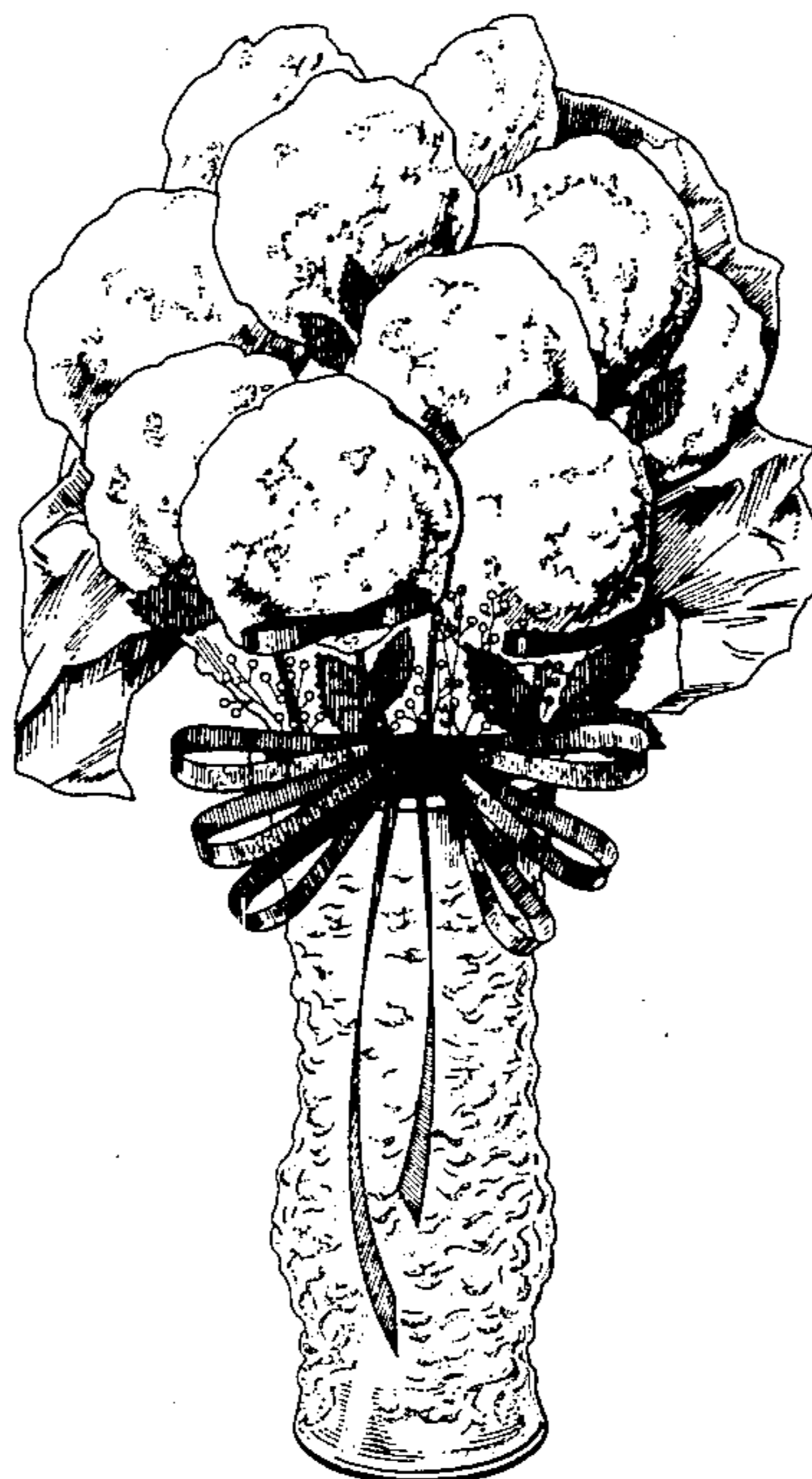

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof the right side being substantially a mirror image thereof.



