FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from above and one side of a combined refrigerator and air conditioner showing my new design;

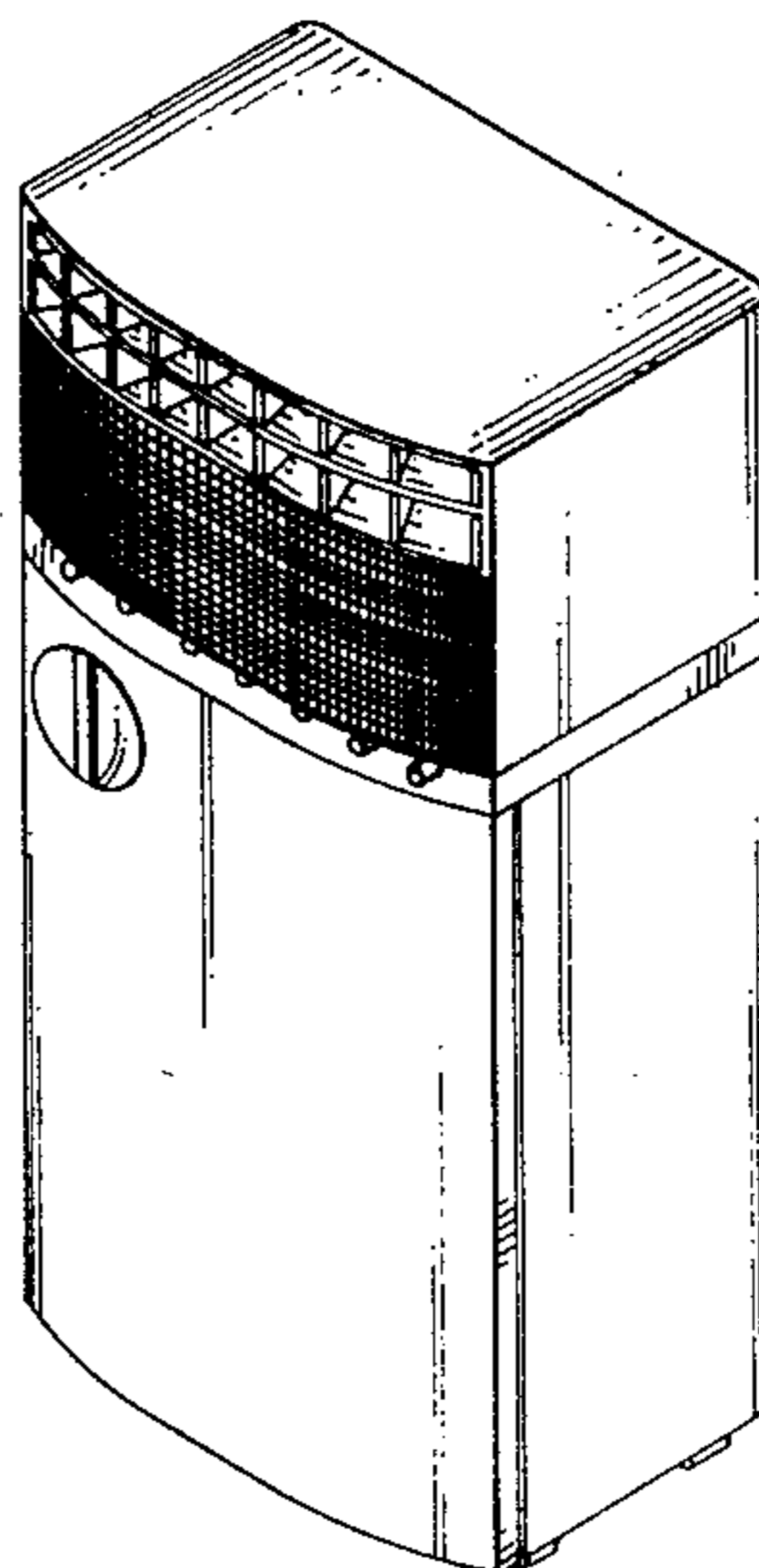
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation thereof.



