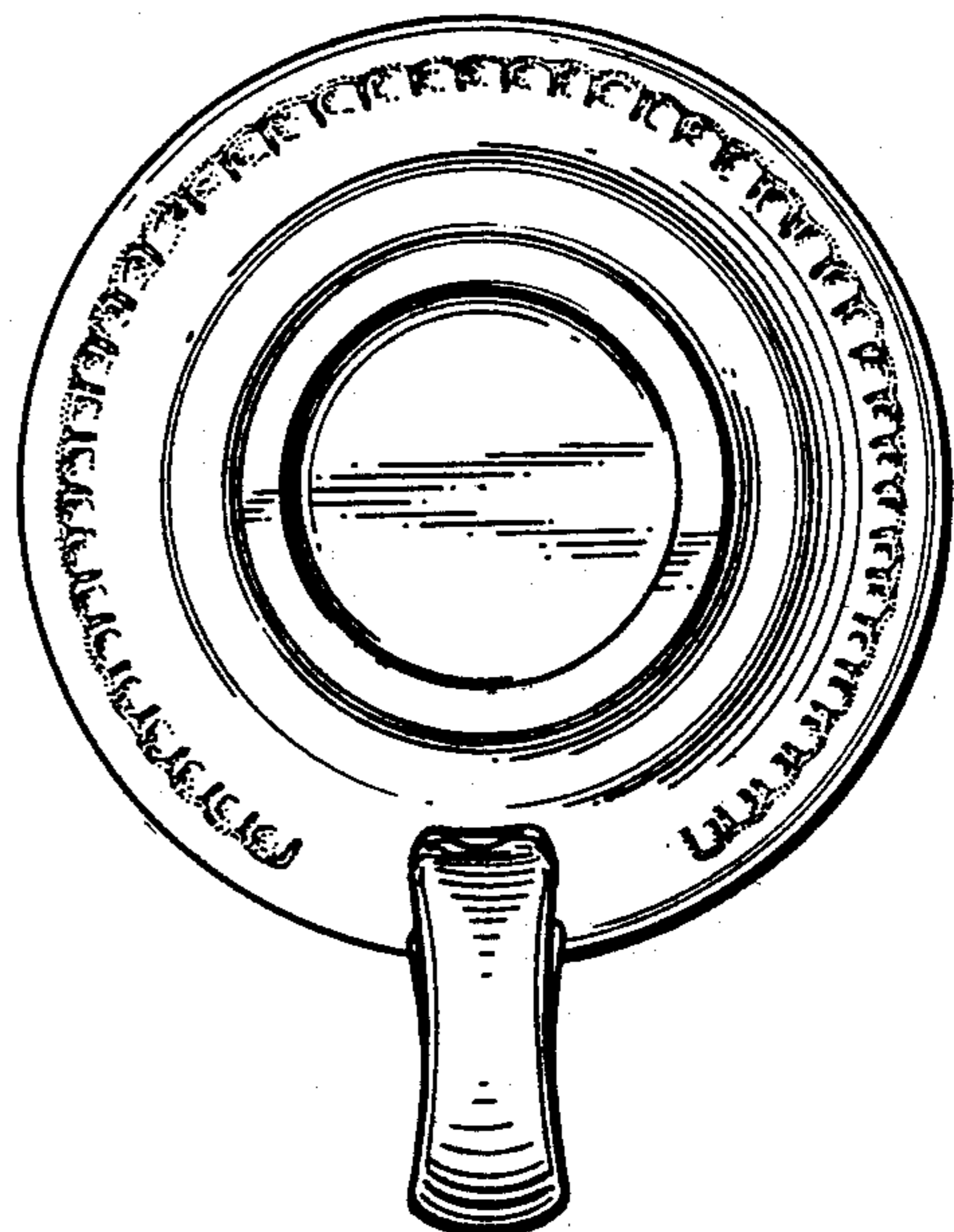
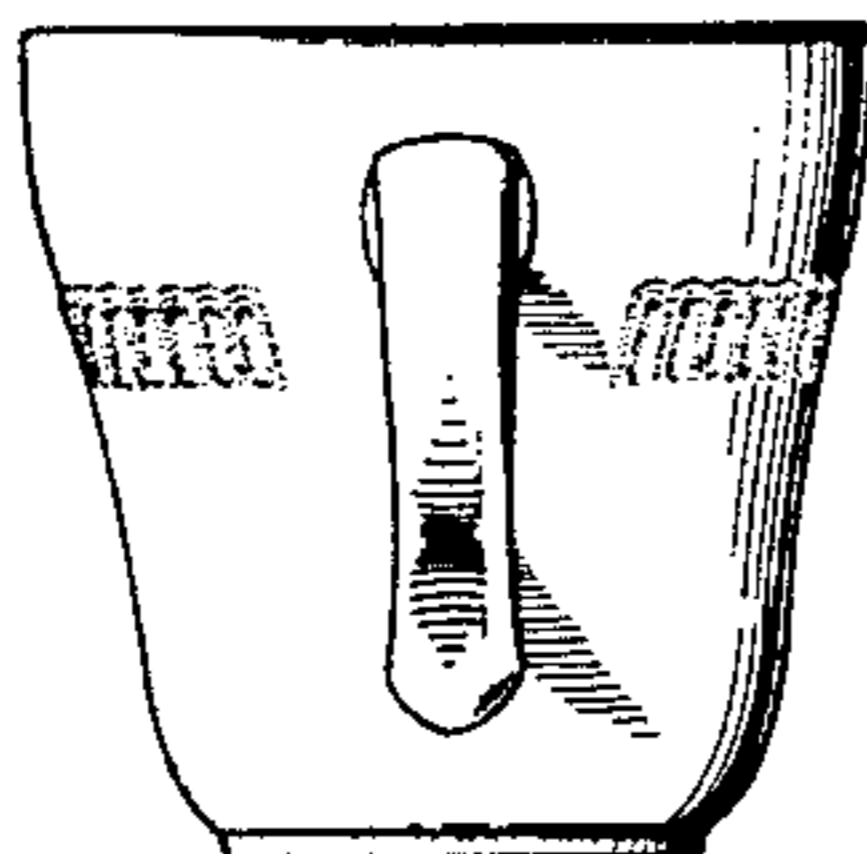
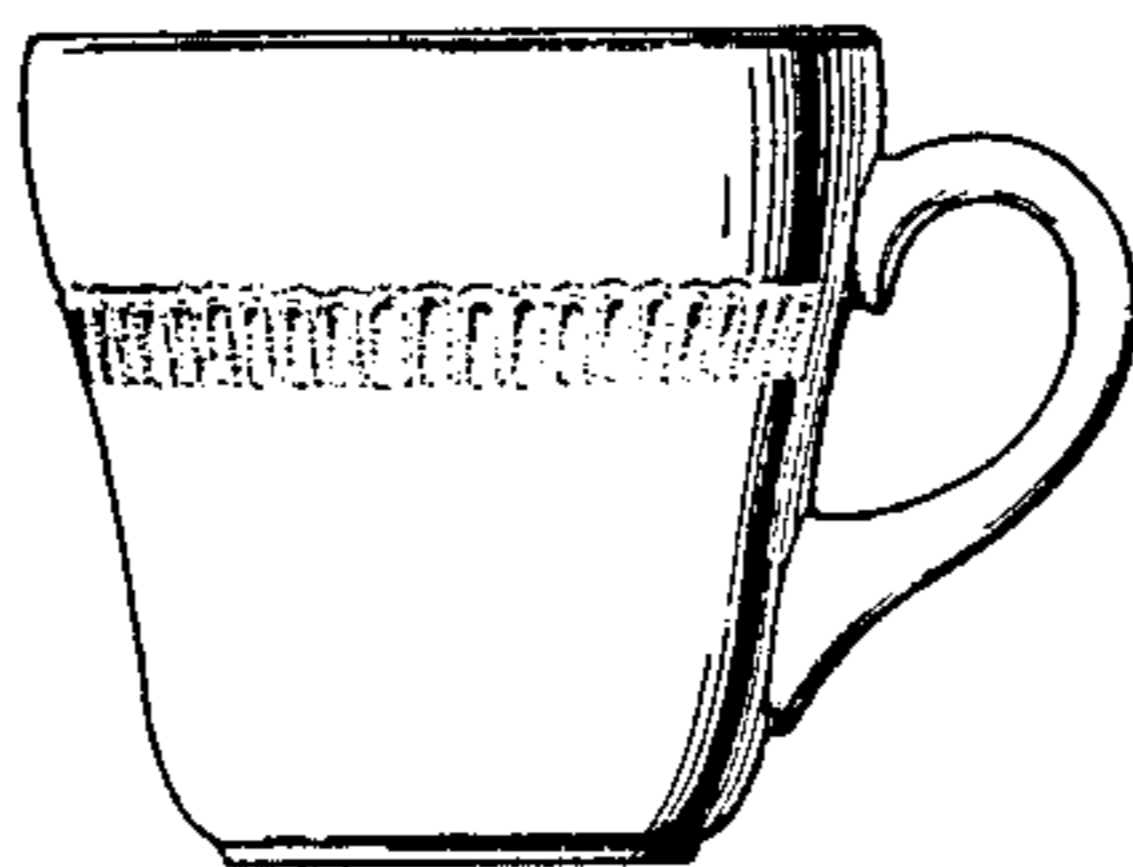

The ornamental design for a beverage cup, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a beverage cup showing my new design, the rear elevational view is a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary view of the sculptured portion within the broken line area of FIG. 2;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 4;
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 4.
