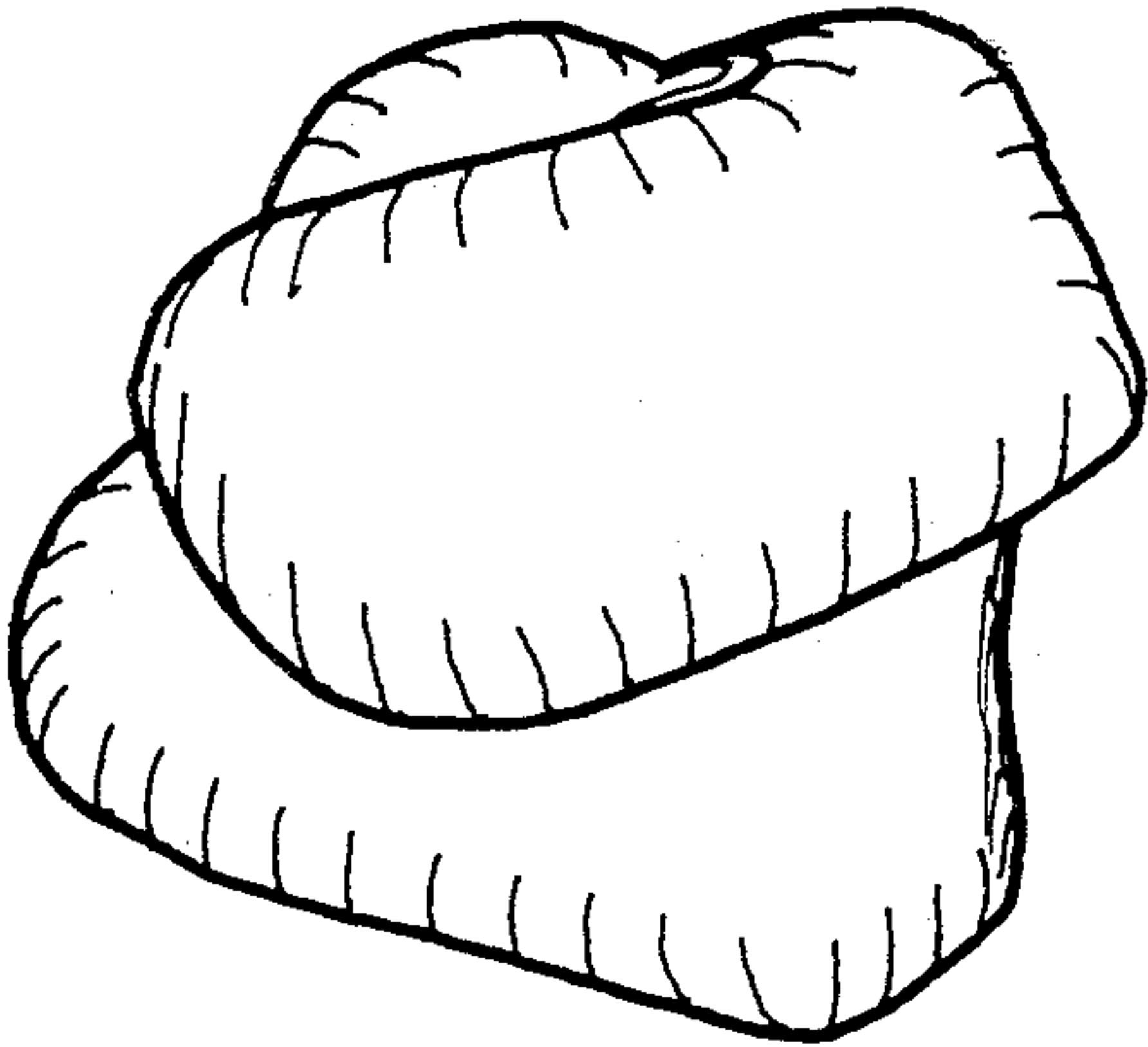

FIG. 3 is a bottom left perspective view thereof.



