thereof, illustrated with the cover in the closed position.

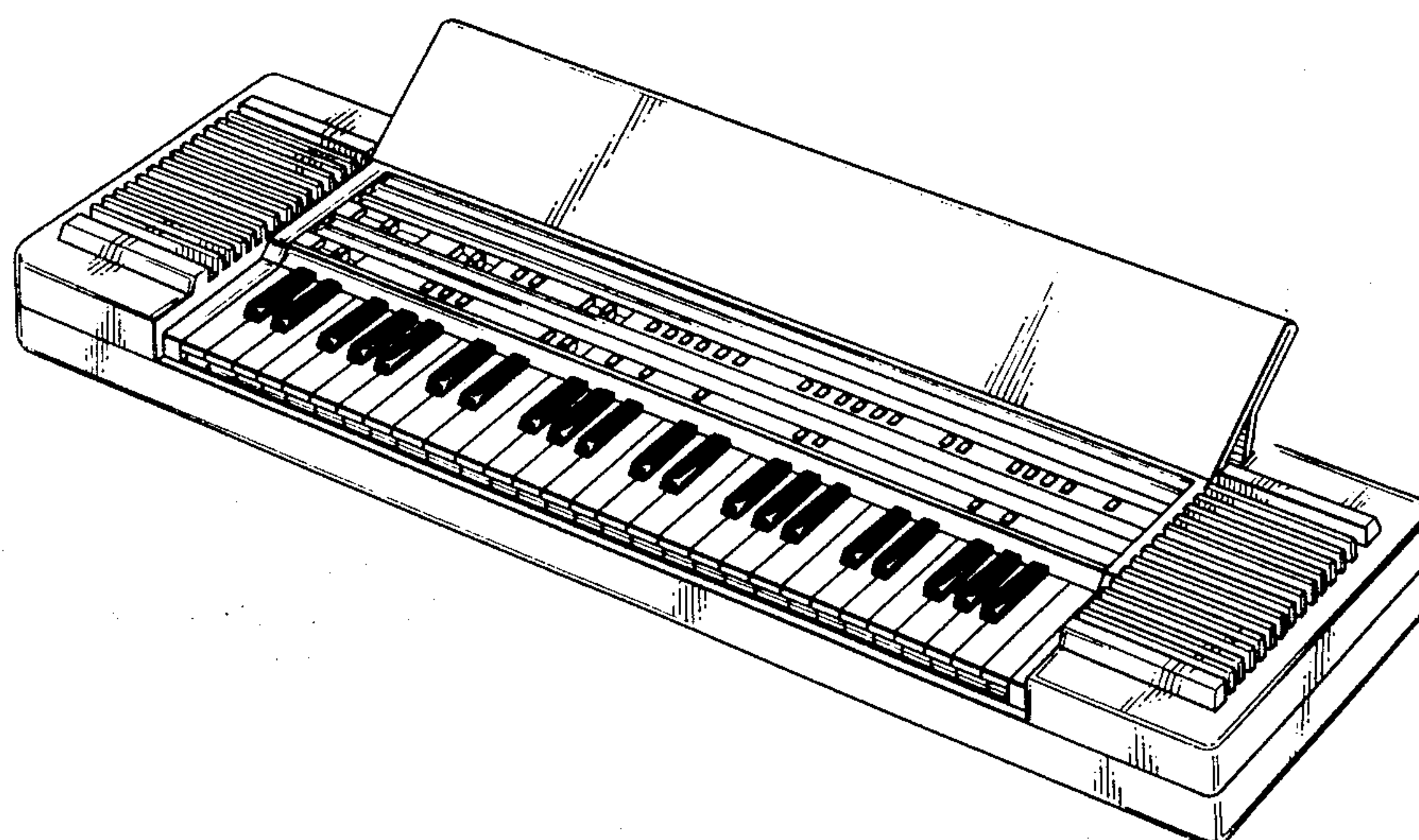

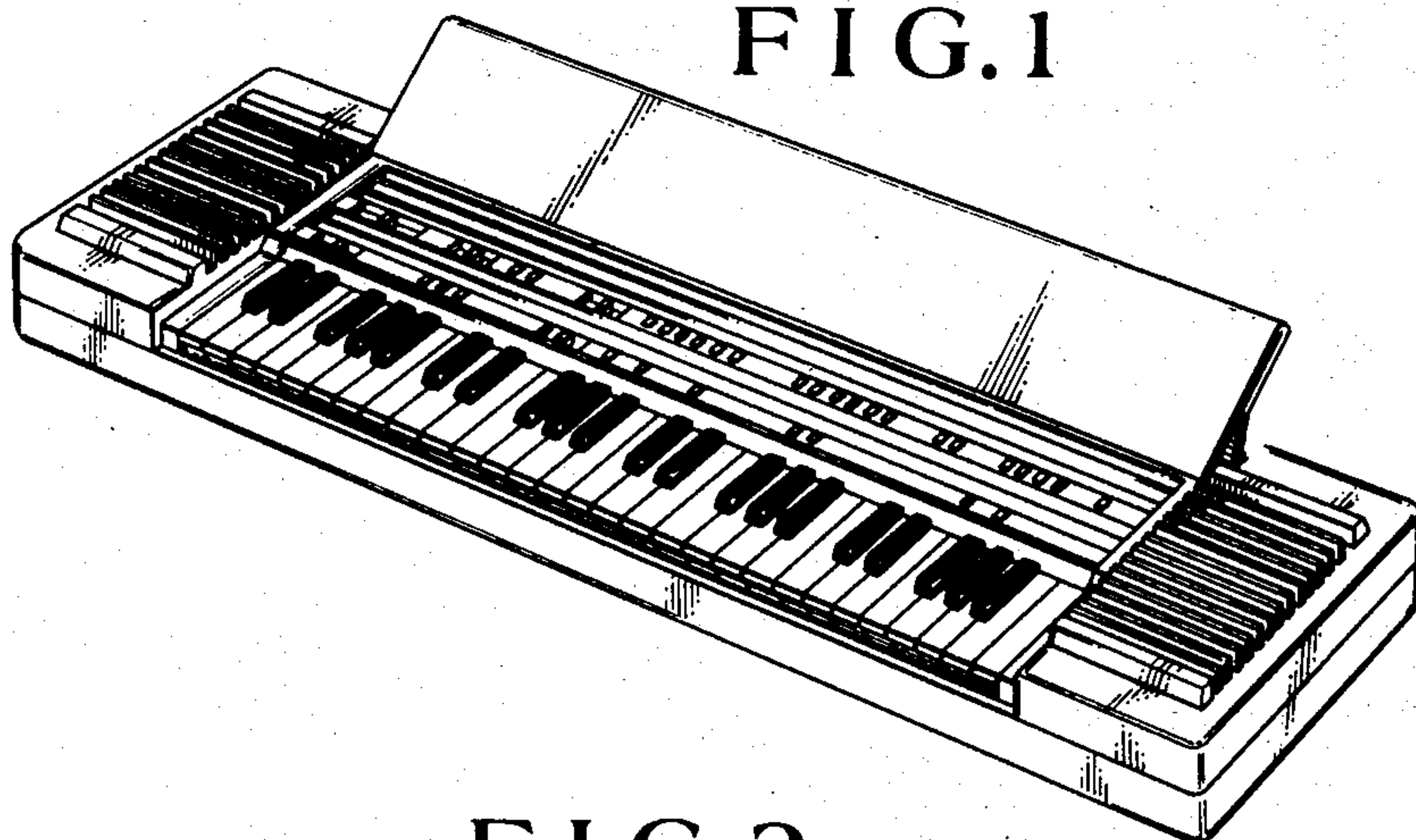

