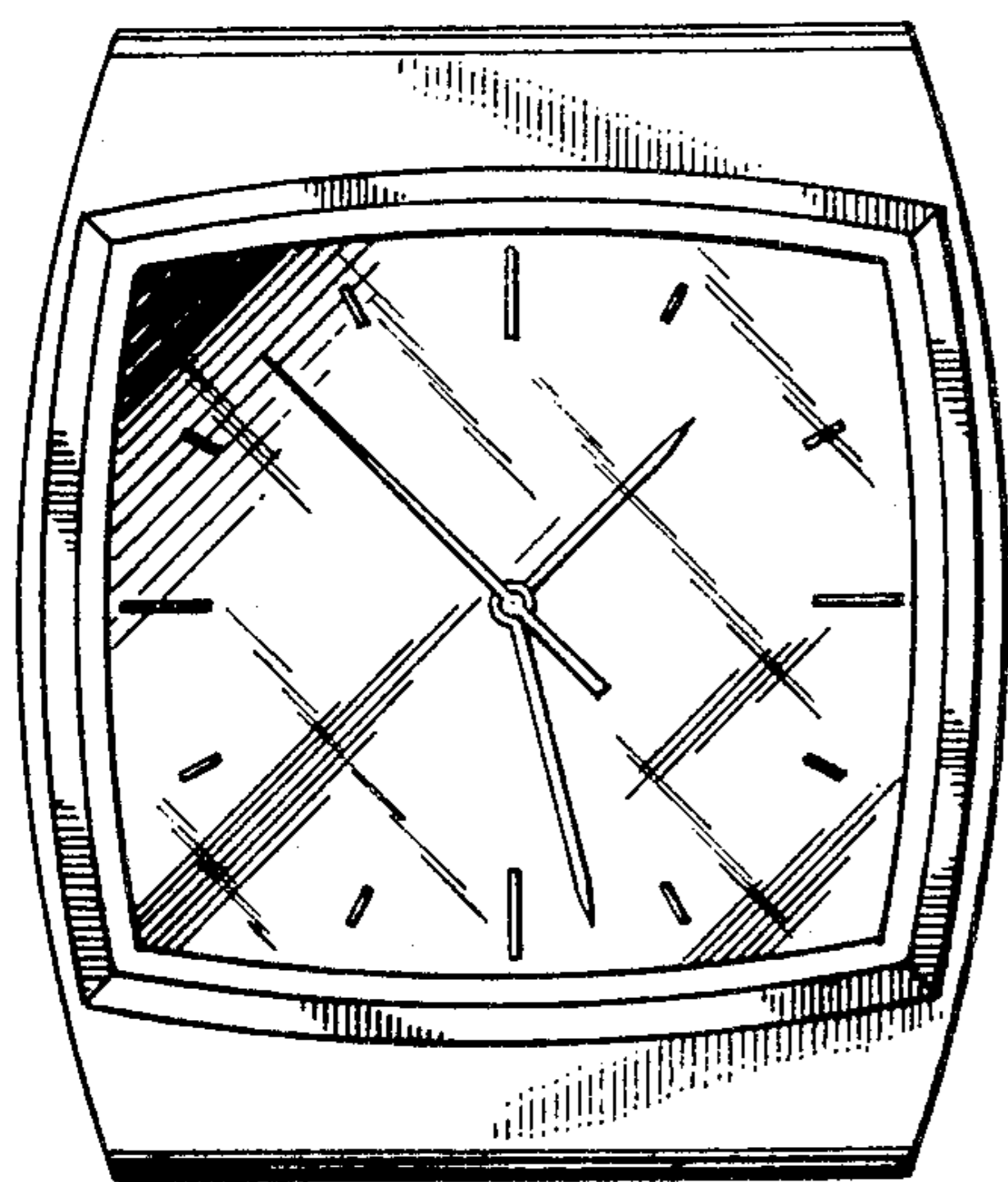

