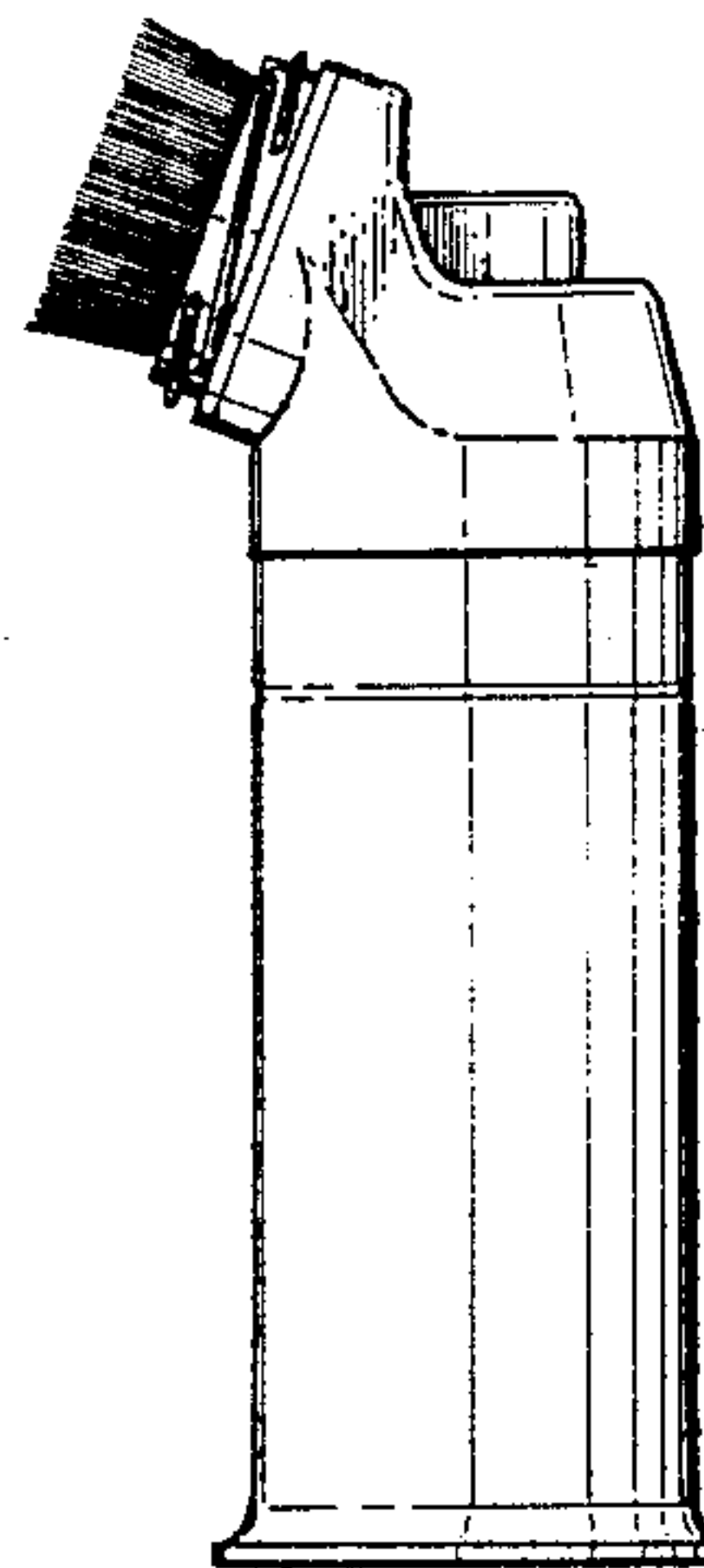
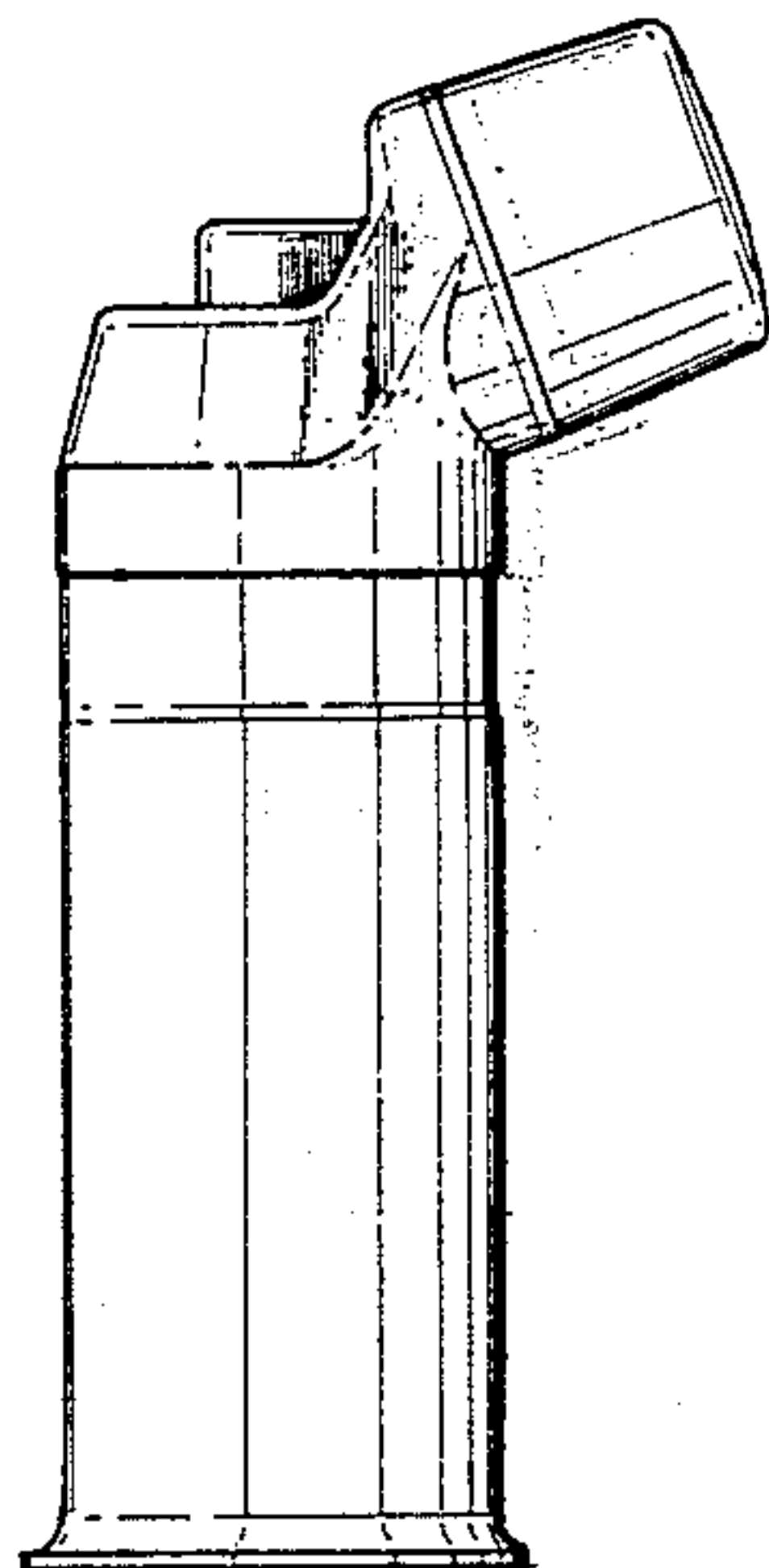

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a brush dispenser for shoe polish or other liquids, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a brush dispenser for shoe polish or other liquids, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view shown with the cap removed; FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the device as shown in FIGS. 1-4.



