DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a washing machine showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view with the top cover opened; and
FIG. 8 is an enlarged top-front perspective view thereof of the upper portion of the machine with the covers of a switch section and an insertion hole opened.

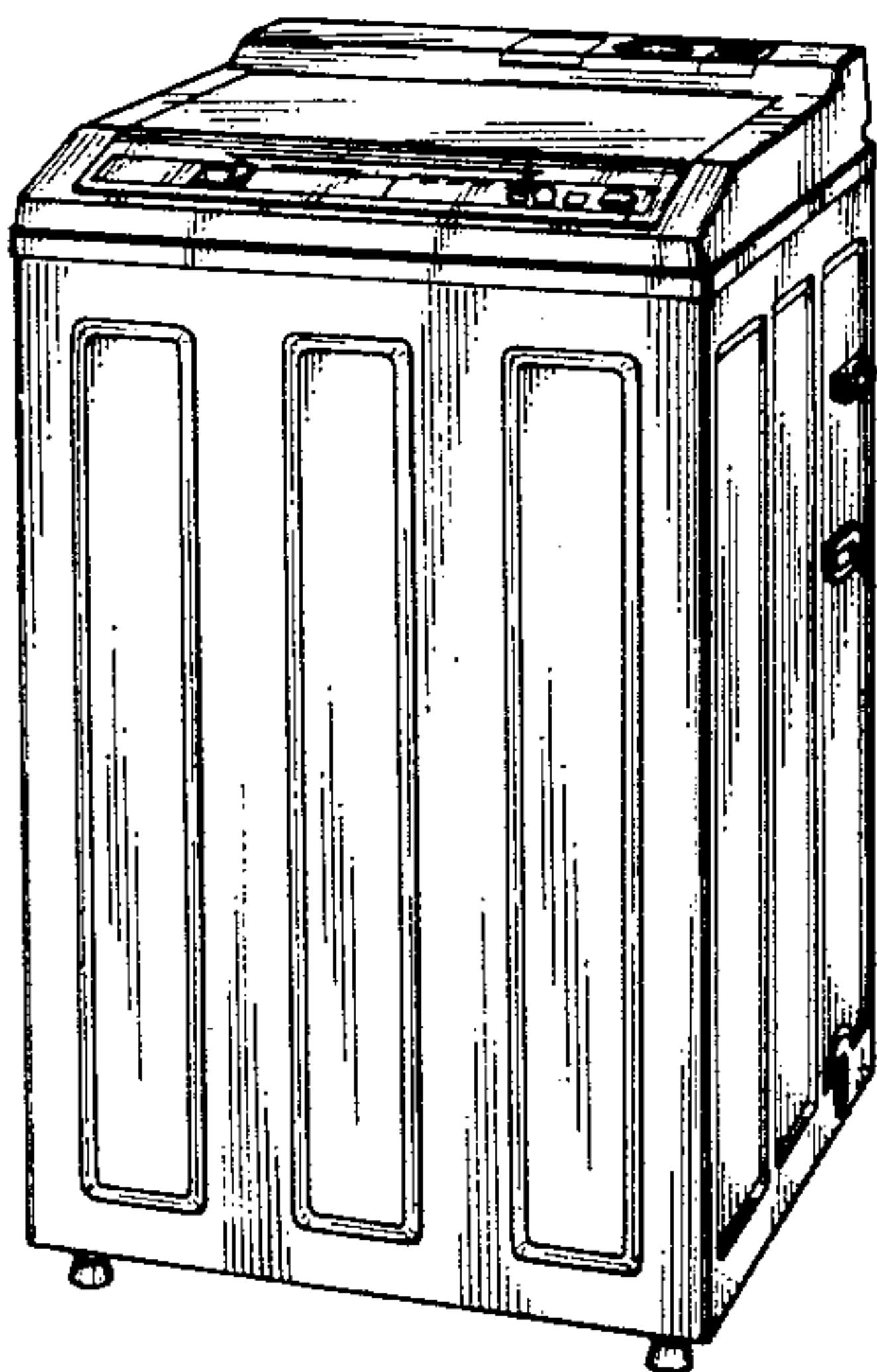

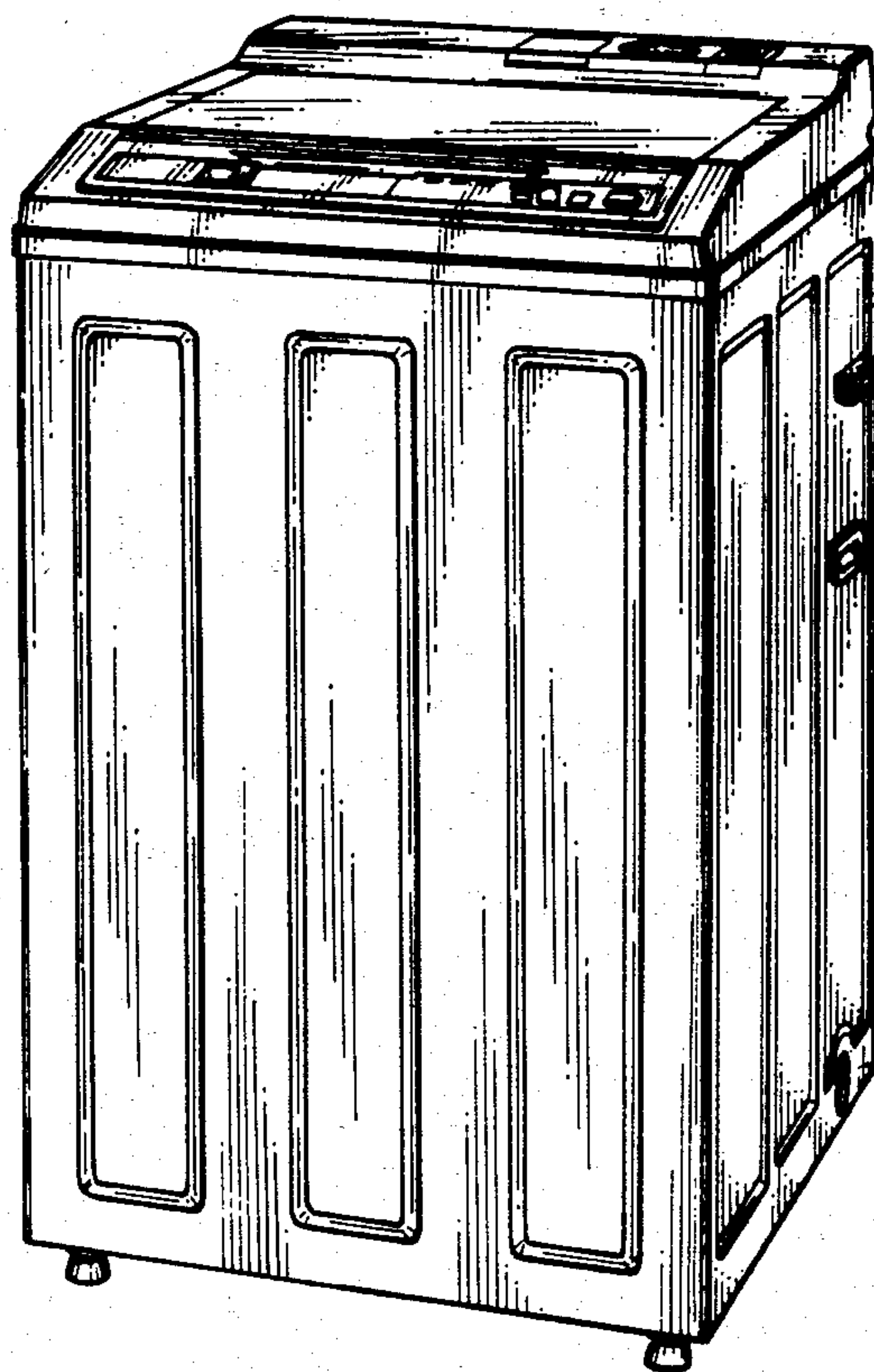
