

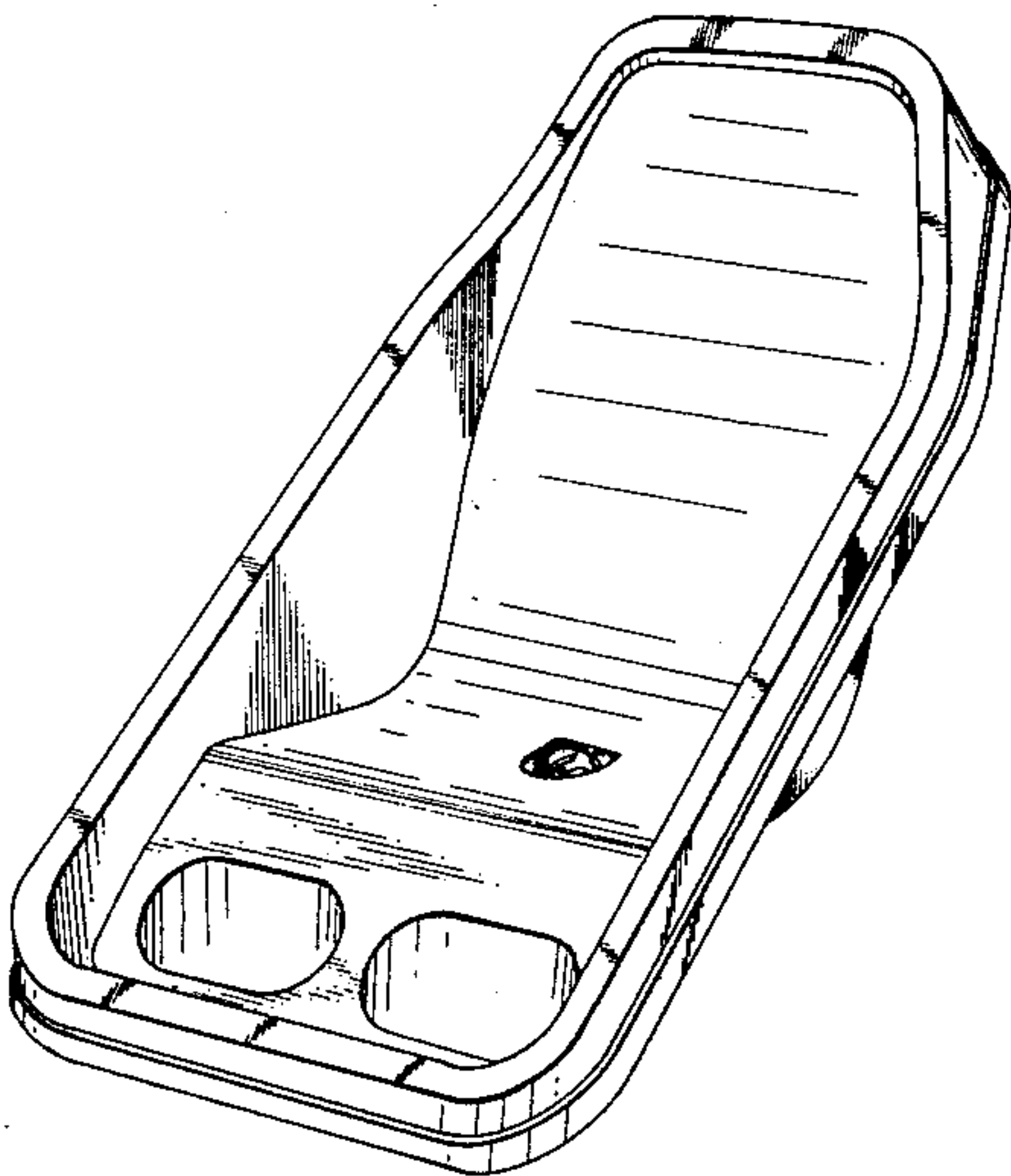

The ornamental design for an infant's bathtub, substan-
tially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