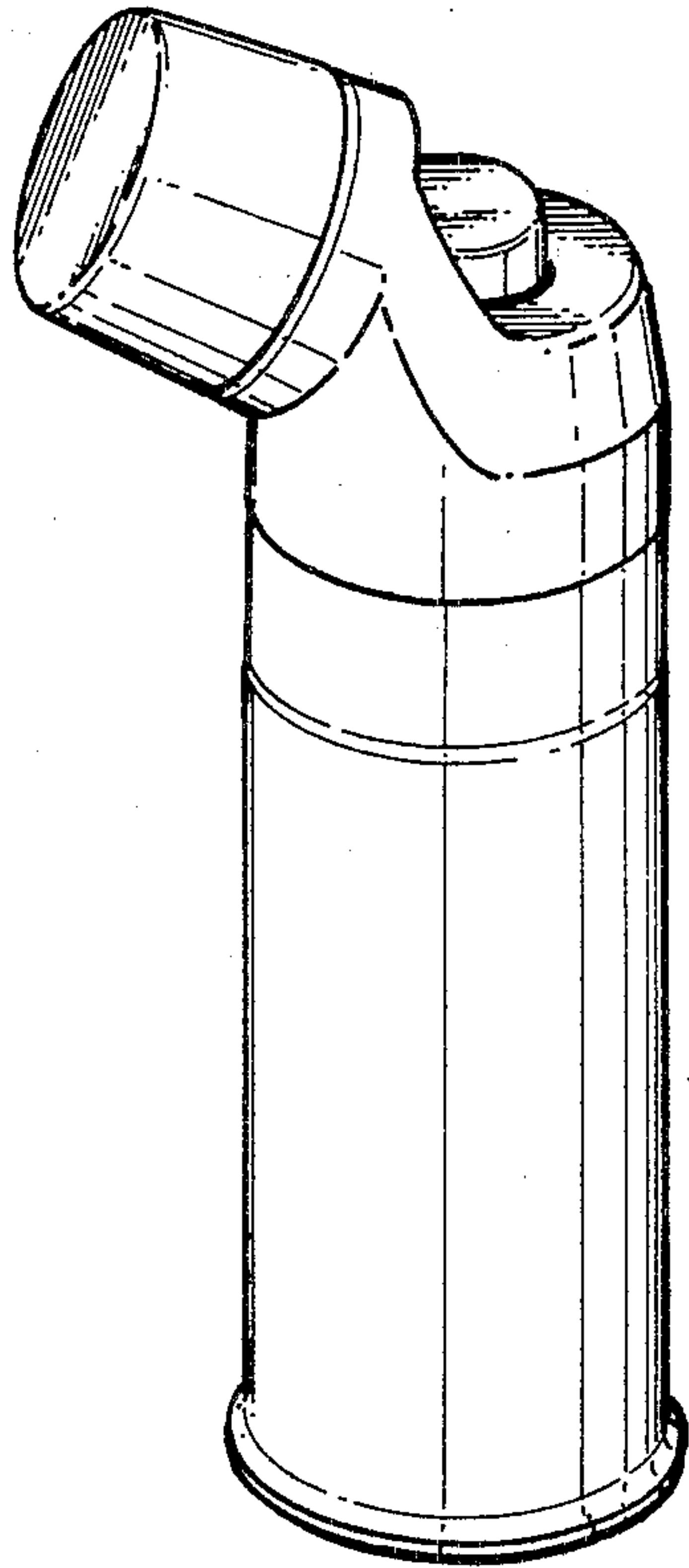

