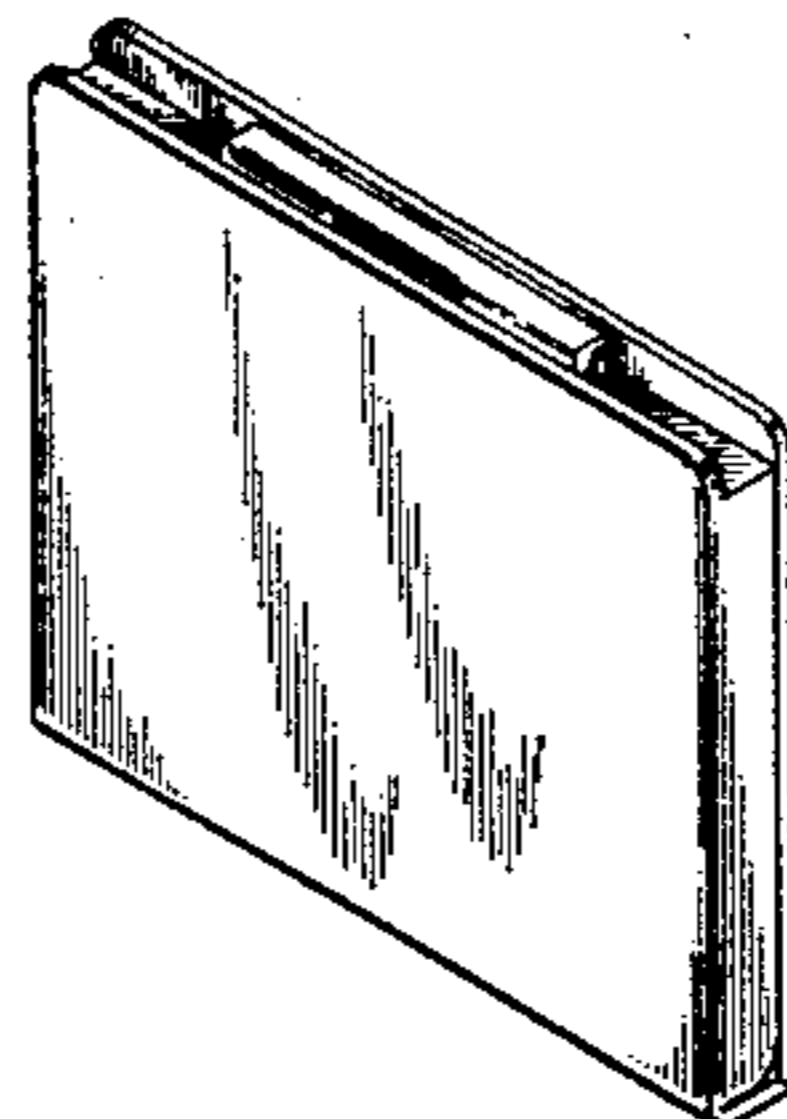
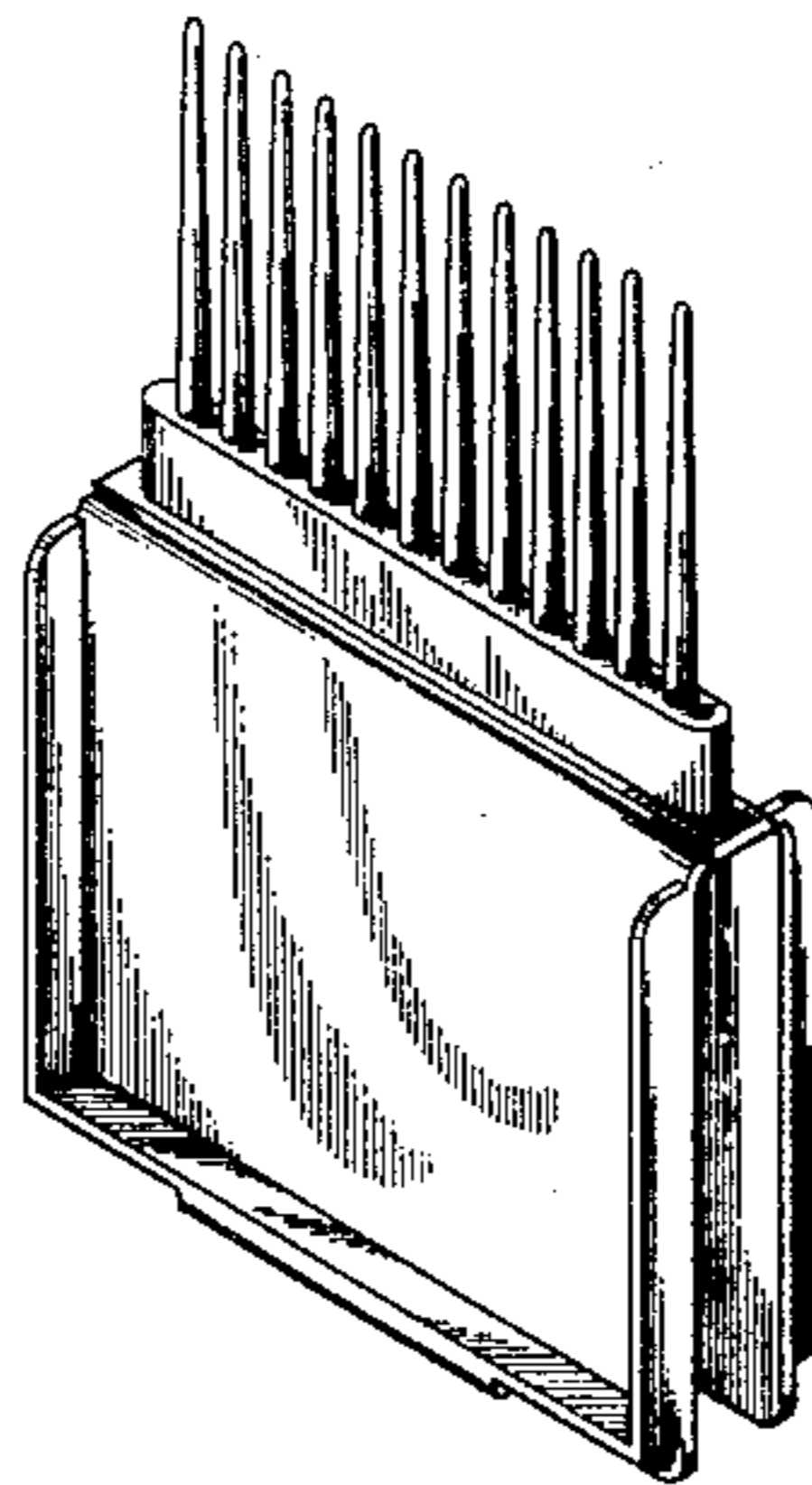

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an encased hair pick with handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an encased hair pick with handle in an open position showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view in a closed position thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view in elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front view in elevation thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side view in elevation thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear view in elevation thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



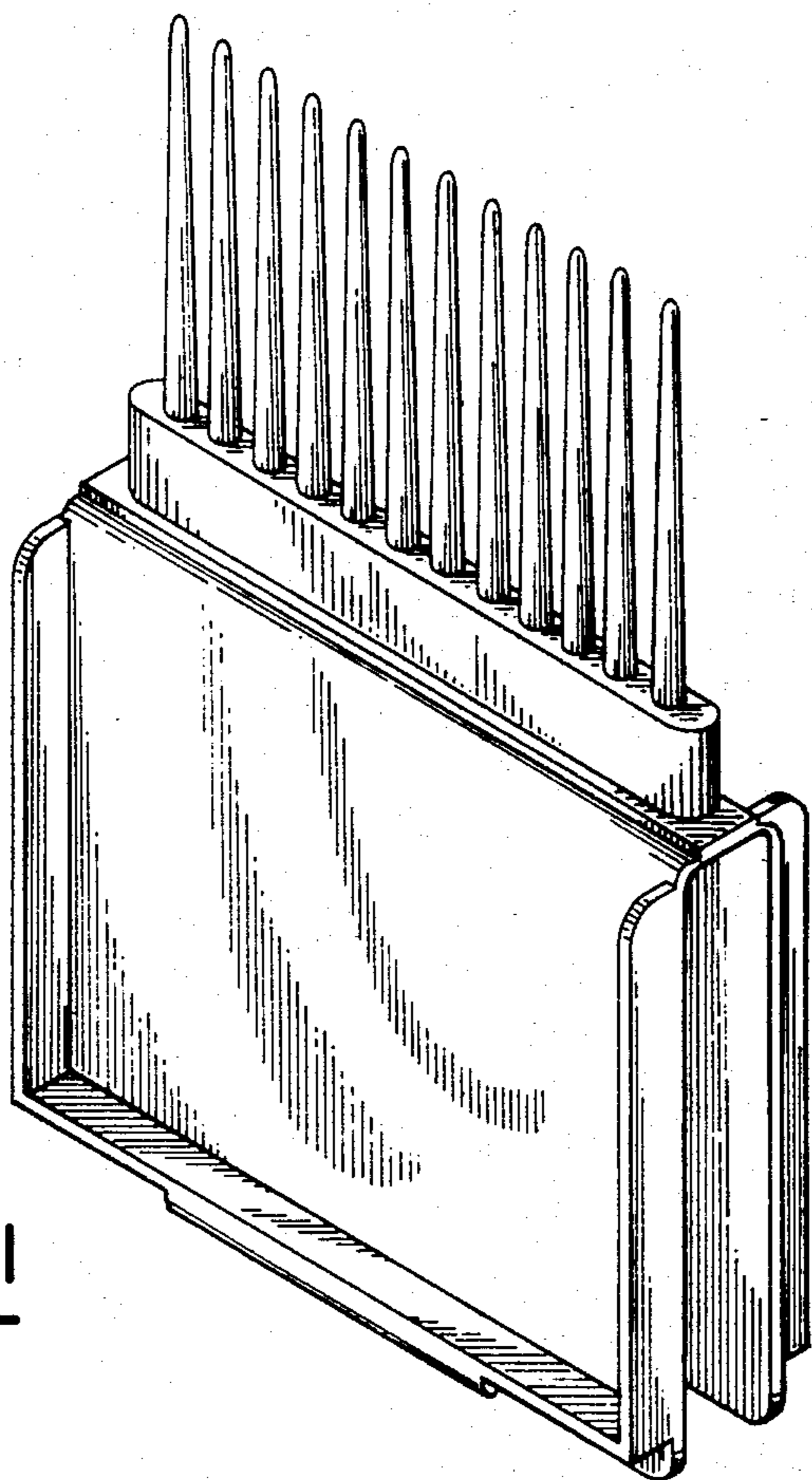

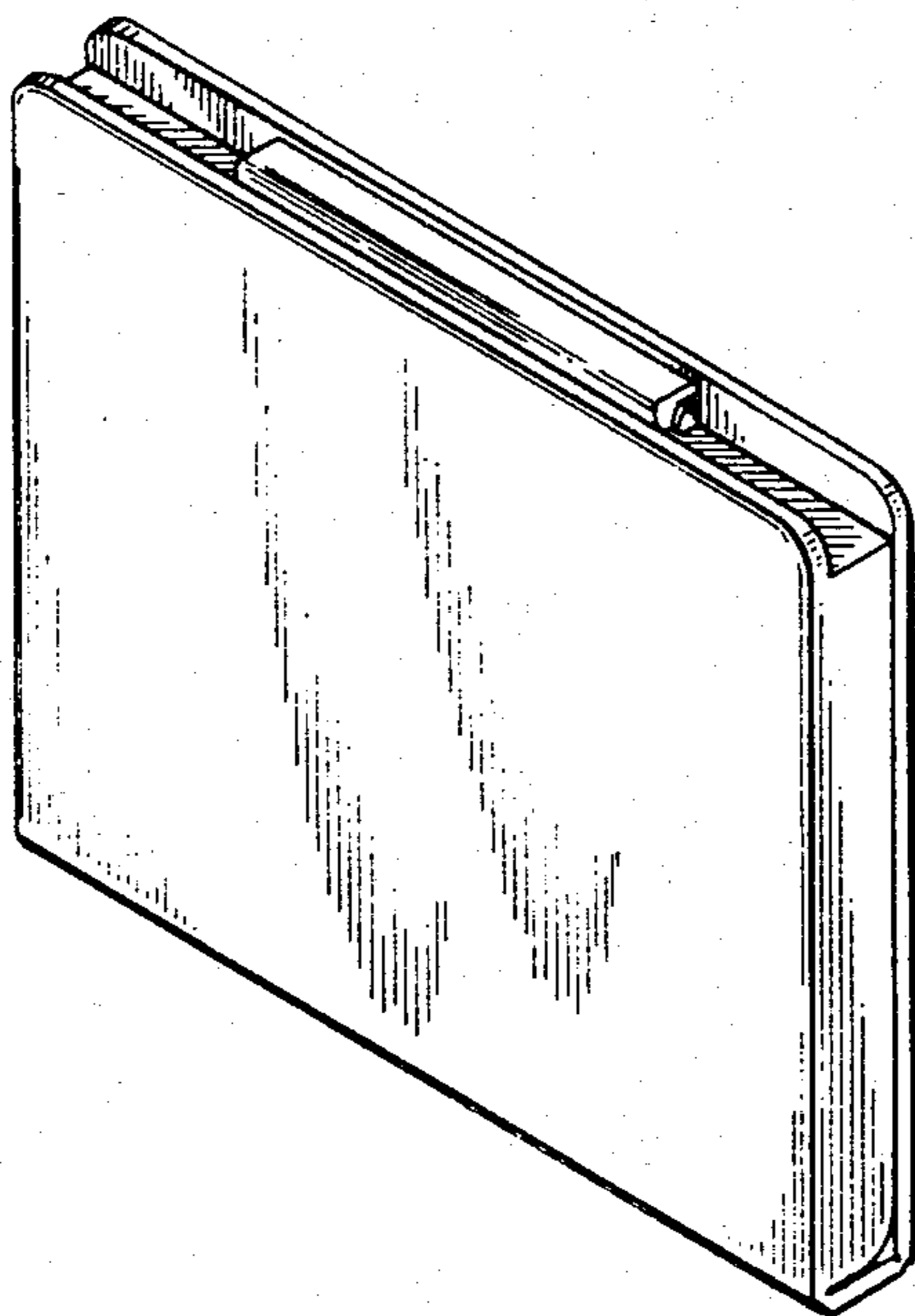