front
and right side of an infant's bathtub showing our new
design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being a mirror image of the left side shown;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



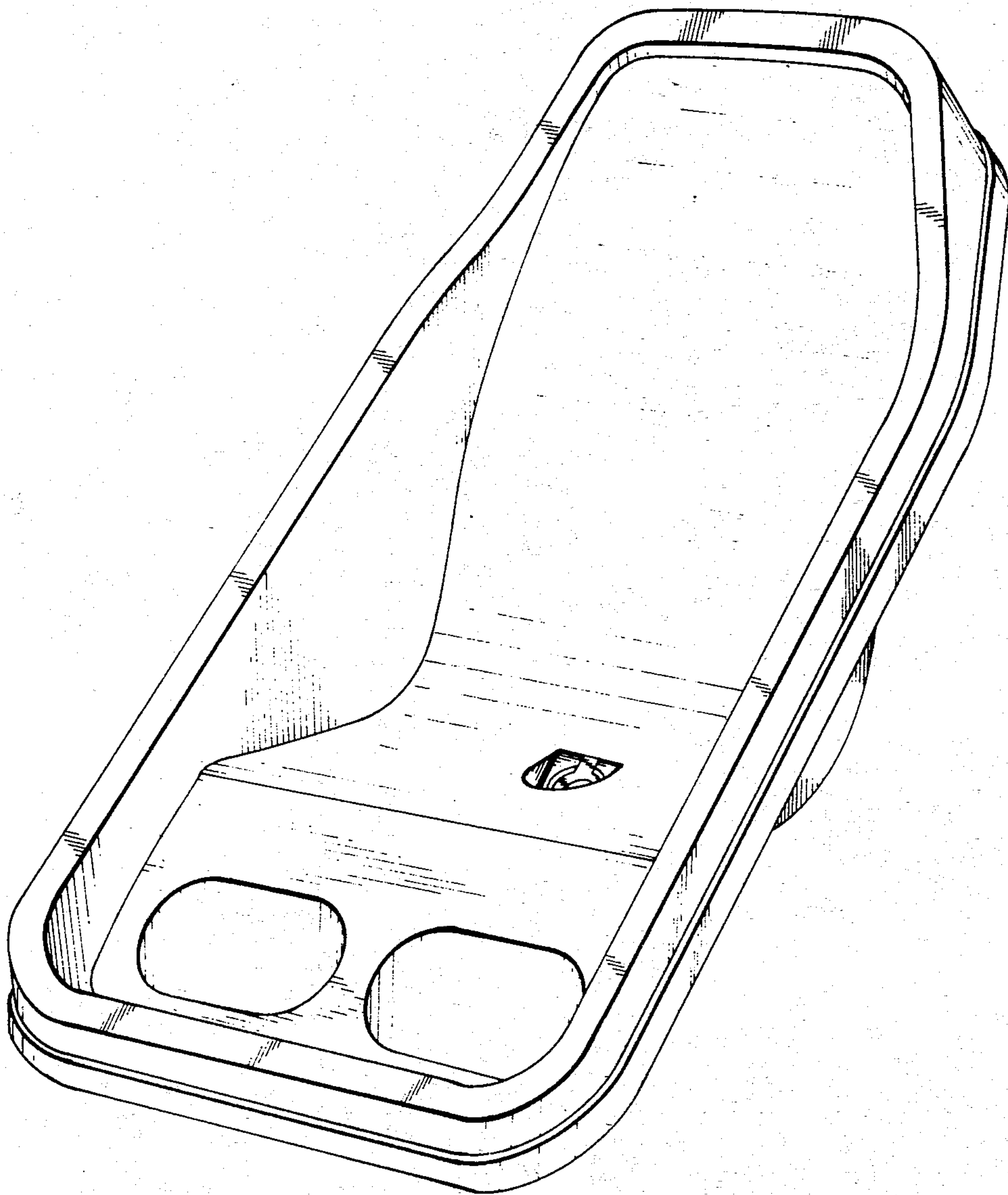

