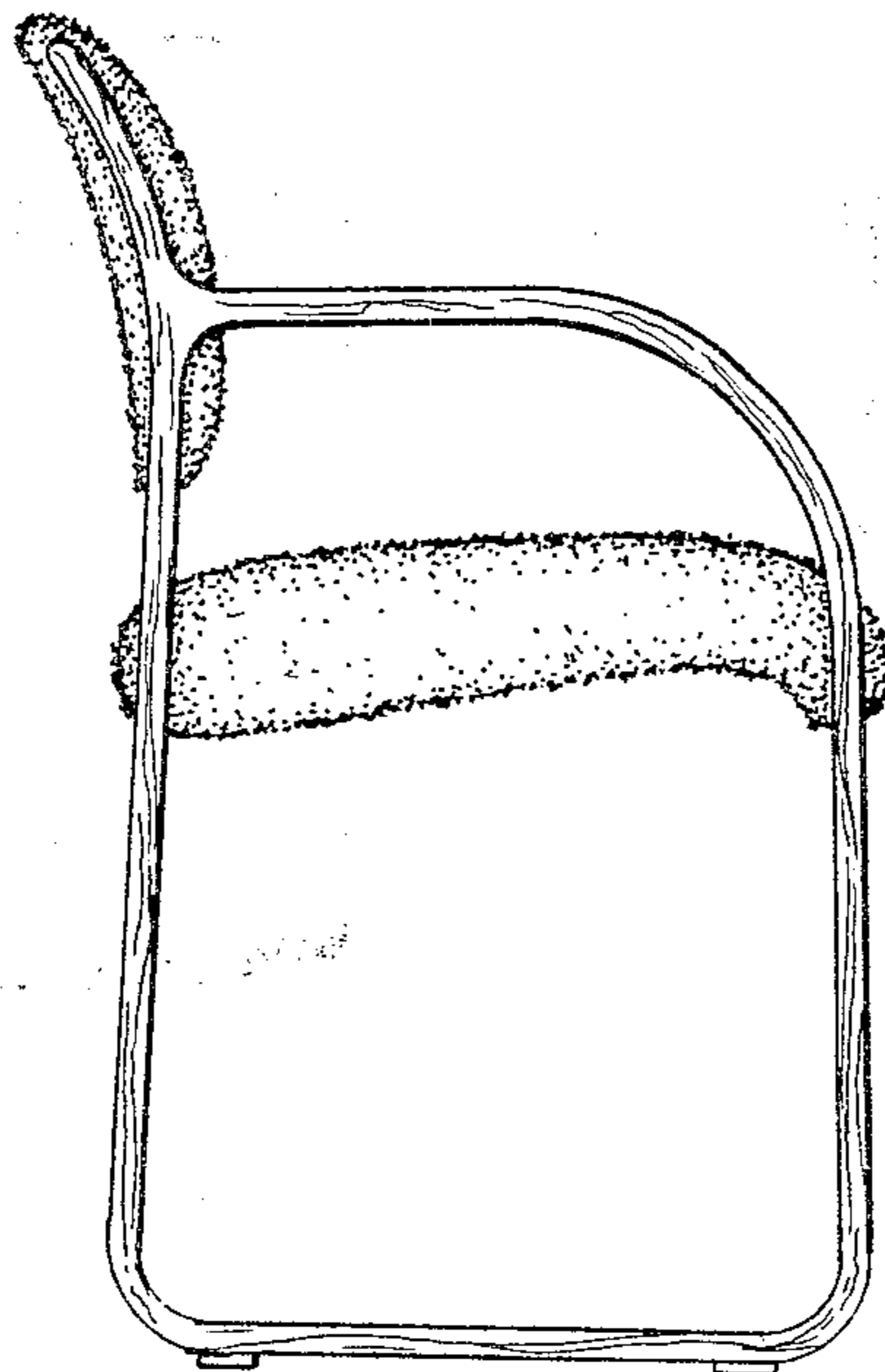

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof, the other side being substantially a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a first alternative embodiment of the chair shown in FIGS. 1-6;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIGS. 7 and 8, the other side being substantially a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIGS. 7-9;
FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of a second alternative embodiment;
FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 11;
FIG. 13 is a side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIGS. 11 and 12, the other side being substantially a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIGS. 11-13;
FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment shown in FIGS. 11-14; and
FIG. 16 is a perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIGS. 11-15.
FIG. 17 is a side elevational view of a third alternative embodiment having added ornamentation at the juncture between the chair arm and back on the chair frame.