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



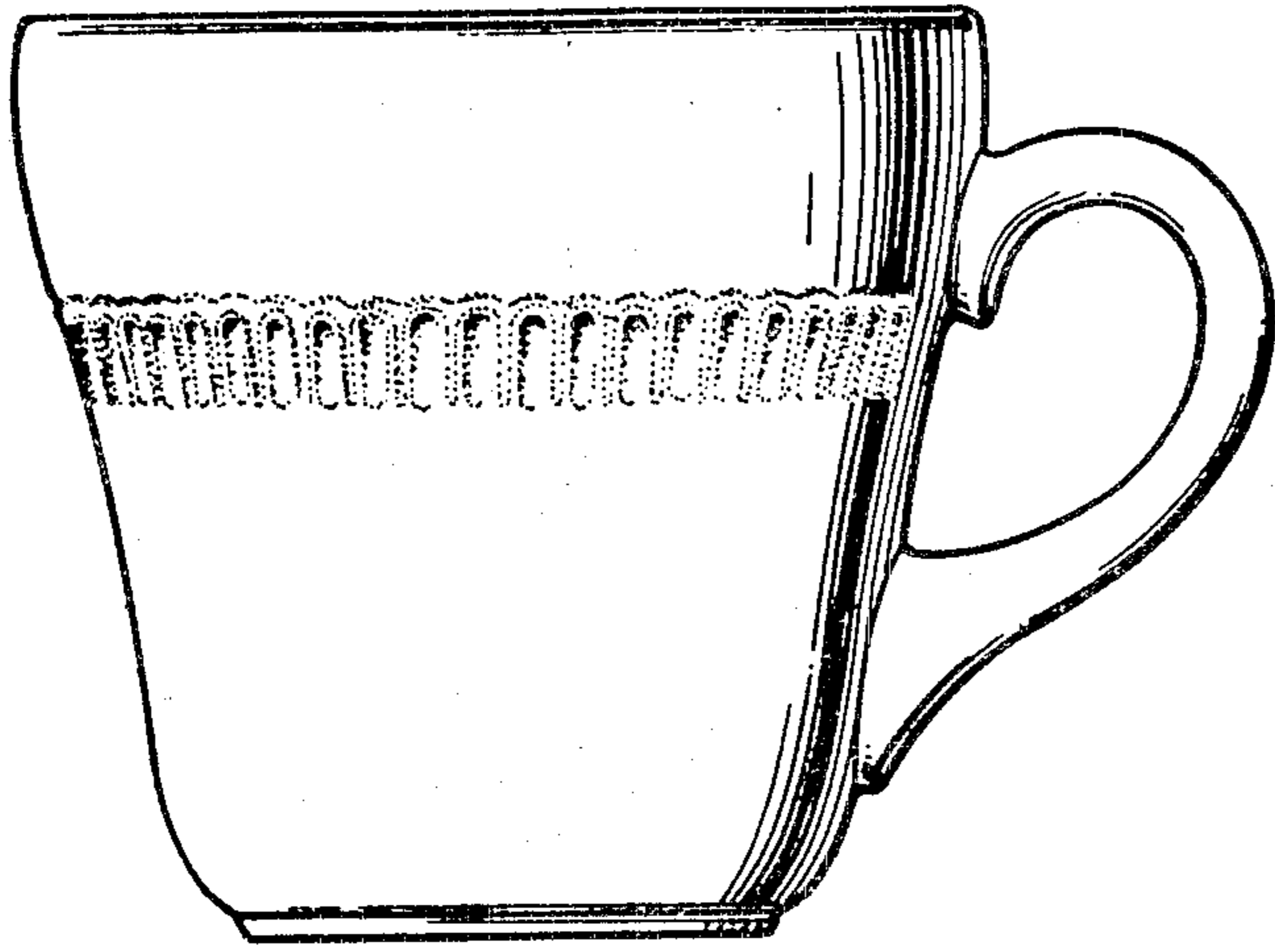

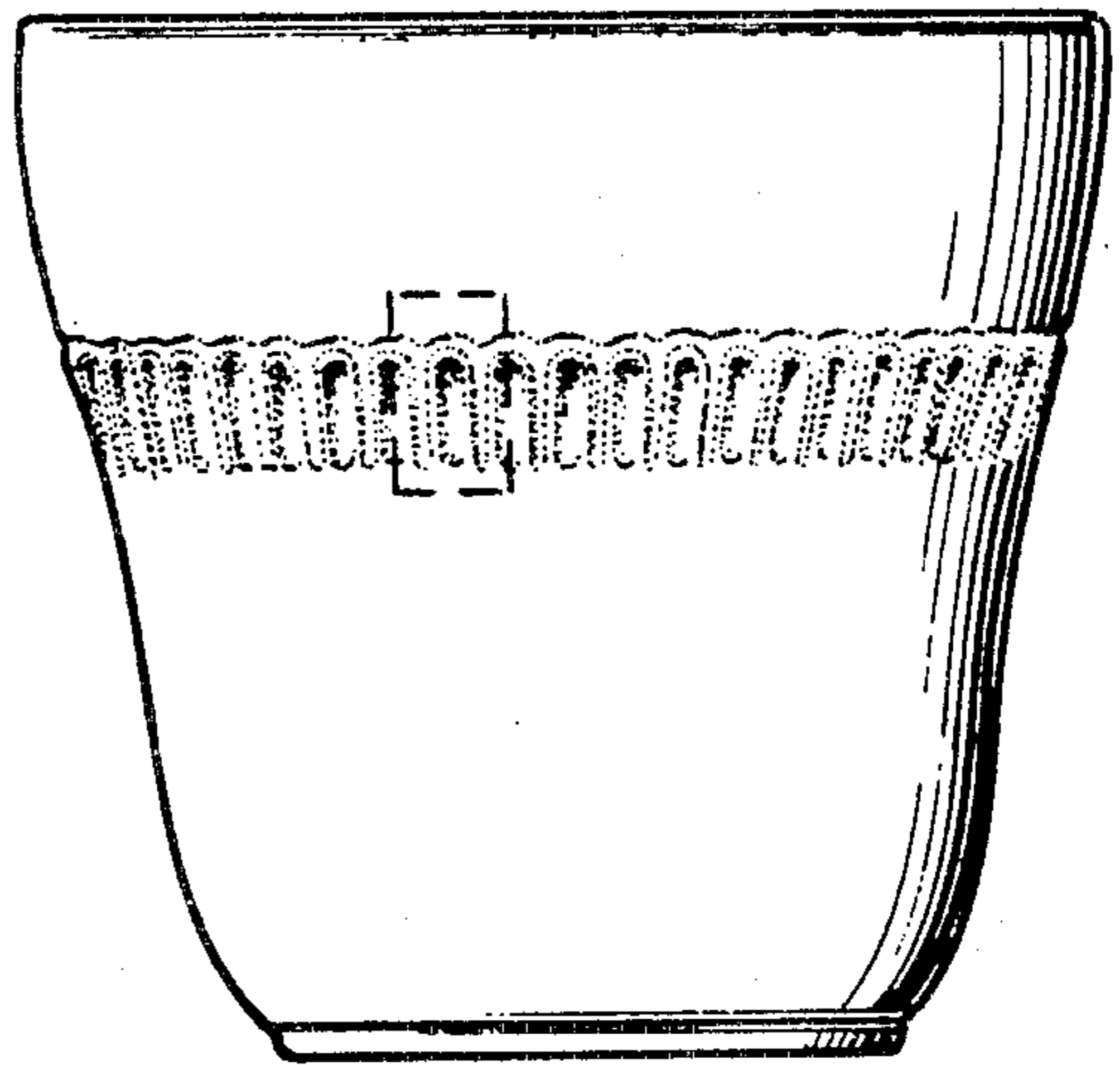