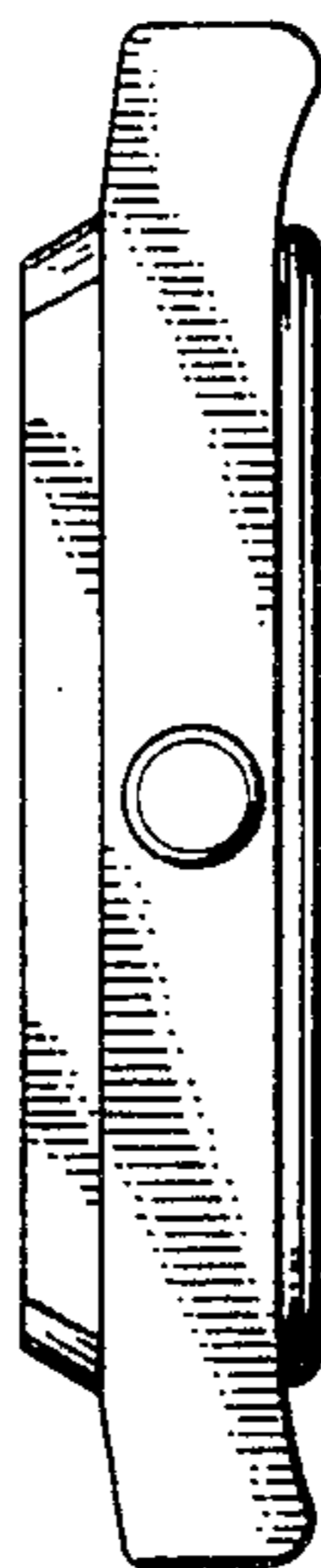

