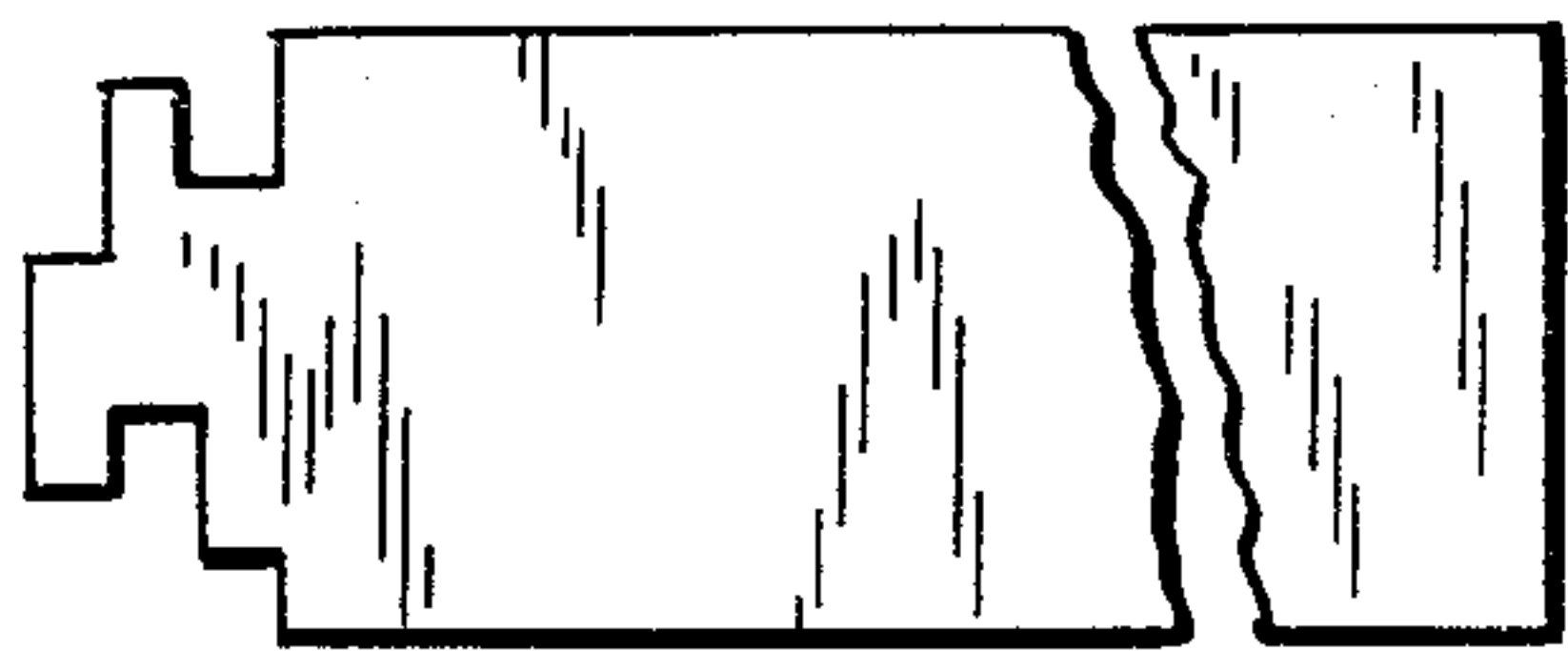

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a partition rail, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the partition rail of the design,
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view of the partition rail;
FIG. 3 is a second embodiment of the partition rail showing a modified cross-section;
FIG. 4 is a third embodiment of the partition rail showing a further modified cross-section; and,
FIG. 5 is a fourth embodiment of the partition rail showing a further modified cross-section.



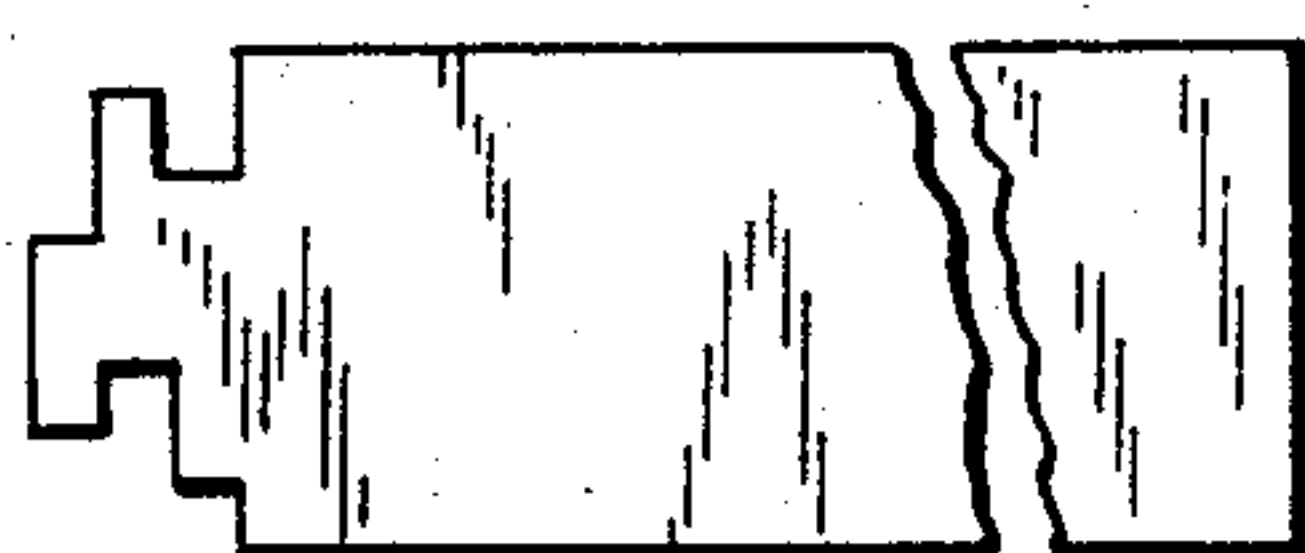