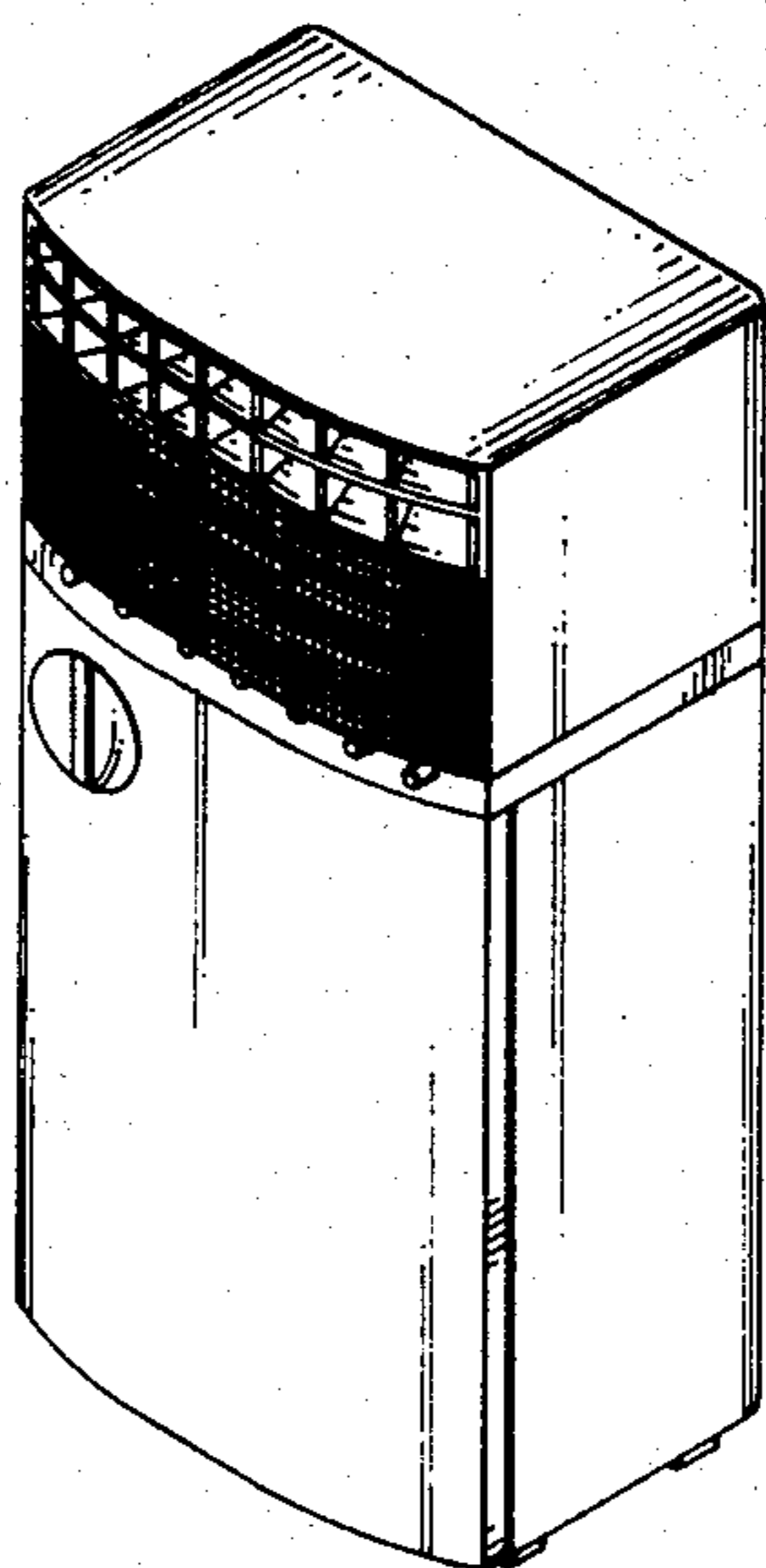