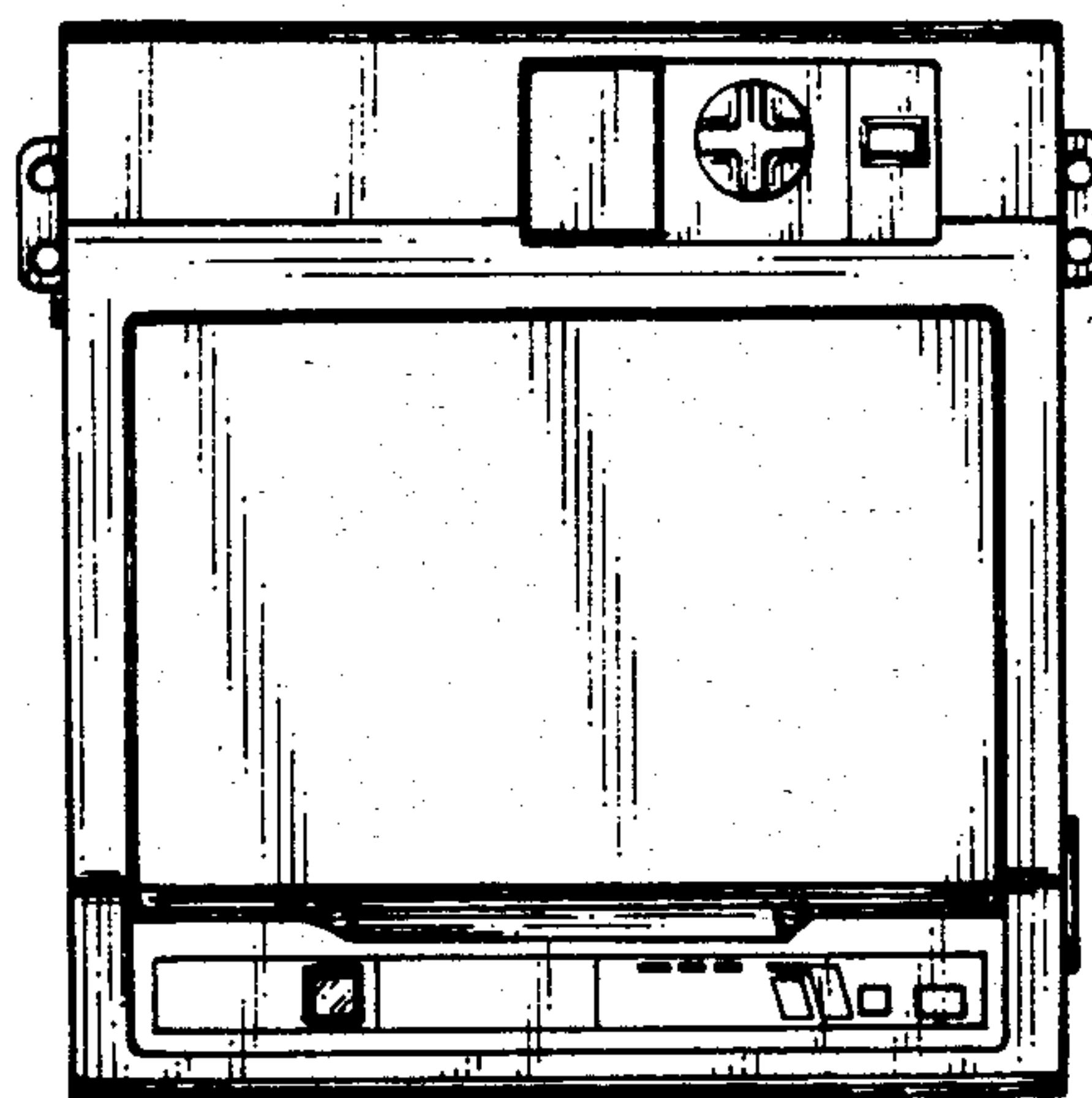

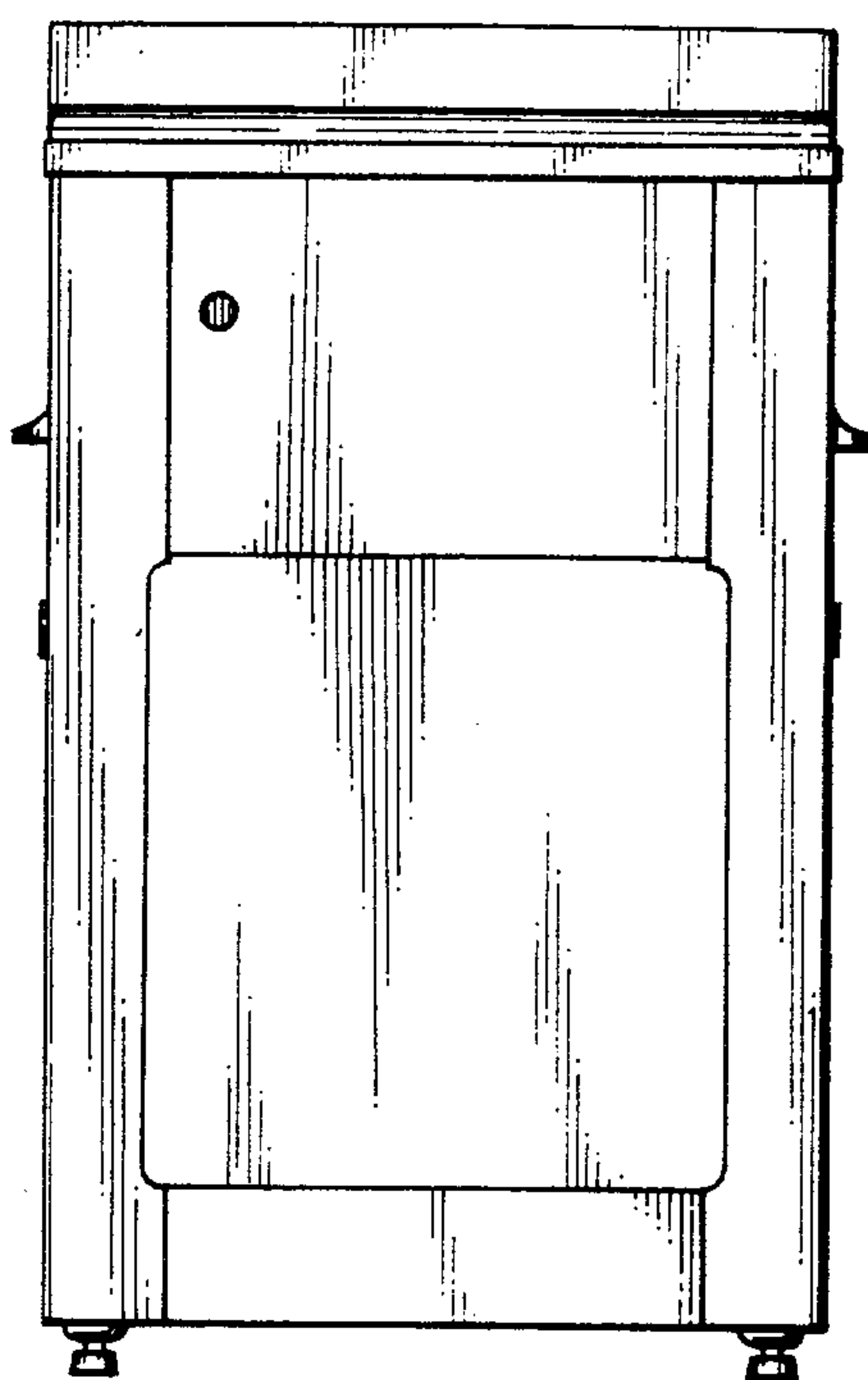