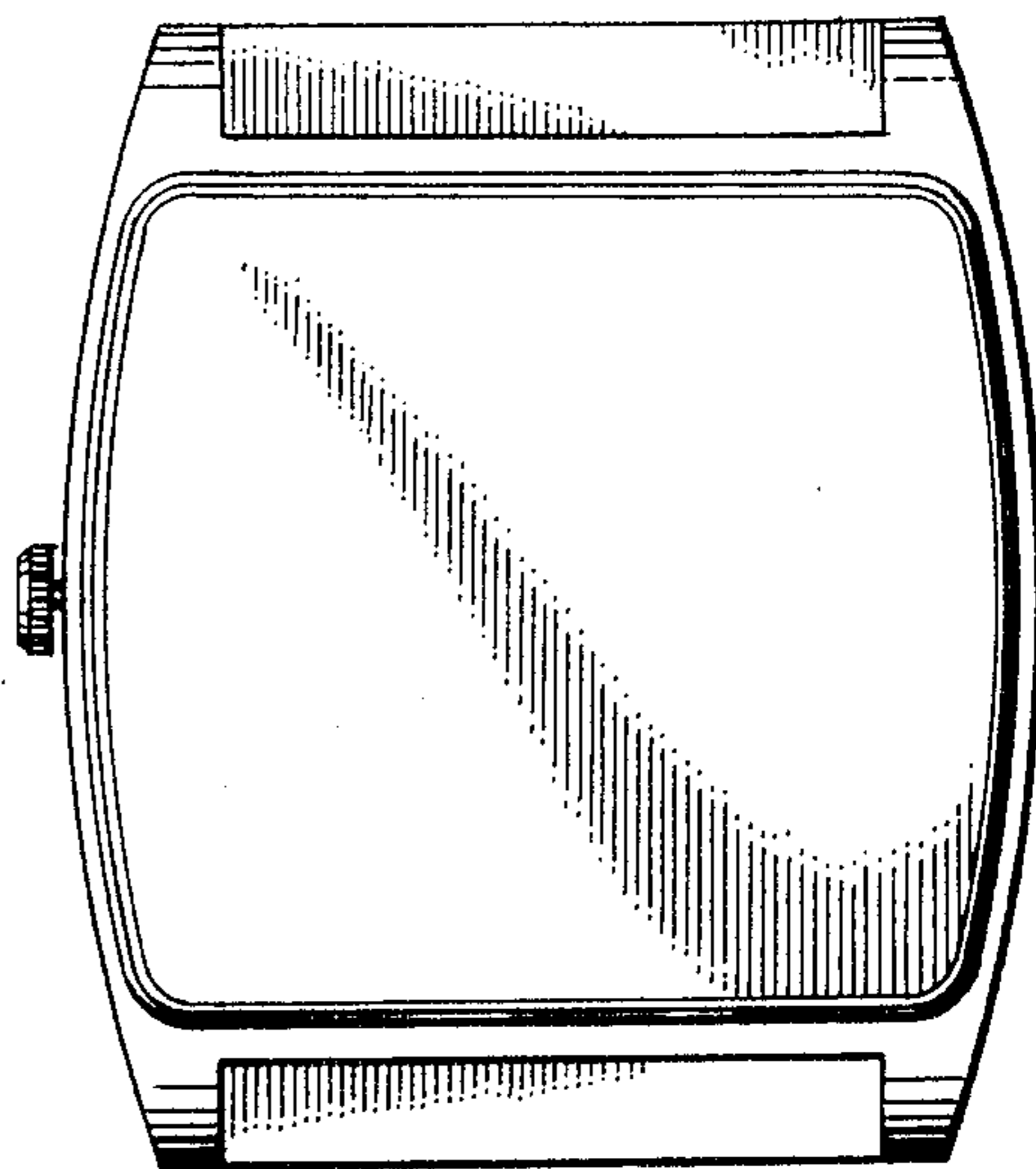

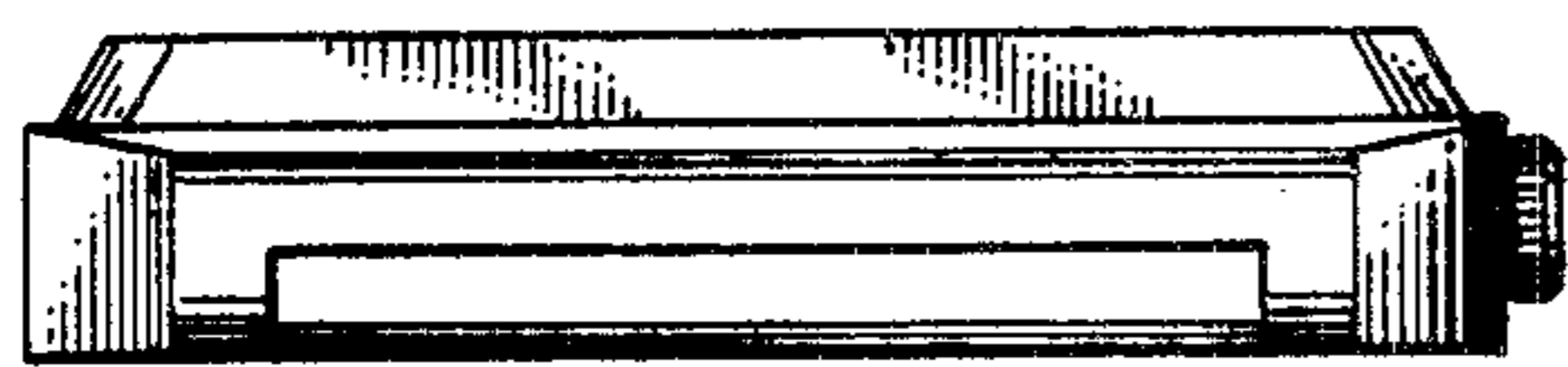