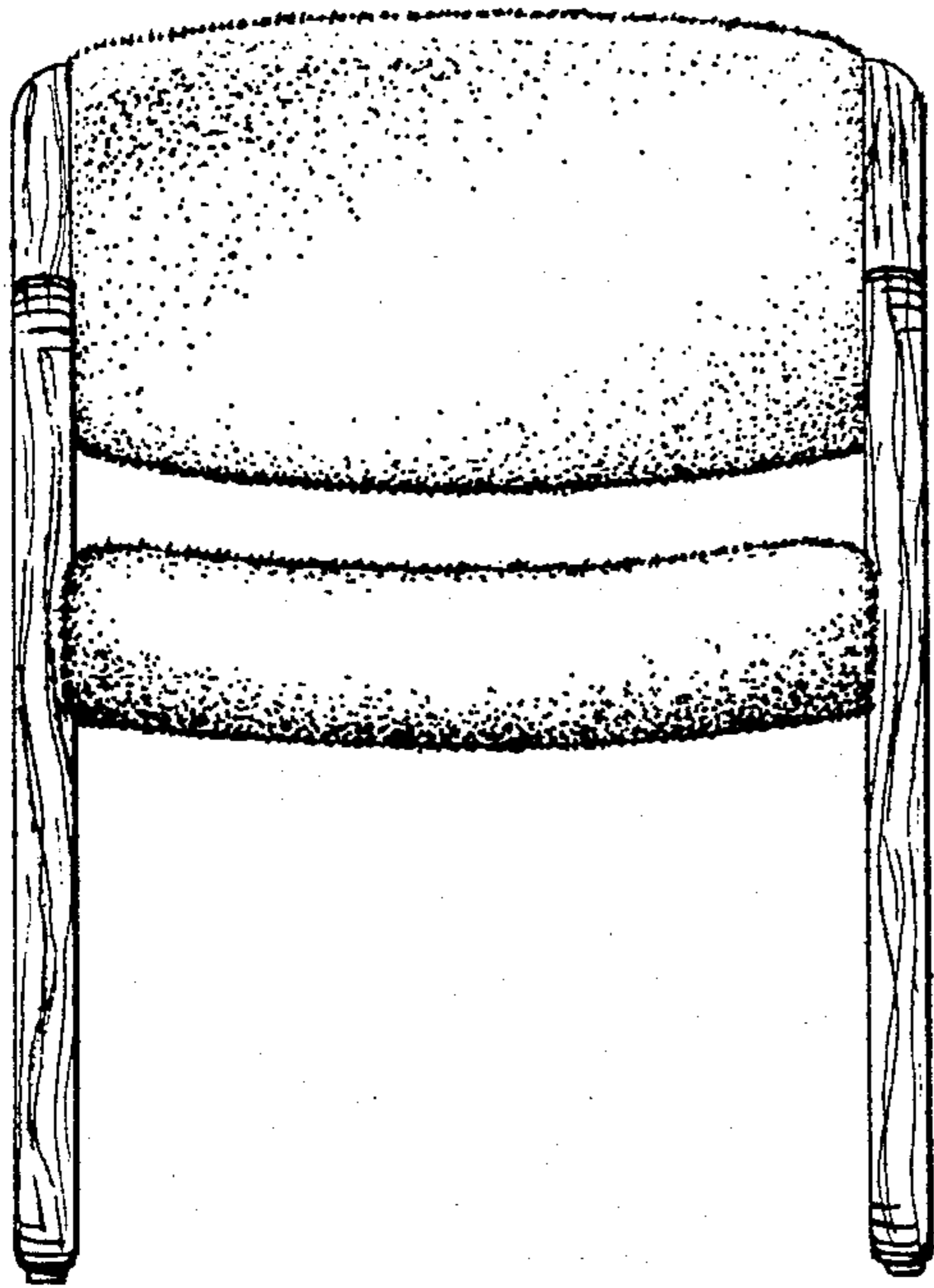

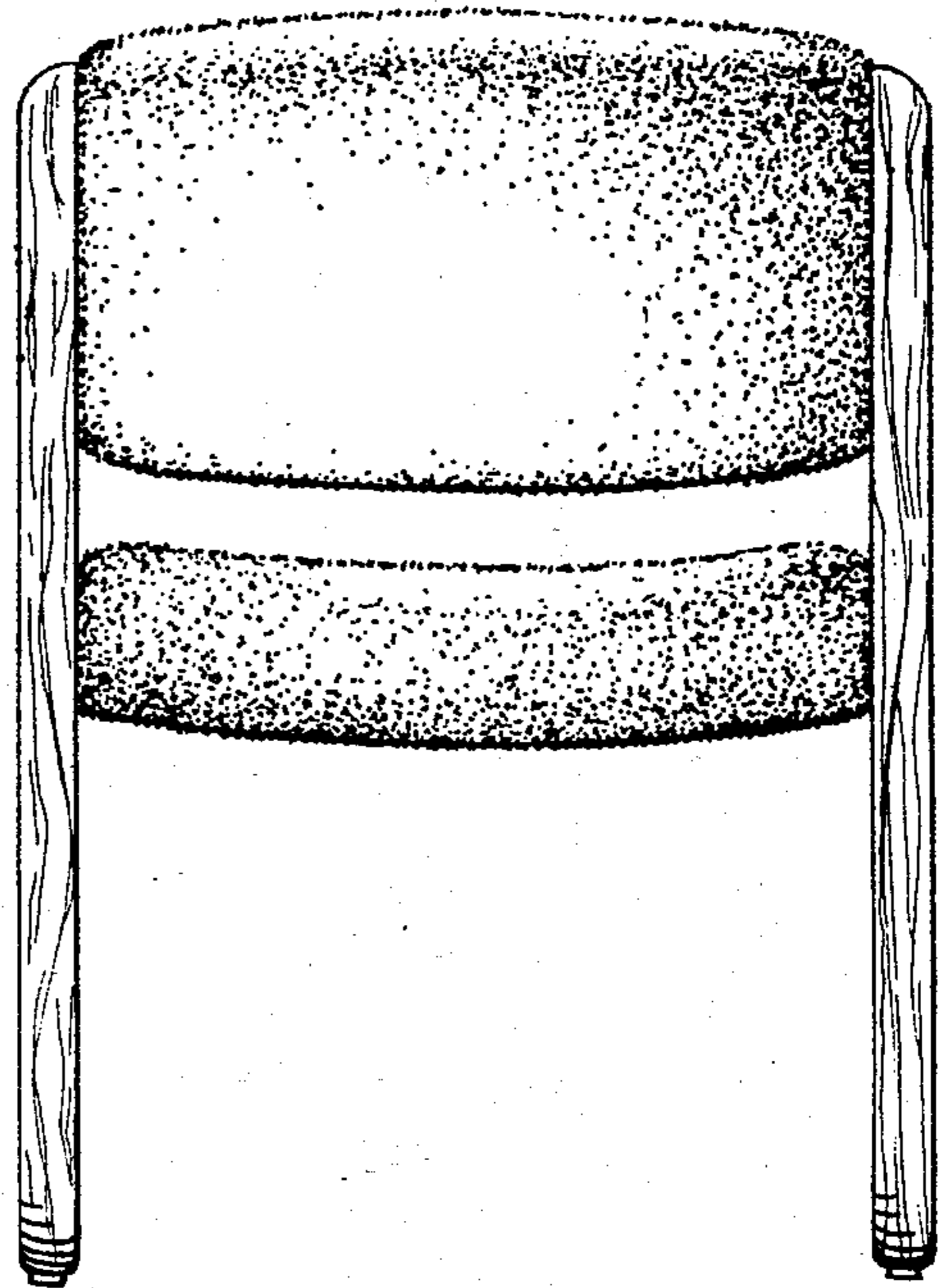