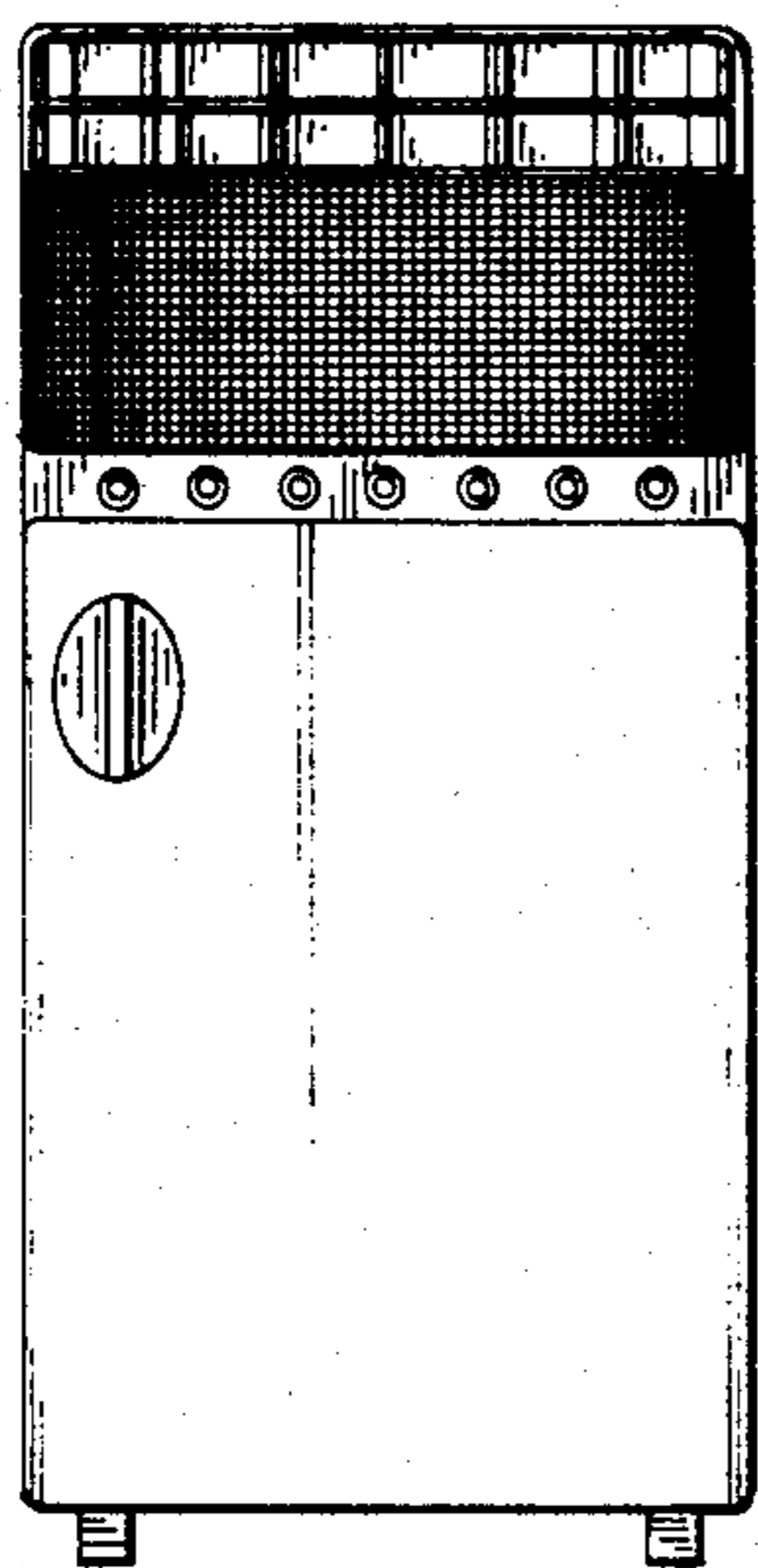