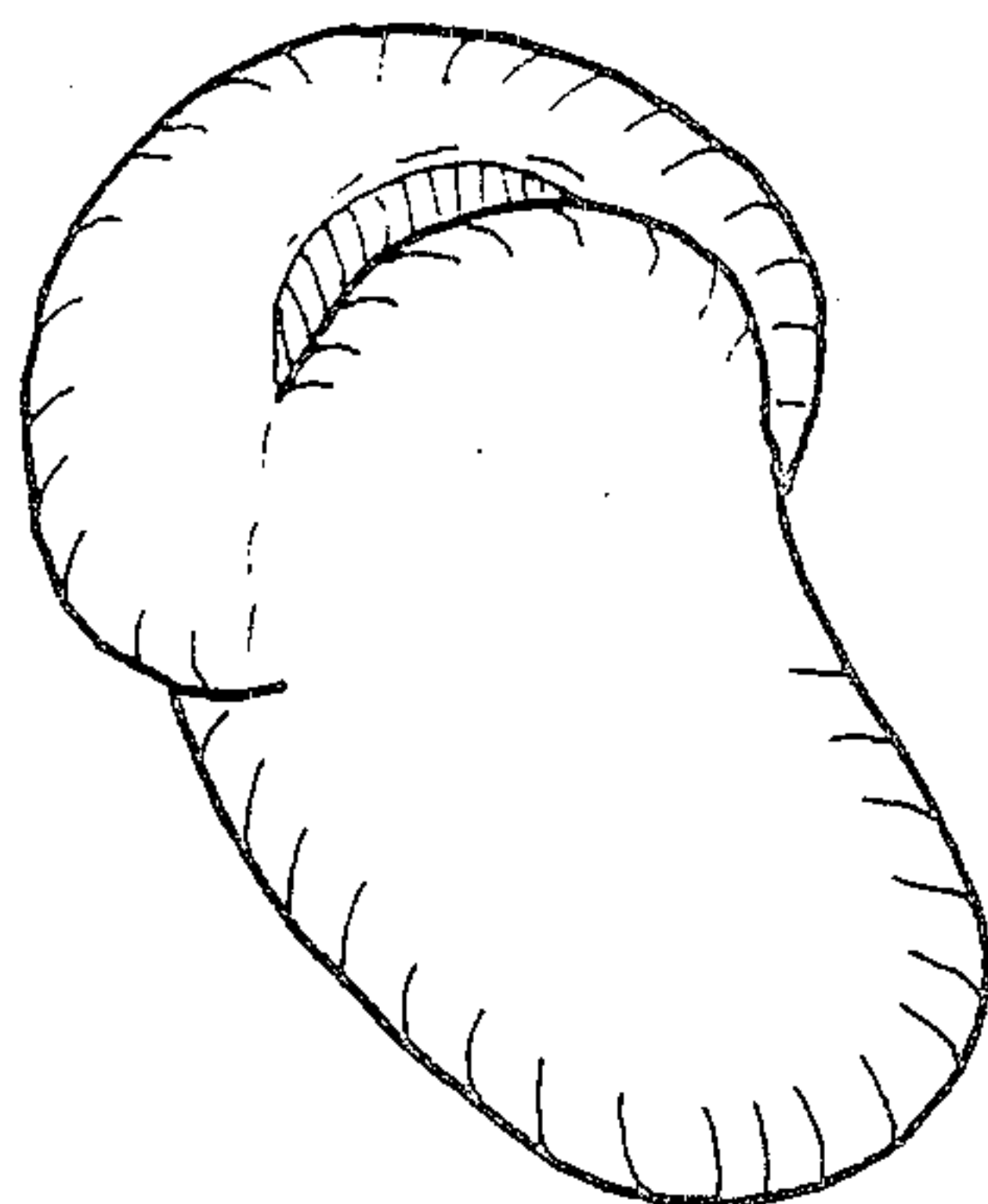