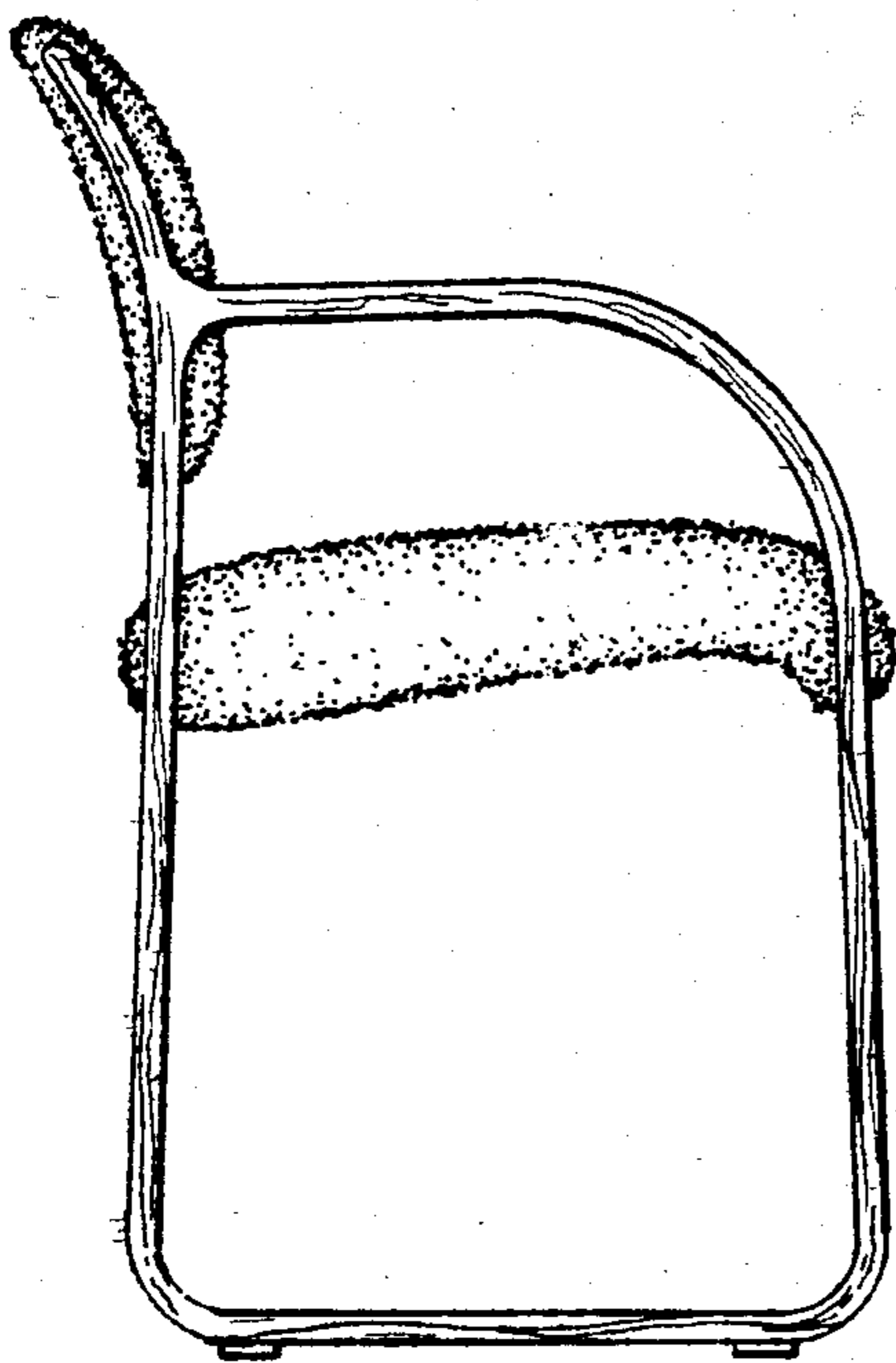

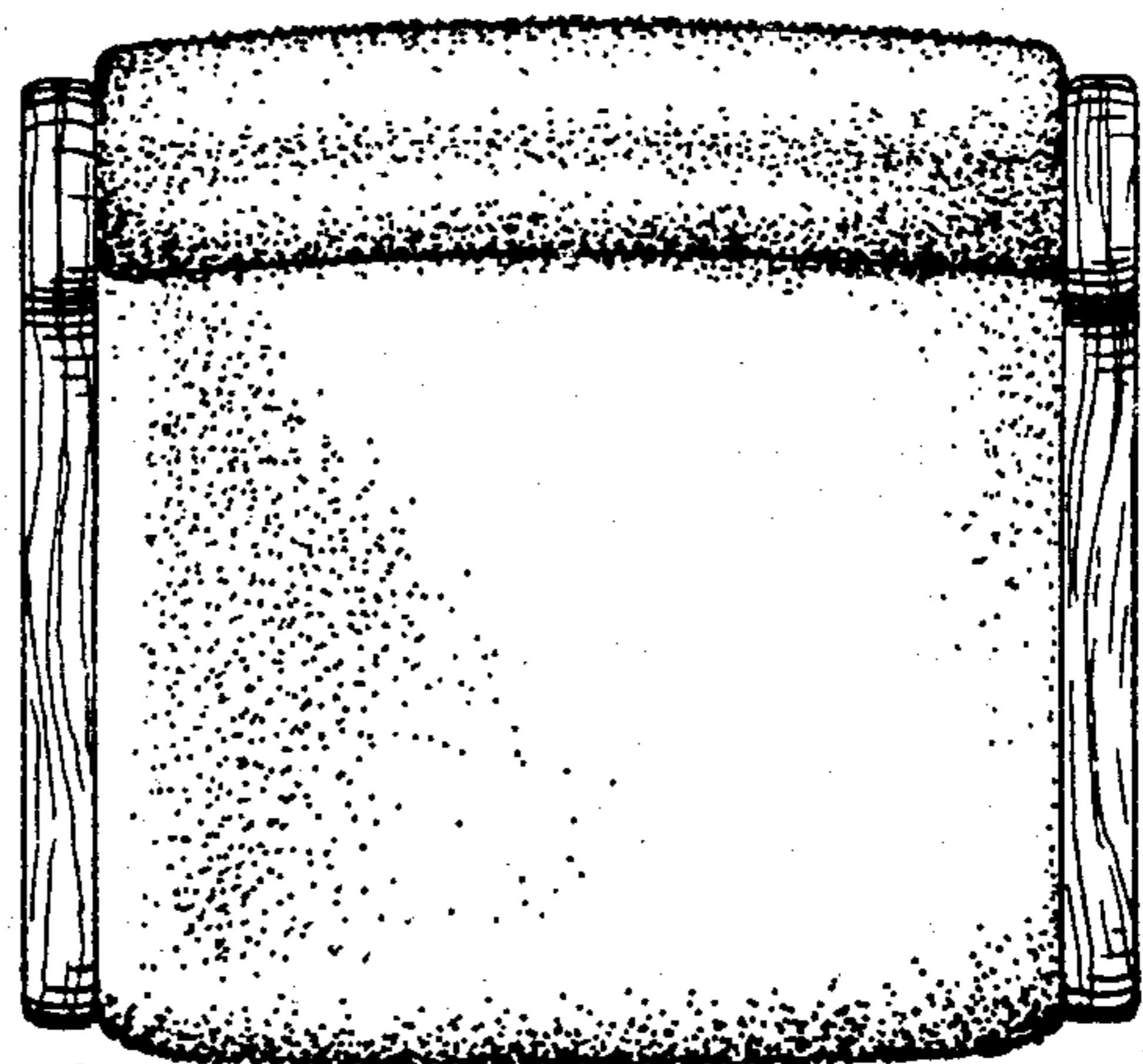

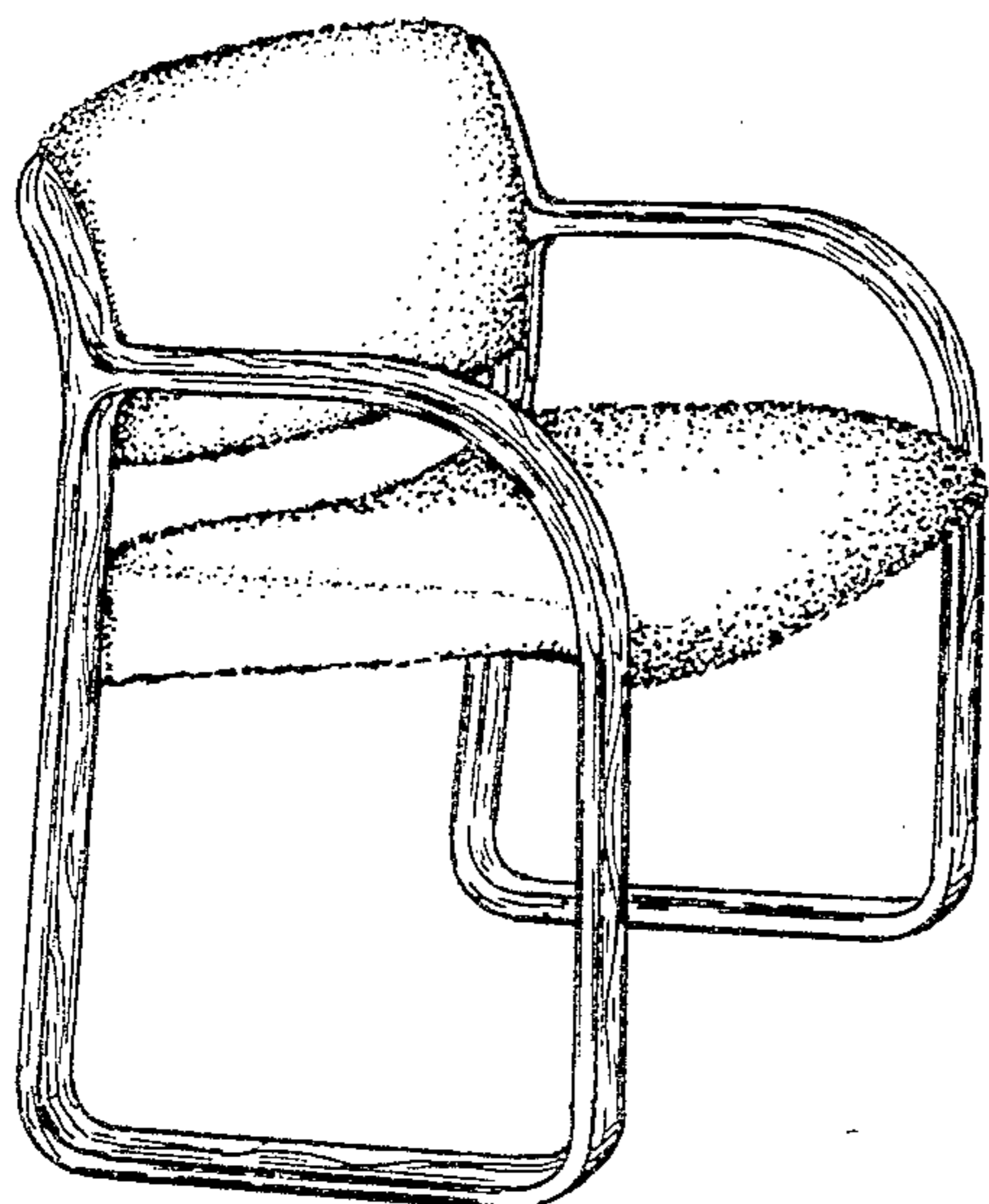