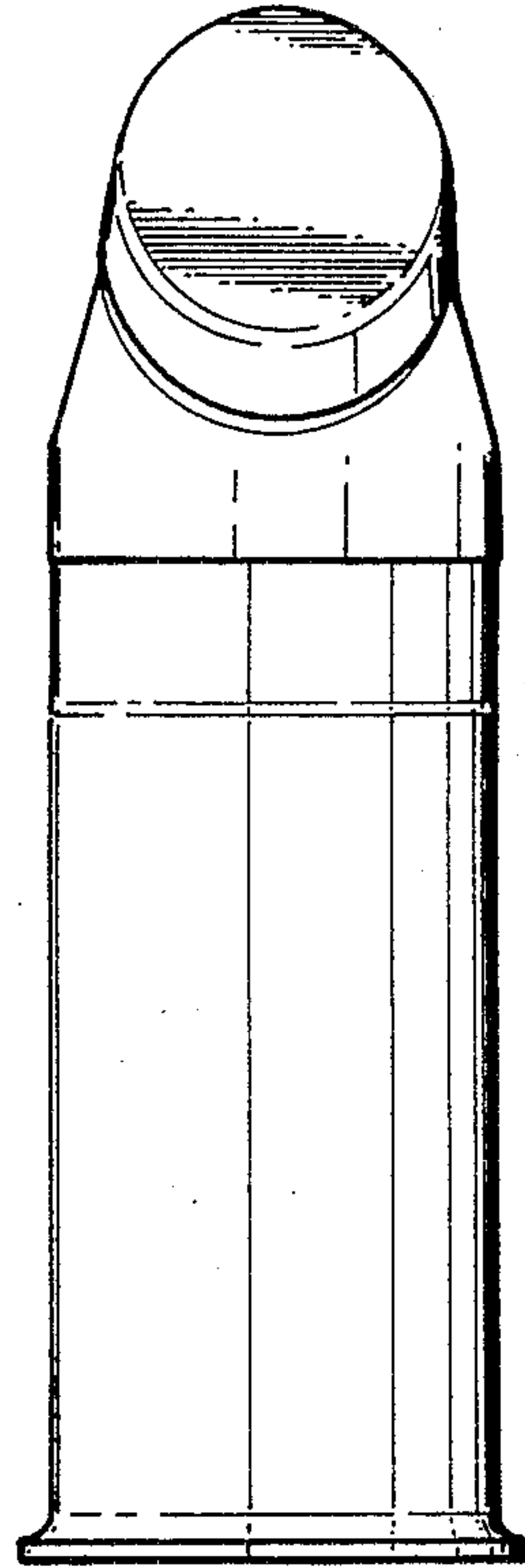

