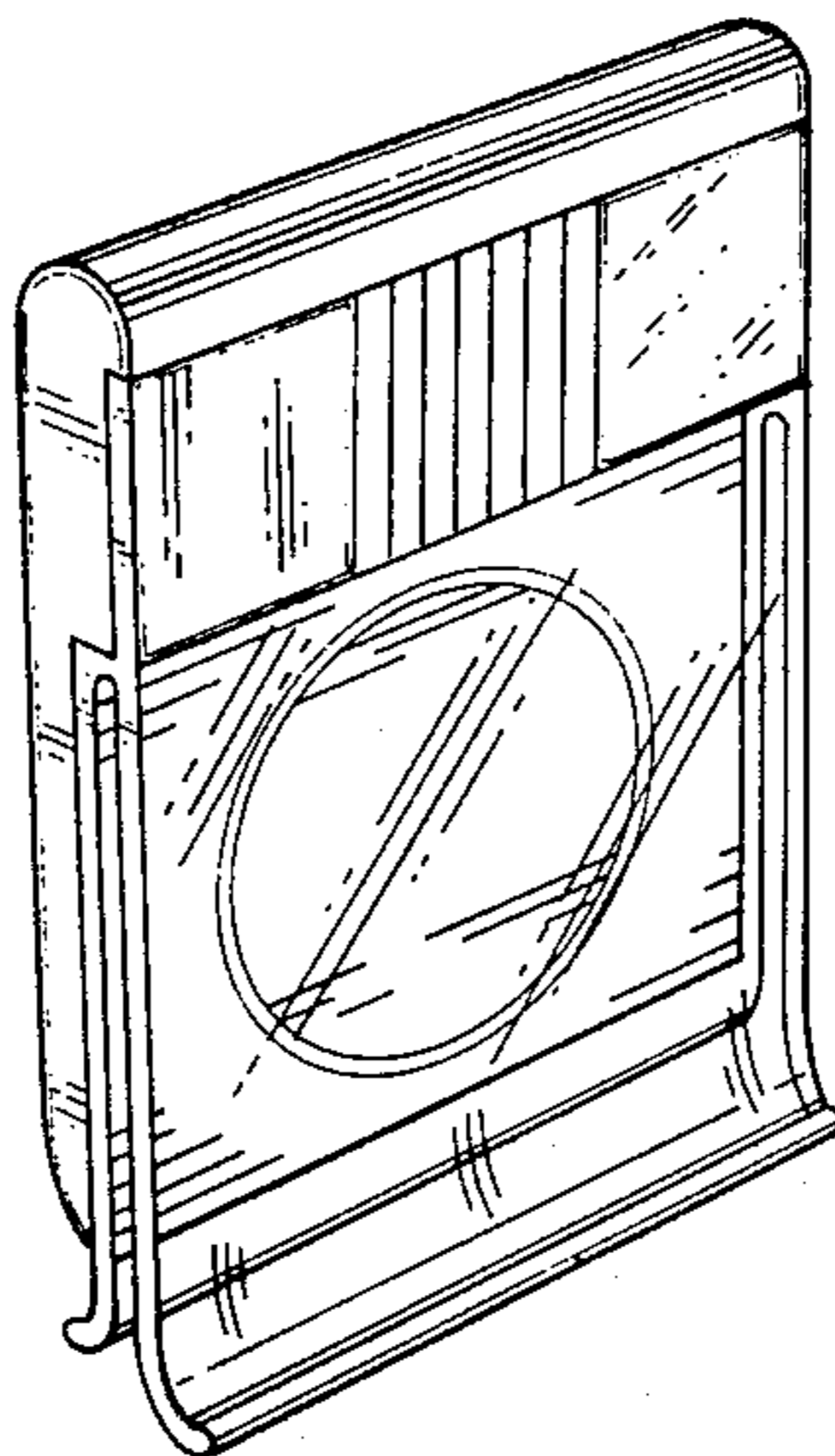

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and