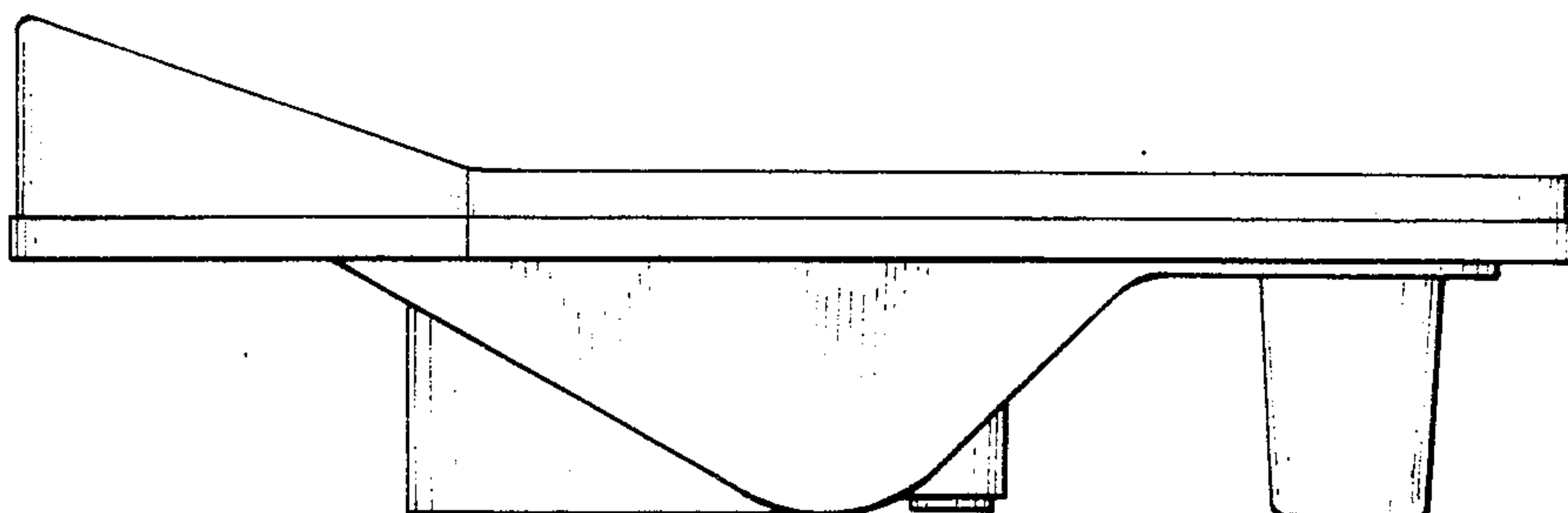

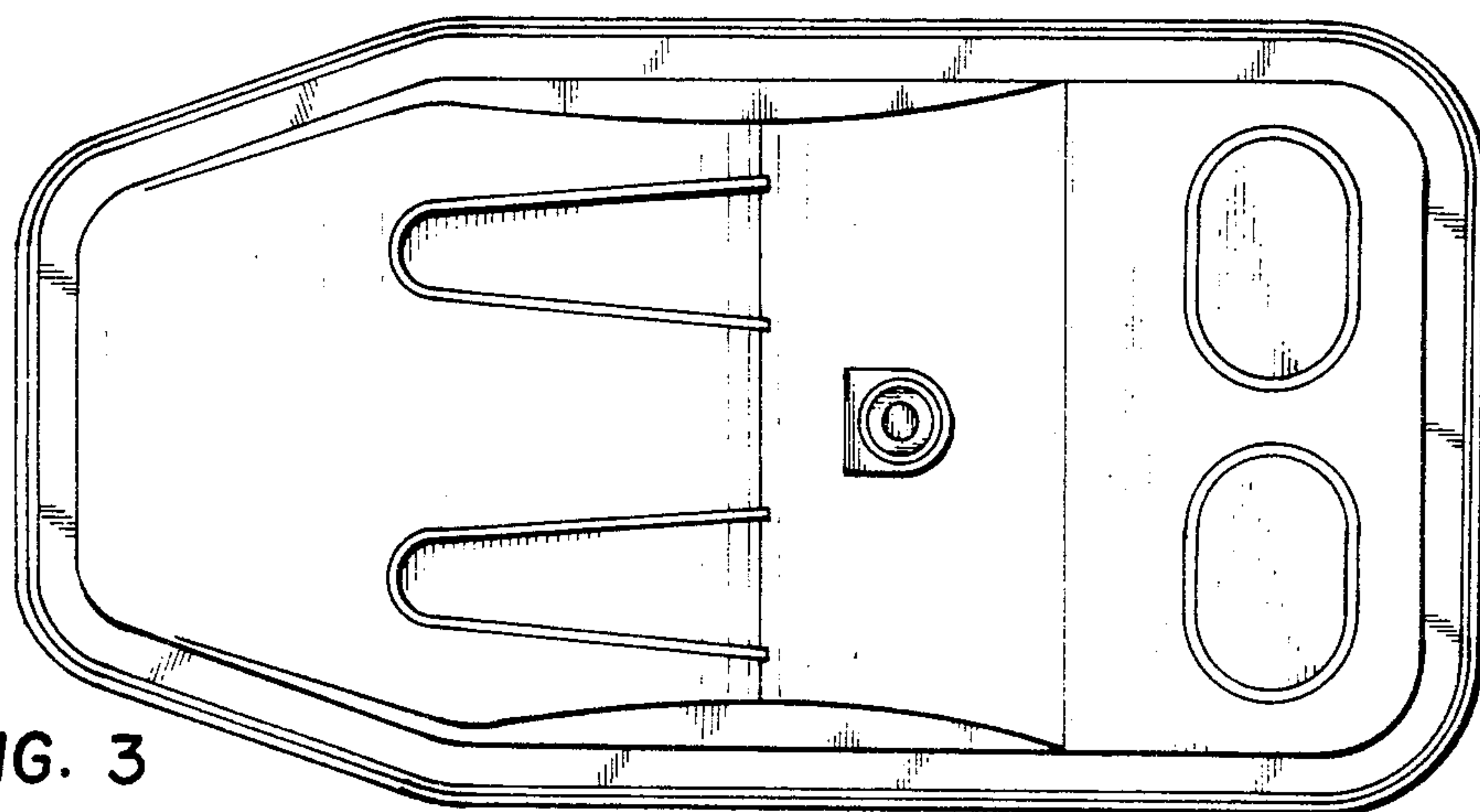

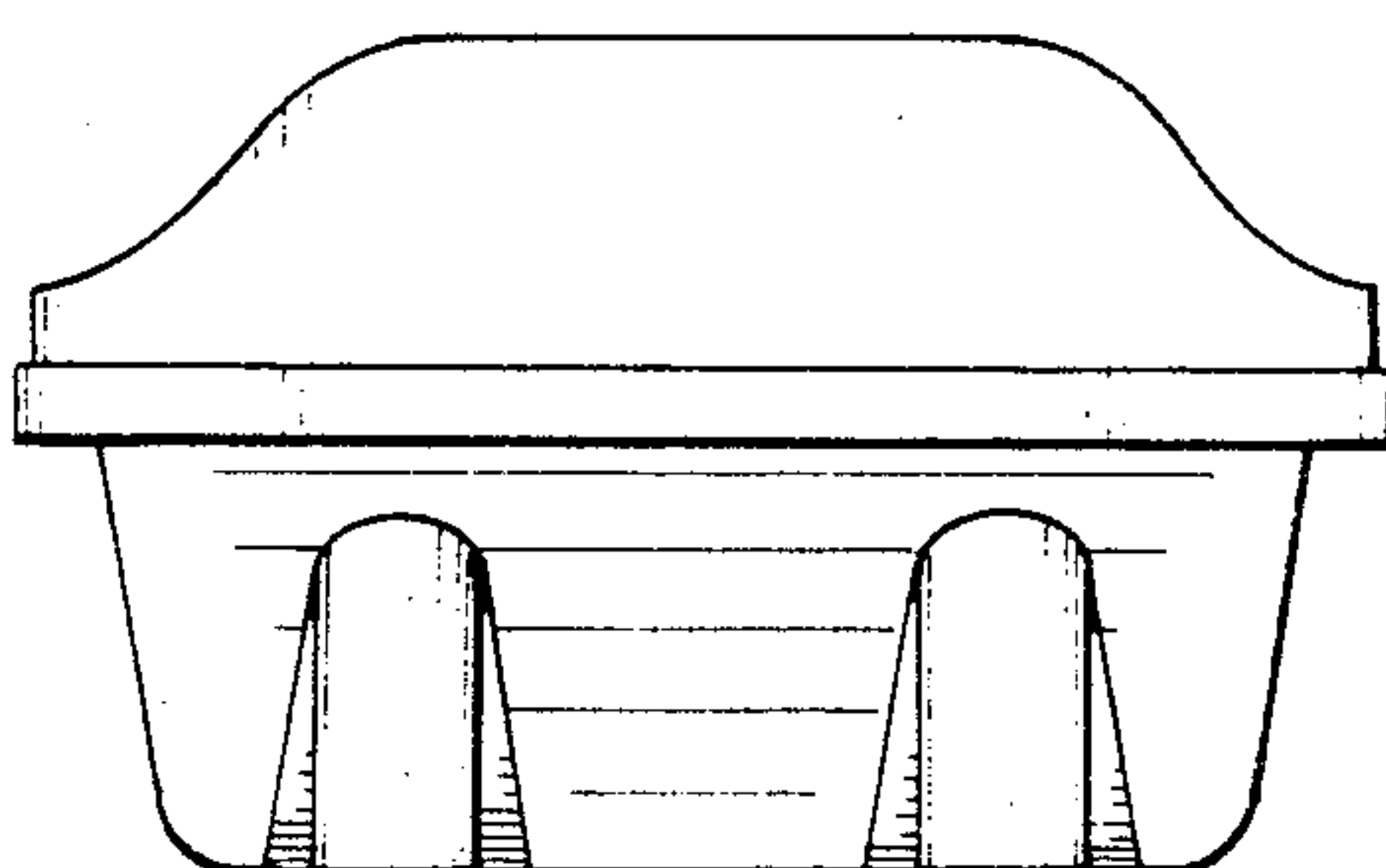