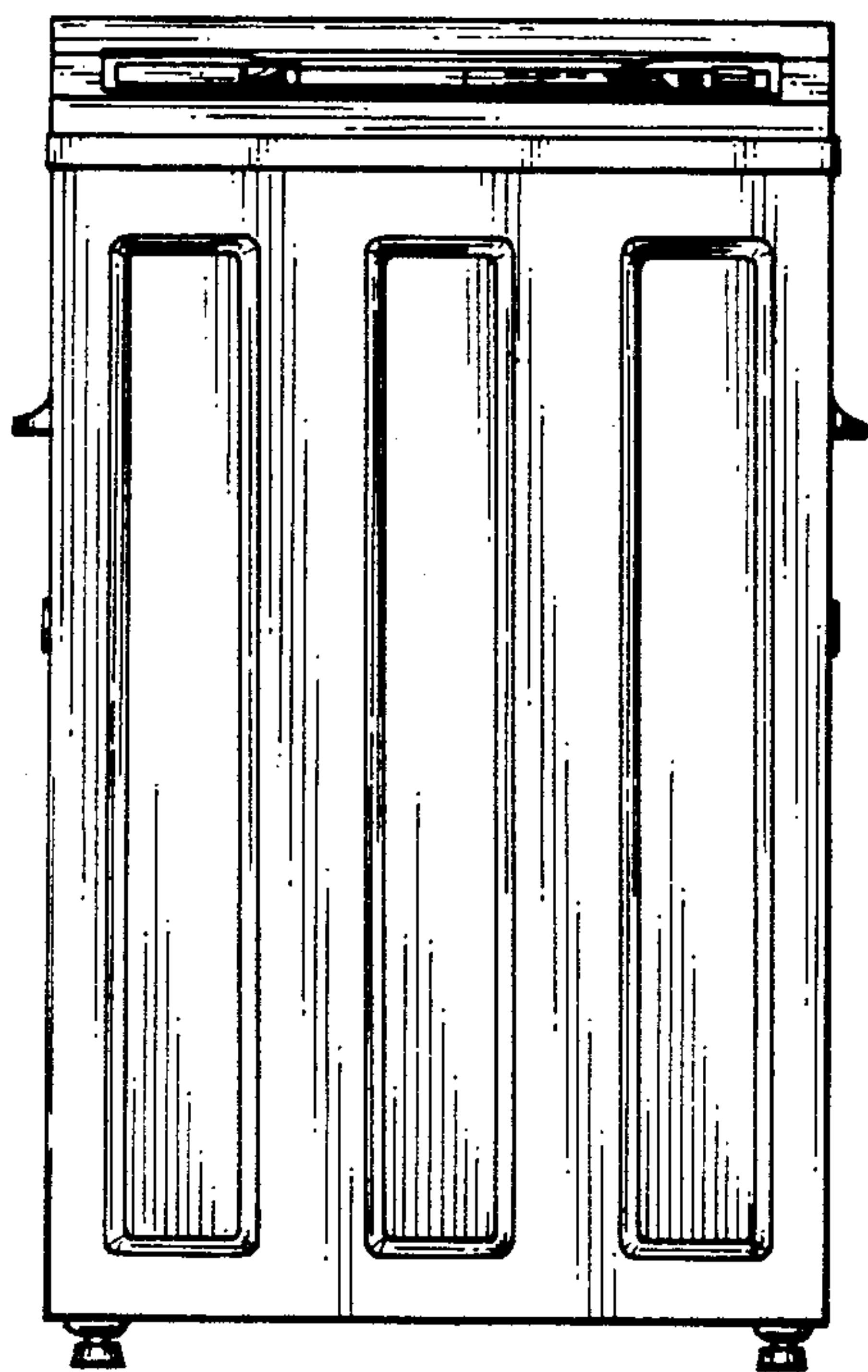

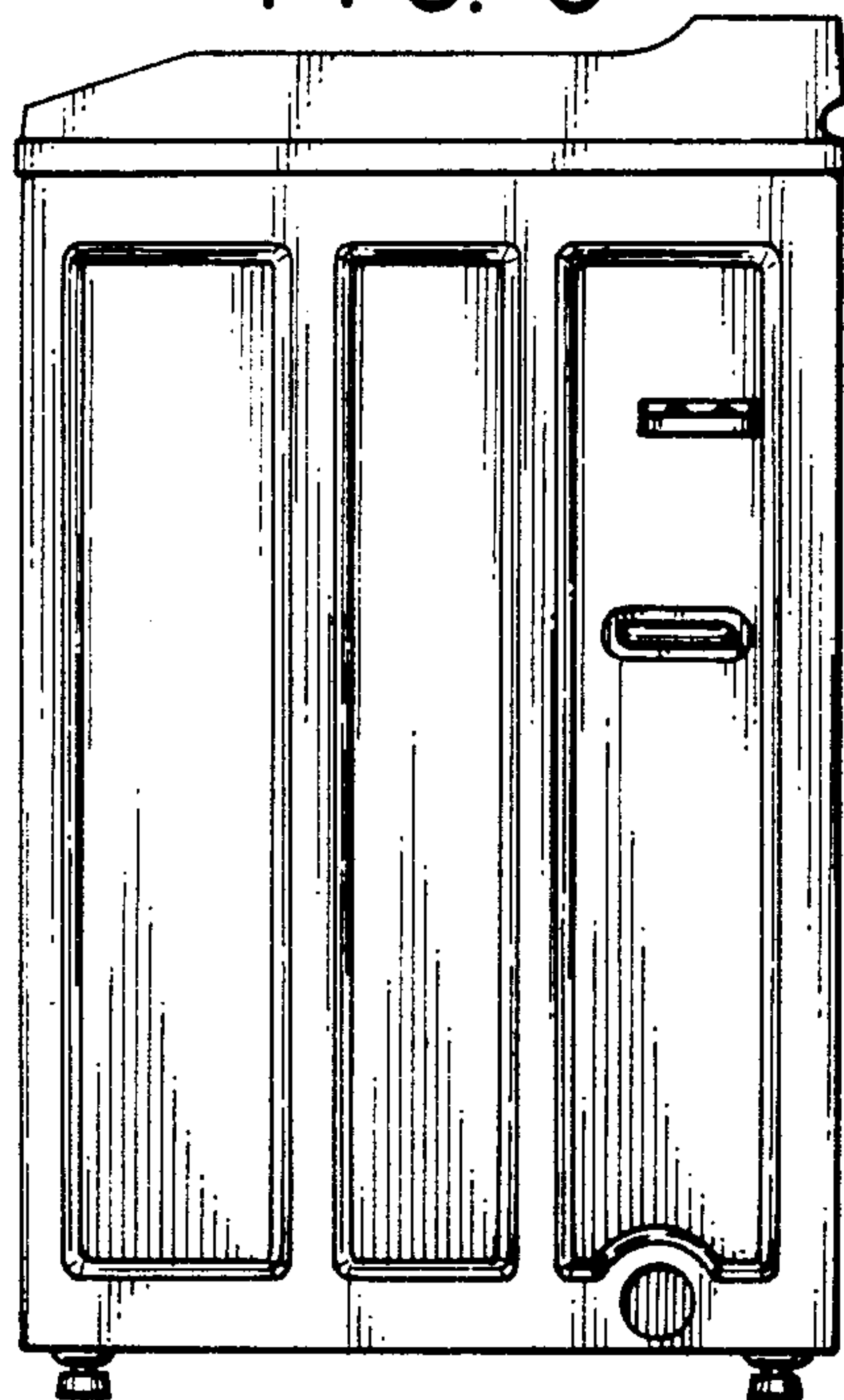