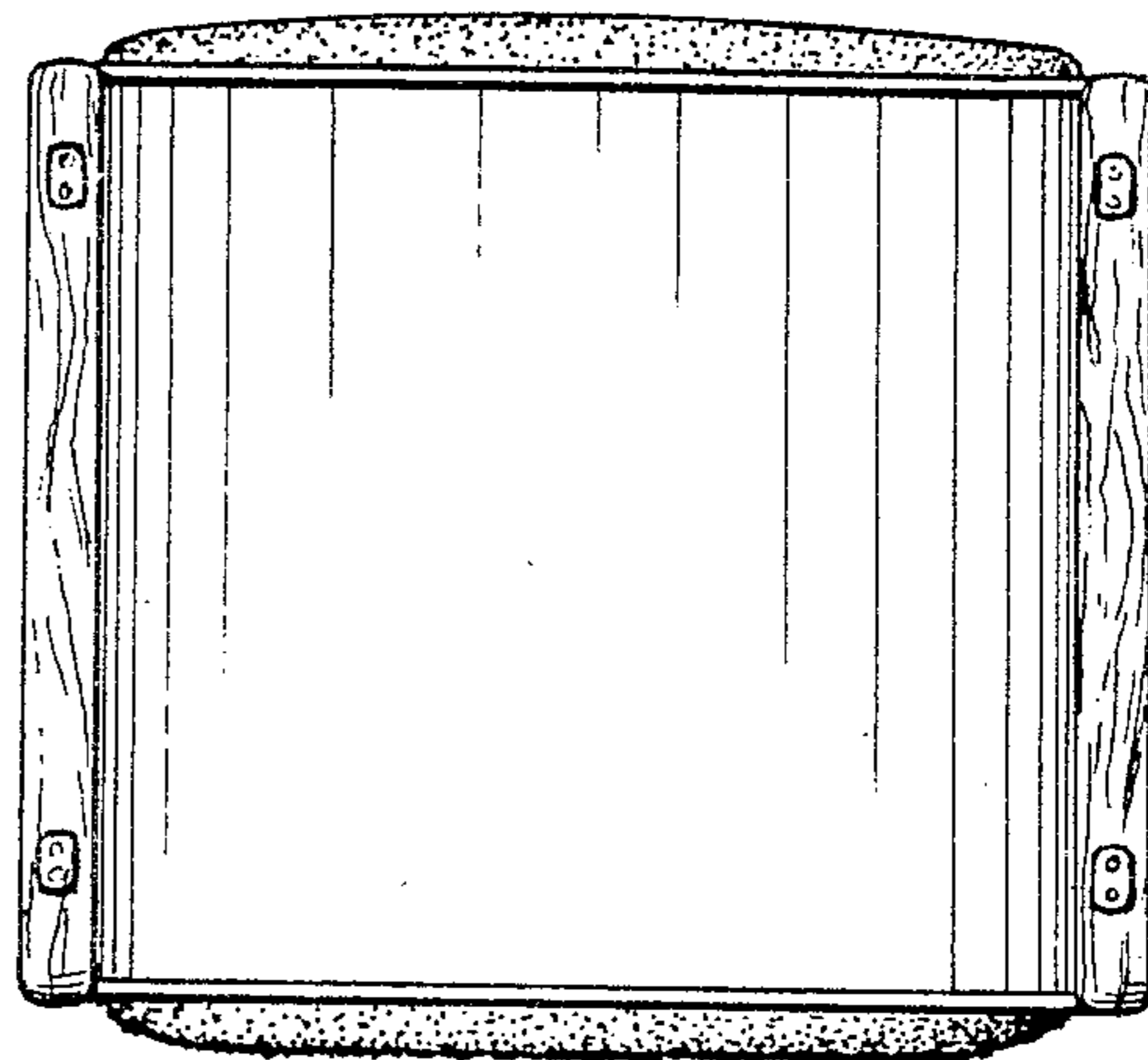

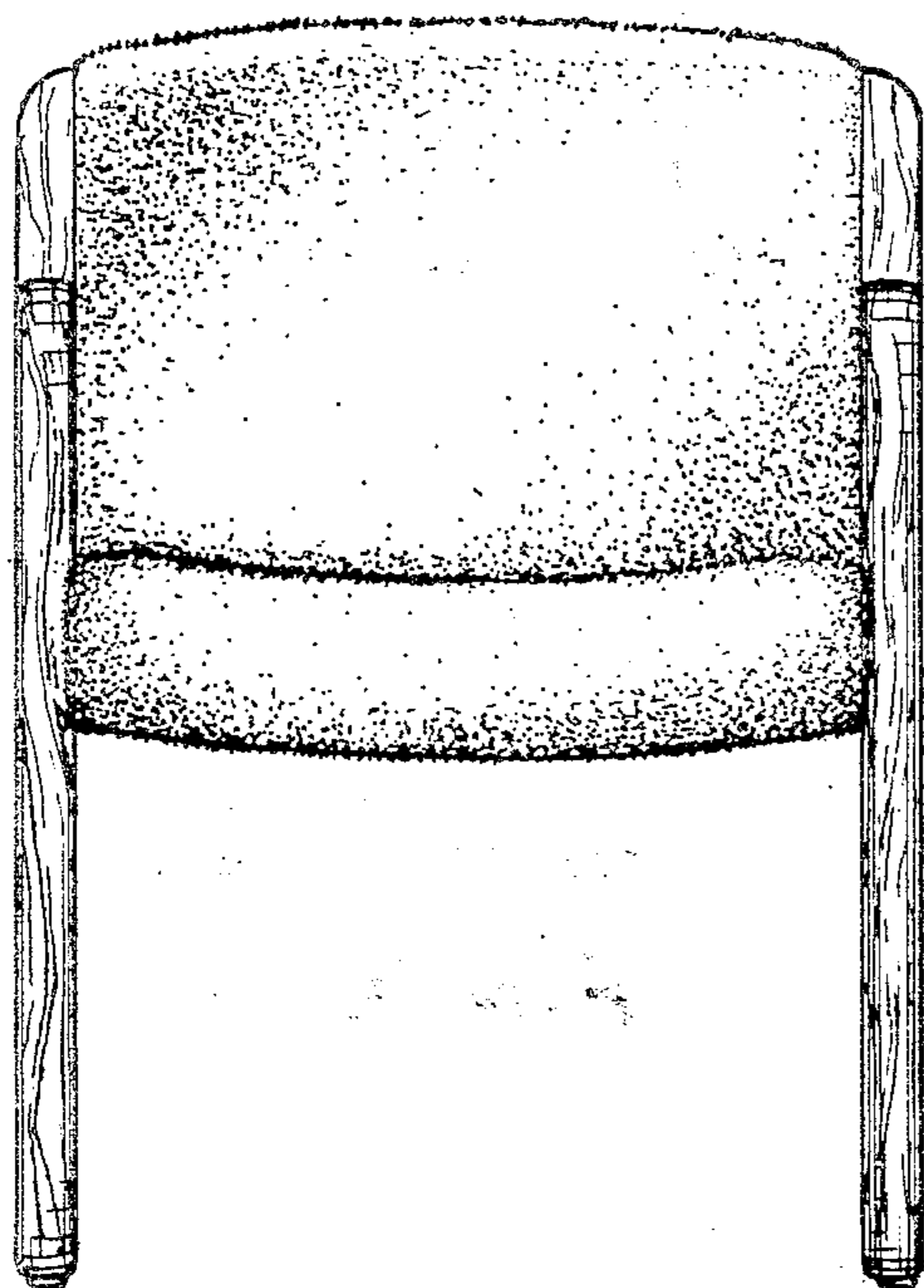

