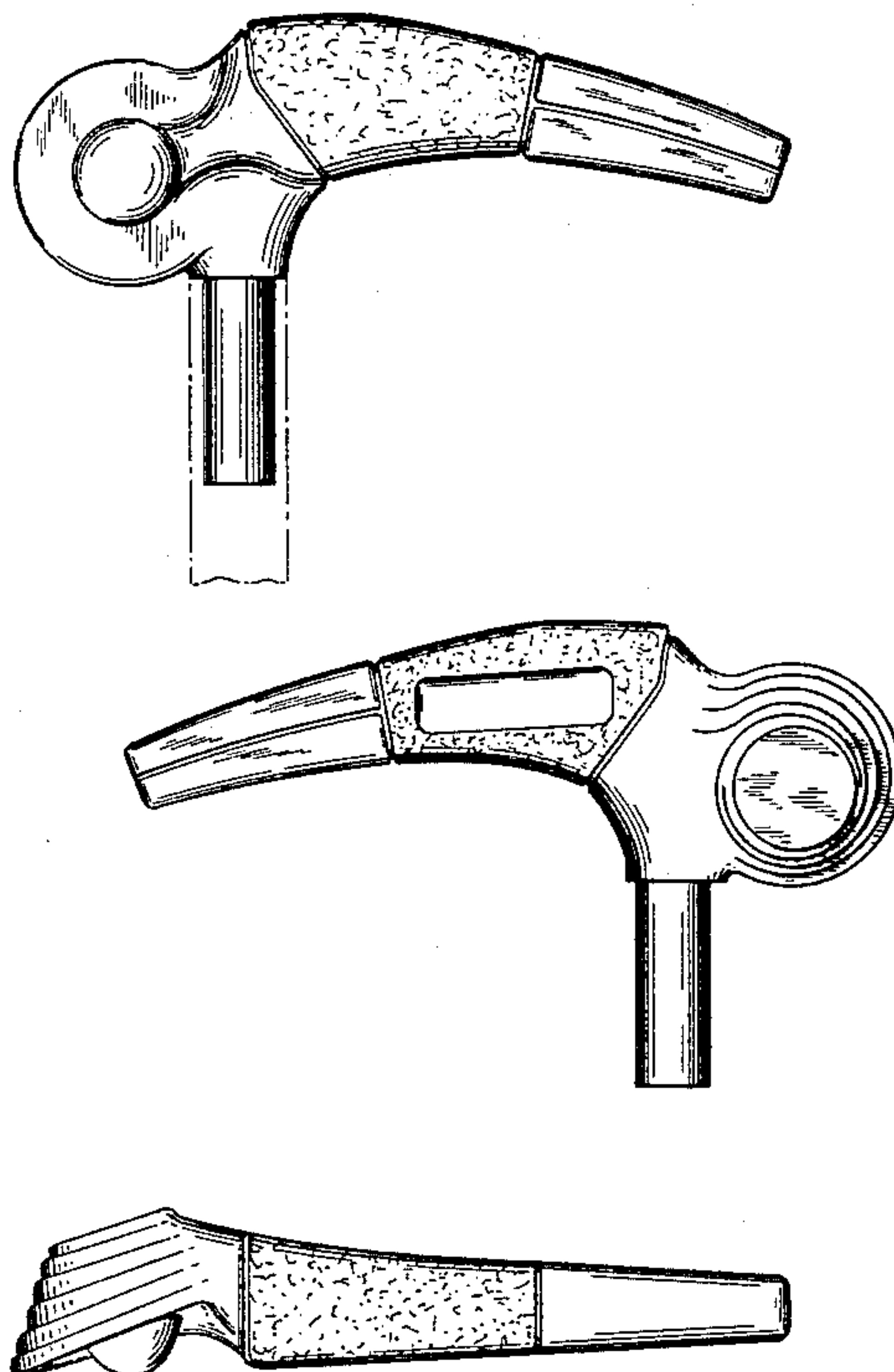

The ornamental design for a cane handle, substantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a Cane Handle showing my new design, the cane shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



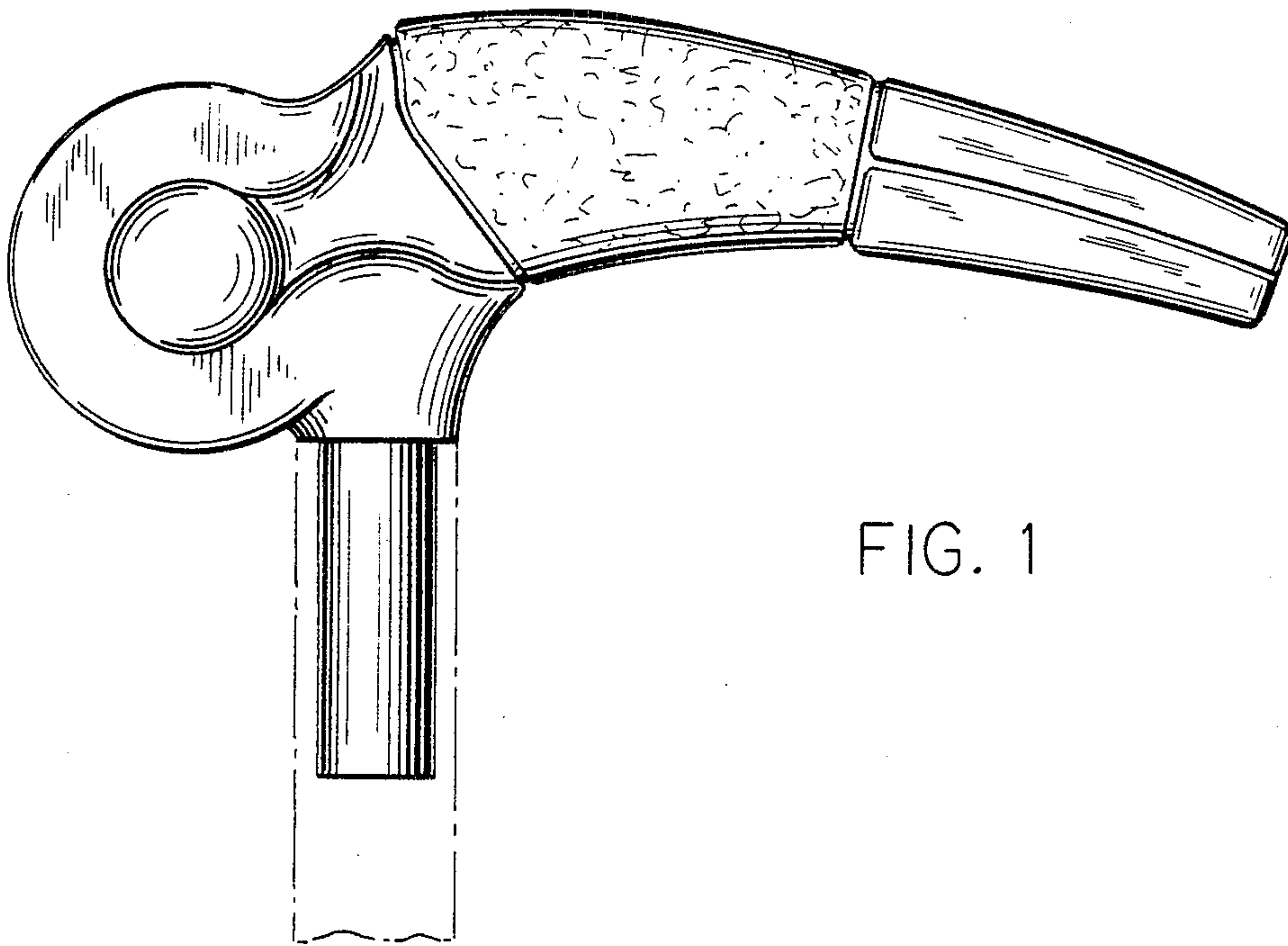