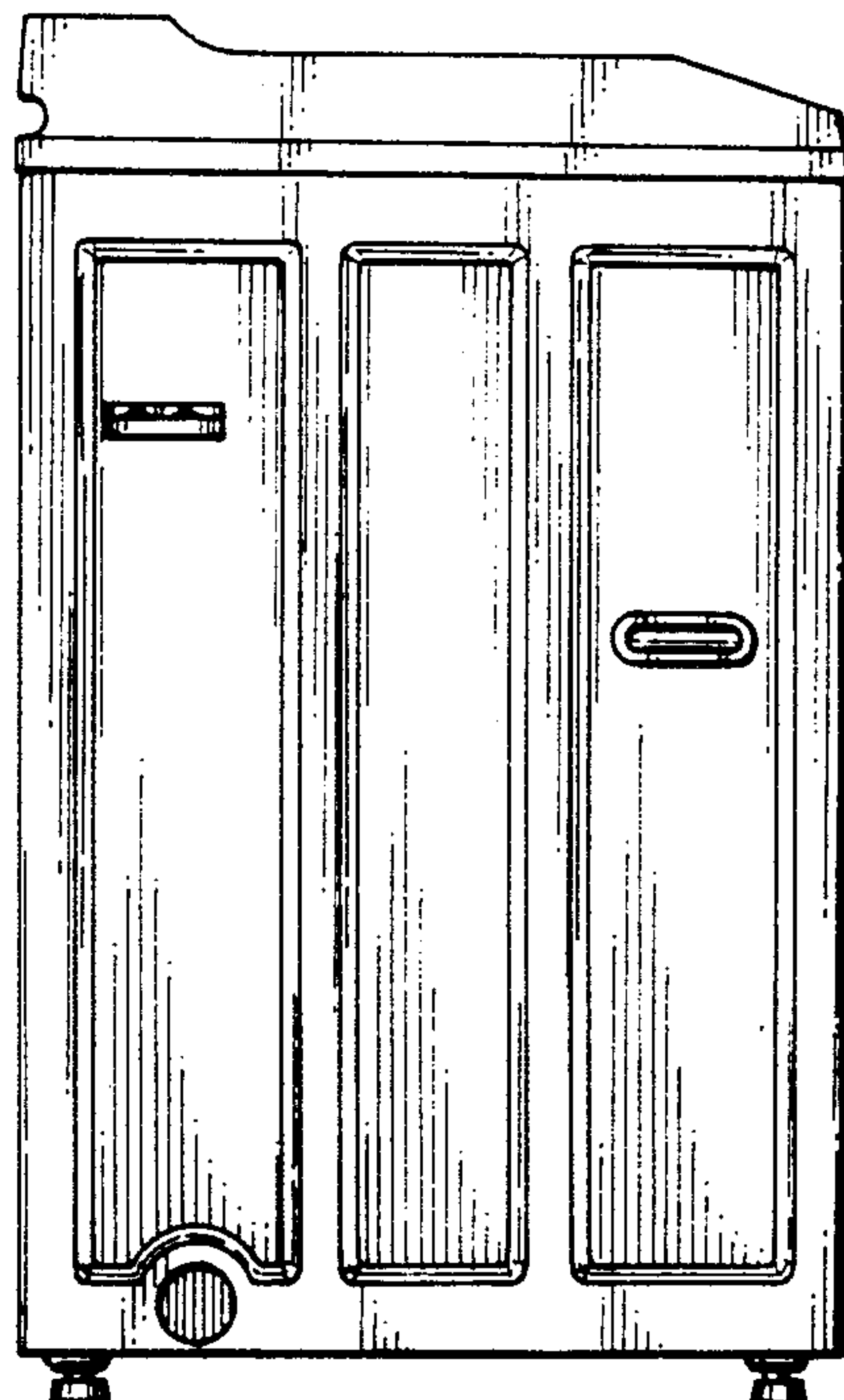

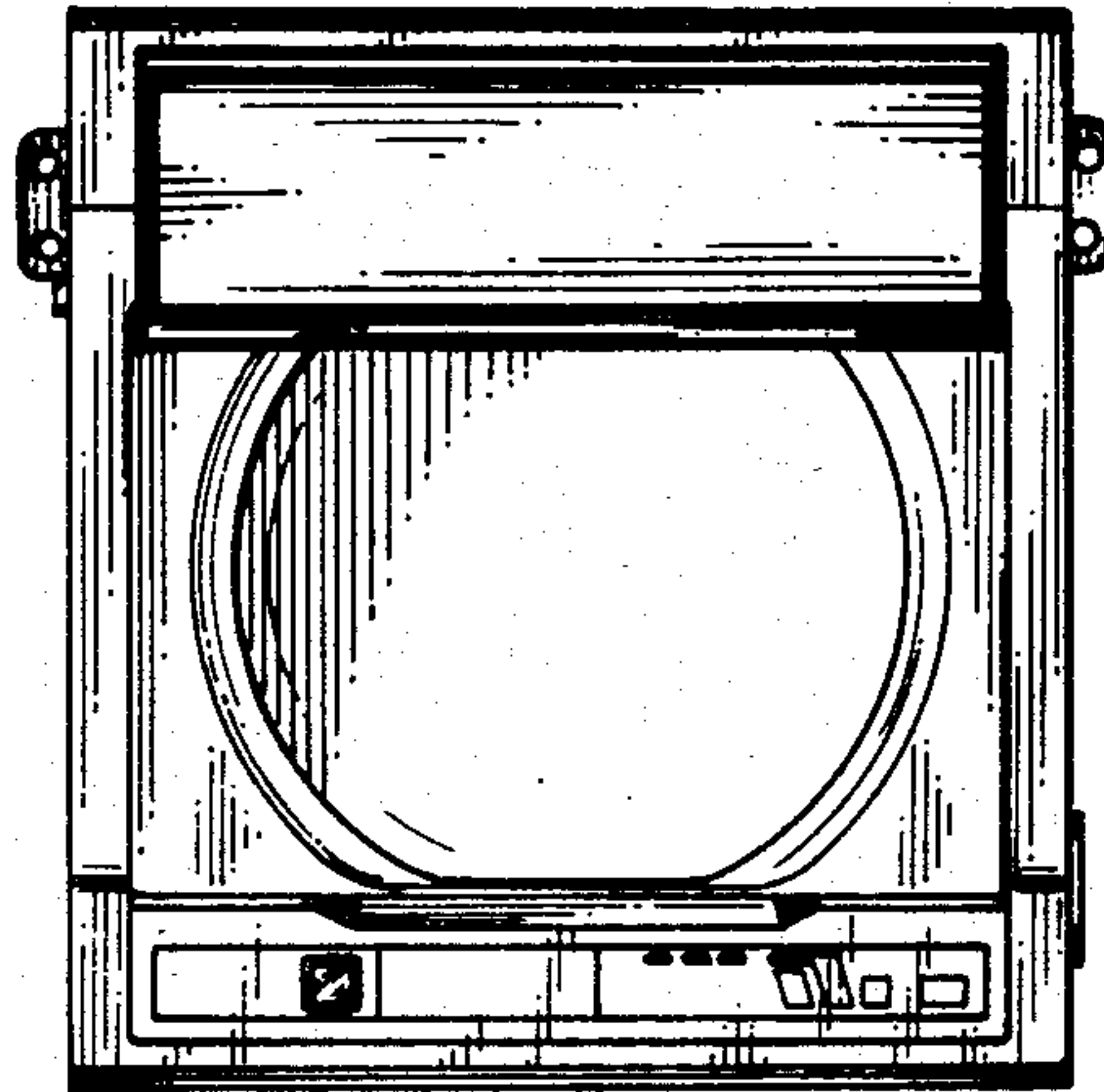