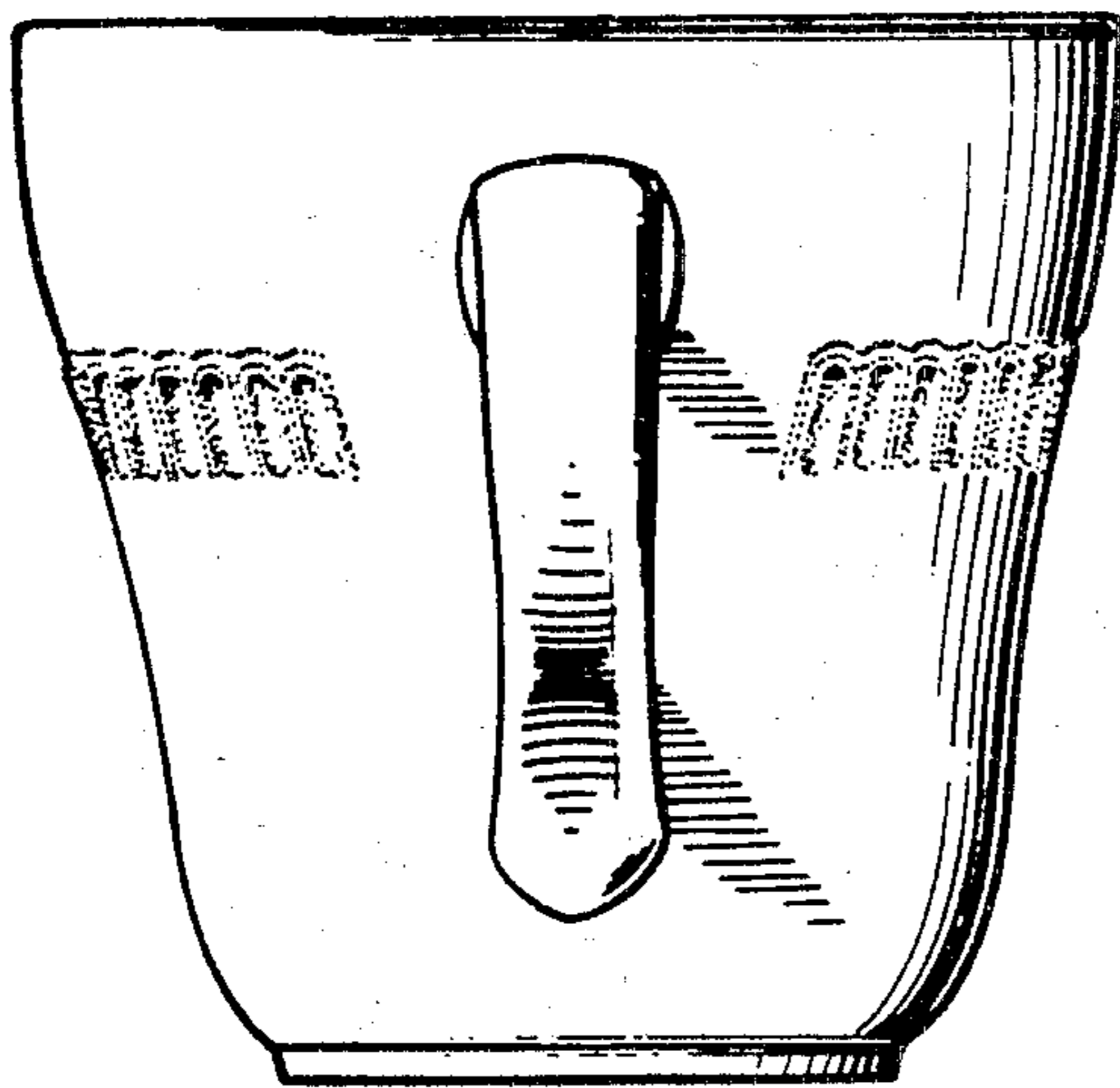