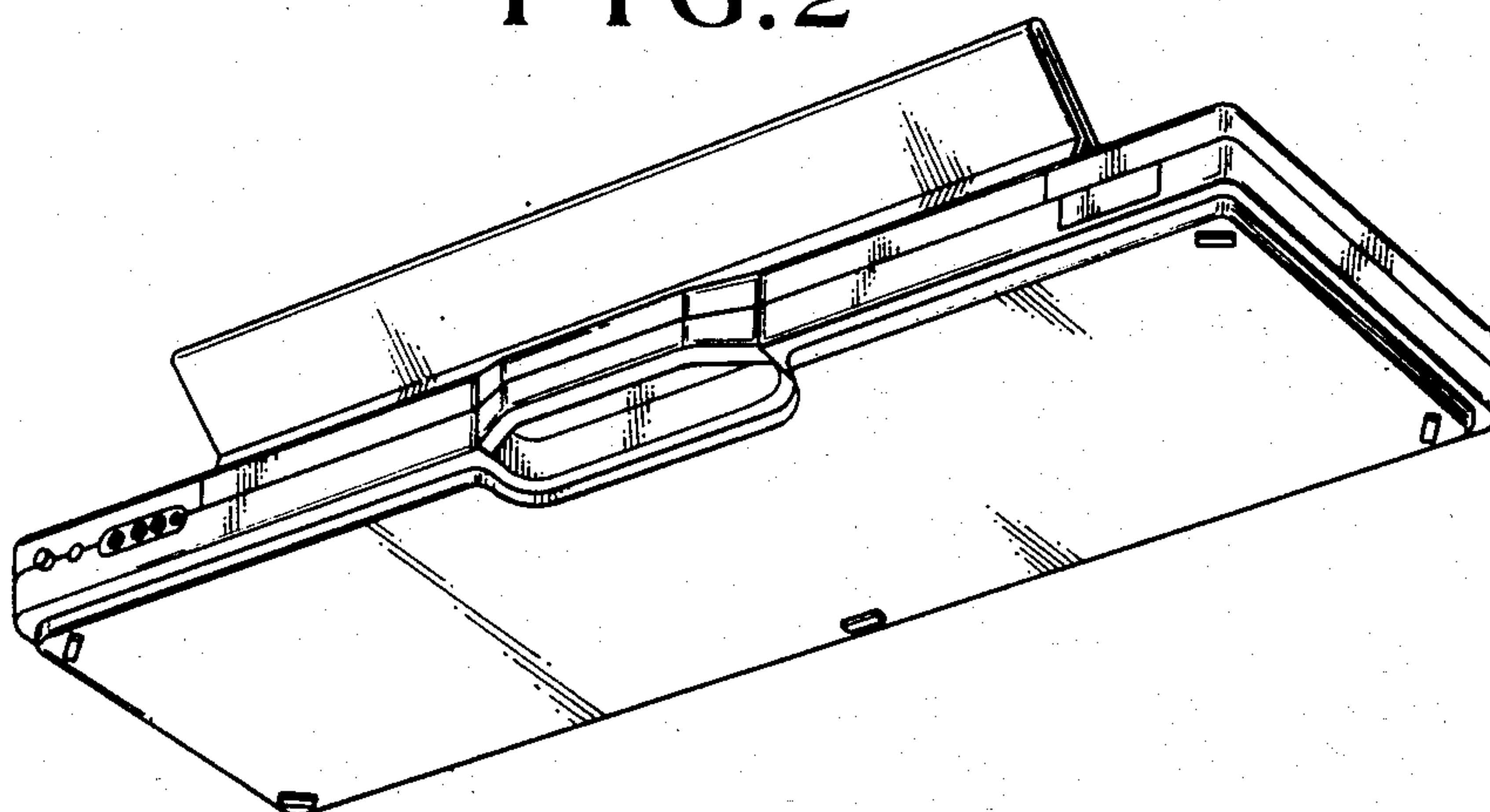

