The ornamental design for an offset handle body for a fishing rod, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a handle body for a fishing rod showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view.

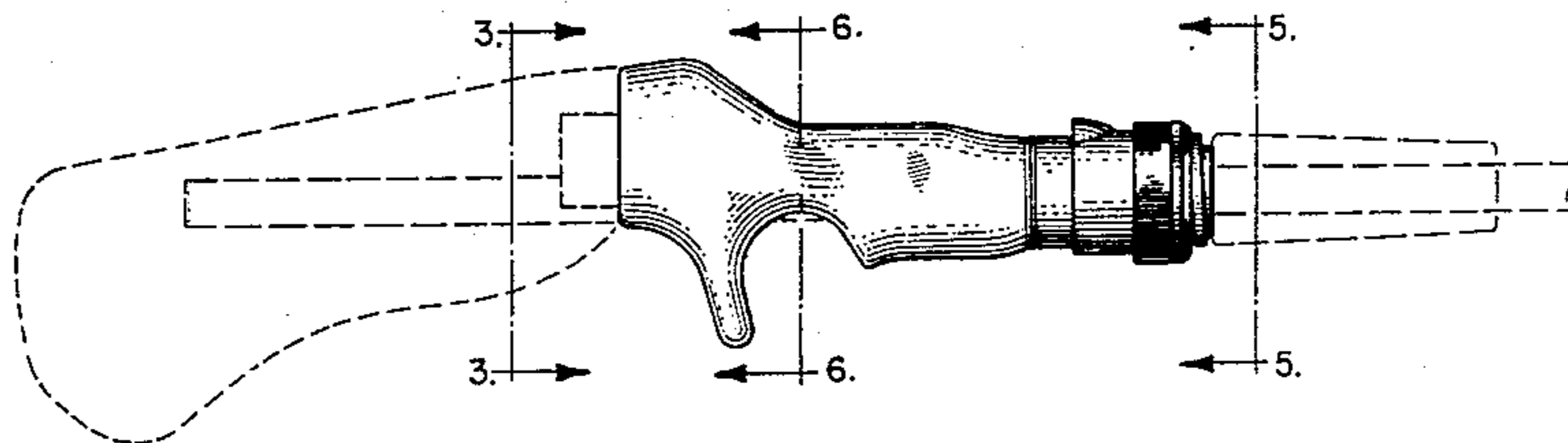
FIG. 3 is a vertical sectional view taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing the grip, rod and foregrip is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



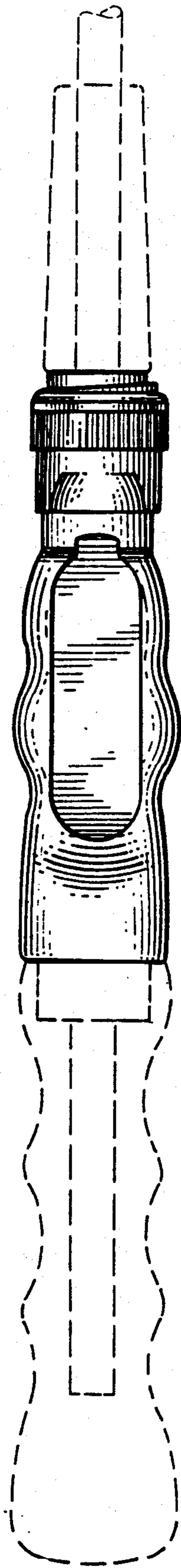

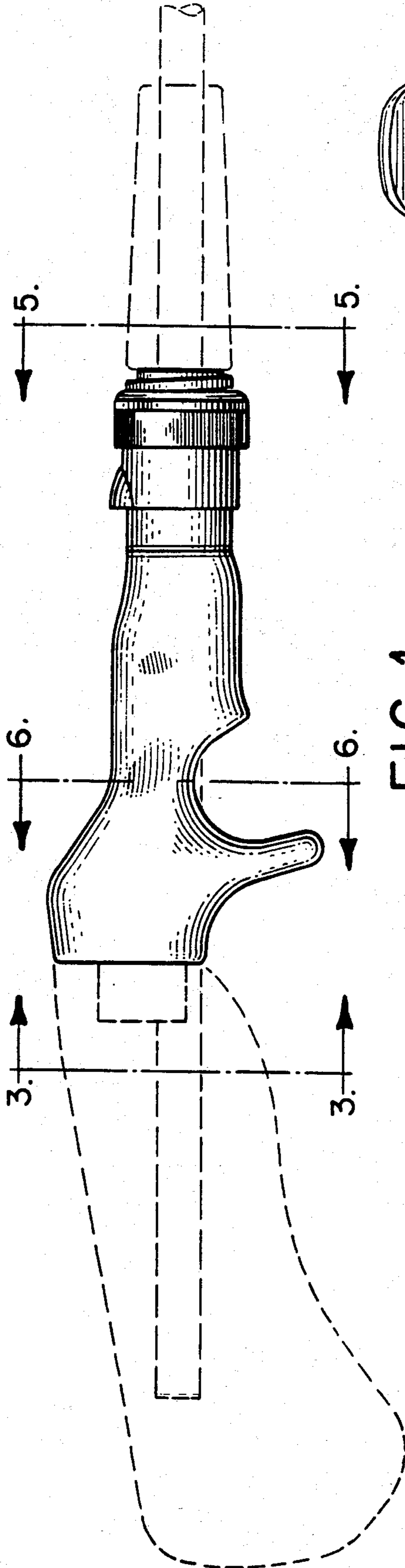