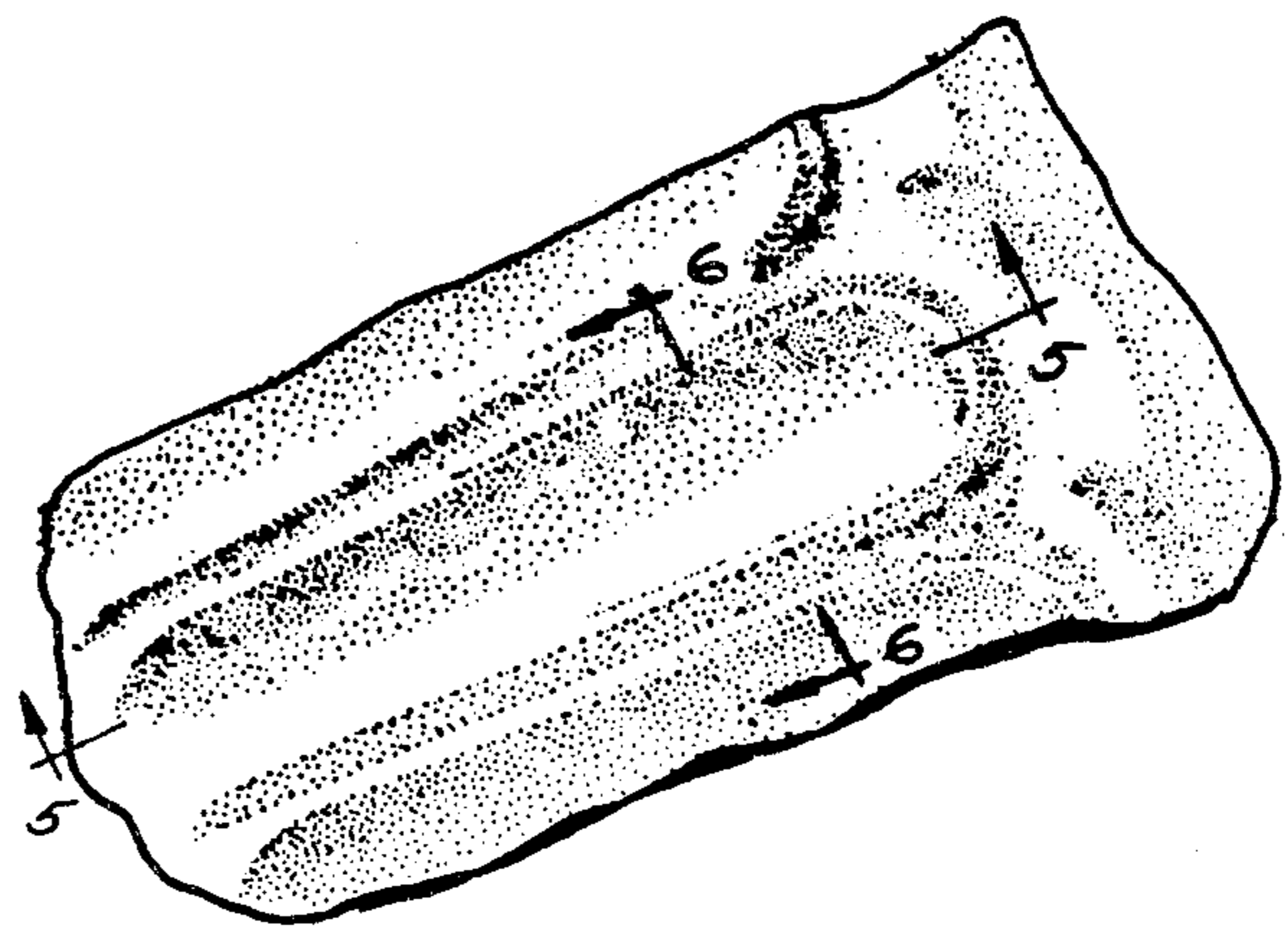

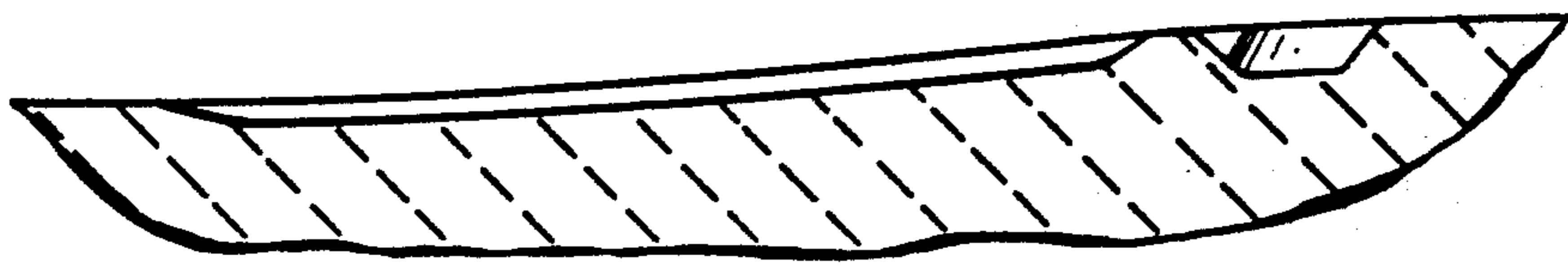