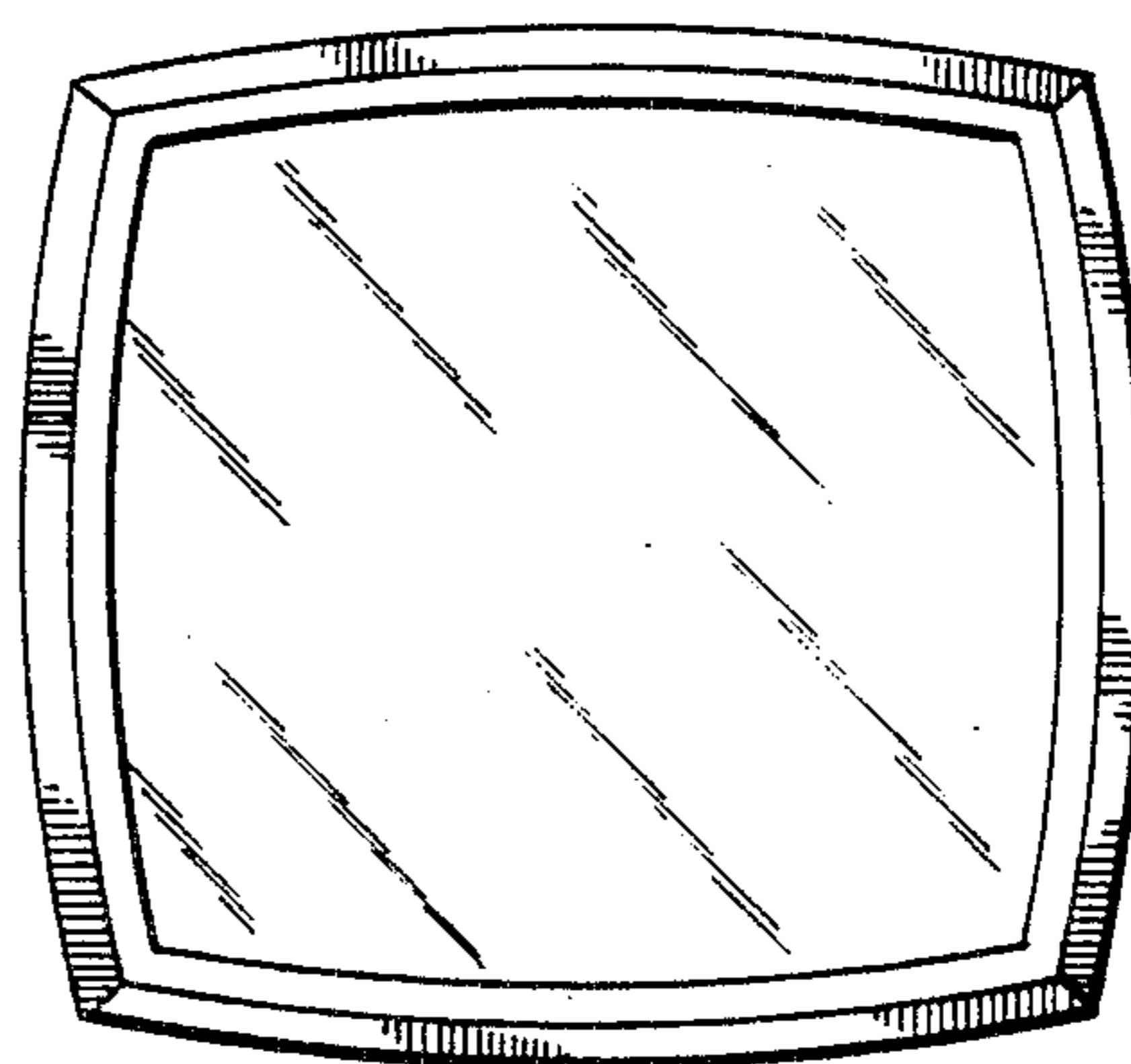