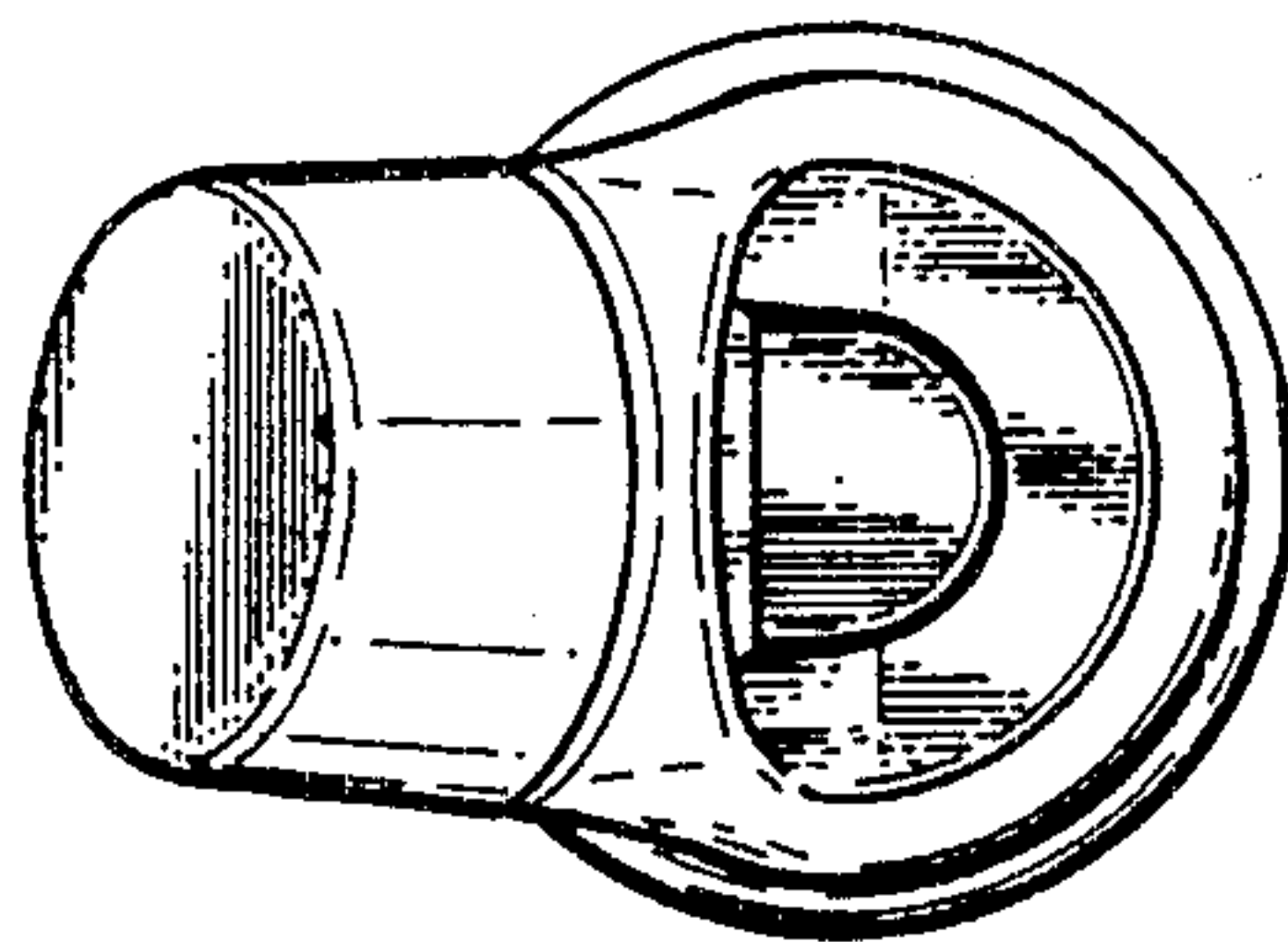

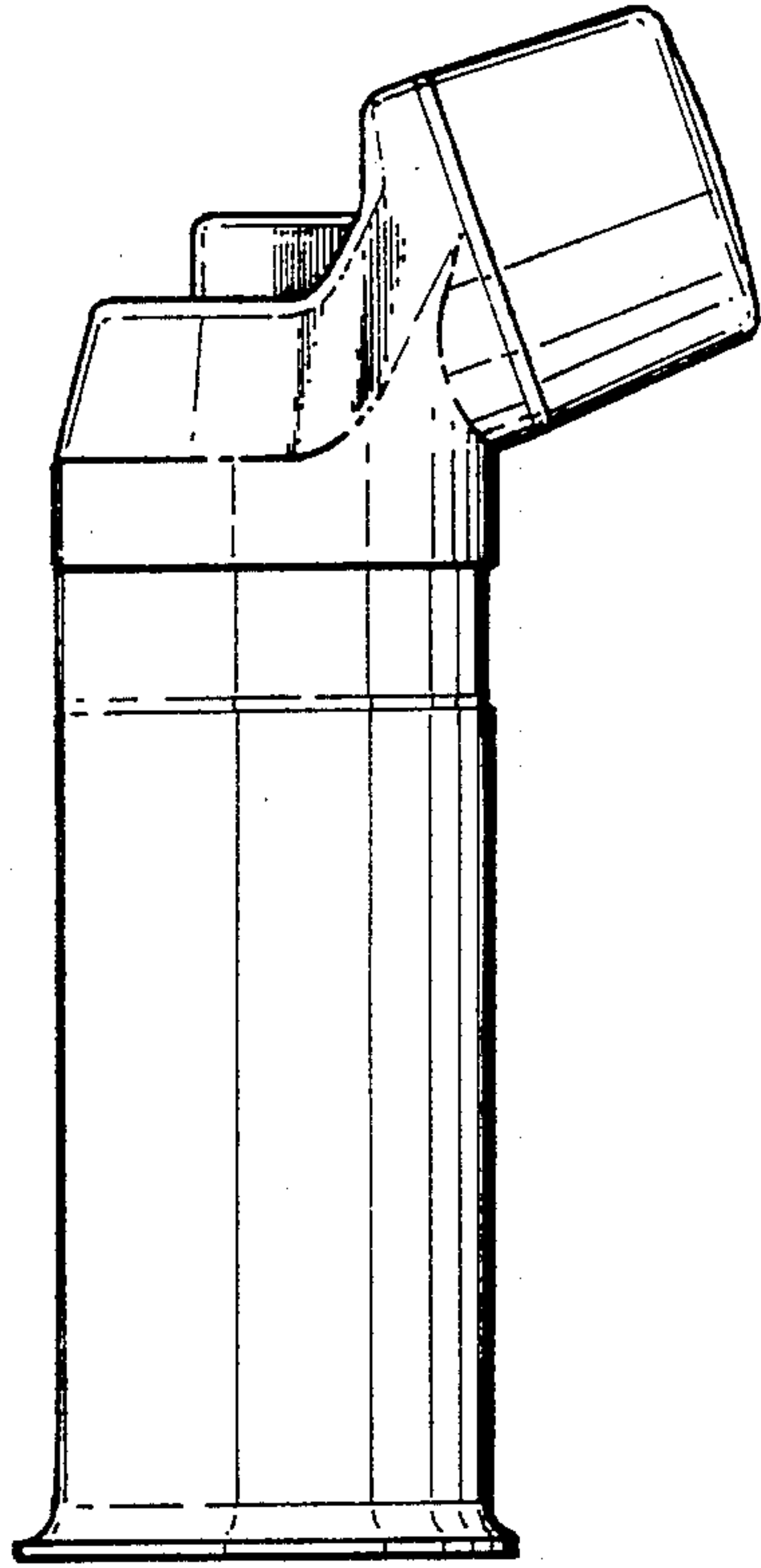