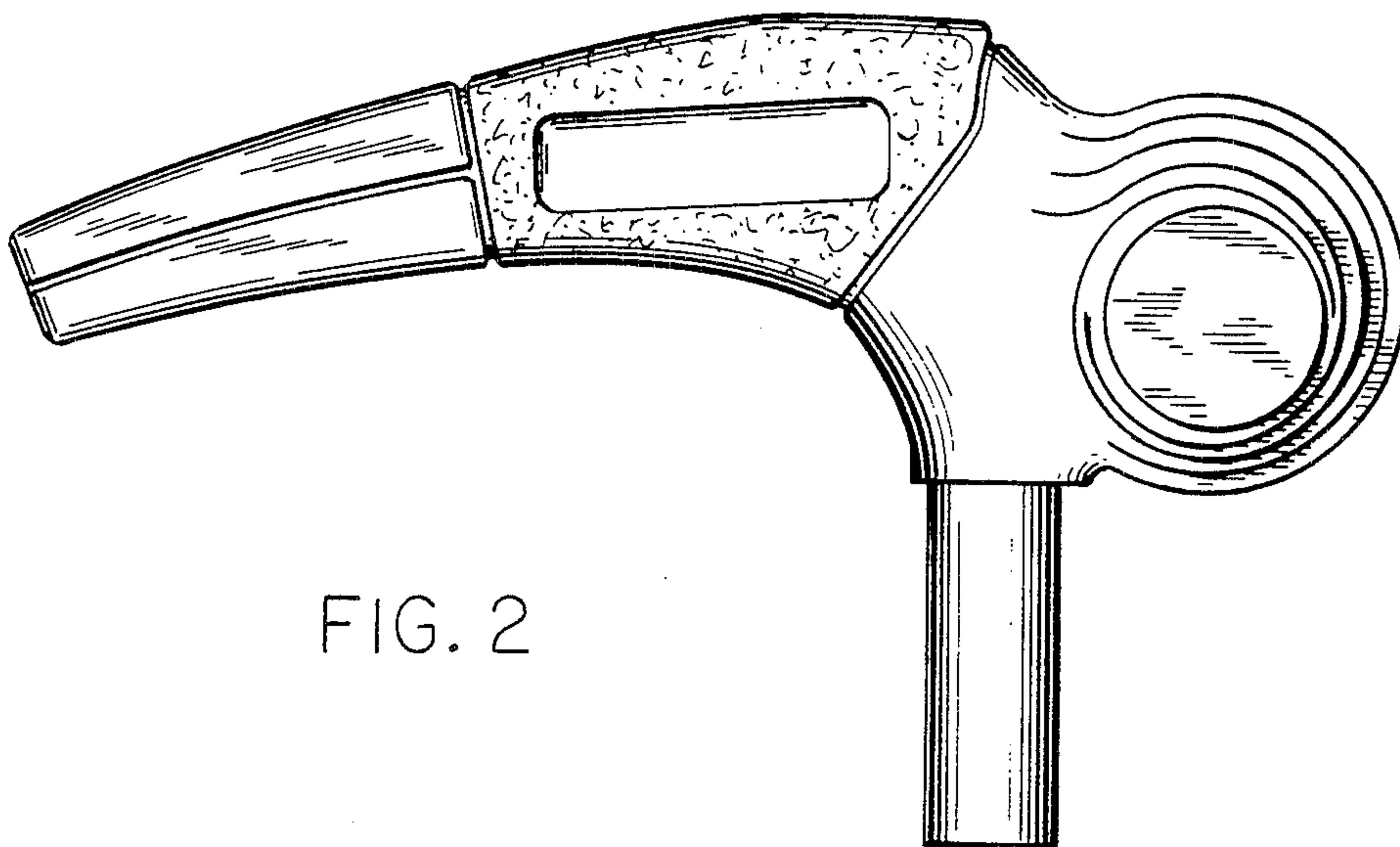

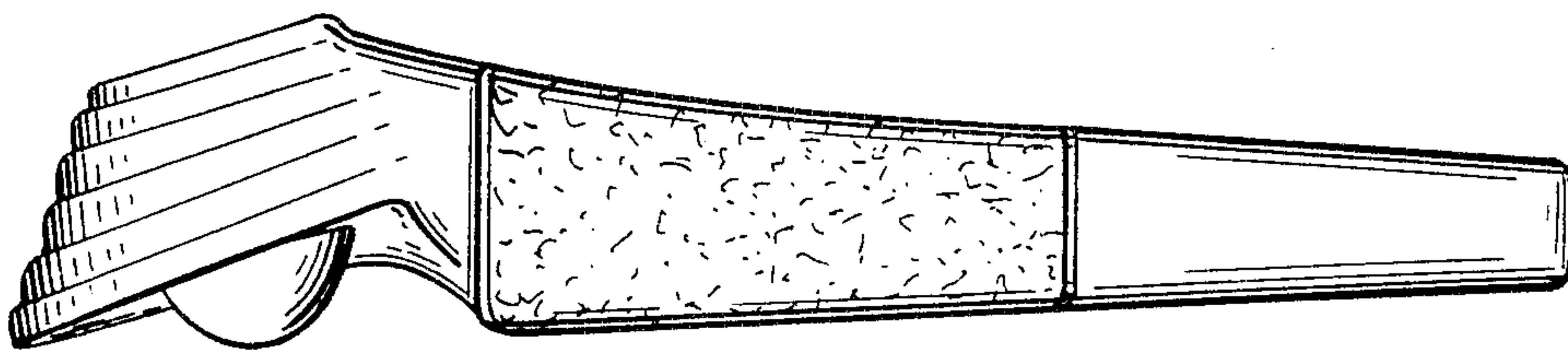

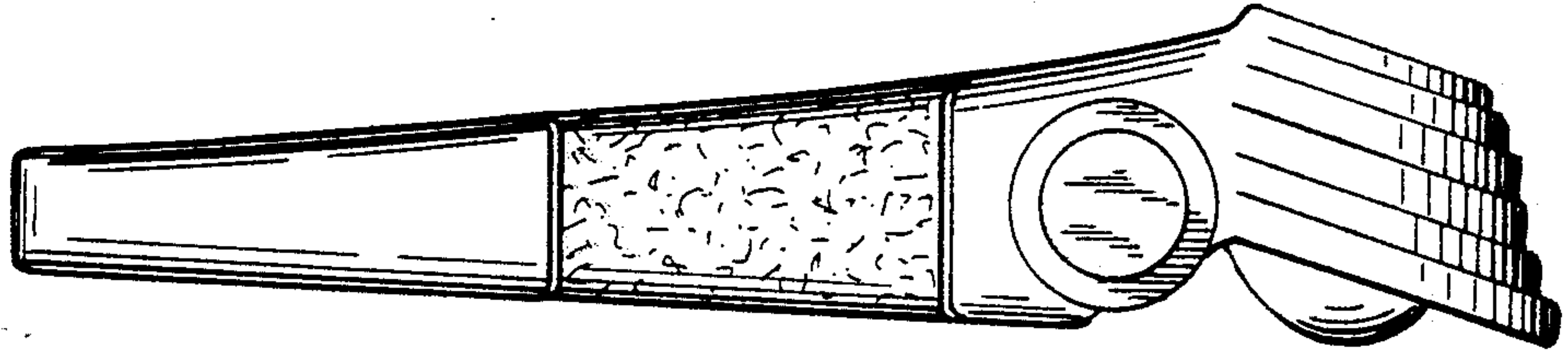