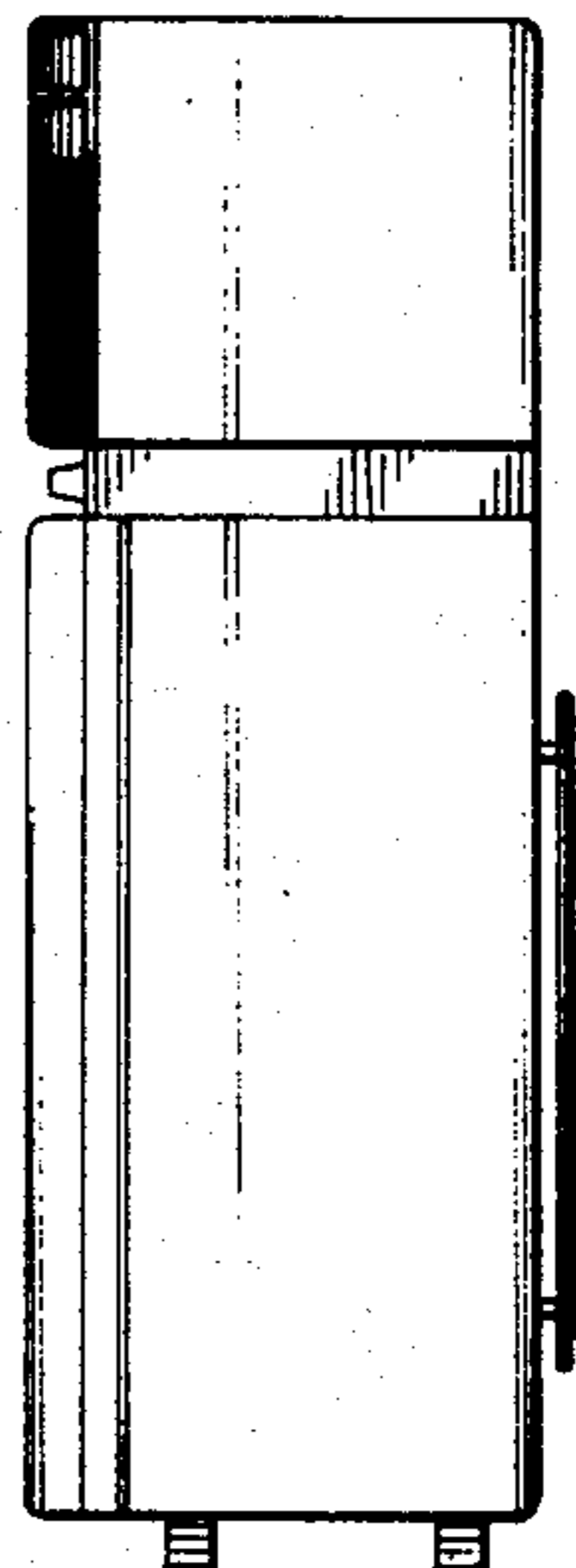

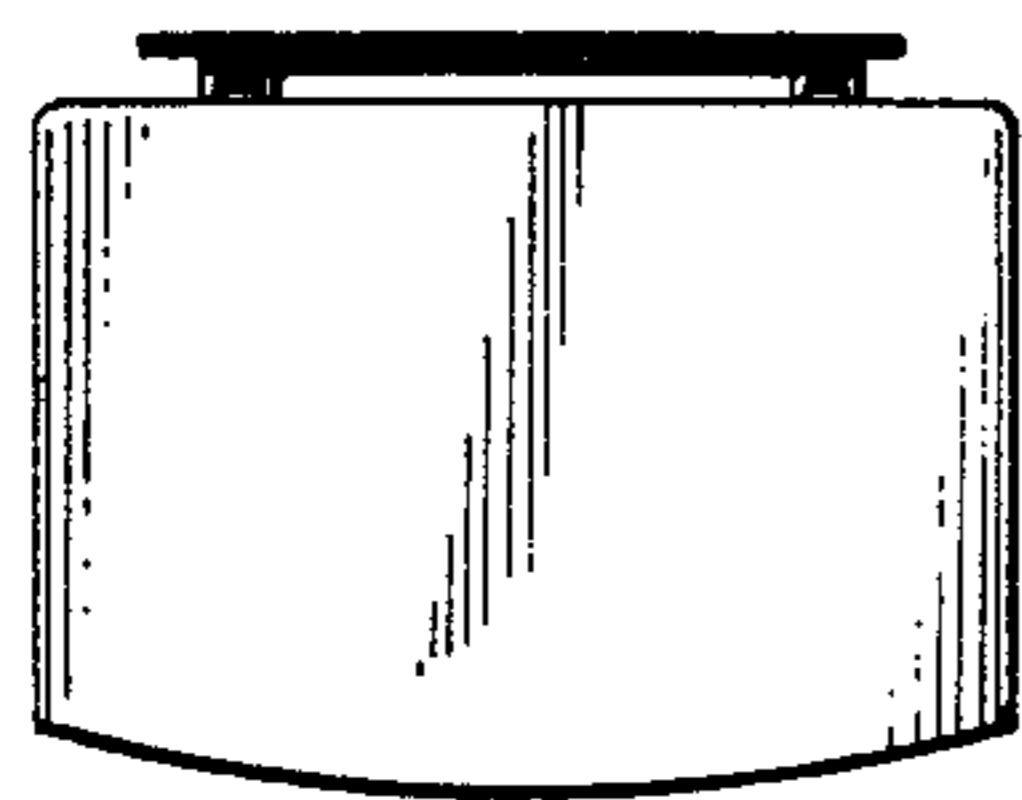