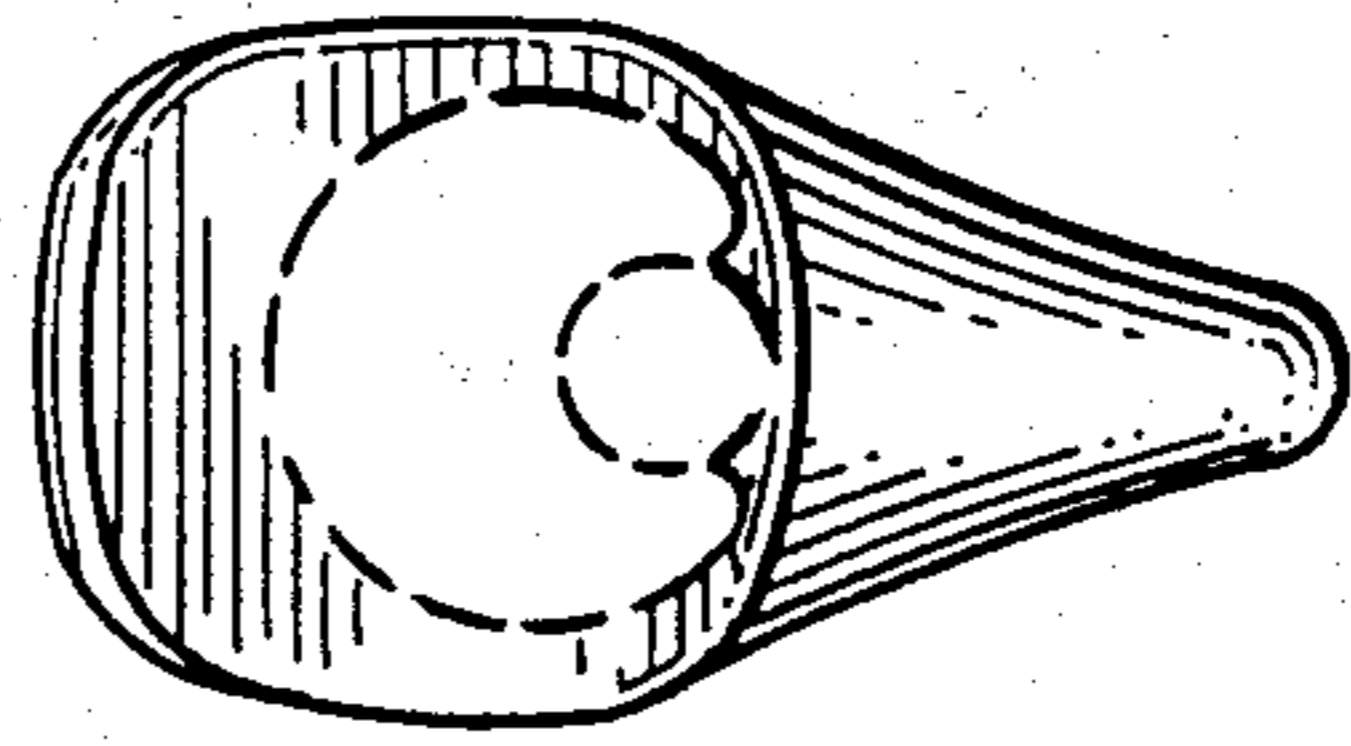

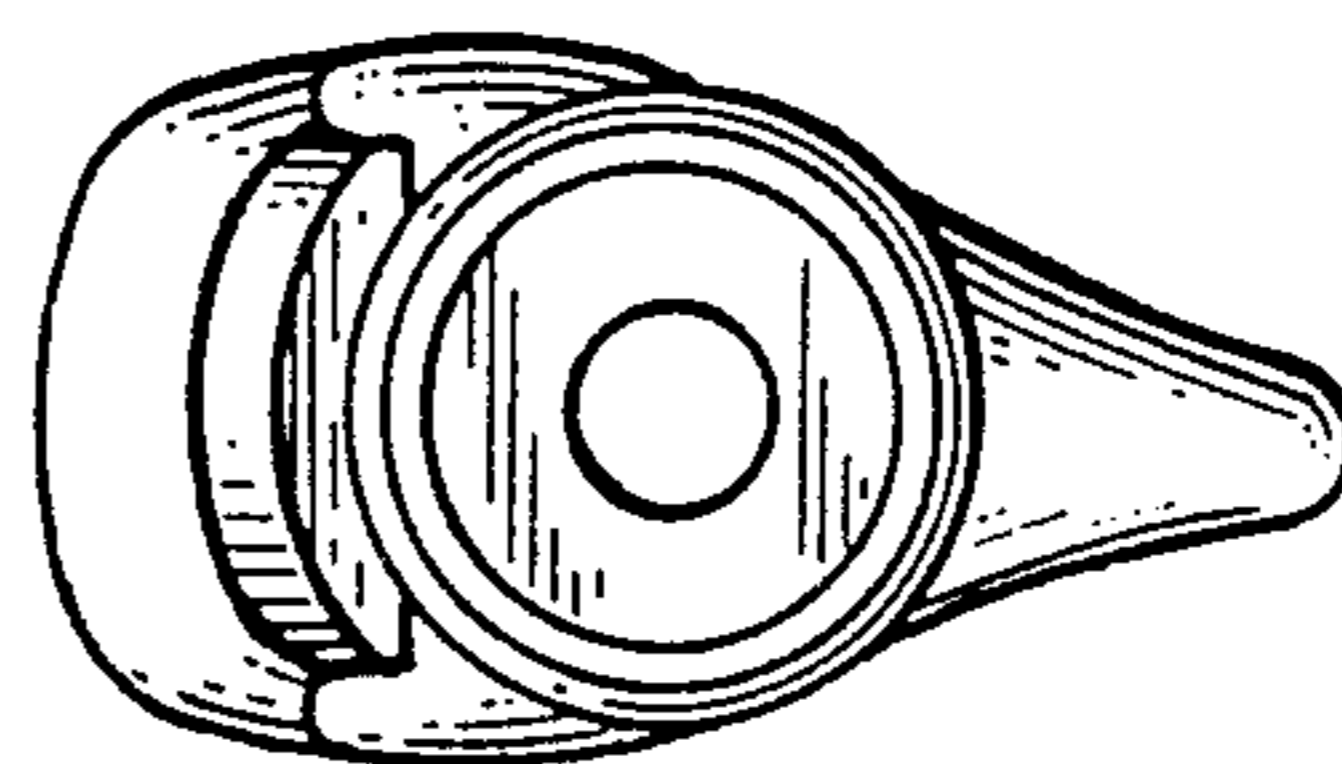
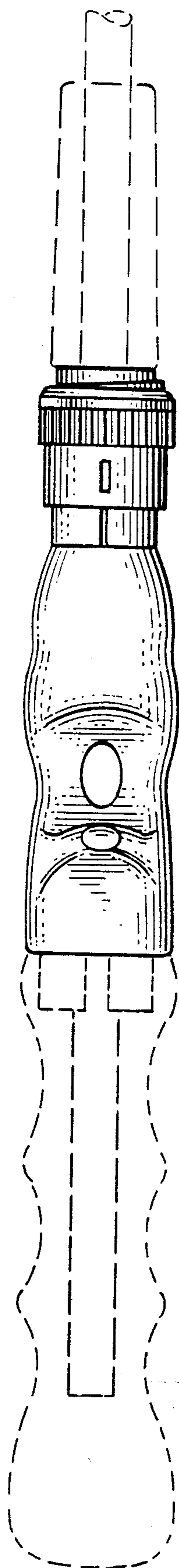

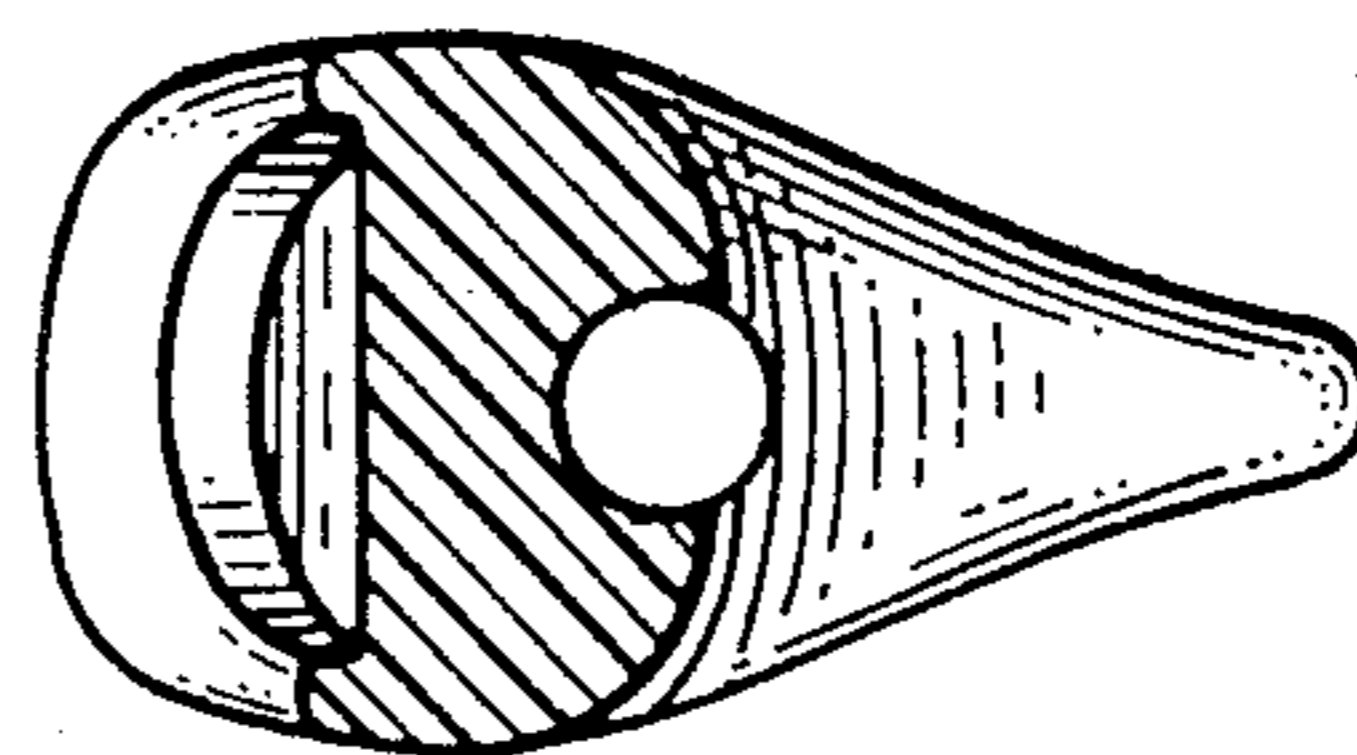