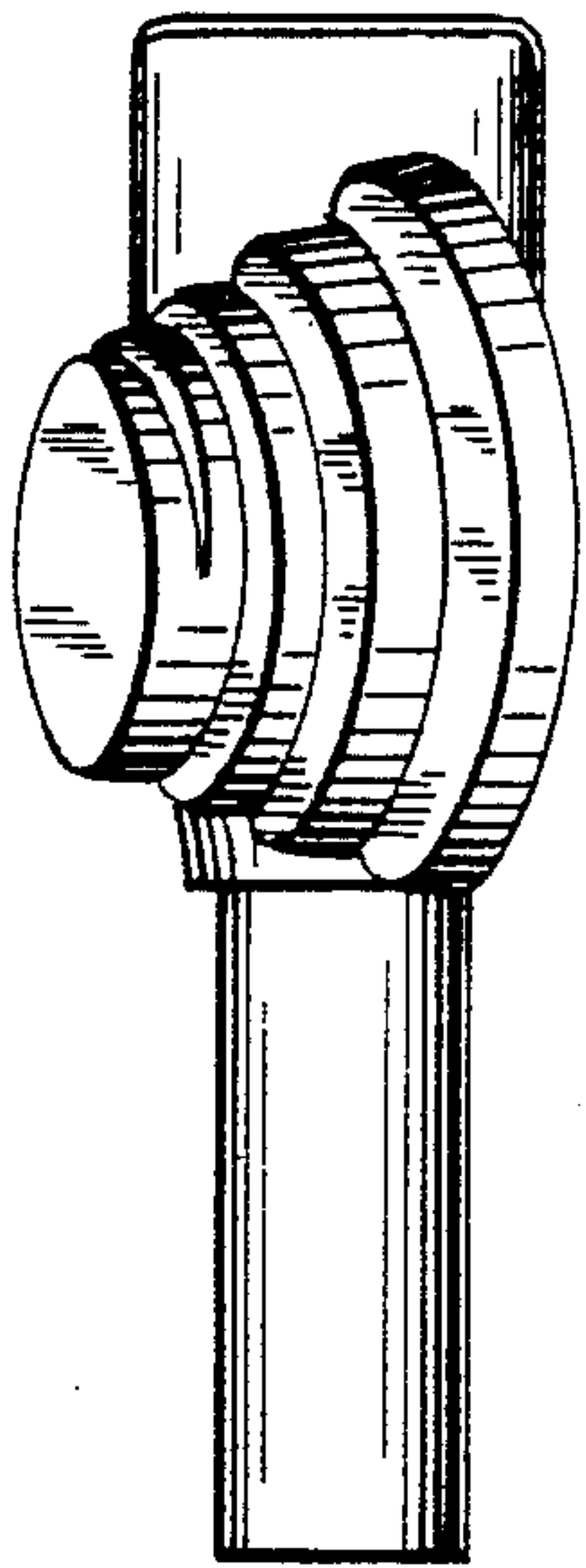

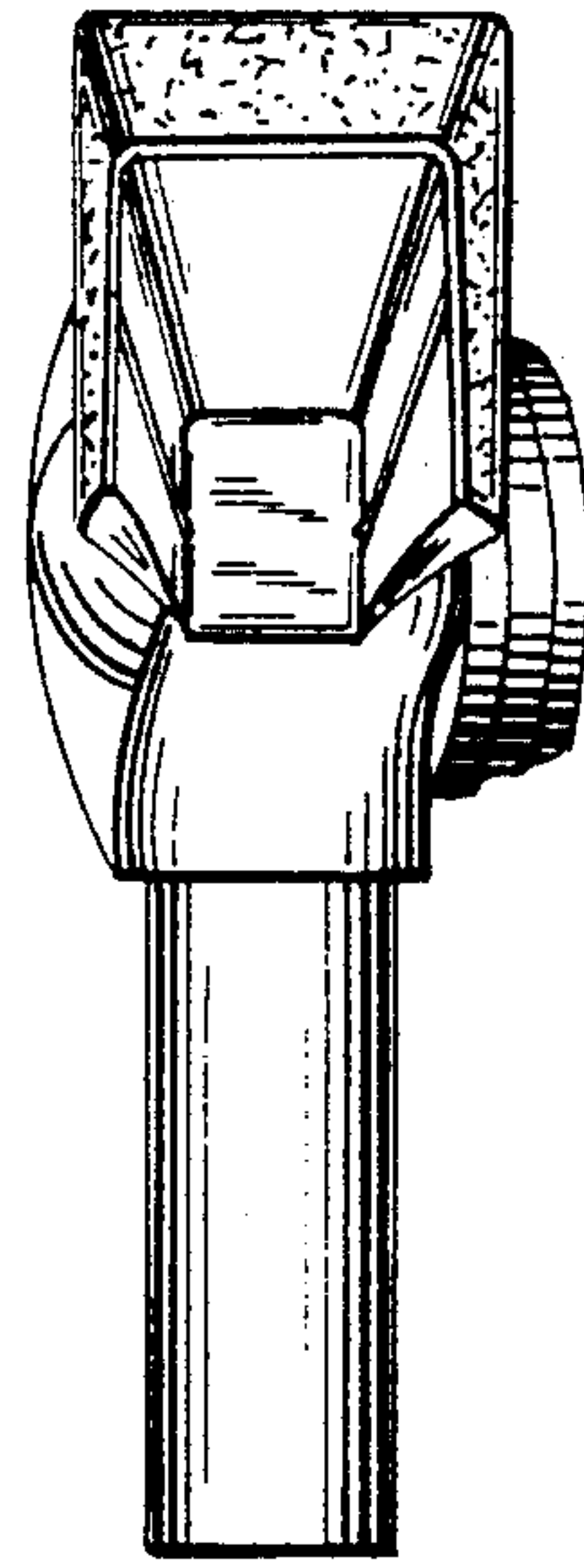