side perspective view of a combined tape player and photograph display therefor showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



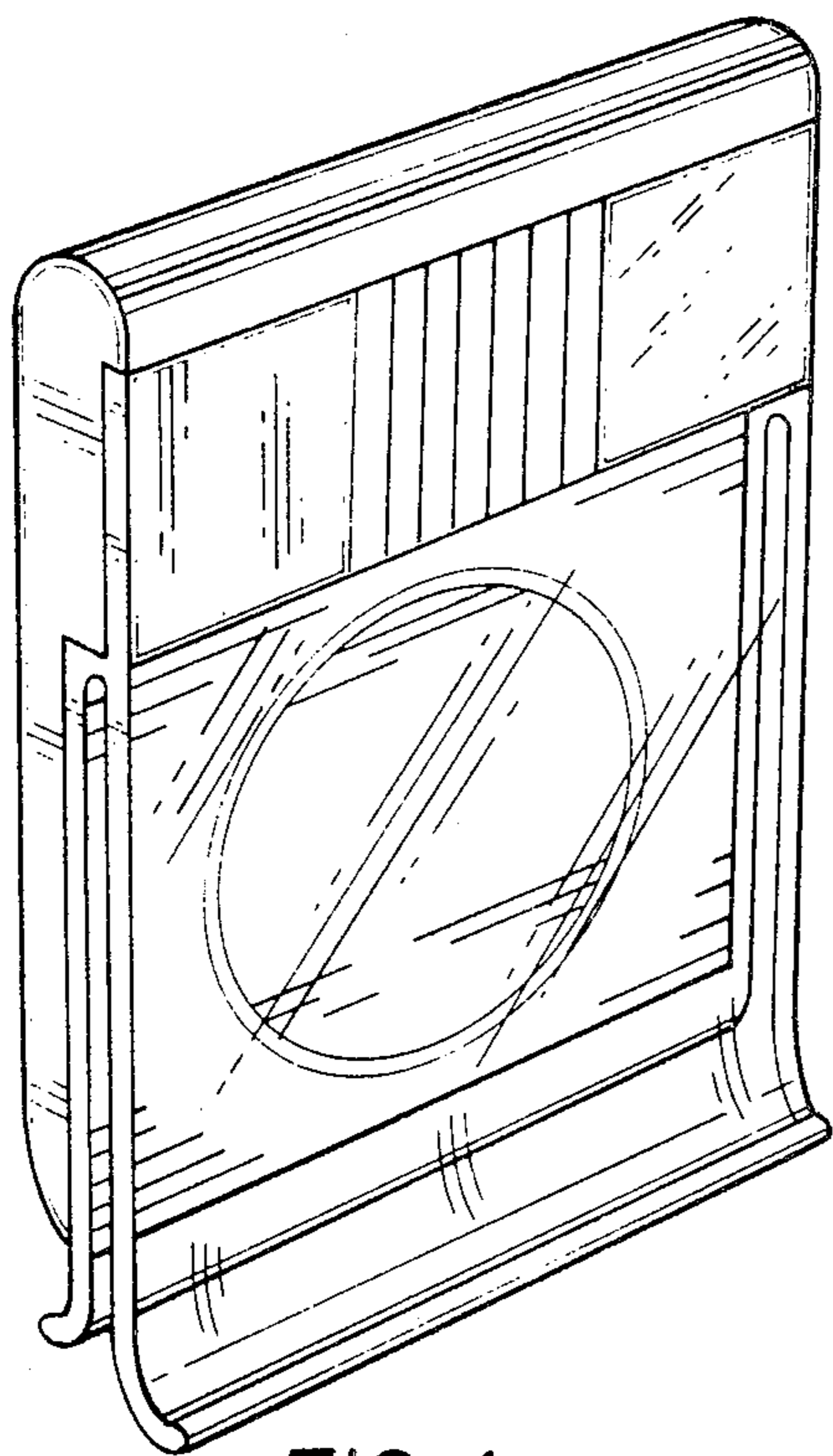