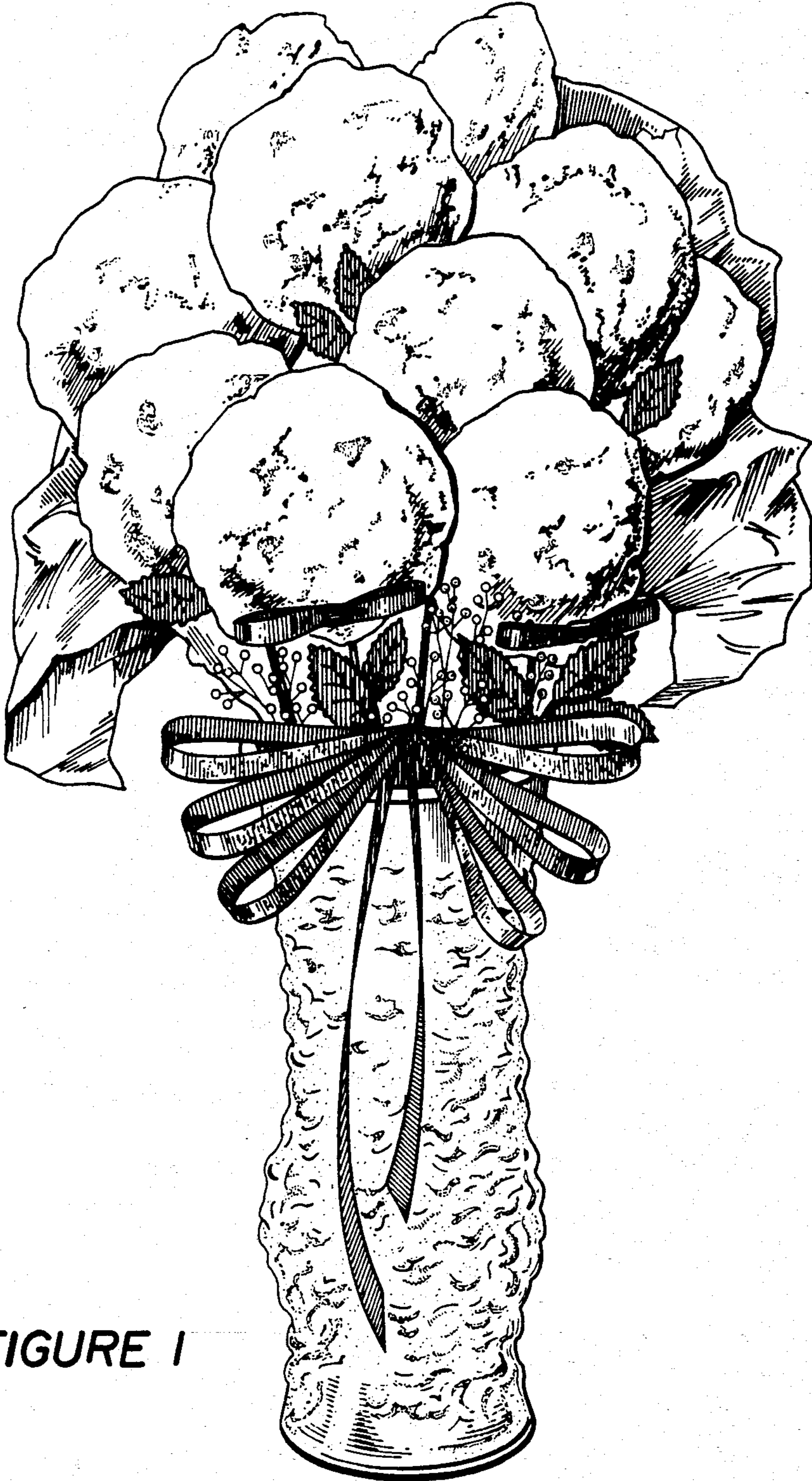

