## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a table, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view taken normal to one side of a table embodying my design, the table being symmetrical about lines joining opposite corners, except for the asymmetry effected by the single leg having the ball connected at its lower end.

FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the table illustrated in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the table illustrated in FIG. 1. FIG. 4 is a side elevation view taken normal to one side of a second table embodying my design, views taken normal to the other sides being identical except for the asymmetry effected by the single leg carrying the ball connected at its lower end.


FIG. 5 is a bottom view of FIG. 2a and FIG. 3a.


FIG. 6 is a side elevation view taken normal to one side of a third table embodying my design, views taken normal to the other sides being identical except for the asymmetry effected by the single leg carrying the ball connected at its lower end.


FIG. 7 is a top view of the tables illustrated in FIG. 4 and FIG. 3a.


FIG. 8 is a side elevation view taken normal to one side of a fourth table embodying my design, views taken normal to the other sides being identical except for the asymmetry effected by the two legs having balls connected at their lower ends.


FIG. 9 is a top view of the table illustrated in FIG. 8. FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the table illustrated in FIG. 8.