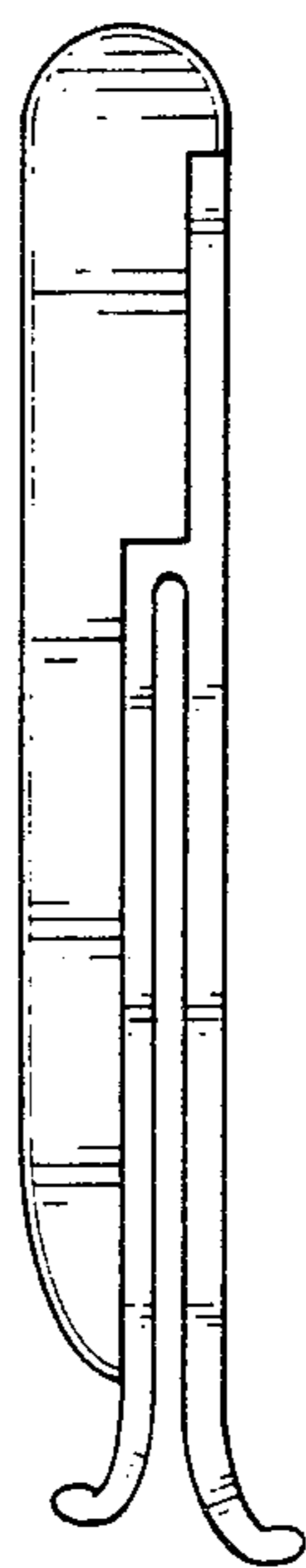

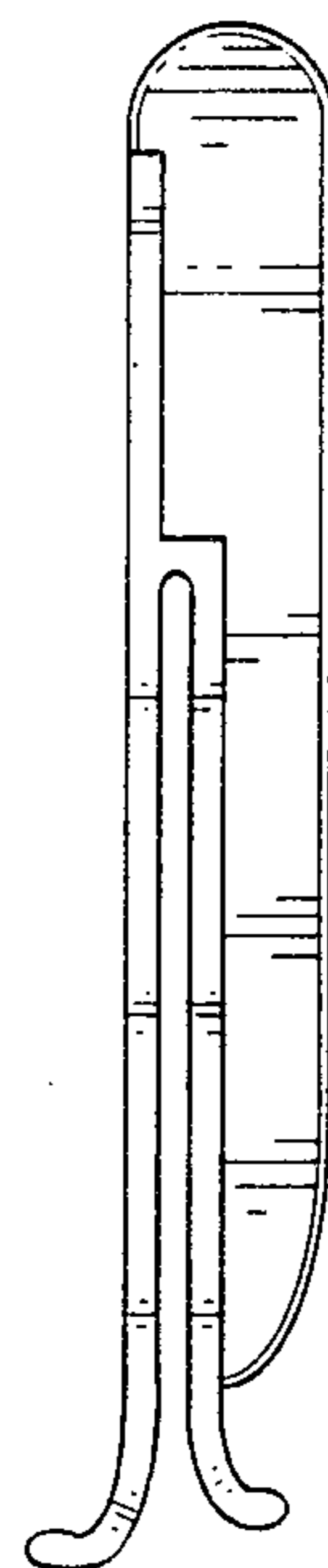