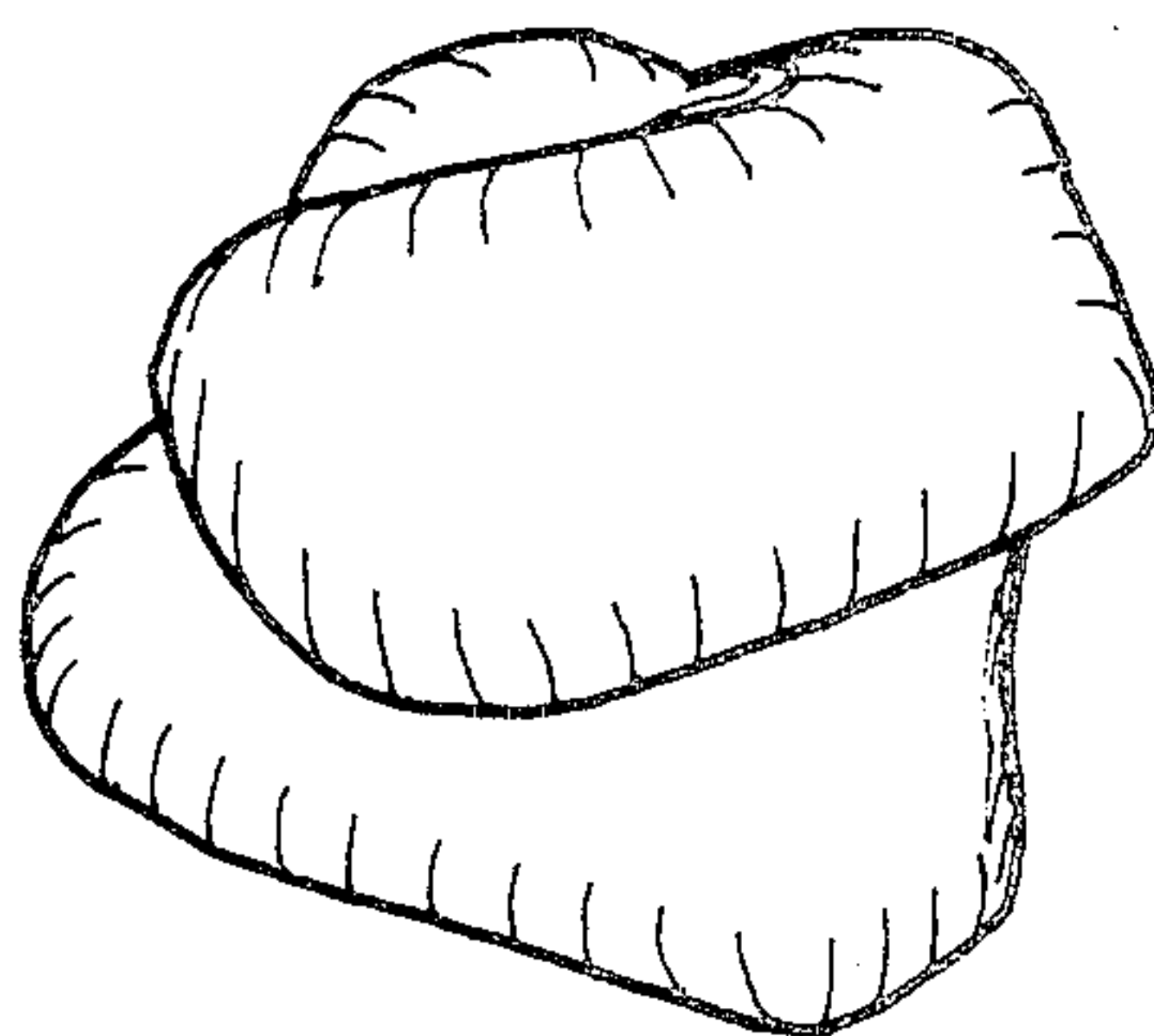