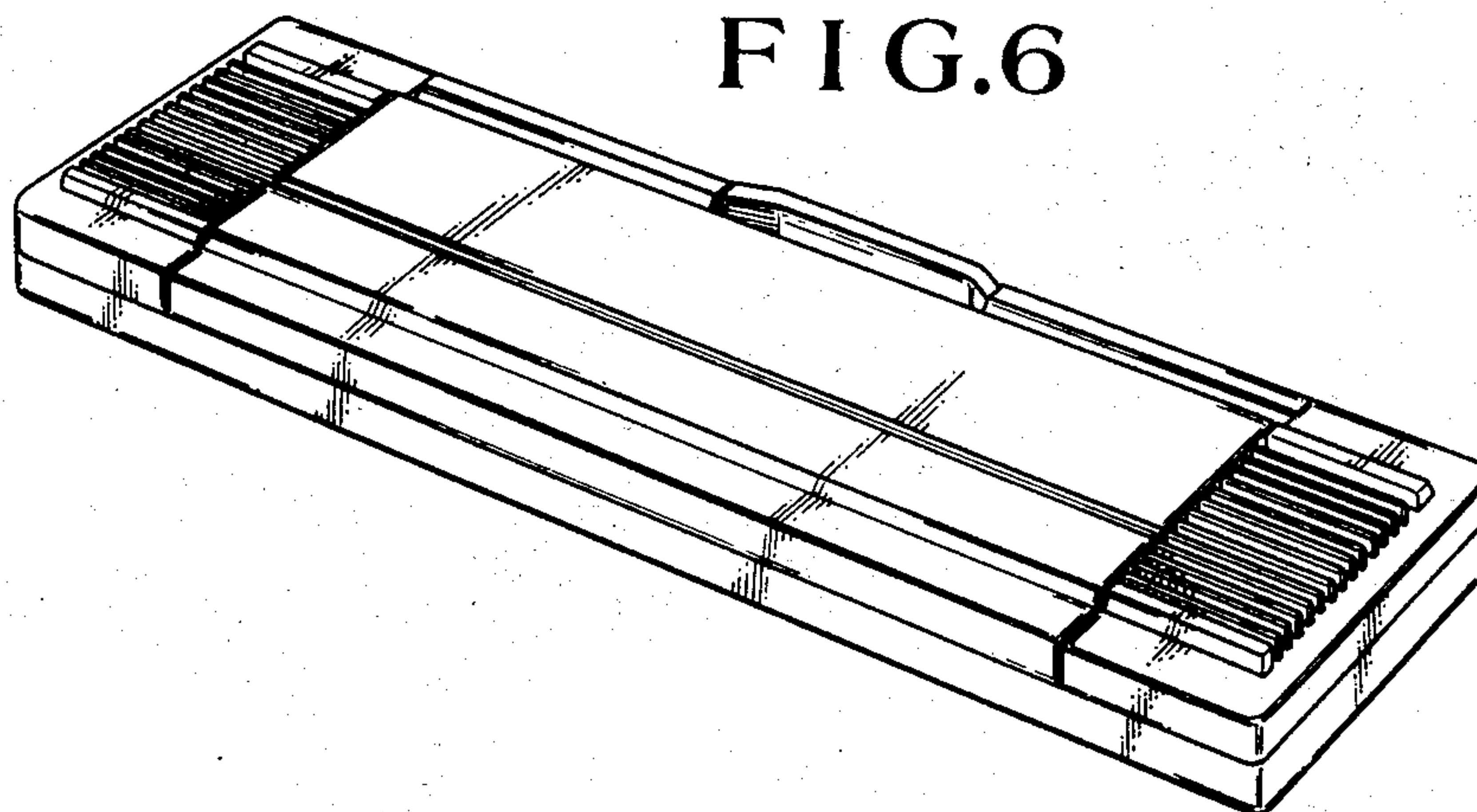

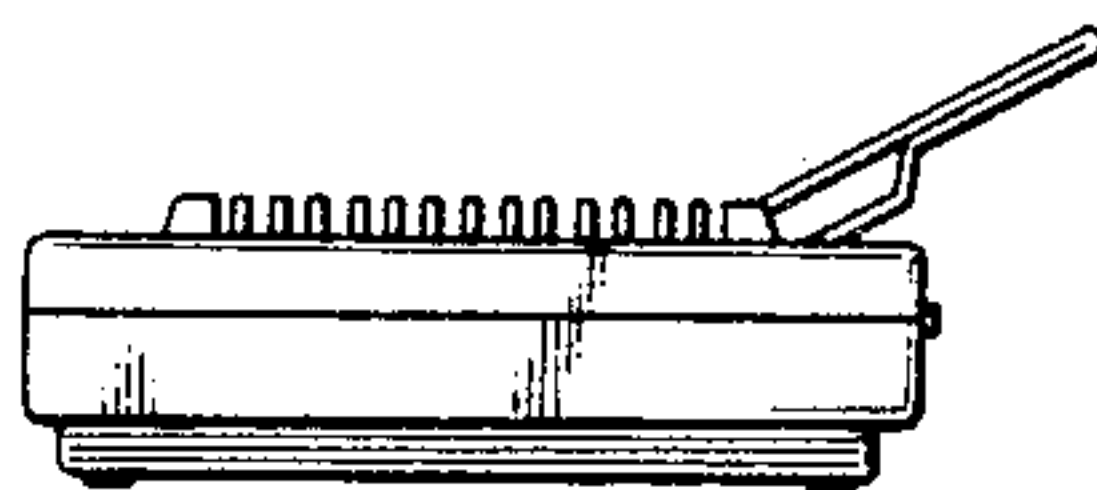