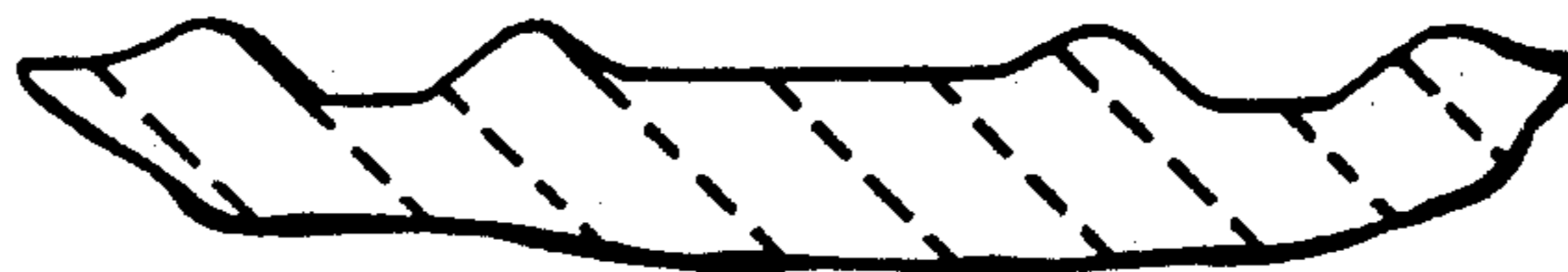