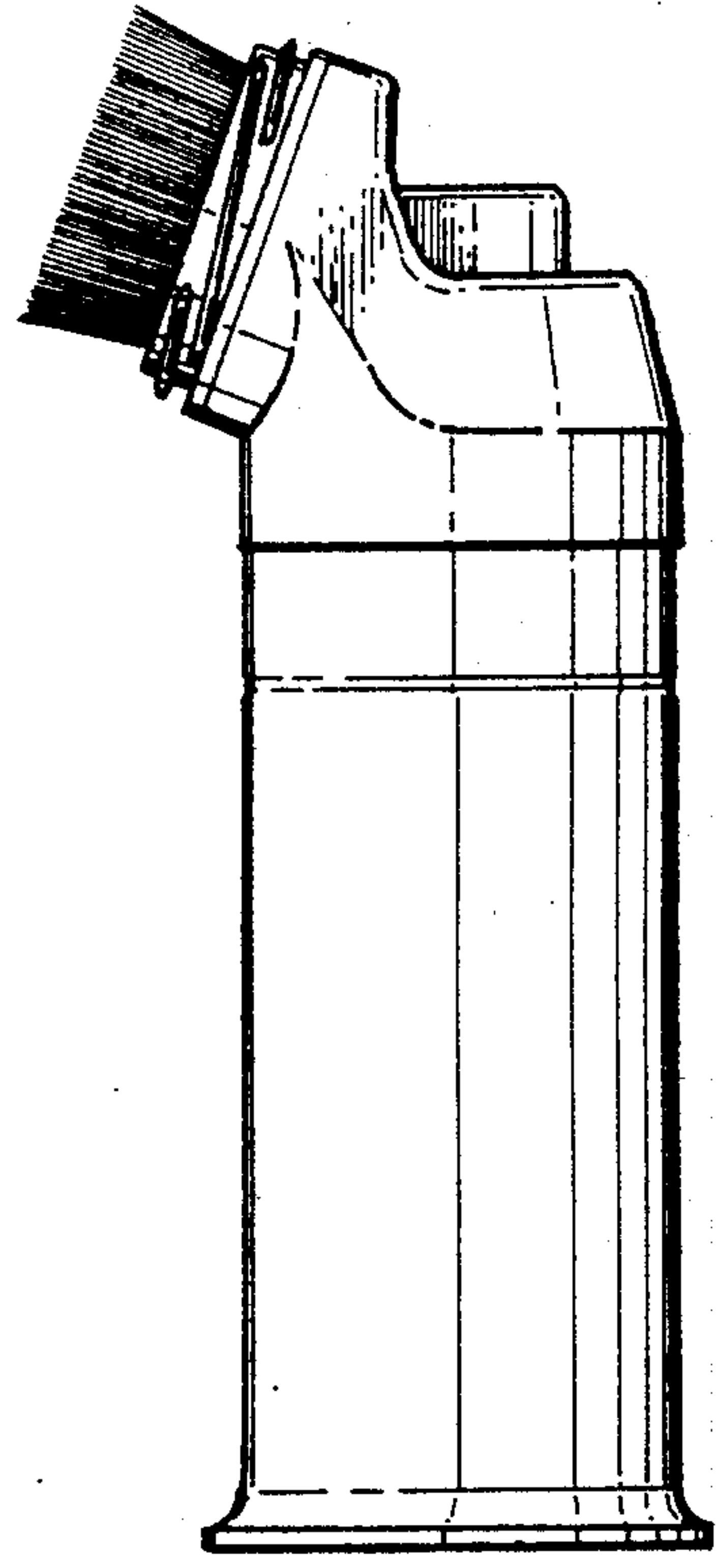