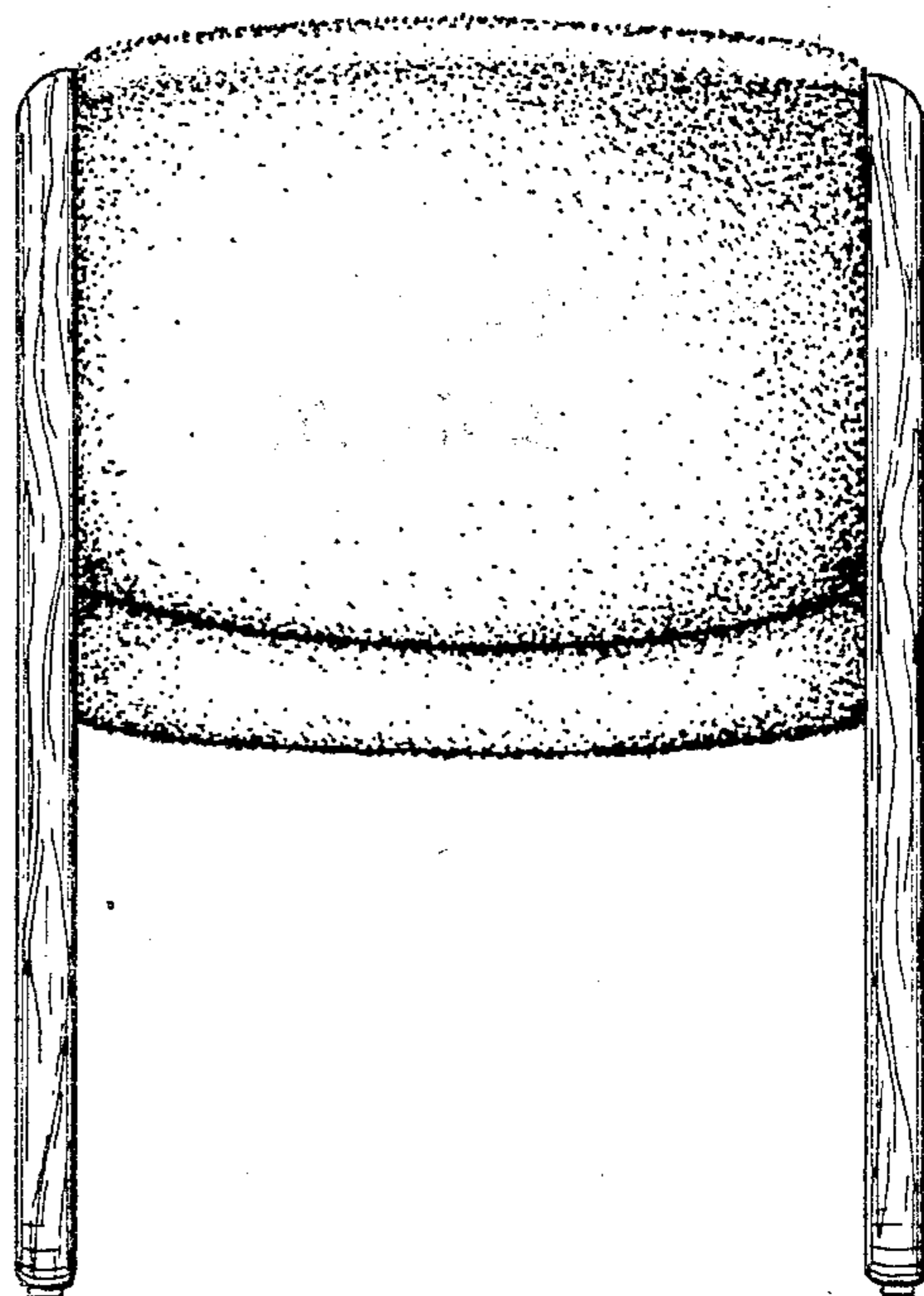

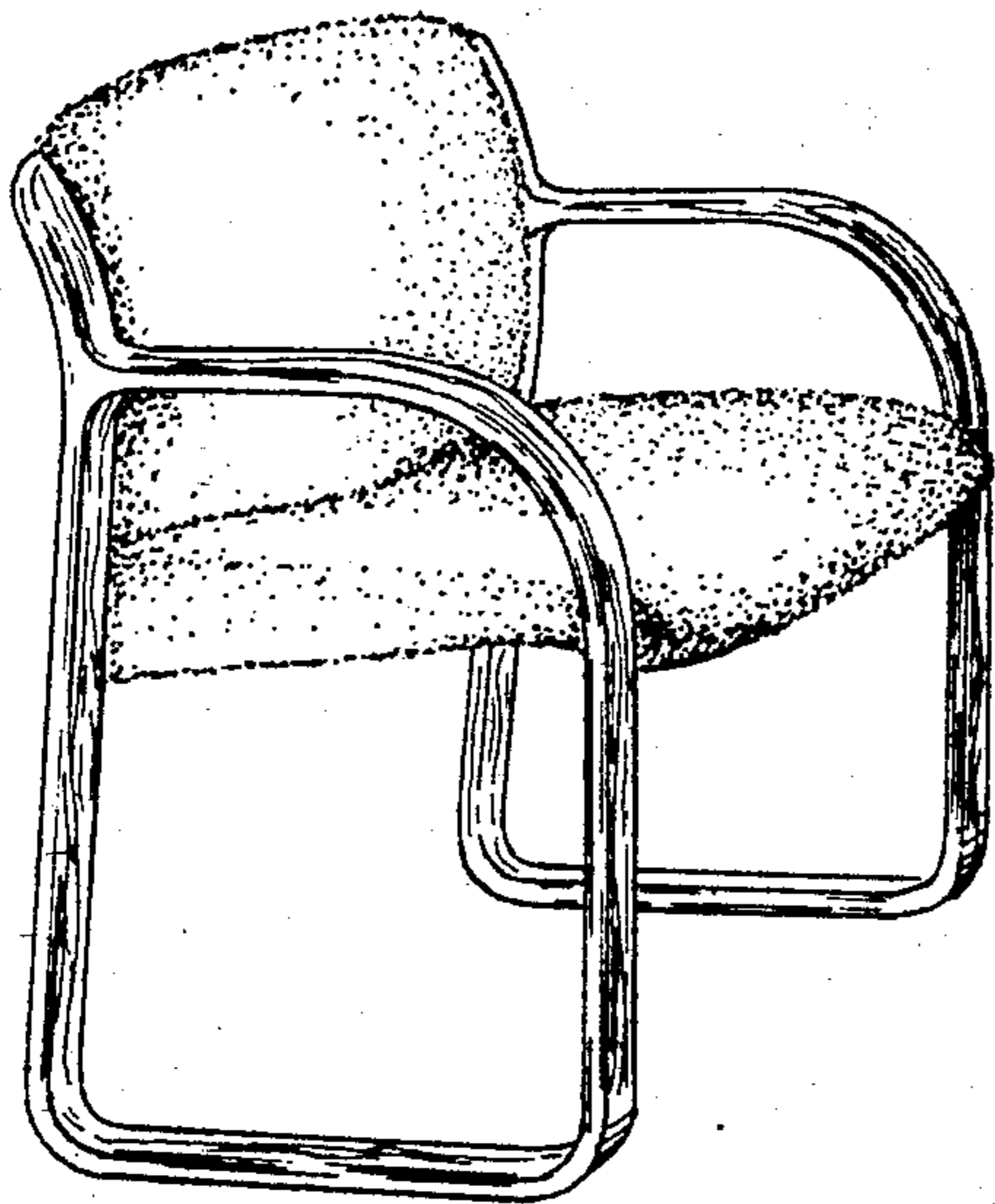

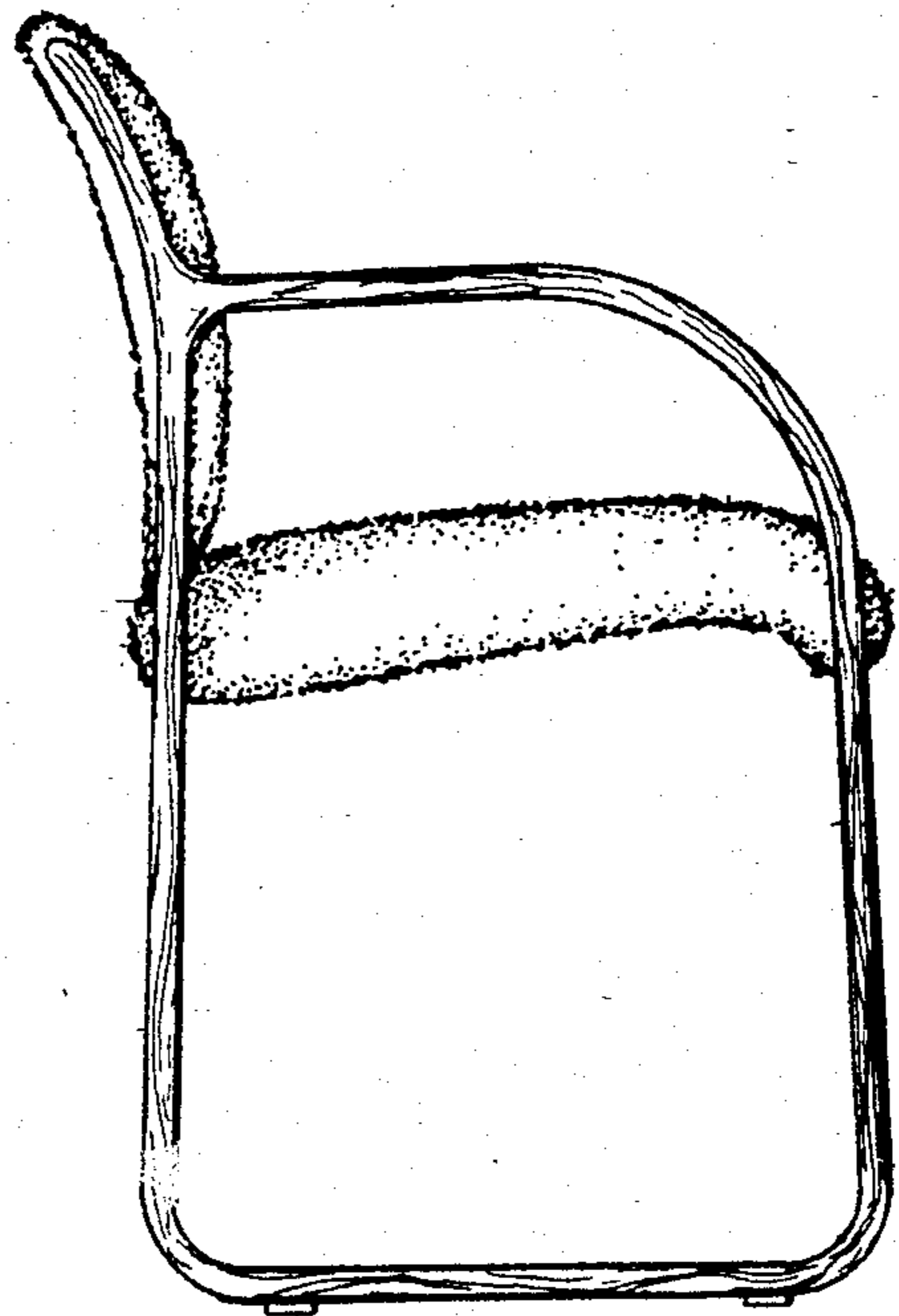

