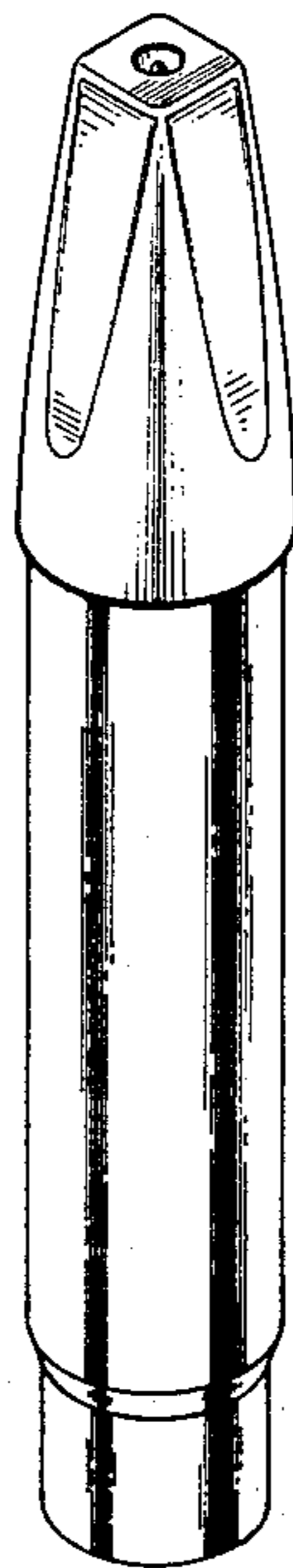
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.



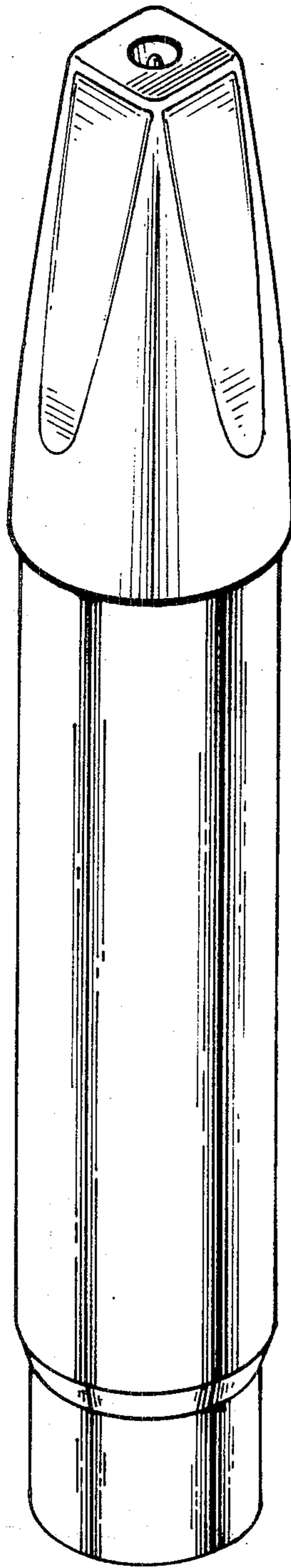

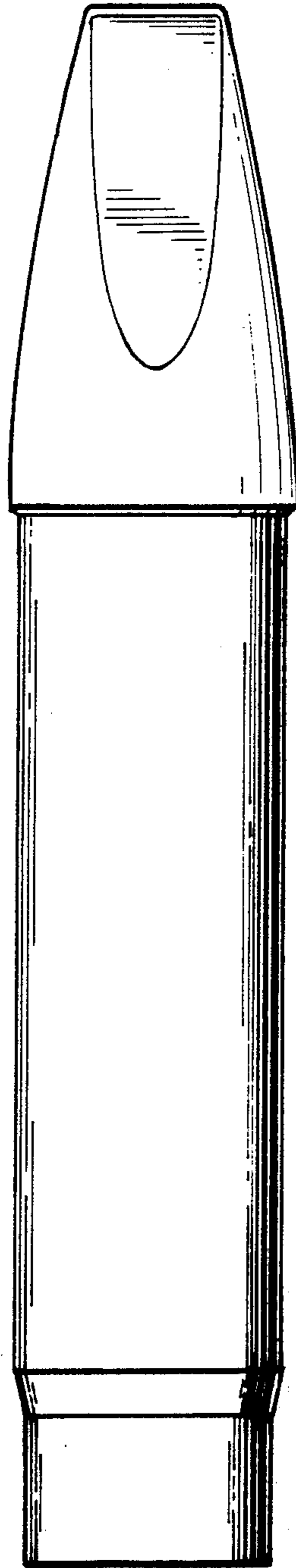