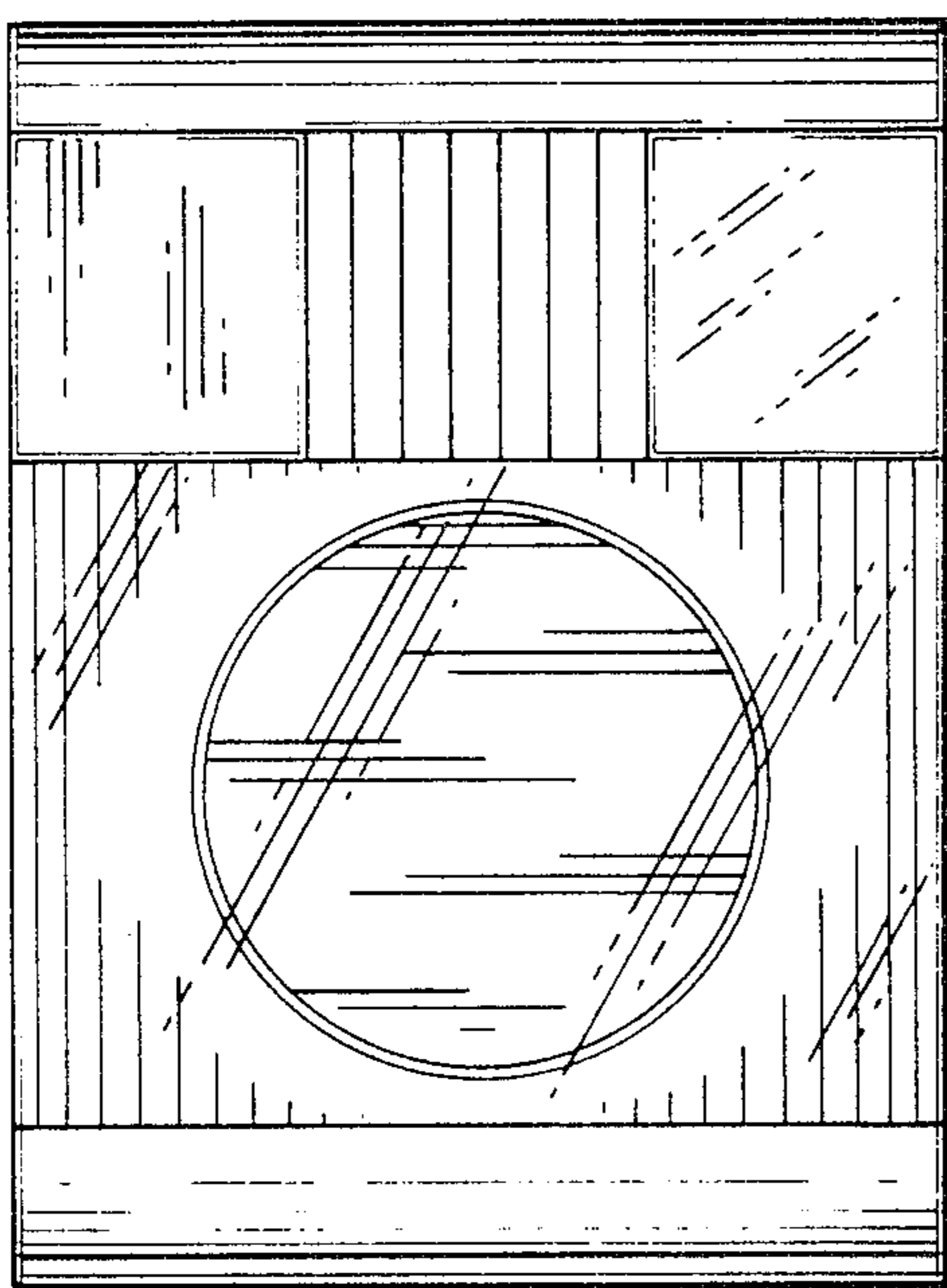

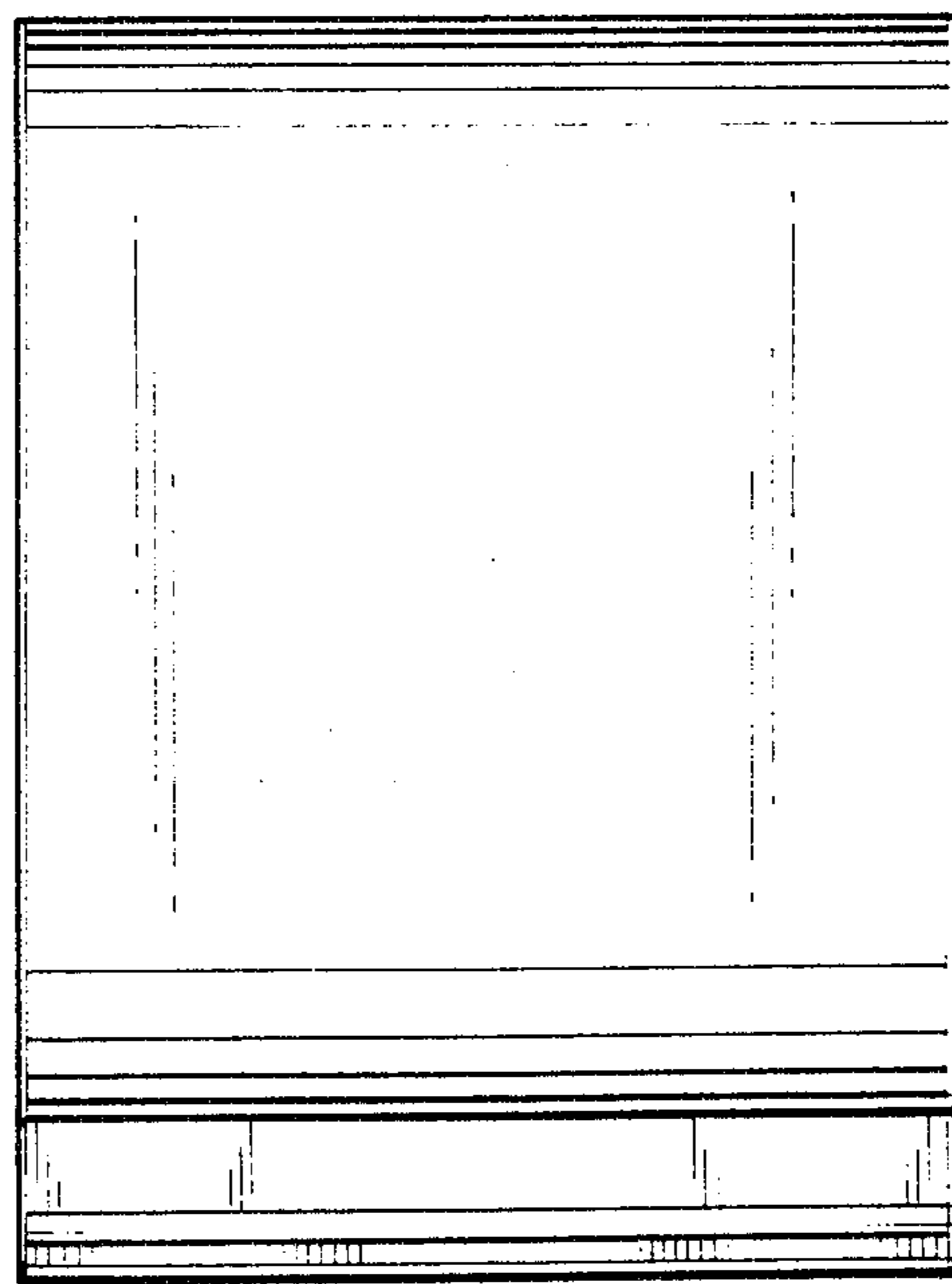