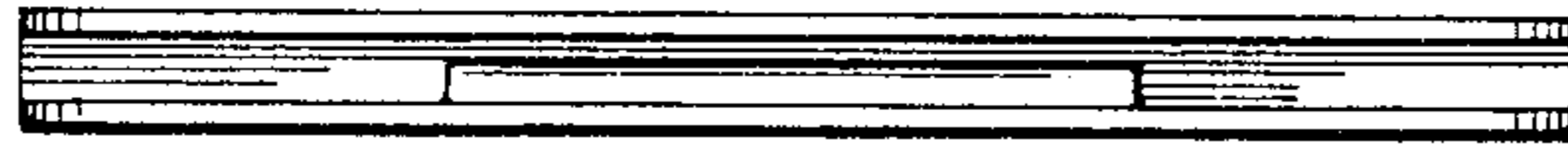

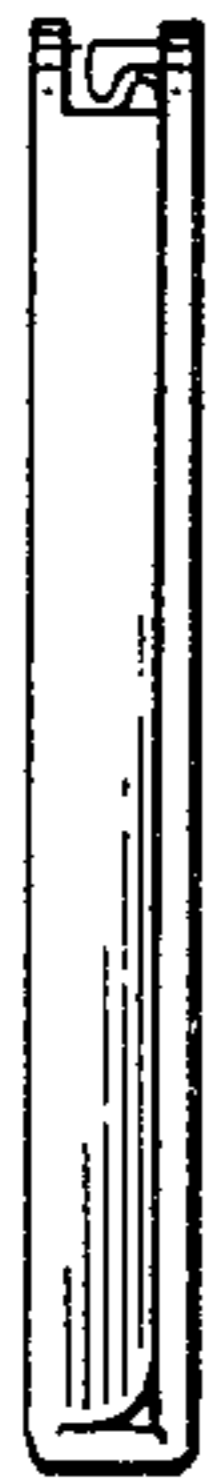

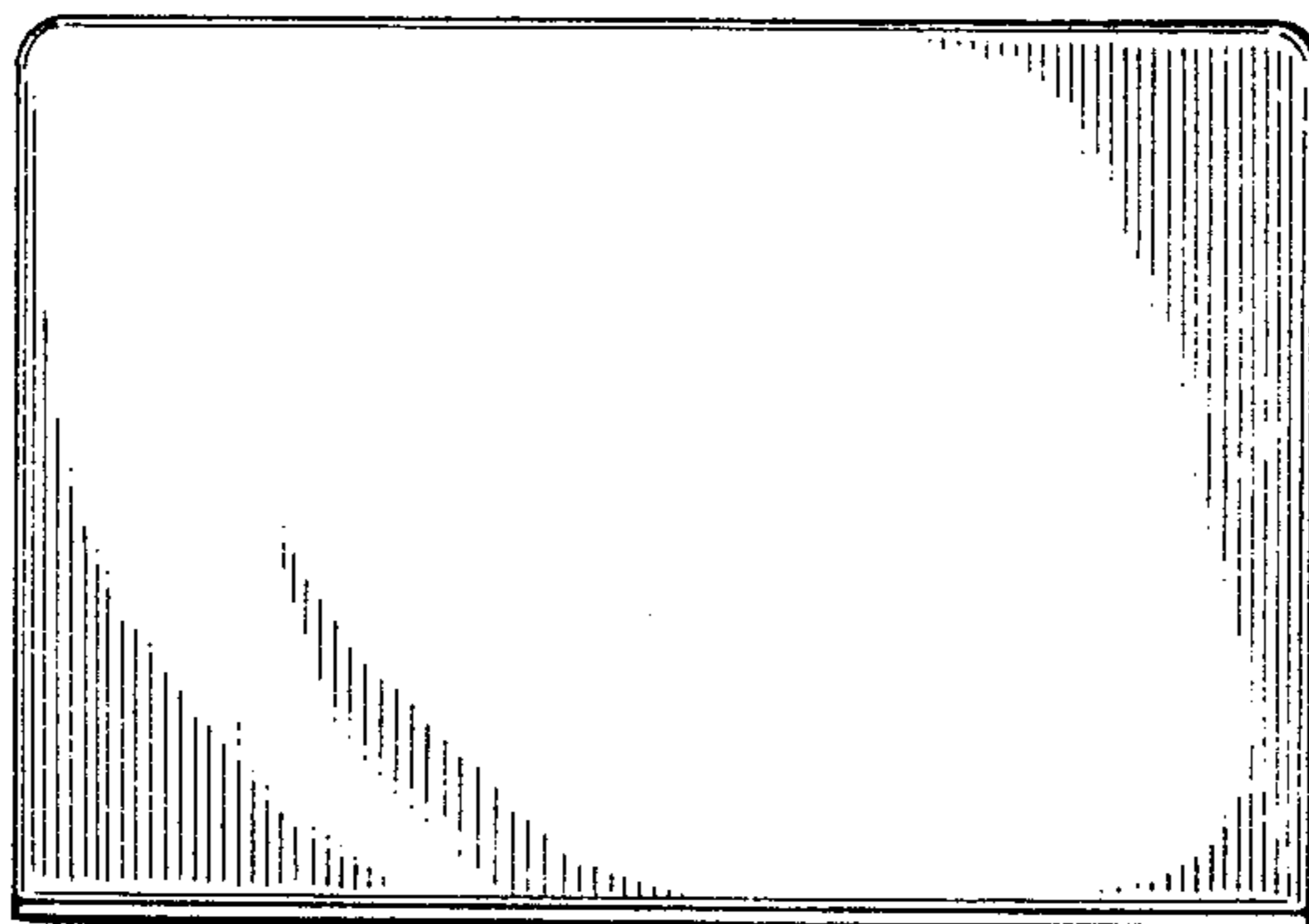

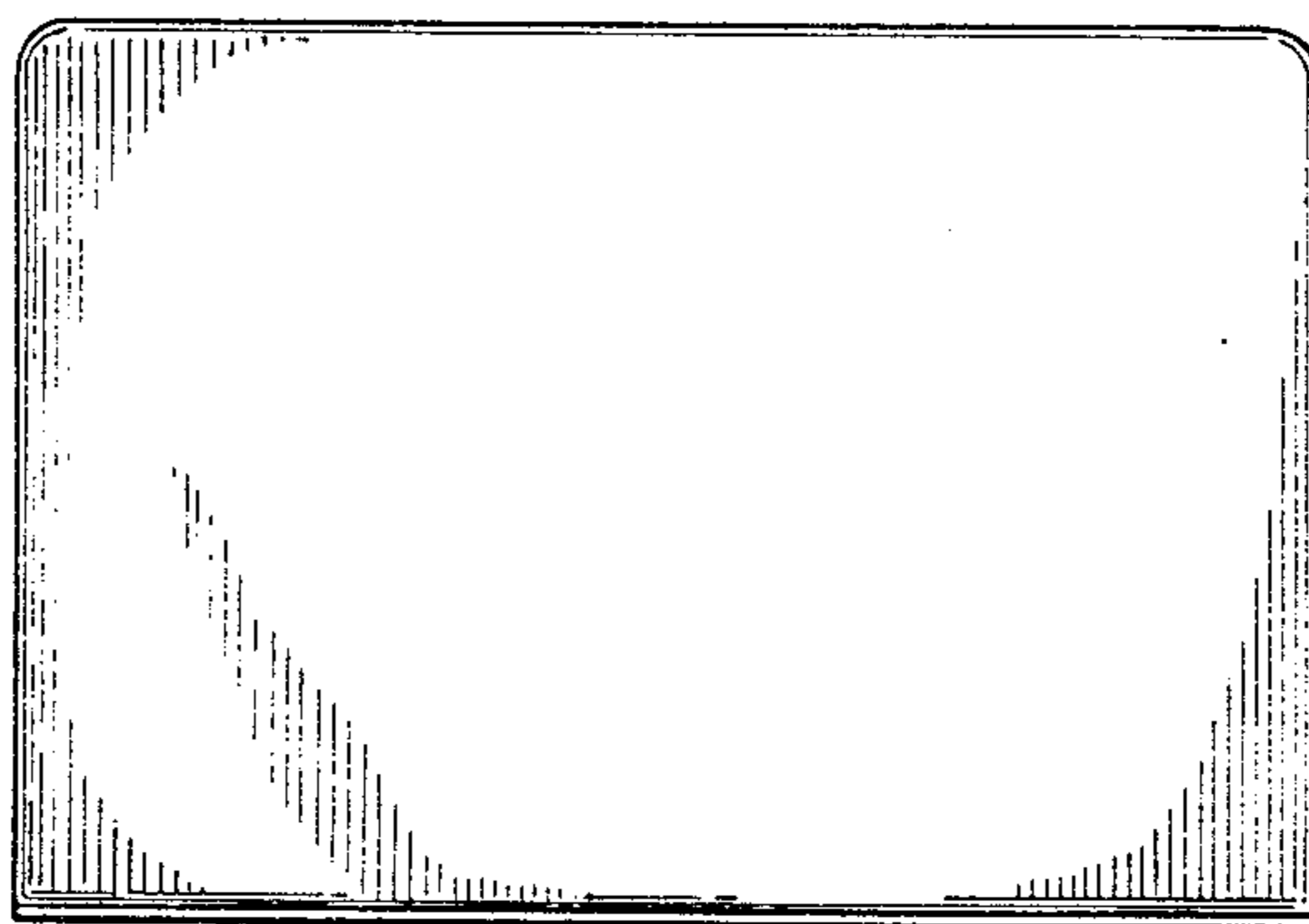