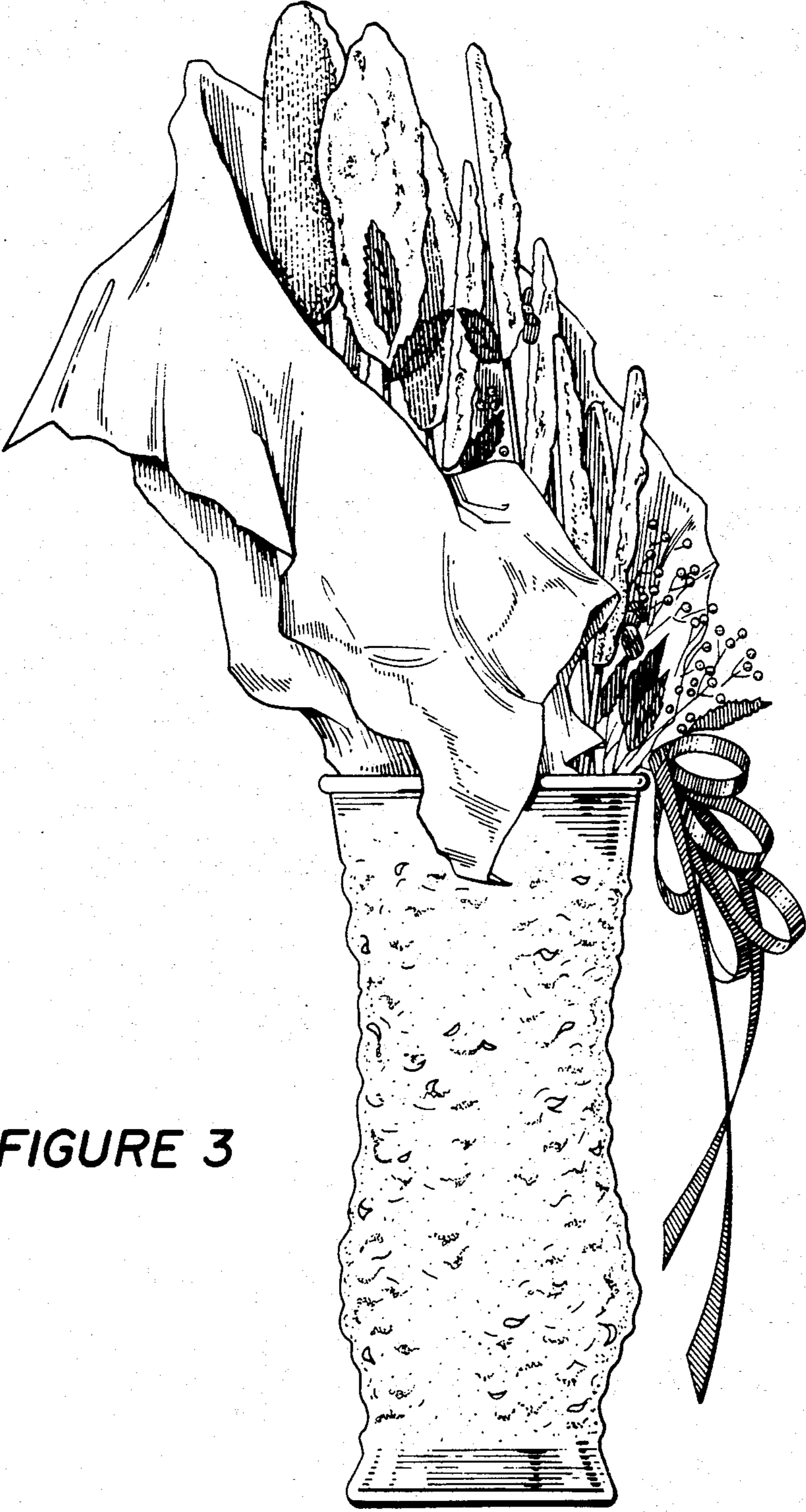