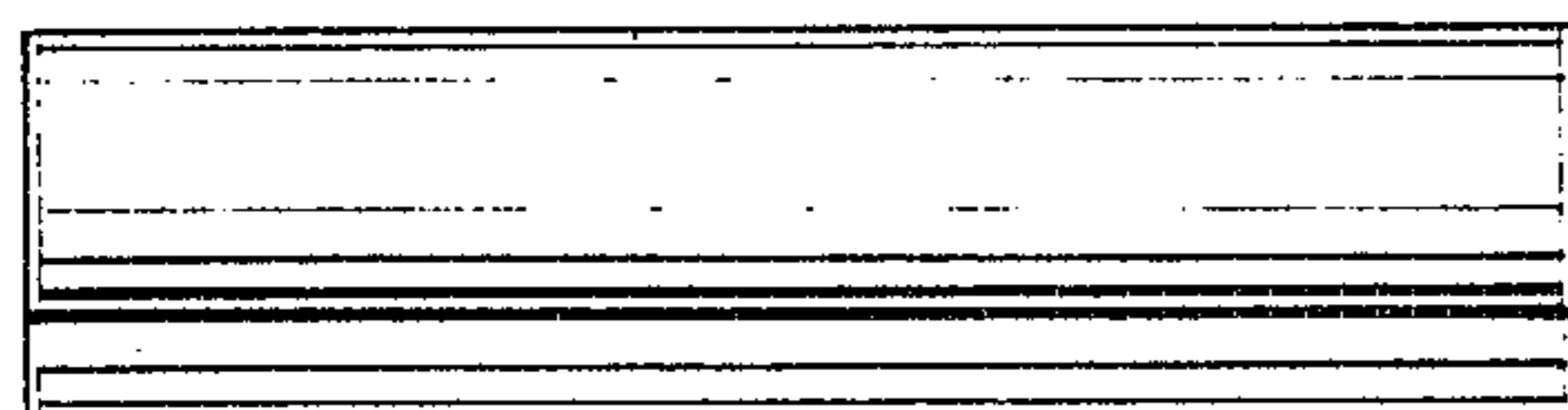

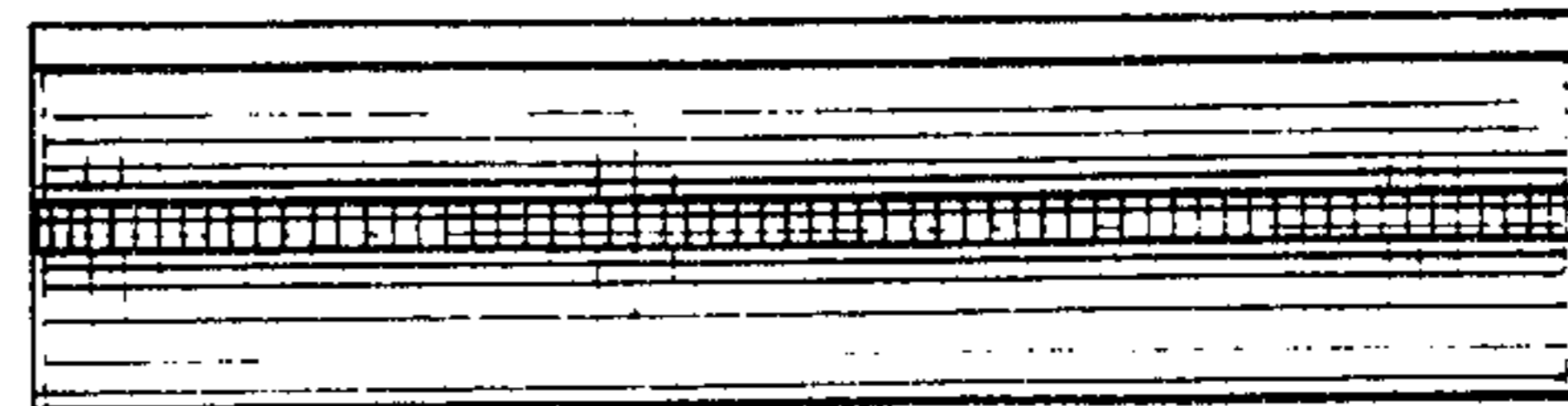