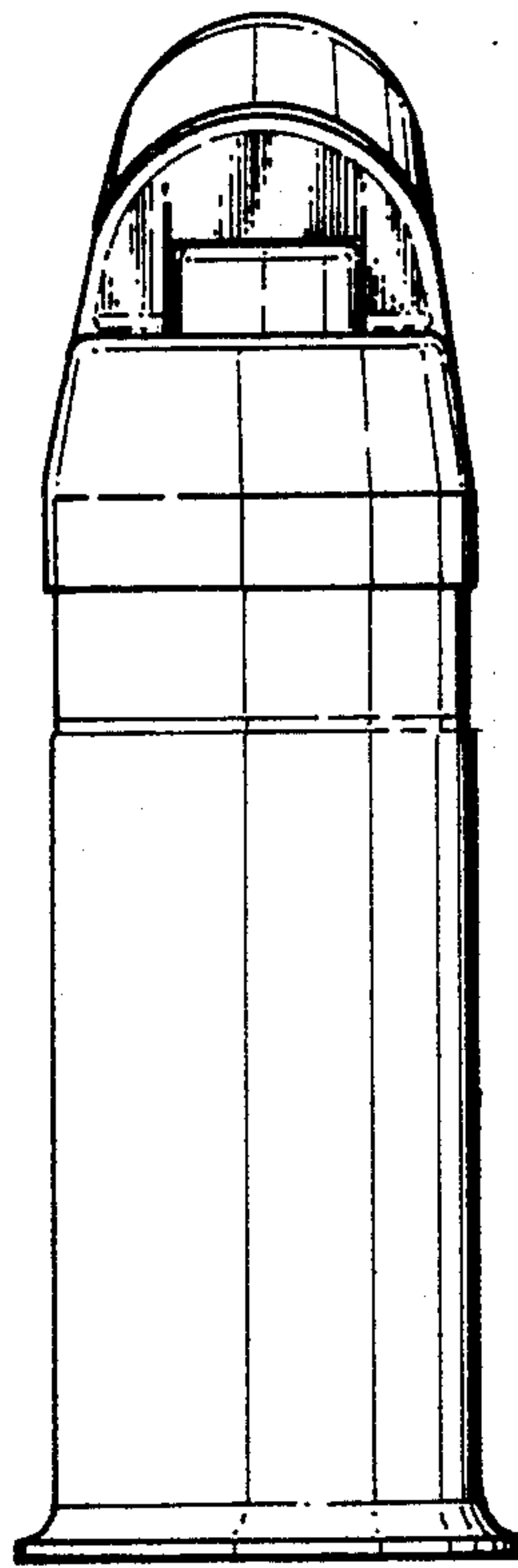