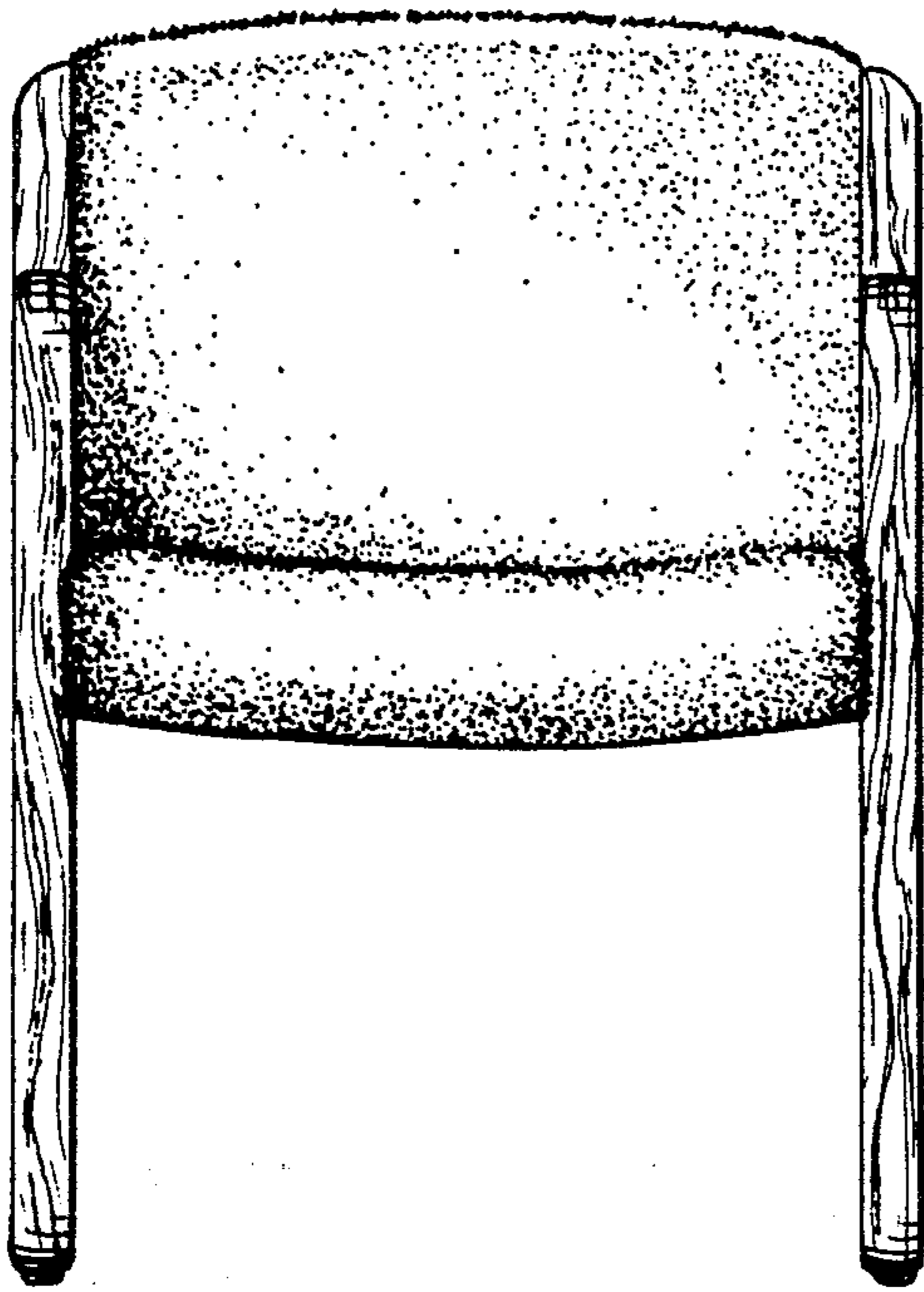

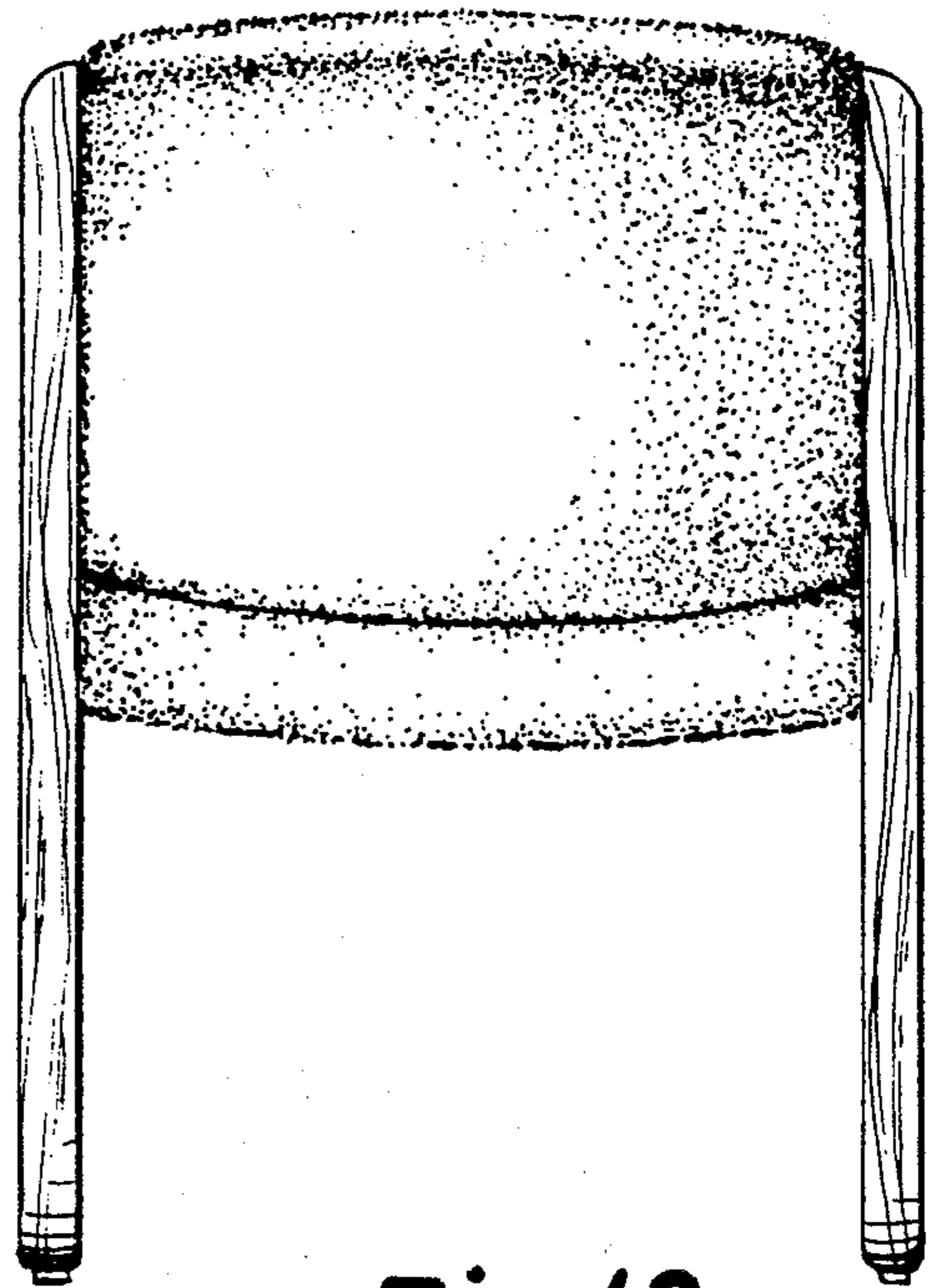