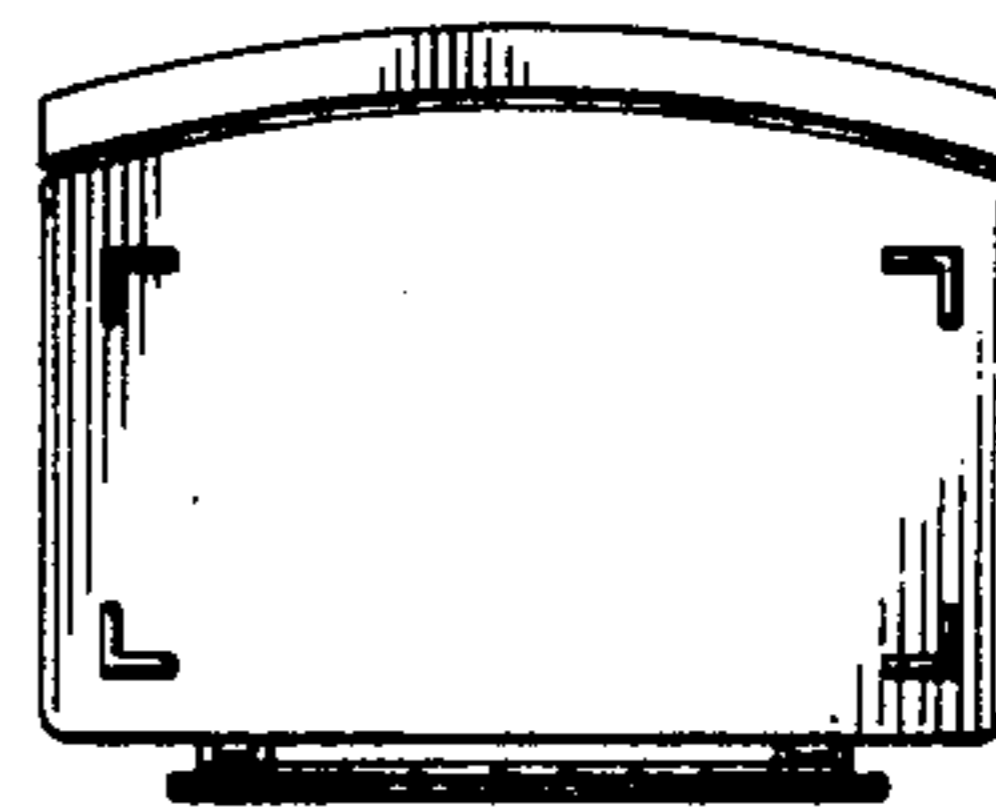

