The ornamental design for a water closet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front of a water closet to my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view from the front, left side and above thereof;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 2, but with the water closet seat raised; and
FIG. 4 is a perspective view from the left side thereof, the right side being a mirror image.

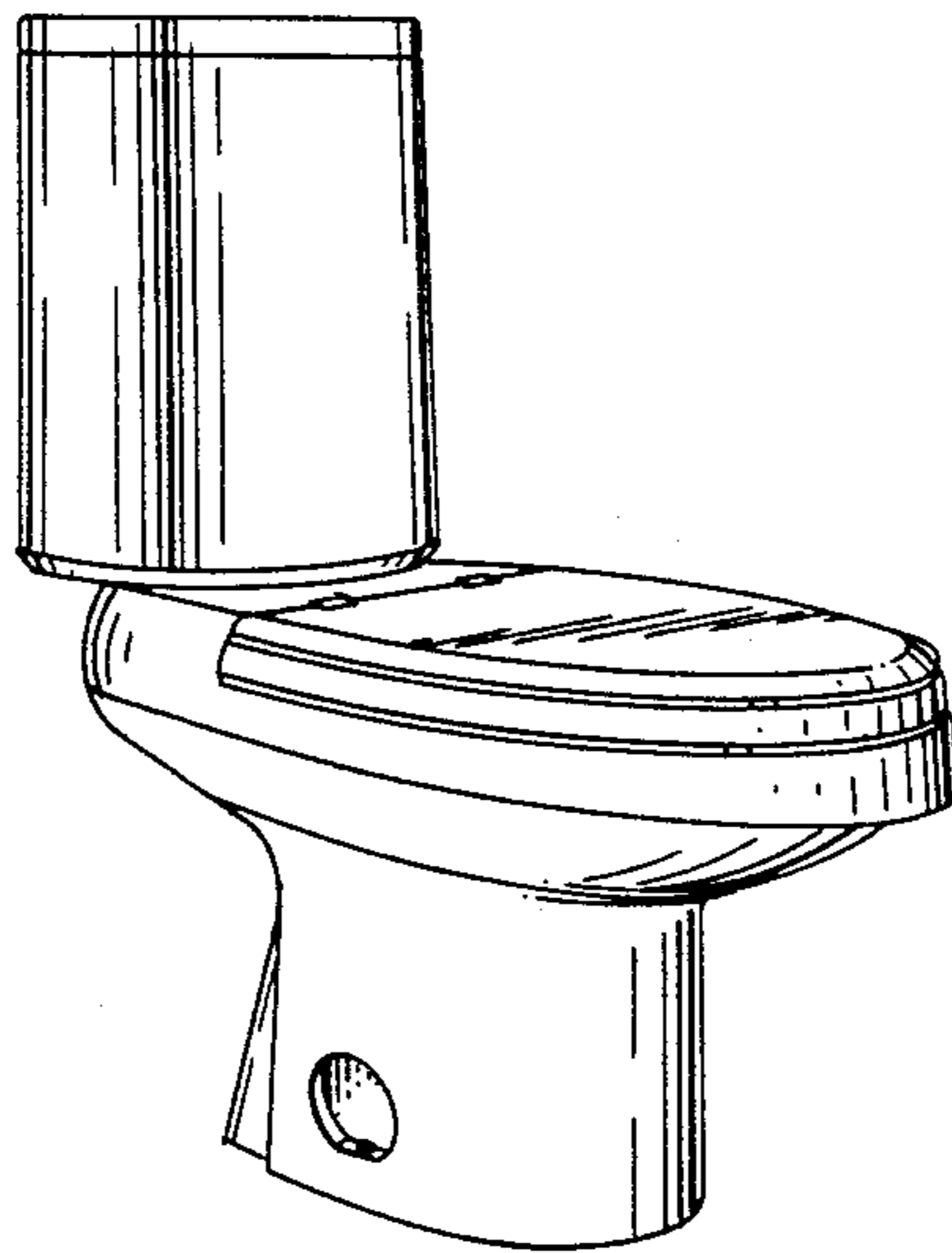

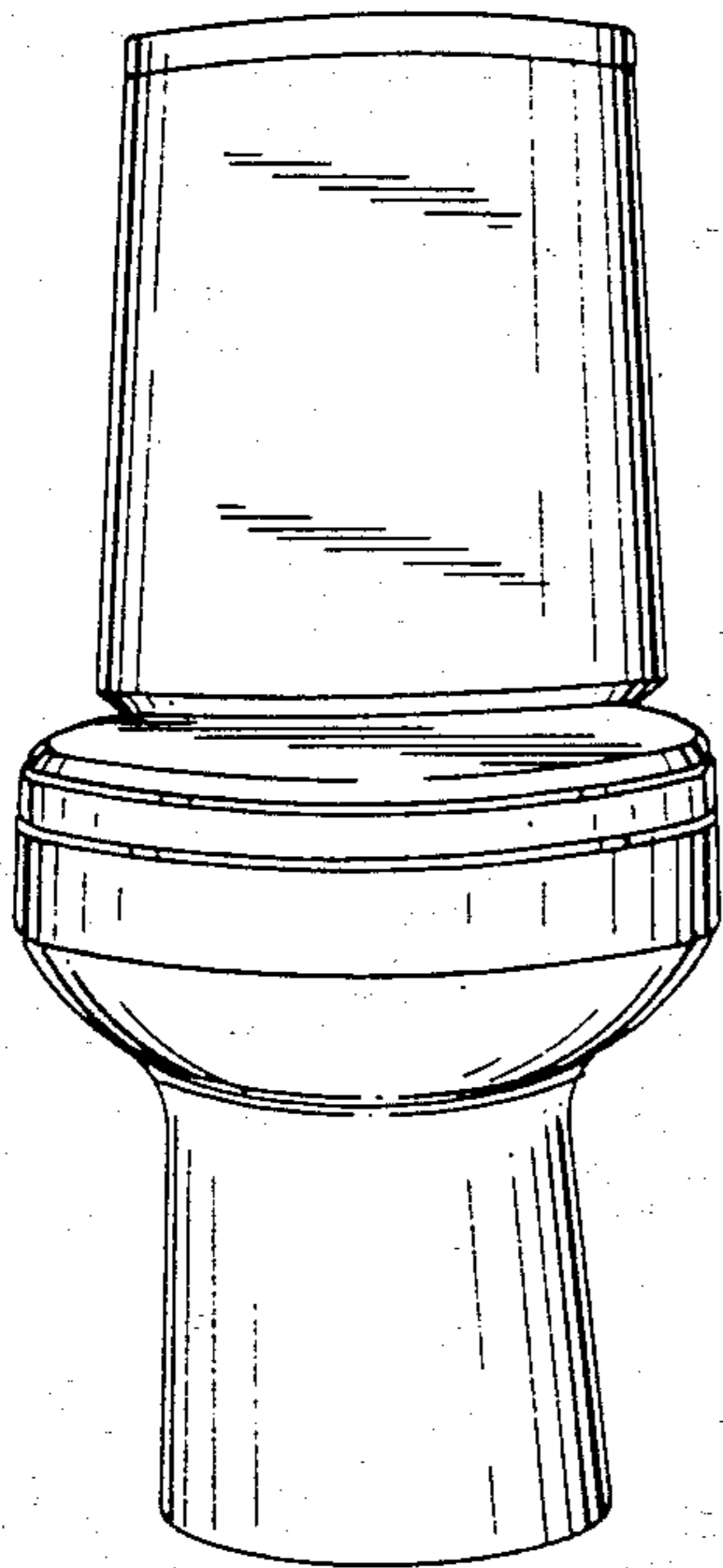

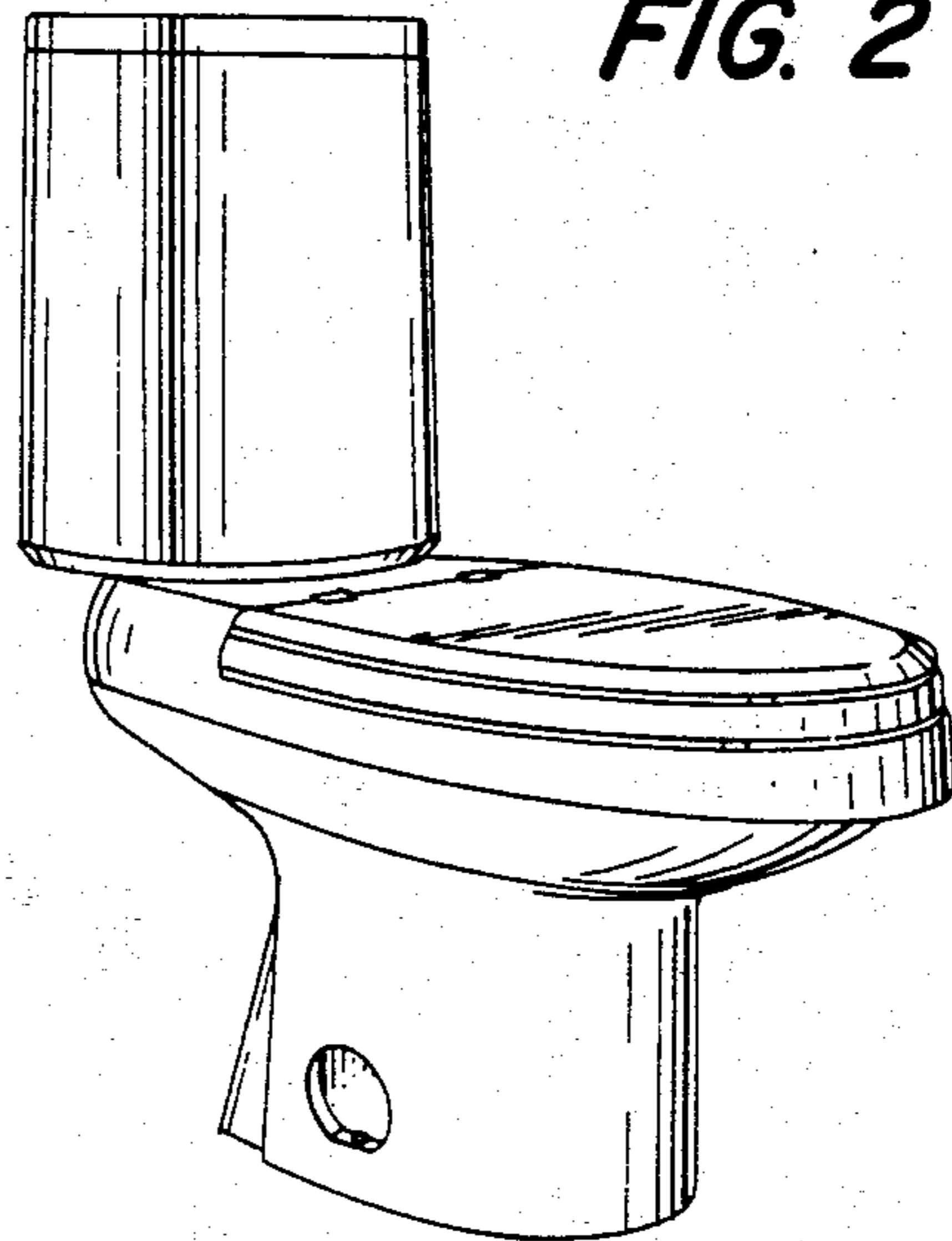

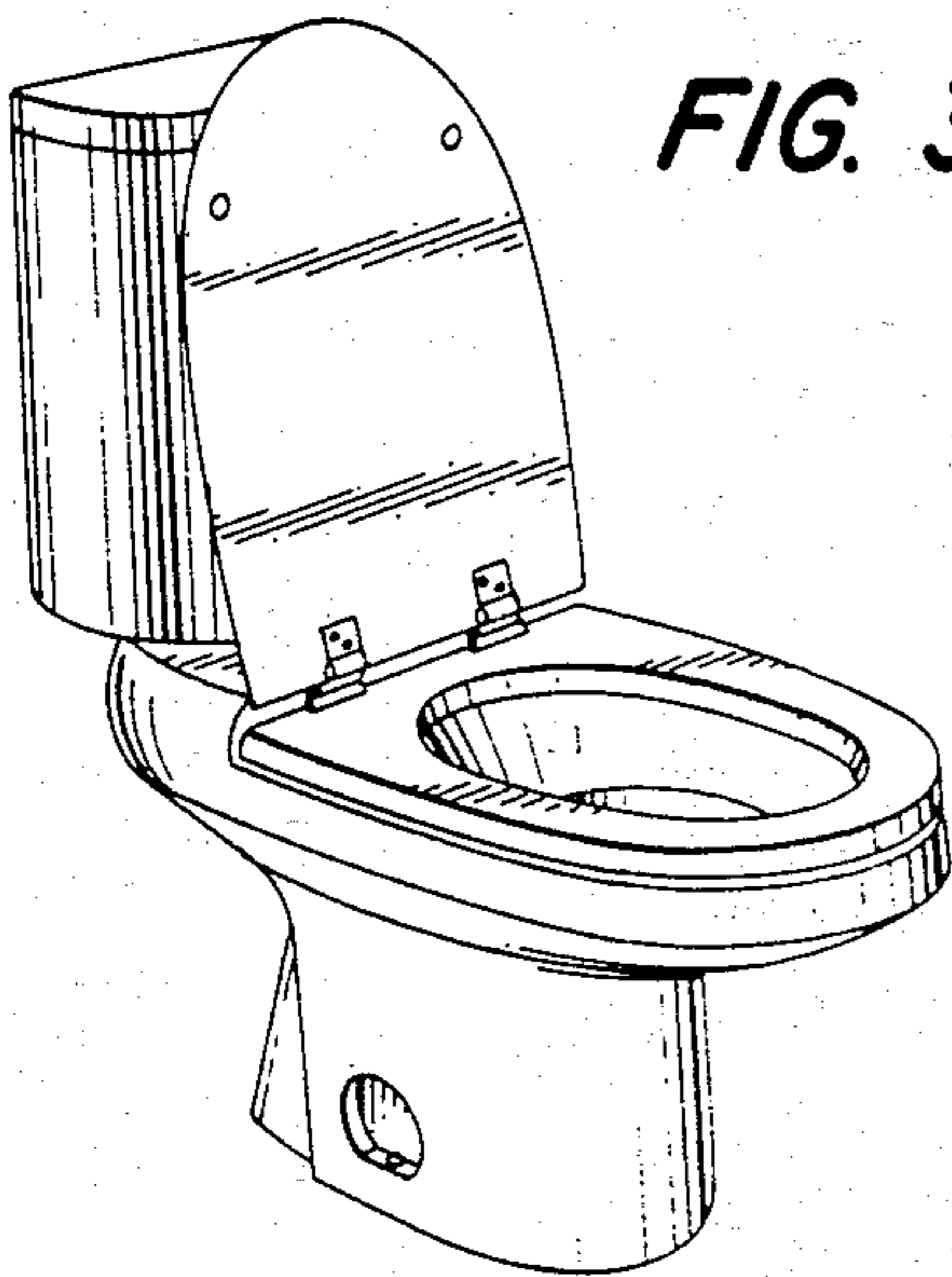