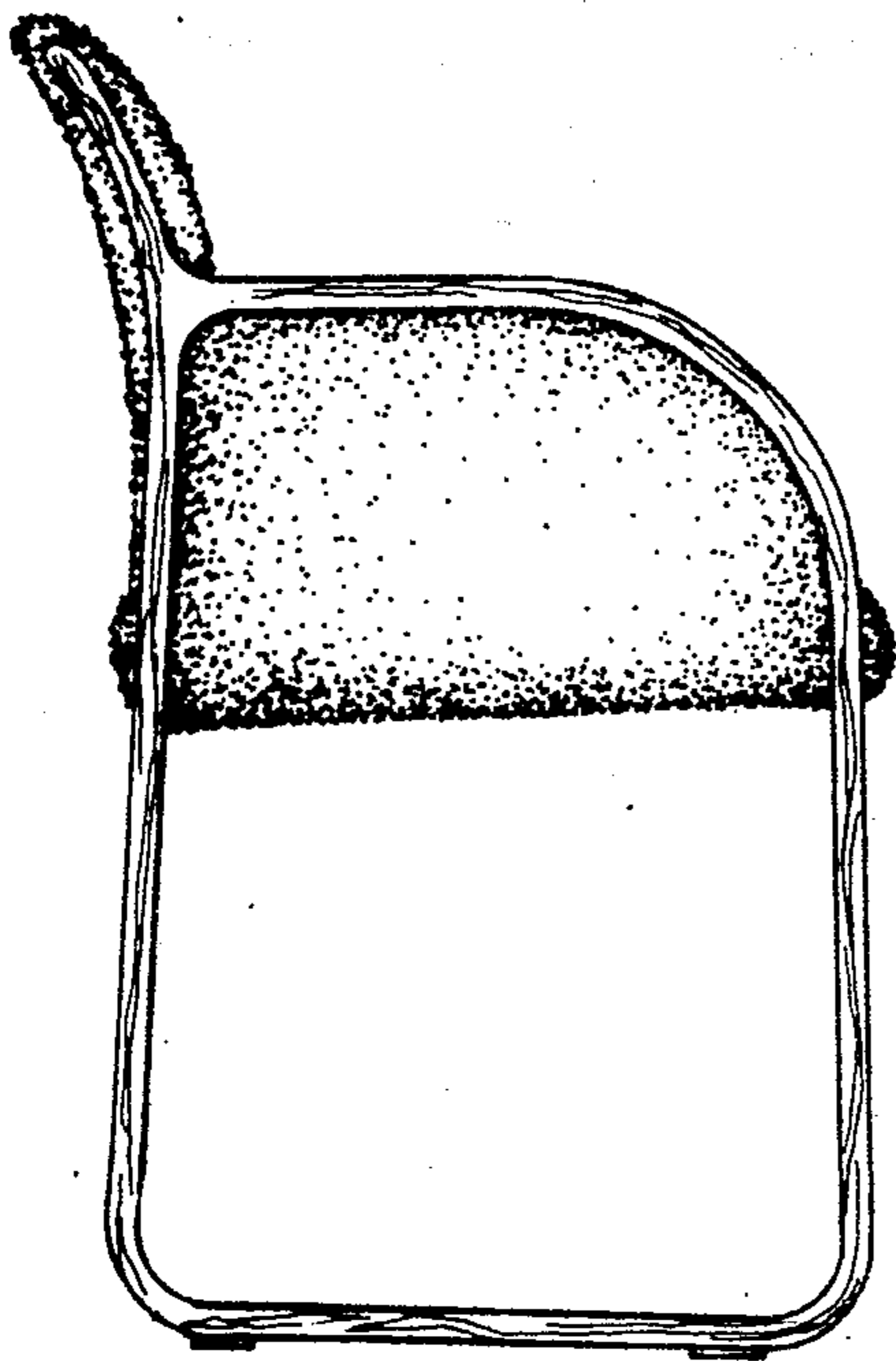

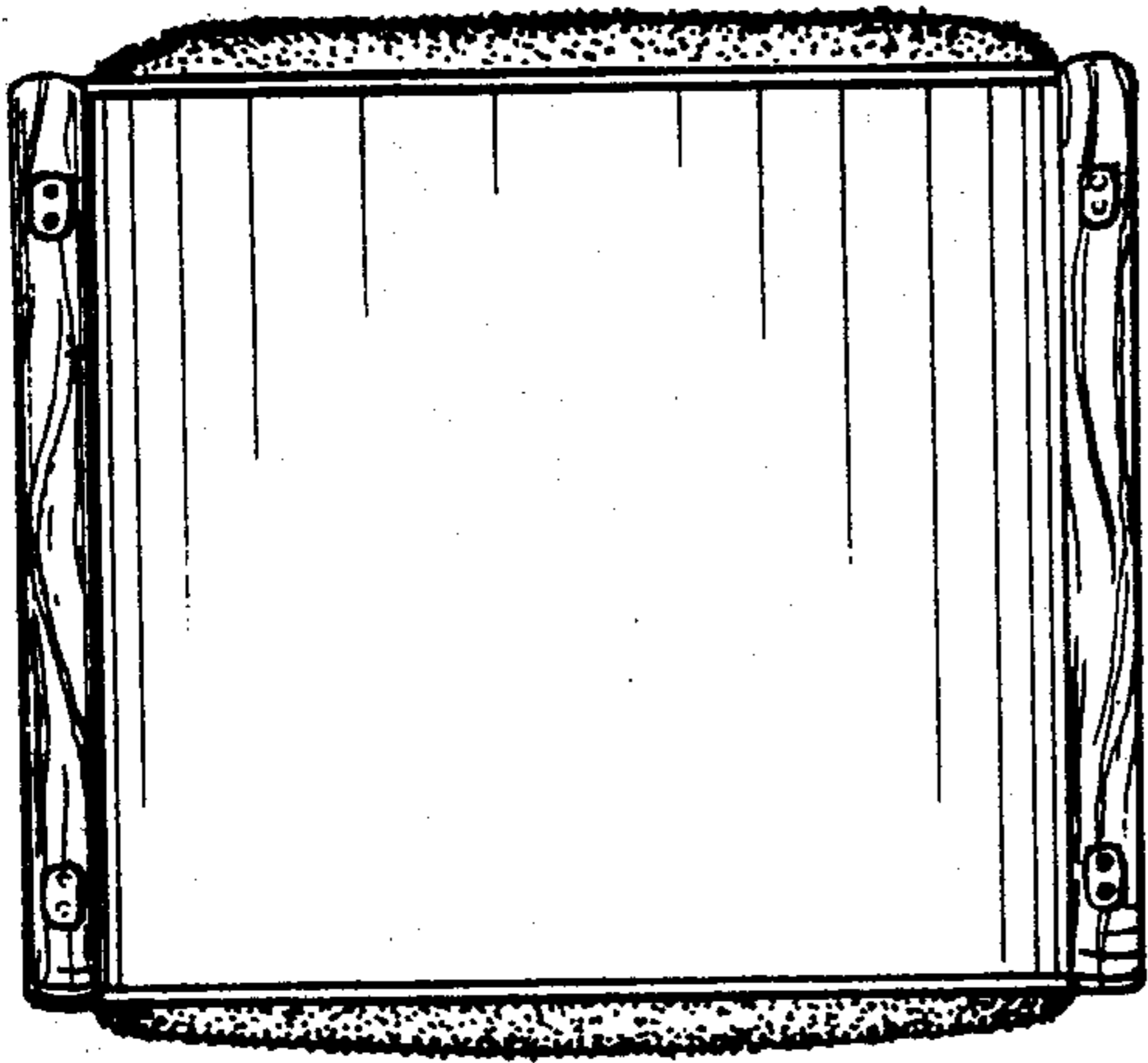

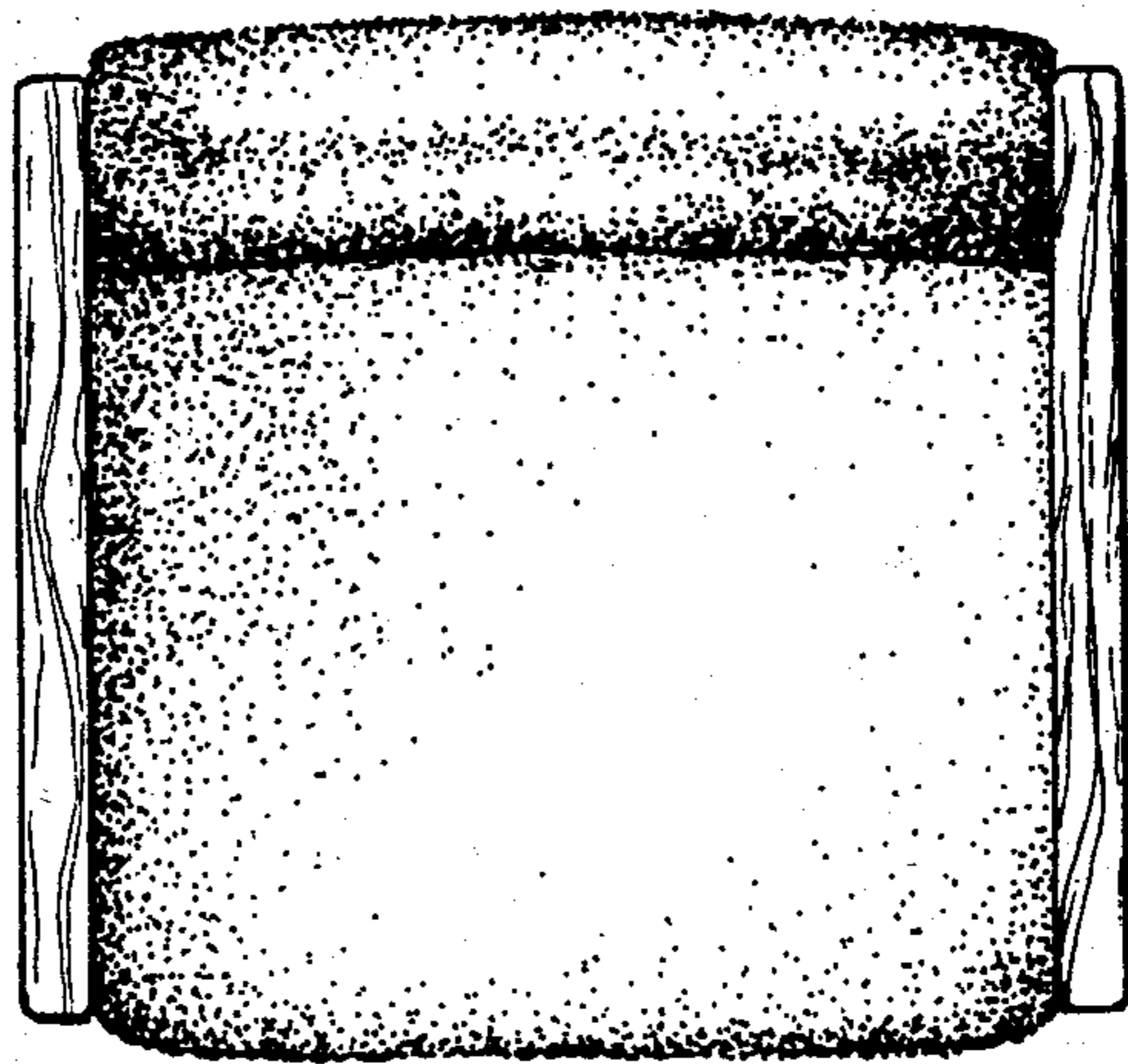