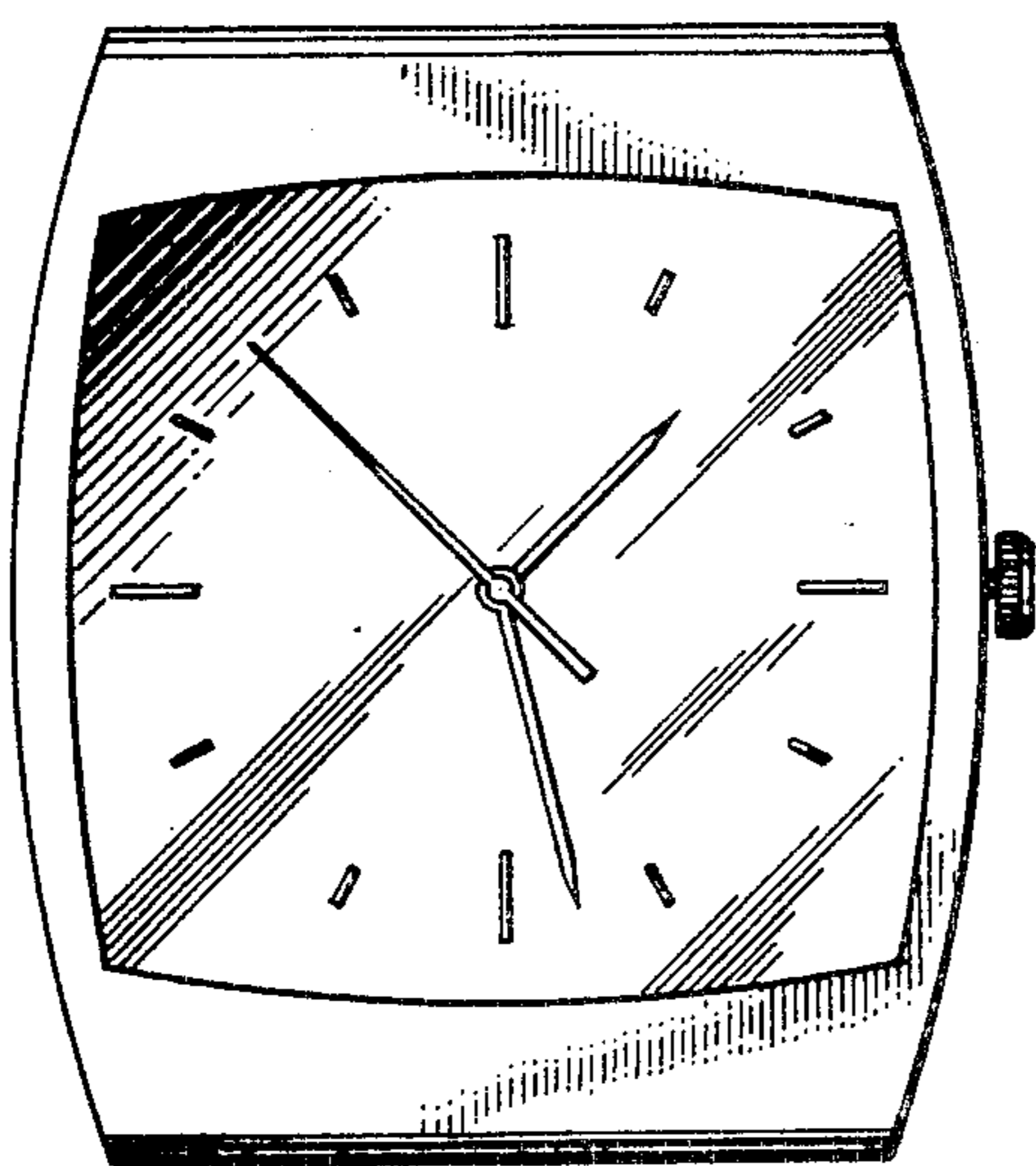