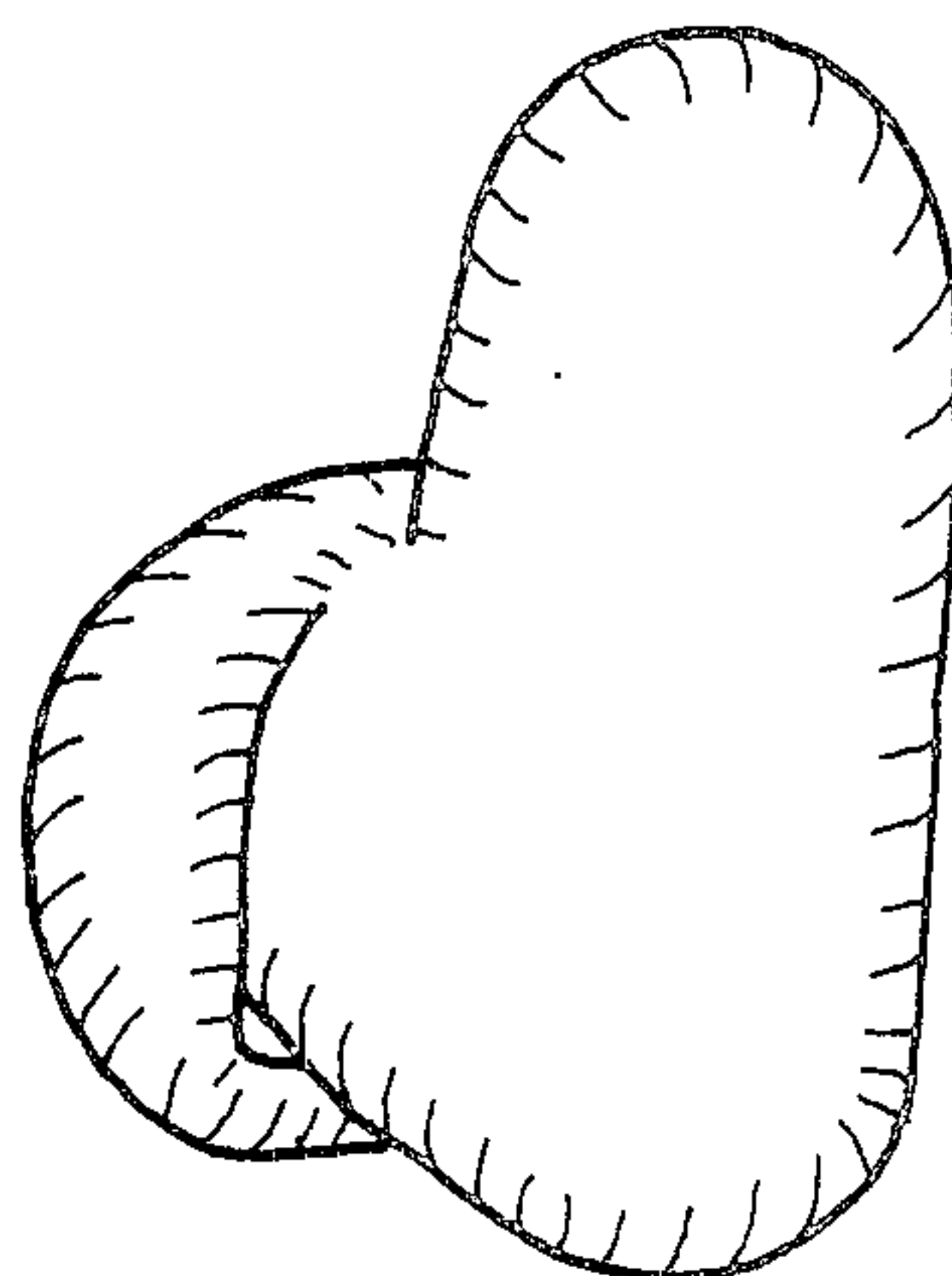