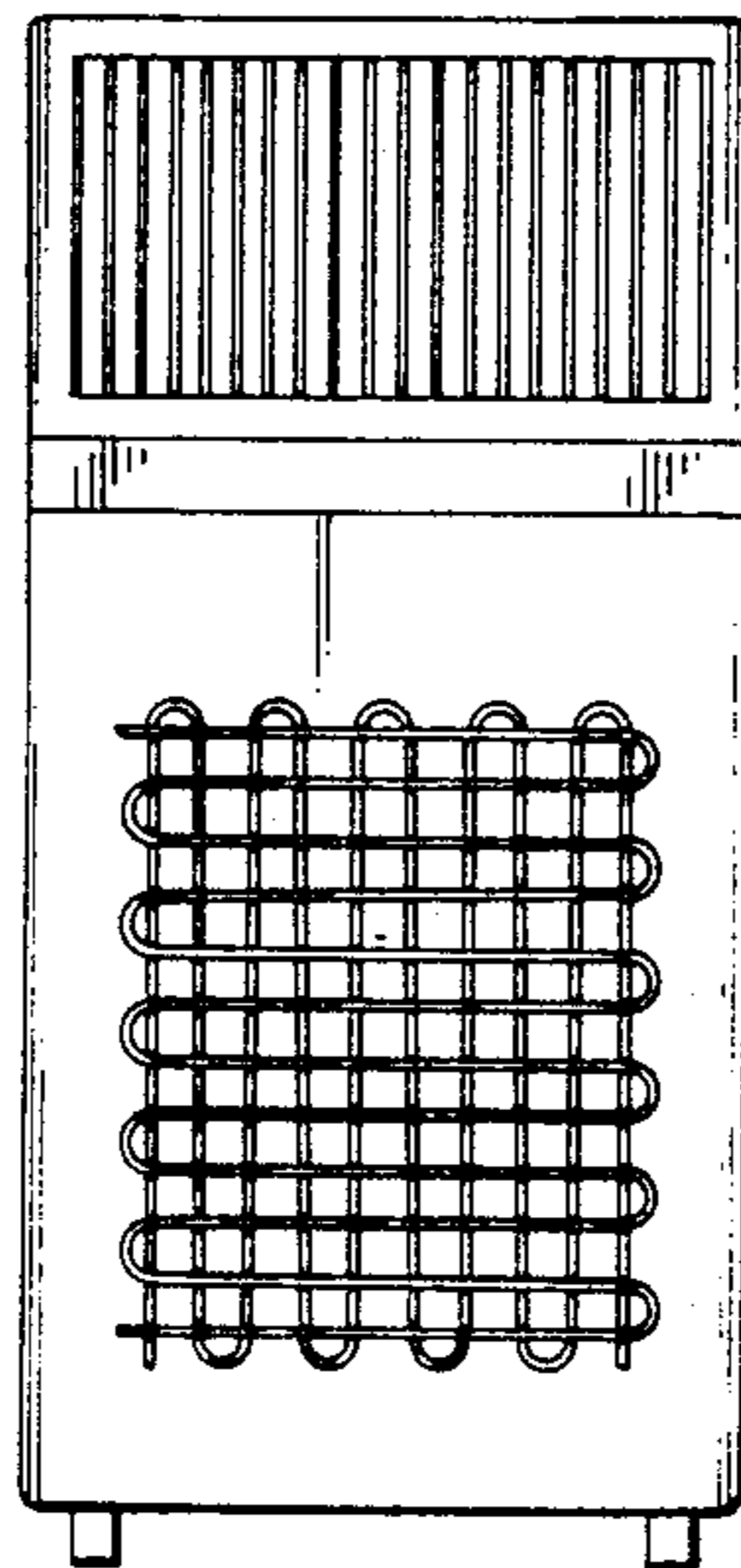