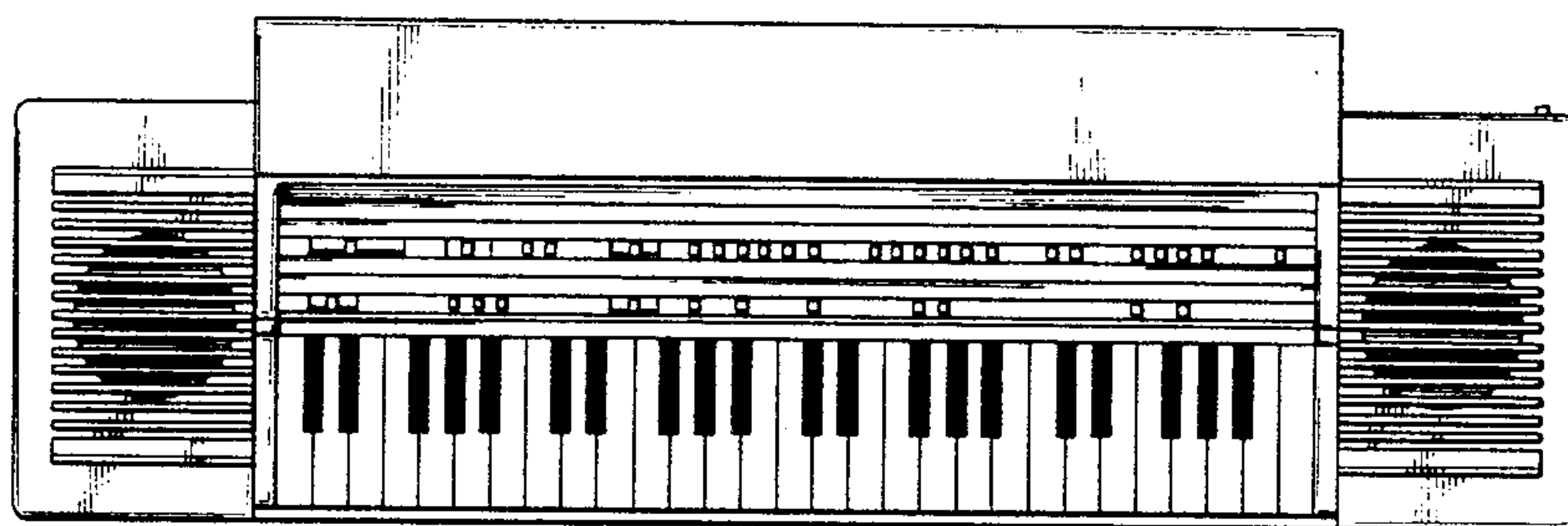