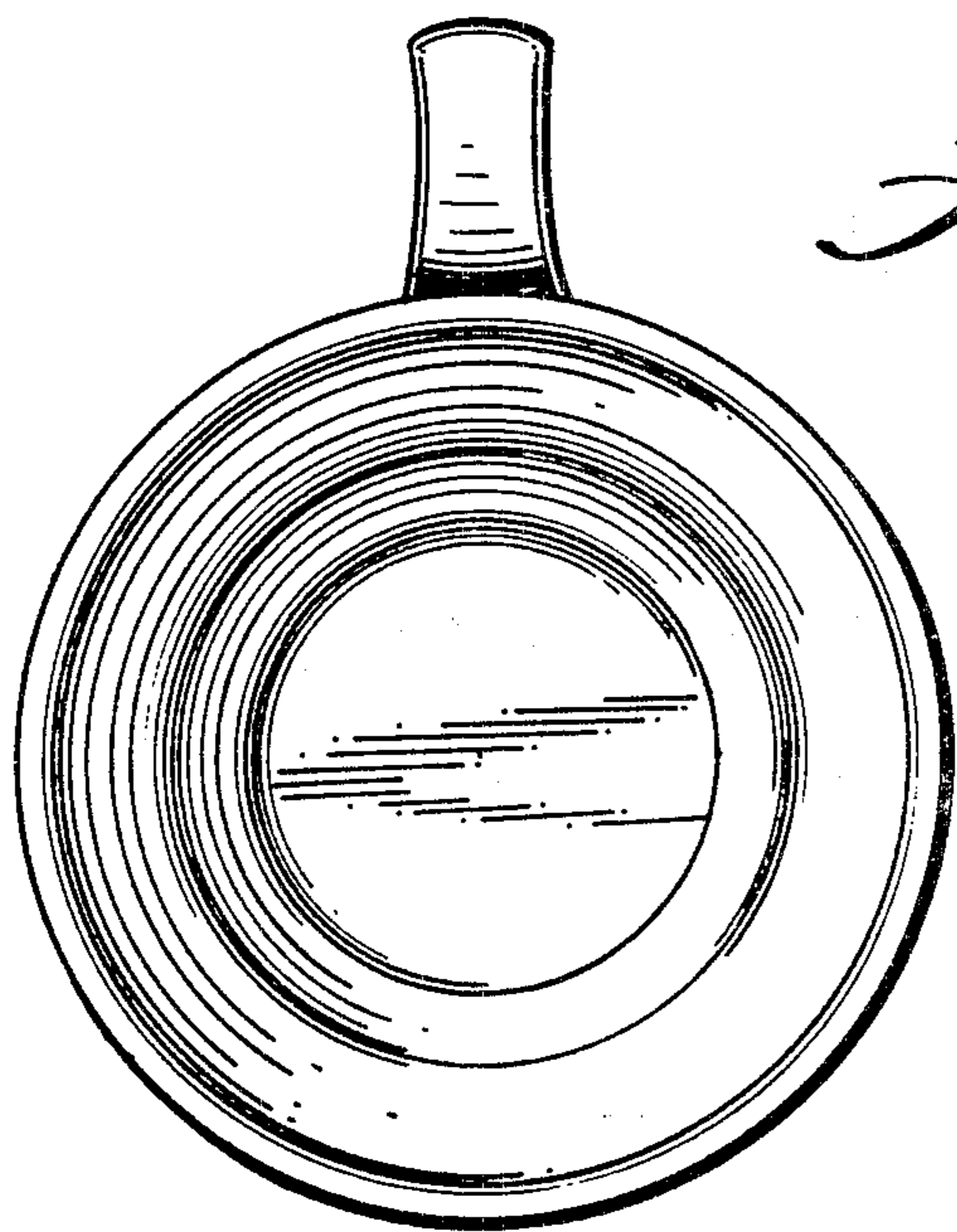

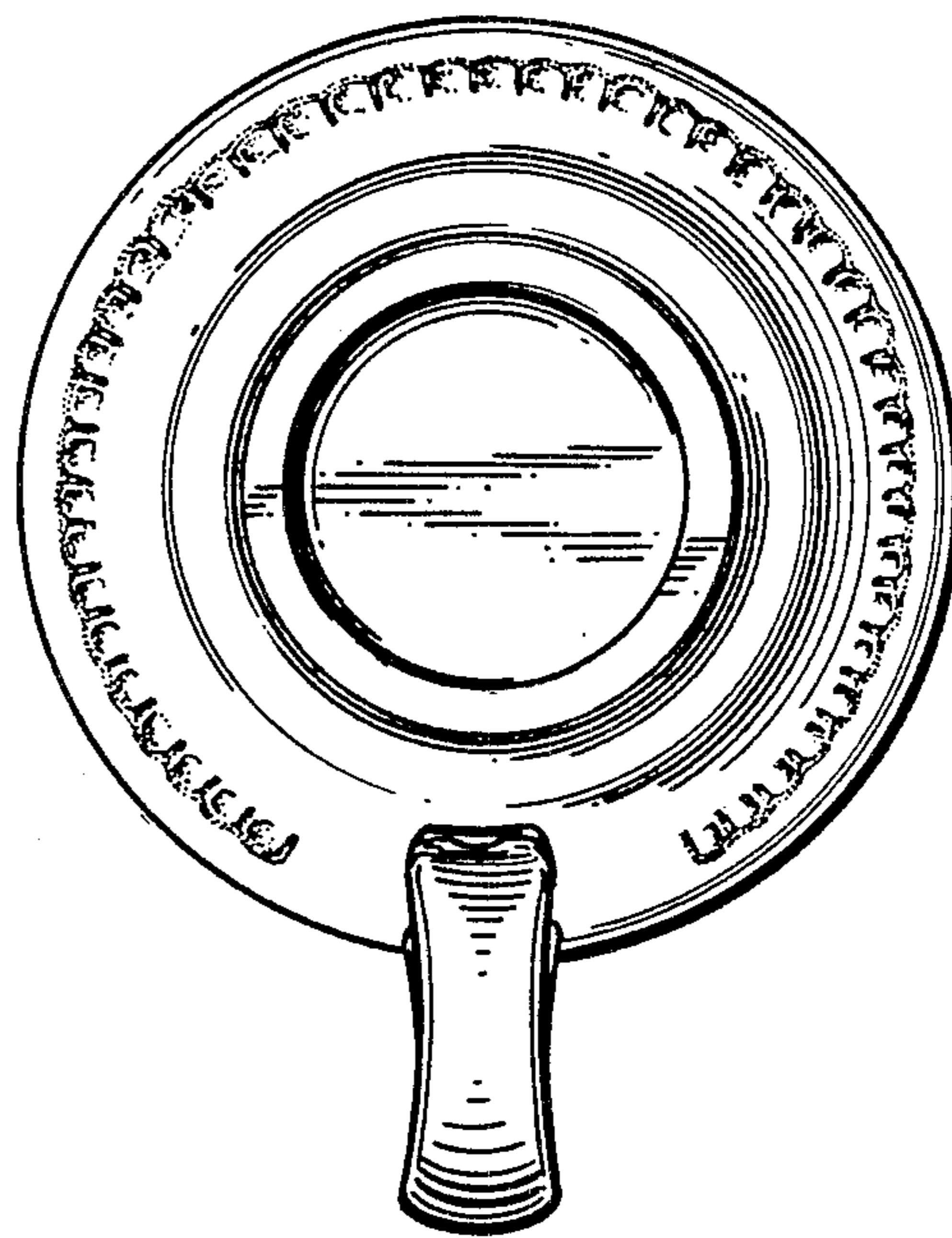