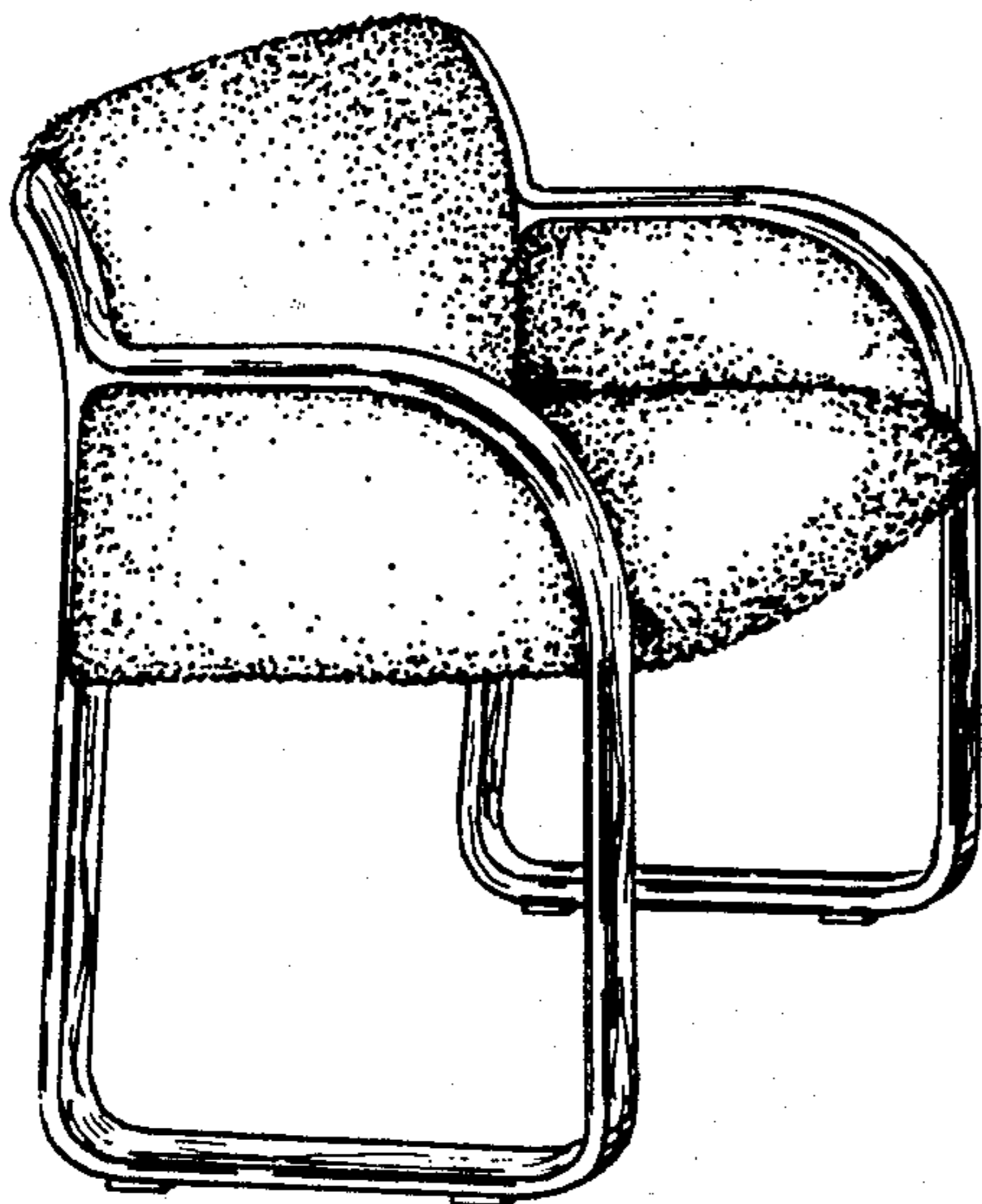

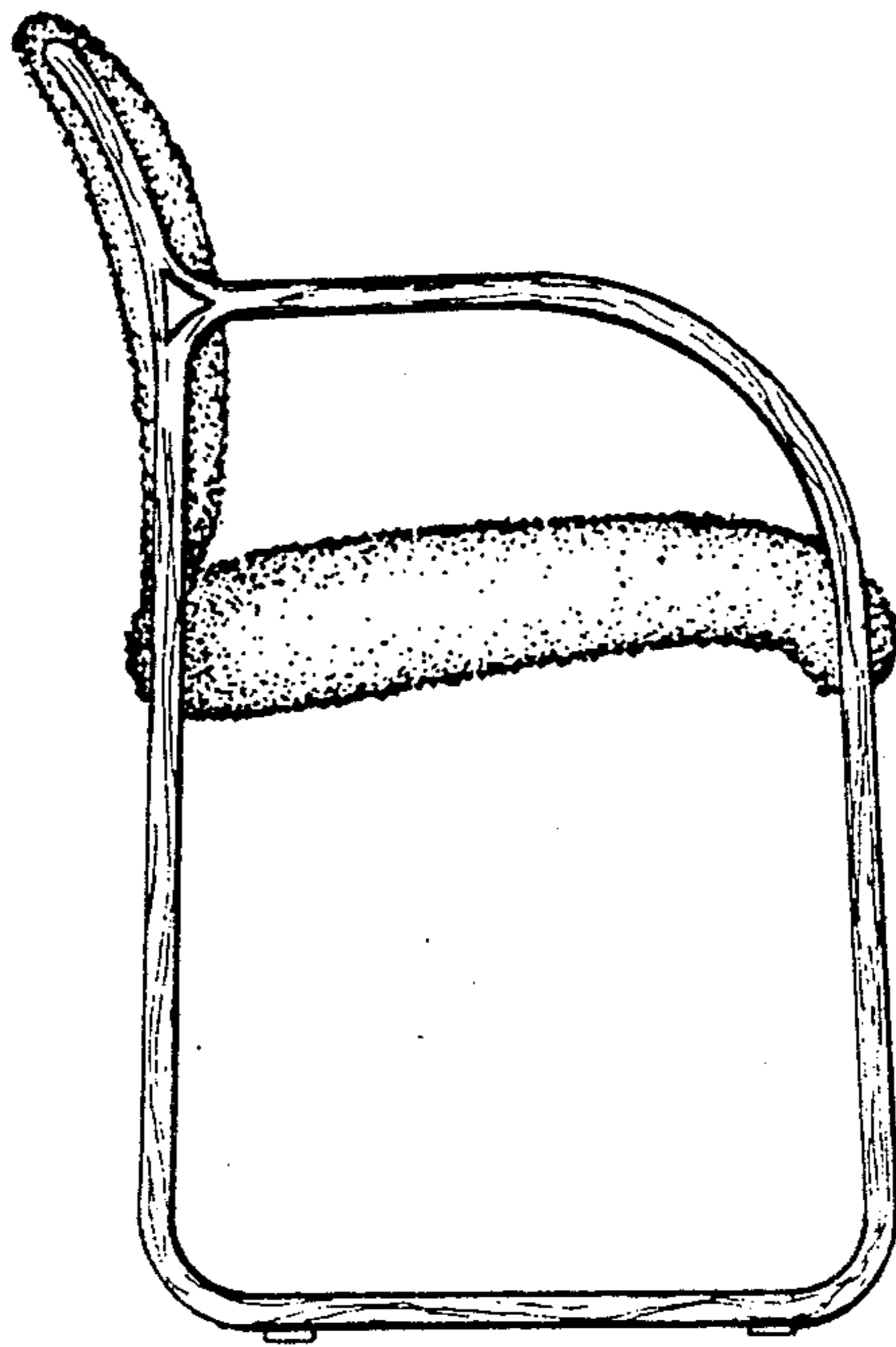
